

Demographic situation in the Republic of Uzbekistan

for January-June 2025

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I. Main demographic indicators

The permanent population of the Republic of Uzbekistan as of July 1, 2025 amounted to **37 859.7** thousand people, which, compared to the same period in 2024, gave an increase of **2.0** %. In January-June 2025, the number of live births amounted to **405.5** thousand people, deaths - **84.1** thousand people, the natural increase reached **321.4** thousand people. The number of people arriving from foreign countries is **673** people, and the number of people leaving for foreign countries is **5 551** people. **95.3** thousand marriages and **23.3** thousand divorces were registered.

II. Number of permanent population

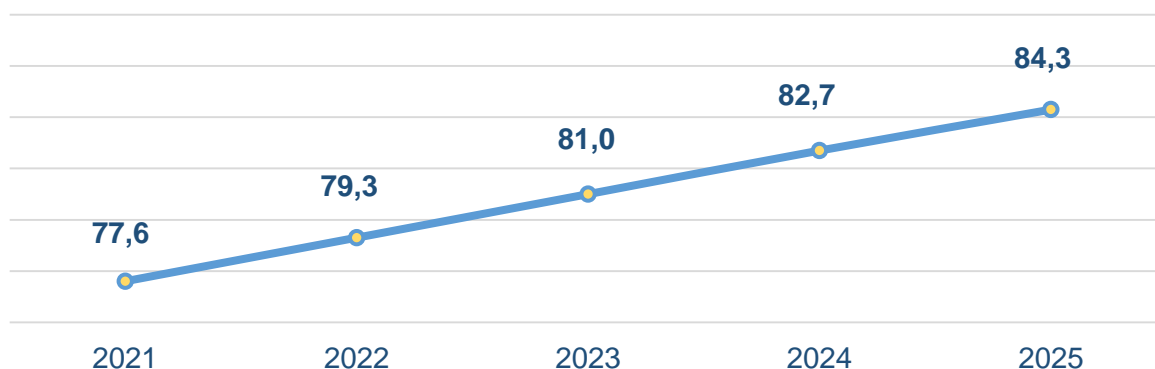
The permanent population of the Republic of Uzbekistan as of July 1, 2025 amounted to **37 859.7** thousand people, having increased by **725.5** thousand people, or **2.0** %, compared to the same period last year. According to the place of permanent residence, **19 296.4** thousand people (**51.0** % of the total population) were recorded in urban areas, and **18 563.3** thousand people (**49.0** %) in rural areas. The number of women is **18 793.9** thousand people (**49.6** %), and men – **19 065.8** thousand people (**50.4** %).

As of July 1, 2025, the population density in the country was **84.3** people per square kilometer. This is **1.6** people more than in the same period in 2024 (**82.7** people per square kilometer as of July 1, 2024).

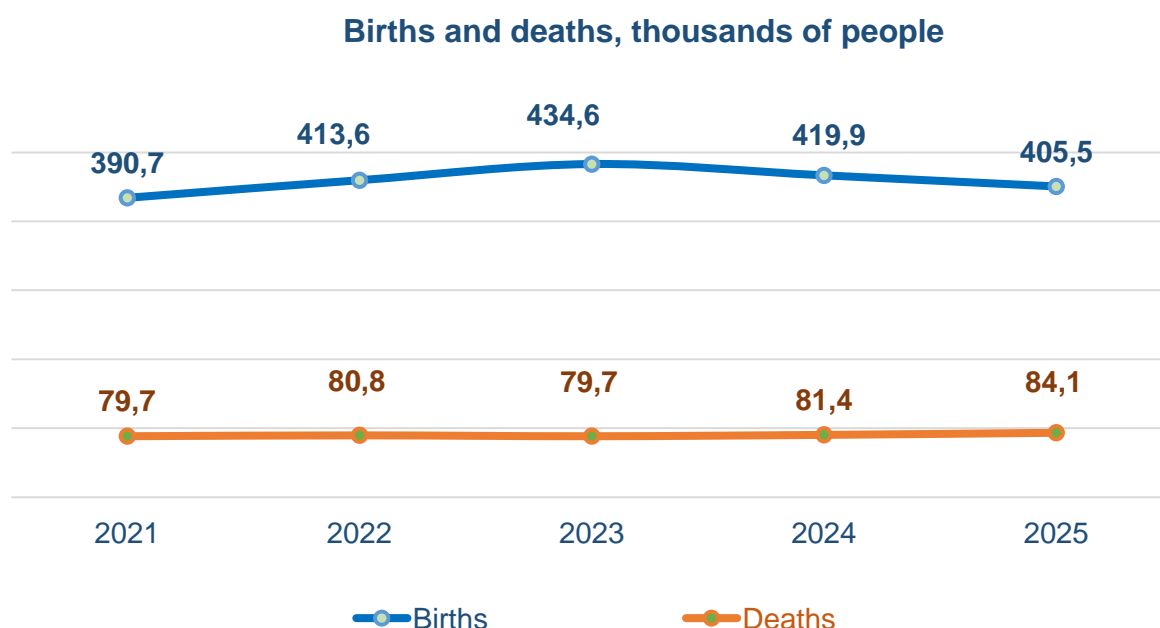

III. Births and deaths

The number of live births in January-June 2025 was **405.5** thousand people, and the birth rate per thousand people was **21.7** per thousand. Compared with the same period in 2024, the number of births in January-June of this year decreased by **14.4** thousand people.

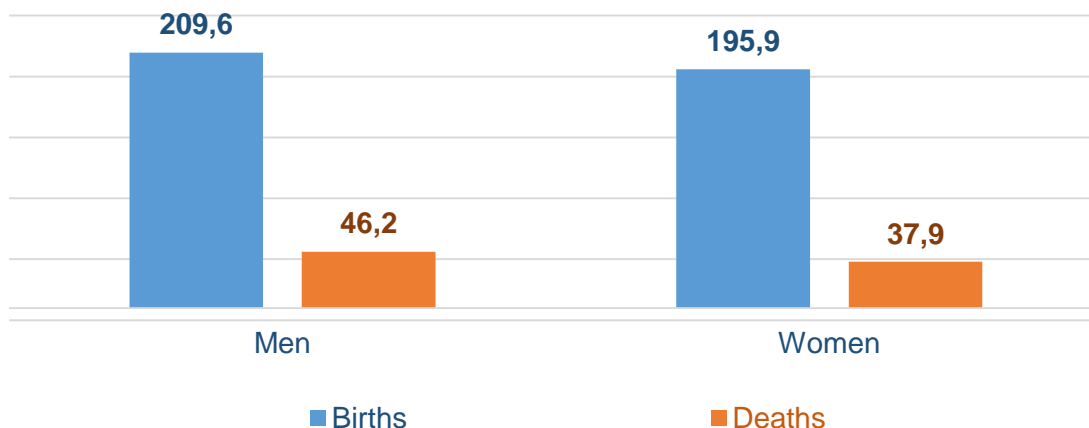
The number of registered deaths in January-June 2025 was **84.1** thousand people, and the death rate per thousand people was **4.5** per thousand. Compared with the same period in 2024, the number of deaths in January-June of this year increased by **2.7** thousand people.



The total number of live births in the republic during the period under review was **405.5** thousand people, of which **209.6** thousand were boys (**51.7** % of the total number of births), and **195.9** thousand were girls (**48.3** %), of which **197.8** thousand were in urban areas (**48.8** % of the total number of births), and **207.7** thousand were in rural areas (**51.2** %).

The total number of deaths in the republic during the period under review was **84.1** thousand people, including **46.2** thousand men (**54.9** % of the total number of deaths), **37.9** thousand women (**45.1** %), of which **45.6** thousand people (**54.2** % of the total number of deaths) were in urban areas and **38.5** thousand people (**45.8** %) were in rural areas.

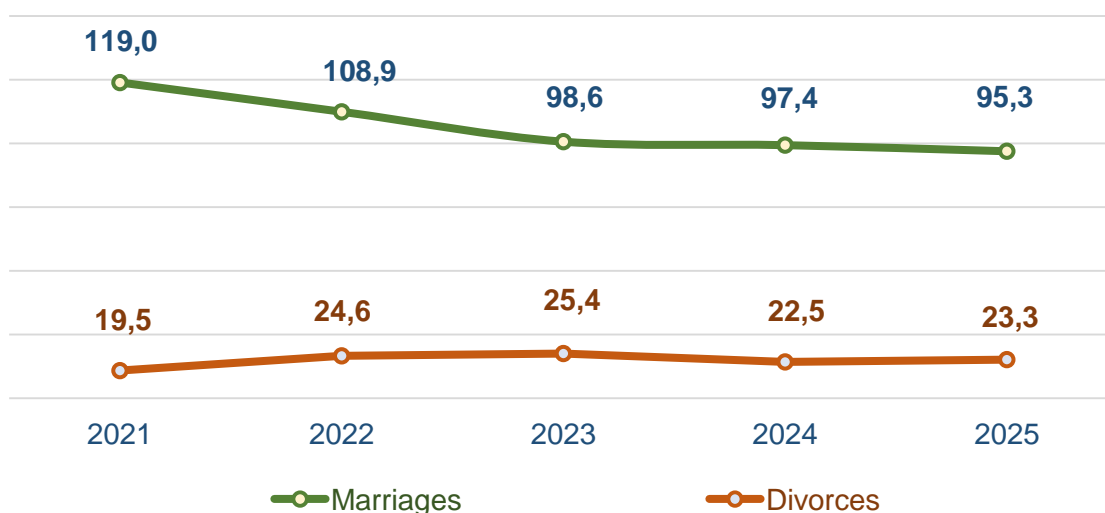

IV. Marriages and divorces

The number of registered marriages in January-June 2025 was **95.3** thousand, and the marriage rate per thousand population was **5.1** per thousand. The number of marriages in January-March of this year, compared with the same period in 2024, decreased by **2.1** thousand.

The number of divorces in January-June 2025 was **23.3** thousand, while the divorce rate per thousand population was **1.2** per mille. The number of divorces in January-June of the current year, compared to the same period in 2024, increased by **0.8** thousand units.

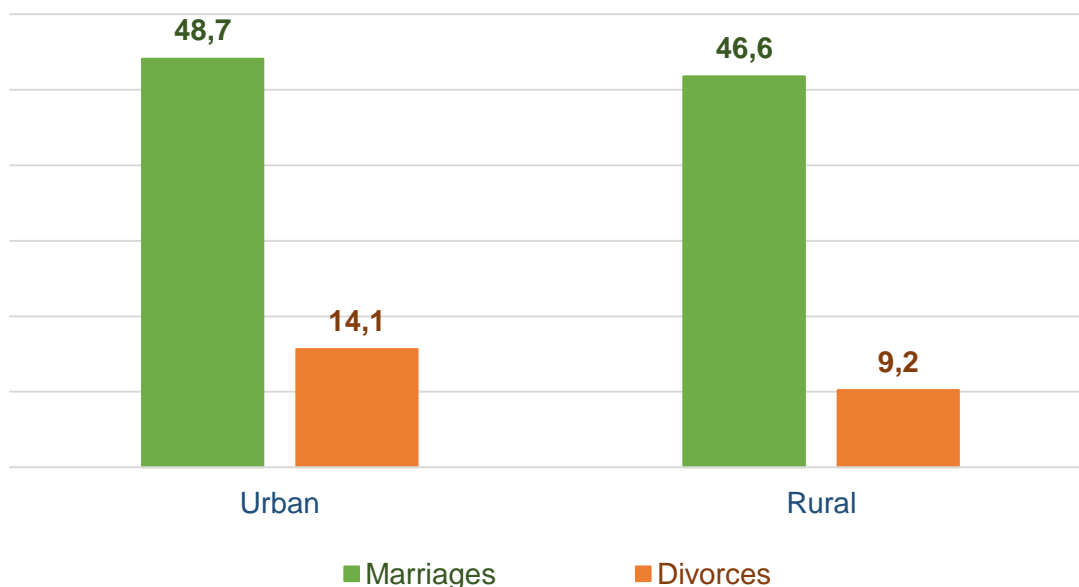
Marriages and divorces, thousands



The number of registered marriages amounted to **95.3** thousand, of which **48.7** thousand (**51.1 %**) were in urban areas and **46.6** thousand (**48.9 %**) in rural areas.

The number of divorces was **23.3** thousand, of which **14.1** thousand (**60.6 %**) were in urban areas and **9.2** thousand (**39.4 %**) in rural areas.

V. Population migration

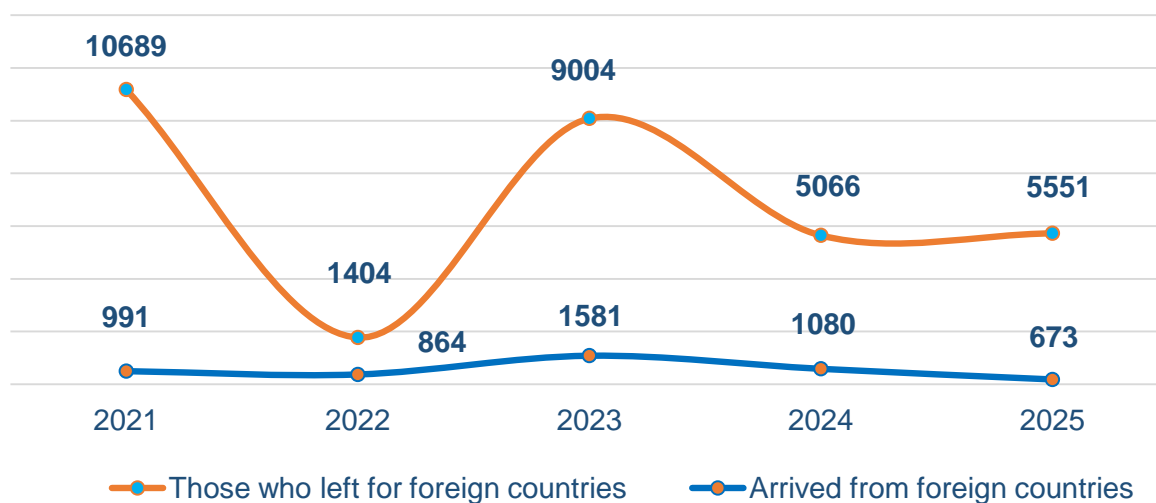
In January-June 2025, the total number of people arriving in the country was **127 759** people, including **127 086** people who arrived from other regions of the republic, and **673** people from abroad.

The total number of people who left reached **132 637**, including **127 086** people who left for other regions of the republic, and **5 551** people who left for foreign countries.

VI. Methodological explanations and metadata of demographic indicators

In order to form **demographic indicators**, the National Statistics Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan integrated the primary database of these organizations through electronic data exchange.

Due to the fact that all the necessary data for the formation of demographic indicators are obtained electronically through integration, a separate form of statistical observation has not been approved.

In order to generate data characterizing demographic indicators, statistical authorities process primary data on natural movement and migration of the population received from other government agencies (from the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan).

Statistics of demographic indicators are formed on the basis of the following data:

- birth certificate records;
- death certificate records;
- marriage certificate records;
- records of the act of divorce;
- statistical registration coupon to the arrival sheet;
- statistical accounting coupon for the departure sheet.
