

The number of operating small enterprises and microfirms by type of economic activity as of 01.01.2023

As of 01.01.2023, the total number of operating small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 523.6 thousand units.

The largest number of them falls on trade (182.2 thousand units), industry (97.9 thousand units), agriculture, forestry and fisheries (53.2 thousand units), construction (46.6 thousand units), accommodation and meals (36.6 thousand units), transportation and storage (20.5 thousand units).

Micro-firms - with an average annual number of employees employed in manufacturing industries - no more than twenty people, in the service sector and other non-productive industries - no more than ten people, in wholesale, retail trade and public catering - no more than five people.


Small enterprises - with an average annual number of employees employed in the light, food and building materials industries provided for by law — no more than two hundred people, metalworking and instrument making, woodworking, furniture industry, as well as other industrial and production sectors provided for by law, — no more than one hundred people, mechanical engineering, metallurgy, fuel and energy and chemical industries, production and processing of agricultural products, construction and other industrial and production spheres provided for by law - no more than fifty people, science, scientific services, transport, communications, services (except insurance companies), trade and catering and other non—productive sphere - no more than twenty-five people.




The number of employees with laborbooks accepted for calculating the average salary by type of economic activity for 2022, in %

Accrued income of individuals with laborbooks in this organization in the form of wages by region for 2022




The number of employees with laborbooks according to the level of education for 2022, in %



The number of employees with laborbooks on the level of education for 2021



The number of employees with workbooks by age for 2022, in %





The number of newly created and closed vacancies




In 2022, 358 041 jobs were created at small enterprises and microfirms, while the number of closed vacancies was 251 469.


The number of newly created jobs by region during the reporting period, units.

The average annual number of employees with laborbooks, thousand people




The average annual number of employees with laborbooks in the reporting period amounted to 1 429.1 thousand people.

For information: in 2021, the average annual number of employees with laborbooks was 1 403.4 thousand people.


The number of external part-timers averaged 34.9 thousand people in 2022.




By region, the largest number of small enterprises and microfirms headed by women was recorded in the city of Tashkent (10 906), Tashkent (4 995), Samarkand (3 289) regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2,593), Khorezm (2 363), Surkhandarya (2 290) and Bukhara (2 212) regions. The lowest indicator was recorded in the Andijan region – 1 098 units .

GENERAL ECONOMIC INDICATORS

In 2022, net revenue from the sale of products (goods, works and services) by small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 572 783.2 billion soums.

The largest amount and share of net proceeds from the sale of products (goods, works and services) by small enterprises and micro-firms by type of economic activity were recorded in the sphere of trade – 281,902.2 billion soums (49.2%), industry – 145,983.1 (25.5%), construction - 70,600.8 (12.3%), agriculture, forestry and fishing agriculture – 17,447.4 (3.0%), transportation and storage – 9,717.6 (1.7%), accommodation and catering services – 9268.1 (1.6%), information and communications – 9,148.7 (1.6%), healthcare and social services – 3,413.0 billion soums (0.6%).


Net revenue from the sale of products (goods, works, services) by small enterprises and micro firms by type of economic activity billion soums






In 2022, the net revenue from the sale of products (goods, works and services) of small enterprises and microfirms headed by women amounted to 31 789,3 billion soums. This is 9,221.7 billion soums more than in the corresponding period of 2021.

The largest amount of net proceeds from the sale of products (goods, works and services) in the reporting year were small enterprises and micro-firms headed by women in Tashkent city (17 642.6 billion soums), Tashkent (3 886.8 billion soums), Samarkand (1 478.8 billion soums), Bukhara (1 249.3 billion soums), Fergana (1 182.6 billion soums) regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan (1 106.9 billion soums), as well as in Khorezm (1 034.3 billion soums) region. The lowest figure was recorded in the Syrdarya region - 365.2 billion soums.

In 2022, the profit (loss) before income tax of small enterprises and microfirms headed by women amounted to 2,263.8 billion soums. This is 422.4 billion soums more than in 2021.


In 2022, the net profit (loss) of small enterprises and microfirms headed by women amounted to 1 760.2 billion soums. Compared to 2021, this is 371.6 billion soums more.

INVESTMENTS IN FIXED ASSETS

In 2022, the volume of investments in fixed assets of small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 99 981.0 billion soums. This is 14 759.9 billion soums more than in 2021.

The largest volume and share of investments in fixed assets of small enterprises and microfirms were noted: in industry – 51 507.1 billion soums (51.5%), construction – 12 794.2 (12.8%), trade – 7 732.3 (7.7%), agriculture, forestry and fisheries – 5 053.2 (5.1%), transportation and storage – 4 047.6 (4.1%), healthcare and social services – 2 721.2 (2.7%), accommodation and catering services – 1 428.7 (1.4%), information and communications – 726.2 billion soums (0.7%).


The volume of investments in fixed assets of small enterprises and microfirms by region for 2022


The volume of investments in fixed assets of small enterprises and microfirms headed by women, by region for 2022, billion soums




INDUSTRY

In 2022, the volume of industrial production of small enterprises and microfirms reached 119 837.1 billion soums. This is 18 554.1 billion soums more than in 2021.

The largest volume of industrial products produced by small enterprises and micro firms in the regions was recorded in the city of Tashkent – 39 051.3 billion soums, Tashkent – 18 409.1 billion soums, Fergana – 10 392.5 billion soums, Samarkand – 9 427.2 billion soums, Andijan – 9 102.9 billion soums, Bukhara – 6 666.0 billion soums and Namangan – 6 195.7 billion soums regions.









Wholesale turnover of small enterprises and microfirms by region, billion soums





by region for 2022, billion soums**






Trade turnover of small enterprises and microfirms for providing food, billion soums



The volume of trade turnover of small enterprises and microfirms providing food by region, billion soums



The volume of trade turnover of small enterprises and microfirms providing food by region for 2022, billion soums






