Preliminary data for January-February 2025

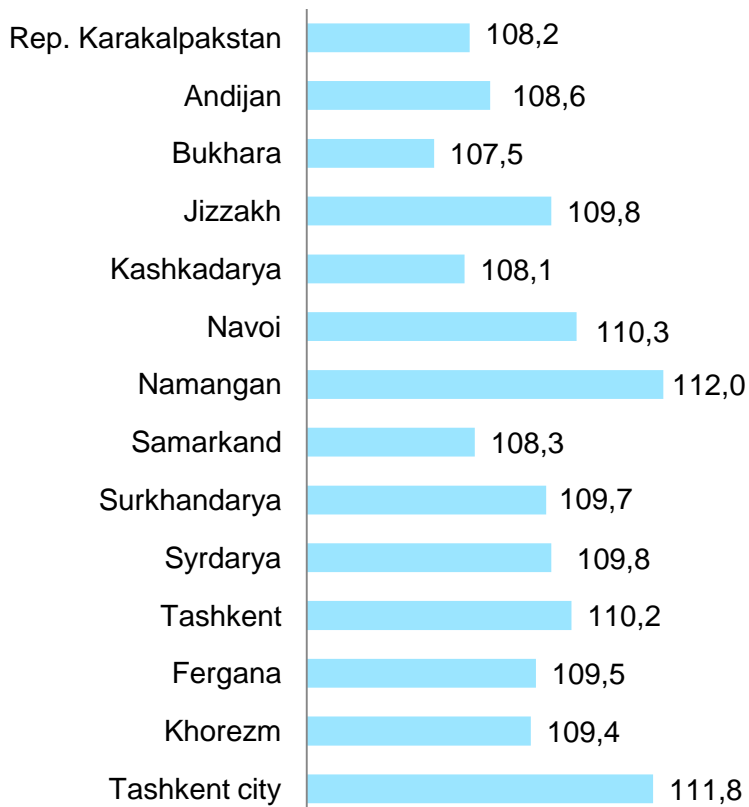

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I. RETAIL TURNOVER

As of March 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the retail trade sector reached 82 504 units, of which the number of operating large enterprises amounted to 370 units, and small enterprises and microfirms – 82 134.

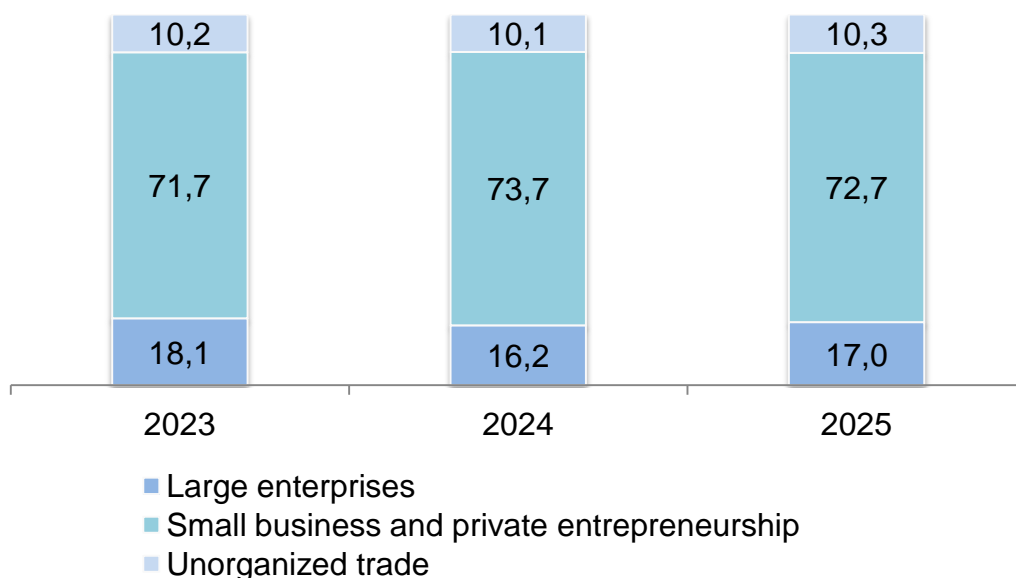
Retail trade turnover for January-February 2025 reached 57 100.1 billion soums and increased by 110.2 % compared to the same period in 2024, also the turnover of large enterprises amounted to 9 688.4 billion soums (growth rate - 109.7 %) and small businesses and private entrepreneurship – 41 526.5 billion soums (growth rate - 109.5 %), including unorganized trade amounted to 5 885.2 billion soums (growth rate - 116.0 %).

Dynamics of large enterprises, small businesses and private entrepreneurship and unorganized trade (in %)



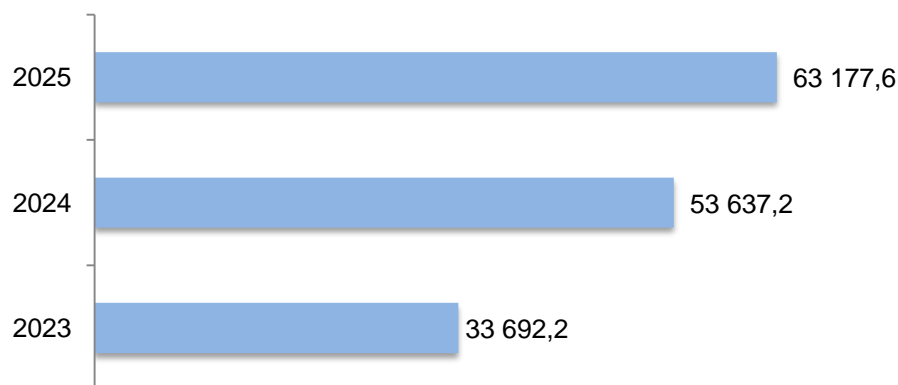
II. WHOLESALE TURNOVER

As of March 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the wholesale trade sector amounted to 46 477 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises is 393, small enterprises and microfirms – 46 084.

According to preliminary data, in January-February 2025, the volume of wholesale trade turnover reached 63 177.6 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2024, increased by 12.3 %.

The turnover of wholesale trade of small business entities, according to statistical calculations, amounted to 46 819.8 billion soums and, compared to the same period in 2024, increased by 108.2 %. The share of this sector in the turnover of wholesale trade in the republic amounted to 74.1 %.

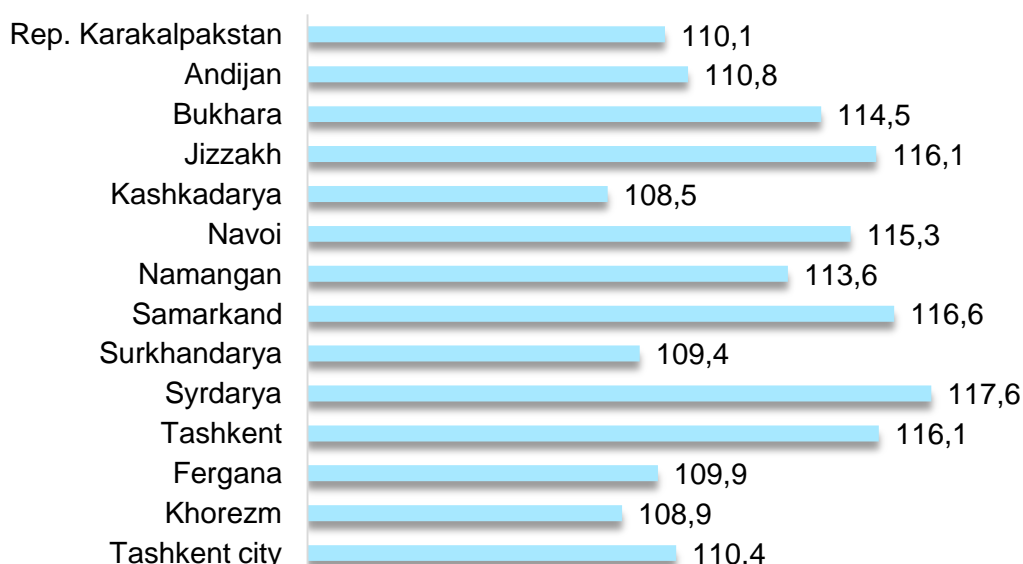
Dynamics of wholesale trade volume (in billion soums)

In January-February 2025, the highest growth rates of wholesale trade turnover of large enterprises, compared to the same period in 2024, were observed in Syrdarya (6.7 times), Jizzakh (2.9 times), Navoi (195.1 %), Tashkent (190.6 %) and Bukhara (174.7 %) regions.

Wholesale trade growth rates by region (in %)



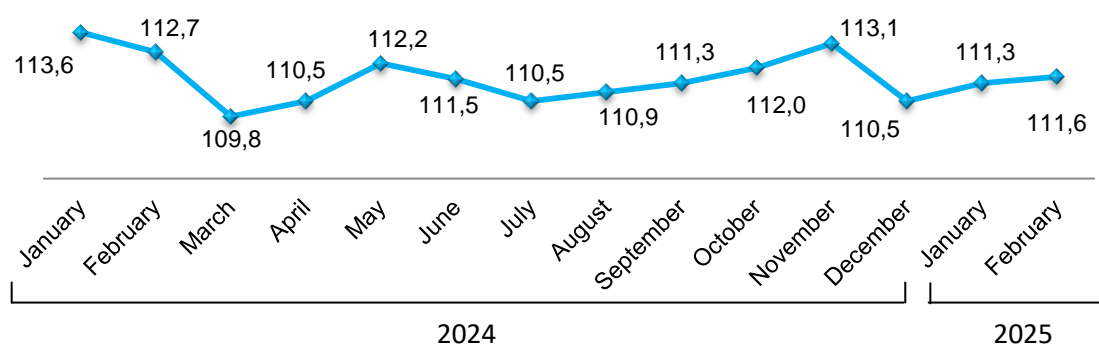

III. TURNOVER OF CATERING ESTABLISHMENTS

As of March 1, 2025, the number of commercial enterprises operating in the public catering sector amounted to 23 990 units, of which the number of large operating enterprises amounted to 90 units, and the number of small enterprises and microfirms reached 23 900.

In January-February 2025, the turnover of public catering enterprises amounted to 26 546.3 billion soums and increased, compared to the same period in 2024, by 111.6 %, of which 83.5 % of the trade turnover falls to the share of small businesses.

IV. METADATA

In developing these Methodological Provisions, the regulatory and legal acts of the Republic of Uzbekistan governing the activities of enterprises and organizations engaged in wholesale and retail trade, as well as the following international guidelines and recommendations were used: “System of National Accounts 2008 (SNA-2008)”, “International Recommendations for Retail and Wholesale Trade Statistics” (UN, 2008), “Methodological Recommendations for Statistical Monitoring of Retail Trade Turnover and Calculating Its Physical Volume Index” (CIS Statistical Committee, 2011).

Taking into account the results of statistical surveys conducted to assess the informal and shadow economy, it can be noted.
