



FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN









*(preliminary data
for January-August 2021)*

At the end of January-August 2021, the republic's foreign trade turnover reached **24 963.7** million US dollars, which, compared to the same period in 2020, increased by **383.1** million US dollars (an increase of 1.6%).

For reference: When compiling statistics on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the United Nations International Standard Trade Classification (hereinafter - SITC) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods. Assignment of SITC codes to goods is carried out using transition keys between the HS and SITC.

Of the total volume of the FTT, exports amounted to **9,277.9** million US dollars (by January-August 2020, a decrease of 20.1% was noted), and imports – **15 685.8** million US dollars (an increase of 20.9%). As a result, the balance of foreign trade turnover amounted to a passive balance in the amount of - **6 407.9** million US dollars.

Among the 20 large partner countries in foreign economic activity, there is also an active foreign trade balance with four countries, in particular with such countries as Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Turkey. The remaining 16 countries maintain a passive balance of foreign trade turnover.

Today Uzbekistan carries out trade relations with **174** countries of the world. The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with the PRC (**19.2%**), the Russian Federation (**17.9%**), Kazakhstan (**9.9%**), Turkey (**8.6%**), the Republic of Korea (**4.8%**), Kyrgyzstan (**2.4%**) and Germany (**1.9%**).

In the structure of the republic's foreign trade turnover, a significant share is noted in Tashkent, which is 39.9%, or **9 967.6** million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded at the level of 1.1%, or **273.4** million US dollars, which is marked in Surkhandarya region.

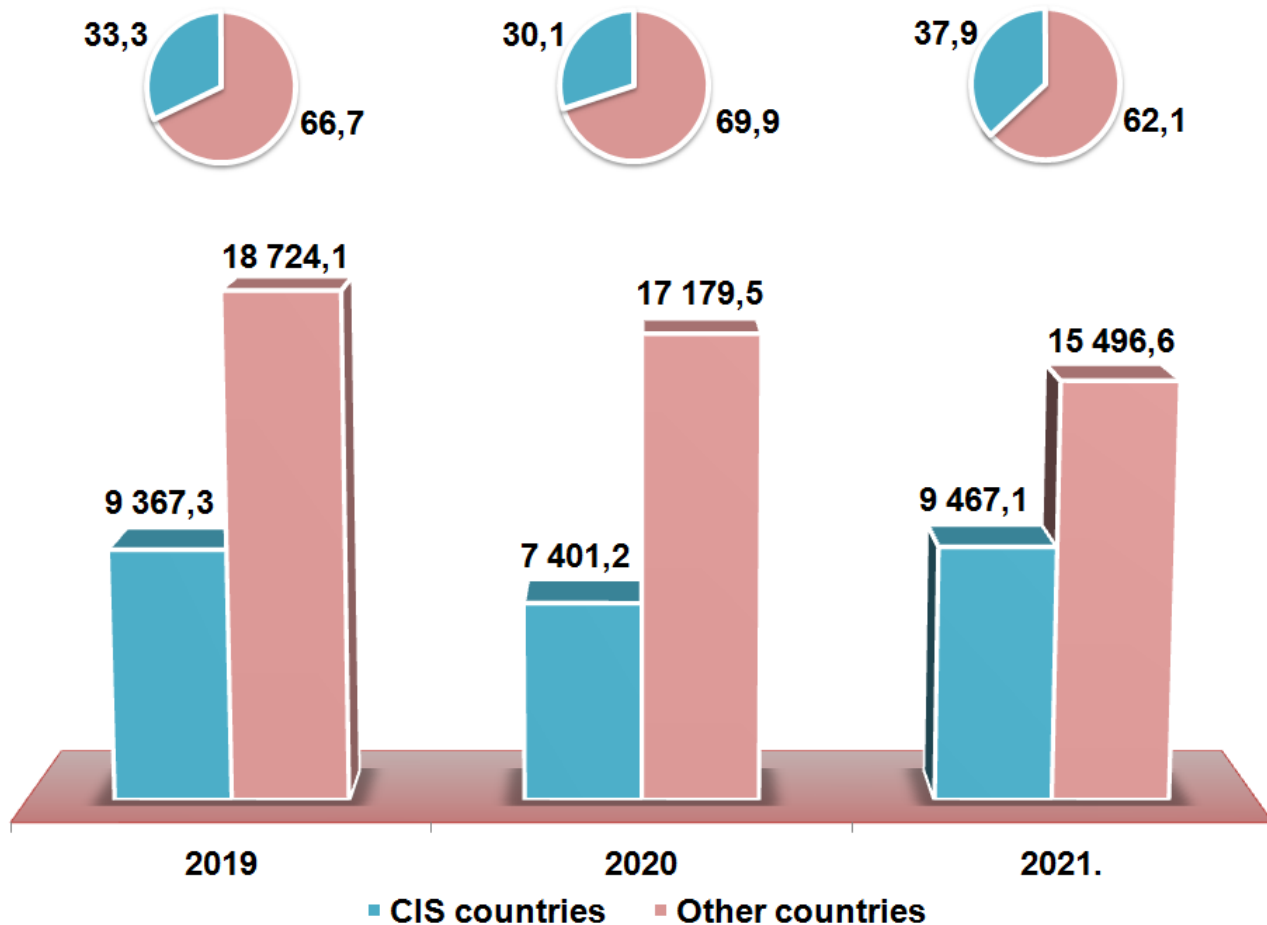
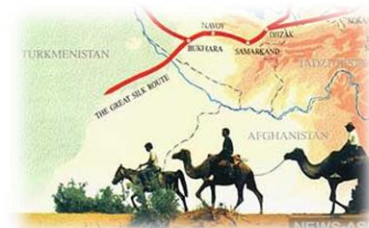

The share of foreign trade turnover of the CIS countries, compared to the same period in 2020, increased by **7.8%** and their share in foreign trade turnover, in January-August 2021, amounted to **37.9%**.

(for January-August 2021, million US dollars)



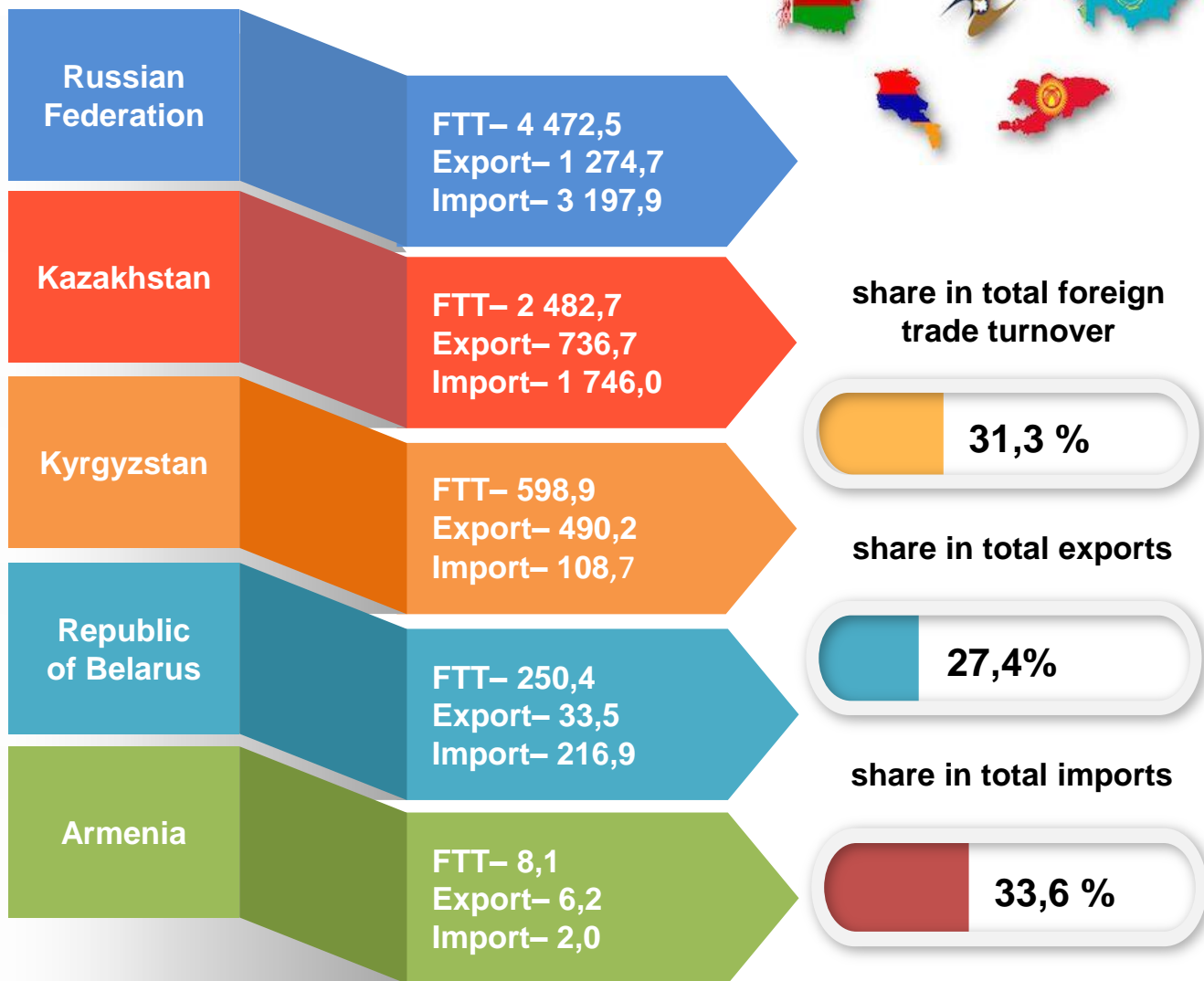
The foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the CIS countries reached **9 467.1** million US dollars. Of these, the volume of exports amounted to **3 280.4** million US dollars, and the volume of imports - **6 186.7** million US dollars.

The largest volume of foreign trade turnover with the CIS countries was recorded with the Russian Federation (**47.2%**), Kazakhstan (**26.2%**) and Kyrgyzstan (**6.3%**).

The foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the EAEU countries amounted to **7 812.7** million US dollars. Of these, the volume of exports amounted to **2 541.3** million US dollars, and the import volume – **5 271.4** million US dollars.

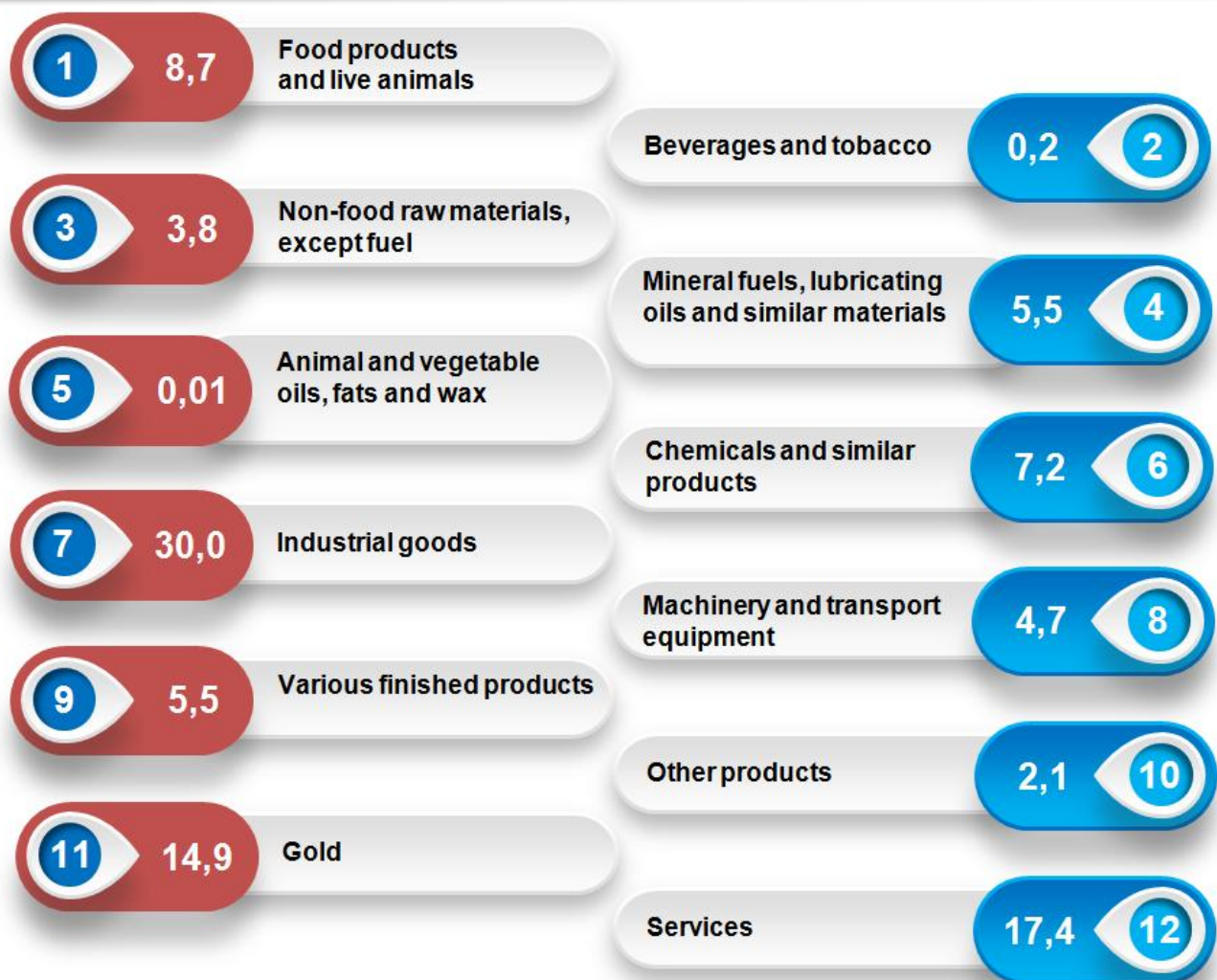


EXPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN *(for January-August 2021)*



In January-August 2021, the total number of exporting entities amounted to **5 527** units, which ensured the increase in the volume of exports without gold to **7 891.4** million US dollars (an increase, compared to the same period in 2020, amounted to **36.0%**).

In the structure of exports, **82.6%** are goods, which mainly fall on industrial goods (**30.0%**), food products and live animals (**8.7%**), chemicals and similar products (**7.2%**).

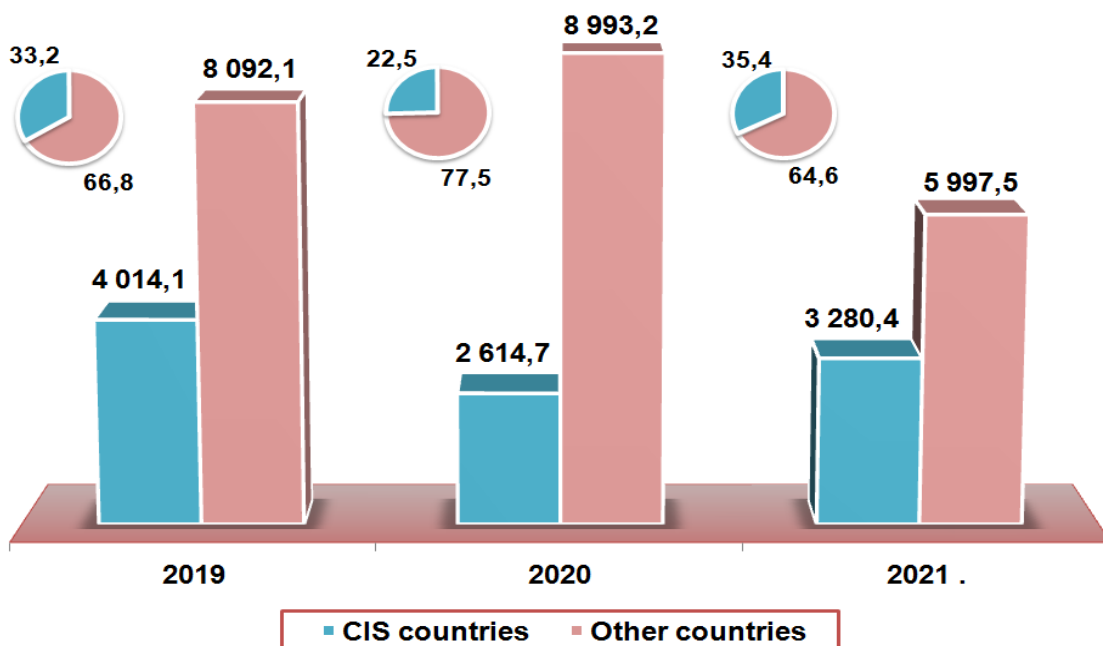

(for January-August, million US dollars, share %)

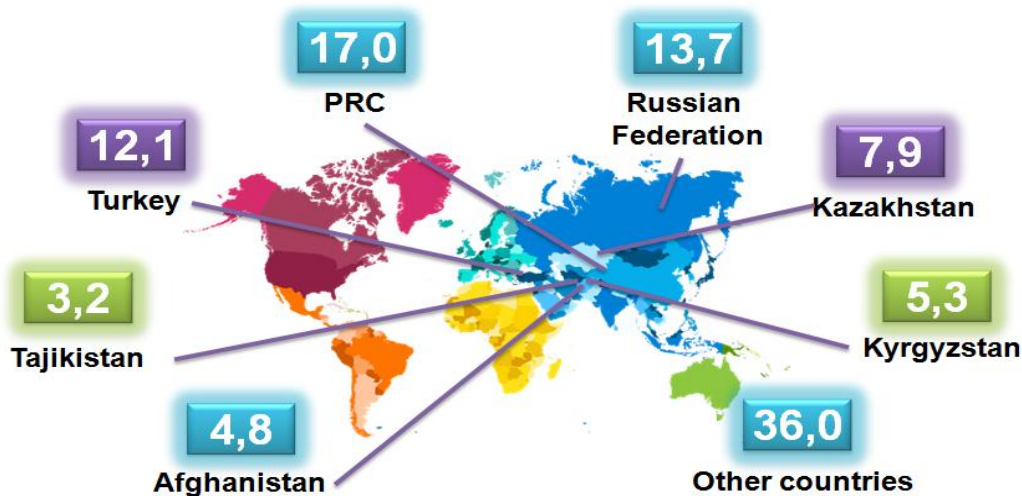


Due to a decrease in exports to other foreign countries, the share of exports to the CIS countries increased and their share in its total volume amounted to **35.4%**.



Compared to 2019-2020, our main partners in the export of goods and services in foreign trade in January-August 2021 were countries such as China, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Afghanistan and Tajikistan. Their share in the total export volume reached **64.0%**.

The volume of exports of fruits and vegetables amounted to **948.6** thousand tons and, in value terms, exceeded **548.6** million US dollars (the rate of decline, compared to the same period in 2020, respectively, amounted to **7.7%**). On the basis of this, **579.0** thousand tons of vegetables were exported in the amount of **244.8** million US dollars, as well as **198.4** thousand tons of fruits and berries in the amount of **195.0** million US dollars.

According to the results of January-August 2021, the largest volume in value terms of exports of fruit and vegetable products falls on the Russian Federation (31.9% of the total volume of fruit and vegetable products), which exceeds the volume of exports to China by 5.5 times.

EXPORT OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS












According to the results of January-August 2021, the export of textile products was carried out in the amount of **1 891.7** million US dollars, which amounted to **20.4%** of the total export volume and, compared to January-August 2020, it increased by **62.0 %**.

Cotton yarn (**55.8%**), as well as finished knitwear and garments (**22.8%**), account for the main share in the structure of export of textile products. In January-August 2021, more than 468 types of textile products were exported to **61** countries of the world.

The volume of exports of services in January-August 2021 amounted to **1 610.2** million US dollars, or **17.4%** of the total trade exports and increased by **23.2%** compared to the same period in 2020.

Transport services (**70.5%**), travel (tourism) (**13.8%**), telecommunications, computer and information services (**6.9%**), and other business services (**4.4%**) account for the lion's share of the export of services.

At the same time, other services (**4.4%**), respectively, account for the largest share of financial services (**1.1%**), insurance and pension services (**1.0%**), construction services (**0.8%**), etc.

(for January-July 2021)

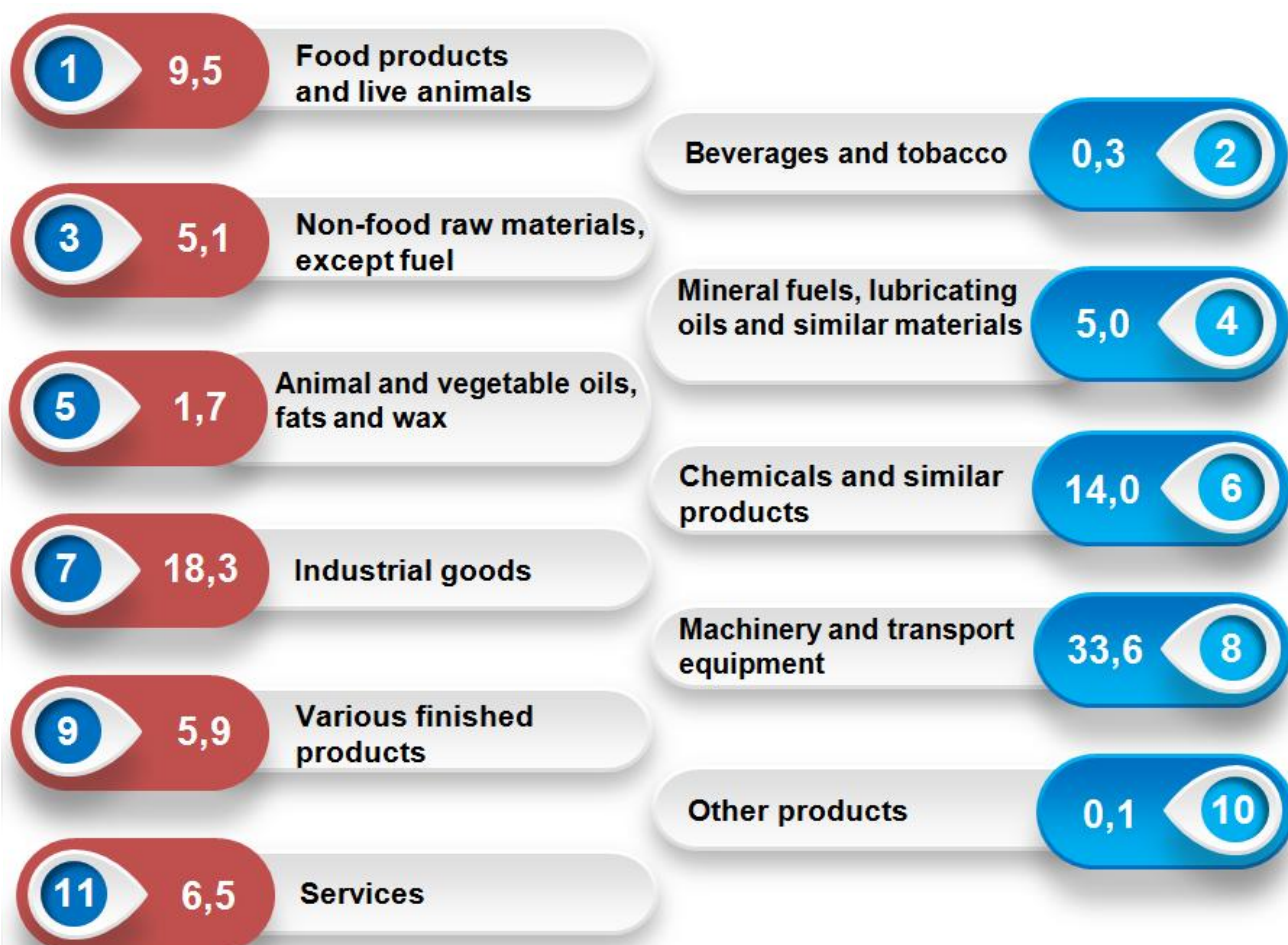


During the reporting period, imports amounted to **15 685.8** million US dollars (an increase in growth rates, compared to January-August 2020, amounted to **120.9%**).

The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (**33.6%**), industrial goods (**18.3%**), as well as chemicals and similar products (**14.0%**).

Analysis of the dynamics of imports of goods also showed that in January-August 2021, compared to the same period in 2020, the volume of imports of goods increased by **2 457.1** million US dollars and amounted to **14 664.6** million US dollars, and imports of services reached **1 021.2** million US dollars.

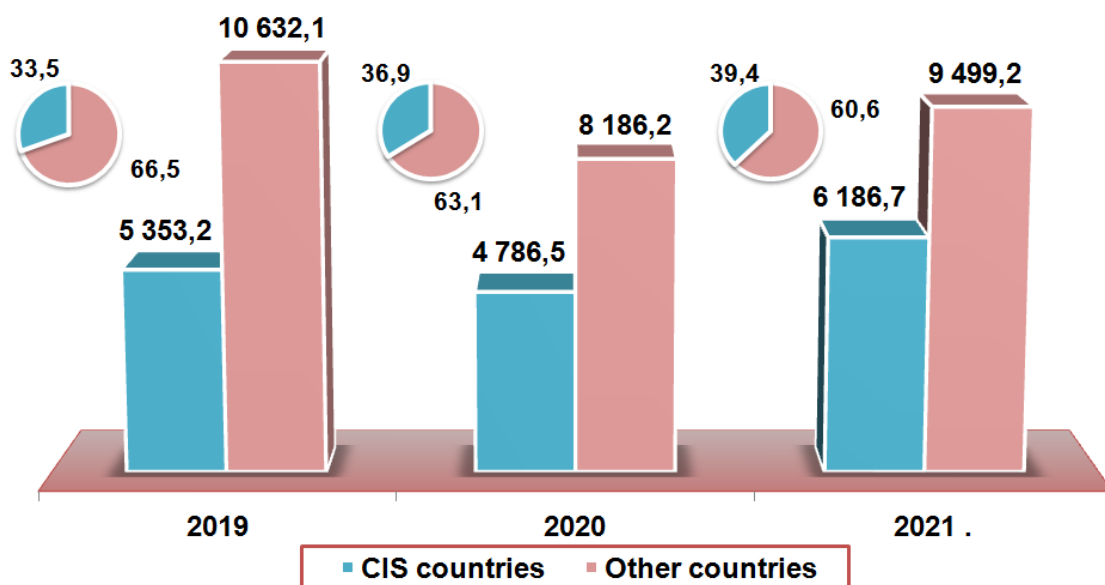


DYNAMICS OF IMPORT FROM THE CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN STATES

(for January-August, million US dollars, share %)



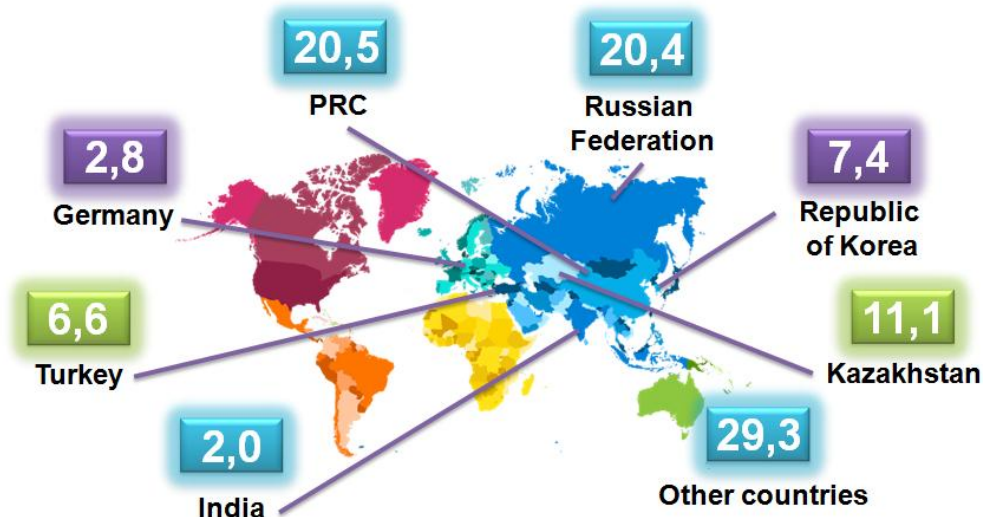
The share of imports from the CIS countries, compared to the same period in 2020, increased by **2.5%** and their share in foreign trade turnover, in January-August 2021, amounted to **39.4%**.



In general, in January-August 2021, goods and services from 153 countries were imported to the Republic of Uzbekistan. One third of imports comes from such large partner countries as China, the Russian Federation, Kazakhstan, the Republic of Korea, Turkey, Germany and India.

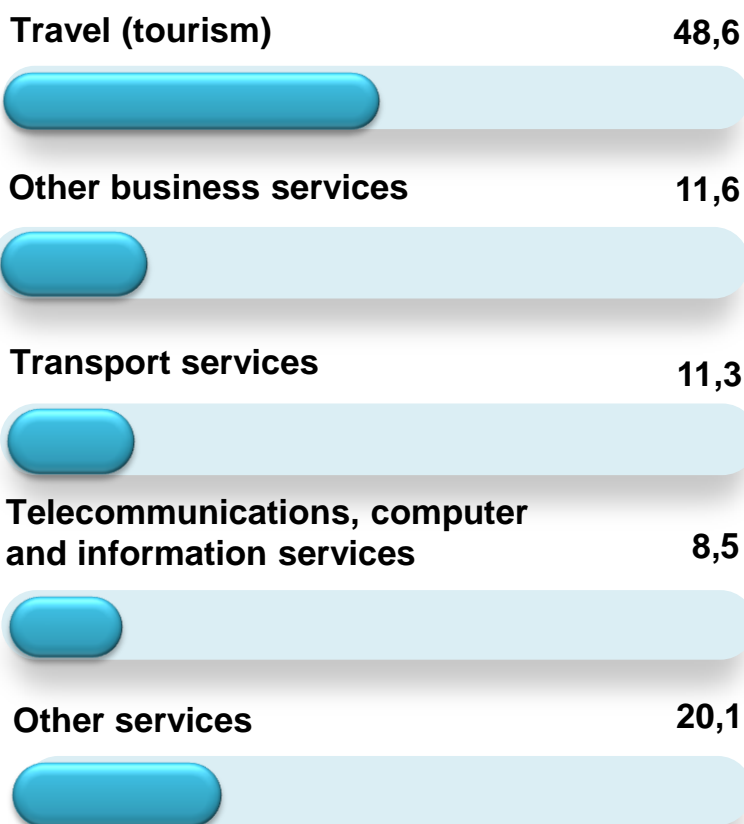
In the structure of imports of the republic, a significant share is noted in the city of Tashkent, which is **47.9%**, or **7 512.4** million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded in Surkhandarya - **0.9%**, or **145.9** million US dollars.



The volume of imports of services in January-August 2021 amounted to **1 021.2** million US dollars, or **6.5%** of its total volume, and increased by **33.5%** compared to the same period in 2020. Travel (tourism - **48.6%**), other business services (**11.6%**), transport services (**11.3%**), telecommunications, computer and information services (**8.5%**) make up the bulk of imports of services.

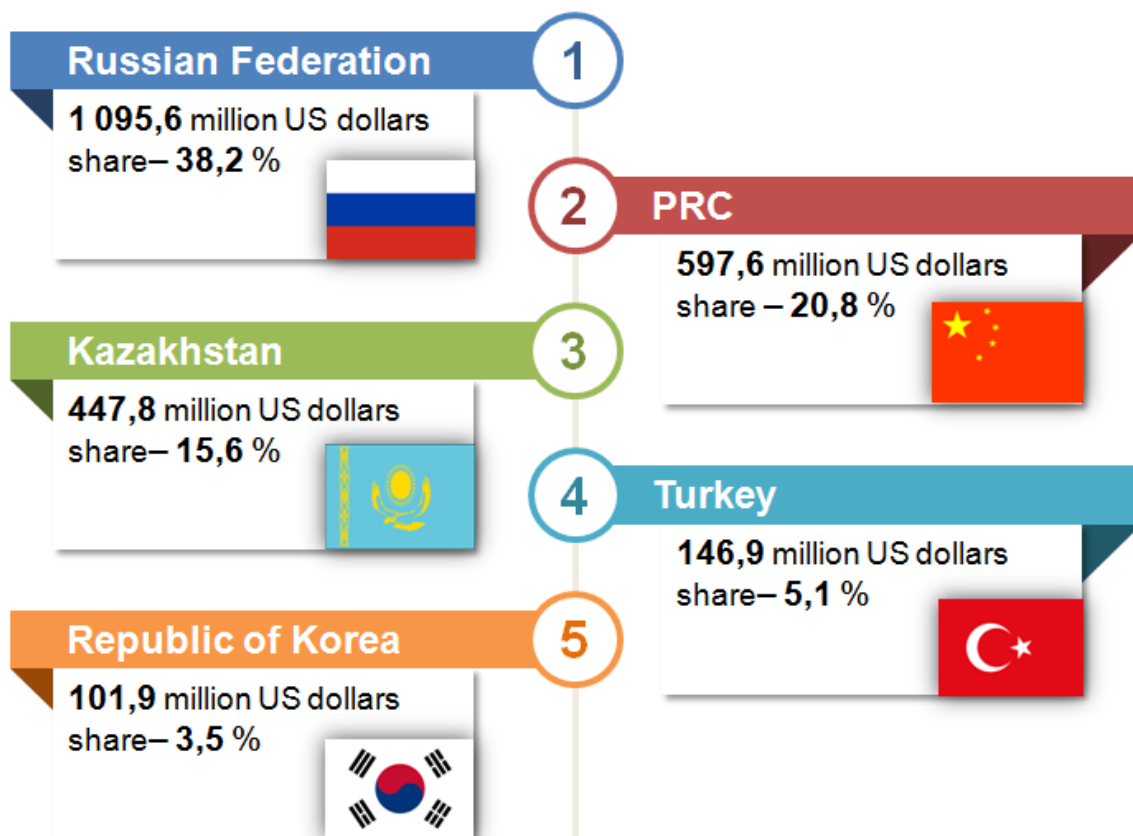
Imports of machinery and transport equipment increased by **391.8** million US dollars. Most of the supply of these goods to the country falls on the PRC - **1 816.6** million US dollars (34.4%), the Republic of Korea - **797.1** million US dollars (15.1%) and Turkey - **518.1** million US dollars (9.8%).
