



## Demographic situation in the Republic of Uzbekistan

for January-September 2025

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### I. Main demographic indicators

The permanent population of the Republic of Uzbekistan as of October 1, 2025 amounted to **38 069.1** thousand people, which, compared with the same period in 2024, gave an increase of **1.9%**. In January-September 2025, the number of live births amounted to **664.6** thousand people, deaths **132.2** thousand people, the natural increase reached **532.4** thousand people. The number of arrivals from foreign countries is **1 133**, and the number of departures to foreign countries is **7 585. 177.0** thousand marriages and **35.4** thousand divorces were registered.

## II. The number of permanent population

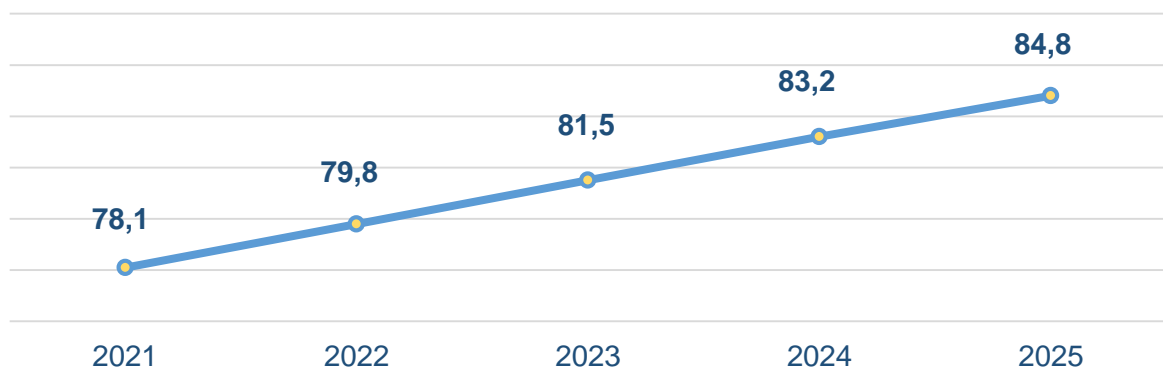
The permanent population of the Republic of Uzbekistan as of October 1, 2025 amounted to **38 069.1** thousand people, having increased by **713.7** thousand people, or **1.9%**, compared to the same period last year. According to the place of permanent residence, **19 396.3** thousand people (**51.0%** of the total population) were recorded in urban areas, and **18 672.8** thousand people (**49.0%**) in rural areas. The number of women is **18 896.6** thousand people (**49.6%**), and men - **19 172.5** thousand people (**50.4%**).

As of October 1, 2025, the population density in the country was **84.8** people per square kilometer. This is **1.6** people more than the same period in 2024 (**83.2** people per square kilometer as of October 1, 2024).

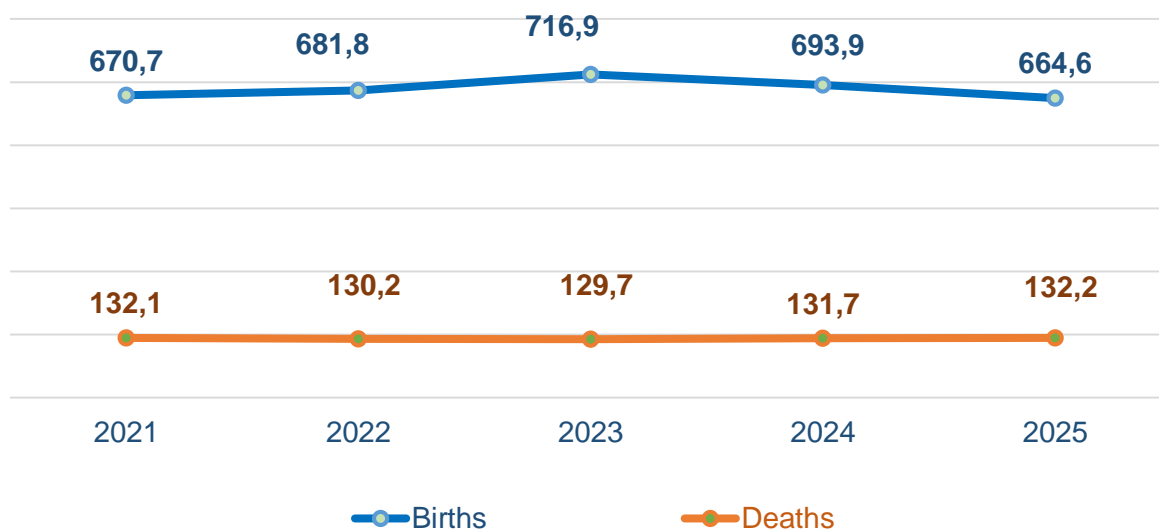

### III. Births and deaths

The number of live births in January-September 2025 was **664.6** thousand people, and the birth rate per thousand people was **23.5** per mille. Compared with the same period in 2024, the number of births in January-September of this year decreased by **29.3** thousand people.

The number of registered deaths in January-September 2025 was **132.2** thousand people, and the death rate per thousand people was **4.7** per mille. Compared with the same period in 2024, the number of deaths in January-September of this year increased by **0.5** thousand people.

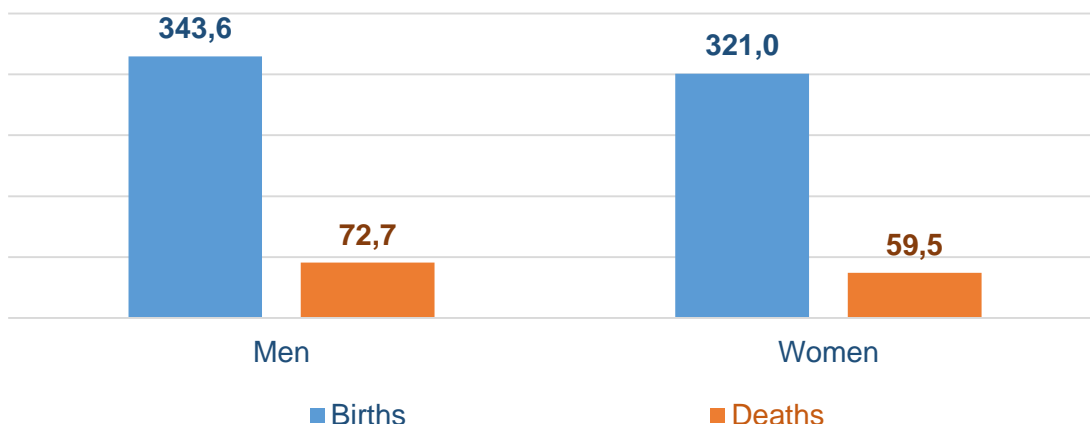
**Births and deaths, thousands of people**



The total number of live births in the republic during the period under review was **664.6** thousand people, of which **343.6** thousand were boys (**51.7%** of the total number of births), and **321.0** thousand were girls (**48.3%**), of which **319.3** thousand were in urban areas (**48.0%** of the total number of births), and **345.3** thousand were in rural areas (**52.0%**).

The total number of deaths in the republic during the period under review was **132.2** thousand people, including **72.7** thousand men (**55.0%** of the total number of deaths), **59.5** thousand women (**45.0%**), of which **71.8** thousand people (**54.3%** of the total number of deaths) were in urban areas and **60.4** thousand people (**45.7%**) were in rural areas.

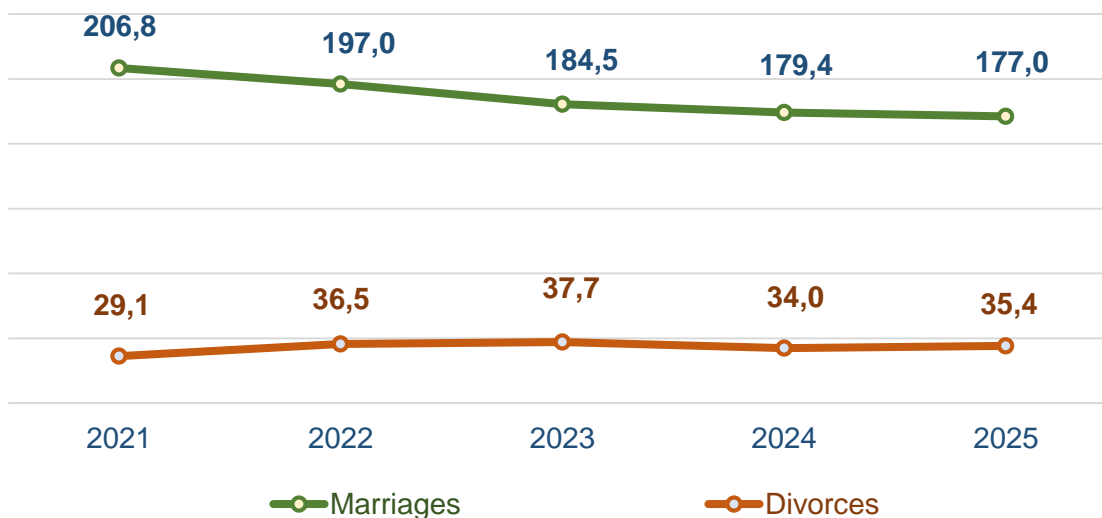

#### IV. Marriages and divorces

The number of registered marriages in January-September 2025 was **177.0** thousand and the marriage rate per thousand population was **6.3** per mille. The number of marriages in January-September of this year, compared with the same period in 2024, decreased by **2.4** thousand.

The number of divorces in January-September 2025 was **35.4** thousand, with the divorce rate per thousand population was **1.3** per mille. The number of divorces in January-September of this year increased by **1.4** thousand compared to the same period in 2024.

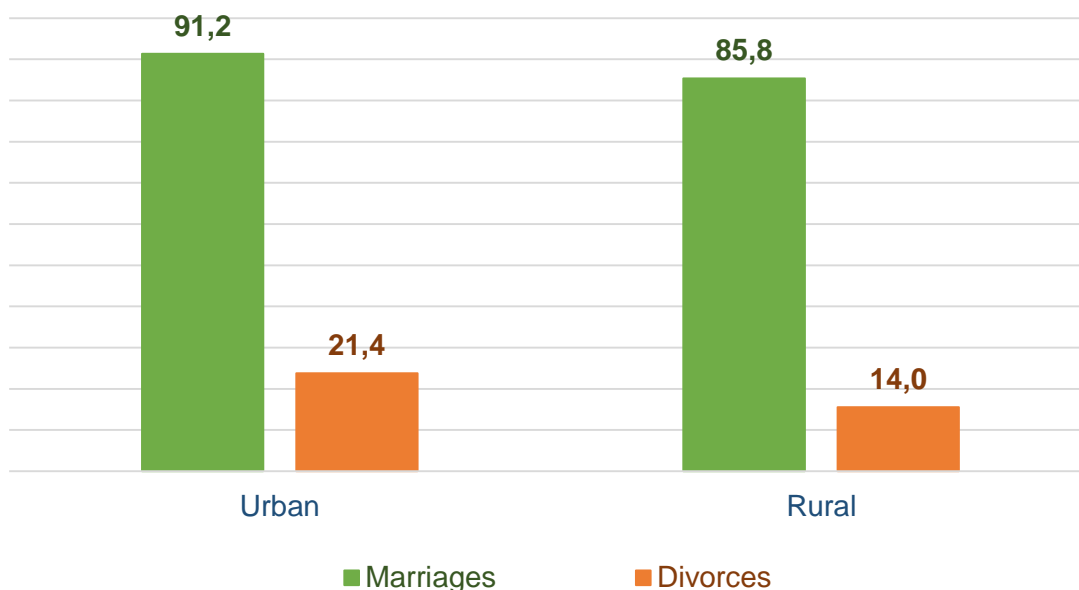
#### Marriages and divorces, thousand



The number of registered marriages amounted to **177.0** thousand, of which **91.2** thousand (**51.5%**) were in urban areas and **85.8** thousand (**48.5%**) in rural areas.

The number of divorces was **35.4** thousand, of which **21.4** thousand (**60.4%**) were in urban areas and **14.0** thousand (**39.6%**) in rural areas.

#### V. Population migration

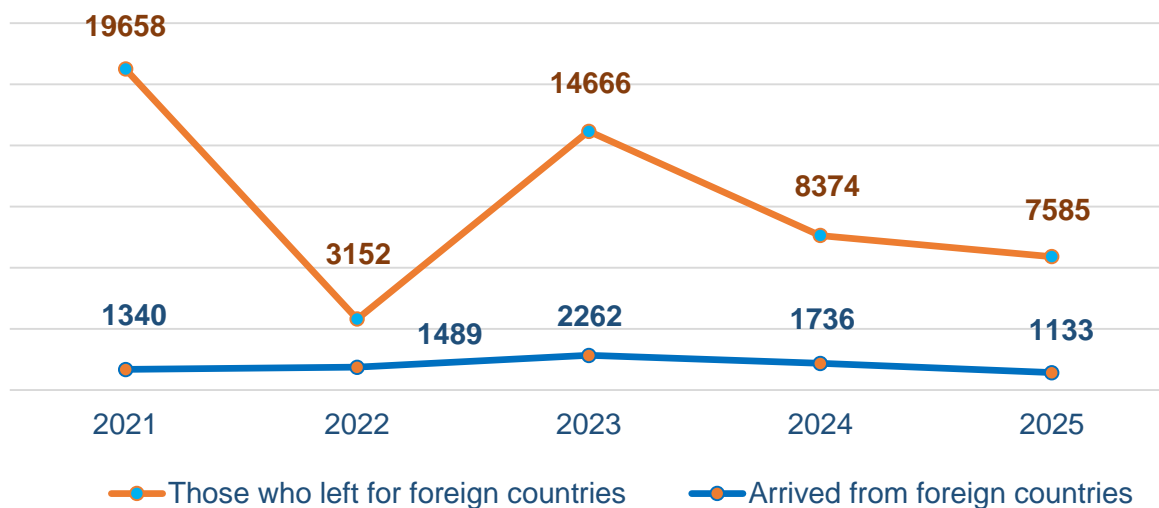
In January-September 2025, the total number of people arriving in the country amounted to **211 300** people, including **210 167** people who arrived from other regions of the republic, and **1 133** people from abroad.

The total number of people who left reached **217 752**, including **210 167** people who left to other regions of the republic, and **7 585** people who left for foreign countries.

## VI. Methodological explanations and metadata of demographic indicators

In order to generate **demographic indicators**, the National Statistics Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan integrated the primary database of these organizations through electronic data exchange.

Due to the fact that all the necessary data for the formation of demographic indicators are obtained electronically through integration, a separate form of statistical observation has not been approved.

In order to generate data characterizing demographic indicators, statistical authorities process primary data on natural movement and migration of the population received from other government agencies (from the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan).

Statistics of demographic indicators are formed on the basis of the following data:

- birth certificate records;
- death certificate records;
- marriage certificate records;
- records of the act of divorce;
- statistical registration coupon to the arrival sheet;
- statistical accounting coupon for the departure sheet.
