0. Prerequisites

0.1 Legal environment

0.1.1 Responsibility for collecting, processing, and disseminating statistics

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

The State Committee on Statistics acts independently in accordance with the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Official Statistics" dated August 11, 2021, which regulates relations in the field of organizing the work of state statistics bodies, determines the powers of state statistics bodies and creates a regulatory framework for maintaining unified system statistical information.

In September 2017, a new “Regulation on the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics” was introduced, defining the mandate, functions and structure of the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics, which is the main body for the collection, processing, analysis and dissemination of data, responsible for coordination, monitoring and supervision of the National Statistical System. Its functions include providing a unified statistical methodology that meets international standards.

The State Committee on Statistics, as well as other state statistical bodies carrying out statistical work, has the right, within its powers, to request and receive state statistical reports, administrative accounting data and other data necessary for conducting state statistical observations, as well as explanations attached to the reports of other bodies.

According to Presidential Executive Order No. 5054 of September 12, 2017, economic and financial data in the country must be consistent and coordinated within the framework of the IMF's enhanced General Data Dissemination System (r-GDDS).

In April 2019, the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan “On additional measures to ensure openness and transparency of public administration, as well as increasing the statistical potential of the country” PD-4273 was adopted, according to which a subdivision responsible for coordination activities of state bodies and organizations for the formation, maintenance and updating of the list on the Open Data Portal of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

By the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 03, 2020 No. PD-4796 “On measures to further improve and develop the national system of statistics of the Republic of Uzbekistan”, in order to ensure the independence of state statistics bodies, increase the objectivity and reliability of statistical information, priority areas for improving the national

statistics system were identified Of the Republic of Uzbekistan and approved the National Strategy for the Development of Statistics of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2020-2025.

0.1.2 Data sharing and coordination among data producing agencies

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

In accordance with Article 9 of the Law “On Official Statistics”, the State Statistics Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan is an authorized state body in the field of official statistics, implementing state policy in the field of official statistics and coordinating the development of statistical programs.

State statistics bodies carry out integration with information systems of state and economic management bodies, as well as local executive bodies in order to conduct statistical observations, form and analyze official statistical data; develop measures for the coordinated dissemination of official statistics within the national statistical system.

Other producers of official statistics that are part of the national statistical system create subdivisions responsible for generating statistical data and ensuring information exchange with the authorized state body.

Producers of official statistics and suppliers of administrative data provide the authorized state body with available statistical and administrative data free of charge in the manner and terms established by statistical programs.

The Statistical Council is a collegial advisory body on the development, functioning and coordination of official statistics under the authorized state body.

The composition of the Statistical Council is approved by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

0.1.3 Confidentiality of individual reporters' data

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

In accordance with Article 29 of the Law “On Official Statistics”, statistical data collected, processed and stored for the production of official statistics are confidential if they allow direct or indirect identification of individuals or legal entities and disclose individual data concerning them.

The Regulation “On the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics” (No. 690, September 2017) provides that the State Committee on Statistics takes security measures to prevent confidentiality issues, including bank secrecy.

In accordance with Article 35 of the Law “On Official Statistics, interference of state bodies, their officials, as well as other persons in the formation of statistical methodology is not allowed.

The State Committee on Statistics employees must follow the code of ethics, including the oath of secrecy, and not disclose any information provided to them in the performance of their duties. They are informed of the responsibilities at the time of appointment. Each employee of The State

Committee on Statistics is obliged to sign an agreement that obliges him not to disclose such data.

0.1.4 Provision of statistical reporting

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

The State Committee on Statistics follows the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) General Statistical Business Process Model (GSBP), which lists the statistical business processes that support quality management and metadata management.

To ensure that the respondents provide information, state statistics bodies, within the limits of their powers, have the right to request and receive from financial, customs, tax authorities, banks, other departments and services, legal entities and their representative offices and branches, individuals, including individual entrepreneurs, information, necessary for the conduct of State statistical observation (at any stage of their development), as well as explanations attached to the reports, and use them for statistical purposes.

In addition, state statistics checks the accuracy of statistical data at enterprises, organisations and institutions, conducts an expert analysis of the completeness and objectivity of the statistical data obtained, and in cases of violations, gives instructions necessary to correct them, and makes appropriate adjustments to statistical data.

0.2 Resources

0.2.1 Staff, facilities, computing resources, and financing

The formation of the indicator in the Central Office is carried out by 2 employees and 1 each - in the Statistics Departments of the service sector of the territorial departments of statistics.

The number of employees is sufficient to fulfill the assigned tasks for the formation of statistical data.

All employees have higher education in the economic sphere and at least once every 2 years undergo training at the Institute for Professional Skills Upgrading and Statistical Research under the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics.

Each workplace is provided with a personal computer, the software is regularly updated.

The financial resources provided are sufficient to carry out the work stipulated by the Program of State Statistical Works.

1. Integrity

1.1 Professionalism

1.1.1 Impartiality of statistics

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

According to the Law “On Official Statistics” (Article 6), the basic principles of state statistics

are independence, transparency, accuracy, reliability, impartiality and objectivity, and statistical confidentiality.

1.1.2 Selection of sources, methodology, and modes of dissemination

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

According to the Law “On Official Statistics” (Article 27), individual data held by the producers of official statistics are used exclusively for statistical purposes to compile aggregate statistics.

Individual data cannot be used by state bodies, citizens' self-government bodies and other organizations, including international ones, for the purposes of investigation, control, litigation, administrative decisions or for other purposes related to individuals and legal entities or households.

1.1.3 Commenting on erroneous interpretation and misuse of statistics

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

The State Statistics Committee may comment on erroneous interpretation and misuse of statistical data on an ad hoc basis.

1.2 Transparency

1.2.1 Disclosure of terms and conditions for statistical collection, processing, and dissemination

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

According to the Law “On Official Statistics” (Article 6), the basic principles of state statistics are independence, transparency and accessibility. The conditions for the collection, processing and dissemination of statistical data are included in the laws and regulations of the Republic of Uzbekistan concerning statistics. These legislative measures are posted on websites and are thus available to the public. Thus, the Law “On Official Statistics” (2021) is posted on the website of the Committee (www.stat.uz). The law is also reproduced in the bulletin of the Oliy Majlis (parliament) and included in the database on regulatory legal acts (norm), as well as in the database of the Ministry of Justice, available at www.Lex.uz.

1.2.2 Internal governmental access to statistics prior to release

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

The government does not have access to The State Statistics Committee data prior to their release. State statistical bodies are independent in the dissemination of statistical data. Intervention by state bodies is not allowed (Article 35 of the Law). Only the Chairman of the Committee has access to statistics prior to their publication.

1.2.3 Attribution of statistical products

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

Data published to the public is clearly identified by the data production agency (logo and footnotes).

1.2.4 Advance notice of major changes in methodology, source data, and statistical techniques

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

Before moving on to the new methodology, The State Statistics Committee provides the public with advance notice when major changes are made to methodology and statistical methods. The State Statistics Committee posts on its website a relevant methodological note explaining what changes users should expect.

1.3. Ethical standards

1.3.1 Guideline for staff behavior

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics

The State Statistics Committee employees must follow the code of ethics, including the oath of secrecy, and not disclose any information provided to them in the performance of their duties. They are informed of the responsibilities at the time of appointment. Each employee of The State Statistics Committee is obliged to sign an agreement that obliges him not to disclose such data.

2. Methodology

2.1 Concepts and definitions

2.1.1 Concepts and definitions

The indicator “Number of mobile subscribers per 100 people” is the ratio of the total number of subscribers (an individual or legal entity that has entered into an agreement with the operator for the provision of mobile services) with access to mobile communications to the population, followed by a ratio of 100.

2.2 Scope

2.2.1 Scope

2.2.1.1 Scope of the data

The geographic coverage of the data includes the Republic of Karakalpakstan, 12 regions and the city of Tashkent.

This indicator is formed on the basis of statistical data on information and communication technologies.

2.2.1.2 Exceptions to coverage

There are no exceptions.

2.2.1.3 Unrecorded activity

The shadow economy is not taken into account.

2.3 Classification/sectorization

2.3.1 Classification/sectorization

The breakdown is carried out by the republic, regions and the city of Tashkent.

The total number of subscribers is determined by the republic, regions and the city of Tashkent.

The main unit of account is an institutional unit.

2.4 Basis for recording

2.4.1 Valuation

The indicator “Number of mobile subscribers per 100 people” is the ratio of the total number of subscribers (an individual or legal entity that has entered into an agreement with the operator for the provision of mobile services) with access to mobile communications to the population, followed by a ratio of 100.

2.4.2 Recording basis

Information for calculating the indicator is formed from the primary data of statistical reporting.

2.4.3 Grossing/netting procedures

The indicators are calculated annually.

3. Accuracy and reliability

3.1 Source data

3.1.1 Source data collection programs

The basis for conducting statistical surveys of enterprises is a comprehensive and constantly updated Unified State Register of Enterprises and Organizations, functioning in accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers No. 274 of September 25, 2012 “On Approval of the Regulation on the Unified State Register of Enterprises and Organizations”.

The data is formed according to the primary data of statistical reporting.

3.1.2 Source data definitions, scope, sectorization, classifications, valuation, and time of recording

The statistical indicator “the number of mobile subscribers per 100 people” is the ratio of the total number of subscribers (an individual or legal entity that has entered into an agreement with the operator for the provision of mobile services) who have access to mobile communications to the population, followed by a ratio of 100.

Statistical coverage is carried out:

- annually based on statistical records.

Date of publication of data:

- annually - no more than 5 months after the reporting period.

3.1.3 Source data timeliness

The data collection program is regulated by the State Statistical Works Program.

Initial data are developed annually no more than 5 months after the reporting period.

3.2 Assessment of source data

3.2.1 Source data assessment

The obtained data are analyzed, undergo mandatory control and verification at the level of territorial departments of statistics, as well as the State Statistics Committee. If errors are detected, the information is necessarily clarified again with the respondents.

Source data are analyzed for comparability with other related data sources.

3.3 Statistical techniques

3.3.1 Source data statistical techniques

To calculate the indicator, a comparison is made of information for the base and current periods.

3.3.2 Other statistical procedures

The calculations are based on data from the Department of Demography and Labor Statistics (average annual resident population).

3.4 Data validation

3.4.1 Validation of intermediate results

To calculate the indicator, the information for the base and current periods is compared.

3.4.2 Assessment of intermediate data

An analysis of possible discrepancies in the main intermediate data is carried out, and the data is adjusted to eliminate discrepancies.

3.4.3 Assessment of discrepancies and other problems in statistical outputs

In case of discrepancies in the previously published data, changes are made during subsequent publications.

3.5 Analysis of data revisions

3.5.1 Revision studies and analyses

In case of discrepancies in the previously published data, changes are made during subsequent publications.

4. Serviceability

4.1 Periodicity and timeliness

4.1.1 Periodicity

The indicator is formed annually.

Indicators are specified when carrying out an inventory based on the data of the annual report.

4.1.2 Timeliness

The indicator is published annually no more than 5 months after the reporting period.

4.2 Consistency

4.2.1 Internal consistency

After confirmation and dissemination, statistical series are not revised.

4.2.2 Temporal consistency

Data from 2010 are presented on the website of the State Statistics Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan (<http://stat.uz/ru>).

4.2.3 Intersectoral and cross-domain consistency

Information is received by the State Committee on Statistics from enterprises and organizations.

4.3 Revision

4.3.1 Revision and/or update schedule

The data for the formation of the indicator are specified within the time frame provided for by the Program of State Statistical Works.

4.3.2 Identification of preliminary and/or revised/updated data

Final data disseminated.

4.3.3 Dissemination of revision studies and analyses

In case of clarification of previously published data, the revised data are provided in subsequent publications. Revised (final) data are disseminated through publications of The State Committee on Statistics.

Data for the reporting period is disseminated. In statistical publications, information is presented in the form of tables and graphs.
