Preliminary data for January-July 2025

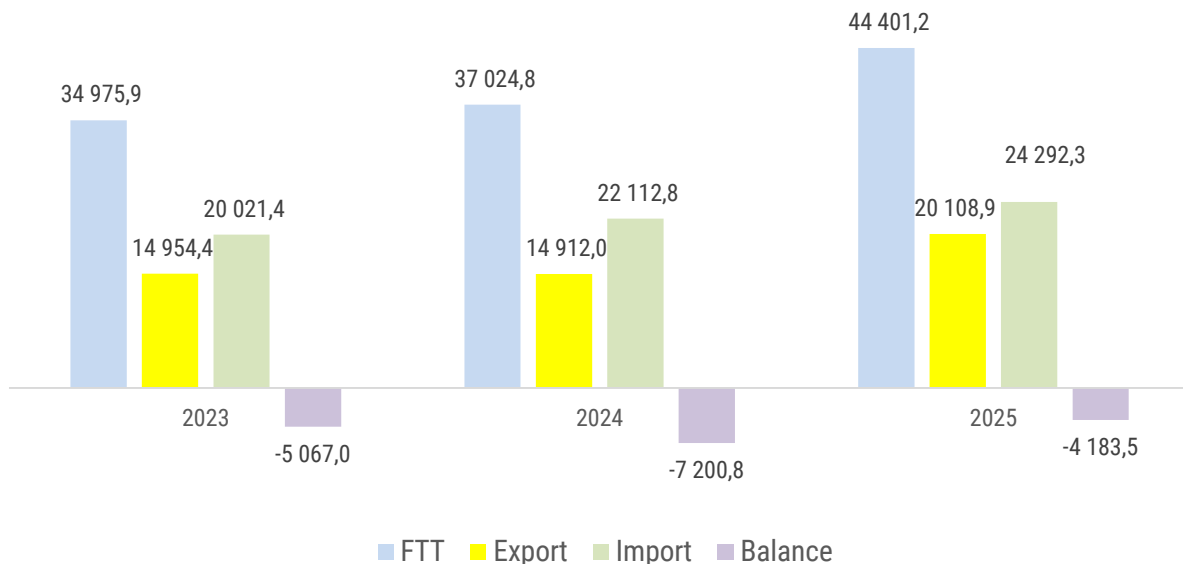
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I. FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER

In January-July 2025, the country's foreign trade turnover (FTT) amounted to **44,4** billion US dollars and increased, compared to the same period in 2024, by **7 376,4** million US dollars, or **19,9** %.

Foreign trade turnover

Of the total WTO volume, exports amounted to **20 108,9** million US dollars (an increase of **34,9** % compared to January-July 2024), and imports reached **24 292,3** million US dollars (an increase of **9,9** % compared to January-July 2024). As a result, the balance of foreign trade turnover was negative in the amount of **- 4 183,5** million US dollars.

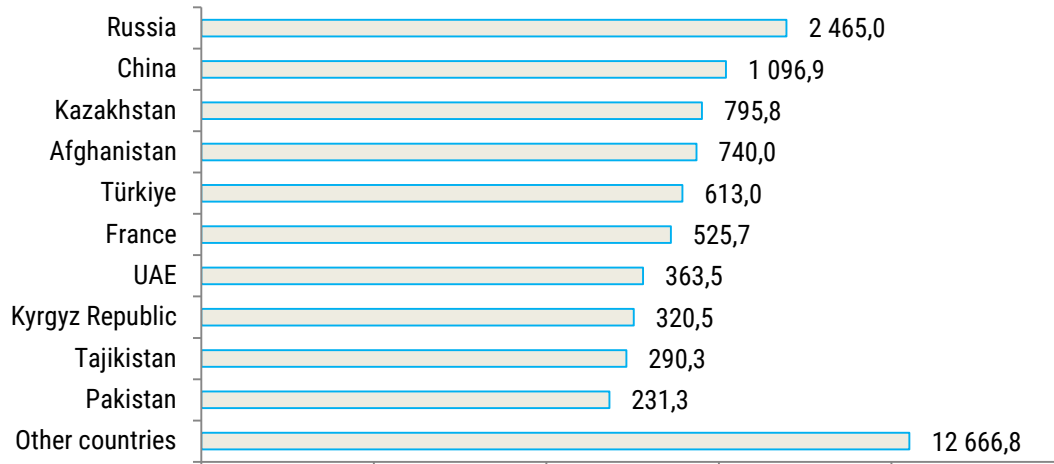

In the export structure, goods account for **75,9 %**, of which industrial goods – **11,1 %**, food products and live animals – **7,5 %**, chemicals and similar products – **5,8 %**, various finished products – **4,4 %**.

Our main partners in the export of goods and services in foreign trade turnover in January-July 2025 were such countries as Russia (**12,3 %**), China (**5,5 %**), Kazakhstan (**4,0 %**), Afghanistan (**3,7 %**), Türkiye (**3,0 %**), France (**2,6 %**), the UAE (**1,8 %**), the Kyrgyz Republic (**1,6 %**), Tajikistan (**1,4 %**), and Pakistan (**1,2 %**). Their share in the total export volume reached **37,0 %**.

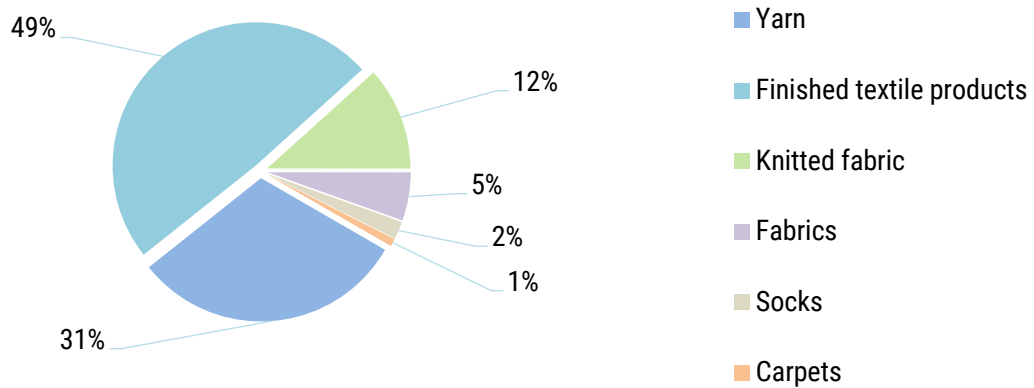
In January-July 2025, 1 277,7 thousand tons of fruit and vegetable products were exported, and, compared to the same period in 2024, this figure increased by **5,2 %**, or **62,9** thousand tons.

The volume of fruit and vegetable exports in the period under review reached **1 066,8** million US dollars (the growth rate, compared to the same period in 2024, was **35,2** %). In the total volume, exports amounted to **5,3** %.

Share of textile exports

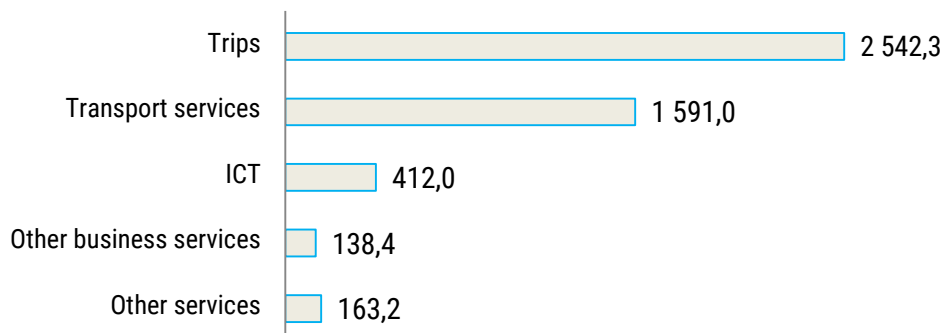


According to the results of January-July 2025, textile exports amounted to **1 471,0** million US dollars, which amounted to **7,3** % of its total volume and, compared to the same period in 2024, it decreased by **17,1** %.

In the structure of textile exports, the main share is occupied by finished textile products (**49,0** %), as well as yarn (**31,0** %).

Export of services

The volume of services exports for January-July 2025 amounted to 4 846,9 million US dollars, or **24,1** % of the total volume of trade exports and increased by **30,2** % compared to the same period in 2024. The main share of services exports is occupied by travel (tourism) (**52,5** %), transport services (**32,8** %), telecommunications, computer and information services (**8,5** %), other business services (**2,9** %).

In the composition of exports of other services (**3,3** %), the largest share belongs to insurance and pension (**1,1** %), as well as financial (**0,9** %) services.

III. IMPORT VOLUME

During this period, imports amounted to **24 292,3** million US dollars (an increase in growth rates, compared to January-July 2024, of **9,9 %**). The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (**33,3 %**), industrial goods (**16,0 %**), as well as chemicals and similar products (**12,8 %**).

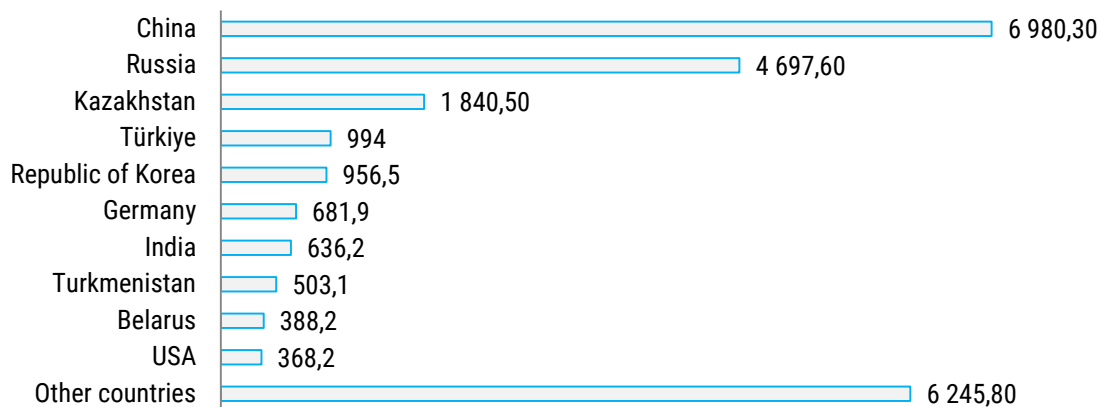

An analysis of the dynamics of imports of goods showed that in January-July 2025, compared with the same period in 2024, the volume of imports of goods increased by **1 569,2** million US dollars and amounted to **21 778,8** million US dollars, and imports of services reached **2 513,5** million US dollars.

In general, goods and services from **163** countries were imported to Uzbekistan in January-July 2025. More than **2/3** of imports come from such large partner countries as China (**28,7 %**), Russia (**19,3 %**), Kazakhstan (**7,6 %**), Türkiye (**4,1 %**), the Republic of Korea (**3,9 %**), Germany (**2,8 %**) and India (**2,6 %**).

Structure of imported goods by sections of SITC (for January-July 2025)

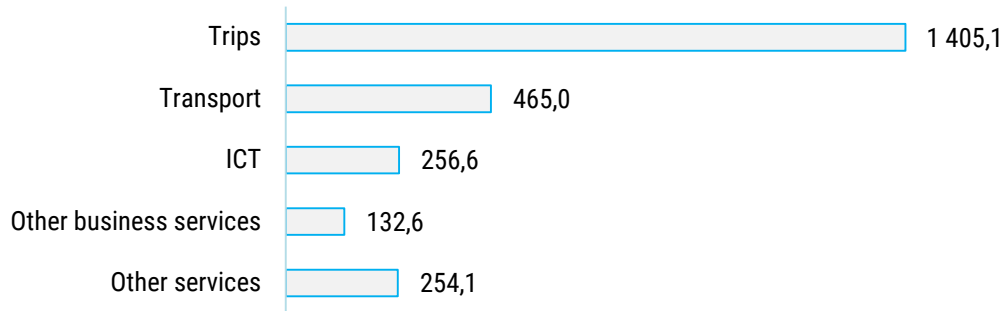

The volume of imports of services for January-July 2025 amounted to **2 513,5** million US dollars, or **10,3** % of the total volume and increased by **32,1** % compared to the same period in 2024.

The main share of imports of services is made up of travel (tourism **55,9 %**), transport services (**18,5 %**), telecommunications, computer and information services (**10,2 %**), as well as other business services (**5,3 %**) and others (**10,1 %**).

IV. METADATA

In forming statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, along with the CN FEA, the International Standard Trade Classification of the United Nations (ISTC) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods into 10 large sections. Assignment of SITC codes to goods is carried out using transition keys between the CN FEA and SITC.

Foreign trade statistics are formed on the basis of data on foreign trade in goods and services: the initial data for the formation of statistics on foreign trade in goods are data from cargo customs declarations of the Customs Committee and statistical observations of the National Statistics Committee on goods moved from residents to non-residents that do not cross the state border and are not included in the customs declaration; the formation of statistics on foreign trade services is carried out on the basis of statistical observations.
