

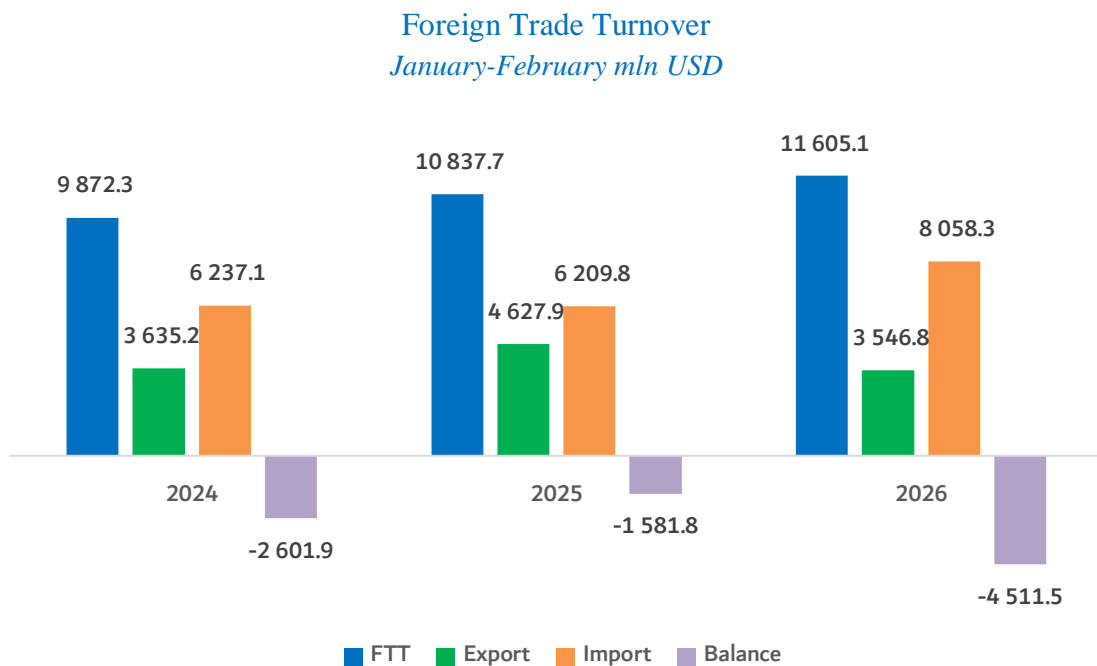
Foreign Trade Turnover

Preliminary data for January-February 2026

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I. Foreign Trade Turnover

In January-February 2026, the foreign trade turnover (FTT) of the country amounted to 11,6 bln USD and increased compared to the same period of 2025 by 767,4 mln USD, or by 7,1 %.



Of the total foreign trade turnover, exports amounted to 3 546,8 mln USD (a decrease of 23,4% compared to January-February 2025), while imports reached 8 058,3 mln USD (an increase of 29,8% compared to January-February 2025). As a result, a negative trade balance of 4 511,5 mln USD was observed.

The decrease in exports for January-February 2026 was due to a reduction in the volume of special exports.

At the same time, exports of goods, excluding special exports, demonstrated steady growth and amounted to 2 097,7 mln USD, an increase of 24,0% compared to the same period of the previous year.

The Republic of Uzbekistan maintains trade relations with more than 160 countries worldwide. The highest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with China (27,5 %), Russia (18,3 %), Kazakhstan (7,2 %), Türkiye (3,6 %) and the Republic of Korea (2,7 %).

In the structure of exports, goods account for 59,1 %, including manufactured goods — 18,1%, food products and live animals — 9,9 %, chemicals and related products — 9,6 %, miscellaneous manufactured articles — 8,5 %.

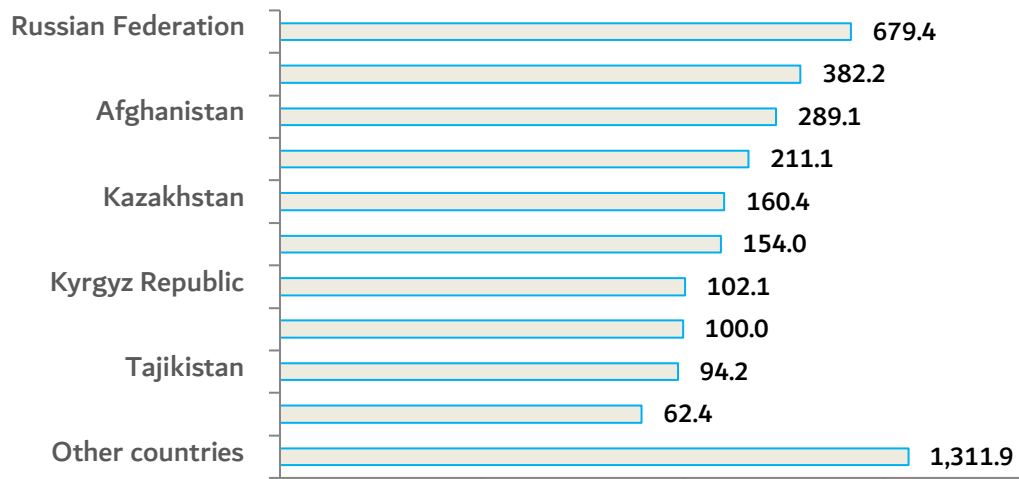

The main partners of Uzbekistan in the export of goods and services in foreign trade turnover in January-February 2026 were countries such as Russia (19,2 %), China (10,8 %), Afghanistan (8,2 %), France (6,0 %), Kazakhstan (4,5 %), Türkiye (4,3 %), Kyrgyz Republic (2,9 %), UAE (2,8 %) and Tajikistan (2,7 %). Their share in total exports exceeded 60,0%.

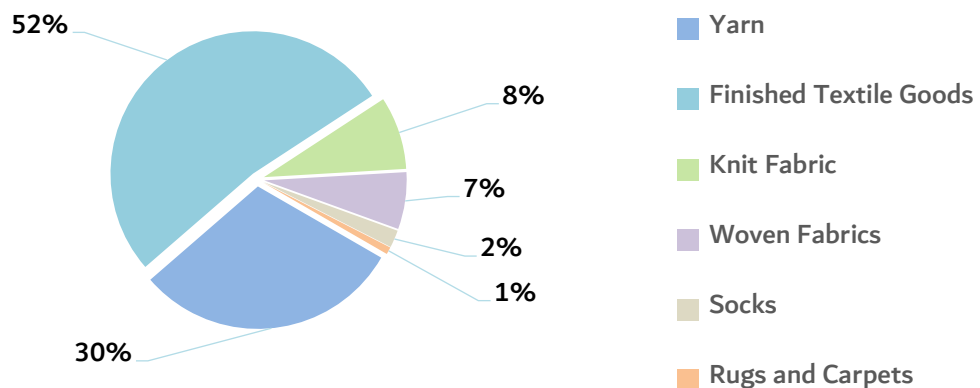
In January-February 2026, 219,9 thousand tons of fruit and vegetable products were exported, and compared to the same period of 2025, this figure increased by 14,0 %, or by 27,1 thousand tons.

In January-February 2026, exports of fruits and vegetables amounted to 207,3 mln US dollars. This figure increased by 18,4 % compared to the same period of 2025, and the share in total exports was 5,8 %.

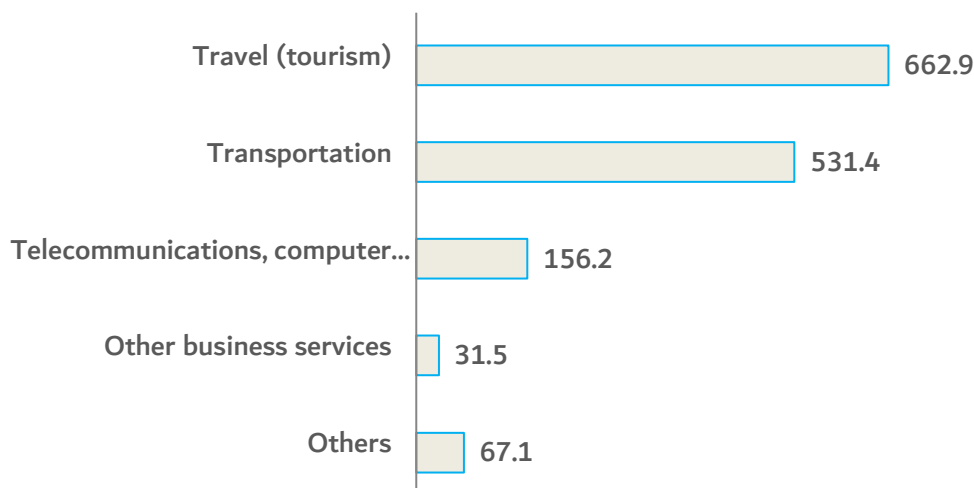
Share of Textile Products Exports



In January-February 2026, textile products were exported in the amount of 466,6 mln US dollars, accounting for 13,2 % of total exports, an increase of 15,5 % compared to the same period of 2025.

In the structure of textile exports, the main share is held by finished textile products (52,2 %), as well as yarn (30,3 %).

The volume of services exports in January-February 2026 consisted 1 449,1 mln US dollars, or 40,9 % of total exports and increased compared to the same period of 2025 by 25,1 %. In the structure of services exports, the main share is held by travel (tourism) (45,7 %), transport services (36,7 %), telecommunications, computer and information services (10,8 %), other business services (2,2 %).

III. Import Indicators

During this period, imports consisted 8 058,3 mln US dollars (compared to January-February 2025, imports increased by 29,8 %). The main share in its structure is held by machinery and transport equipment (36,1 %), manufactured goods (14,3 %), as well as chemicals and related products (11,9 %).

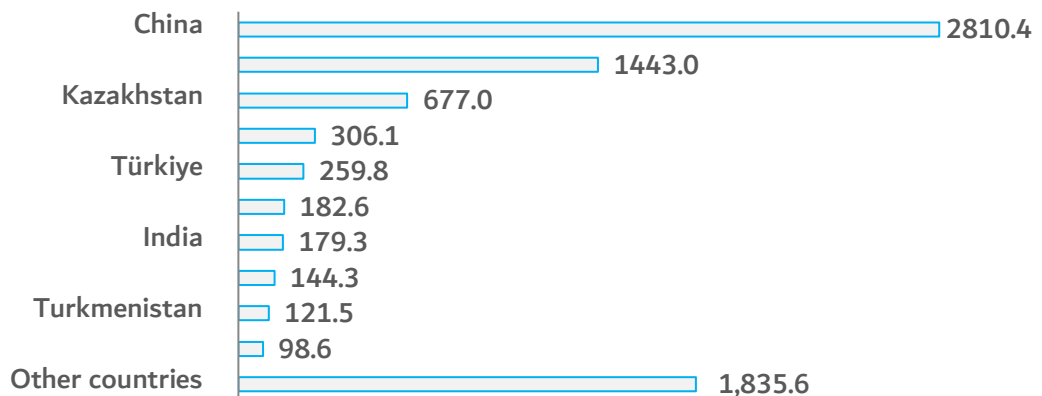
Analysis of import dynamics showed that in January-February 2026, compared to the same period of 2025, the volume of goods imports increased by 1 701,3 mln US dollars and amounted to 7 214,3 mln US dollars, while services imports reached 844,0 mln USD.

Overall, in January-February 2026, goods and services were imported into Uzbekistan from more than 135 countries. More than 70,0% of total imports came from major partner countries such as China (34,9 %), Russia (17,9 %), Kazakhstan (8,4 %), Republic of Korea (3,8 %), Türkiye (3,2 %), Germany (2,3 %) and India (2,2 %).

Structure of Imported Goods by SITC Sections for January-February 2026 year

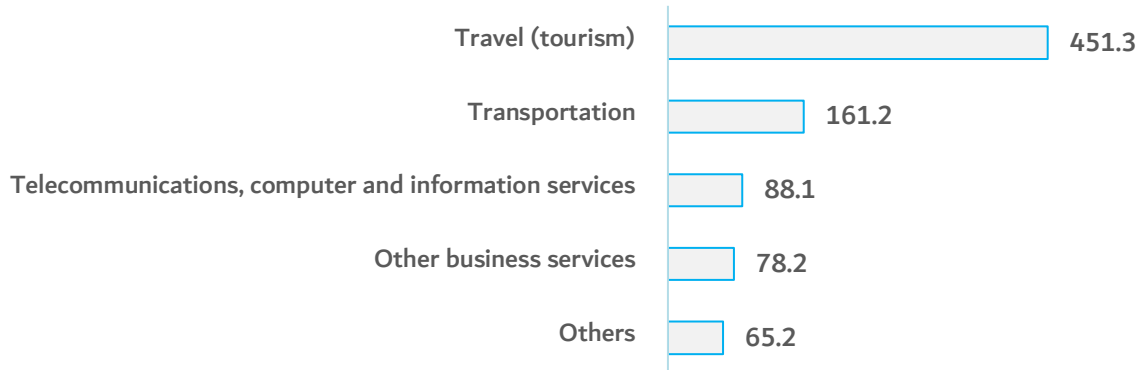

The volume of services imports for January-February 2026 amounted to 844,0 mln USD, or 10,5 % of its total volume and increased compared to the same period of 2025 by 21,1%.

In the structure of services imports, the main share is held by travel (tourism) (53,5 %), transport services (19,1 %), telecommunications, computer and information services (10,4 %), and other business services (9,3 %).

IV. Metadata

In compiling statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, along with the HS (Harmonized System), the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods into 10 major sections. SITC codes are assigned to goods using concordance keys between the HS and SITC.

Foreign trade statistics are compiled based on data on foreign trade in goods and services: the source data for compiling foreign trade statistics on goods are data from cargo customs declarations of the Customs Committee and statistical surveys of the National Statistics Committee on goods transferred from residents to non-residents that do not cross the state border and are not included in customs declarations; foreign trade services statistics are compiled based on statistical surveys.

In certain cases, minor discrepancies between the total and the sum of components are due to rounding of data.
