## **RETAIL AND WHOLESALE TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN**

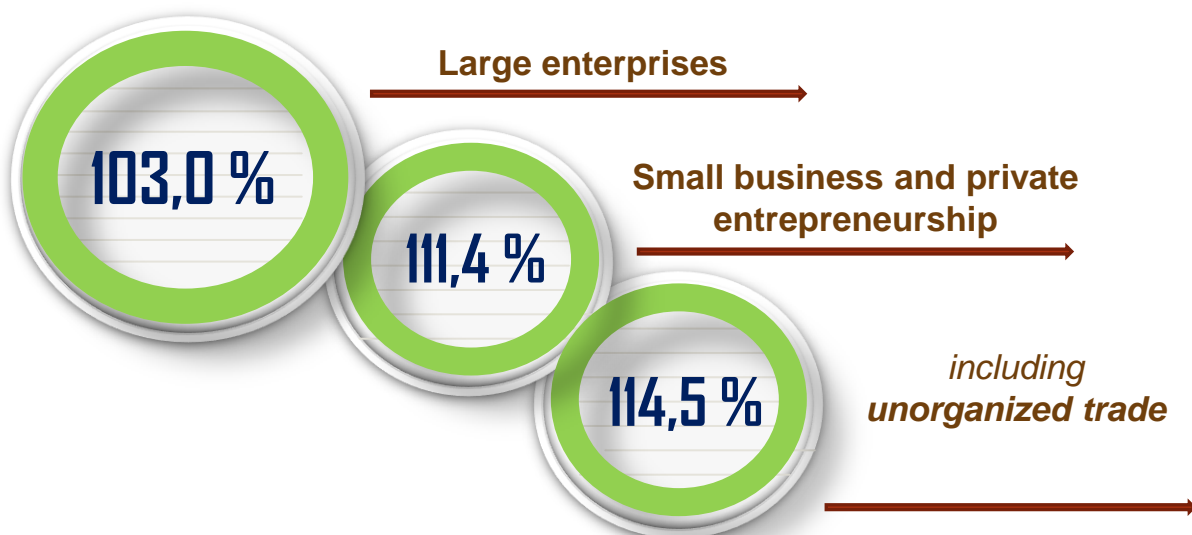

**Statistical data** - the most important tool for describing and managing socio-economic phenomena and processes occurring in society. At present, it is impossible to make informed management decisions in the sphere of public policy without using high-quality statistical data. Among them, the formation of trade statistics is of great importance. In particular, this includes the indicator of statistics of the turnover of wholesale, retail and catering enterprises.

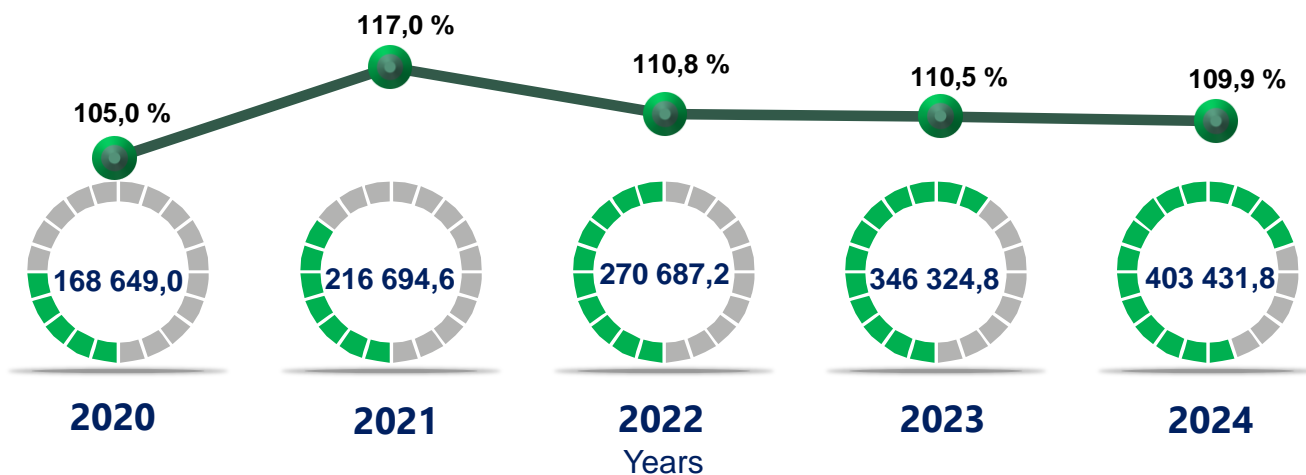
## Growth rate of main indicators of retail turnover (for January-December)



As of January 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the retail trade sector reached 80 118 units, of which the number of operating large enterprises amounted to 319 units, and small enterprises and microfirms – 79 799. In particular, the retail trade indicators include data collected on the basis of observations of organized and unorganized trade among individuals operating in the trade sector without forming a legal entity.

**Retail turnover** - the cost of goods sold to the population for personal, family, household and other similar use not related to entrepreneurial activity.

## Dynamics of growth rate and turnover in retail trade (for January-December, in billion soums)



Over the past five years (2020–2024), high growth rates in retail turnover were noted in 2021, and this figure amounted to 117.0 %.

## Retail growth rate by month (for 2023-2024, in %)



In January-December 2024, the growth rate of retail turnover was 109.9 %.

Retail trade turnover for January-December 2024 reached 403 431.8 billion soums and increased by 109.9 % compared to the same period in 2023. The turnover of large enterprises amounted to 64 629.2 billion soums (growth rate - 103.0 %), and small businesses and private entrepreneurship – 338 802.6 billion soums (growth rate - 111.4 %), including unorganized trade amounted to 37 932.8 billion soums (growth rate - 114.5 %).

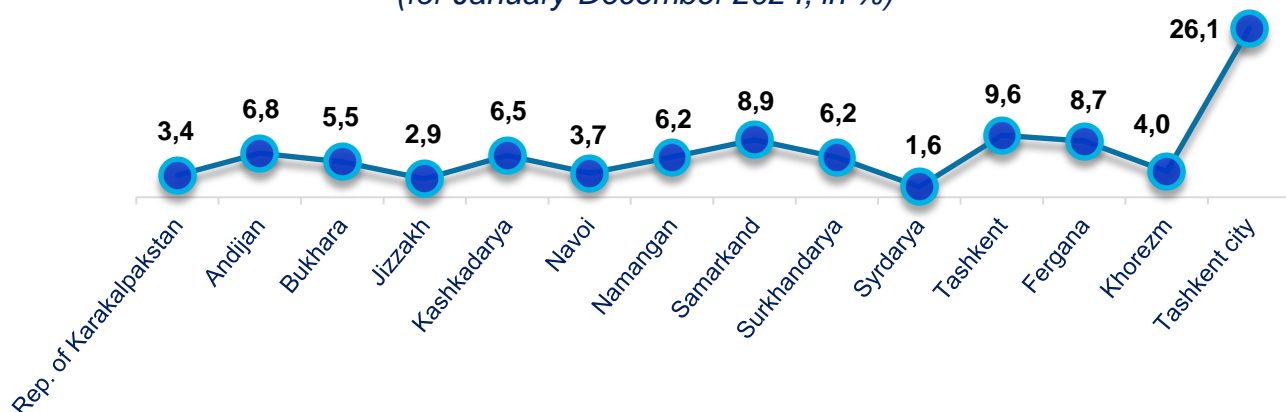

Compared with January-December 2023, significant growth rates in the period under review were noted in Tashkent region (111.9 %), Tashkent city (110.9 %) and Namangan region (110.0 %), where an increase in the growth rate of retail trade was observed.

### Volume and share of retail turnover by territory

In the structure of retail trade turnover, a significant share in January-December 2024 was noted in Tashkent, which amounted to 26.1 %, or 105 341.3 billion soums.

The smallest share was recorded at 1.6 %, or 6 495.4 billion soums, which was observed in the Syrdarya region.

Compared with the corresponding period in 2023, during the period under review, all regions saw an increase in growth rates in retail trade.



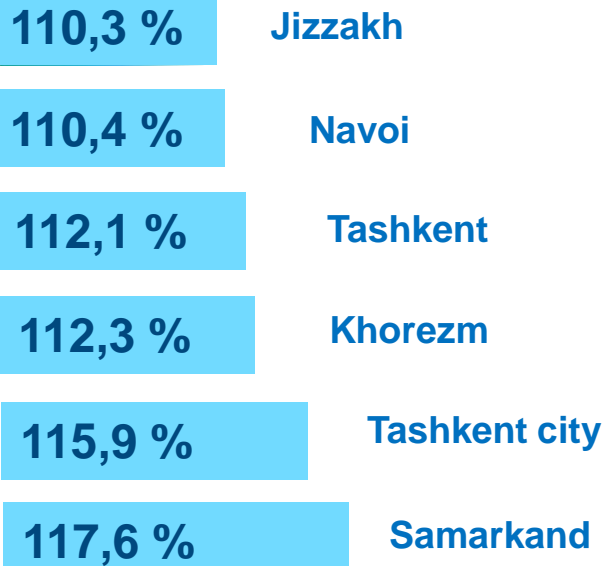

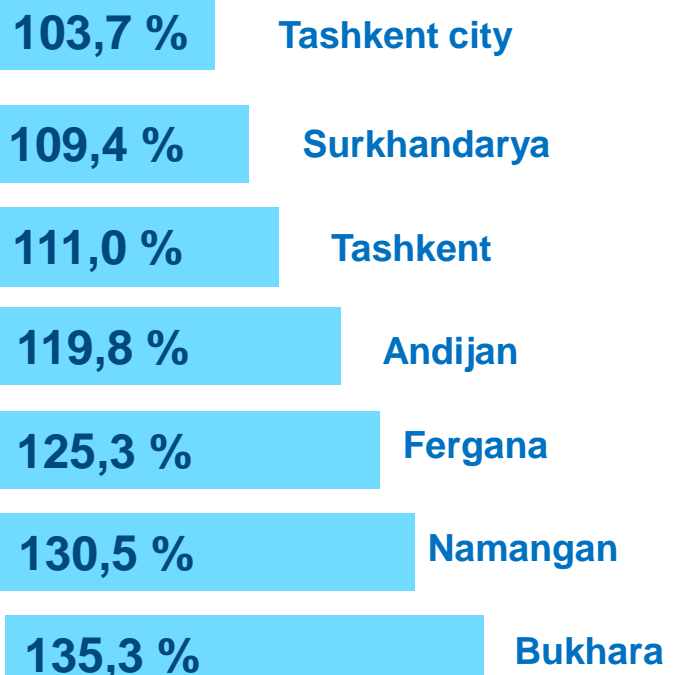
## Regions with the highest growth rates of small business and private entrepreneurship

The retail trade turnover of small businesses and private entrepreneurship, according to statistical calculations, in January-December 2024 amounted to 338 802.6 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 11.4 %. The share of this sector in the republic in the retail trade turnover reached 84.0 %.

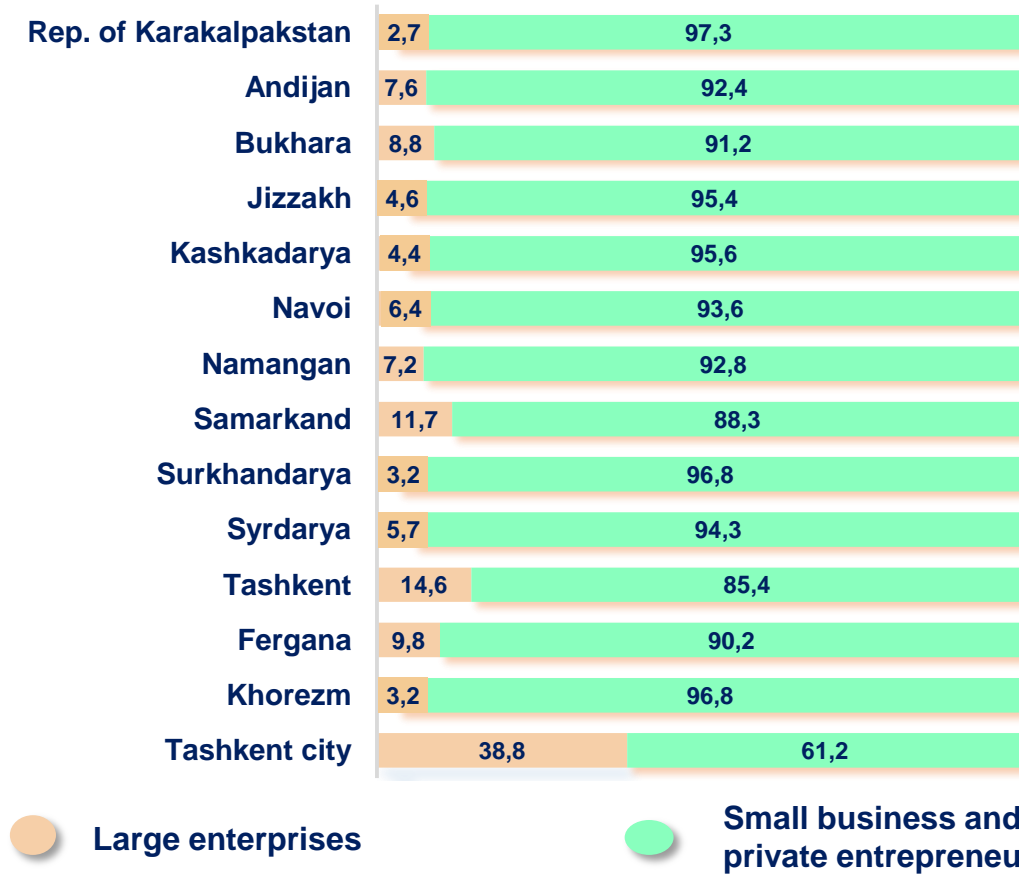


## Regions with the highest growth rates of large enterprises

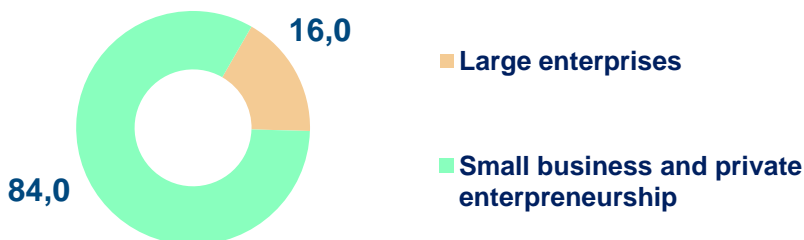
In the structure of retail trade turnover, the volume of trade turnover of large enterprises in January-December 2024, compared with the corresponding period of 2023, increased by 3.0 % and reached 64 629.2 billion soums, which amounted to 16.0 % of its total volume.



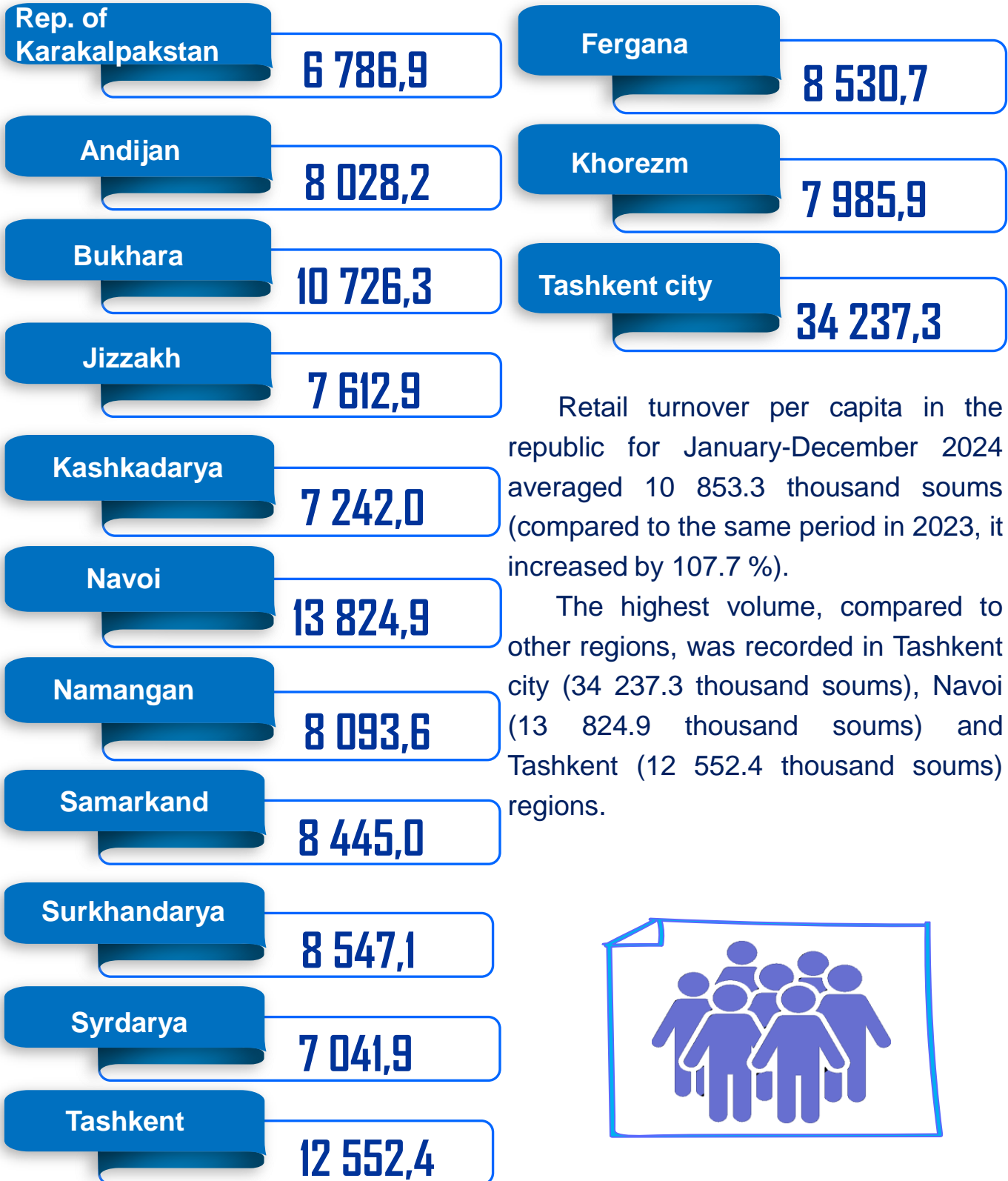
## SHARE OF LARGE ENTERPRISES, SMALL BUSINESSES AND PRIVATE ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN RETAIL TRADE TURNOVER (in %)



The share of small businesses and private entrepreneurship, compared to other regions, in January-December 2024 was the highest in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (97.3 %), Surkhandarya (96.8 %) and Khorezm (96.8 %) regions. In the structure of retail trade turnover, the share of large enterprises' turnover amounted to 16.0% of total sales, their main share was observed in Tashkent city (38.8 %), Tashkent (14.6 %), Samarkand (11.7 %) and Fergana (9.8 %) regions.



## VOLUME PER CAPITA IN RETAIL TRADE TURNOVER (information by region, in thousands of soums)



Retail turnover per capita in the republic for January-December 2024 averaged 10 853.3 thousand soums (compared to the same period in 2023, it increased by 107.7 %).

The highest volume, compared to other regions, was recorded in Tashkent city (34 237.3 thousand soums), Navoi (13 824.9 thousand soums) and Tashkent (12 552.4 thousand soums) regions.

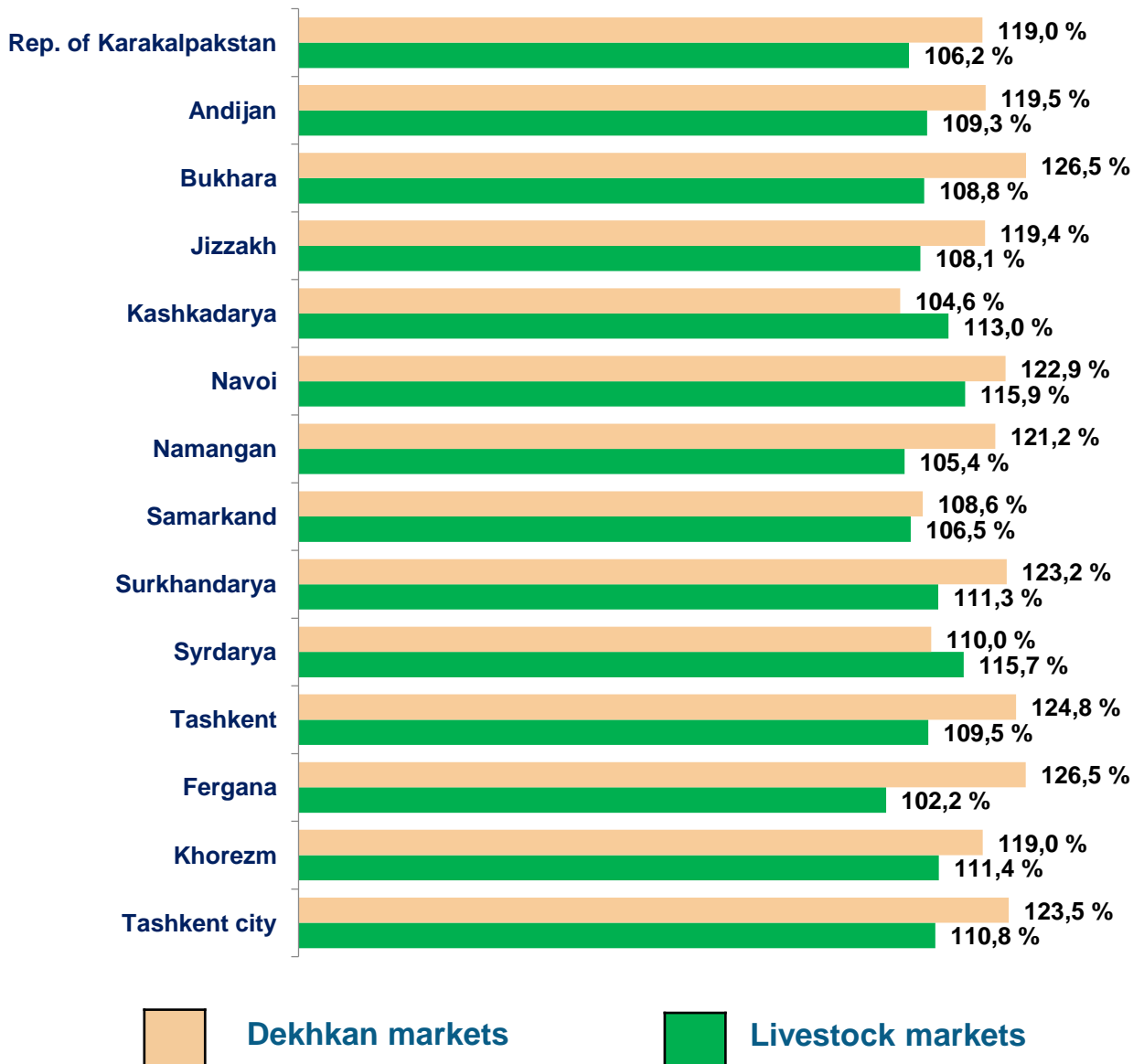




**Unorganized trade turnover** - also taken into account when forming indicators of domestic trade. This includes the volume of sales made by individuals at the dekhkan (food) market, as well as at the livestock, poultry and other animal markets. Unorganized trade includes agricultural products grown by individuals (farmers) on their own farms.

**A dekhkan (food) market** - a property complex operating on a permanent or temporary basis in places intended to create the necessary conditions for the retail sale and purchase of a wide range of agricultural food products and processed products using shopping arcades, trading places and stationary retail outlets (including retail pavilions).

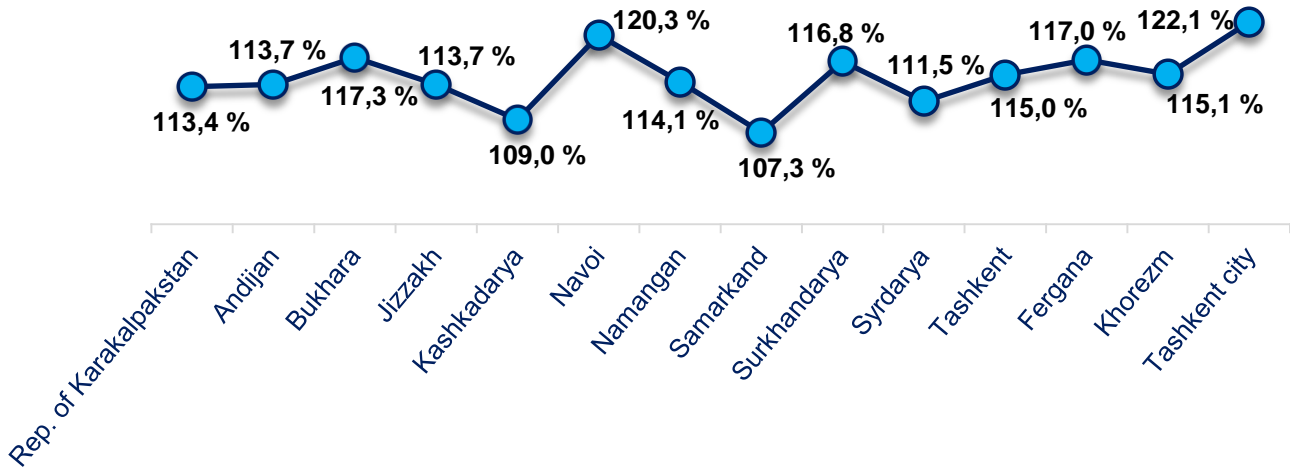

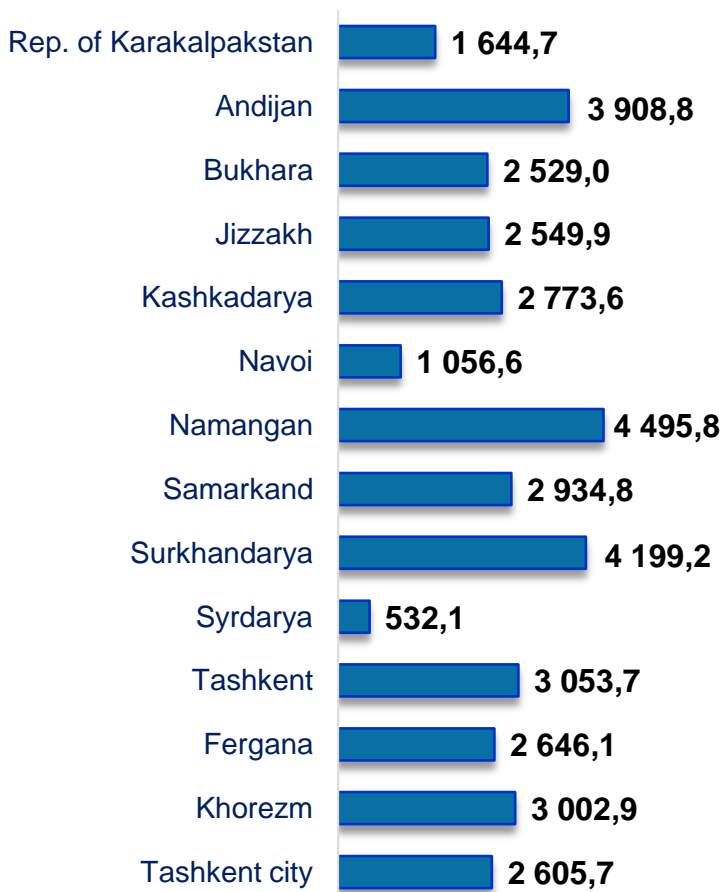

## Volume of unorganized trade turnover by region (for January-December 2024, in billion soums)



According to preliminary data from a survey of individuals, the turnover of unorganized trade for January-December 2024 amounted to 37 932.8 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2023, it increased by 114.5 %. Including the turnover of trade in dehqan markets amounted to 20 160.8 billion soums (an increase of 120.0 %), the turnover of trade in livestock markets was recorded at 17 772.0 billion soums (a decrease of 108.9 %).

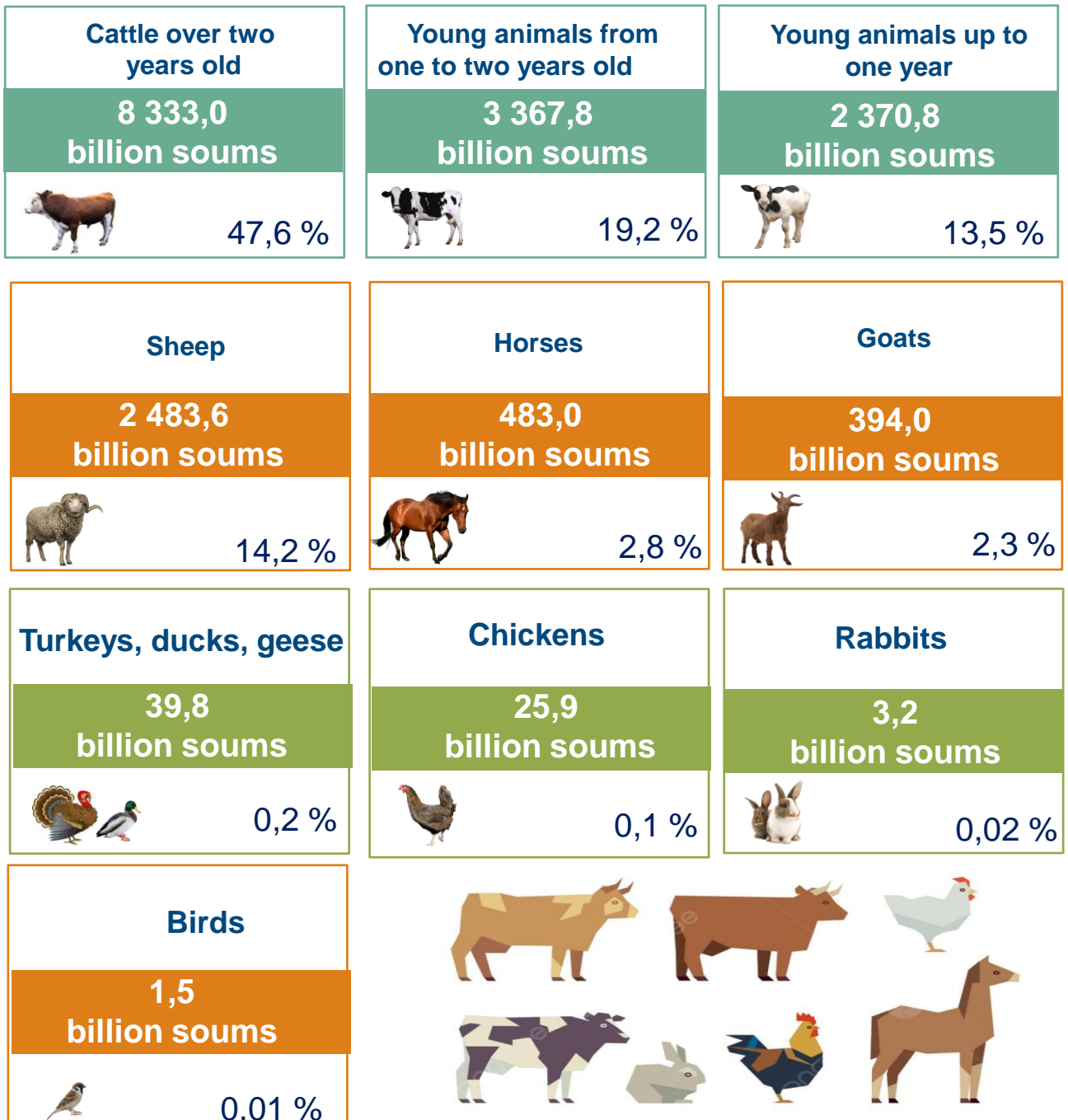
In January-December 2024, a survey of individuals engaged in the sale of agricultural products (grown in private farms) was conducted in all regions of the republic, according to the results of which the turnover of this type of trade amounted to 20 160.8 billion soums. High sales of fresh agricultural products reached 9 615.9 billion soums.

In January-December 2024, a survey of individuals engaged in the sale of poultry and livestock (kept in private farms) was conducted in all regions of the republic, according to the results of which the turnover of this type of trade amounted to 17 772.0 billion soums. The sale of livestock of different ages reached 14 072.4 billion soums, sheep and goats – 2 877.6 billion soums, horses - 483.0 billion soums, birds - 70.4 billion soums.

## TURNOVER OF FOOD ENTERPRISES

As of January 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the public catering sector amounted to 22 983 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises amounted to 80 units, and the number of small enterprises and microfirms reached 22 903.

In January-December 2024, the turnover of public catering enterprises amounted to 182 929.5 billion soums and increased, compared to the same period in 2023, by 110.5 %, of which 86.6 % of the trade turnover is accounted for by small businesses.

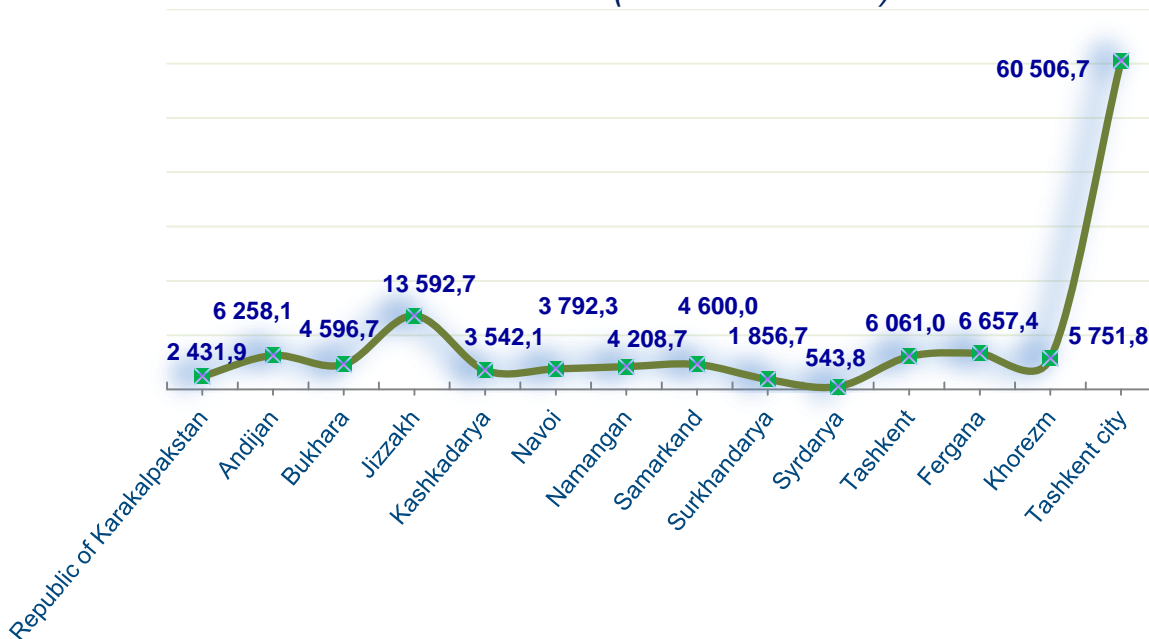

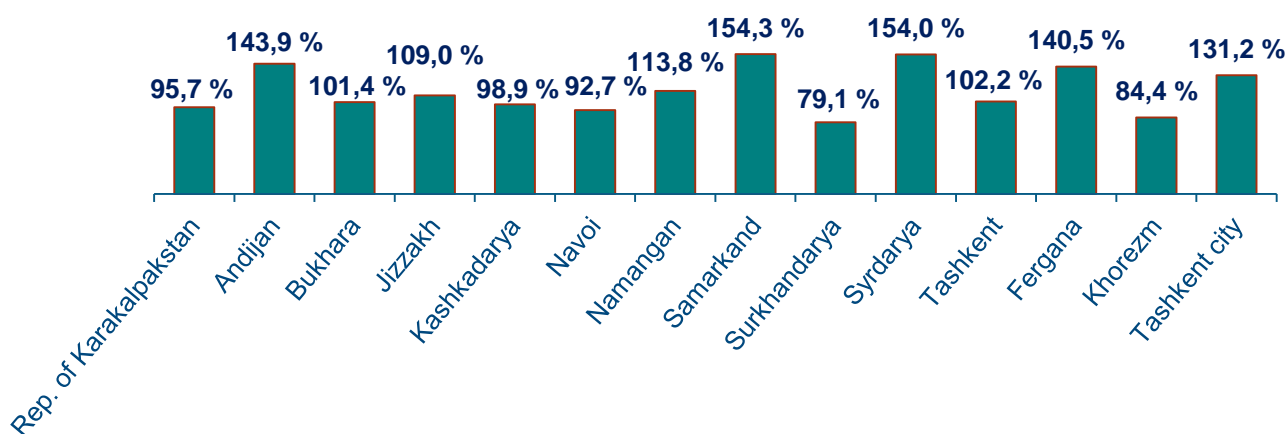
The highest volumes, compared to other regions, were recorded in Tashkent city (60 506.7 billion soums), Jizzakh (13 592.7 billion soums) and Fergana (6 657.4 billion soums) regions.

### Turnover of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories (in billion soums)



The turnover of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories (except for maintenance and repair of motor vehicles) for January-November 2024 amounted to 124 399.9 billion soums and increased by 18.8 % compared to the same period in 2023. The turnover of large enterprises amounted to 49 887.5 billion soums (growth rate - 128.8 %), and small businesses and private entrepreneurship – 74 512.4 billion soums (growth rate - 112.9 %).

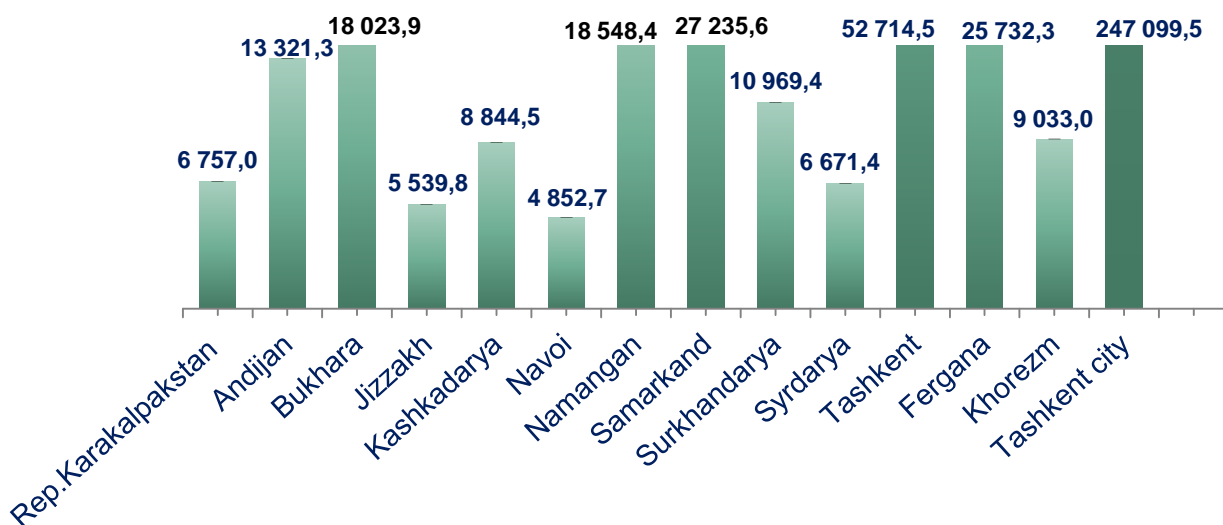
### Growth rate of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories





**Wholesale turnover** - the cost of goods purchased from outside for the purpose of resale and actually shipped without modification to third-party organizations and individual entrepreneurs for use in business activities or for their own use (processing), regardless of whether payment has been made for these goods or not.

## Wholesale turnover in the republic *(in billion soums)*



According to preliminary data, in January-December 2024, the volume of wholesale trade turnover reached 455 343.2 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 11.4 %.

## Share and volume of trade turnover



The turnover of wholesale trade of small business entities, according to statistical calculations, amounted to 345 952.9 billion soums and, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, increased by 112.1 %. The share of this sector in the turnover of wholesale trade in the republic amounted to 76.0 %.

As of January 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the wholesale trade sector amounted to 44 661 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises was 345, small enterprises and microfirms – 44 316.

In January-December 2024, the highest growth rates of wholesale turnover of large enterprises, compared to the same period in 2023, were observed in the Jizzakh region (2.4 t), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (170.4 %), Samarkand (131.0 %) and Tashkent (121.1 %) regions.
