### I. Volume of completed construction work - total

In January-July 2026, the volume of construction work performed in Uzbekistan amounted to 227 446.6 billion soums. Compared to January-July 2025, the growth rate was 112.9%.

Figure 1. Volume and growth rates of completed construction work

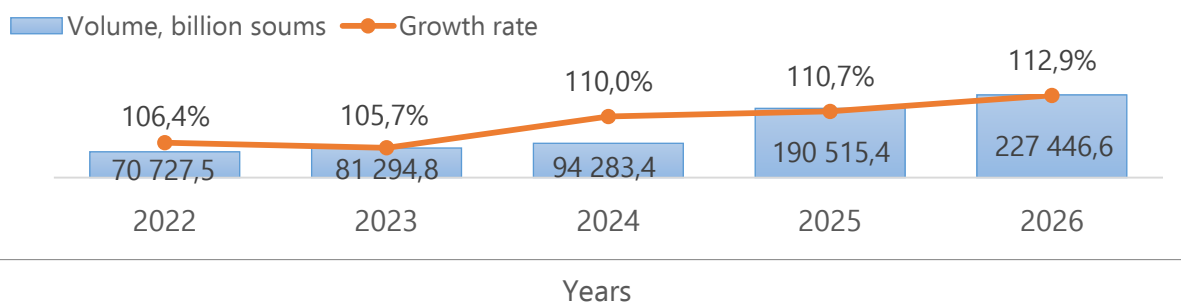

## II. Construction works by type of economic activity

In January-July 2026, construction work in Uzbekistan by type of economic activity was distributed as follows:

- the share of construction of buildings and structures in the total volume of construction work amounted to 68.3% and the growth rate compared to January-July 2025 was 106.8%.
- the share of civil engineering construction compared to January-July 2025 was 19.7% and the growth rate was 122.3%.
- the share of specialized construction work was 11.8%, which is 141.2% compared to January-July 2025.

Figure 2. Construction works by type of economic activity, January-July 2026

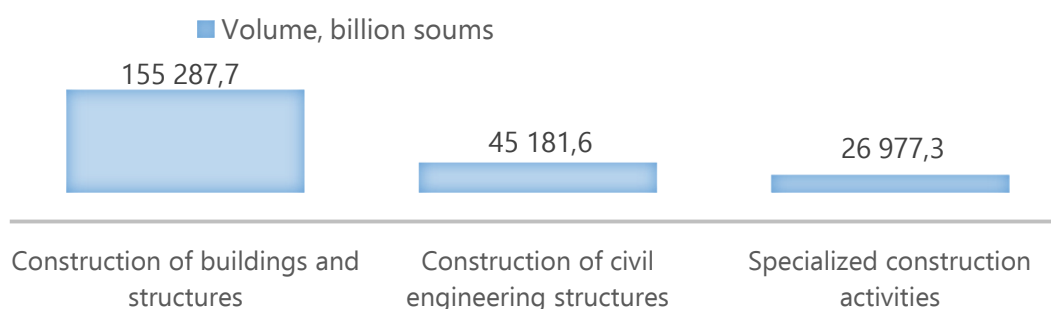

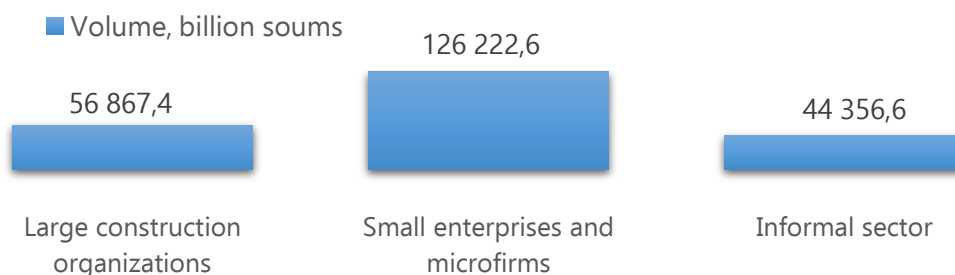

### III. Distribution of construction work volumes by type of enterprise

Figure 3. Volume of construction work by type of enterprise, January-July 2026



In January-July 2026, the volume of construction work performed by large construction organizations in current prices amounted to 56 867.4 billion soums. Their share in the total volume was 25.0% and the growth rate compared to January-July 2025 was 116.3%.

Small enterprises and micro-firms accounted for 55.5% of the total volume of construction work. The volume of work performed by them at current prices amounted to 126 222.6 billion soums, the growth rate compared to January-July 2025 reached 113.9%.

The informal sector accounted for 19.5% of the total volume of construction work. The volume of current prices amounted to 44 356.6 billion soums and the growth rate compared to January-July 2025 was 106.3%.

Figure 4. Volume and growth rates of construction work by type of enterprise, January-July 2026

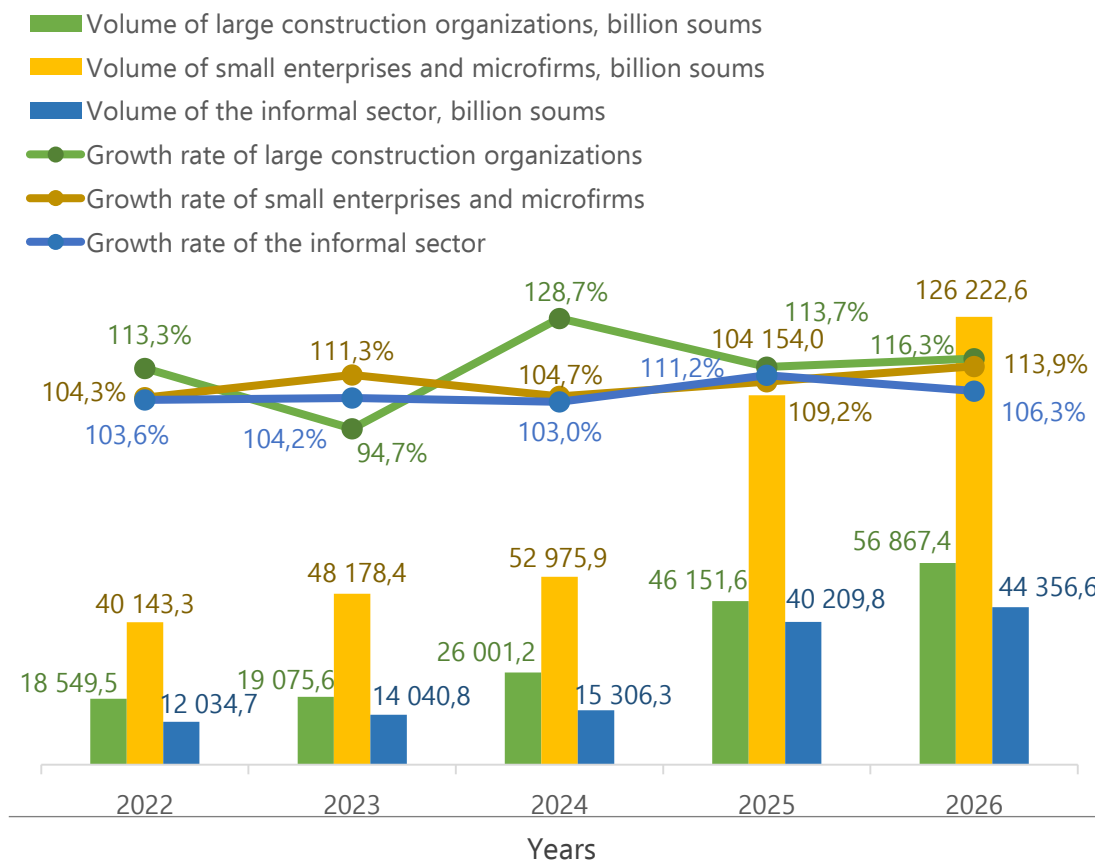


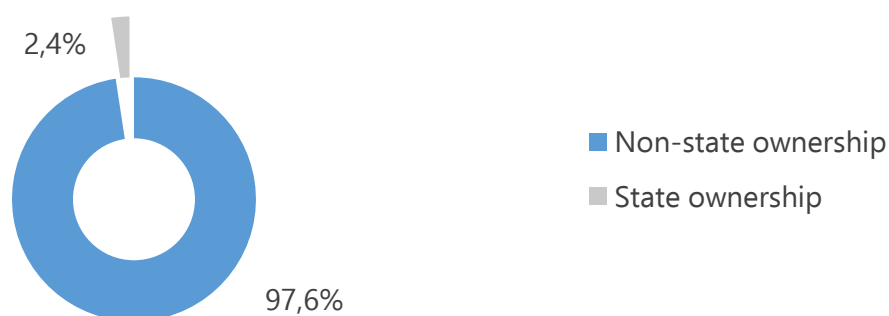

The largest volume of construction work performed by large construction organizations was noted in the city of Tashkent (17.2 trillion soums), Tashkent region (4.1 trillion soums) and Navoi region (3 trillion soums).

#### IV. Methodological explanations and metadata for construction works

**Construction works** are the result of construction production, which is a set of works performed during the construction, reconstruction, expansion, major and current repair of buildings and structures.

The cost of construction works includes the preparation and drafting of work plans for the development of construction sites, water supply, heat supply, sewerage, foundation laying, wall lifting, sanitary and technical works for the installation of building structures and other contract work (launching and adjustment, excavation, cultural and technical works, etc.).

Statistical accounting of construction work is maintained in the volume actually performed during the reporting period, regardless of the time of payment, at current prices of the reporting period, excluding VAT.

Formation of statistical information on the volume of construction work:

- a) statistical reports of legal entities engaged in construction activities (monthly, annual);
- b) results of quarterly sample surveys of the activities of small enterprises and micro-firms;
- d) statistical reports of the territorial departments of the Chamber of State Cadastres of the Republic of Uzbekistan engaged in monitoring the construction of individual housing and non-residential facilities by individuals;
- e) data from a sample statistical survey of individual housing commissioned;
- f) on the basis of a statistical assessment of the volume of repair of individual housing using the self-financing method.
