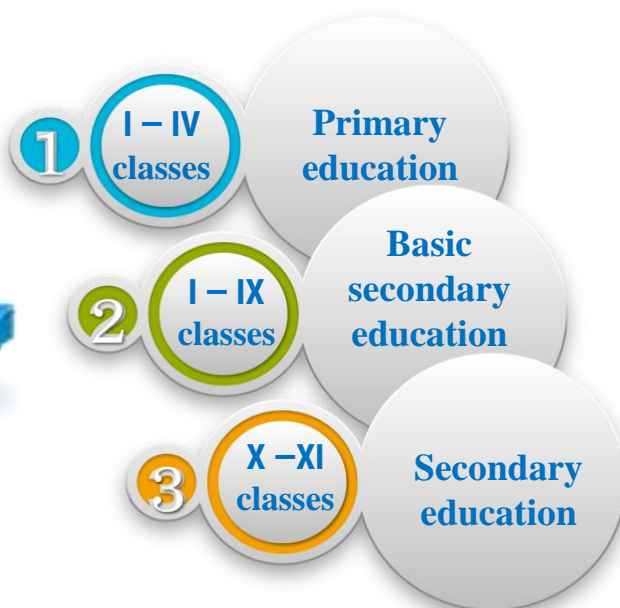

THE SYSTEM OF GENERAL SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

The duration of general secondary education is 11 years, which is a mandatory independent form of the continuing education system.

General secondary education is carried out in general educational institutions continuously, for a mandatory eleven years.

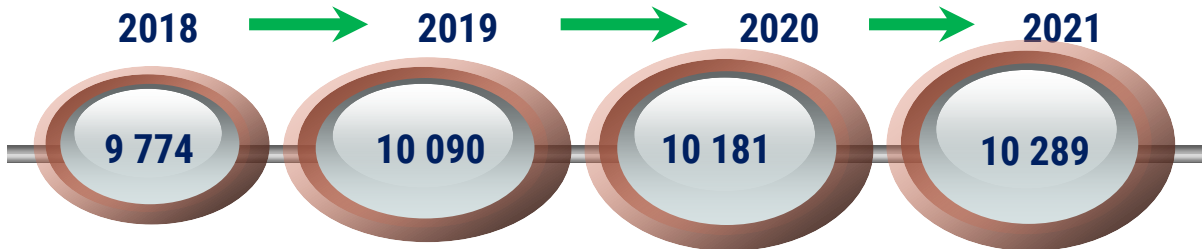
It consists of three levels and has a full-time education.



There are the following types of educational institutions: elementary school, general secondary school, specialized school for individual subjects, specialized boarding school for individual subjects, creative school, Presidential school, state specialized boarding school for Olympic and national sports, specialized boarding school for children with physical disabilities, a specialized (auxiliary) school for children with mental, sensory (sensory) or mental disabilities, a boarding school, a specialized boarding school of a sanatorium type, a republican specialized educational institution.

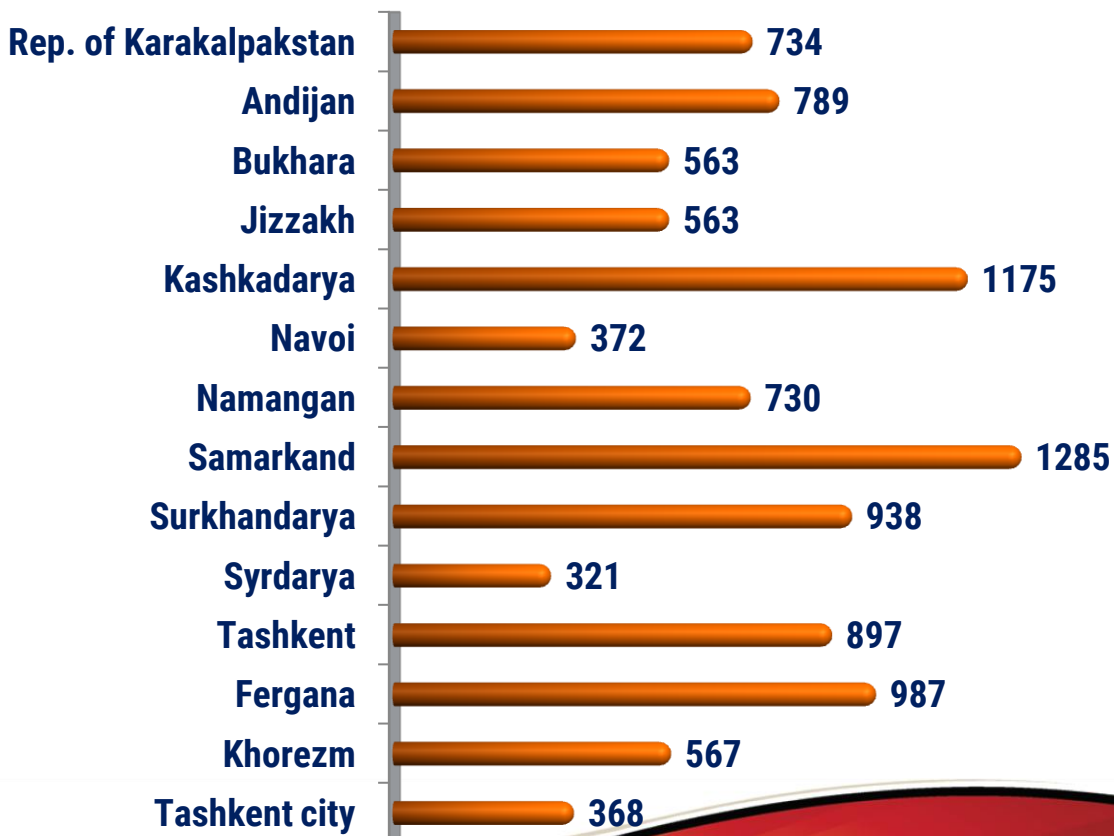

In the Republic of Uzbekistan, the number of operating general education institutions at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year amounted to 10 289 units, which, compared to 2018, increased by 515 units.

Number of general education institutions by region (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, units)



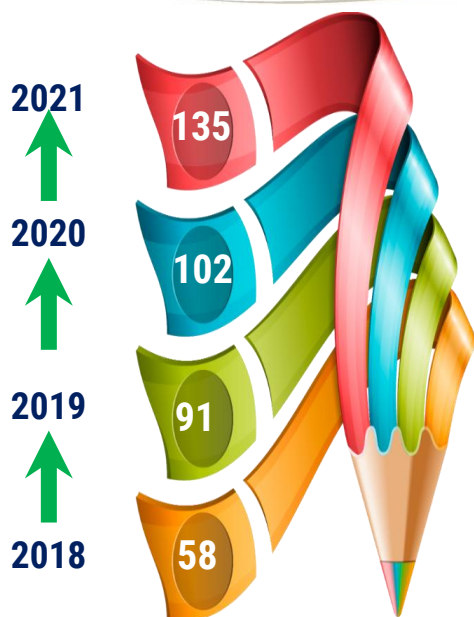

Number of non-state educational organizations (at the beginning of the academic year, units)

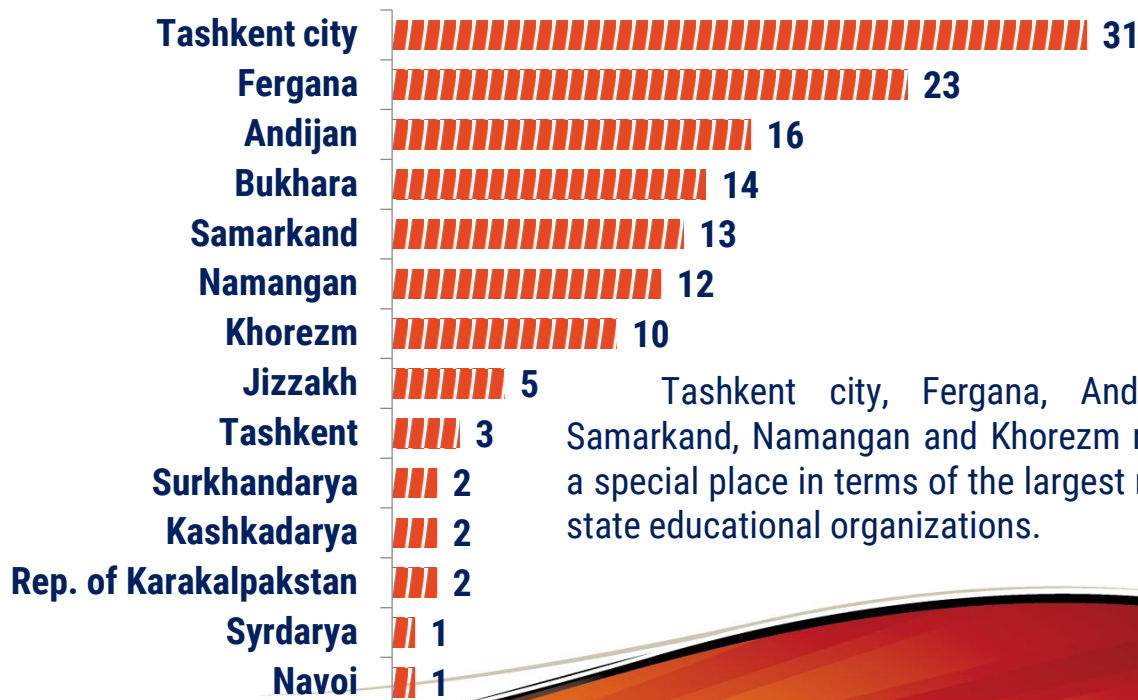
Non-state general educational organizations carry out their educational activities in accordance with state standards and requirements.

Thanks to the attention that has been paid to this type of education in recent years, the number of non-state general educational organizations is growing every year.

Thus, in 2021 alone, the number of operating non-state general educational organizations increased by 33 units, which, compared to 2018, increased by 77 units.

Tashkent city, Fergana, Andijan, Bukhara, Samarkand, Namangan and Khorezm regions occupy a special place in terms of the largest number of non-state educational organizations.

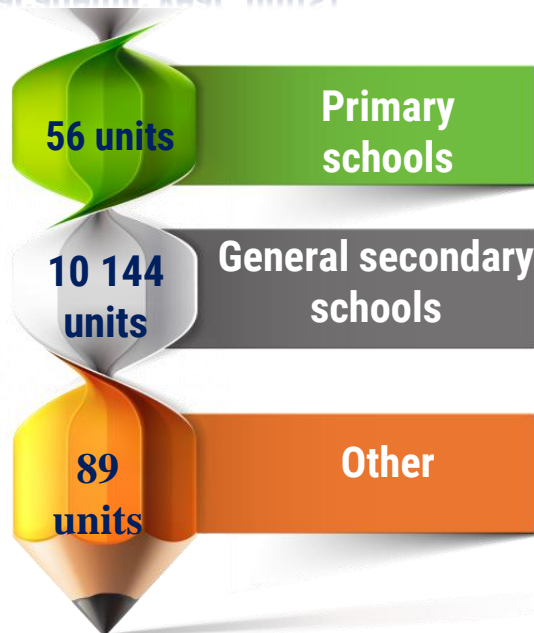

Distribution of general educational institutions by types of education (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, units)

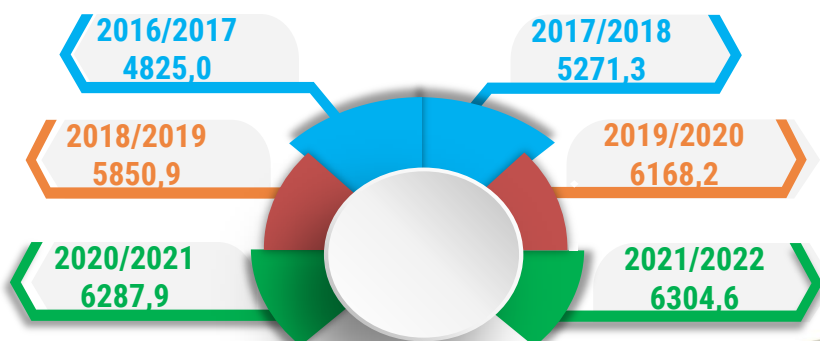
General educational institutions are divided into three types: elementary schools, general secondary schools and other educational institutions.

At the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, there were 10 144 general secondary schools, 56 primary schools and 89 other educational institutions.

In total, 6 272.3 thousand students study in general secondary schools, 7.6 in primary schools, 21.8 in other educational institutions, and 2.8 thousand in classes organized in other educational institutions.



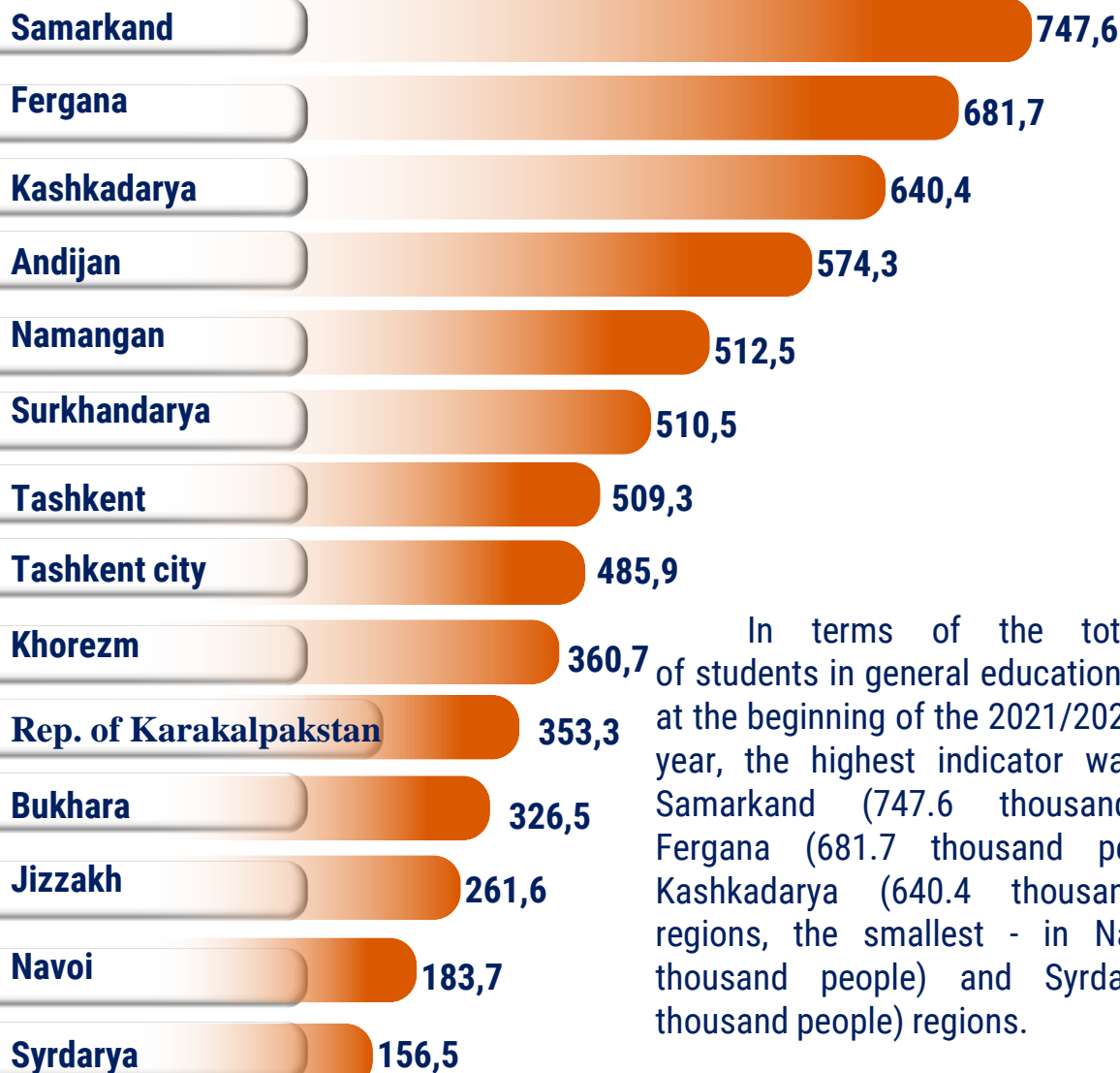
Number of students in general education institutions (at the beginning of the academic year, thousand people)



If compared with 2016, we can note an increase in the number of students in general education institutions by 1 479.6 thousand people, or by 30.7%.

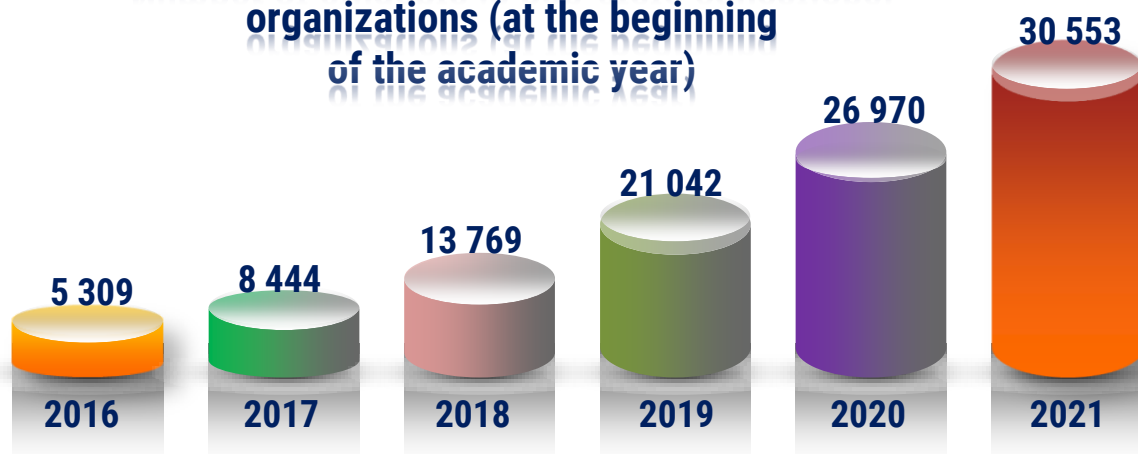
Distribution of students in general education institutions by regions (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, thousand people)



In terms of the total number of students in general education institutions at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, the highest indicator was noted in Samarkand (747.6 thousand people), Fergana (681.7 thousand people) and Kashkadarya (640.4 thousand people) regions, the smallest - in Navoi (183.7 thousand people) and Syrdarya (156.5 thousand people) regions.

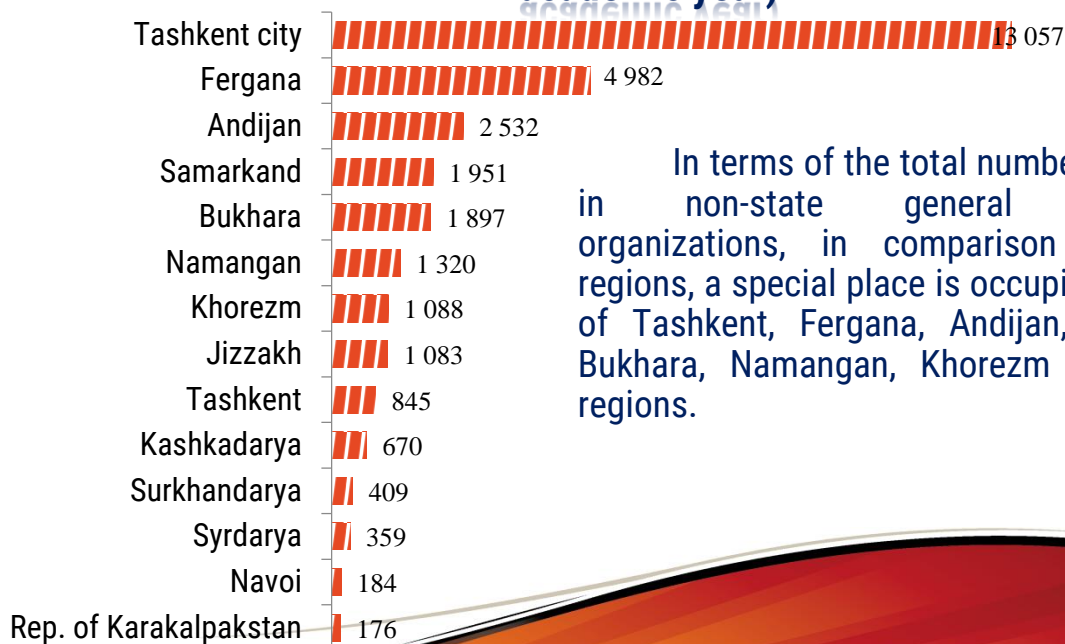

In 2021, the number of students in non-state general educational organizations, compared to 2016, increased by 25 706 people.

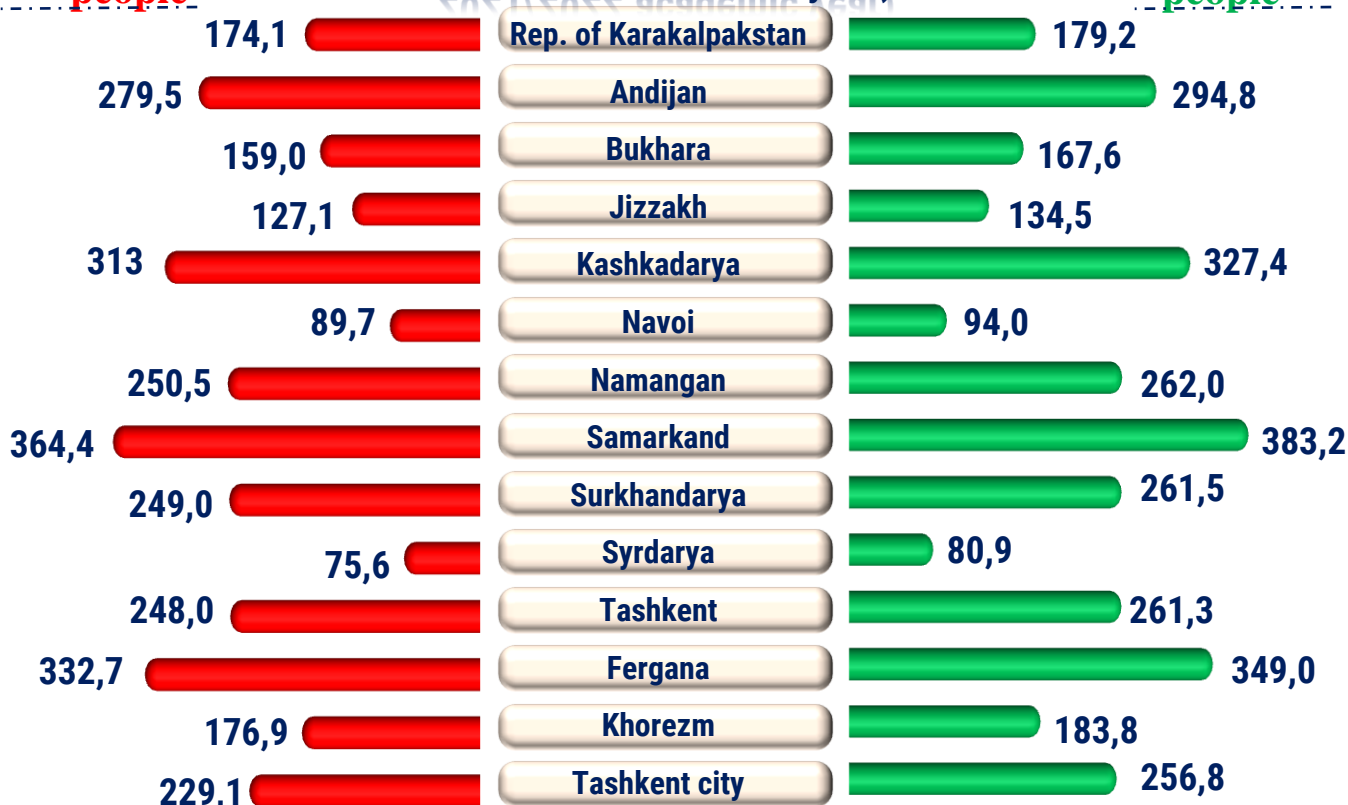

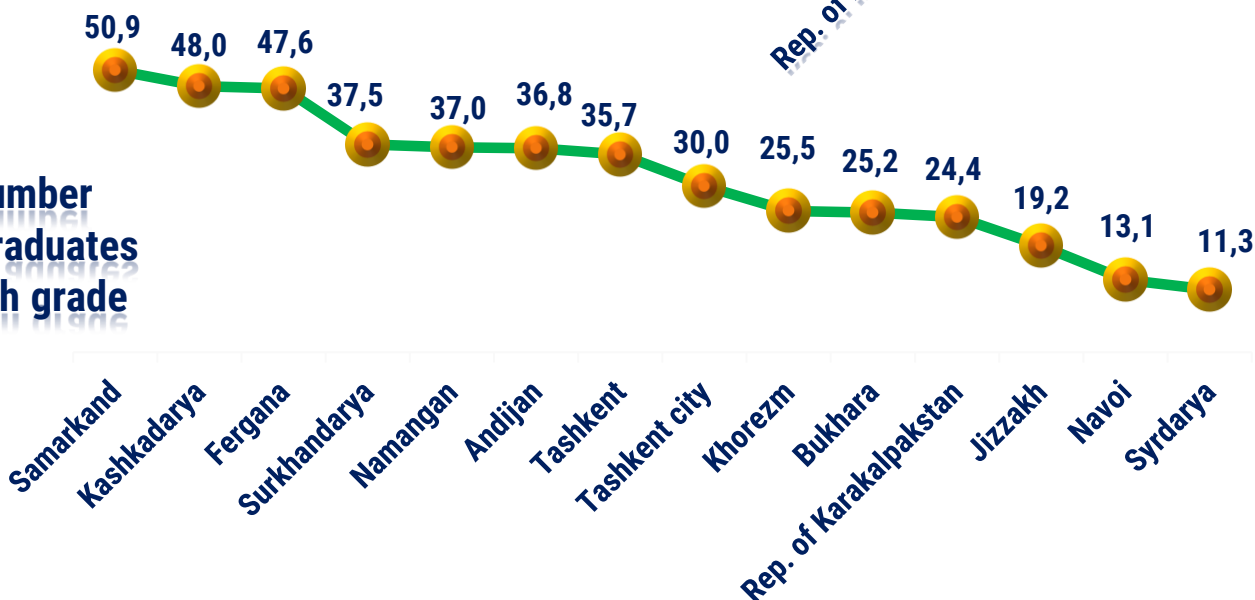

Number of graduates 11th grade

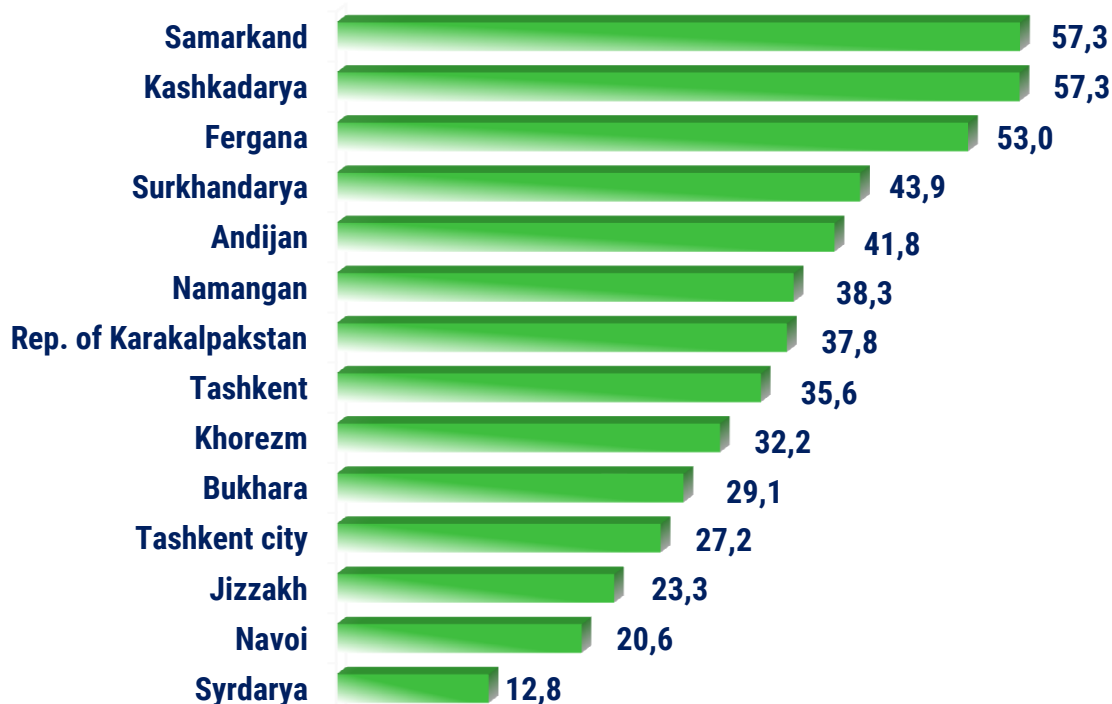


In total, 442.2 thousand students graduated from 11 classes in secondary schools of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2021. In terms of regions, the highest figure was recorded in the Samarkand region - 50.9 thousand students, the lowest, compared with other regions, was observed in Syrdarya region - 11.3 thousand people.

490.3 thousand students graduated from 9 classes of general educational institutions. The highest rate was noted in Samarkand region (54.3 thousand students) and Fergana region (54.3 thousand students), the lowest - in Navoi (14.9 thousand students) and Syrdarya (11.7 thousand students) regions.

At the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, 510.0 thousand teachers (excluding part-time teachers) worked in general education institutions, which, compared with 2016 (in 2016 - 390.6 thousand people), increased by 30.6%.

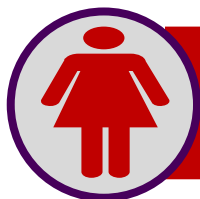
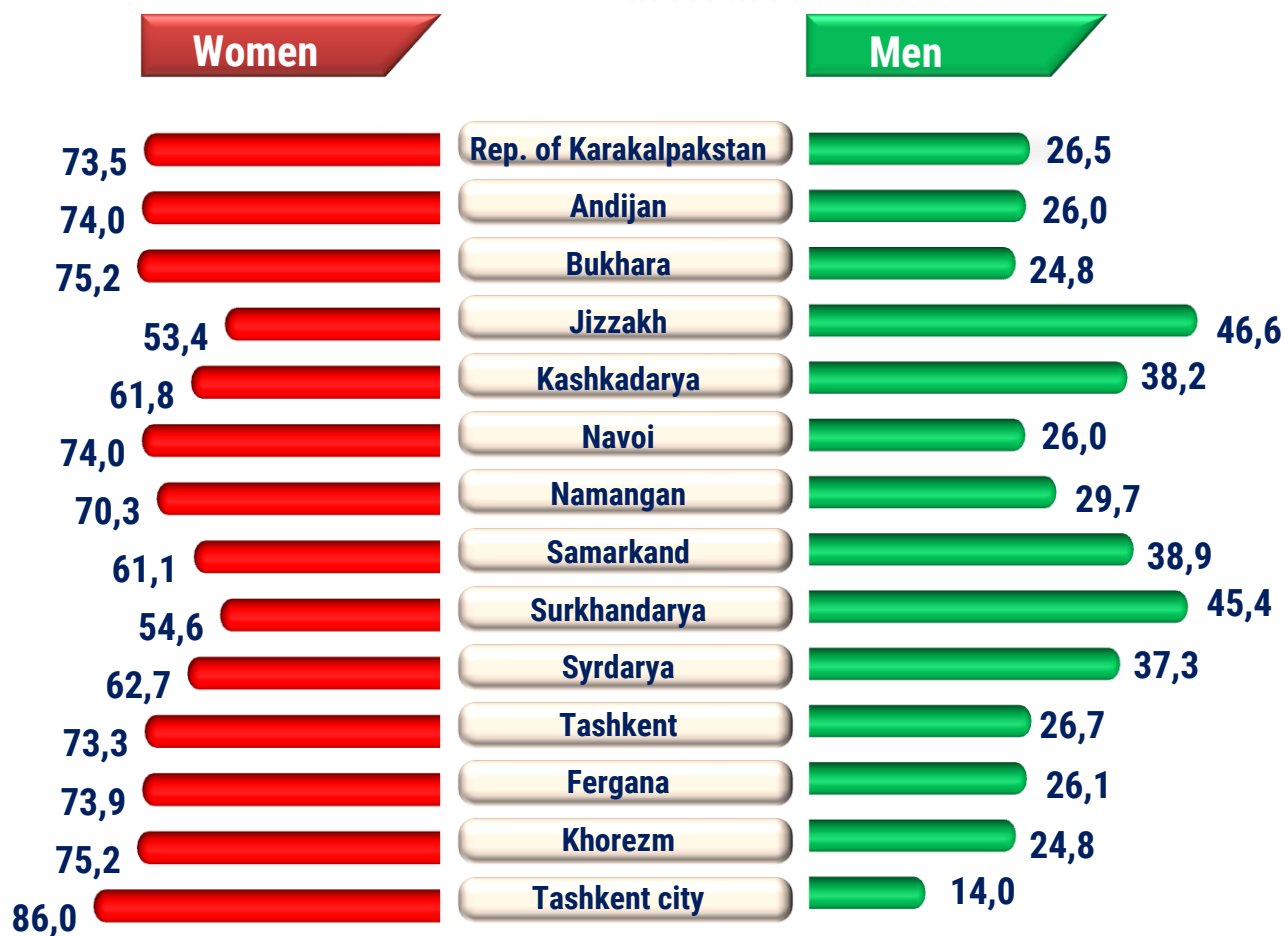
Number of teachers of non-state general education organizations (at the beginning of the academic year)

Gender distribution of teachers working in general education institutions, % (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year)



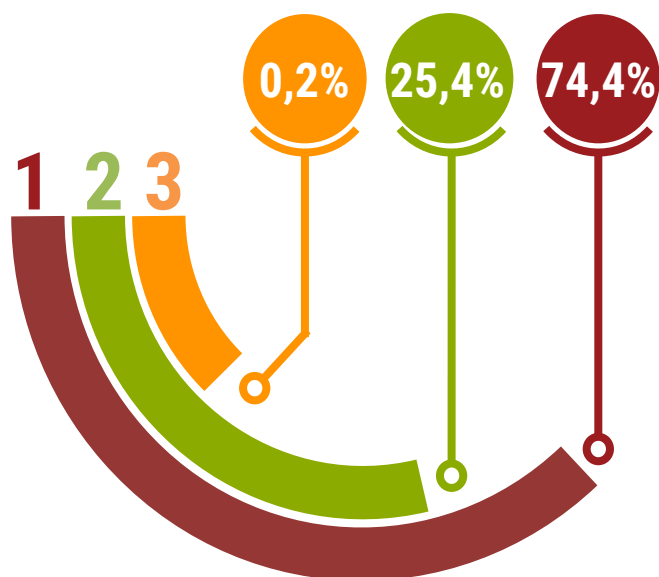

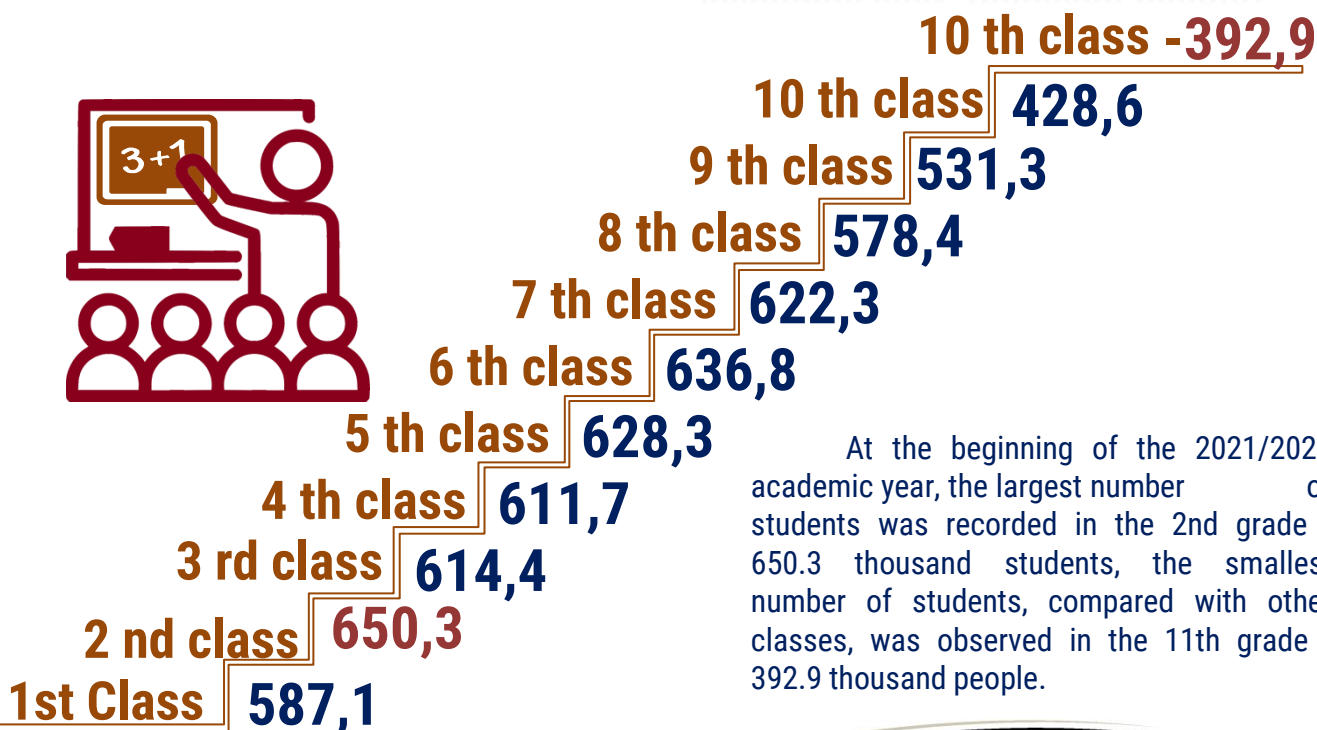
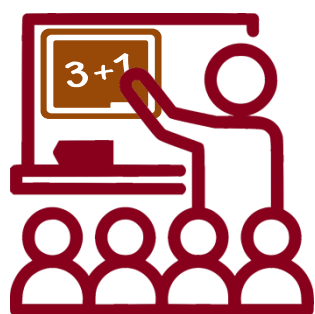
Share of general education institutions providing shift education* (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year)



At the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, out of the total number of general education institutions, 2588 institutions (25.4%) teach in one shift, 7580 (74.4%) - in two and 19 institutions (0.2%) - in three shifts.

Thus, 4134.6 thousand students study in the first shift, 2140.7 in the second shift and 4.6 thousand people in the third shift.

Number of students in classes (at the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, thousand people)

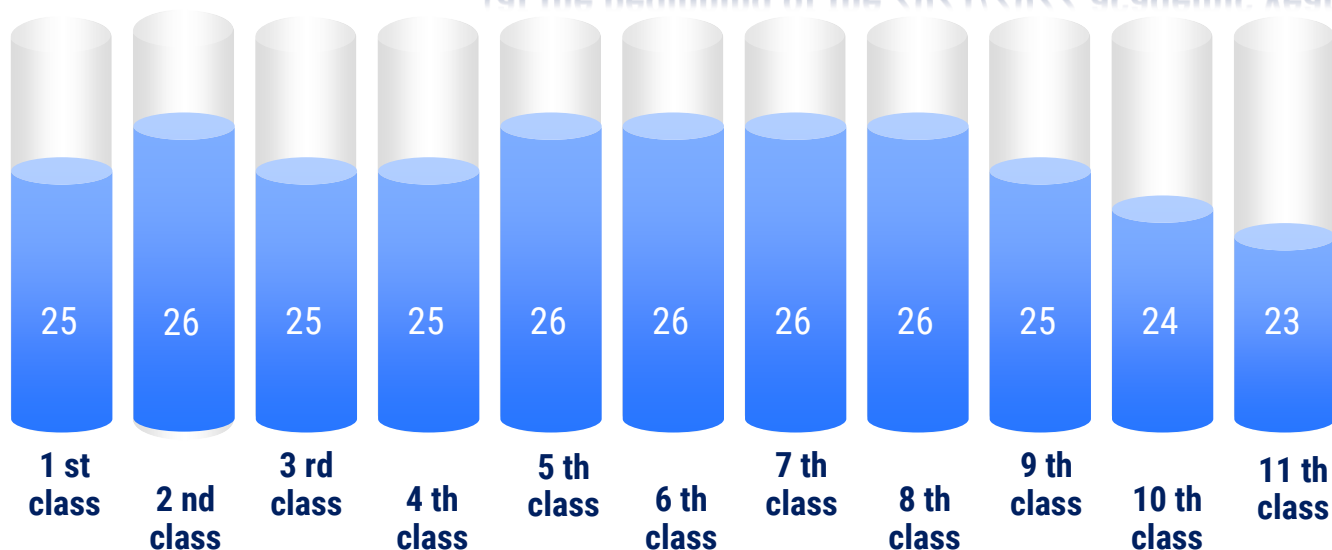


At the beginning of the 2021/2022 academic year, the largest number of students was recorded in the 2nd grade - 650.3 thousand students, the smallest number of students, compared with other classes, was observed in the 11th grade - 392.9 thousand people.

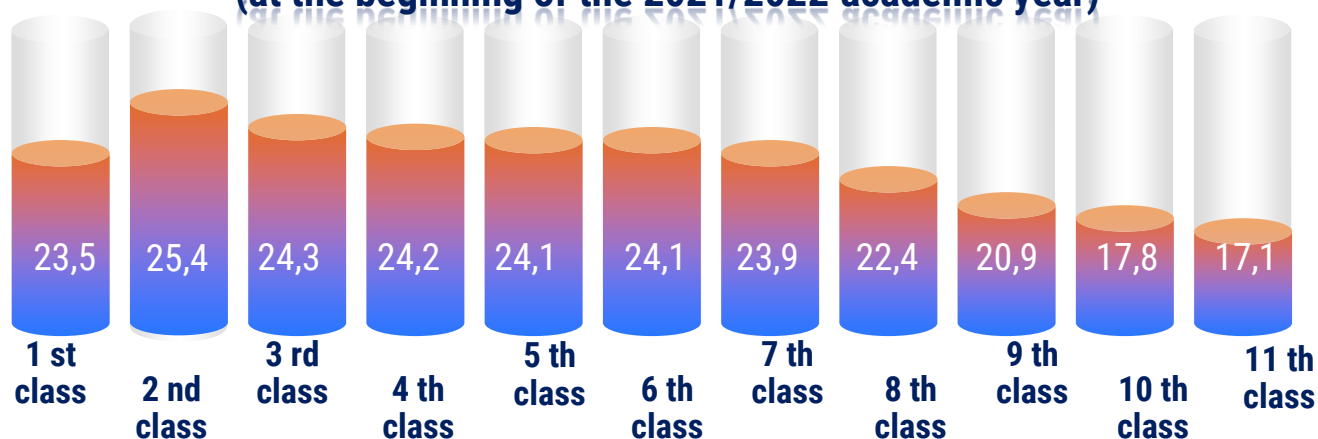

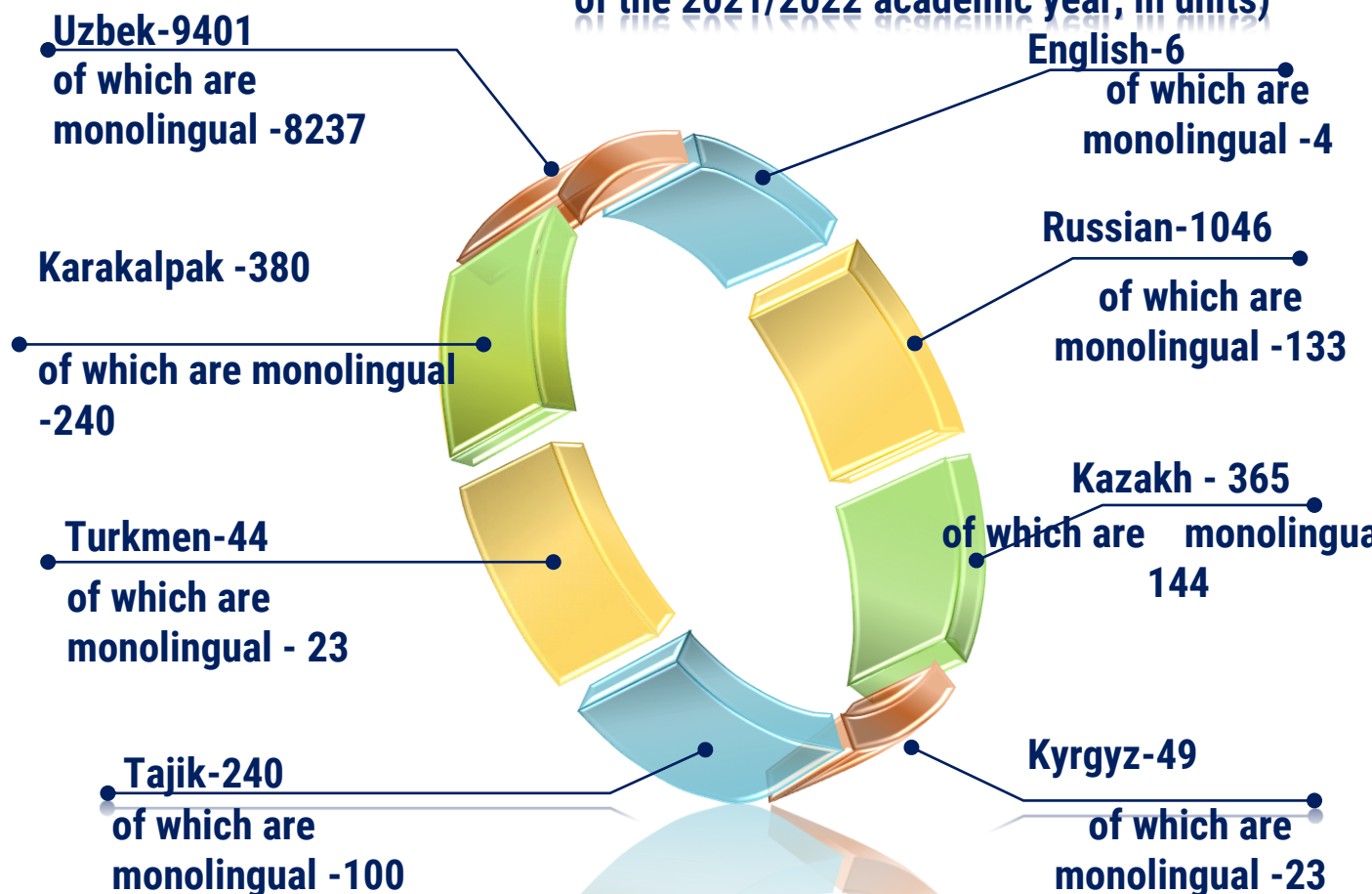

**Distribution of general education institutions
by language of instruction * (at the beginning
of the 2021/2022 academic year, in units)**



There are 377 schools in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and 3 schools in Navoi region that teach in the Karakalpak language. Turkmen language is taught in 41 institutions of the Republic of Karakalpakstan and 3 in the Khorezm region. Education in Tajik language is conducted in general educational institutions of Jizzakh, Kashkadarya, Navoi, Namangan, Samarkand, Surkhandarya, Syrdarya, Tashkent and Fergana regions. Students study in Kazakh language in general educational institutions of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, as well as in Bukhara, Jizzakh, Navoi, Syrdarya, Tashkent and Khorezm regions. General educational institutions with instruction in Russian are available in all regions of the republic.

Notes on statistics

General education schools are institutions that provide education, all-round development and aesthetic education of children.

A general education institution is the main link in the system of continuous education and provides all citizens of the Republic of Uzbekistan with a guaranteed right and the opportunity to receive free general education within the limits of state educational standards.

Students of general educational institutions include persons who are on the lists at the beginning of the school year and study at the levels of primary and general secondary education of general educational institutions, as well as students of schools for children with disabilities in physical or mental development.

Graduates of general education institutions are the number of people who have completed their studies in these institutions and received a certificate of secondary education.

The number of teachers is the number of persons with secondary specialized, higher or special training involved in the training and professional education of students.

Admission to educational organizations is an indicator of the number of persons admitted to study in a given academic year. This does not include the number of repeaters and people who returned from among previously trained students.

Graduates of general education institutions are the number of people who have completed their studies in these institutions and received a certificate of secondary education.
