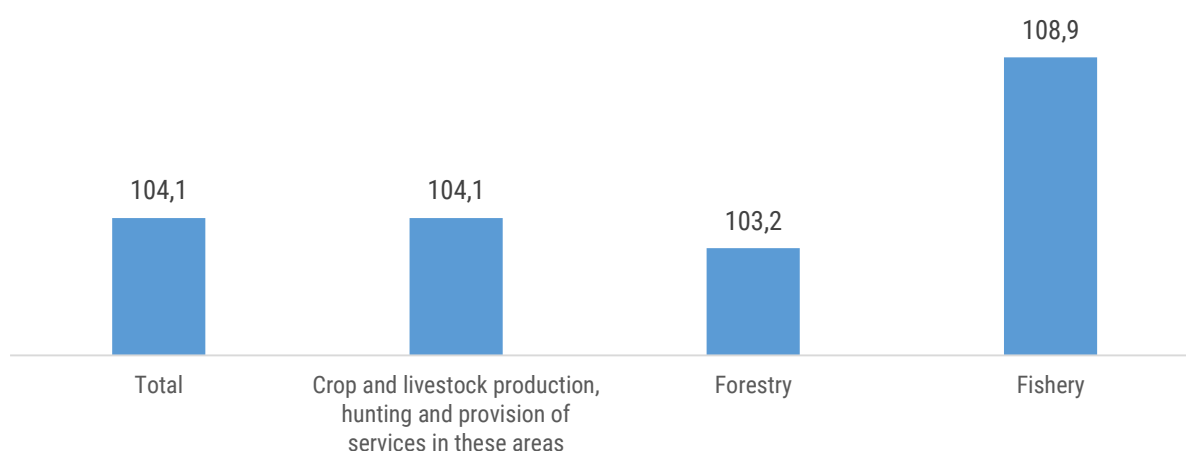

I. Volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries

According to preliminary data, the total volume of products (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January–September 2025 amounted to **366 216.0** billion soums, including crop and livestock production, hunting and the provision of services in these areas – **356 406.4** billion soums, forestry – **7 408.0** billion soums, and fisheries – **2 401.6** billion soums.

II. The volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries by regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan

Analyzing the growth rates of agricultural, forestry and fisheries products (services) by region compared to the same period in 2024, it should be noted that high growth rates were observed in Fergana (**107.1%**), Jizzakh (**106.0%**), Syrdarya (**105.8%**), Tashkent (**105.0%**), Khorezm (**104.9%**) and Bukhara (**104.7%**) regions.

Compared with other regions, insignificant growth rates were noted in Andijan (**101.0%**), Kashkadarya (**102.0%**), Surkhandarya (**102.2%**) and Namangan (**103.8%**) regions.

III. Agricultural products

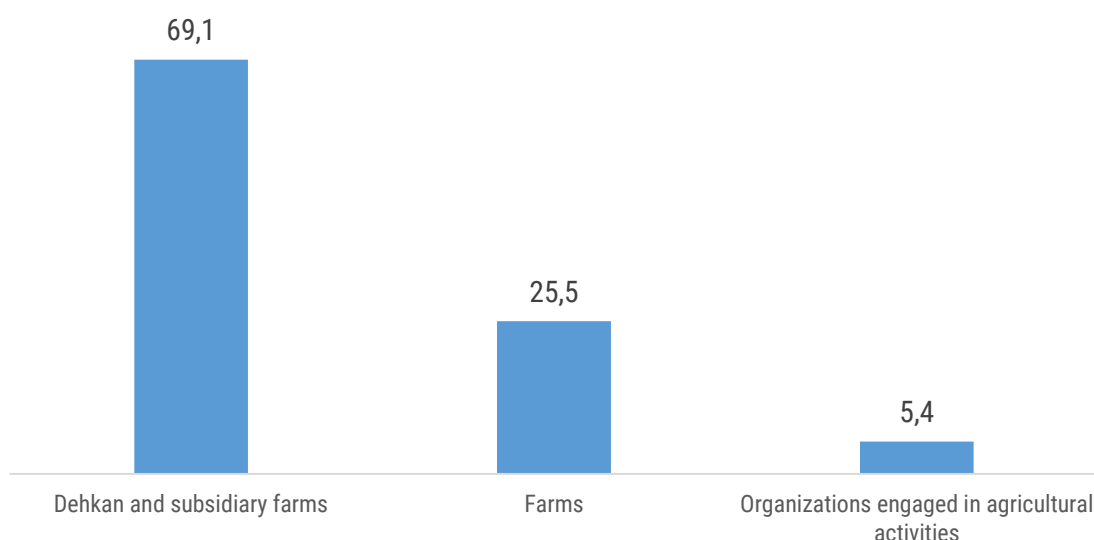
The volume of agricultural production in January–September 2025 amounted to **352 689.4** billion soums, or **104.0%** of the corresponding period in 2024, including crop production reaching **159 110.7** billion soums (**105.9%**), livestock production – **193 578.7** billion soums (**102.1%**).

Regionally, significant agricultural production volumes were recorded in Samarkand (**42 933.3** billion soums), Kashkadarya (**34 301.1** billion soums), Tashkent (**34 264.5** billion soums), and Fergana (**33 689.1** billion soums) regions.

Whereas lower volumes were observed in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**11 415.4** billion soums), Syrdarya (**11 453.1** billion soums), and Navoi (**16 633.7** billion soums) regions.

High growth rates were noted in Fergana (**107.0%**), Jizzakh (**105.9%**), Syrdarya (**105.6%**) and Tashkent (**104.9%**) regions, while low growth rates were observed in Andijan (**100.8%**), Kashkadarya (**101.9%**) and Surkhandarya (**102.1%**) regions.

Distribution of agricultural production by farm category (%)



An analysis by farm categories showed that **69.1%** of the total volume of agricultural output comes from dehkan and subsidiary farms, **25.5%** from farms, and **5.4%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Plant products

The volume of crop production in January–September 2025 amounted to **159 110.7** billion soums, or **105.9%** of the corresponding period in 2024.

In terms of regions, significant volumes of crop production were noted in Samarkand (**20 634.6** billion soums), Fergana (**19 280.9** billion soums), Andijan (**18 621.4** billion soums), Tashkent (**14 925.8** billion soums) and Surkhandarya (**14 780.5** billion soums) regions, while insignificant volumes of production were noted in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**4 329.2** billion soums), Navoi (**4 762.5** billion soums), Syrdarya (**5 812.7** billion soums) and Jizzakh (**8 310.5** billion soums) regions.

High growth rates were observed in Jizzakh (**113.3%**), Fergana (**110.0%**), Khorezm (**109.9%**), Syrdarya (**109.3%**), Bukhara (**108.3%**), and Navoi (**107.8%**) regions. In contrast, low growth rates were observed in Andijan (**100.2%**), Surkhandarya (**101.9%**), Kashkadarya (**101.9%**), and Namangan (**103.8%**) regions.

In January–September 2025, all categories of farms produced **8 406.9** thousand tons of grain (an increase of **11.2%** compared to January–September 2024), **3 056.5** thousand tons of potatoes (an increase of **0.1%**), **9 850.8** thousand tons of vegetables (an increase of **0.1%**), **2 133.7** thousand tons of melons (an increase of **15.4%**), **2 558.6** thousand tons of fruits and berries (an increase of **4.3%**), and **1 468.5** thousand tons of grapes (an increase of **7.7%**).

An analysis of data on grain crop production by farm category in January–September 2025 showed that 75.5% of the total volume was produced by farms, 13.7% by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and 10.8% by organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Accordingly, from the total volume of potato production, farms account for **22.2%**, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **76.0%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **1.8%**, accordingly, farms account for **27.0%** of the total volume of vegetable production, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **69.6%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **3.4%**, and from the total volume of melon production, farms account for **39.0%**, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **56.0%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **5.0%**, accordingly, farms account for **44.9%** of the total volume of fruit and berry production, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **51.6%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **3.5%**, accordingly, farms account for **51.3%** of the total volume of production grapes, to dehkan and subsidiary farms - **45.8%**, to organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **2.9%**.

Livestock products

The volume of livestock production in January–September 2025 amounted to **193 578.7** billion soums, or **102.1%** of the corresponding period in 2024.

In terms of regions, significant volumes of livestock production were recorded in Samarkand (**22 298.7** billion soums), Kashkadarya (**22 215.0** billion soums), Tashkent (**19 338.7** billion soums), Bukhara (**18 344.0** billion soums), and Jizzakh (**15 472.1** billion soums) regions, while low production volumes were recorded in Syrdarya region (**5 640.4** billion soums), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**7 086.2** billion soums), and Navoi region (**11 871.2** billion soums).

High growth rates were observed in the Tashkent (**104.1%**), Namangan (**103.5%**), Fergana (**102.7%**), and Navoi (**102.5%**) regions. In contrast, insignificant growth rates were noted in the Bukhara (**101.1%**), Khorezm (**101.3%**), and Samarkand (**101.4%**) regions.

In January–September 2025, all categories of farms produced **2 169.6** thousand tons of live weight meat, **9 002.4** thousand tons of milk, **6 723.8** million eggs, sheared **33 342** tons of wool, received **1 163.1** thousand pieces of karakul skins and caught **98.5** thousand tons of fish.

During the reporting period, the volume of meat produced in live weight amounted to **102.7%** compared to the same period in 2024, milk - **100.5%**, eggs - **106.2%**, sheared wool - **102.6%**, received karakul skins - **103.4%**, caught fish - **109.3%**.

Analyzing data on meat production by farm category in January–September 2025, it should be noted that farms account for **6.3%** of total meat production, dehkan and subsidiary farms account for **85.2%**, and organizations engaged in agricultural activities account for **8.5%**.

Accordingly, **6.6%** of the total milk production comes from farms, **91.7%** from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **1.7%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In addition, **16.4%** of the total volume of eggs received came from farms, **53.5%** from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **30.1%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Also, of the total volume of sheared wool, **12.4%** came from farms, **81.1%** from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **6.5%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In addition, **11.7%** of the total volume of karakul skins comes from farms, **77.9%** from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **10.4%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In turn, **51.6%** of the total volume of fish caught comes from farms, **5.7%** from dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **42.7%** from organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

IV. Livestock and poultry population

Across all farm categories, as of October 1, 2025, the number of cattle reached **14 281.3** thousand heads (an increase of **1.1%** compared to October 1, 2024), cows reached **5 049.7** thousand heads (an increase of **0.4%**), sheep and goats reached **24 811.2** thousand heads (an increase of **1.6%**), horses reached **287.7** thousand heads (an increase of **3.2%**), and poultry reached **110 794.2** thousand heads (an increase of **8.7%**).

Analyzing data on cattle numbers by farm category as of October 1, 2025, it should be noted that **7.4%** of cattle are owned by farms, **90.5%** by dehkan and subsidiary farms, and **2.1%** by organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Accordingly, farms account for **8.5%** of the total number of cows, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **89.4%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **2.1%**, accordingly, farms account for **15.7%** of the total number of sheep and goats, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **76.7%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **7.6%**, accordingly, farms account for **24.8%** of the total number of horses, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **68.1%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **7.1%**, and farms account for **16.8%** of the total number of birds, dehkan and subsidiary farms - **46.5%**, organizations engaged in agricultural activities - **36.7%**.

V. Methodological notes and metadata on agriculture, forestry and fisheries

Gross output of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries is the value of products produced for own consumption and sale in the industry, as well as the total cost of services, formed on the basis of the value of gross output (services) of crop and livestock production, hunting, forestry and timber harvesting, in the fisheries and aquaculture industry.

Agricultural output is a general indicator of the volume of agricultural production and is defined as the sum of the value of crop and livestock products produced in the reporting period in farms, dehkan and subsidiary farms and organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

A farm is a business entity engaged in the production of agricultural products and other types of activities not prohibited by law, using land plots provided for lease.

A dehkan farm is a farm that grows and sells agricultural products based on the personal labor of members of the dehkan farm on a plot of land provided to the head of the dehkan farm on the right of lifelong inheritable possession or lease (sublease).

A subsidiary farm is a labor activity associated with the cultivation (processing) of agricultural products intended both for free trade and for the needs of the family on personal household plots.

Organizations carrying out agricultural activities are large agricultural organizations, microfirms and small enterprises carrying out agricultural activities with the formation of a legal entity, as well as non-agricultural organizations that have a subsidiary farm.

The livestock population includes the population of all age groups for the main types of livestock (cattle, including cows, sheep and goats, pigs, etc.) by farm category.

Meat production includes the live weight of all types of farm animals and birds, both sold for slaughter and slaughtered on the farm.

Milk production is determined by the actual milk yield of cows, goats, sheep, mare and camels, including milk yield and colostrum used to feed young animals. Milk sucked by calves is not included in gross production.

Egg production includes the number of eggs produced from all bird species, as well as eggs used to hatch chicks from hens or in an incubator.
