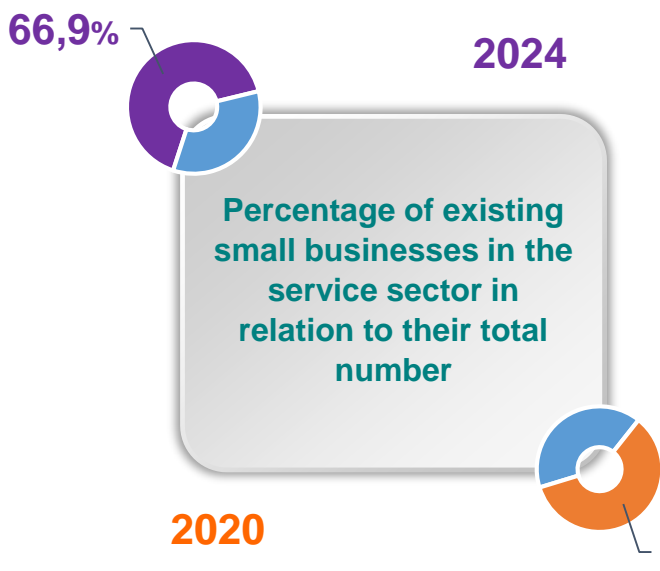

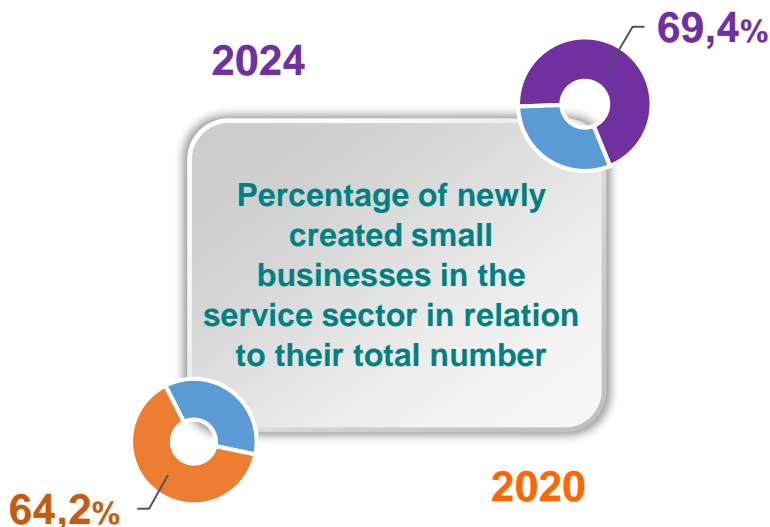

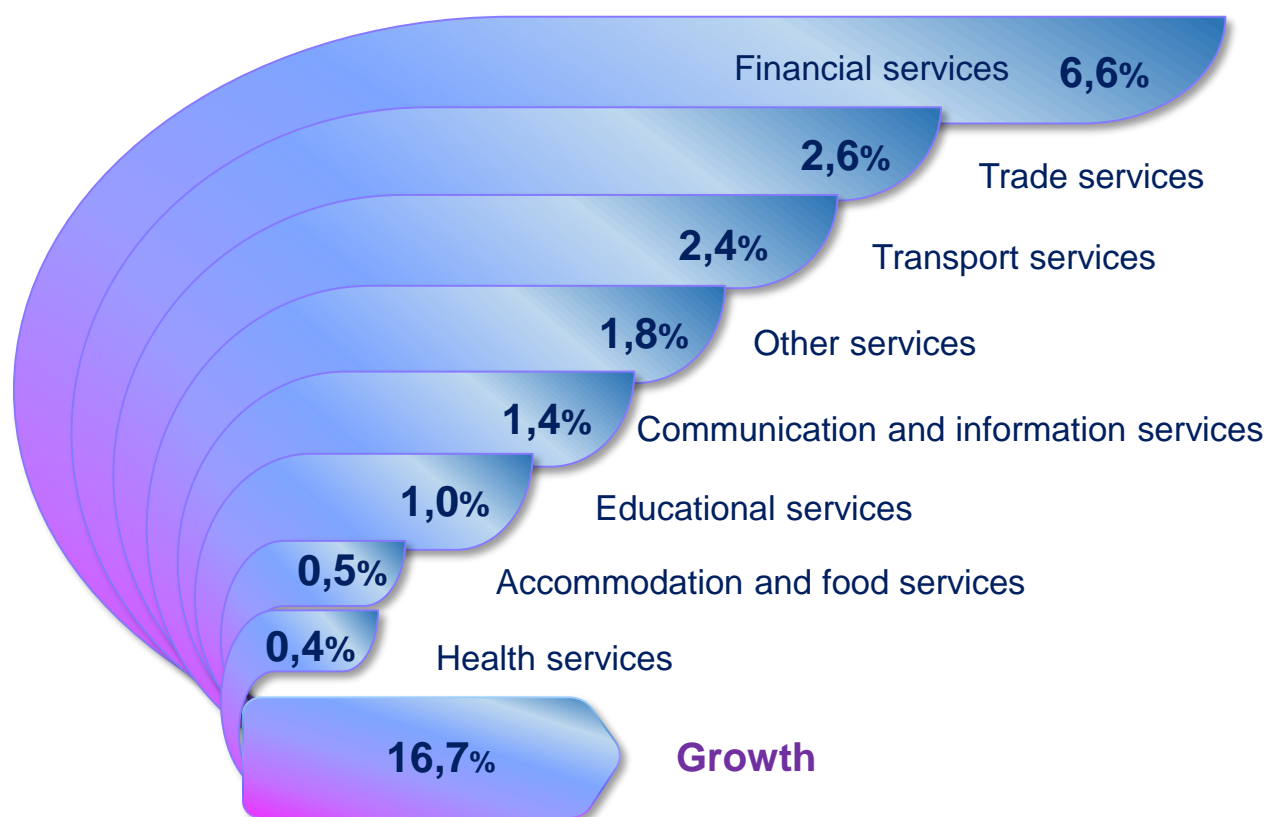

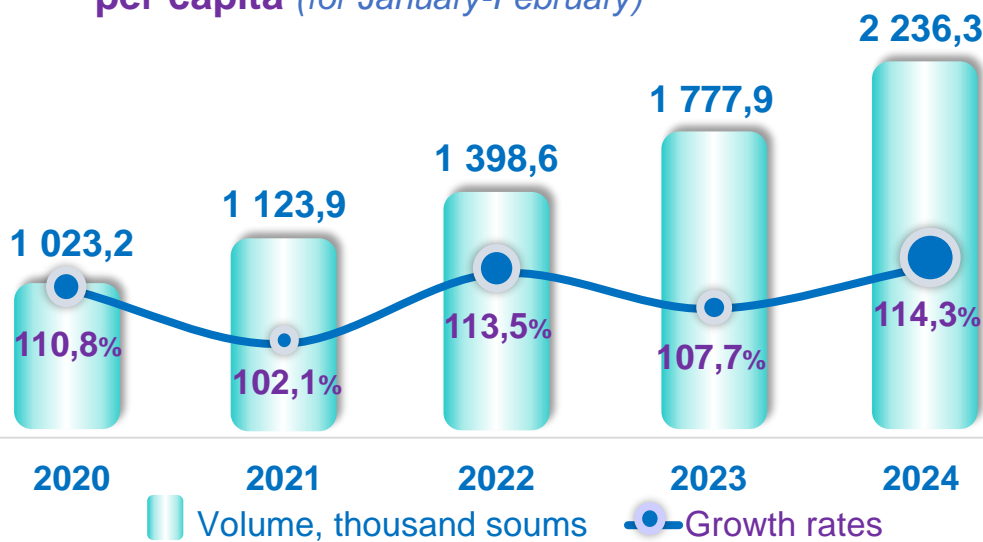

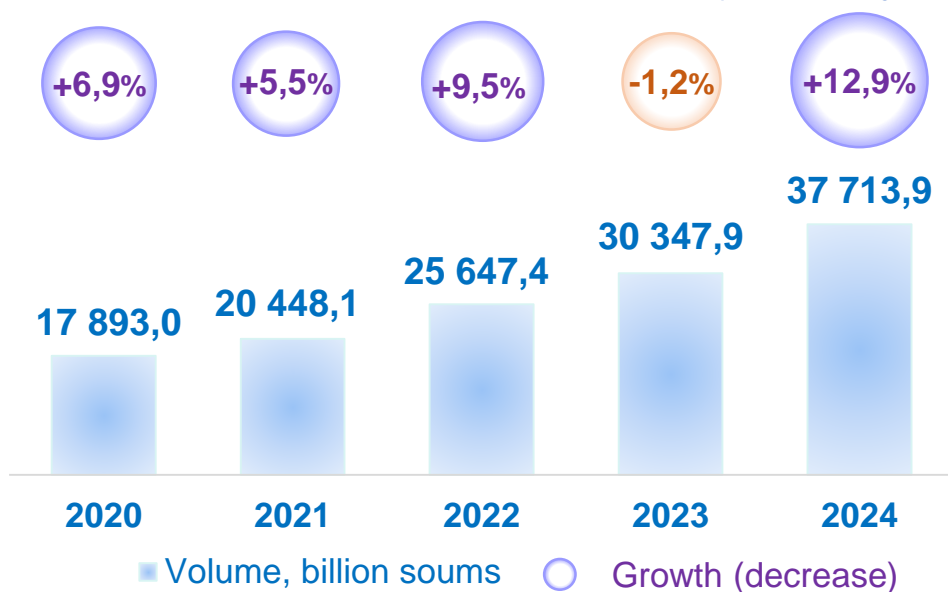
Dynamics of the main indicators of market services per capita (for January-February)



Services per capita by region (for January-February 2024)

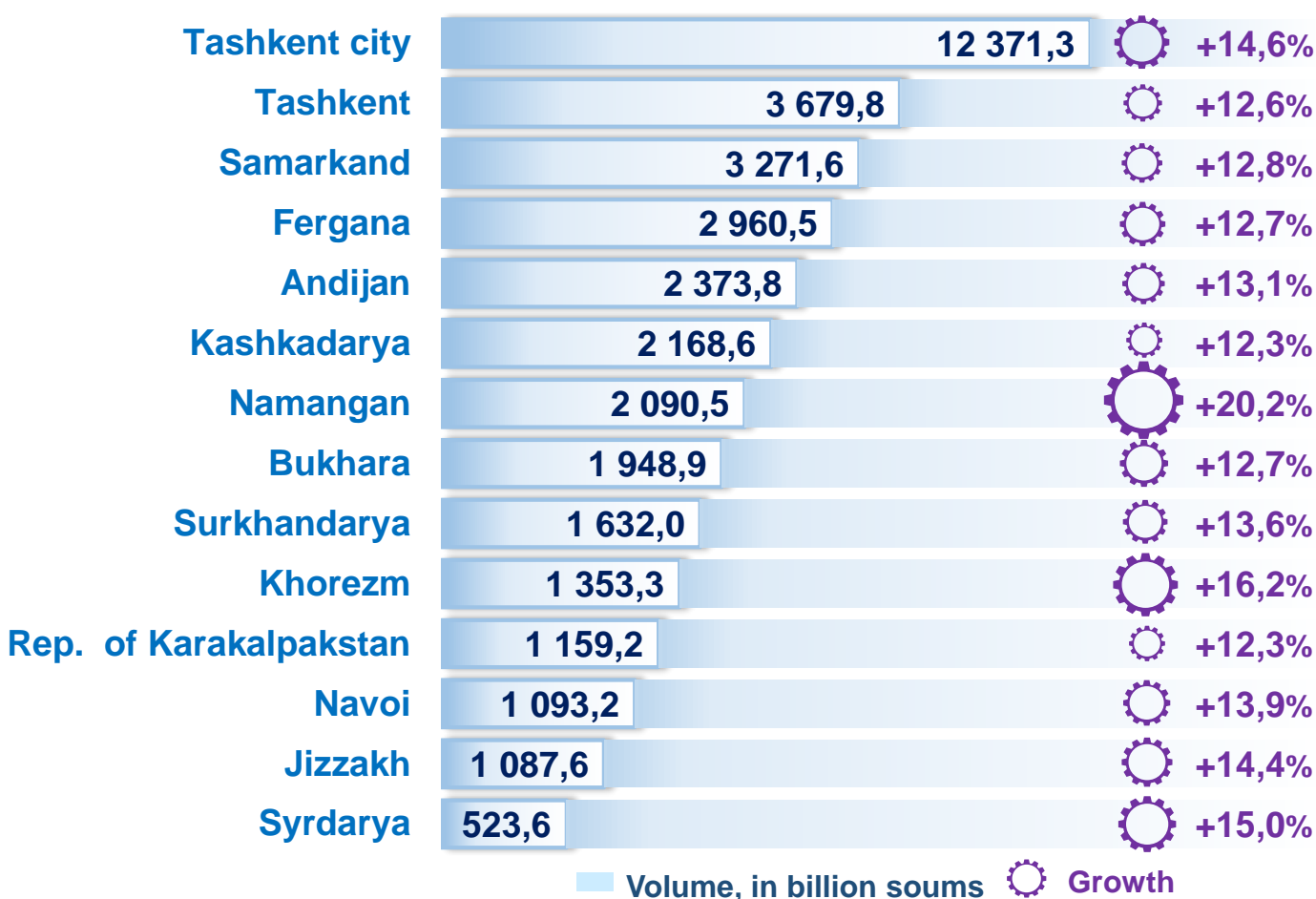

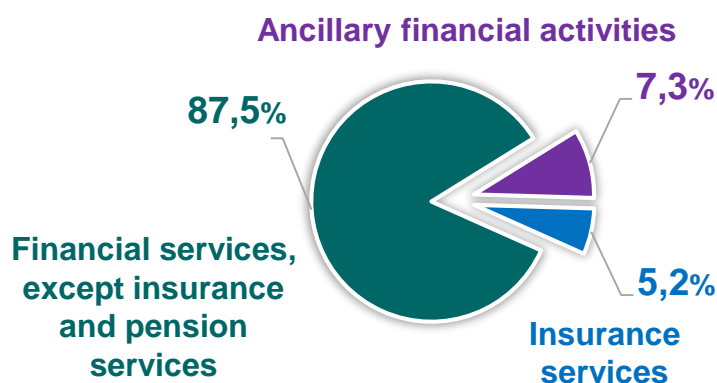

In the structure of financial services, their share, except for insurance and pension services, amounted to **87,5 %** in **January-February 2024**.

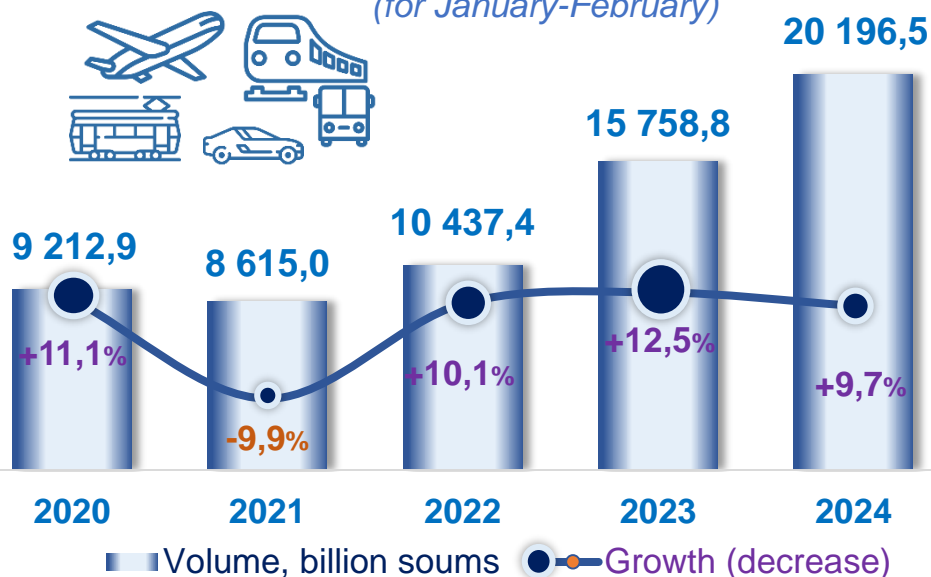
The share of the Tashkent city in the total volume of financial services amounted to **58.0%**, or **11 834.1 billion soums**. Compared to **January-February 2023**, high growth rates were recorded here at **139.3%**.

In the total volume of transport services, road transport services predominate - **46.3%**.

The volume of transport services in the Tashkent city reached **3 835.5** billion soums. In this region, the growth rate of transport services was noted at **125.0%**.

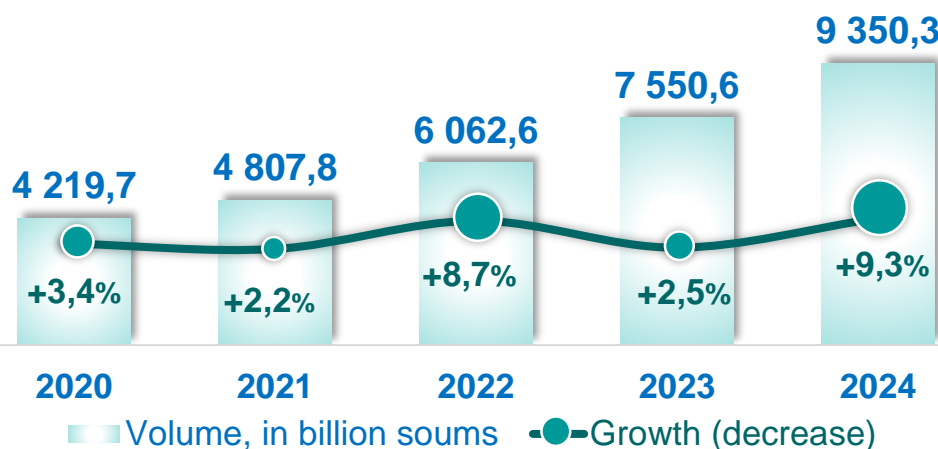

Compared to **January-February 2023**, high growth rates of **118.1%** were recorded in the Namangan region.

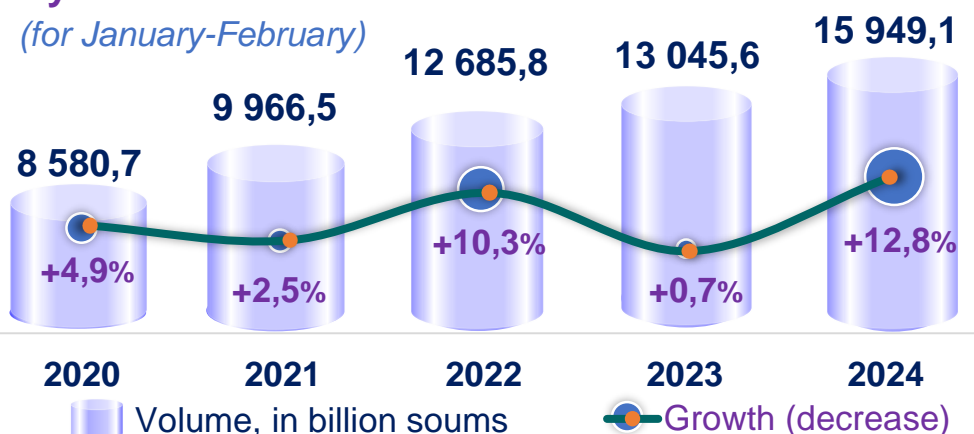

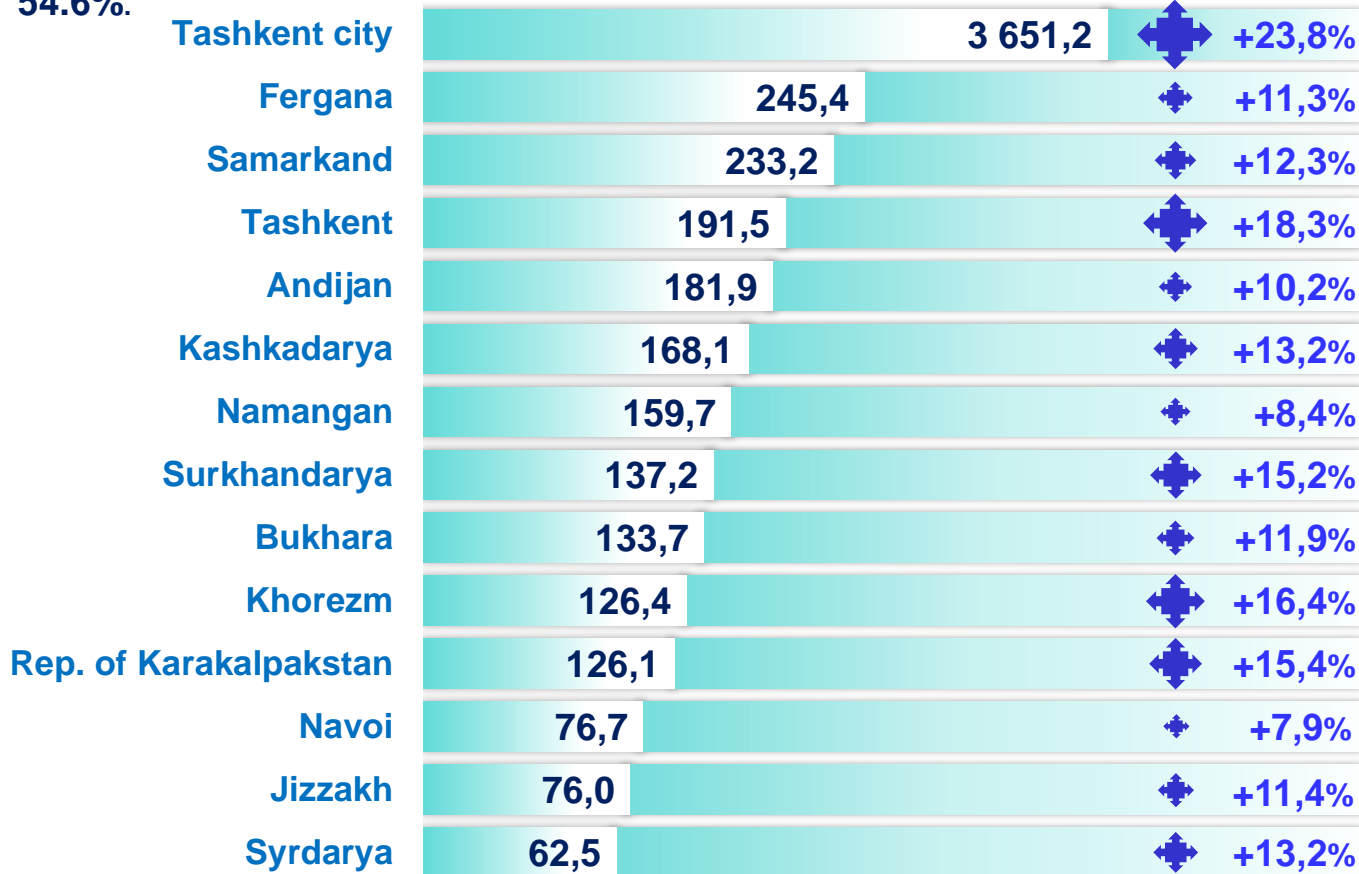
Dynamics of communication and information services ¹⁾ (for January-February)

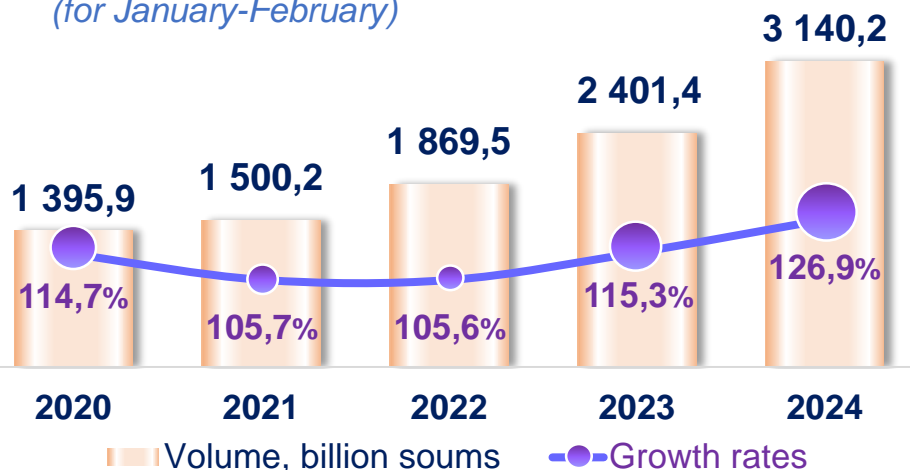

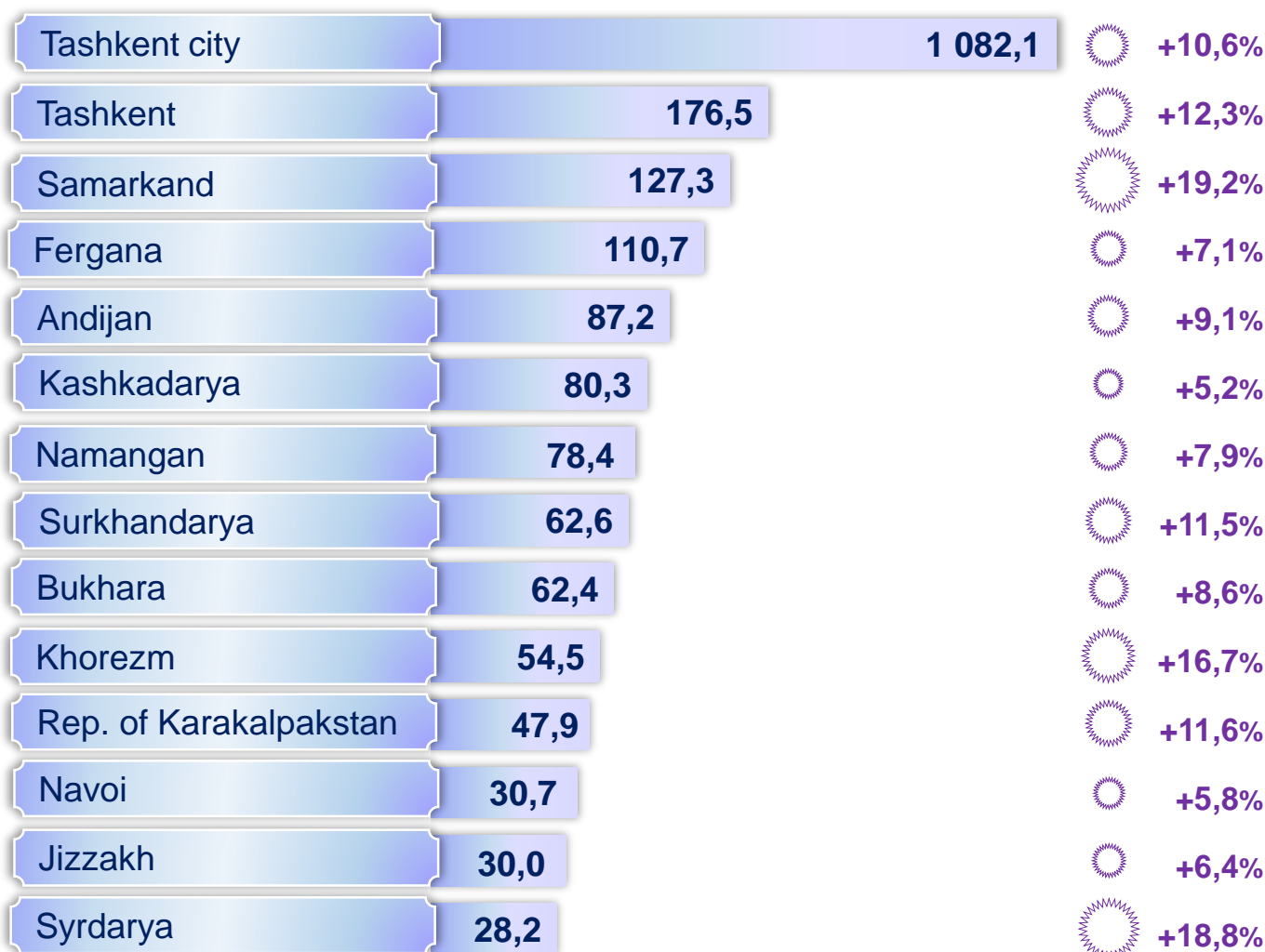

Services related to real estate by region

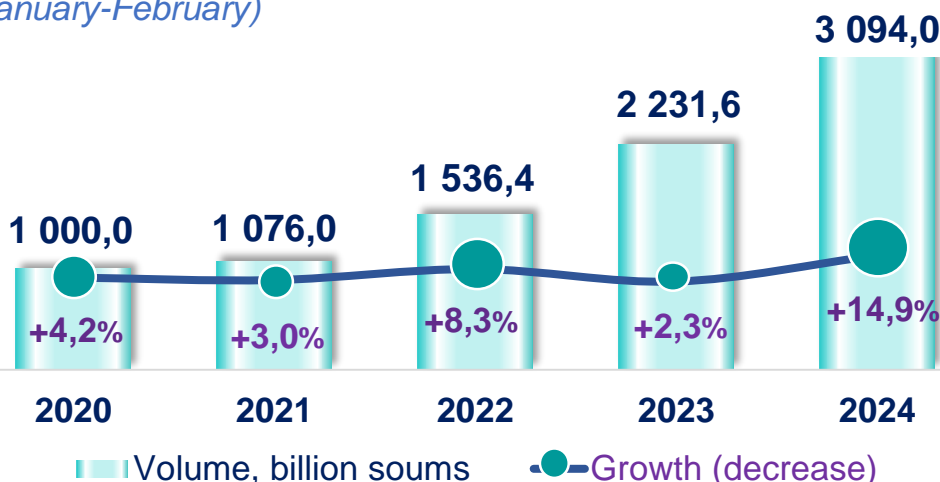

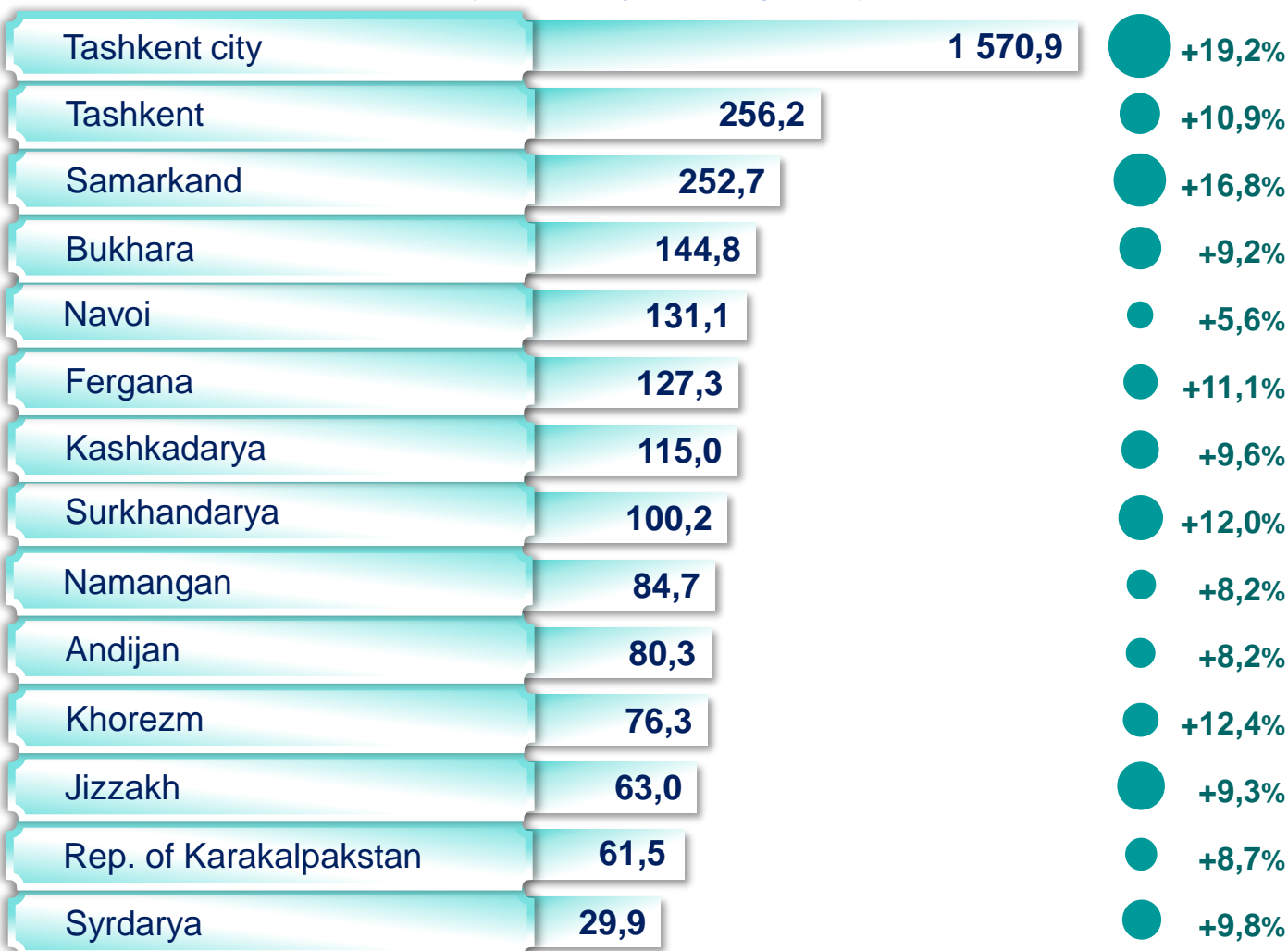

Accommodation and catering services by region (for January-February 2024)



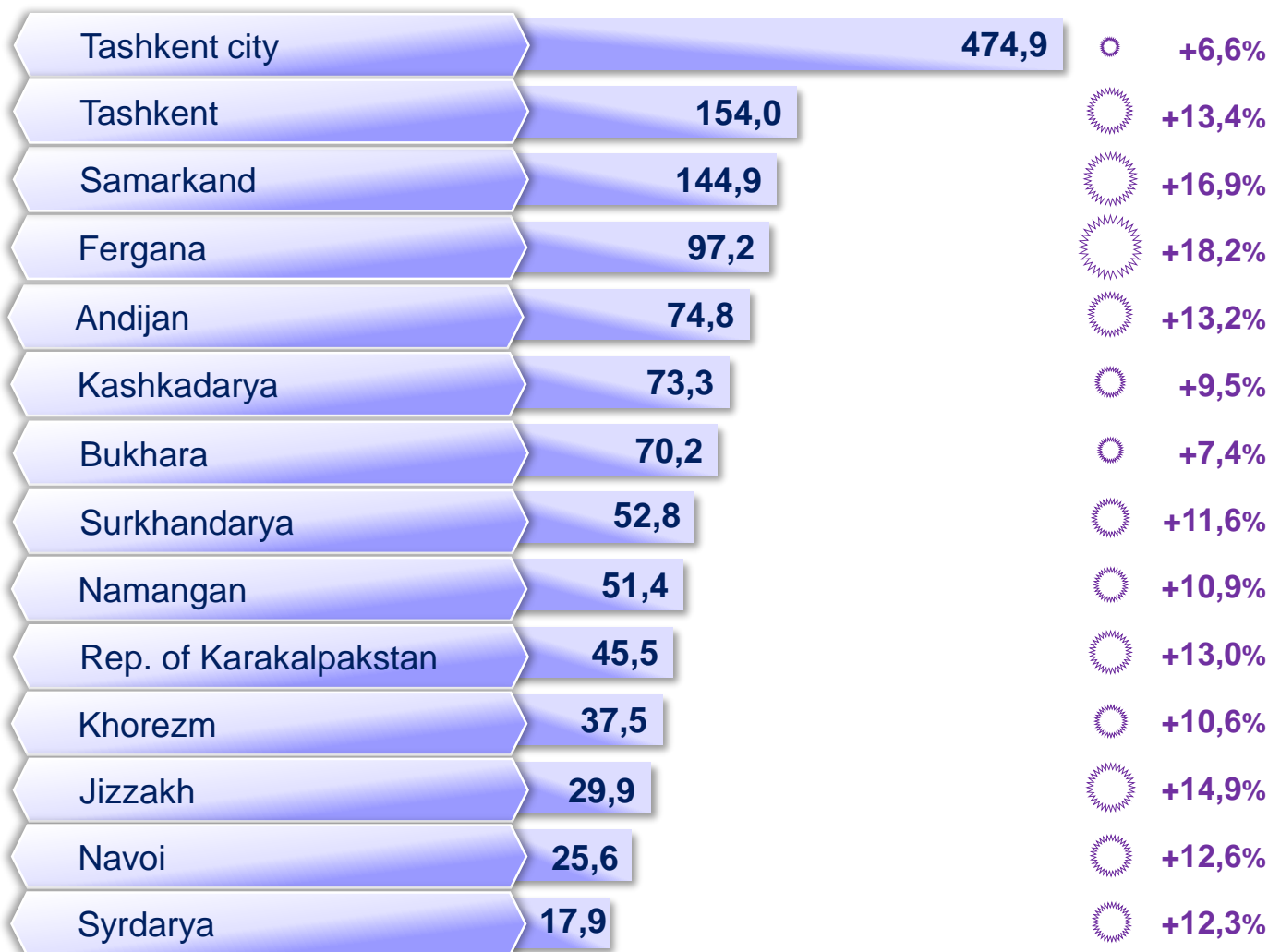

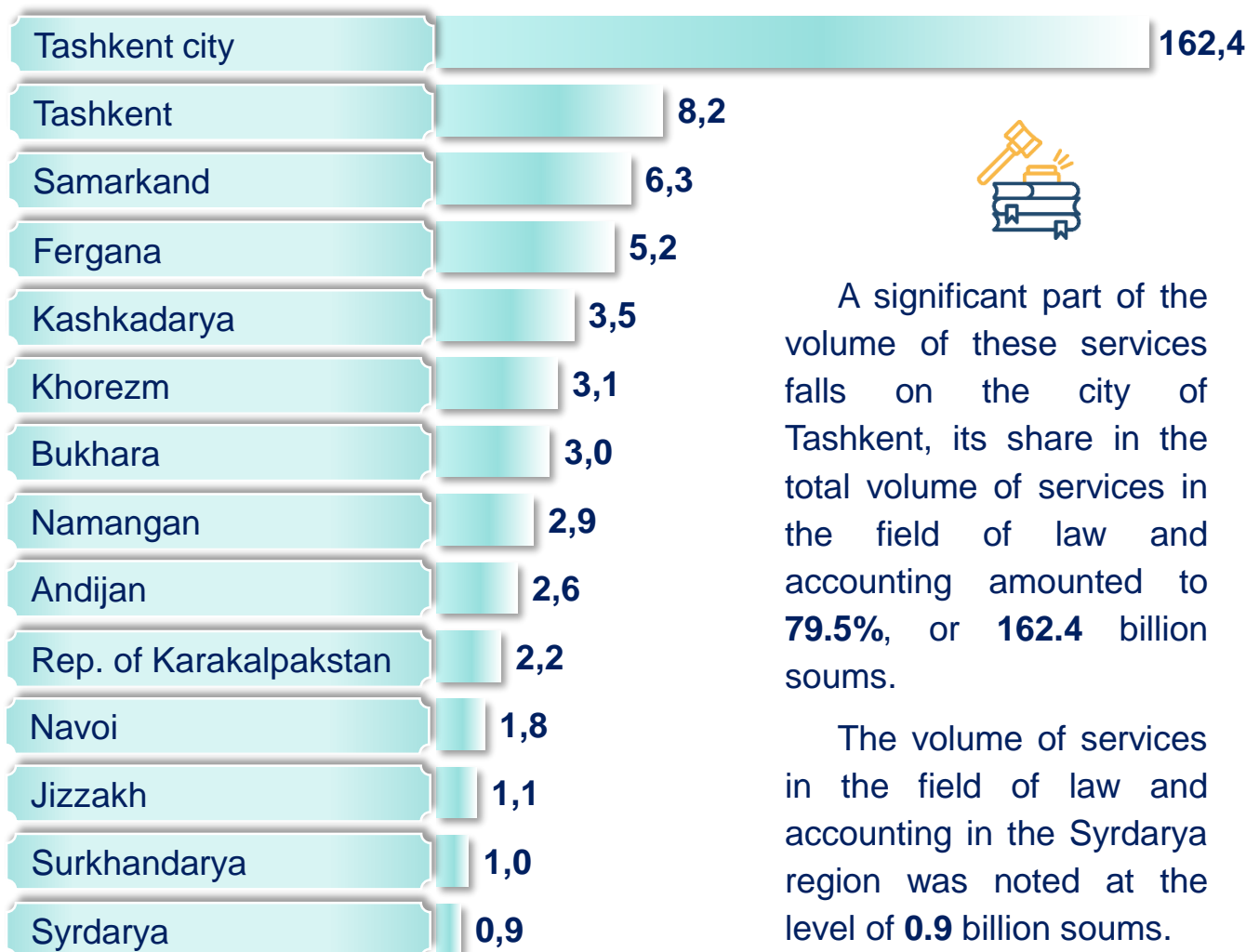


For **January-February 2024**, the volume of services in the field of law and accounting reached **204.2** billion soums.

(for January-February 2024, in billion soums)



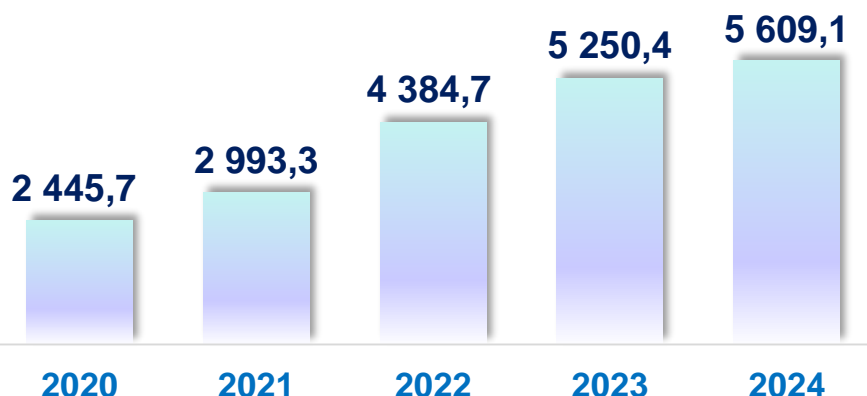
A significant part of the volume of these services falls on the city of Tashkent, its share in the total volume of services in the field of law and accounting amounted to **79.5%**, or **162.4** billion soums.

The volume of services in the field of law and accounting in the Syrdarya region was noted at the level of **0.9** billion soums.

Dynamics of legal and accounting services per capita

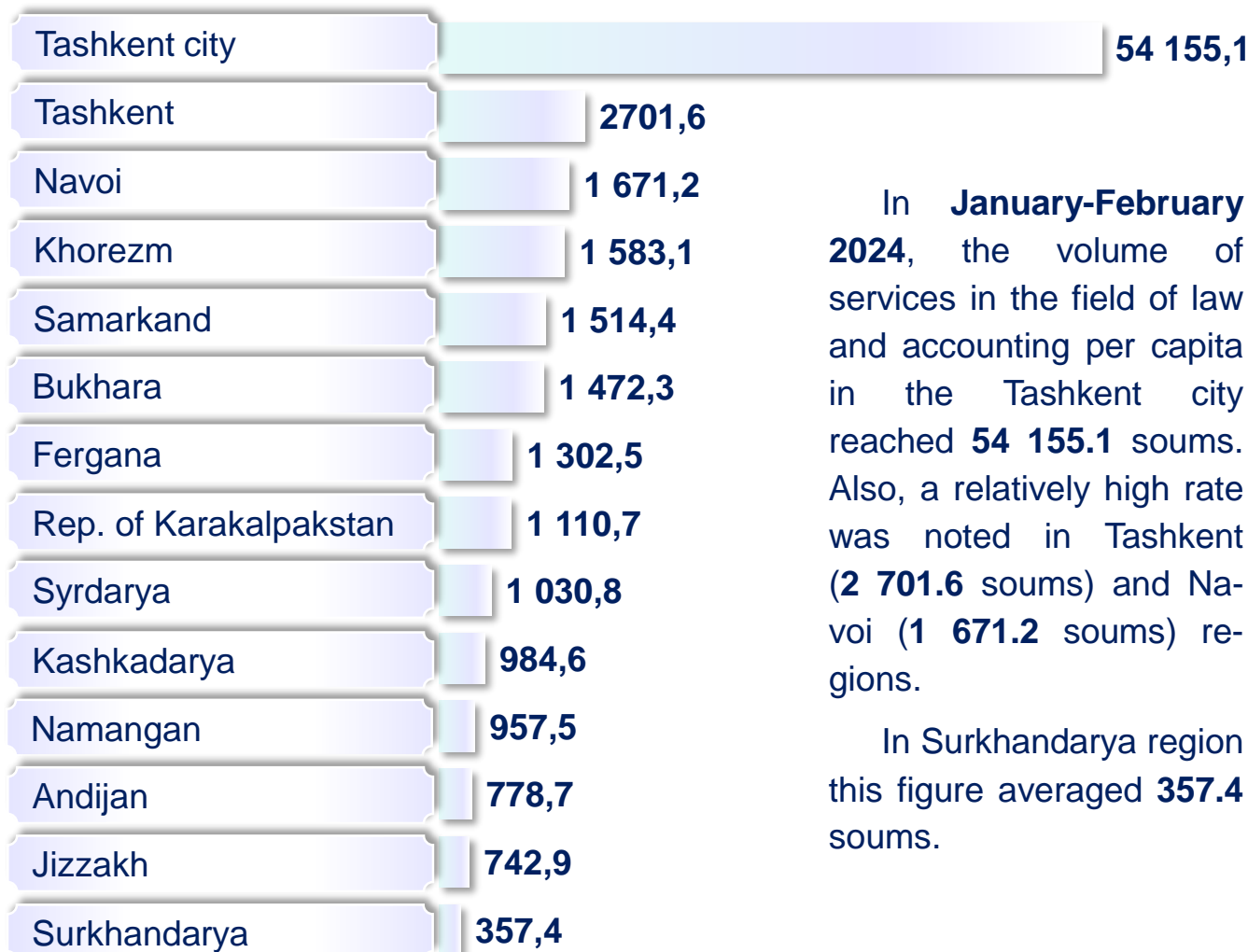

Compared to **January-February 2020**, the volume of services in the field of law and accounting per capita in **January-February 2024** increased by **3 163.5** soums and amounted to **5 609.1** soums.



Legal and accounting services per capita by region

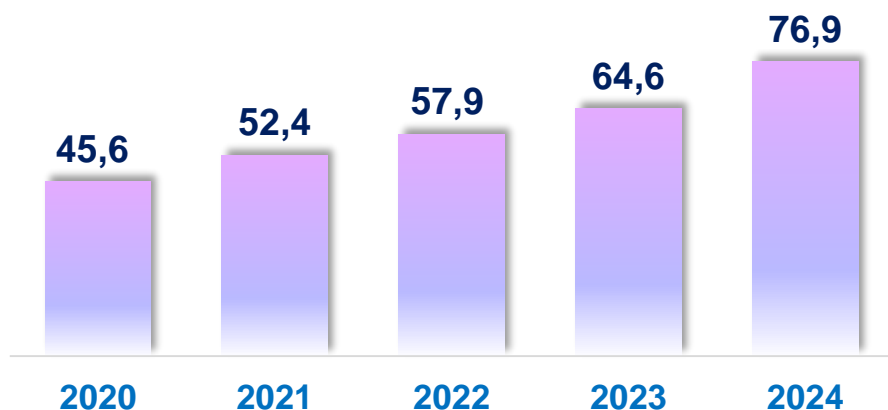

In **January-February 2024**, the volume of services in the field of law and accounting per capita in the Tashkent city reached **54 155.1** soums. Also, a relatively high rate was noted in Tashkent (**2 701.6** soums) and Navoi (**1 671.2** soums) regions.

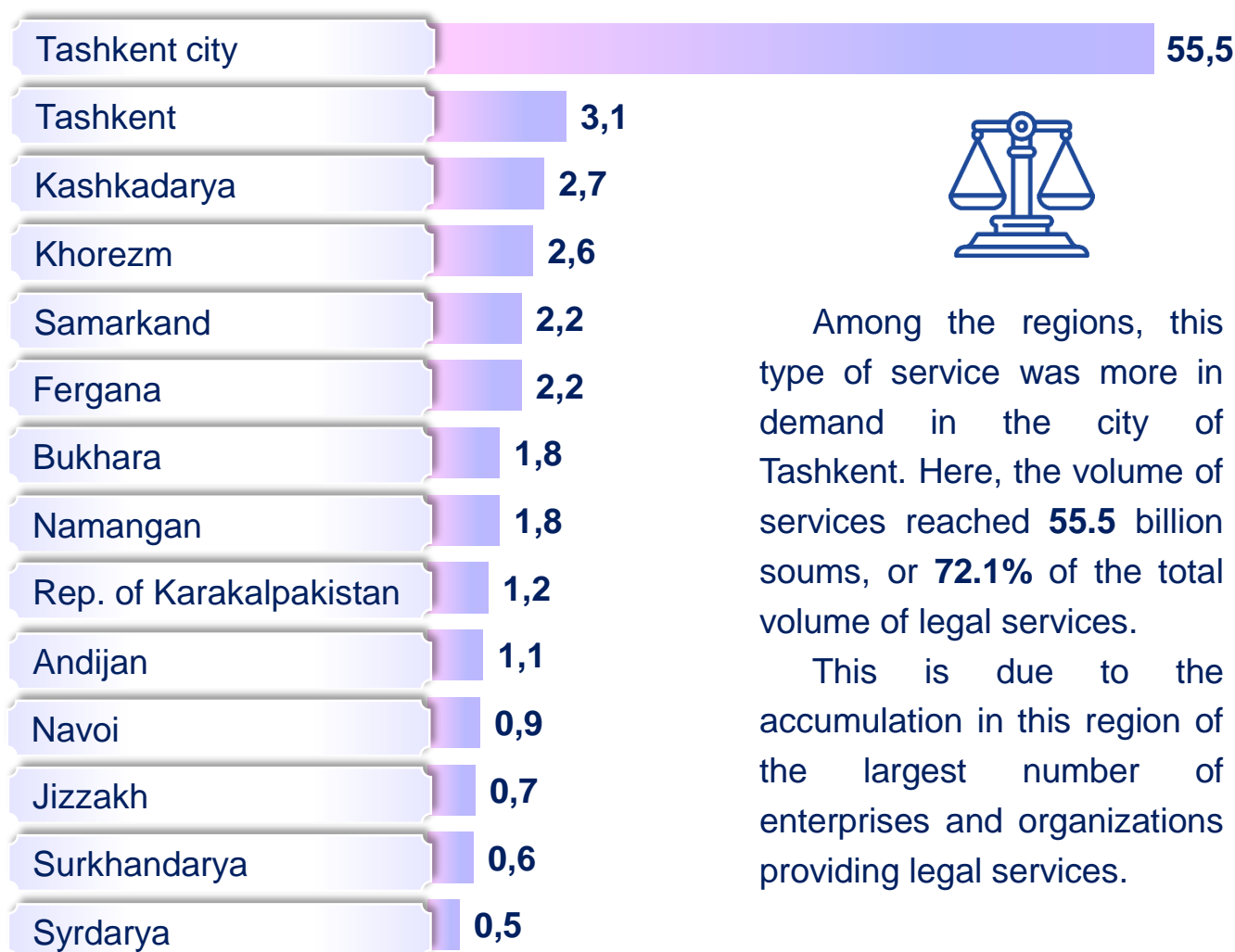
In Surkhandarya region this figure averaged **357.4** soums.

For **January-February 2024**, the share of legal services in the total volume of services in the field of law and accounting amounted to **37.7%**, or **76.9** billion soums.

Among the regions, this type of service was more in demand in the city of Tashkent. Here, the volume of services reached **55.5** billion soums, or **72.1%** of the total volume of legal services.

This is due to the accumulation in this region of the largest number of enterprises and organizations providing legal services.

Dynamics of legal services per capita

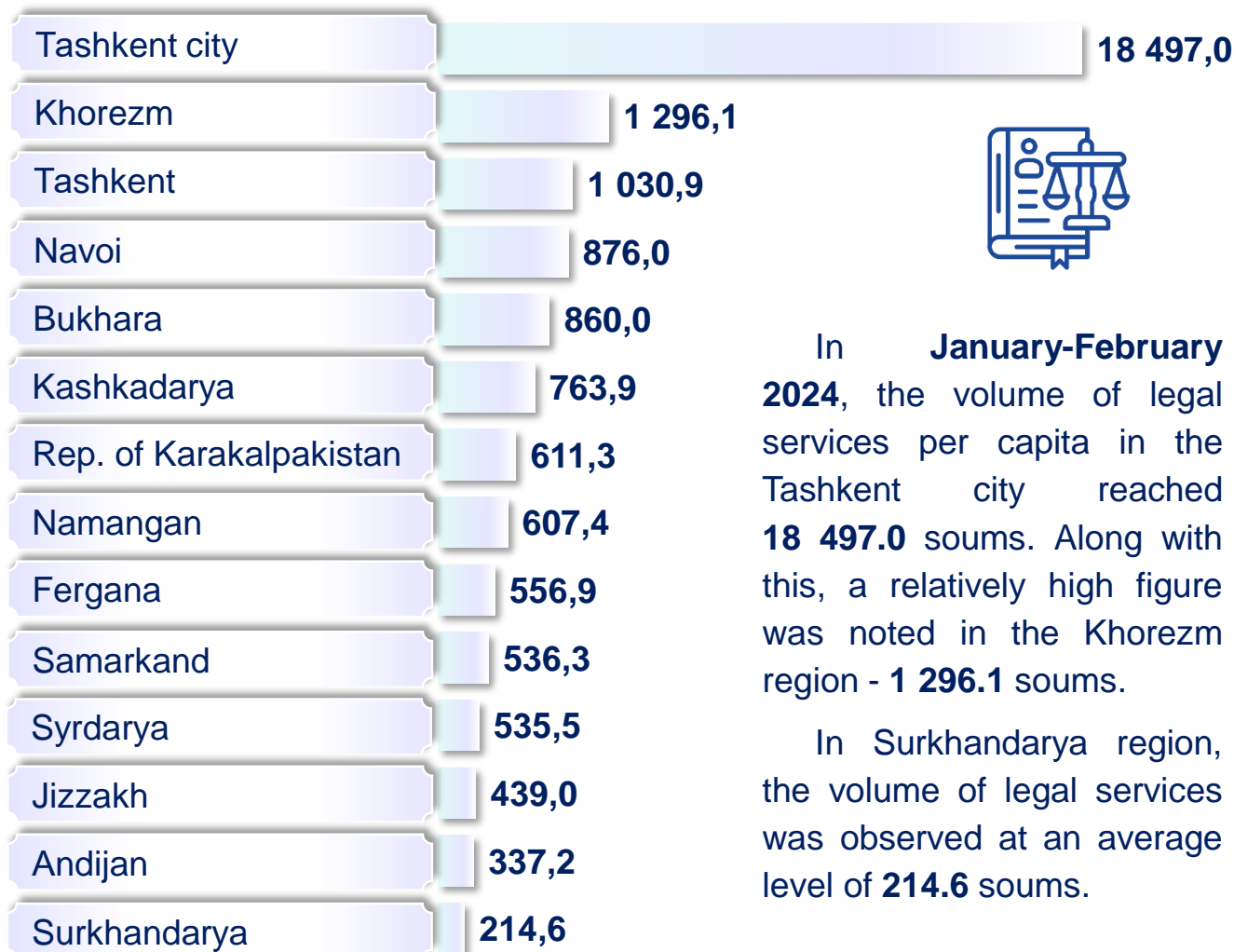

Compared to **January-February 2020**, the volume of legal services per capita in **January-February 2024** increased by **755.1** soums and amounted to an average of **2 112.5** soums.

(for January-February 2024, in soum)

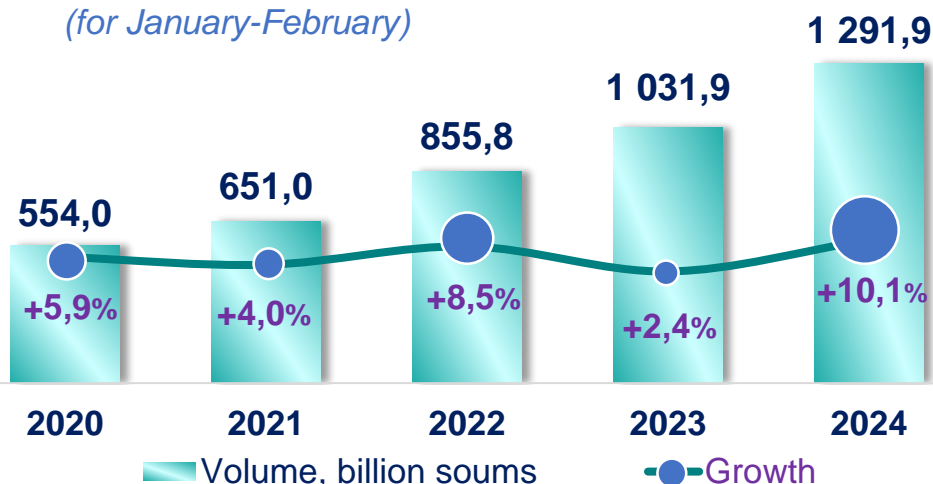


In **January-February 2024**, the volume of legal services per capita in the Tashkent city reached **18 497.0** soums. Along with this, a relatively high figure was noted in the Khorezm region - **1 296.1** soums.

In Surkhandarya region, the volume of legal services was observed at an average level of **214.6** soums.

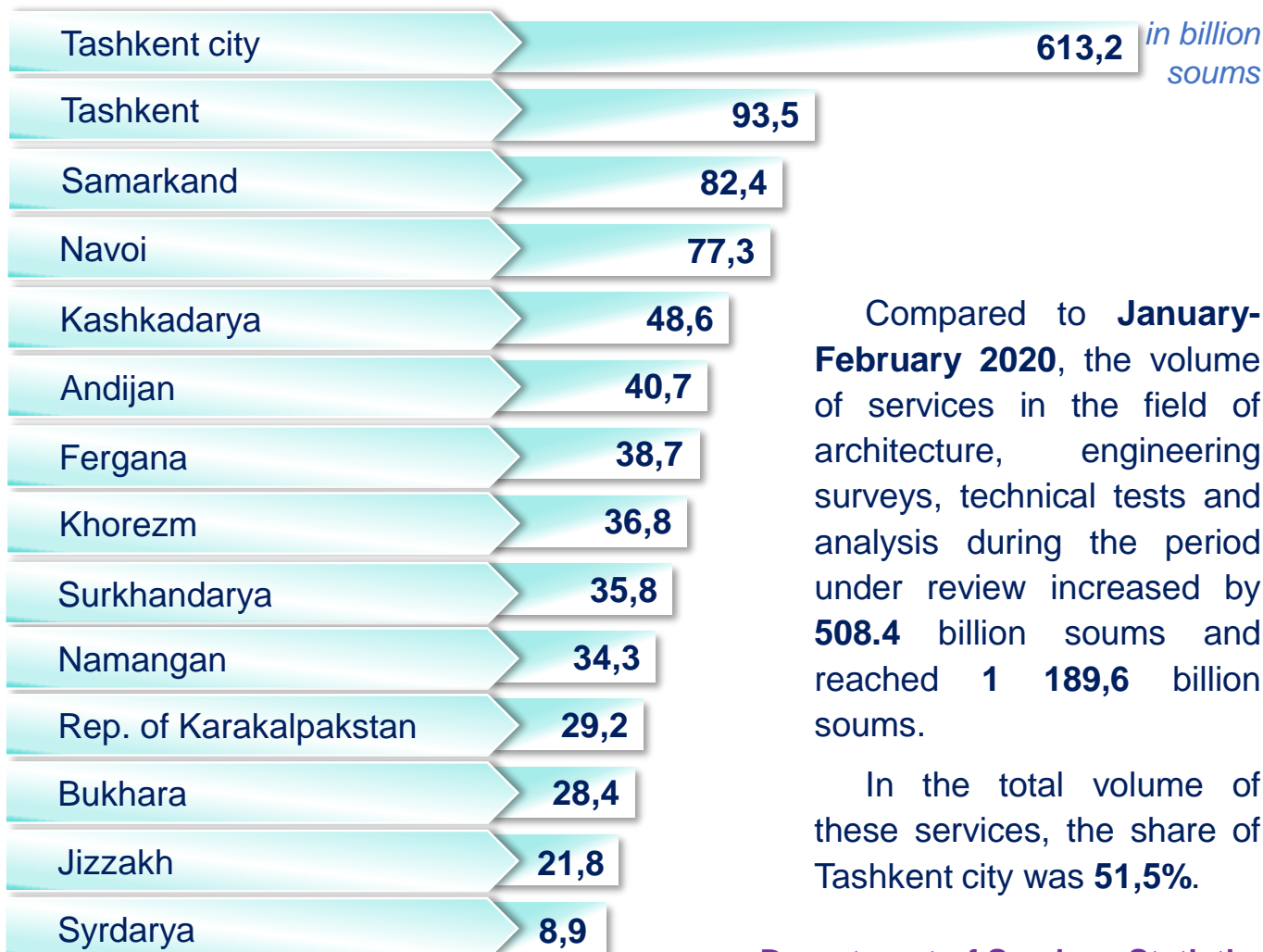

Architectural, Engineering, Technical Testing and Analysis Services by Region *(for January-February 2024)*



Compared to **January-February 2020**, the volume of services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys, technical tests and analysis during the period under review increased by **508.4** billion soums and reached **1 189,6** billion soums.

In the total volume of these services, the share of Tashkent city was **51,5%**.

The volume of financial services is accounted for by the amount of interest income received from financial intermediation (in the amount of payment for them), as well as in the form of payment for the services of a financial institution for granting a loan or saving a deposit.

The volume of transport services is the amount of income from transportation and other activities directly related to the implementation of the transport process (loading and unloading, freight forwarding services, transport maintenance, etc.) by type of transport.

Motor transport services is the amount of income from transportation and other activities directly related to the implementation of the transport process (loading and unloading, freight forwarding services, transport maintenance, etc.), broken down by type of transport.

The volume of trade services, including electronic ones, is the gross income, which is the difference between the selling and purchase value of goods sold. In the case of a transaction for the purchase and sale of goods in the interests of another person on the basis of contracts, orders, commissions or agency agreements, the cost of services in the amount of remuneration is reflected.

The volume of communication and information services at current prices is defined as the sum of the income of enterprises and organizations (in the amount of revenue from their sale) providing services in this area.

The Education section includes public and private education at any level and training in any profession, full-time or part-time, as well as through Internet channels and through postal correspondence. This includes education provided by institutions within the regular school system at various levels, as well as adult education (training and retraining courses), educational support activities, etc. When carrying out **educational activities**, the cost of market services provided, including distance learning (contract), is reflected.

The volume of services in the field of healthcare is the cost of market services rendered for various types of medical care and sanitary services provided by healthcare institutions.

The volume of services for the provision of food and beverages is the cost of turnover, which includes, in addition to the realized overlay, the cost of products used in food preparation and sold without processing.

The volume of accommodation services includes the cost of services provided for the provision of places for short-term stays (hotels, hotels, motels, etc.).

When providing **services related to real estate**, the cost of services related to real estate transactions is indicated, from renting out one's own real estate, which is under economic management, operational management or leased.

The issue of **rental and rental services** is determined in the amount of revenue from renting cars and equipment without an operator, rental of household goods and personal items.

The volume of computer and household goods repair services is the amount of revenue from the rendered market services for repair, maintenance of computers and peripheral equipment, repair of communication equipment, consumer electronics, home and garden equipment, shoes and leather goods, furniture and household accessories, clothing and accessories, sporting goods, musical instruments, hobby items and other personal consumption items and household goods.

The volume of **services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys and the provision of technical advice** includes the cost of design, survey, design, technological works and services performed in accordance with the requirements provided for in the contract, as well as the cost of construction supervision and other engineering services performed in-house.

The volume of services in the field of law and accounting is the amount of revenue from the provision of market services in the field of law, for providing advice to clients on their legal rights and obligations and other legal services, as well as for maintaining accounting books, accounting and auditing, preparation tax returns.

The volume of legal services includes the cost of market services provided for legal representation and protection of interests in courts and other judicial bodies, by persons who are members of the bar or under their supervision: provision of consulting services and representation in civil, criminal cases, labor disputes, as well as for the preparation of legal documents, services of bailiffs, arbitrators, inspectors and judges.
