## Industrial production of the Republic of Uzbekistan for January-August

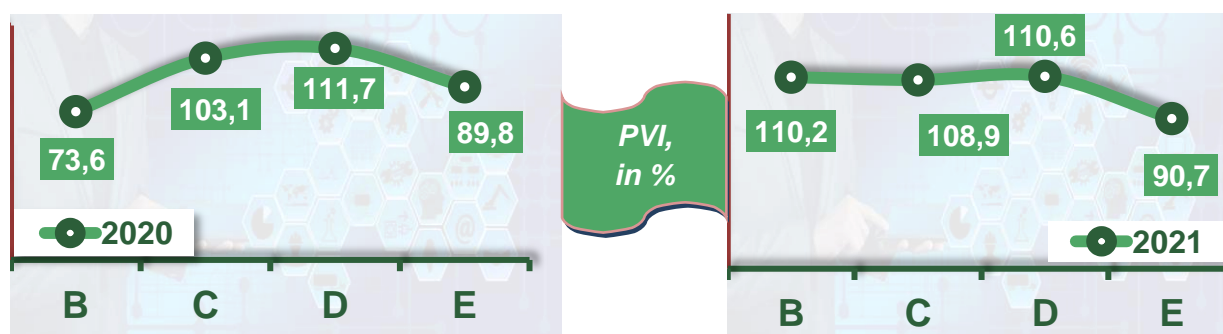
According to preliminary data, in January-August 2021, enterprises of the republic produced industrial products worth 269.8 trillion soums, the index of physical volume\* of industrial production by the same period in 2020 amounted to 109.2%.

In the structure of production, the largest share falls on manufacturing enterprises (82.5%), the volume of production of which amounted to 222.6 trillion soums.

### Industrial production by main types of economic activity

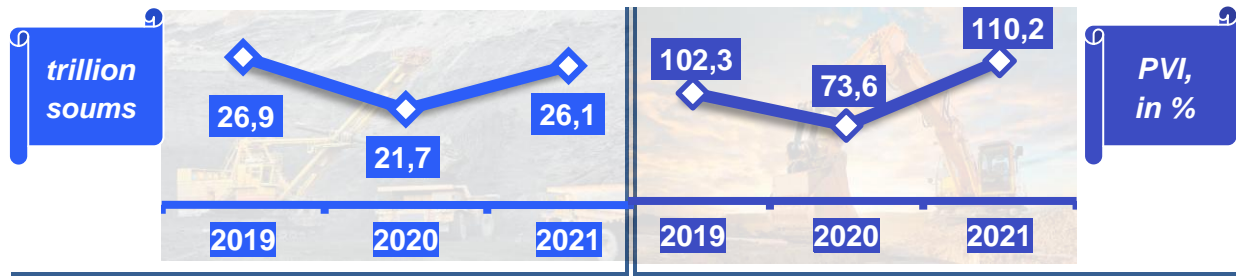


The main factors of growth in the physical volume of industrial production were its increase in the mining industry by 10.2%, in the manufacturing industry - by 8.9%, power supply, gas, steam and air conditioning - by 10.6%.

\*The index of the physical volume of industrial production is a relative indicator that characterizes the change in the mass of products (works, services) in the compared periods.

for January-August



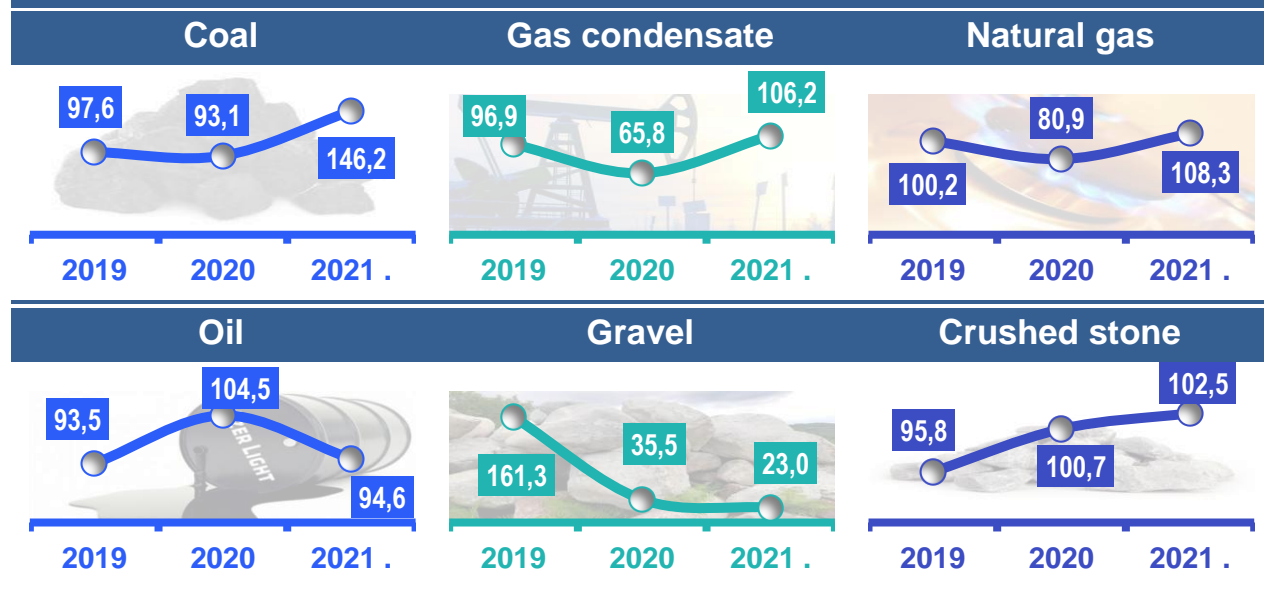
The volume of products manufactured by mining and quarrying enterprises in January-August 2021 amounted to 26.1 trillion soums, or 9.7% of the total industry.

### Industrial production by large mining and quarrying enterprises

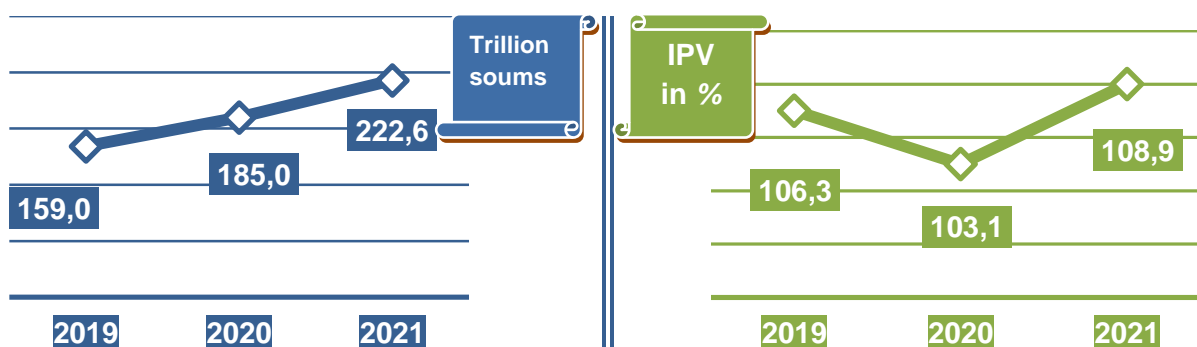

## Manufacturing industry

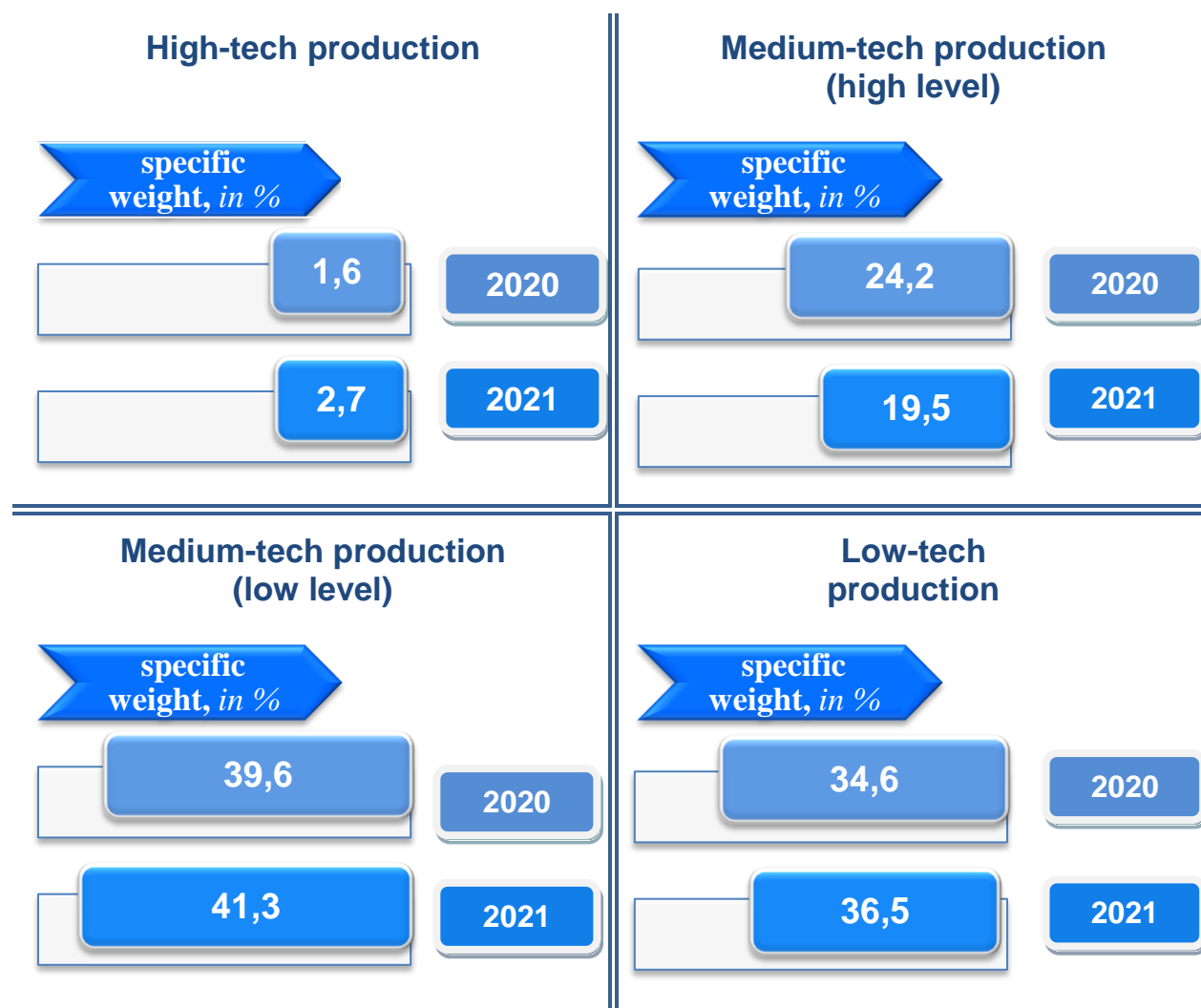


Manufacturing enterprises in January-August 2021 produced goods for 222.6 trillion soums, or 82.5% of the total industry.

### Share for the period from the beginning of the year, in %



In the structure of the manufacturing industry, the share of high-tech industries amounted to 2.7% (1.6% in January-August 2020), medium-high-tech - 19.5% (24.2%), medium-low-tech - 41.3% (39.6%) and low-tech - 36.5% (34.6%).

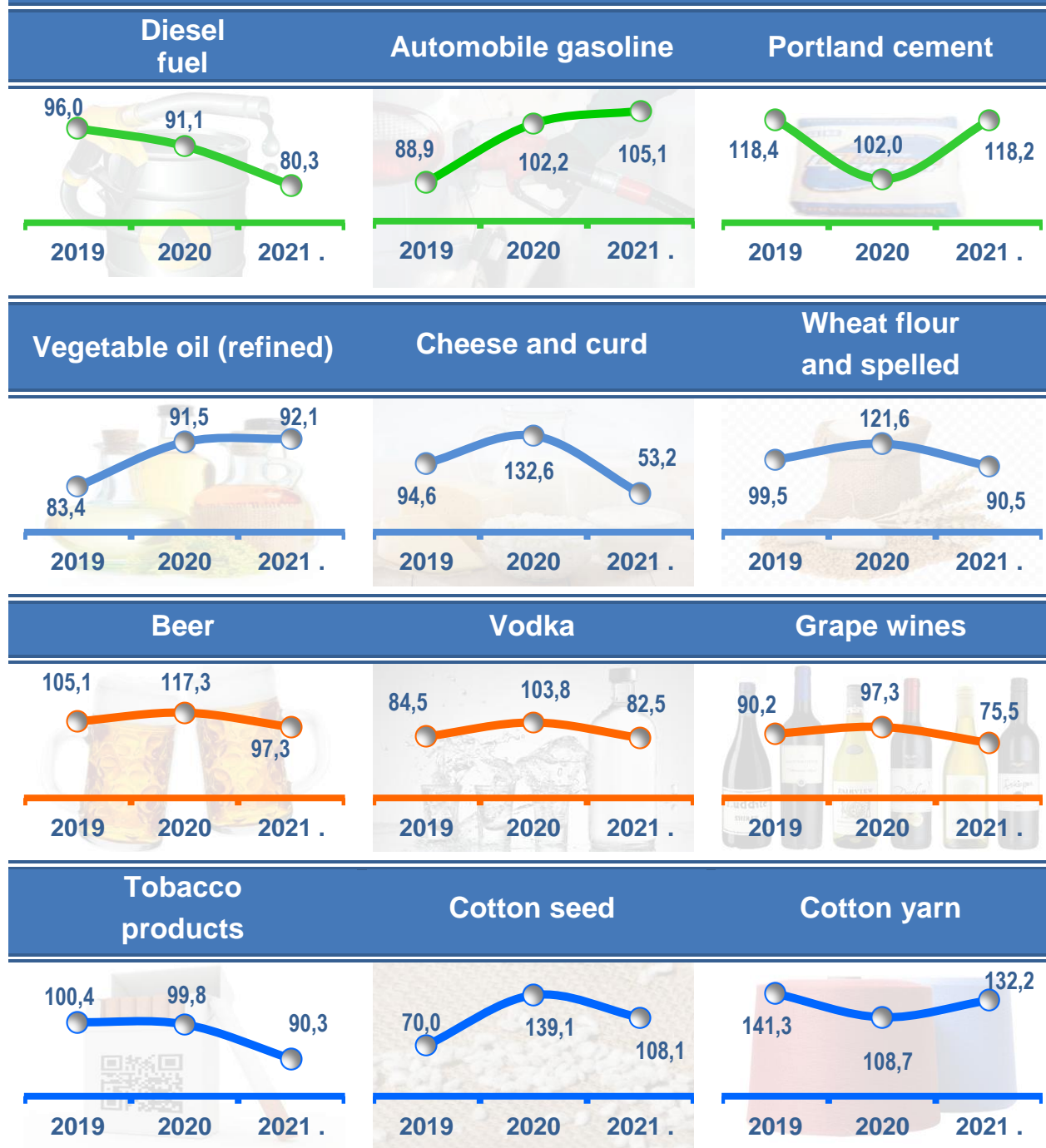


In the volume of the manufacturing industry, the share of enterprises for the production, repair, assembly of machinery and equipment, the production of cars, trailers, semi-trailers and other finished products amounted to 16.8% (the physical volume index amounted to 97.9% against January-August 2020), the metallurgical industry - 27.9% (112.6%), enterprises for the production of textile, clothing and leather products - 17.2% (122.6%), for the production of food, drinks and tobacco products - 16.7% (108.3%), enterprises for the production of chemical products, rubber and plastic products - 9.6% (105.9%).

## Manufacturing of industrial products by large manufacturing enterprises

In January-August 2021, the republic produced 729.4 thousand tons of motor gasoline (an increase of 5.1% compared to the corresponding period of 2020), 416.4 thousand tons of cotton yarn (an increase of 32.2%), 190.6 million liters of beer (decrease by 2.7%) and 1 186.2 thousand tons of flour from soft wheat and spelled (decrease by 9.5%).

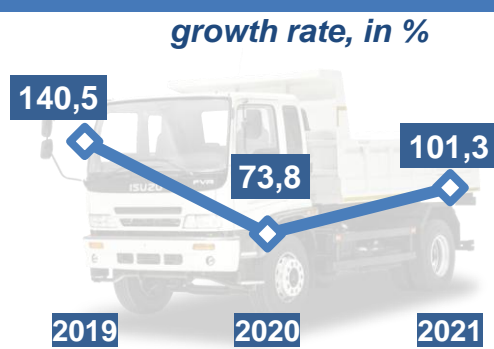
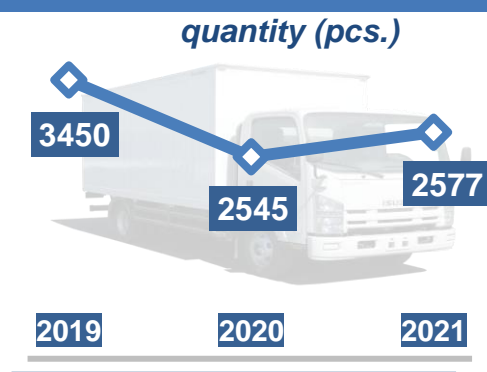

### Production of trucks for January-August

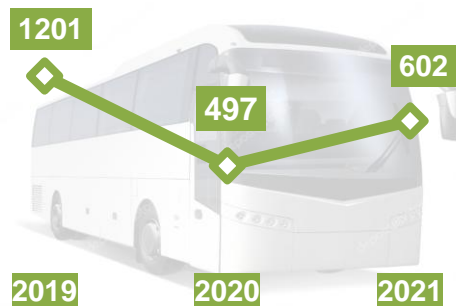

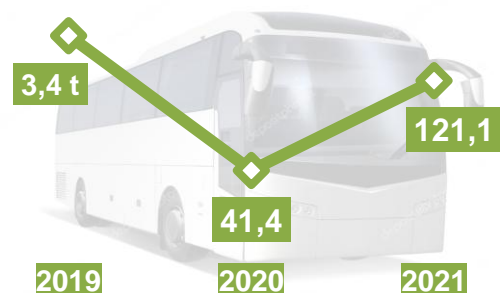
In January-August 2021, 602 buses were produced in the republic (by the corresponding period of 2020, an increase in production was noted by 21.1%).

quantity (pcs.)



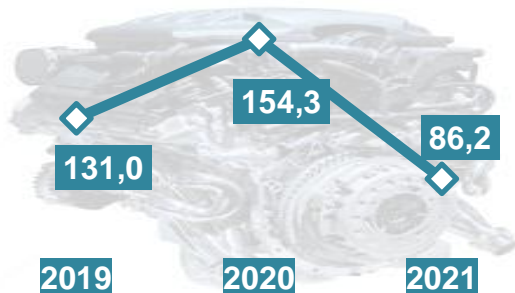

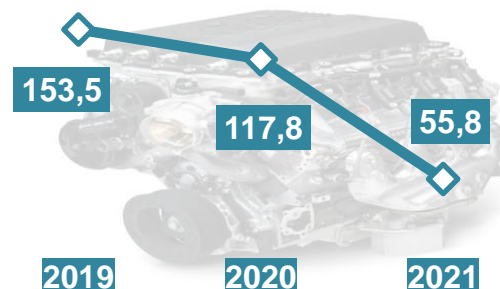
In January-August 2021, 86.2 thousand units of automobile engines were produced in the republic (a decrease by 44.2% compared to the corresponding period of 2020).

quantity (thousand pcs.)



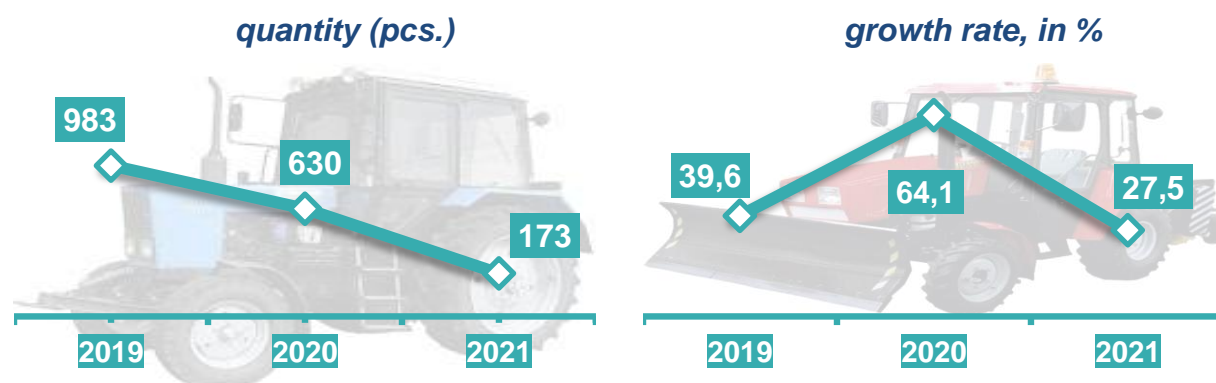

## Manufacturing of industrial products by large manufacturing enterprises

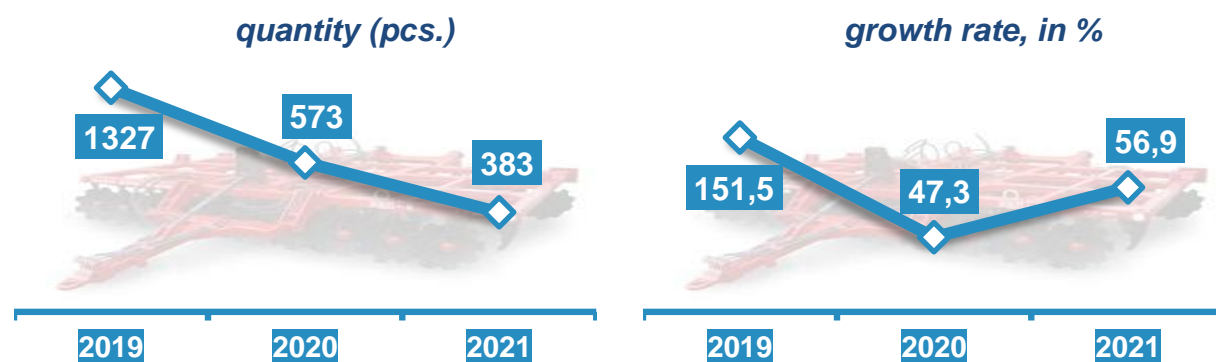
In January-August 2021, 173 tractors were produced in the republic (by January-August 2020, the production volume decreased by 72.5%).

### Tractor manufacturing for January-August



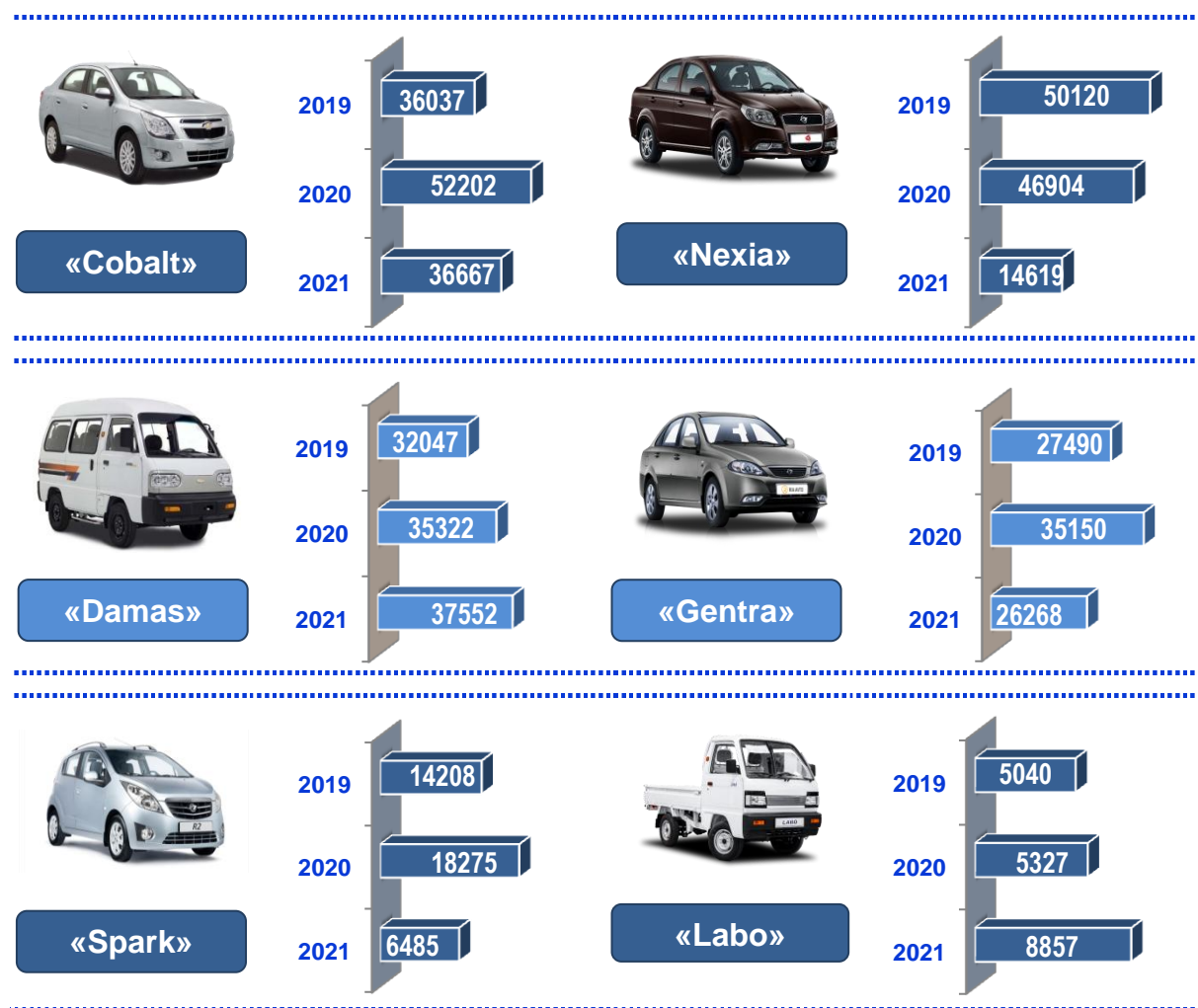
In January-August 2021, 383 pieces of rippers and cultivators were produced in the republic (by the corresponding period of 2020, a decrease in production by 43.1% was recorded).

In the automotive industry in January-August 2021, 36 667 Cobalt cars were produced (growth rates compared to the same period in 2020 amounted to 70.2%), 14 619 - Nexia (31.2%), 26 268 - Gentra (74.7%), 37 552 - Damas (106.3%), 6 485 - Spark (35.5%) and 8 857 - Labo (166.2%).

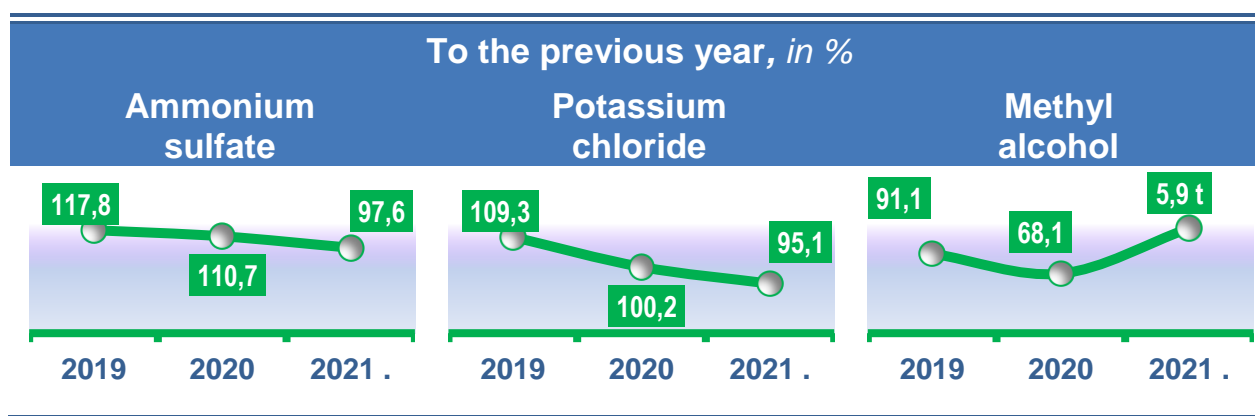
**Car production in the Republic of Uzbekistan**

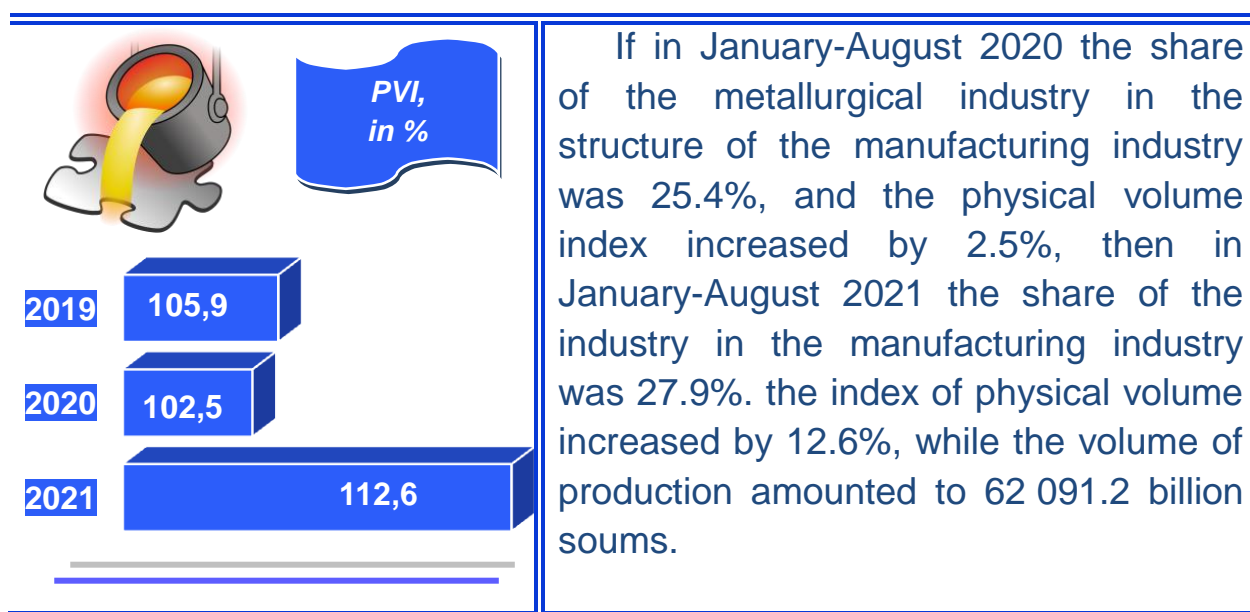

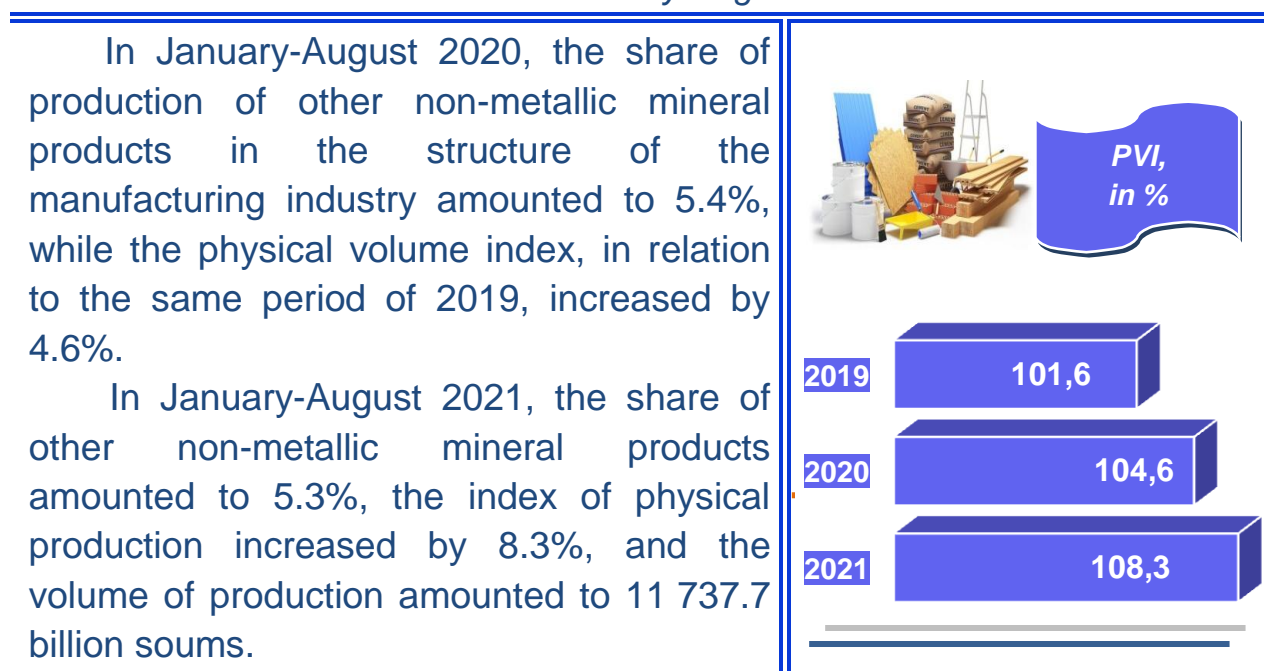
The overhaul of the technological equipment made it possible to increase the capacity utilization of chemical enterprises and exceed the production indicators of the previous year for the production of methyl alcohol (5.9 times by January-August 2020), paints and varnishes based on acrylic or vinyl polymers (107.3%) and caustic soda (123.7%). At the same time, there is a decrease in the production of ammonium sulfate (97.6% compared to January-August 2020).

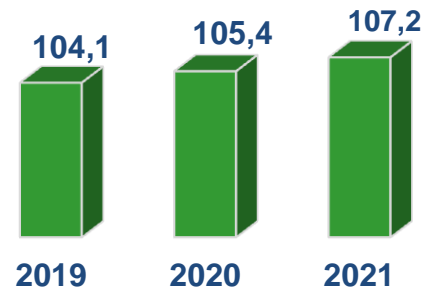


## Food production for January-August

If in January-August 2020 the share of food production in the manufacturing industry amounted to 13.7%, and the physical volume index, in relation to 2019, reached 105.4%, then in January-August 2021 the share of food decreased to 13.3%, the index of physical volume increased by 7.2%, the total production amounted to 29 560.4 billion soums.

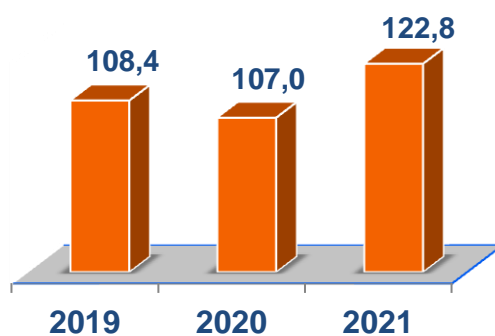

At the end of January-August 2020, the share of beverage production in the structure of the manufacturing industry amounted to 2.5%, while the physical volume index, in relation to the same period in 2019, amounted to 107.0%.

In January-August 2021, the share of beverage production was 2.8%, the physical volume index was 122.8%, and the production volume reached 6 332.4 billion soums.

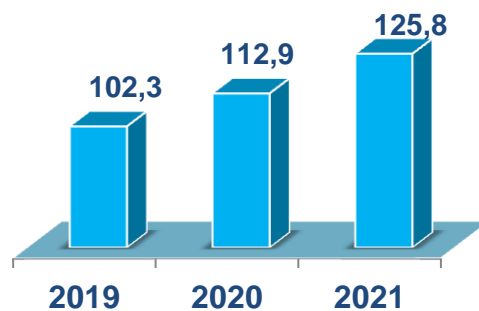
## Production of textile products for January-August

At the end of January-August 2020, the share of the production of textiles in the structure of the manufacturing industry amounted to 11.1%, while the physical volume index, in relation to the same period of 2019, amounted to 112.9%.

In January-August 2021, the share of textile production amounted to 13.1%, the index of the physical volume of their production increased by 25.8%, and the production volume amounted to 29 186.3 billion soums.

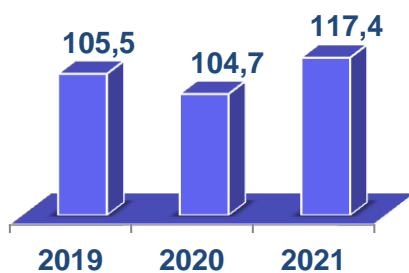

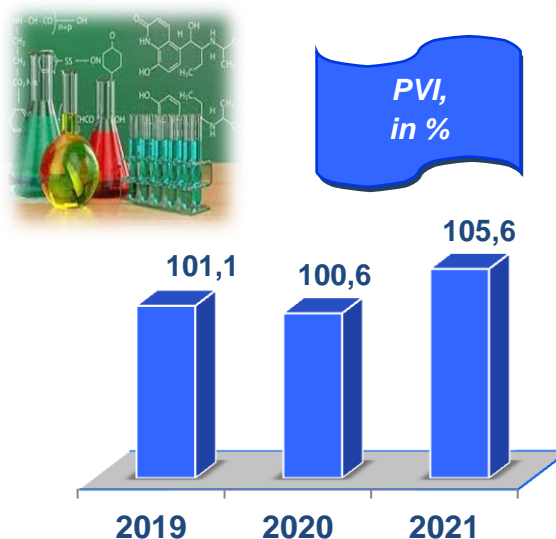


If in January-August 2020 the share of clothing production in the structure of the manufacturing industry was 3.4%, and the physical volume index was 104.7%, then in January-August 2021 the share of the industry in the manufacturing industry was 3.6%, the index physical volume - 117.4%, production volume reached 7 952.3 billion soums.

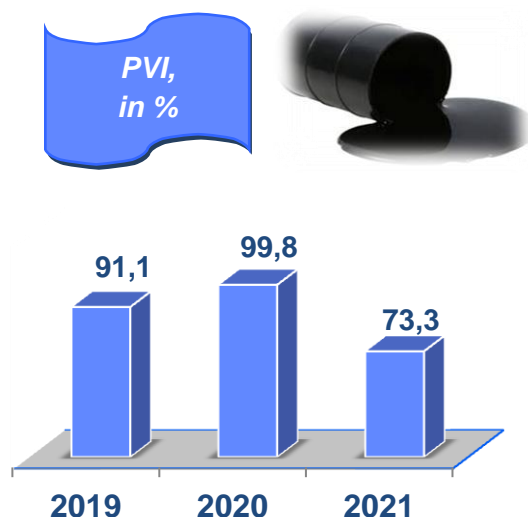
## Production of chemical products for January-August

In January-August 2020, the share of chemical production in the structure of the manufacturing industry was 7.5%, while the physical volume index, in relation to the same period in 2019, amounted to 100.6%.

In January-August 2021, the share of chemical products amounted to 7.7%, the index of the physical volume of production increased by 5.6%, and the volume of production amounted to 17 232.9 billion soums.



## Production of coke and refined petroleum products for January-August

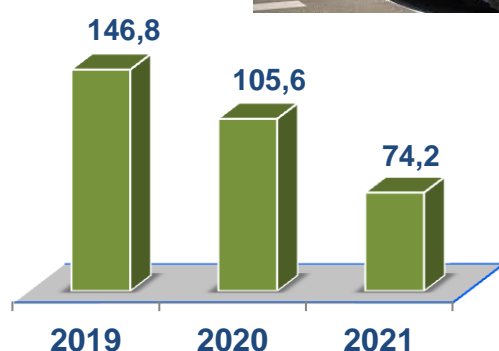


At the end of January-August 2020, the share of coke and product production in the structure of the manufacturing industry amounted to 3.9%, while the physical volume index, in relation to the same period in 2019, amounted to 99.8%.

In January-August 2021, the share of coke and refined products production amounted to 3.2%, the physical volume index also decreased by 26.7%, and the production volume amounted to 7 128.2 billion soums.

At the end of January-August 2020, the share of production of vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers in the structure of the manufacturing industry amounted to 12.2%, while the volume index, in relation to the same period of 2019, reached 105.6%.

In January-August 2021, the share of this industry amounted to 7.7%, the physical volume index decreased by 25.8%, and the production volume amounted to 17 102.6 billion soums.

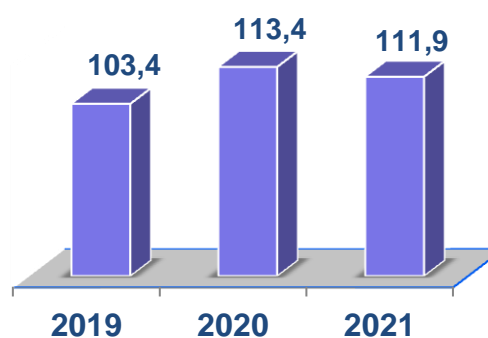
## Manufacture of rubber and plastic products for January-August

At the end of January-August 2020, the share of production of rubber and plastic products in the structure of the manufacturing industry amounted to 1.8%, while the physical volume index, in relation to the same period of 2019, amounted to 113.4%.

In January-August 2021, the share of this industry was 1.8%, the physical volume index was 111,9 %, and the production volume was 4 053.5 billion soums.

## Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning

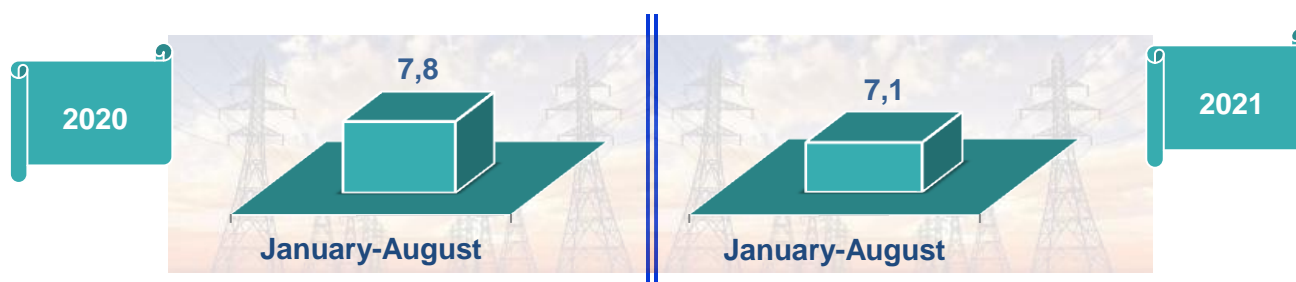

The volume of products produced by the enterprises of electricity supply, gas supply, steam and air conditioning amounted to 19.2 trillion soums (7.1% of the total industrial volume).

The index of the physical volume of the industry, compared to the corresponding period of 2020, increased by 10.6%.

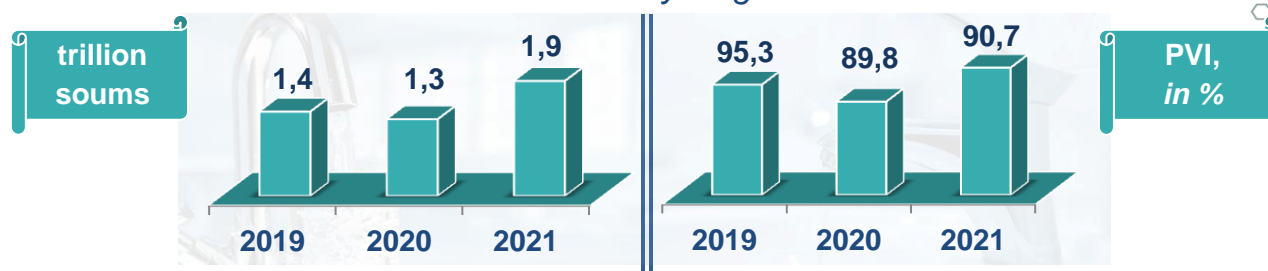
### Share since the beginning of the year, *in%*

The volume of products produced by enterprises of water supply, sewerage, waste collection and disposal amounted to 1.9 trillion soums (0.7% of the total industry).

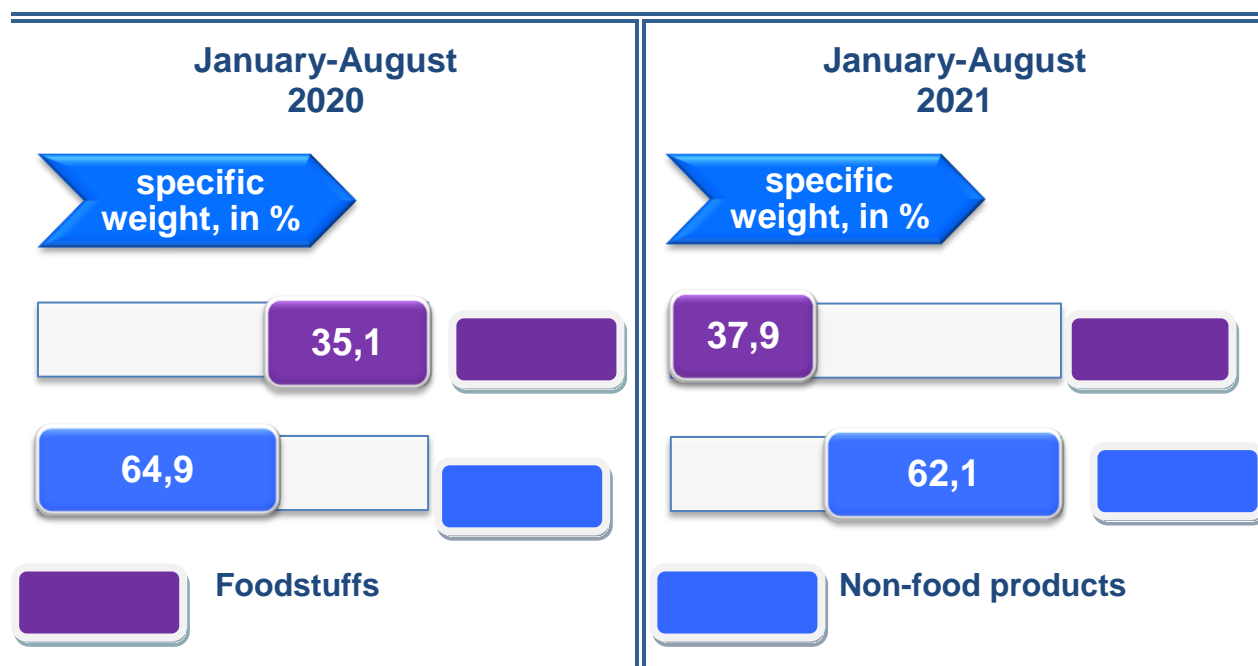

Compared to the corresponding period of 2020, there was a decrease in services for the emptying, cleaning and treatment of cesspools, sedimentation tanks and septic tanks by 3.9%. At the same time, an increase in the production of textile waste was recorded by 0.3%, as well as services for the removal, transportation of wastewater and their treatment - by 54.0%.

## Production of consumer goods

As a result of measures taken to expand the range and stimulate the production of finished products, the production of consumer goods amounted to 86.6 trillion soums and, in comparison with the corresponding period of 2020, the growth rate reached 107.5%, the share in the total volume of industry was 32.1%.



In the structure of food production, the production of wine and vodka products and beer amounted to 5.8% (7.0% in January-August 2020).

In the structure of consumer goods production in the republic, the largest share falls on the city of Tashkent (23.2% of the total volume of consumer goods), Andijan (15.8%), Tashkent (11.4%) and Samarkand (9.3%) regions.

The largest growth in consumer goods production was recorded in Jizzakh (125.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2020), Bukhara (123.4%), Syrdarya (121.1%), Namangan (118.9%), Khorezm (113.5 %), Tashkent (112.8%) regions and Tashkent city (122.4%), exceeding the national average (107.5%).



During the reporting period, enterprises with foreign investments produced goods worth 64.3 trillion soums, the share of which in the total production volume amounted to 23.8%.

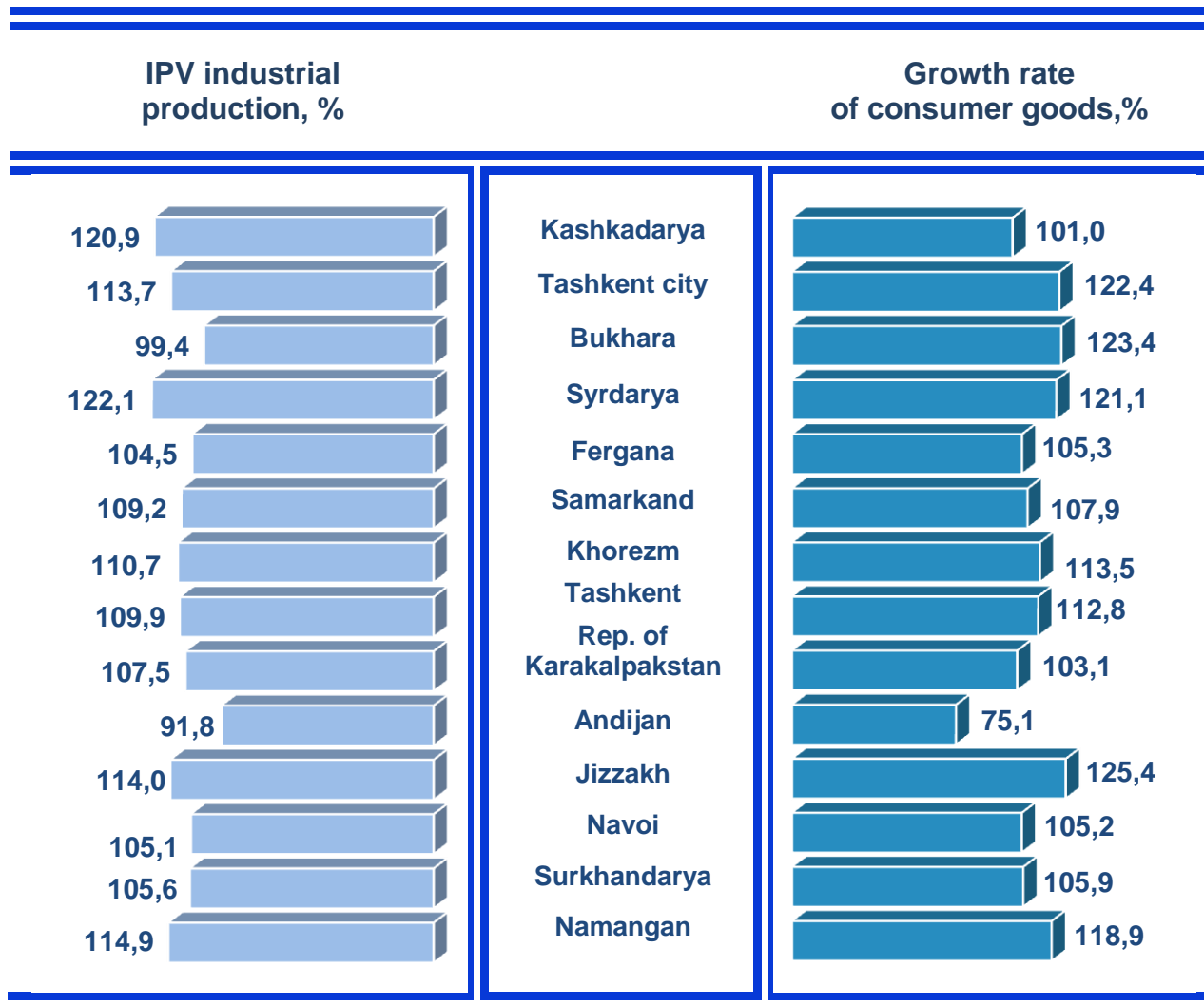

by regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan**

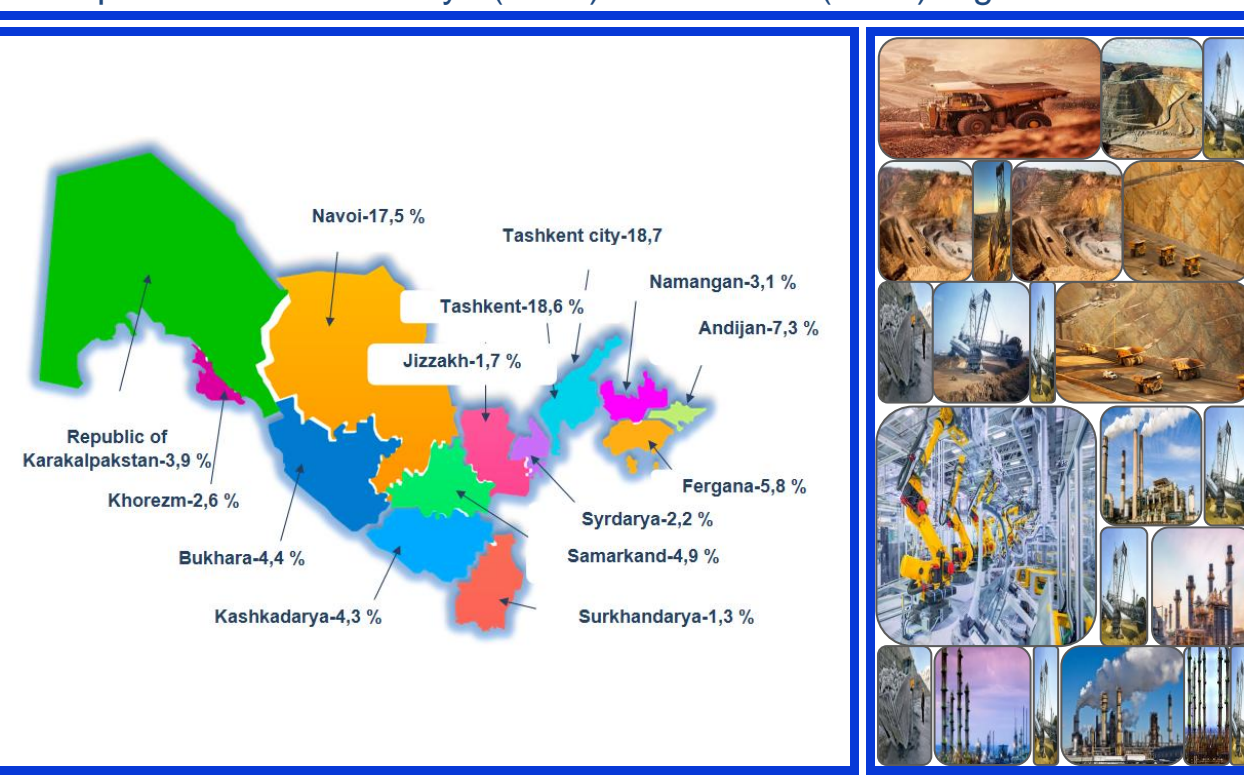


The change in industrial production was significantly influenced by the growth of the index of the physical volume of industrial production in Syrdarya (122.1% compared to January-August 2020), Kashkadarya (120.9%), Namangan (114.9%), Jizzakh (114.0 %), Khorezm (110.7%) regions and Tashkent city (113.7%).

## The share of industrial products of the regions in the total production of the Republic of Uzbekistan

In the structure of industrial output of the republic, the largest share falls on the enterprises of Tashkent city (18.7% of the republican volume of industry), Tashkent (18.6%), Navoi (17.5%), Andijan (7.3%) and Fergana (5.8%) regions.

The smallest share of industrial production was recorded at the enterprises of Surkhandarya (1.3%) and Jizzakh (1.7%) regions.



Analysis of the differentiation of industrial output per capita showed an excess of the national average (7 772.5 thousand soums) in Navoi (46 487.4 thousand soums), Tashkent (16 822.3 thousand soums) regions and Tashkent city (18 616.5 thousand soums).

The production of consumer goods per capita in the reporting period in the republic amounted to 2 496.2 thousand soums, including in Tashkent city – 7 415.5 thousand soums, Andijan region – 4 287.8 thousand soums, Tashkent region – 3 298.8 thousand soums, Syrdarya region – 2 572.8 thousand soums.

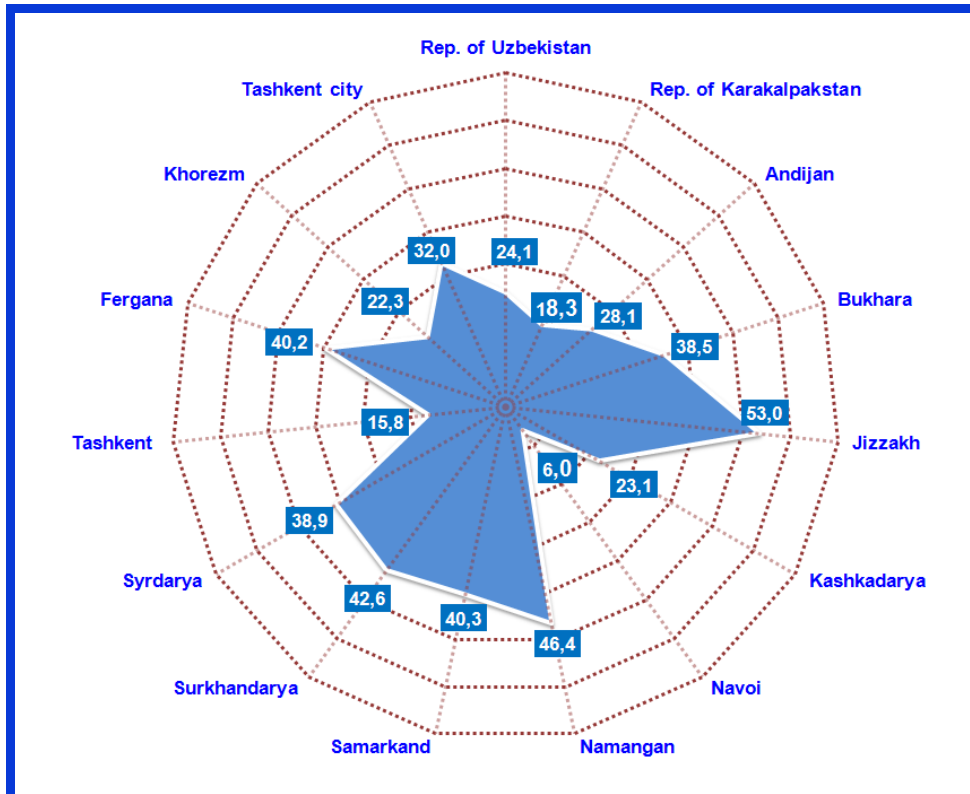
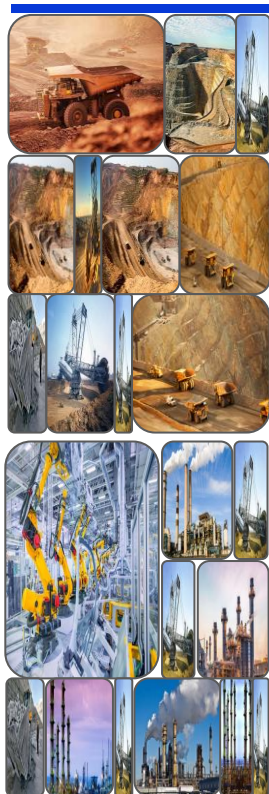

## Small business contribution to industrial production for January-August 2021, in %

During the reporting period, small businesses produced goods for 65,0 trillion soums, the share of which in the total production volume amounted to 24,1 %.

In terms of regions, the largest share of small business was observed in Jizzakh (53,0 % of the total industry in the region), Namangan (46,4%), Surkhandarya (42,6%), Fergana (40,2 %), Samarkand (40,3 %) regions.

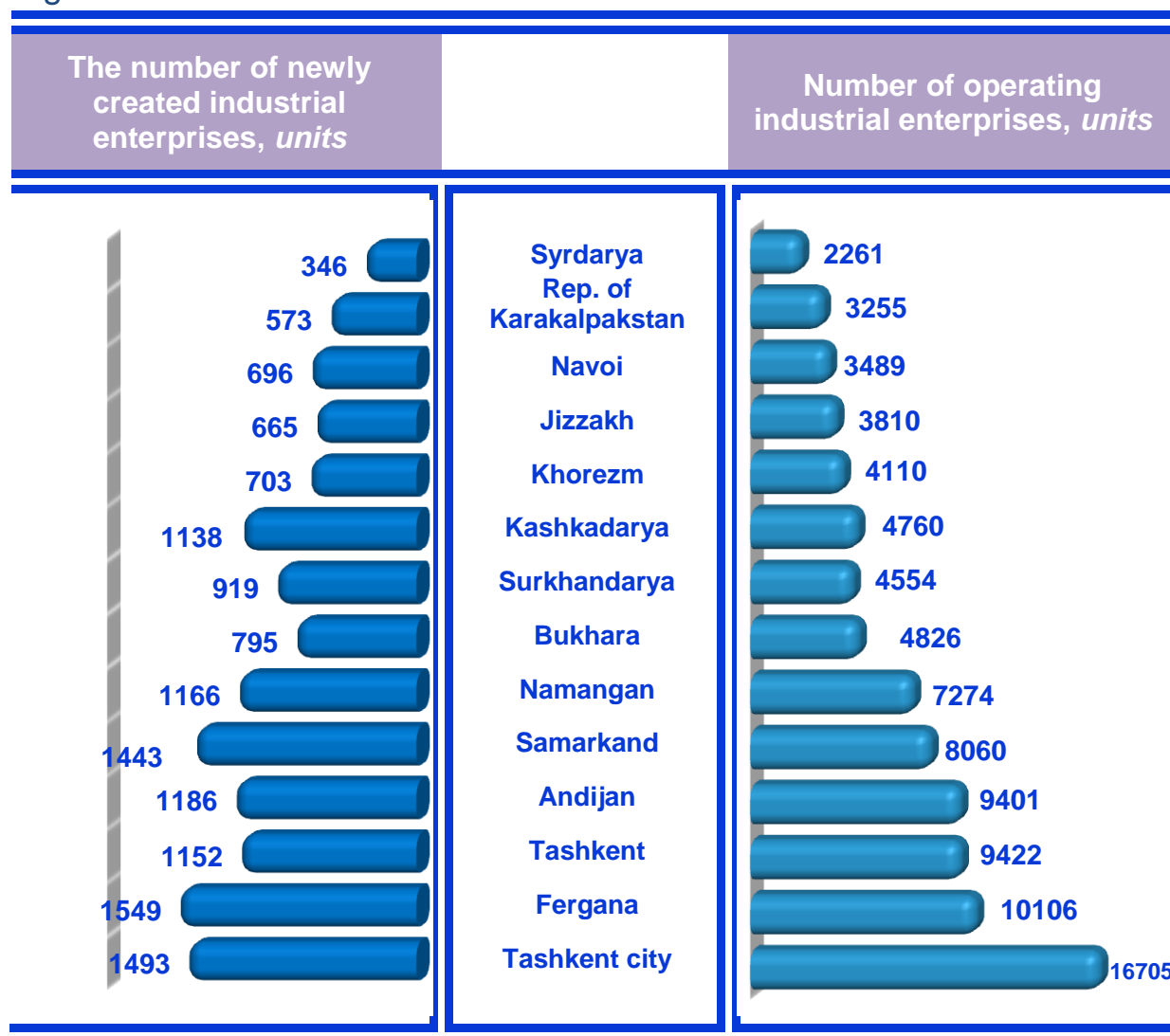


At the same time, the smallest share of small business was noted in Navoi (6.0%), Tashkent (15.8%), Khorezm (22.3%), Kashkadarya (23.1%), regions, as well as in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (18.3%). Analysis of the structure of industrial production in the context of the regions of the republic showed that the low share of production of small businesses in the total volume of industry is explained by the significant volume of production of large industrial enterprises located in these regions.

## Number of operating and newly created industrial enterprises

*as of September 1, 2021*

Today, 92.0 thousand industrial enterprises operate in the republic, of which 16.7 thousand (18.2% of the total number of operating enterprises) are in the city of Tashkent, 10.1 thousand (11.0%) - Fergana, 9.4 thousand (10.2%) - Tashkent region, 9.4 thousand (10.2%) - Andijan region, 8.1 thousand (8.8%) - Samarkand region and 7.3 thousand (7.9%) - Namangan region.

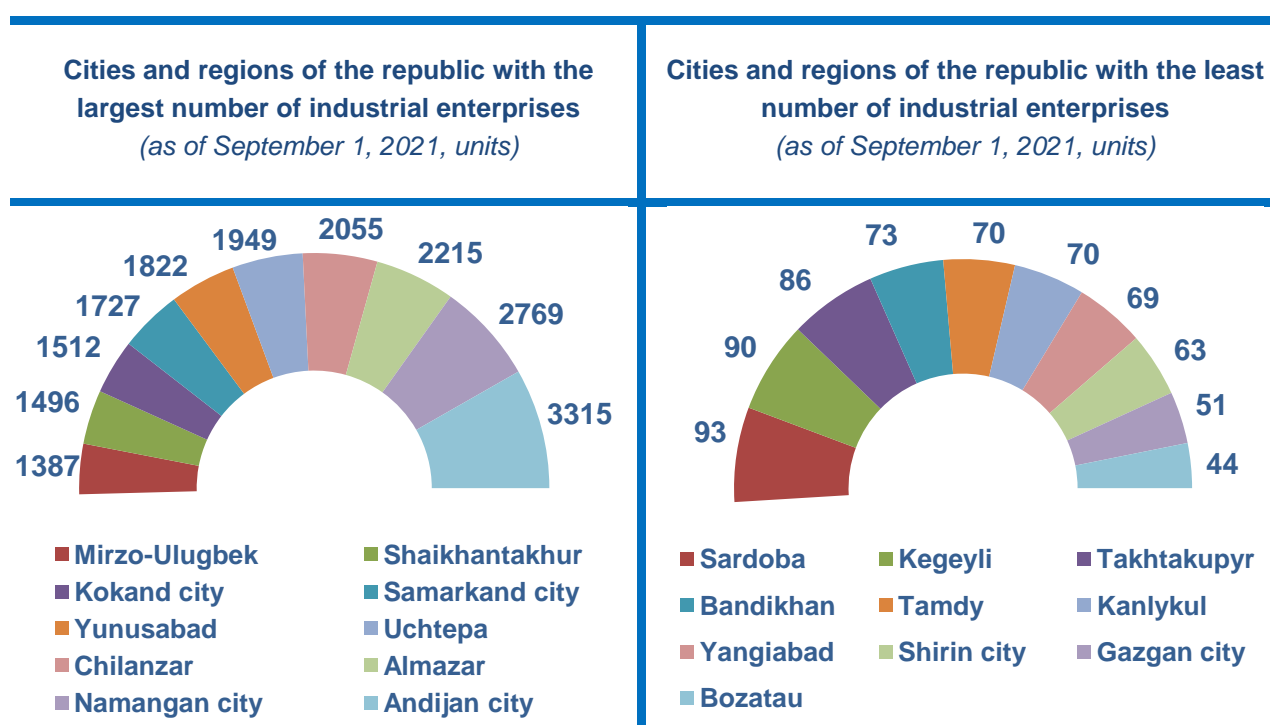


In January-August 2021, 13 824 industrial enterprises were newly created in the republic, of which 1 549 (11.2% of the total number of newly created ones) accounted for Fergana, 1 443 (10.4%) - Samarkand, 1 166 (8.4%) - Namangan, 1 138 (8.2%) - Kashkadarya region and 1 493 (10.8%) - Tashkent city.

## Operating industrial enterprises in the context of cities and regions

*as of September 1, 2021*

To date, the largest number of operating industrial enterprises are located in the cities of Andijan (3 315 units), Namangan (2 769 units), Samarkand (1 727 units), Kokand (1 512 units), as well as in the following districts of Tashkent city: Almazar (2 215 units), Chilanzar (2 055 units), Uchtepa (1 949 units), Yunusabad (1 822 units), Shaikhantakhur (1 496 units) and Mirzo-Ulugbeksky (1 387 units).



As of September 1, 2021, the minimum number of operating industrial enterprises is located in the city of Shirin (63 units), Syrdarya region; Tamdy district (70 units) and Gazgan city (51 units) of Navoi region; Yangiabad (69 units) district of Jizzakh region; Kegeyli (90 units), Kanlykul (70 units), Takhtakupyr (86 units) and Bozatau (44 units) districts of the Republic of Karakalpakstan; Bandikhan district (73 units), Surkhandarya region.
