Entrepreneurial activity (entrepreneurship) is an initiative activity carried out by business entities in accordance with the law, aimed at obtaining income (profit) at their own risk and under their own property liability.

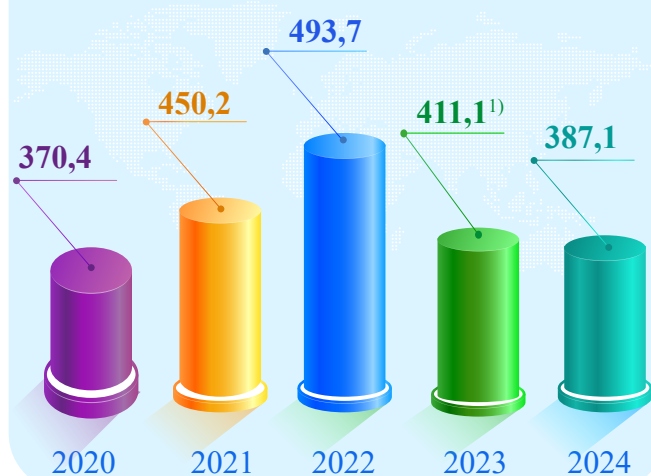
Operating small businesses and micro-firms

As of July 1, 2024, the total number of operating small businesses and microfirms amounted to **387.1** thousand. The number of small business entities per 1000 population amounted to **13.0** units.

Number of newly created small businesses and micro-firms

In January-June 2024, **41.0** thousand new small enterprises and microfirms (excluding dehkan and farm enterprises) were created.

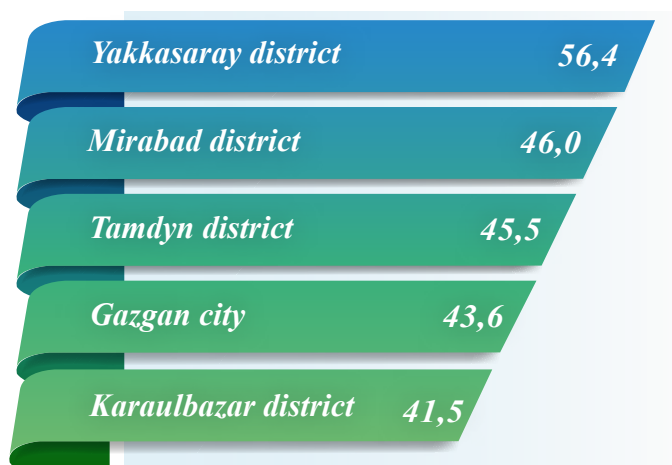
Number of operating small business entities (per 1000 population, units) *as of July 1, 2024*

Dynamics of operating small business entities in the Republic of Uzbekistan (per 1000 population, units) *as of July 1*

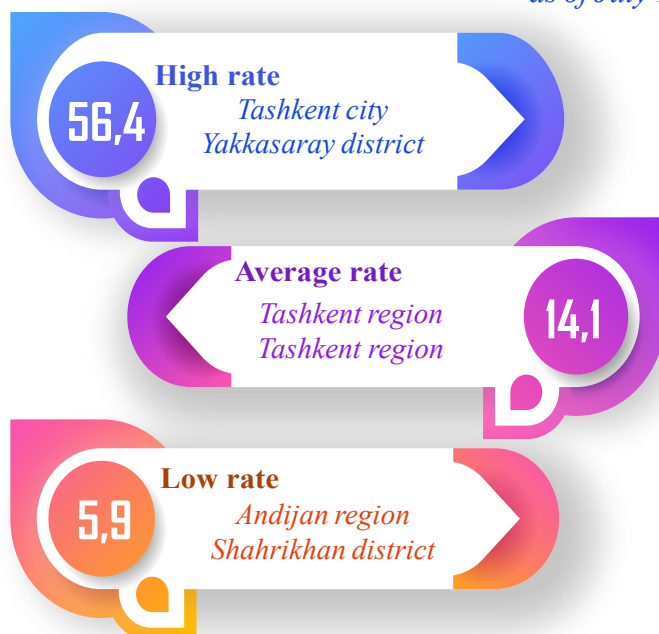


Cities and districts with the highest indicators for the number of operating small businesses (per 1000 population, units) *as of July 1, 2024*

Number of newly created small enterprises and microfirms by region, units for January-June 2024

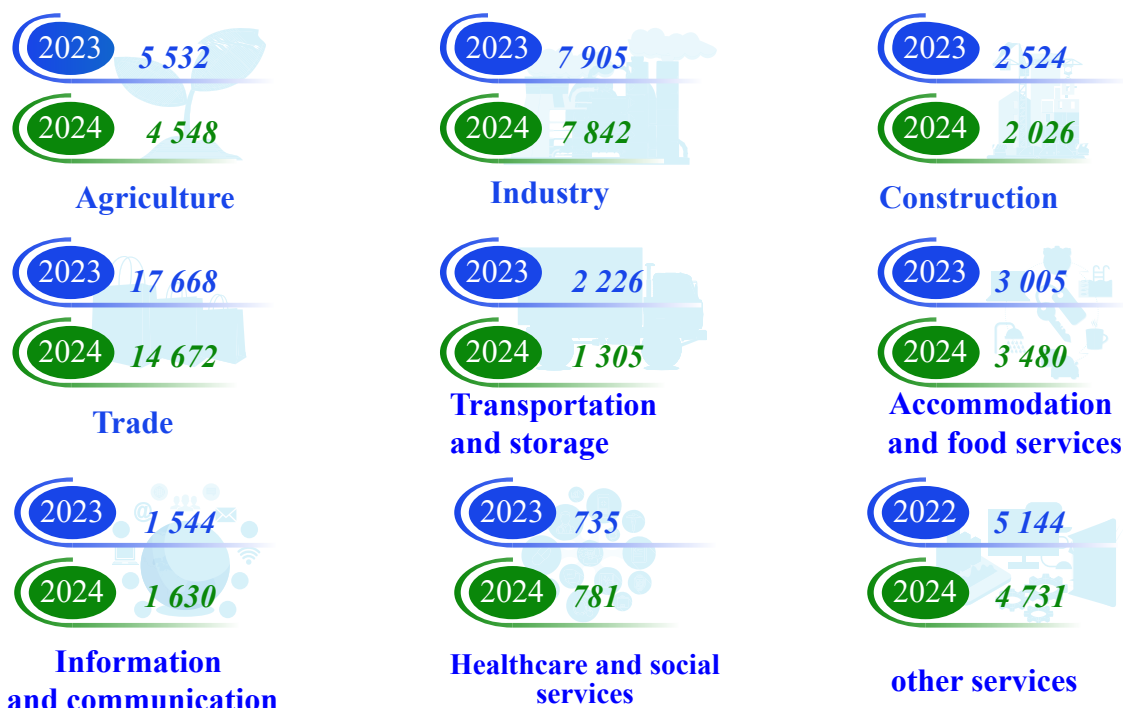

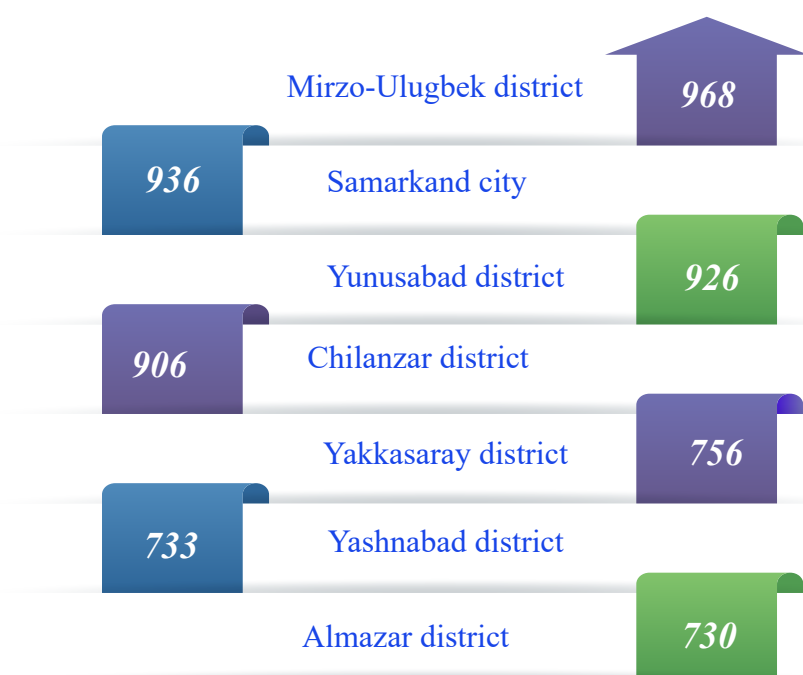


The number of newly created small enterprises and microfirms

for January-June 2023-2024.



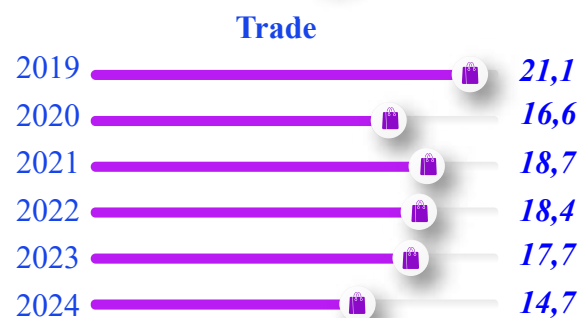
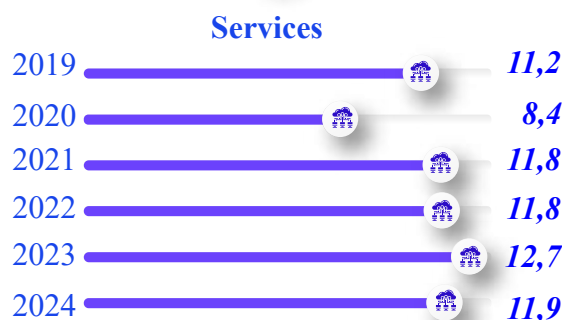
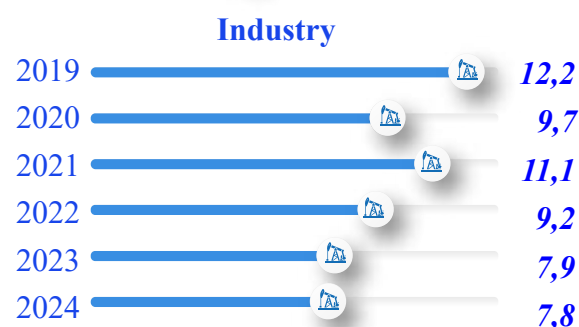
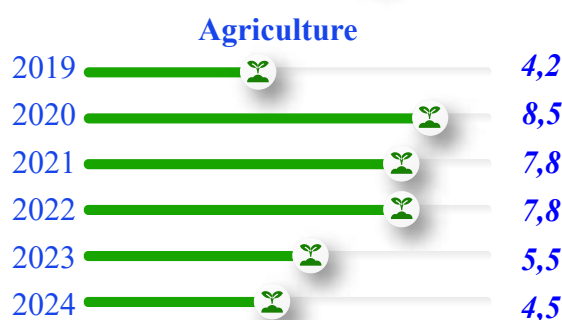
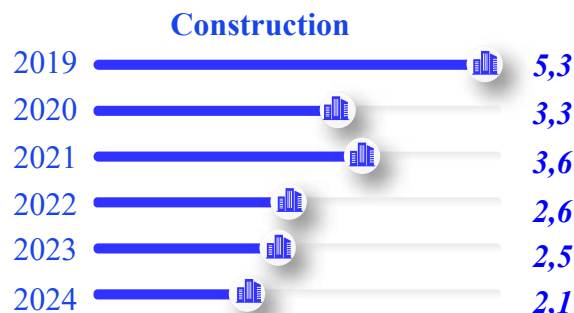
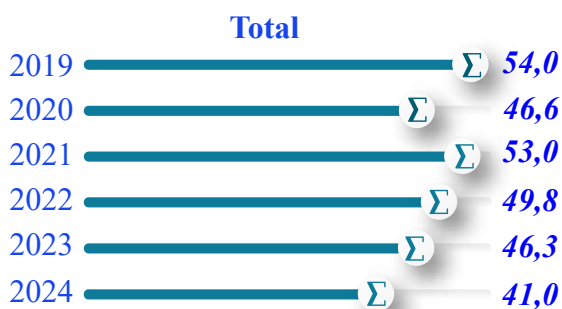

for January-June 2024

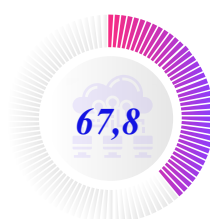
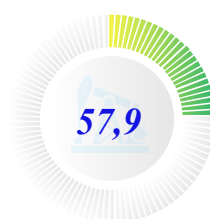
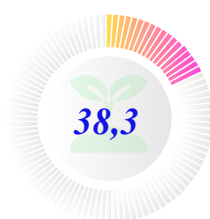
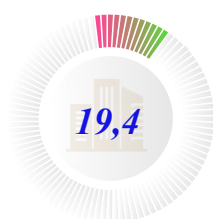


An analysis of the cities and districts of the republic showed that the largest number of newly created small enterprises and microfirms was recorded in Mirzo-Ulugbek district - **968** units, Samarkand city - **936** units, Yunusabad - **926** units, Chilanzar - **906** units, Yakkasaray - **756** units, Yashnabad - **733** units, Almazar - **730** units, Samarkand - **682** units, Shaikhantakhur - **680** units, Namangan city - **664** units and Mirabad district - **629** units.

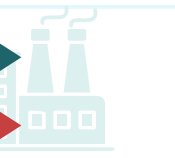
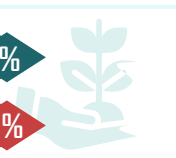
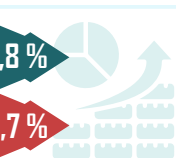
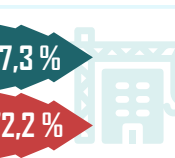


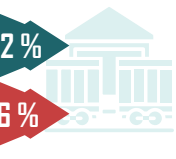
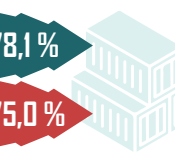


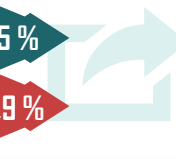
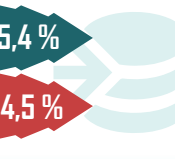
As a result of the measures taken aimed at further improving the system of support for entrepreneurship and improving the business climate, resolutions and decrees adopted by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan for January-June 2019-2024, a total of **290.6** thousand small enterprises and microfirms were created. It should be noted that the largest number of new entities were created in the field of trade - **107.2** thousand units (or **36.9%**), the service sector - **67.8** thousand units (or **23.3%**), industry - **57.9** thousand units (or **19.9%**), agriculture, forestry and fisheries - **38.3** thousand units (or **13.2%**) and construction - **19.4** thousand units (or **6.7%**).

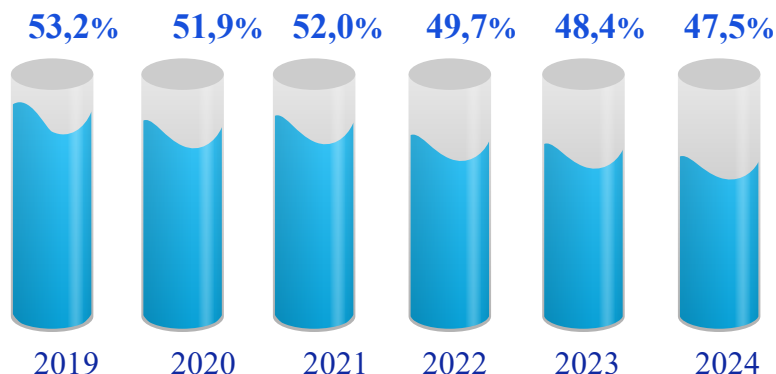

KEY ECONOMIC INDICATORS OF SMALL BUSINESS ENTITIES

Dynamics of the share of small businesses in GDP for January-June 2019-2024

In January-June 2024, the share of small businesses in GDP amounted to **47.5%** and, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, decreased by **0.9** percentage points. The main reason for this decrease was the increase in the volume of added value in large economic entities.

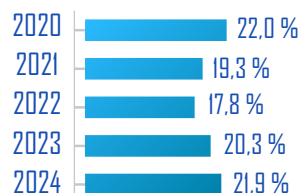


The share of small business in GDP by type of economic activity, % of GVA for January-June 2020-2024

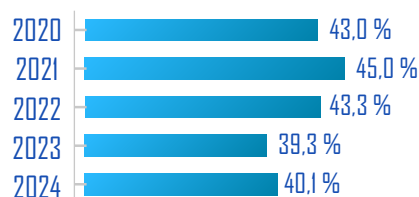

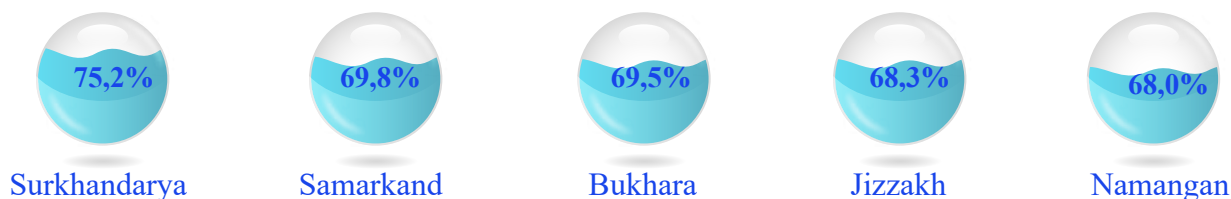

By type of economic activity in January-June 2024, the largest share of small business in GDP was in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - **96.7%**, construction - **74.8%**, services - **40.1%** and industry - **21.9%**.

In regional terms, the largest share of small business in GRP falls on Surkhandarya (**75.2%**), Samarkand (**69.8%**), Bukhara (**69.5%**), Jizzakh (**68.3%**), Namangan (**68.0%**), Fergana (**68.0%**) and Khorezm (**66.6%**) regions. In other regions, respectively: in Kashkadarya - **64.6%**, Andijan - **64.0%**, Syrdarya - **60.7%** regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan - **52.7%**, Tashkent city - **48.4%** and Tashkent region - **47.4%**.

In January-June 2024, small business entities produced industrial products worth **103 691.0** billion soums, or **28.0%** of their total volume. In January-June 2023, the growth rate was **116.5%**.

In January-June 2024, the volume of construction work performed by small businesses amounted to **57 674.9** billion soums, or **72.2%** of their total volume. The growth rate compared to the corresponding period of 2023 was **103.1%**.

In January-June 2024, small businesses spent **111 619.1** billion soums, or **48.7%** of their total, on fixed capital investments. The growth rate compared to the corresponding period of 2023 was **119.4%**.

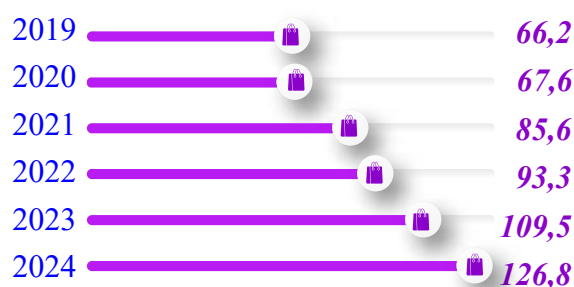

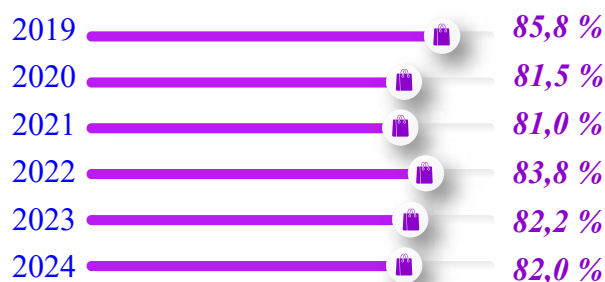

Volume, trillion soums



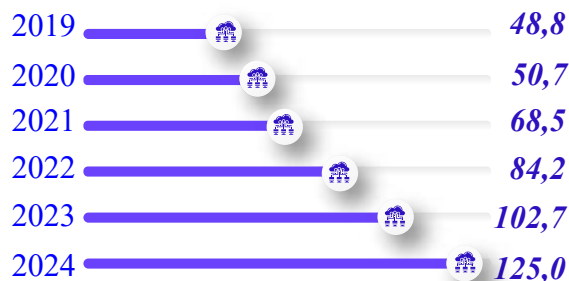

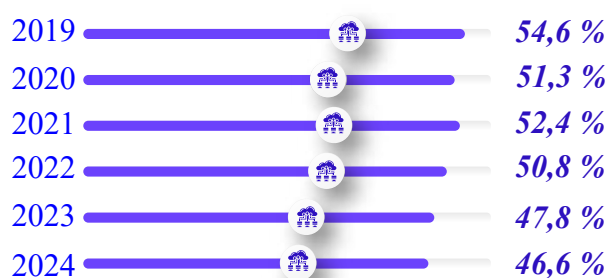

Volume, trillion soums



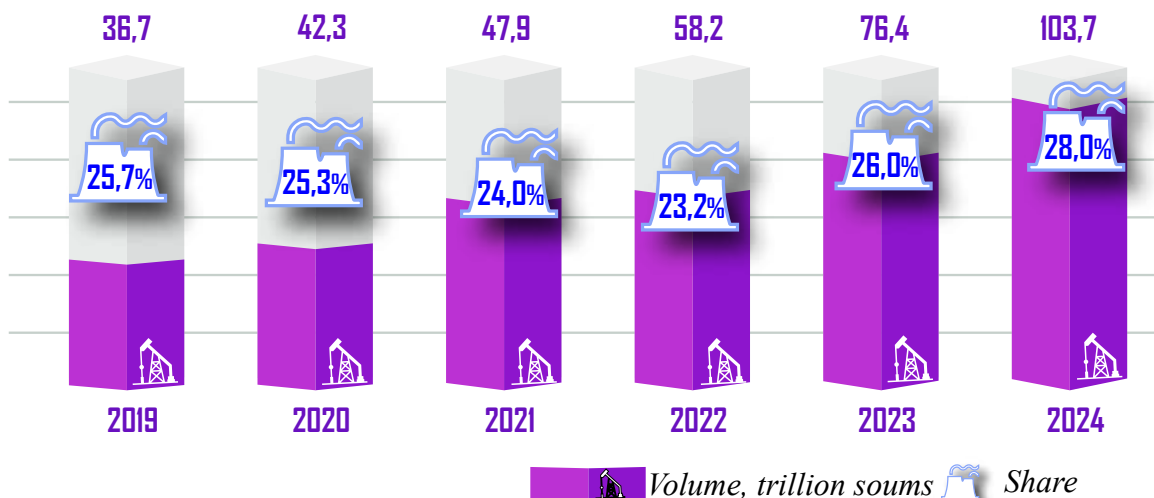

Dynamics of changes in the volume and share of industrial production of small business entities for January-June 2019-2024



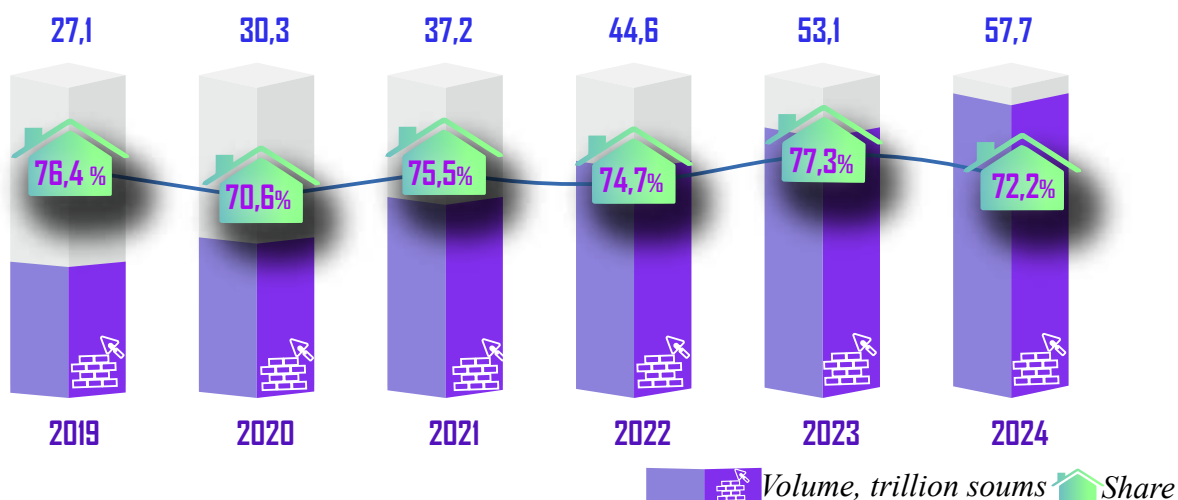
In January-June 2024, small businesses produced industrial products worth **103 691.0** billion soums, or **28.0%** of their total volume. In regional terms, the largest share of small businesses in the total production volume was in Surkhandarya - **59.2%**, Fergana - **49.8%**, Samarkand - **48.8%**, Namangan - **46.5%** and Bukhara - **38.5%** regions.

In regional terms, the largest volume of industrial production falls on Tashkent city (23 837.2 billion soums), Tashkent (15 201.9 billion soums), Fergana (9 502.9 billion soums), Samarkand (9 087.1 billion soums), Andijan (8 971.8 billion soums) and Bukhara (6 420.2 billion soums) regions.

In January-June 2024, the volume of construction work performed by small businesses in the Republic of Uzbekistan amounted to **57 674.9** billion soums, or **72.2%** of their total volume. In regional terms, the largest share falls on Andijan - **95.1%**, Namangan - **92.7%** and Jizzakh - **91.9%** regions.

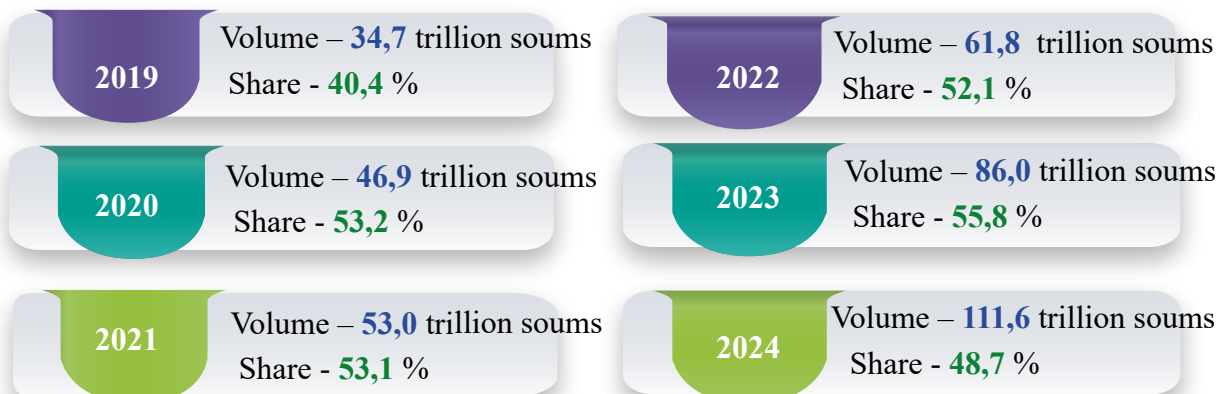
Volume and share of construction work completed by small businesses by region for January-June 2024

Dynamics of changes in the volume and share of investments in fixed capital by small business entities for January-June 2019-2024



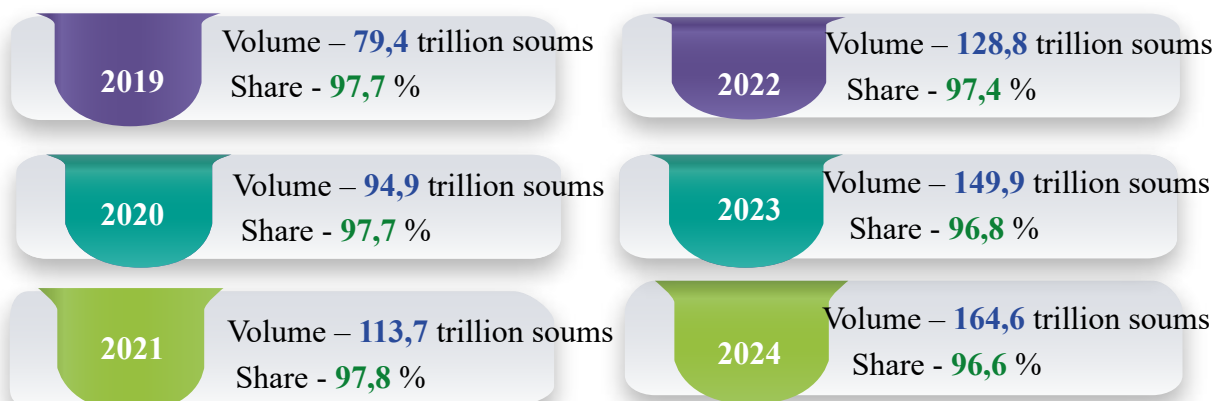
In January-June 2024, small businesses spent **111 619.1** billion soums, or **48.7%** of their total, in fixed capital investments. Regionally, the largest share of small businesses in the total volume of fixed capital investments was in Namangan - **74.5%**, Fergana - **67.1%**, Andijan - **65.4%**, Syrdarya - **65.4%** regions.

Volume and share of investments in fixed capital of small business entities by region for January-June 2024



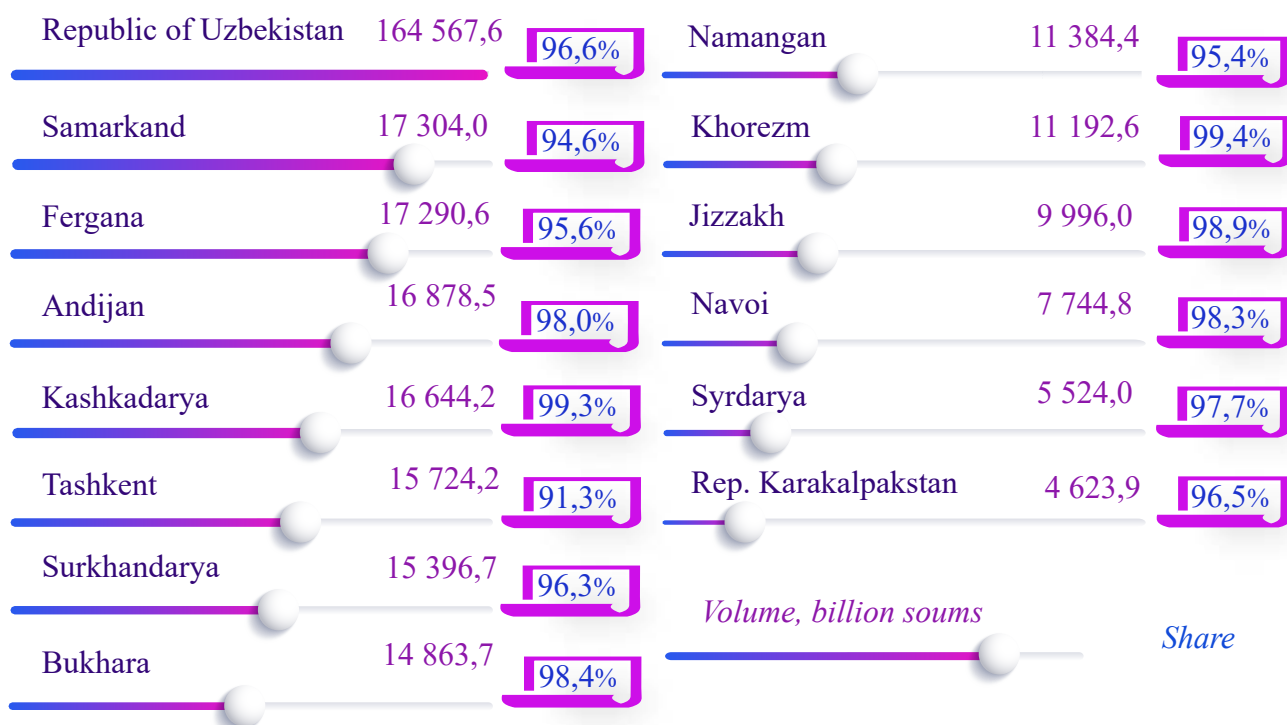

In January-June 2024, the volume of production of goods (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries amounted to **164 567.6 billion soums**, or **96.6%** of their total volume. In regional terms, the largest share was noted in Khorezm - **99.4%**, Kashkadarya - **99.3%**, Jizzakh - **98.9%**, Bukhara - **98.4%** and Navoi - **98.3%** regions.

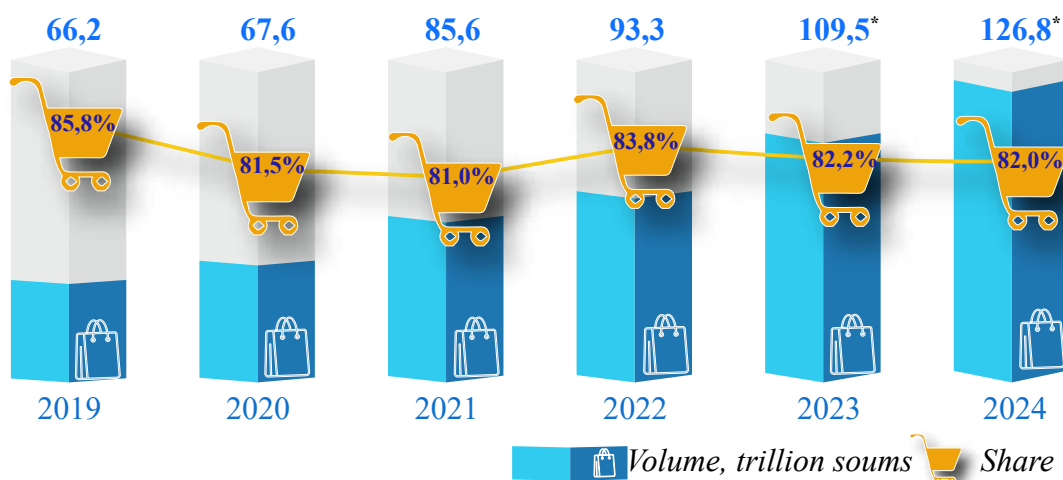
Volume and share of agricultural production of small business entities by region for January-June 2024

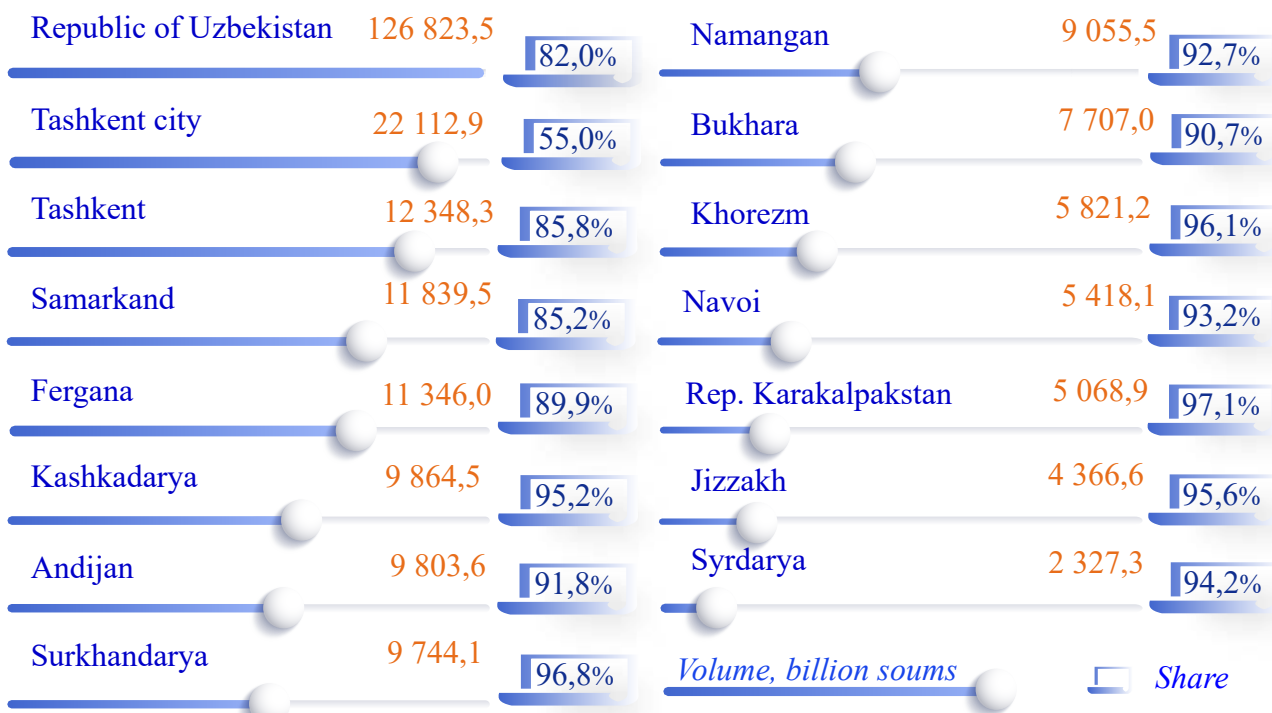

In January-June 2024, the volume of retail turnover of small businesses amounted to **126 823.5** billion soums, or **82.0%** of its total volume. In terms of regions, the largest share falls on the Republic of Karakalpakstan - **97.1%**, Surkhandarya - **96.8%**, Khorezm - **96.1%** and Jizzakh - **95.6%** regions.

Volume and share of retail turnover of small businesses by region for January-June 2024

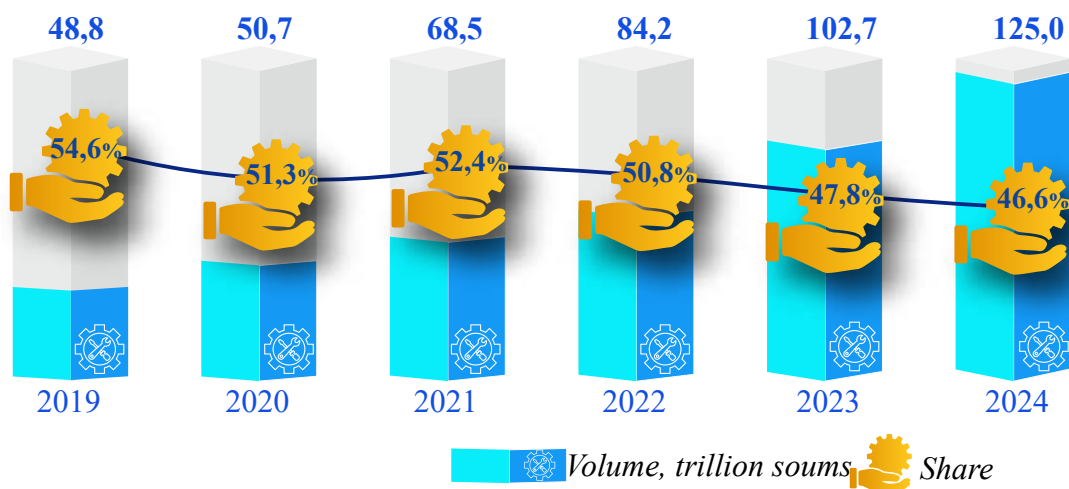


In regional terms, the largest volume of retail trade turnover was recorded in Tashkent city (**22 112.9** billion soums), Tashkent (**12 348.3** billion soums), Samarkand (**11 839.5** billion soums), Fergana (**11 346.0** billion soums), Kashkadarya (**9 864.5** billion soums), Andijan (**9 803.6** billion soums), Surkhandarya (**9 744.1** billion soums), Namangan (**9 055.5** billion soums) and Bukhara (**7 707.0** billion soums) regions.

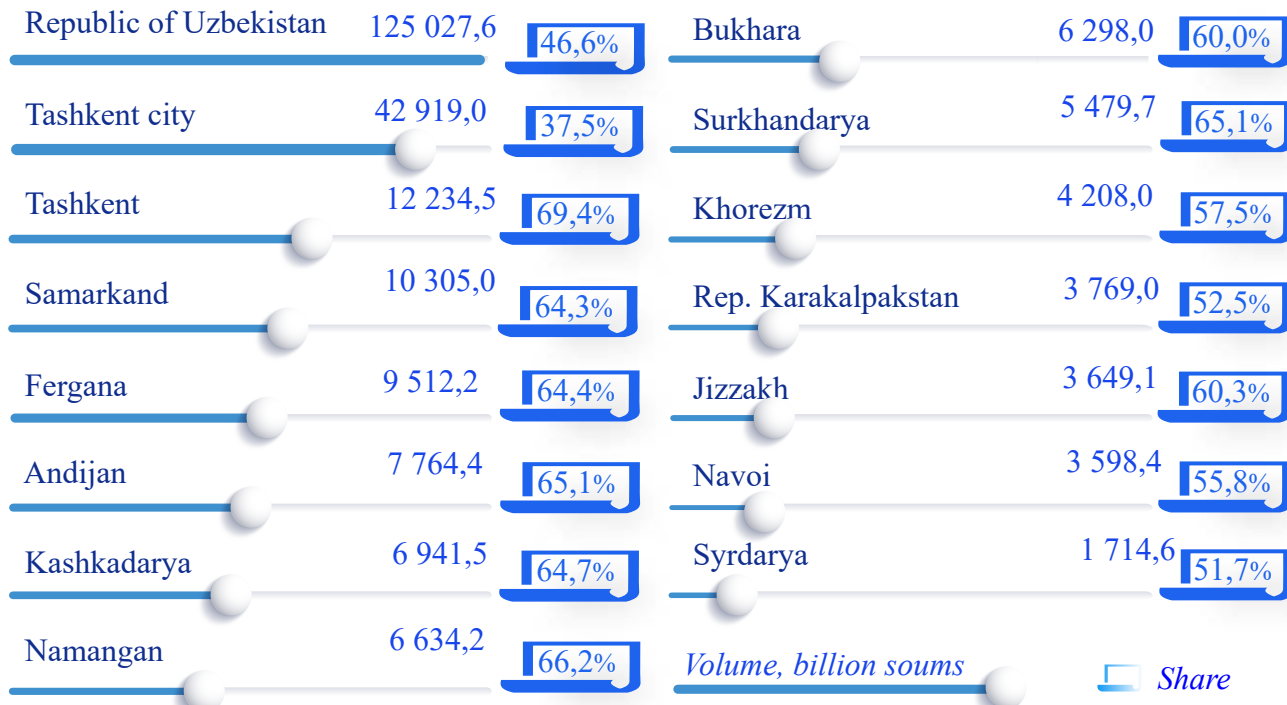

In January-June 2024, the volume of services produced (rendered) by small businesses amounted to **125 027.6** billion soums, or **46.6%** of their total volume. In regional terms, the largest share falls on Tashkent - **69.4%**, Namangan - **66.2%**, Andijan - **65.1%**, Surkhandarya - **65.1%**, Kashkadarya - **64.7%** and Fergana - **64.4%** regions.

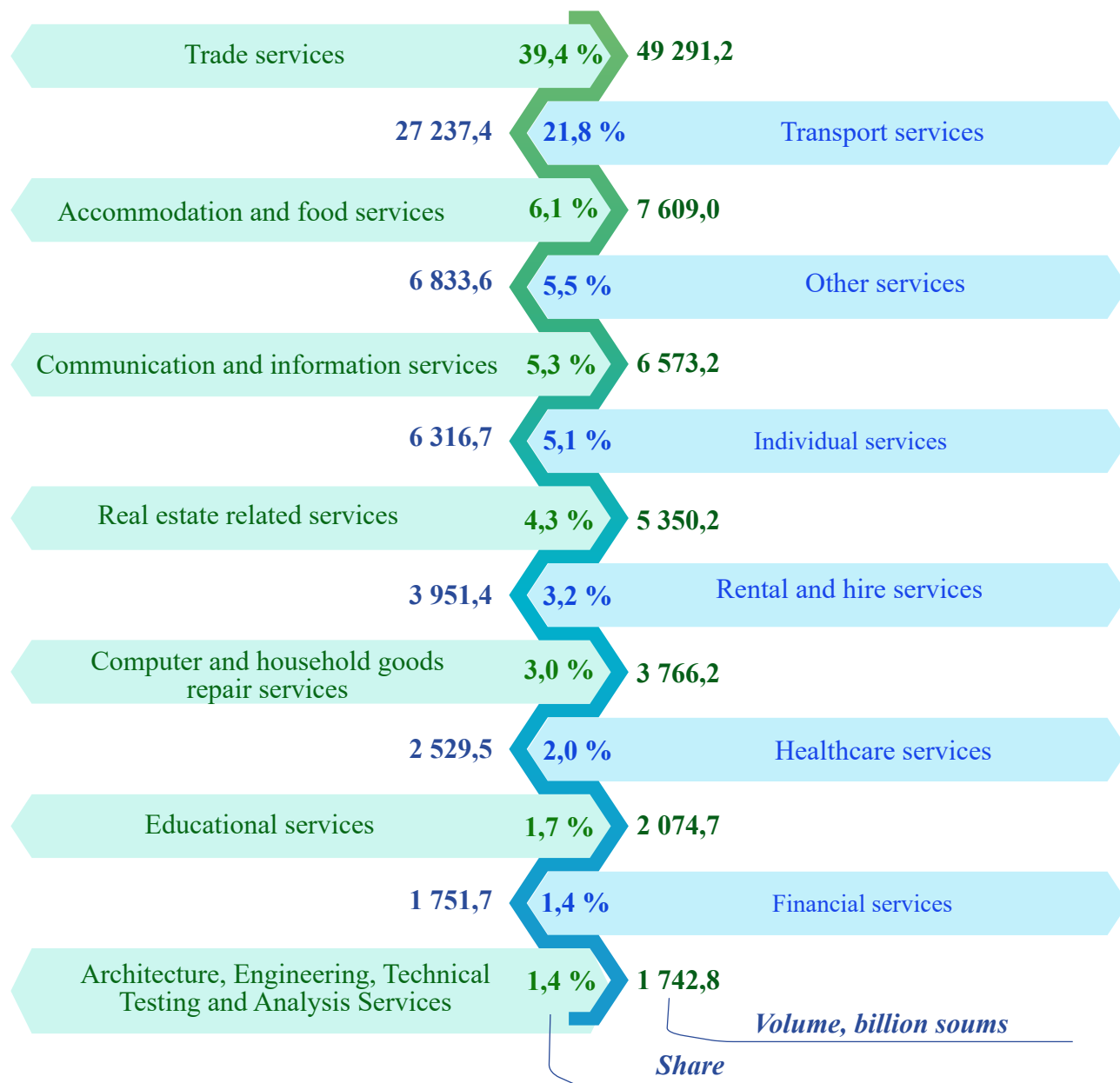
**Volume and share of services produced (rendered)

In regional terms, the largest volume of services was recorded in Tashkent city (**42 919.0** billion soums), Tashkent (**12 234.5** billion soums), Samarkand (**10 305.0** billion soums), Fergana (**9 512.2** billion soums), Andijan (**7 764.4** billion soums), Kashkadarya (**6 941.5** billion soums), Namangan (**6 634.2** billion soums), Bukhara (**6 298.0** billion soums), Surkhandarya (**5 479.7** billion soums), Khorezm (**4 208.0** billion soums) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**3 769.0** billion soums).

for January-June 2024

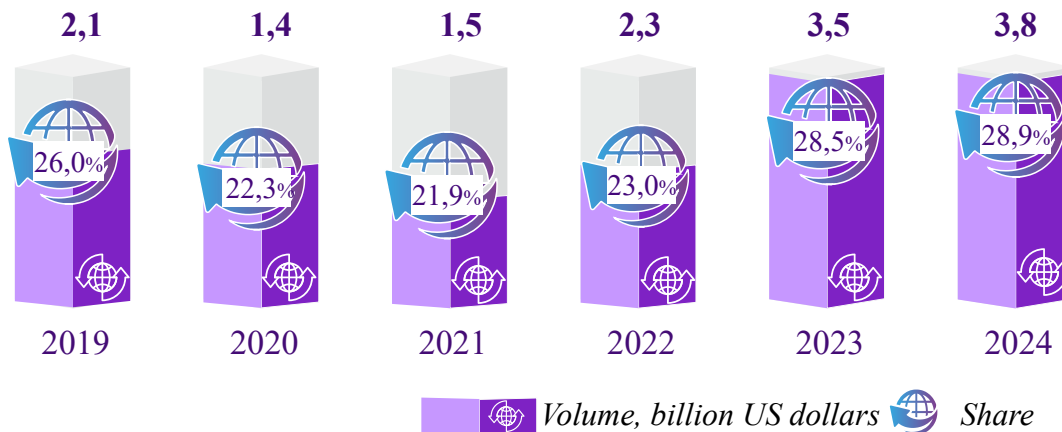


According to the diagram above, the largest share of small business entities in the service sector falls on trade services - **39.4%** (49 291.2 billion soums), transport services - **21.8%** (27 237.4 billion soums), accommodation and food services - **6.1%** (7 609.0 billion soums), other services - **5.5%** (6 833.6 billion soums).

Individual entrepreneurship is the implementation of entrepreneurial activity by an individual without forming a legal entity.

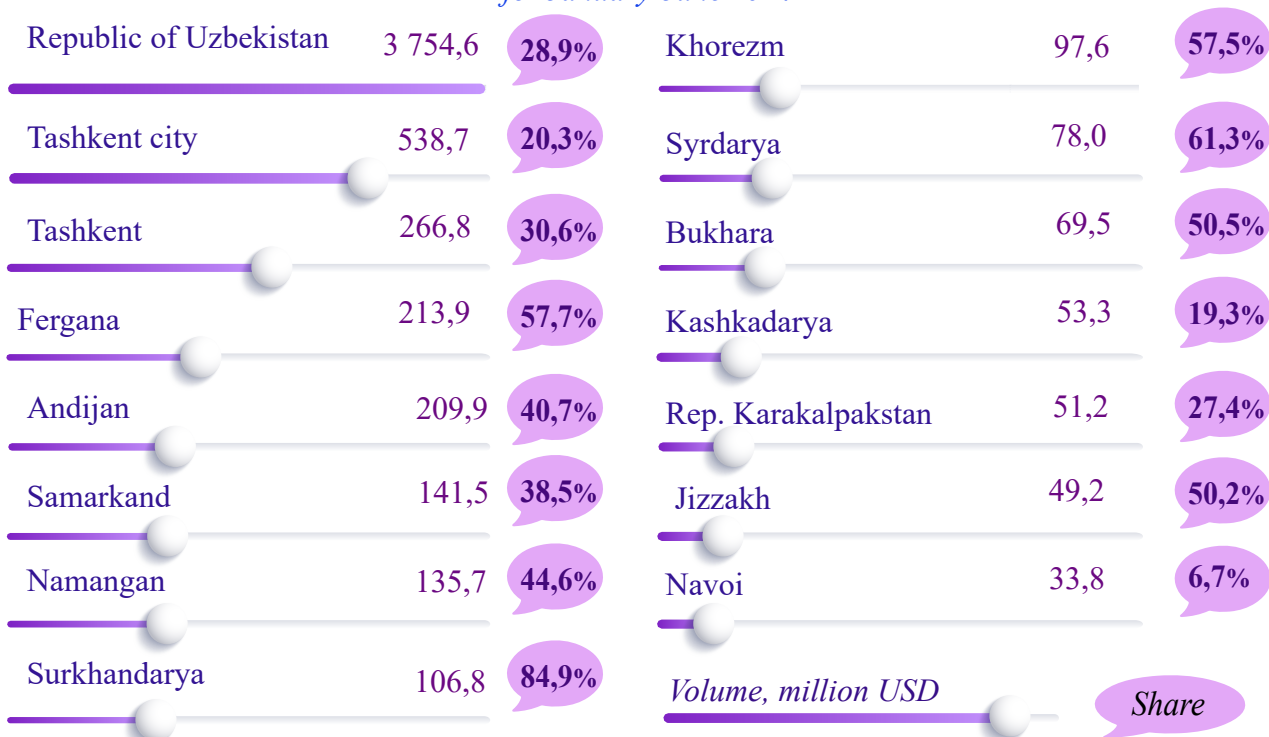
Individual entrepreneurship is carried out by an individual entrepreneur independently, on the basis of property belonging to him by right of ownership, as well as by virtue of another property right that allows for the possession and (or) use of property.

Dynamics of changes in the volume and share of exports of products (works, services) of small business entities for January-June 2019-2024



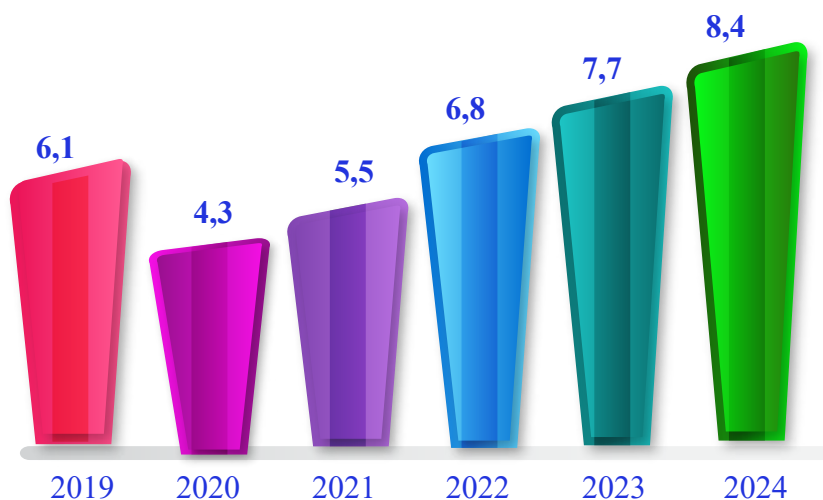
In January-June 2024, the volume of exports of products (works, services) of small businesses amounted to **3.8 billion US dollars**, or **28.9%** of its total volume.

In January-June 2024, in the regional context, the largest small business export of products (works, services) was noted in Surkhandarya (**84.9%**), Syrdarya (**61.3%**), Fergana (**57.7%**), Khorezm (**57.5%**), Bukhara (**50.5%**) and Jizzakh (**50.2%**) regions.

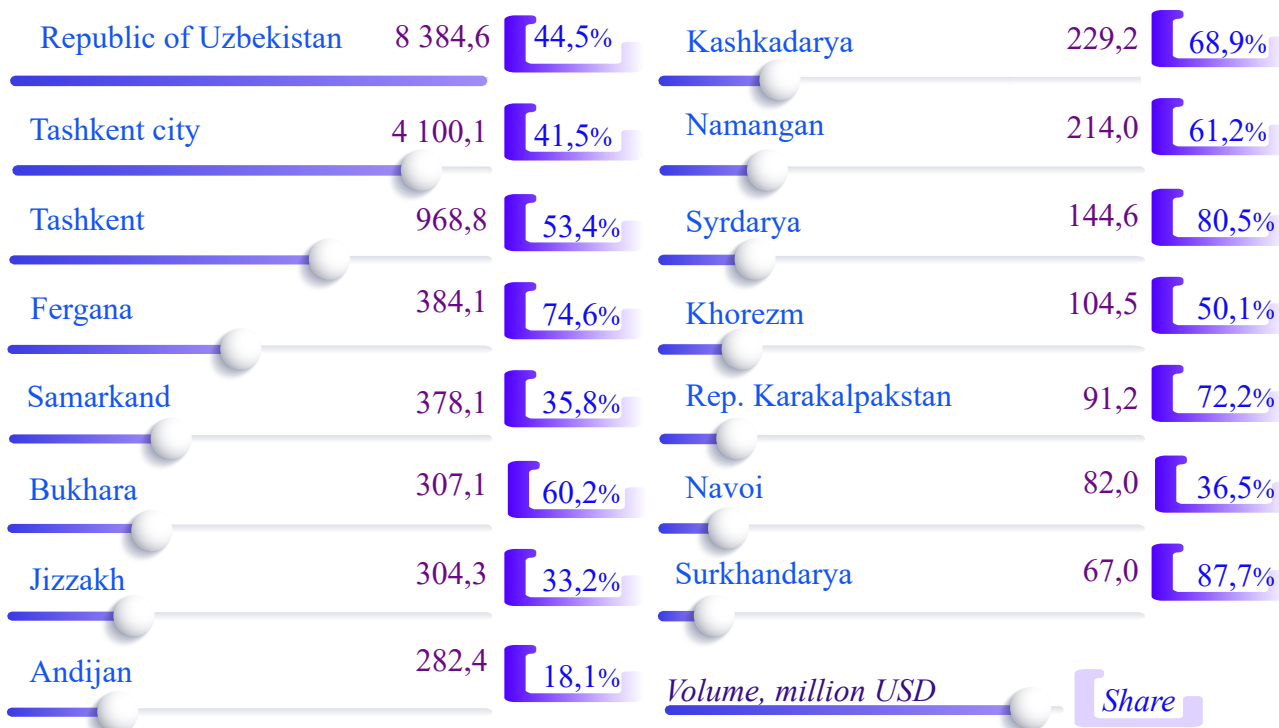
Dynamics of changes in the volume of imports of products (works, services) of small business entities, billion US dollars for January-June 2019-2024



For January-June 2024, the volume of imports of products (works, services) of small businesses amounted to **8 384.6** million US dollars, or **44.5%** of its total volume.

In regional terms, the largest share of small businesses in the import of products (works, services) falls on the Surkhandarya (**87.7%**), Syrdarya (**80.5%**), Fergana (**74.6%**) regions, Republic of Karakalpakstan (**72.2%**), Kashkadarya (**68.9%**), Namangan (**61.2%**) and Bukhara (**60.2%**) regions.

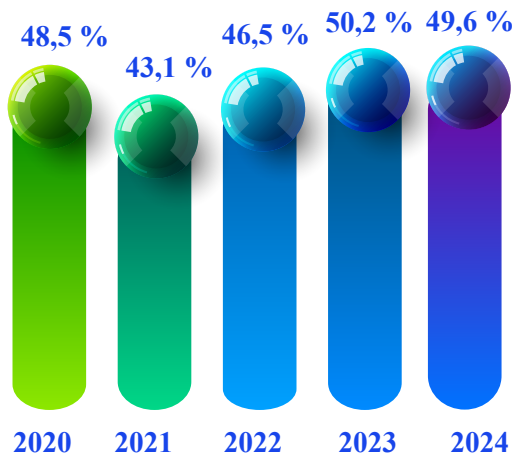
Volume and share of imports of products (works, services) of small business entities by region for January-June 2024

Dynamics of changes in the main indicators of small business entities in transport services for January-June 2020-2024

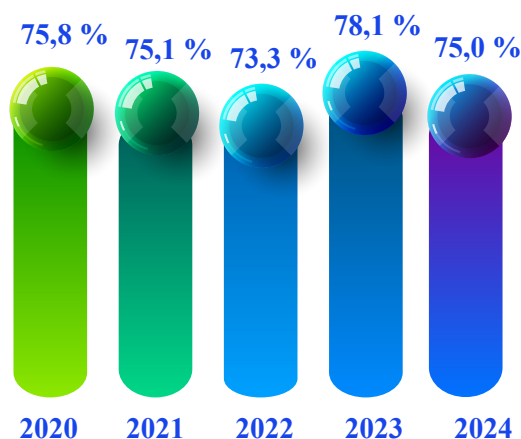
The share of small business entities in the total volume of cargo transportation



In the period under review in 2024, the share of small businesses in the total volume of cargo turnover was **75.0%**. For January-June 2023, its growth rate was **105.2%**.

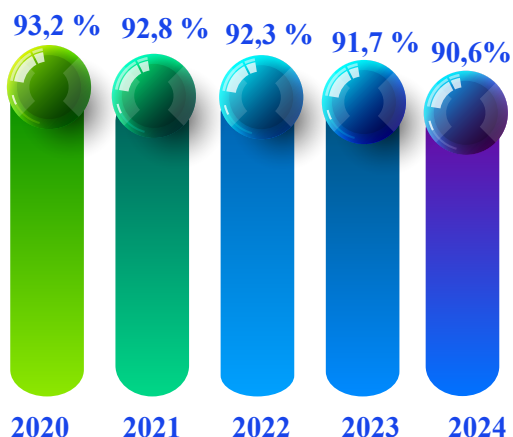
In January-June 2024, the share of small businesses in the total volume of freight transportation amounted to **49.6%**. For the same period in 2023, its growth rate was **104.8%**.

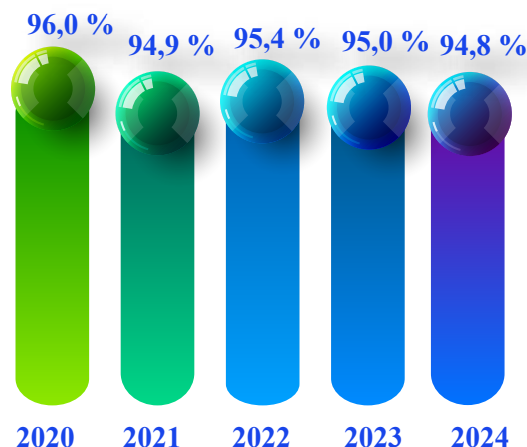
The share of small business entities in the total volume of passenger transportation

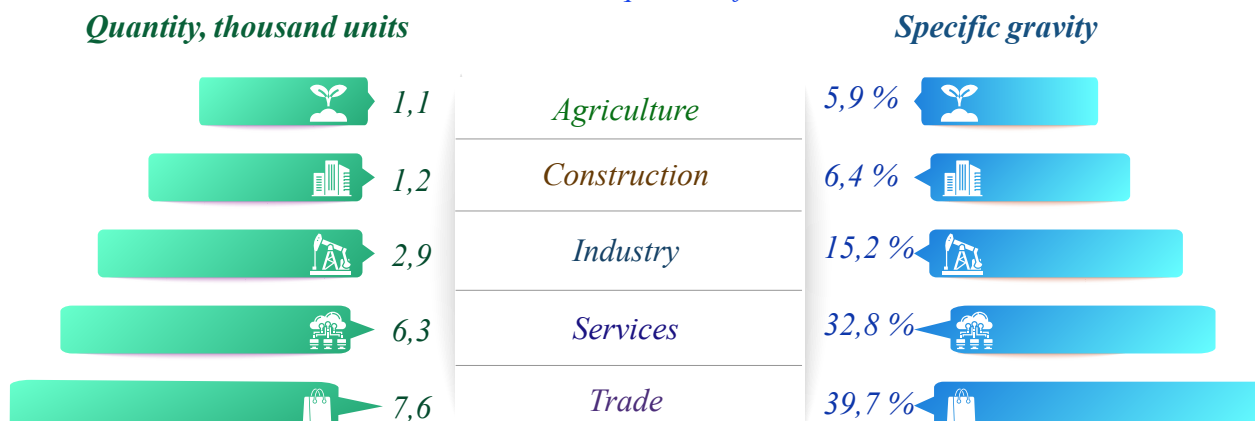

RESULTS OF THE SAMPLE SURVEY OF SMALL ENTERPRISES AND MICROFIRMS

Distribution of small enterprises and microfirms participating in the sample survey by types of economic activity in the second quarter of 2024

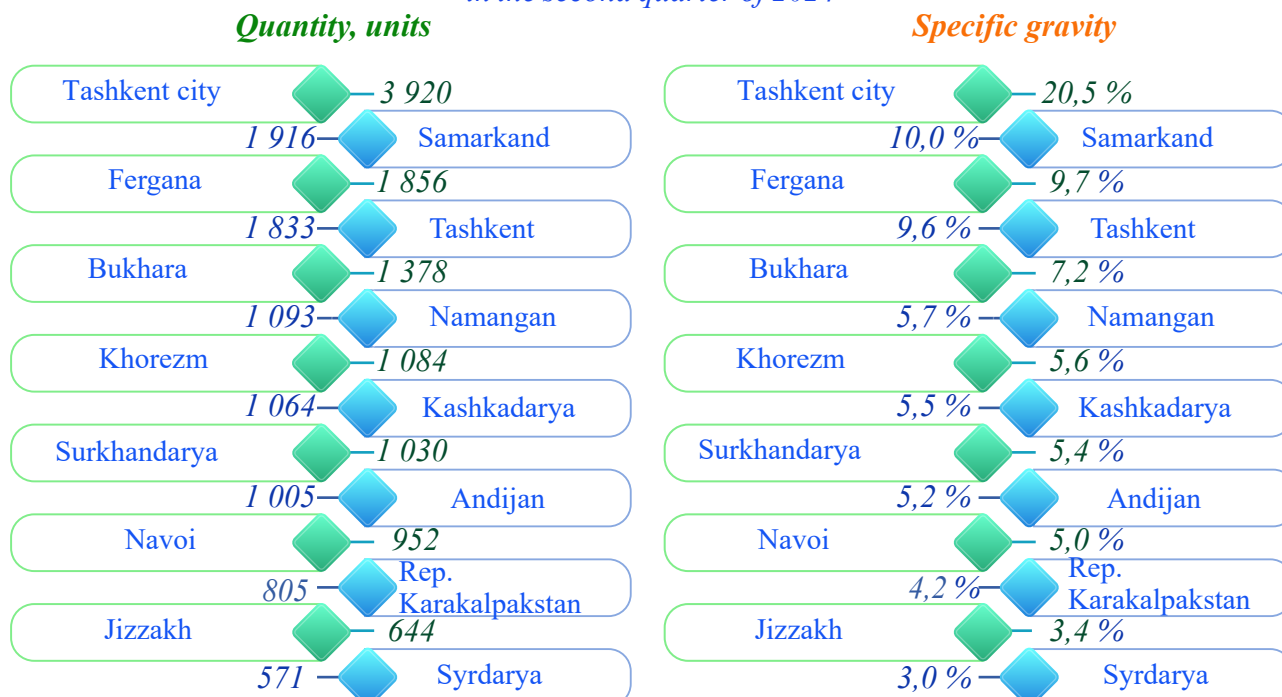


A sample survey of small businesses and microfirms was conducted in the second quarter of 2024.

In total, **19 151** small businesses and microfirms took part in the survey, of which **6 873 (35.9%)** entities assessed the economic situation as favorable, **11 027 (57.6%)** as satisfactory, and **1 251 (6.5%)** as unsatisfactory.

By type of economic activity, the share of small enterprises and microfirms participating in the sample survey was **39.7% (7 608 units)** in trade, **32.8% (6 280 units)** in services, **15.2% (2 916 units)** in industry, **6.4% (1 228 units)** in construction, and **5.9% (1 119 units)** in agriculture, forestry and fisheries.

Distribution of small enterprises and microfirms participating in the sample survey by region in the second quarter of 2024

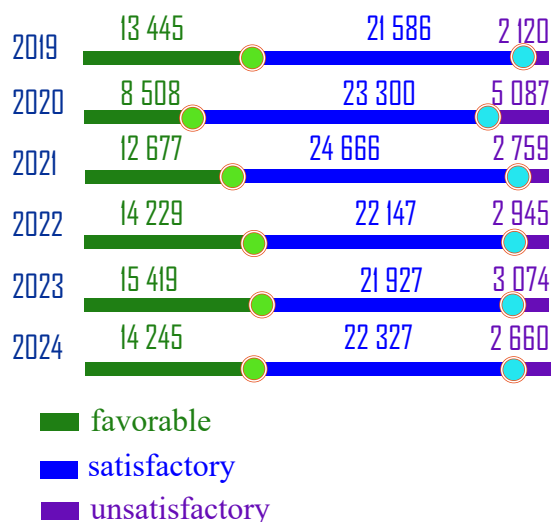


By region, the largest number of small enterprises and microfirms that participated in the sample survey was recorded in Tashkent city (**3 920 units**), Samarkand (**1 916 units**), Fergana (**1 856 units**) and Tashkent (**1 833 units**) regions.

Dynamics of the assessment of the economic situation (for the current period) of small enterprises and microfirms, units. *for January-June 2019-2024*

When analyzing the assessment of the general economic situation based on the results of a sample survey of the activities of small enterprises and microfirms, it should be noted that in January-June 2019, **13 445** enterprises assessed the current economic situation as favorable. In January-June 2024, this figure reached **14 245** units, which is **800** more than in 2019.

Also, the number of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as satisfactory in 2019 was **21 586** units, and in January-June 2024 this figure reached **22 327** units, or increased by **741** units.



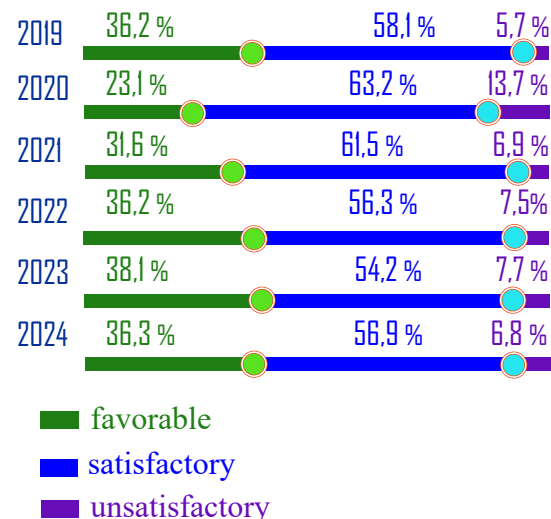
The number of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as unsatisfactory was **2 120** in 2019, and **2 660** in January-June 2024, which is **540** more.

Dynamics of the assessment of the economic situation (for the current period) of small enterprises and microfirms *for January-June 2019-2024*

An analysis of the assessment of the general economic situation based on the results of a sample survey of the activities of small businesses and microfirms showed that the share of enterprises that assessed the current economic situation as favorable in 2019 was **36.2%**. In the period under review in 2024, this indicator increased by **0.1** percentage points compared to 2019 and amounted to **36.3%**.

Also, the share of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as satisfactory in 2019 was **58.1%**.

In January-June 2024, this figure amounted to **56.9%**.



In turn, the share of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as unsatisfactory was **5.7%** in 2019. For January-June 2024, this figure increased by **1.1** percentage points and amounted to **6.8%**.

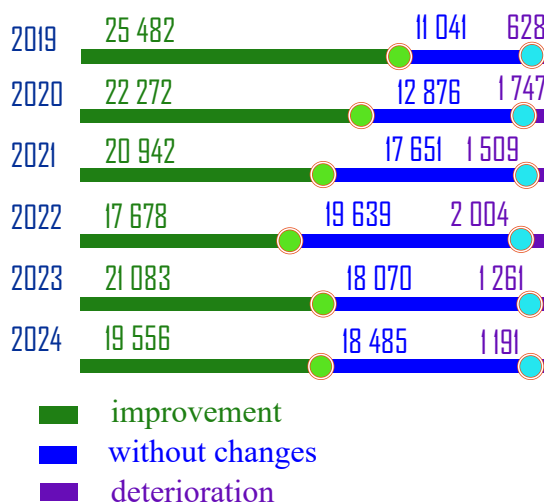
RESULTS OF THE SAMPLE SURVEY OF SMALL ENTERPRISES AND MICROFIRMS

Dynamics of assessment of the economic situation by small businesses and microfirms (prospects for changes in the next three months), units. *for January-June 2019-2024*

During the analysis of the assessment of the general economic situation by small enterprises and microfirms based on the results of a sample survey of their activities, it was found that the number of enterprises expecting an improvement in the economic situation in the next three months in 2019 was **25 482** units. In January-June 2024, this figure was **19 556** units.

It should also be said that the number of enterprises that do not expect any changes in the economic situation in 2019 was **11 041** units, for January-June 2024 - **18 485** units, which is, accordingly, **7 444** units more.

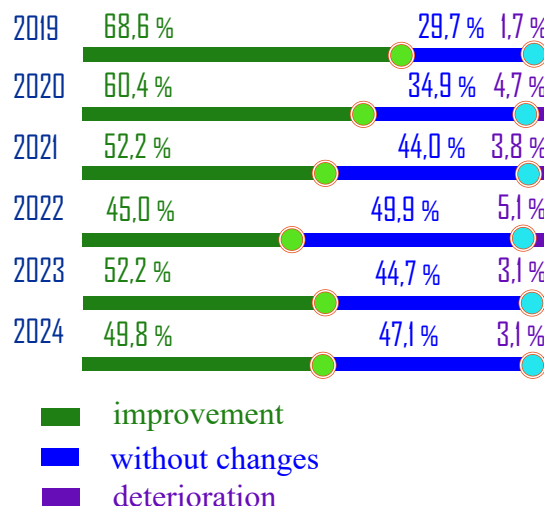
Along with this, the number of enterprises expecting a deterioration in the economic situation in 2019 was **628** units. For January-June 2024, this figure increased by **563** units and amounted to **1 191** units.



Dynamics of assessment of the economic situation by small businesses and microfirms (prospects for changes in the next three months) *for January-June 2019-2024*

During the analysis of the assessment of the general economic situation in small enterprises and microfirms based on the results of a sample survey of their activities, the share of enterprises expecting an improvement in the economic situation in the next three months was established. Thus, if in January-June 2019 it was **68.6%**, then in the period under review in 2024 this figure was **49.8%**.

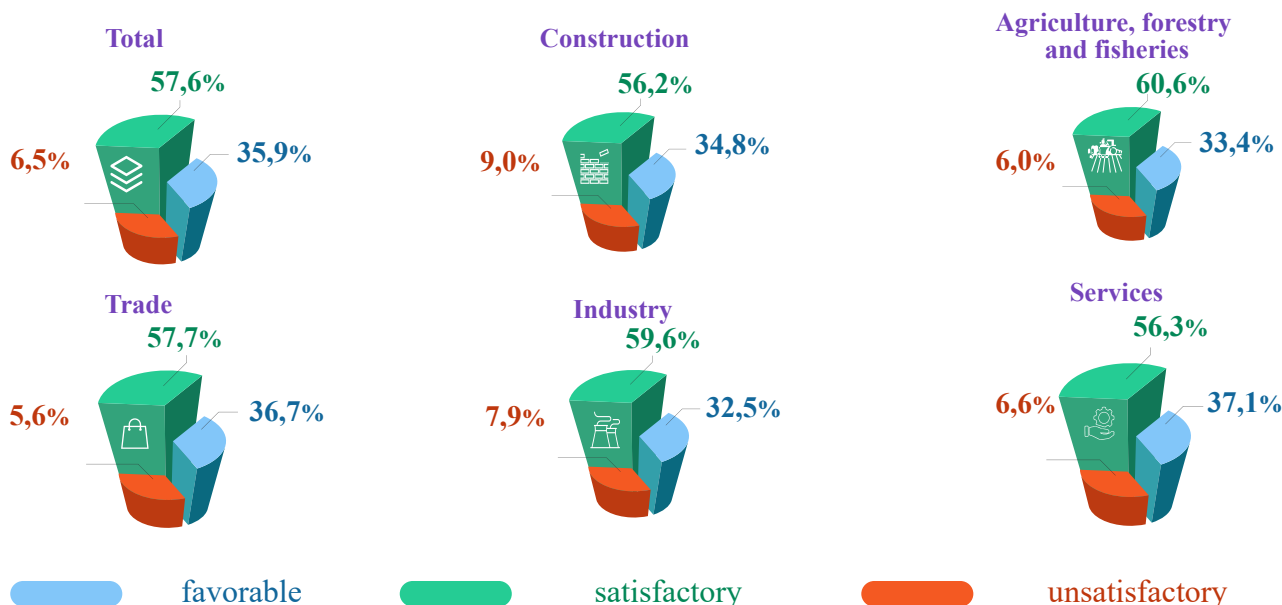
Also, the share of enterprises that do not expect any changes in the economic situation in January-June 2019 was **29.7%**, and in January-June 2024 their share increased by **17.4** percentage points and amounted to **47.1%**.



Meanwhile, the share of enterprises expecting a deterioration in the economic situation in January-June 2019 was **1.7%**. For January-June 2024, this figure increased by **1.4** percentage points and amounted to **3.1%**.

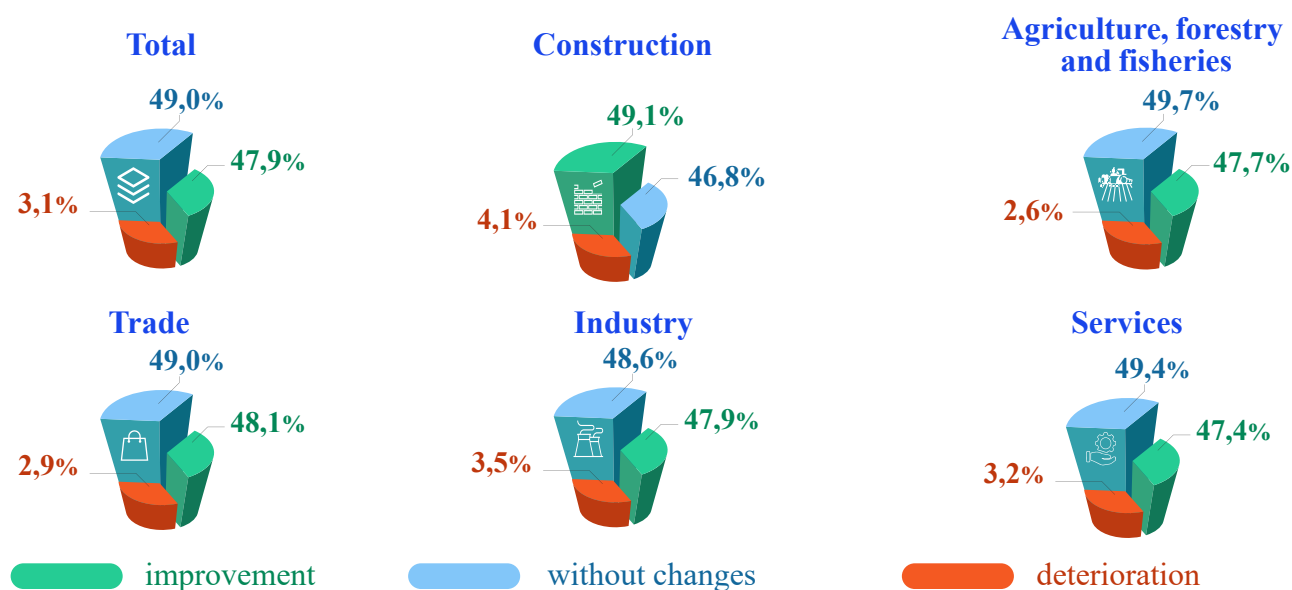
Assessment of the economic situation of small enterprises and microfirms by types of economic activity (for the current period) in the second quarter of 2024



According to the results of a survey conducted in the second quarter of 2024, it was found that the largest share of small businesses and microfirms that assessed the current economic situation as favorable were in the service sector - **37.1%**, trade - **36.7%**, construction - **34.8%**. The largest share of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as satisfactory was noted in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - **60.6%**, industry - **59.6%**, trade - **57.7%**.

A significant proportion of enterprises that assessed the economic situation as unsatisfactory were recorded in construction – **9.0%**, industry – **7.9%**, and also in the service sector – **6.6%**.

RESULTS OF THE SAMPLE SURVEY OF SMALL ENTERPRISES AND MICROFIRMS

In the second quarter of 2024, the largest share of small businesses and microfirms that noted an improvement in the prospects for changes in the economic situation over the next three months was: in construction - **49.1%**, trade - **48.1%**, industry - **47.9%**.

Also, the share of enterprises that do not expect any changes in the next three months was: in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - **49.7%**, in the service sector - **49.4%**, in trade - **49.0%**.

The share of enterprises that noted a deterioration in the prospects for changes in the next three months was: in construction – **4.1%**, industry – **3.5%**, and the service sector – **3.2%**.

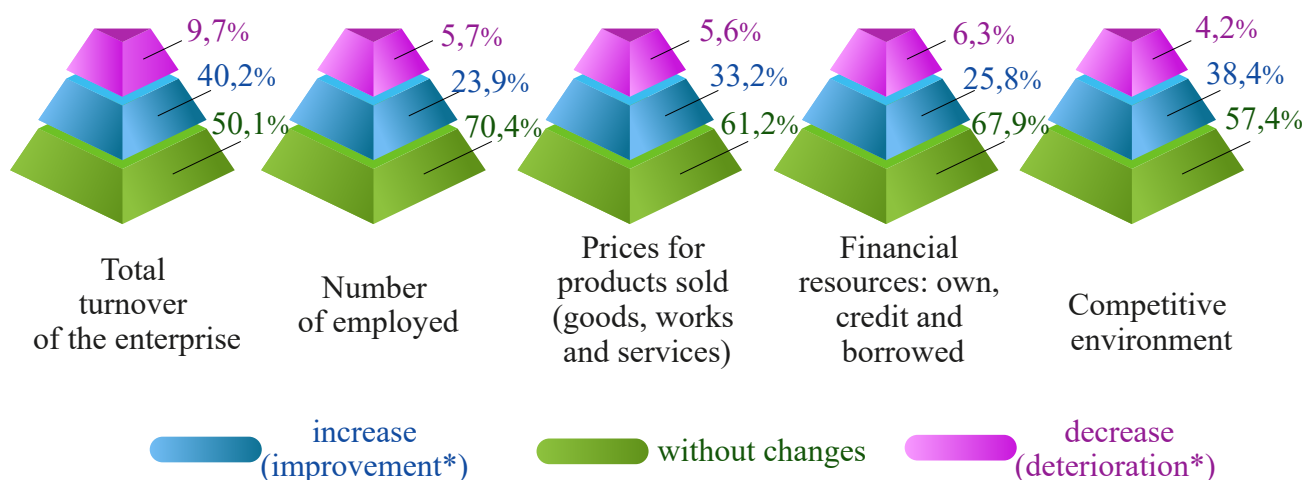

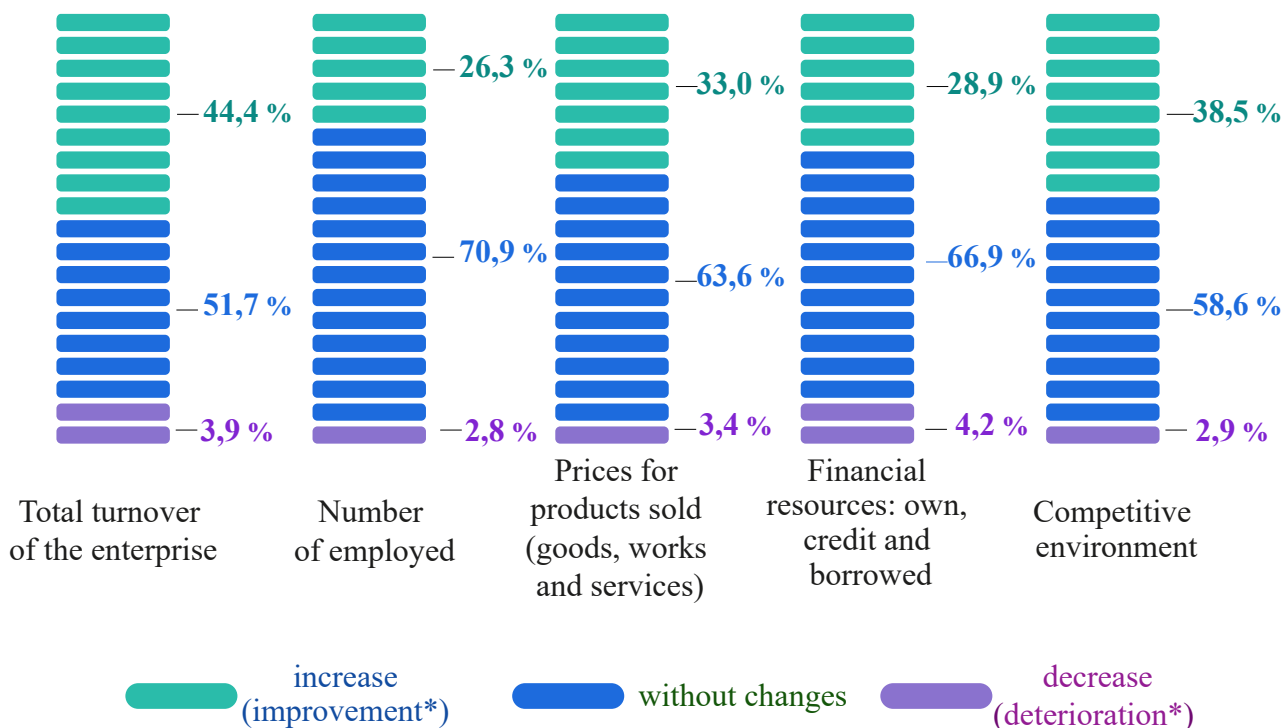
