## RETAIL AND WHOLESALE TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

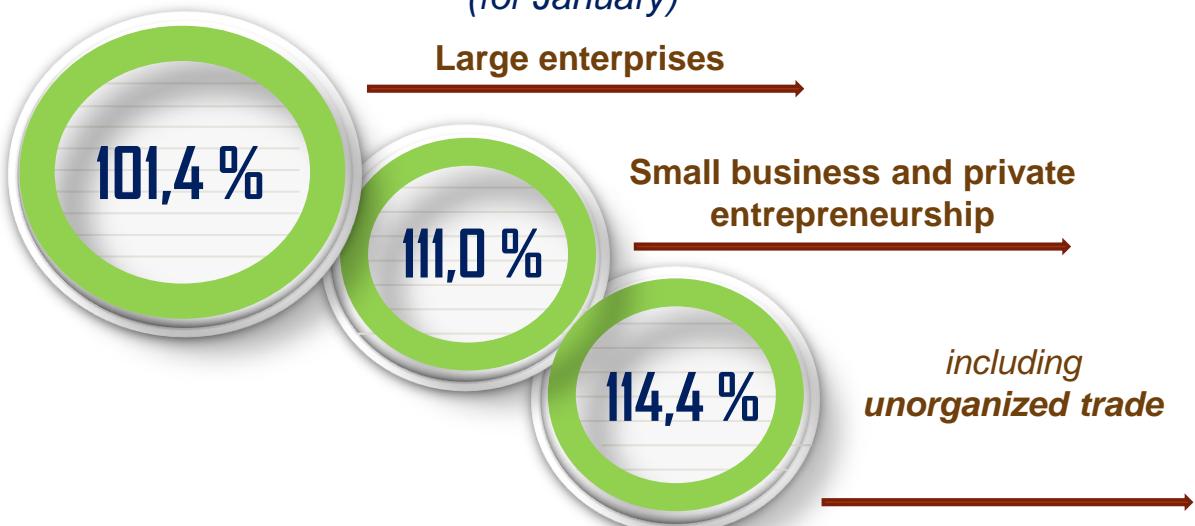

**Statistical data** - the most important tool for describing and managing socio-economic phenomena and processes occurring in society. At present, it is impossible to make informed management decisions in the sphere of public policy without using high-quality statistical data. Among them, the formation of trade statistics is of great importance. In particular, this includes the indicator of statistics of the turnover of wholesale, retail and catering enterprises.

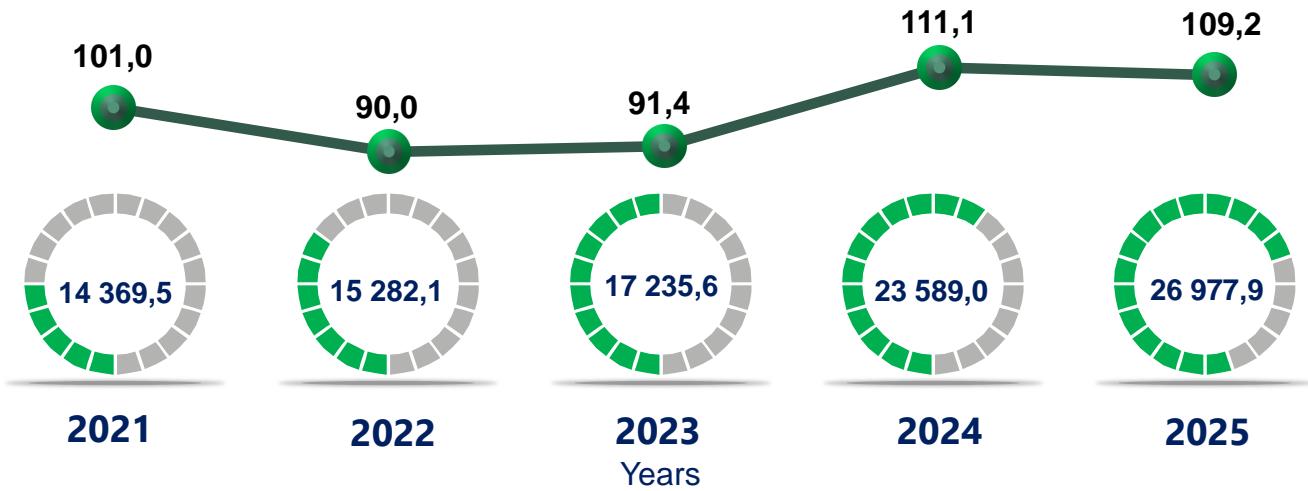
**Growth rate of main indicators  
of retail turnover  
(for January)**



As of February 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the retail trade sector reached 81 033 units, of which the number of operating large enterprises amounted to 324 units, and small enterprises and micro firms – 80 709. In particular, the retail trade indicators include data collected on the basis of observations of organized and unorganized trade among individuals operating in the trade sector without forming a legal entity.

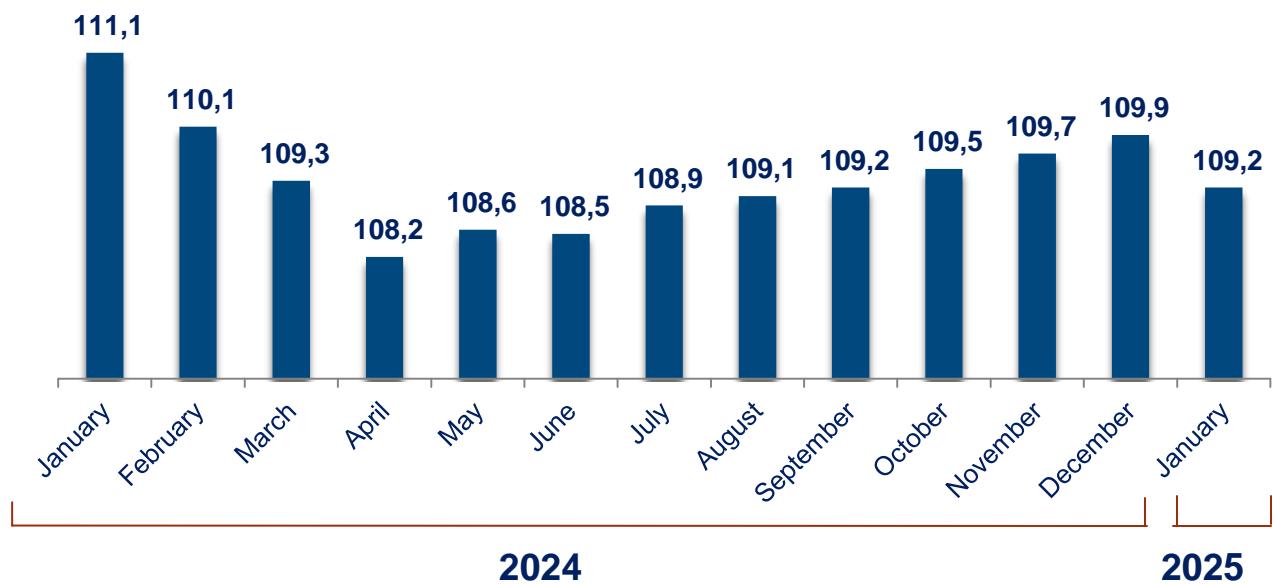
**Retail turnover** - the cost of goods sold to the population for personal, family, household and other similar use not related to entrepreneurial activity.

## Dynamics of growth rate and turnover in retail trade (for January, in billion soums)



Over the past five years (2021–2025), high growth rates in retail turnover were recorded in 2024, and this figure amounted to 111.1 %.

## Retail growth rates by month (for 2024-2025, in %)



In January 2025, the growth rate of retail turnover was 109.2%.

Retail trade turnover as of January 2025 reached 26 977.9 billion soums and increased by 109.2 % compared to the same period in 2024, also the turnover of large enterprises amounted to 4 678.1 billion soums (growth rate - 101.4 %), and small businesses and private entrepreneurship – 22 299.8 billion soums (growth rate - 111.0 %), including unorganized trade amounted to 2 916.0 billion soums (growth rate - 114.4 %).

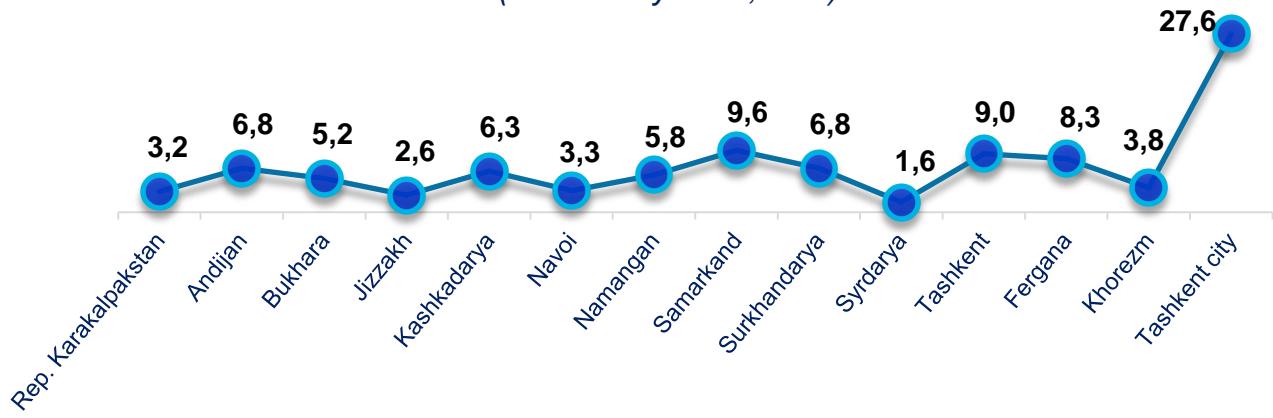

Compared to January 2025, significant growth rates in the period under review were noted in Tashkent (111.6 %), Namangan (111.5 %) and Navoi (111.4 %) regions, where an increase in the growth rate of retail trade was observed.

## Volume and specific weight of retail turnover by territory (for January 2025, in %)

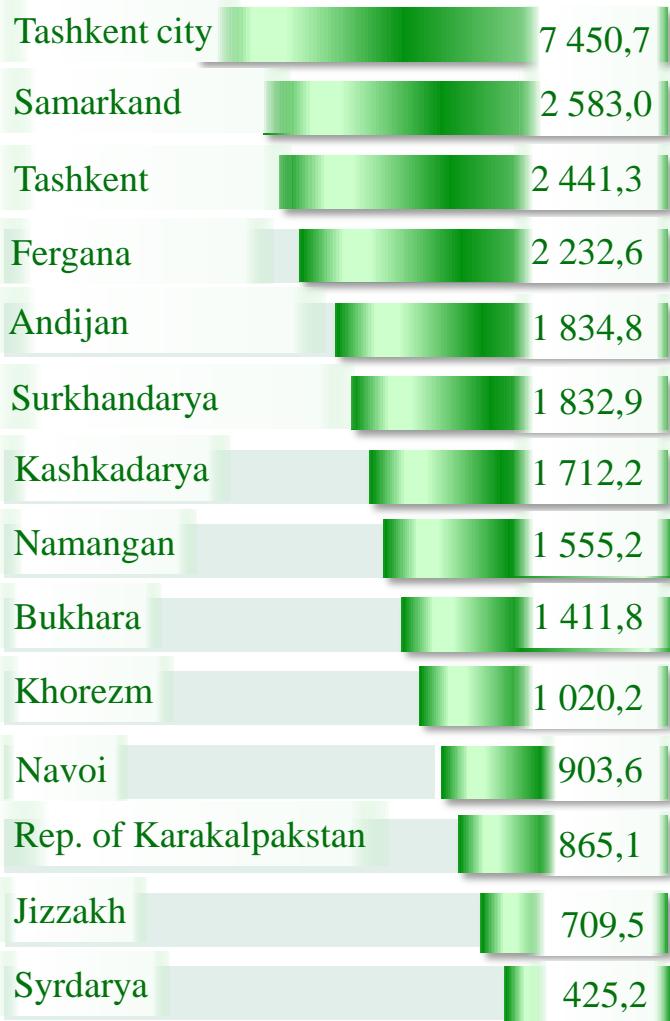


In the structure of retail trade turnover, a significant share in January 2025 was noted in Tashkent city, which amounted to 27.6 %, or 7450.7 billion soums. The smallest share was recorded at 1.6 %, or 425.2 billion soums, which was observed in the Syrdarya region.

Compared to the corresponding period of 2024, during the period under review, all regions saw an increase in growth rates in retail trade.

## Regions with the highest growth rates of small business and private entrepreneurship

The retail trade turnover of small businesses and private entrepreneurship, according to statistical calculations, in January 2025 amounted to 22 299.8 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 11.0 %. The share of this sector in the republic in the retail trade turnover reached 82.7 %.

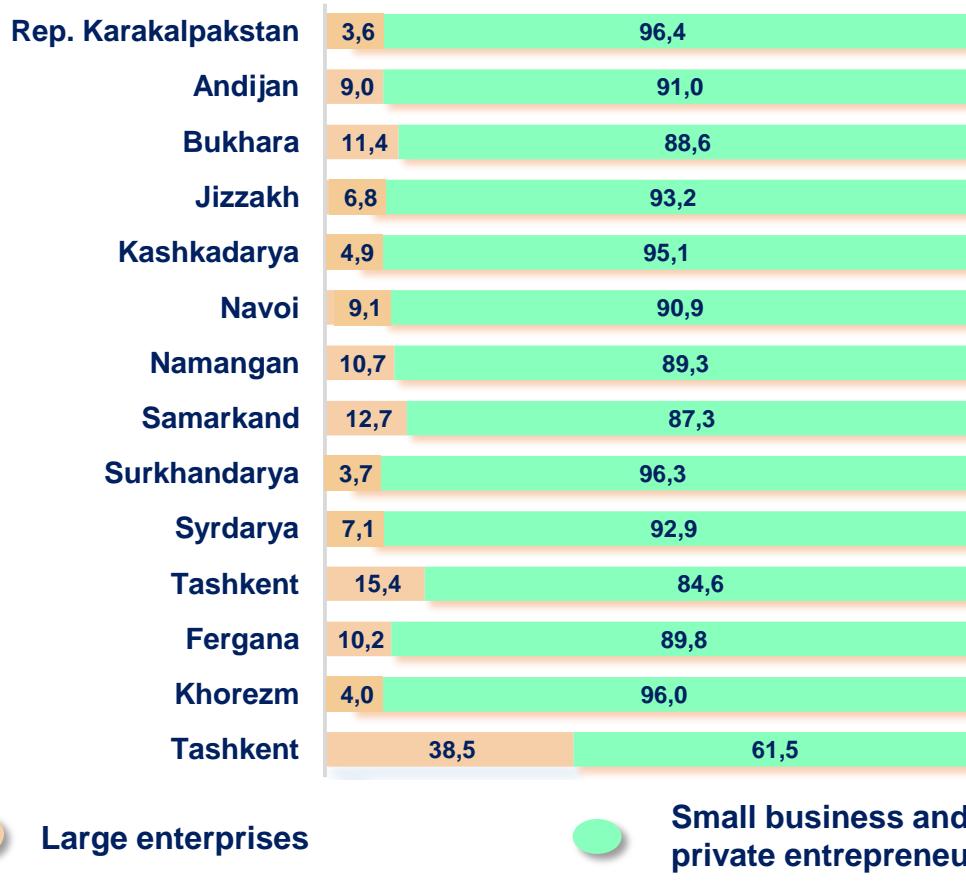
## Regions with the highest growth rates of large enterprises

In the structure of retail trade turnover, the volume of trade turnover of large enterprises in January 2025, compared with the same period in 2024, increased by 1.4 % and reached 4 678.1 billion soums, which amounted to 17.3 % of its total volume.

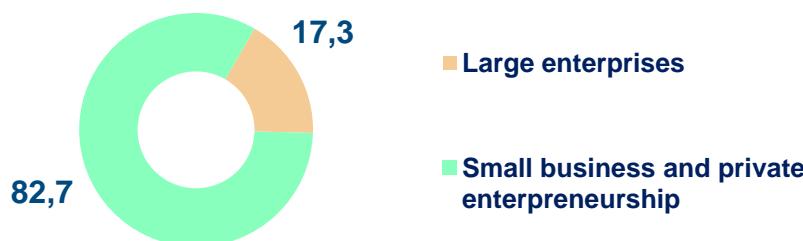

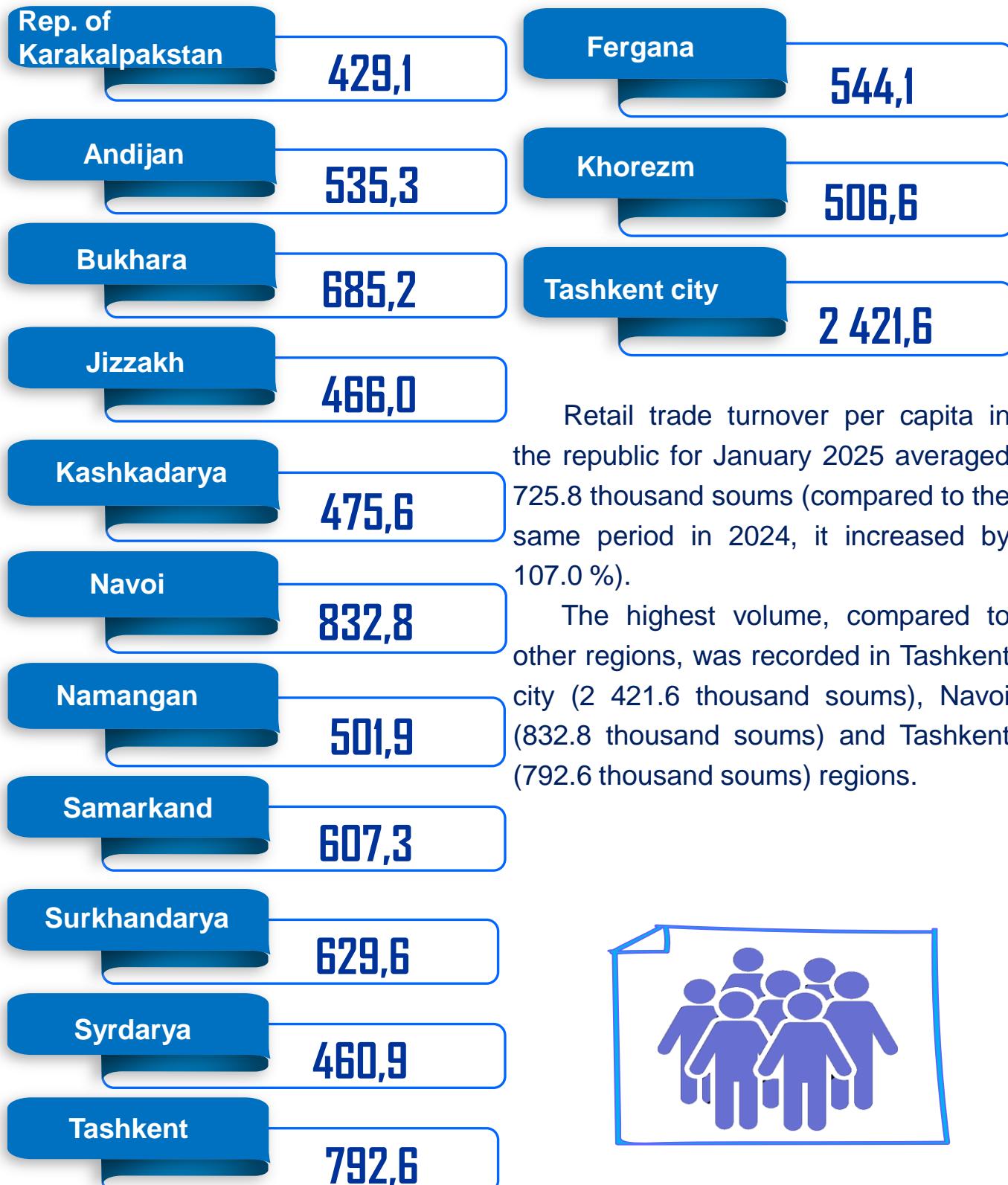


The share of small business and private entrepreneurship, compared to other regions, in January 2025 was the highest in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (96.4 %), Surkhandarya (96.3 %) and Khorezm (96.0 %) regions. In the structure of retail trade turnover, the share of turnover of large enterprises amounted to 17.3 % of total sales, their main share was observed in Tashkent city (38.5 %), Tashkent (15.4 %), Samarkand (12.7 %) and Bukhara (11.4 %) regions.



## VOLUME PER CAPITA IN RETAIL TRADE TURNOVER

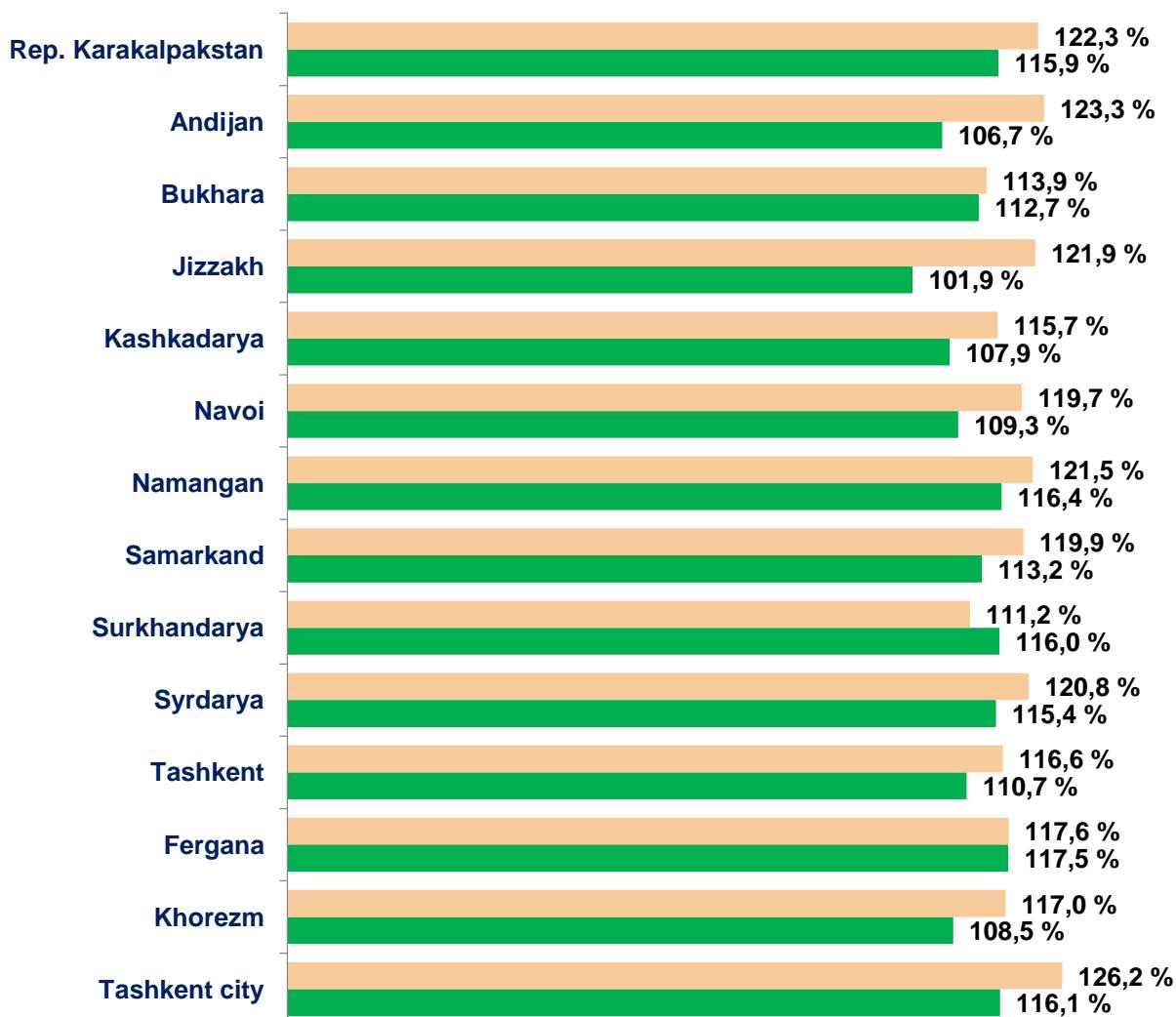

**Unorganized trade turnover** - also taken into account when forming indicators of domestic trade. This includes the volume of sales made by individuals at the dehkan (food) market, as well as at the livestock, poultry and other animal markets. Unorganized trade includes agricultural products grown by individuals (farmers) on their own farms.

Livestock markets

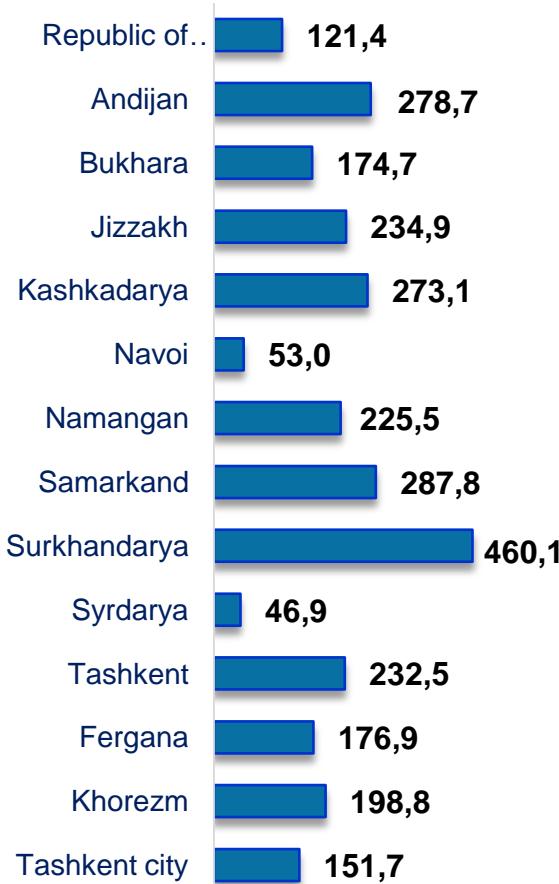
**A dekan (food) market** - a property complex operating on a permanent or temporary basis in places intended to create the necessary conditions for the retail sale and purchase of a wide range of agricultural food products and processed products using shopping arcades, trading places and stationary retail outlets (including retail pavilions).

According to preliminary data from the survey of individuals, the turnover of unorganized trade in January 2025 amounted to 2 916.0 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2024, it increased by 114.4 %. Including the turnover of trade in dehkan markets amounted to 1 251.2 billion soums (an increase of 118.5 %), the turnover of trade in livestock markets was recorded at 1 664.8 billion soums (a decrease of 111.5 %).

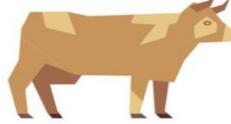
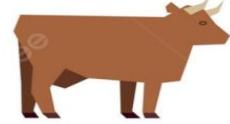
In January 2025, a survey of individuals engaged in the sale of agricultural products (grown in private farms) was conducted in all regions of the republic, according to the results of which the turnover of this type of trade amounted to 1 251.2 billion soums. High sales of fresh agricultural products reached 604.9 billion soums.

In January 2025, a survey of individuals engaged in the sale of poultry and livestock (kept in private farms) was conducted in all regions of the republic, according to the results of which the turnover of this type of trade amounted to 1 664.8 billion soums. The sale of livestock of different ages reached 1 383.5 billion soums, sheep and goats - 244.4 billion soums, horses - 30.6 billion soums, birds - 6.2 billion soums.

## TURNOVER OF FOOD ENTERPRISES

As of February 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the public catering sector amounted to 23 427 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises amounted to 80 units, and the number of small enterprises and micro firms reached 23 347.

In January 2025, the turnover of catering enterprises amounted to 11 514.8 billion soums and increased, compared to the same period in 2024, by 111.3 %, of which 81.7 % of the trade turnover falls to the share of small businesses.

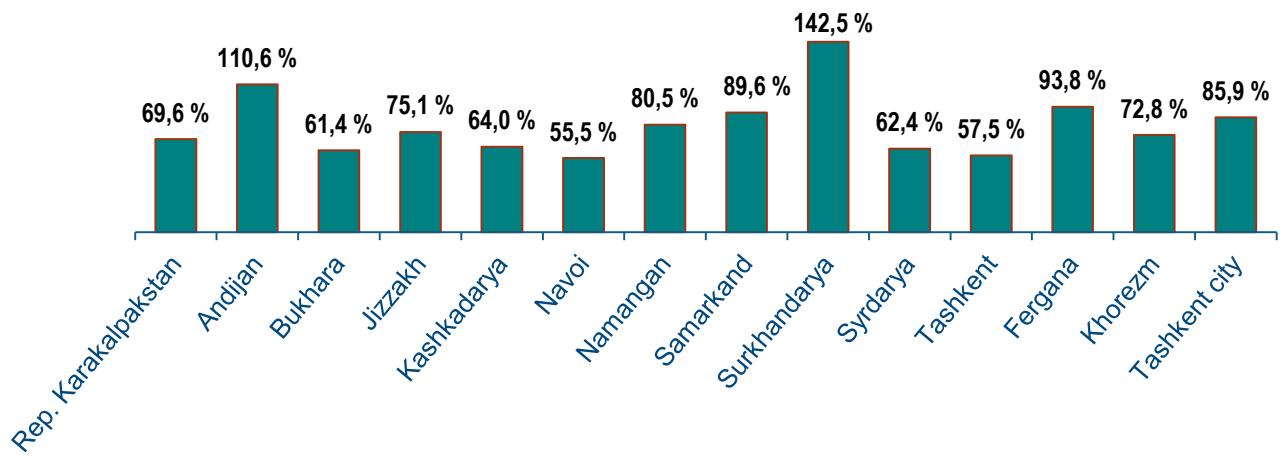
The highest volumes, compared to other regions, were recorded in Tashkent city (2 639.0 billion soums), Jizzakh (496.2 billion soums) and Fergana (357.7 billion soums) regions.

## Turnover of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories (in billion soums)



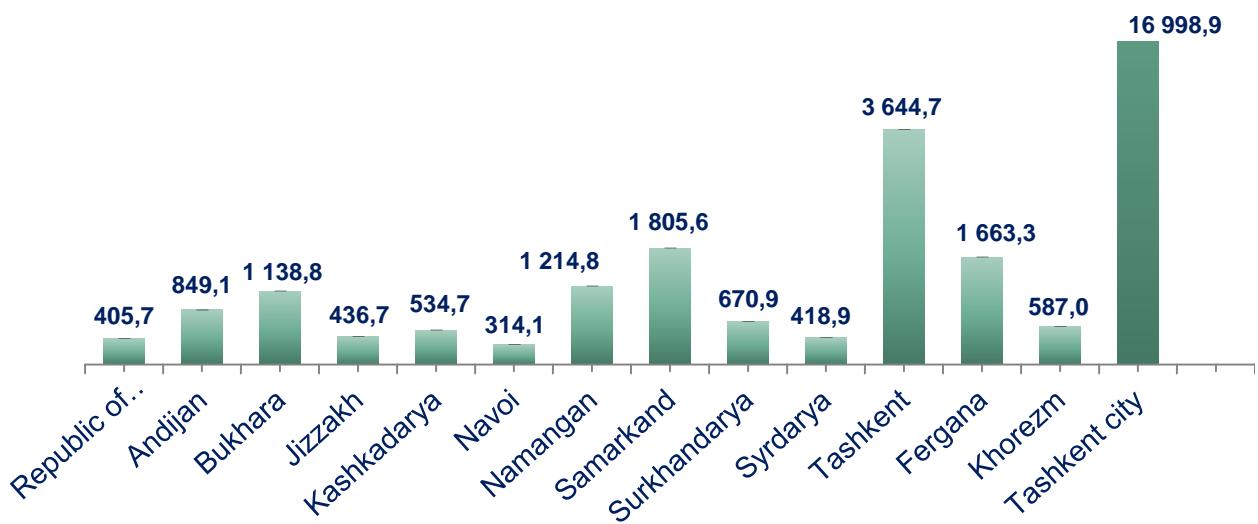
The turnover of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories (except for maintenance and repair of motor vehicles) for January 2025 amounted to 5 739.0 billion soums and increased by 79.4 % compared to the same period in 2024. The turnover of large enterprises amounted to 2 346.9 billion soums (growth rate - 71.7 %), and small businesses and private entrepreneurship – 3 392.1 billion soums (growth rate - 85.8 %).

### Growth rate of wholesale and retail trade in motor vehicles and their accessories



**Wholesale turnover** - the cost of goods purchased from outside for the purpose of resale and actually shipped without modification to third-party organizations and individual entrepreneurs for use in business activities or for their own use (processing), regardless of whether payment has been made for these goods or not.

## Wholesale turnover in the republic (in billion soums)



According to preliminary data, in January 2025, the volume of wholesale trade turnover reached 30 683.2 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2024, increased by 10.6 %.

## Share and volume of trade turnover



The turnover of wholesale trade of small businesses, according to statistical calculations, amounted to 22 829.5 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2024, increased by 108.8 %. The share of this sector in the turnover of wholesale trade in the republic amounted to 74.4 %.

As of February 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the wholesale trade sector amounted to 45 611 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises is 345, small enterprises and micro firms – 45 266.

In January 2025, the highest growth rates of wholesale turnover of large enterprises, compared to the same period in 2024, were observed in the Navoi region (4.8 times), Jizzakh (4.8 times), Fergana (4.8 times) and Syrdarya (199.9%) regions.
