

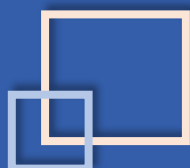

Preliminary data

In order to increase the share of the service sector in the country's economy, expand the types and improve their quality, as well as to further support business entities in this area, the Resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated May 11, 2021 No. PD-5113 "On measures to accelerate the development of the service sector" approved the target parameters for the development of the service sector in our country and provides for their monitoring.

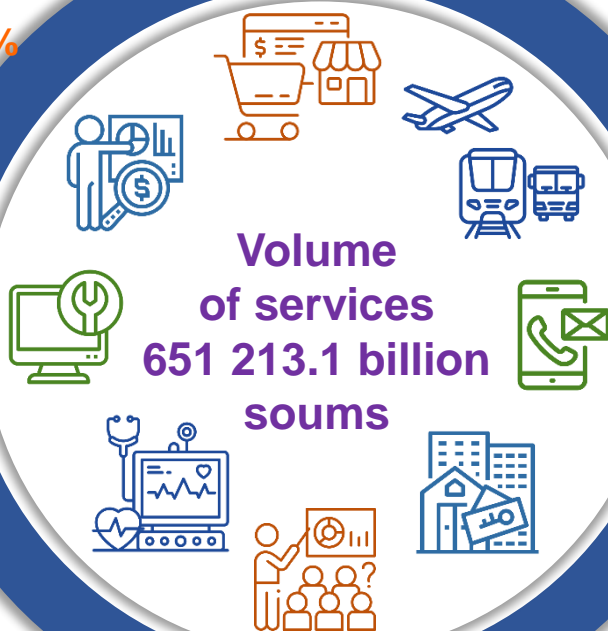

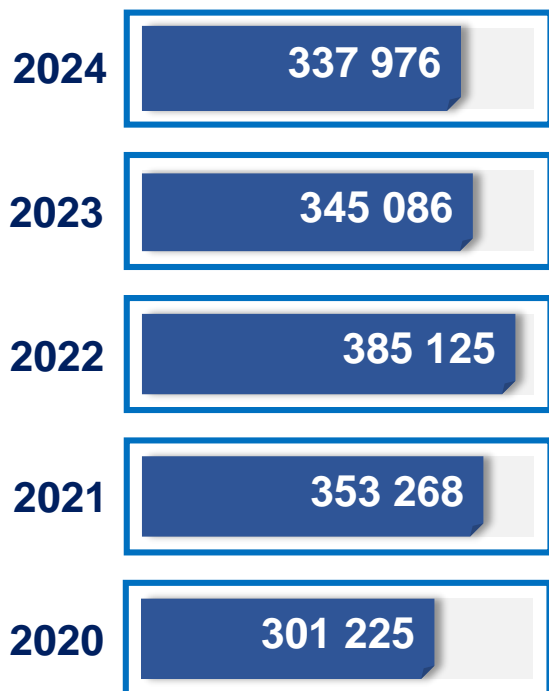

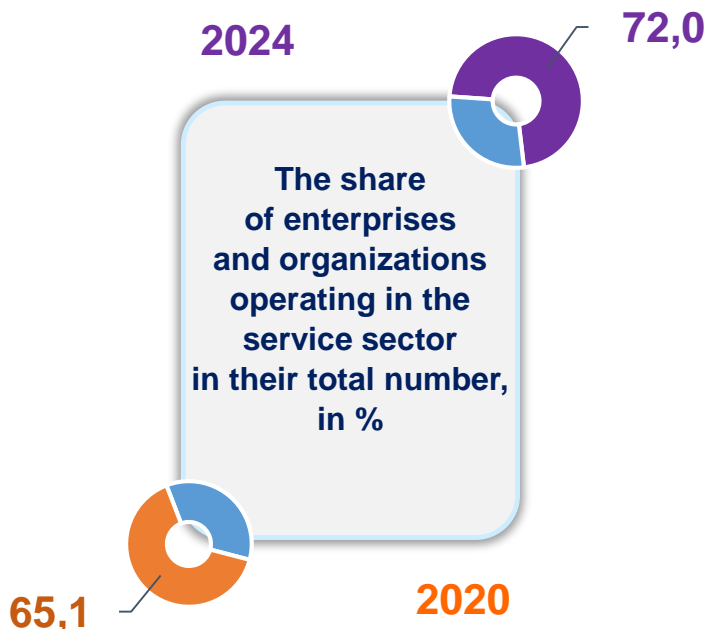

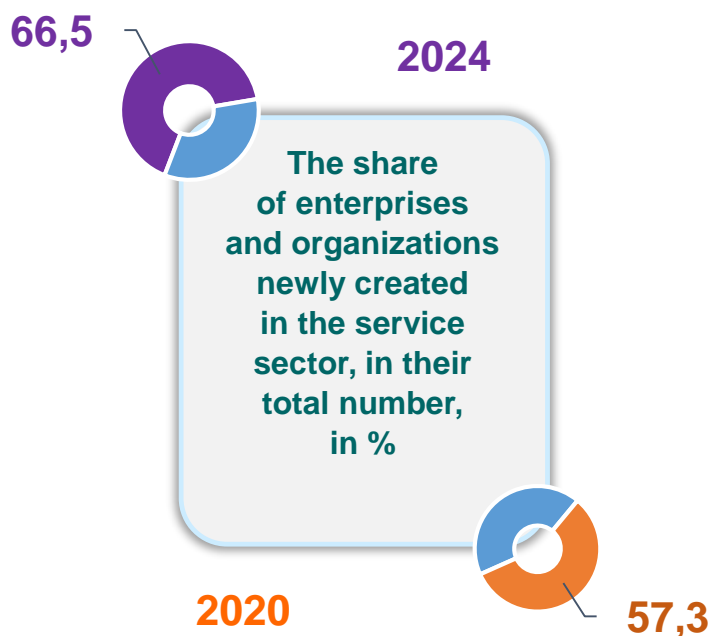
Operating enterprises and organizations

(as of November 1)

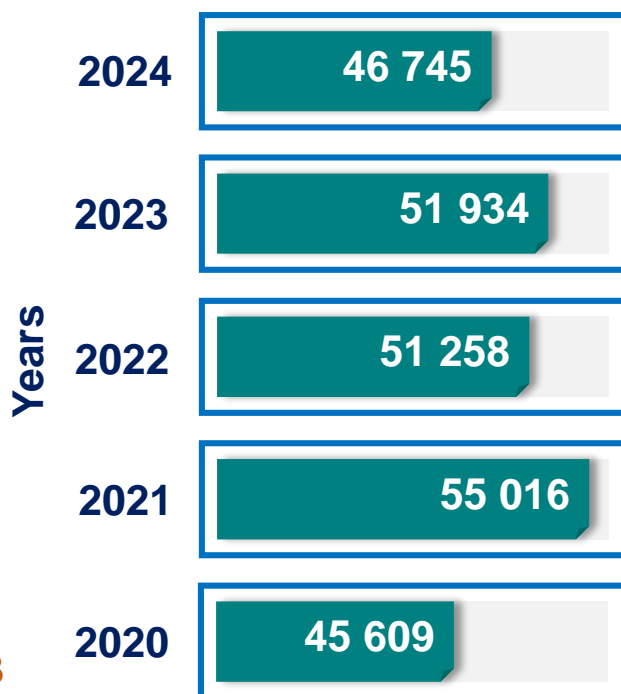


Newly created enterprises and organizations

(for January-October)

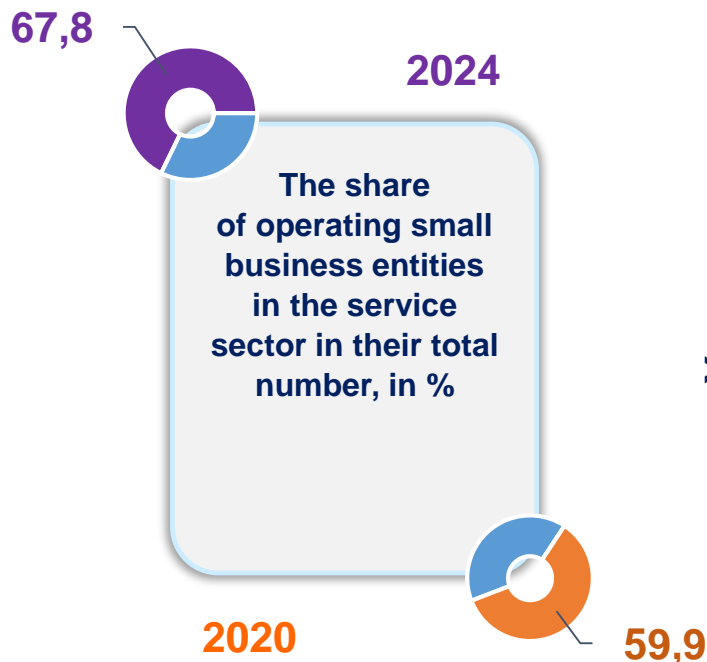

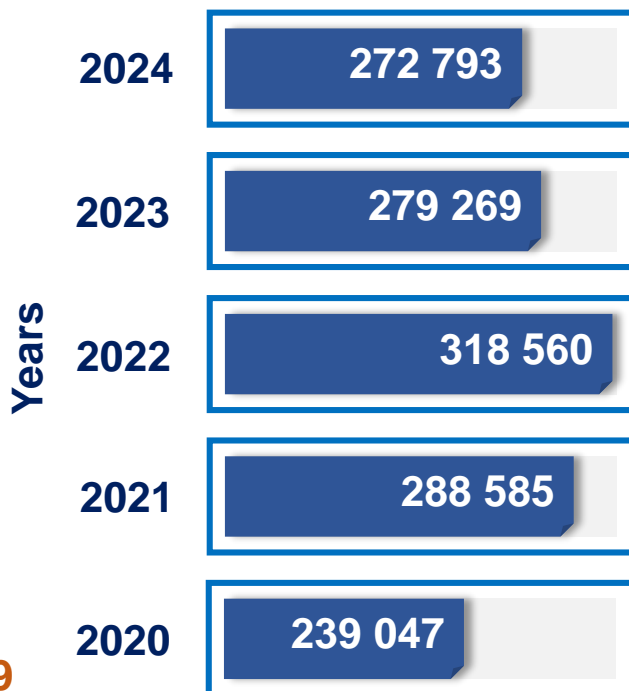


Current small business entities

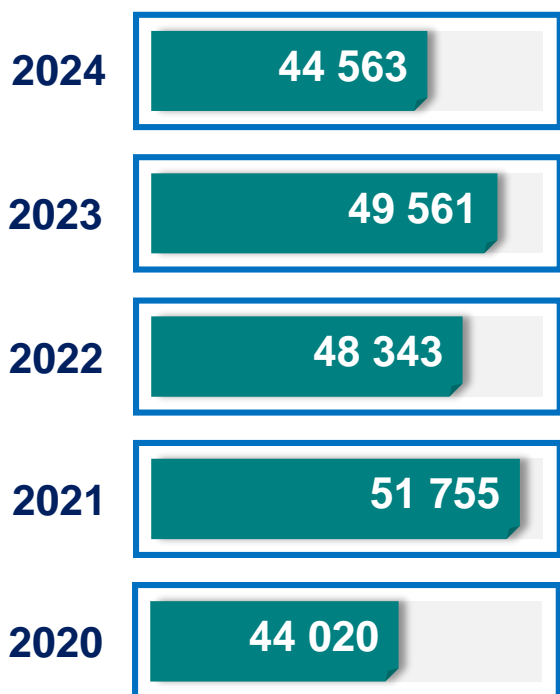

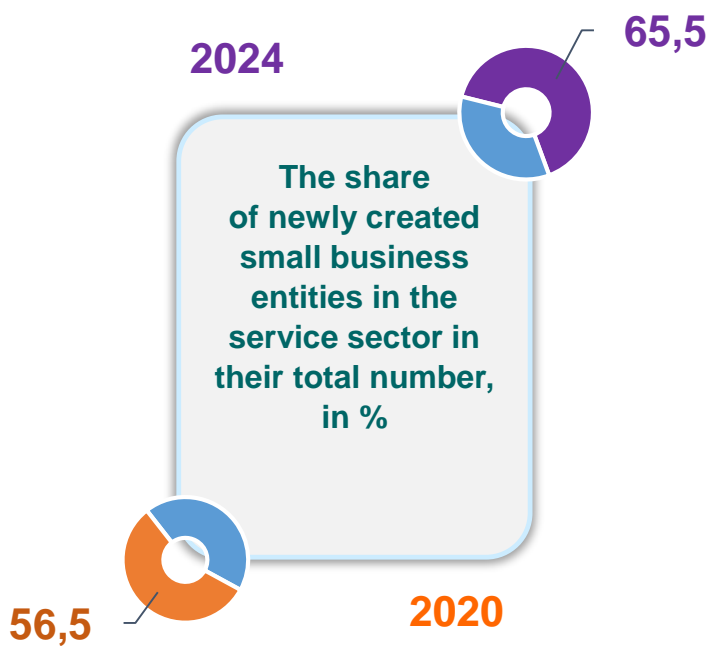

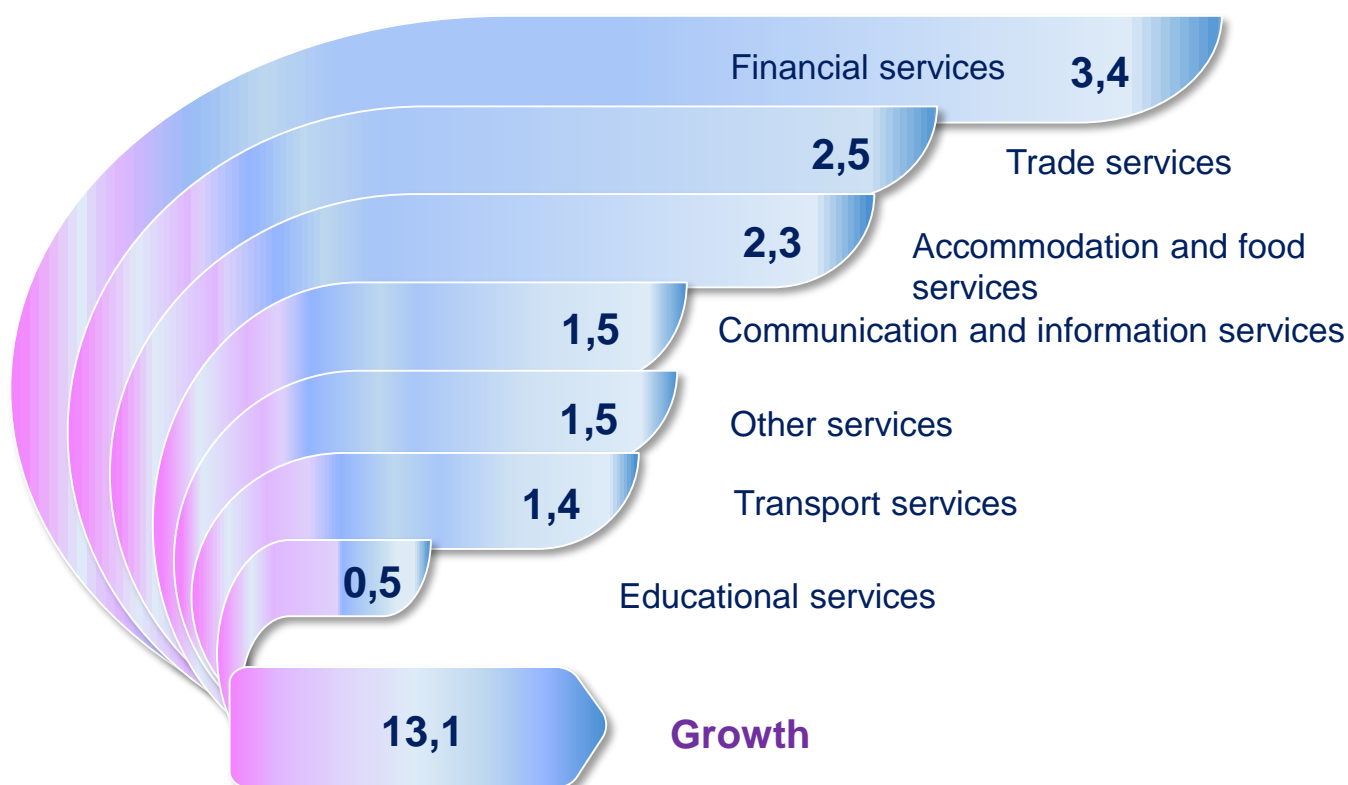

The volume of market services provided reflects the cost of services provided to consumers (legal entities and individuals, including non-residents) over a certain period of time.

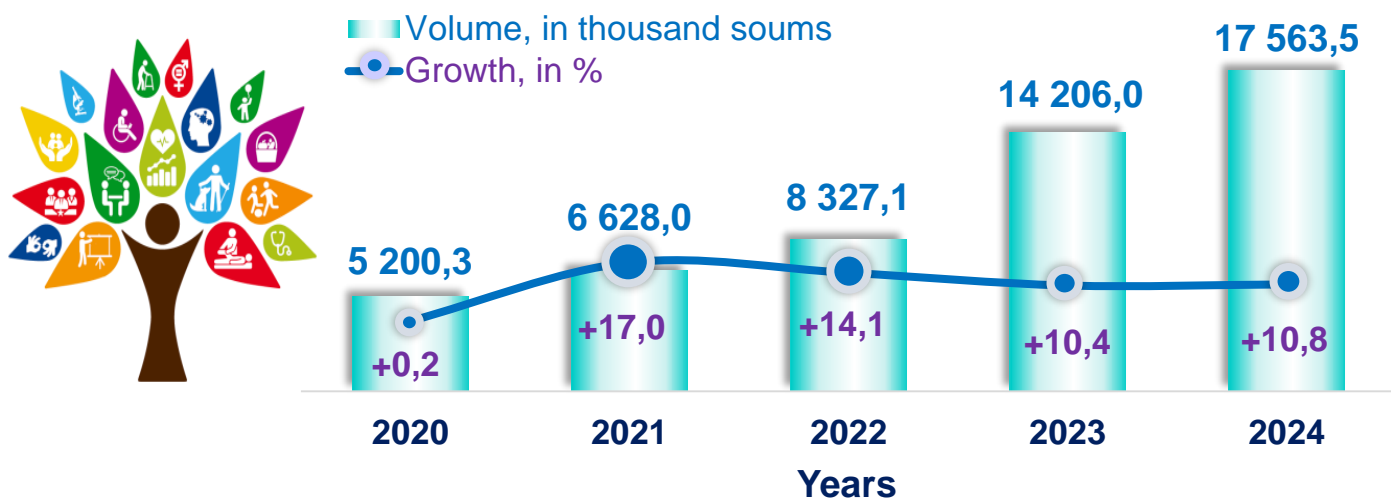

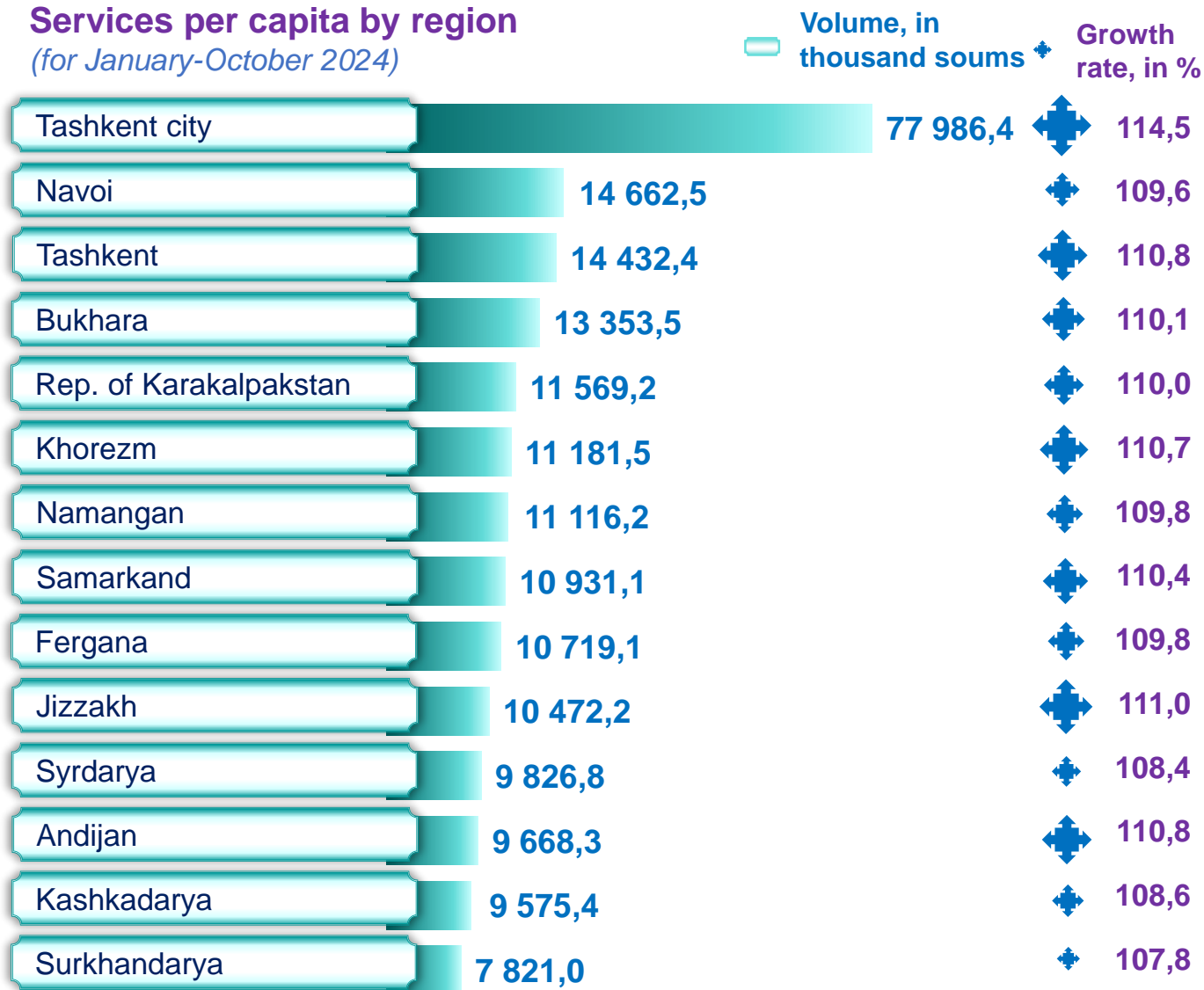

Services per capita by region (for January-October 2024)

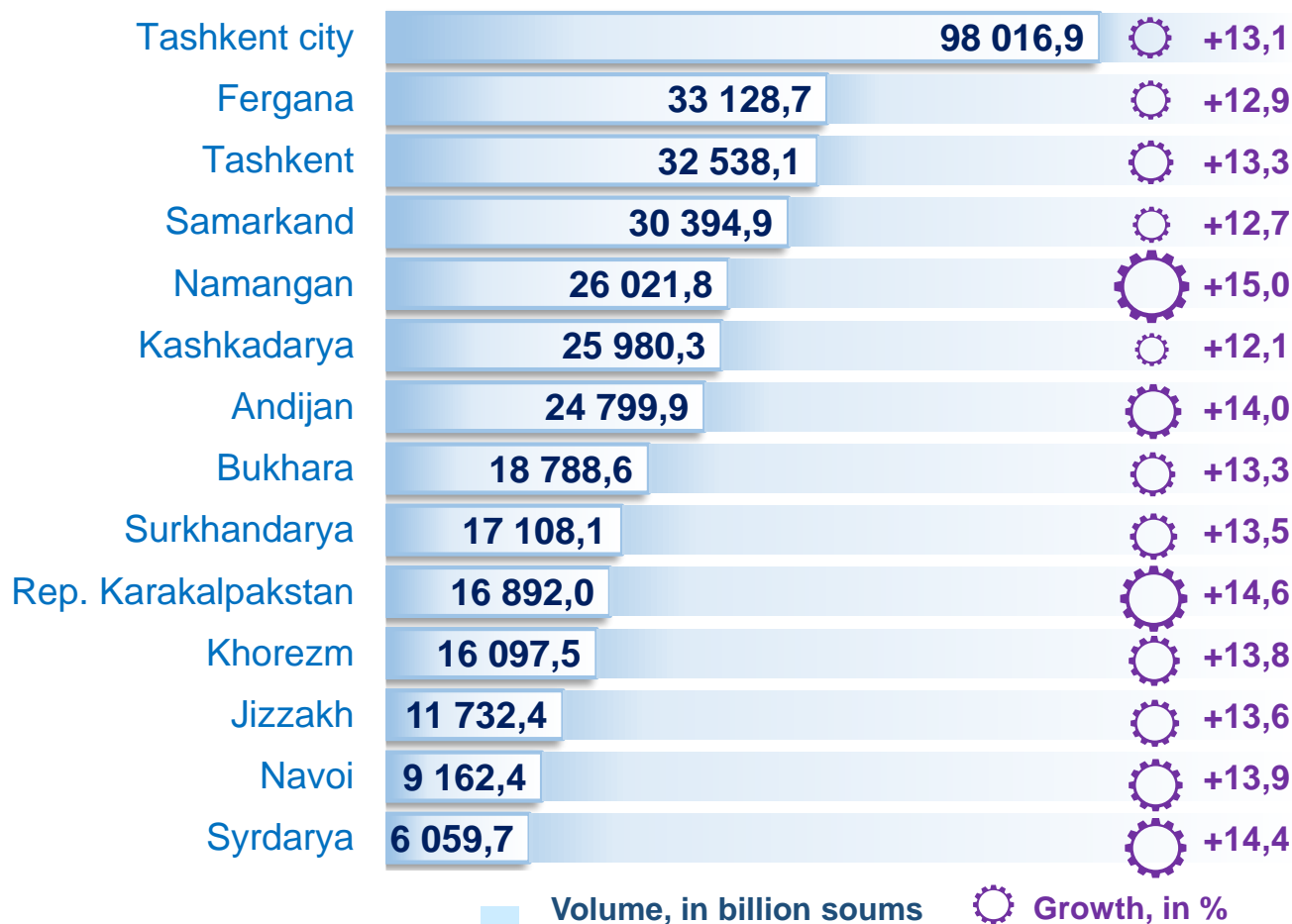


Dynamics of the main indicators of small business in the service sector (for January-October)

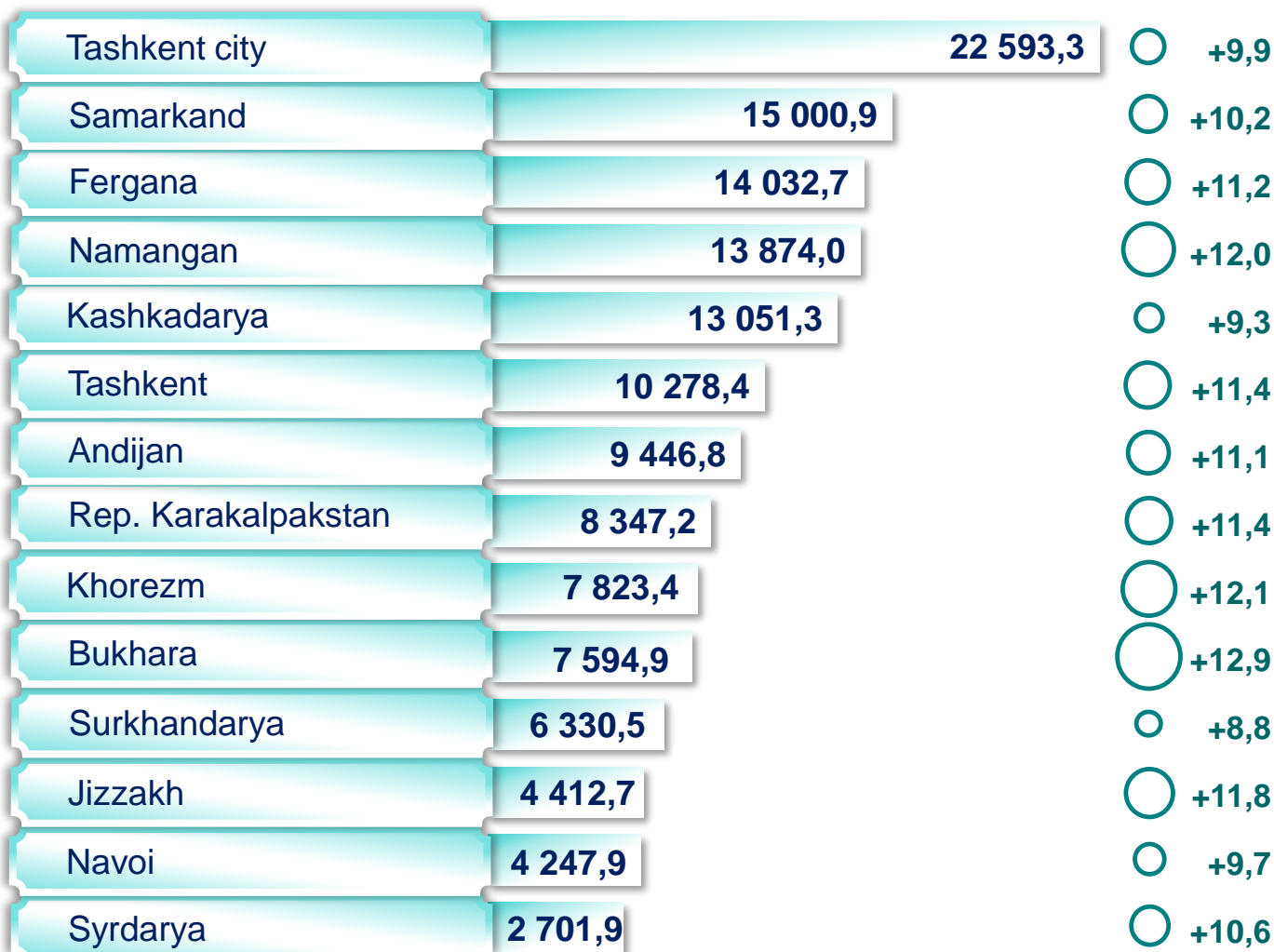
Dynamics of accommodation and food services (for January-October) ¹⁾

For **January-October 2024**, the share of accommodation and food services (taking into account the shadow economy) in the total volume of services amounted to **21.4 %**. Their structure is dominated by services for the provision of food and beverages - **95.6 %**.

Dynamics of trade services (for January-October) ¹⁾

For **January-October 2024** the share of retail trade (taking into account the shadow economy) amounted to more than half of the total volume of trade services, or, more precisely, **52.4 %**.

Auxiliary financial activities

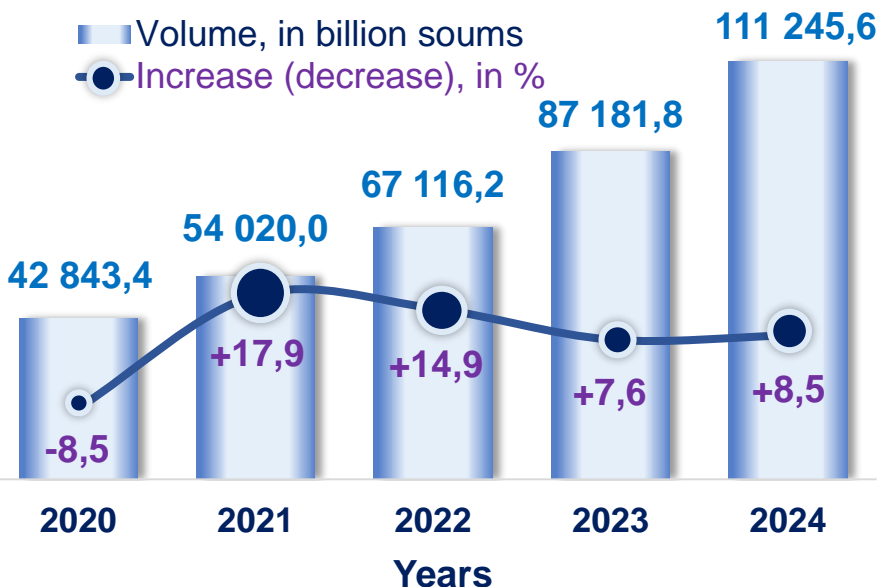


In the structure of financial services, their share, excluding insurance and pension services, amounted to **87.6 %** in **January-October 2024**.

The share of Tashkent city in the total volume of financial services was **59.1 %**, or **65 137.4** billion soums. Also, compared to January-October 2023, this region recorded the highest growth rate – **127.3 %**.

Dynamics of transport services

In the total volume of transport services, automobile transport services predominate – **49.0 %**.

The volume of transport services in Tashkent reached **21 704.9** billion soums. In this region, the growth rate of transport services was noted at **123.2 %**.

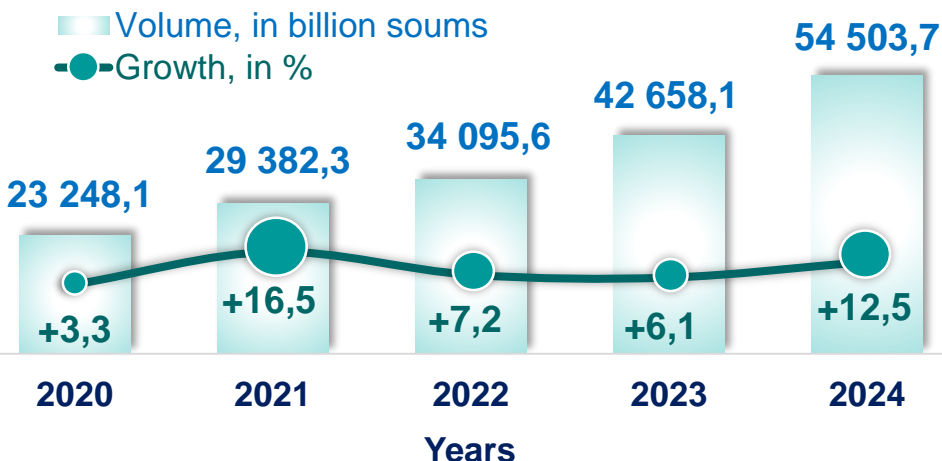

Moreover, in the total volume of motor transport services, the largest share is accounted for by taxi services – **45.7 %**.

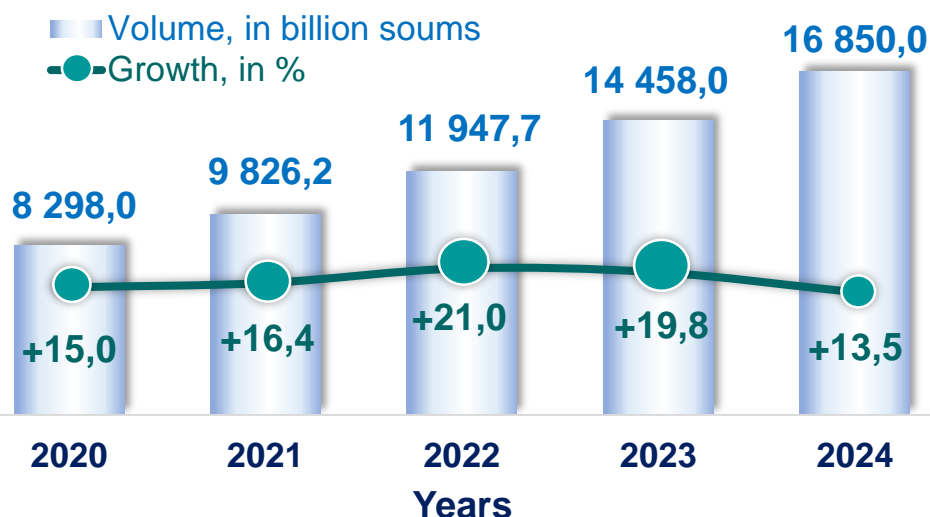

(for January-October)

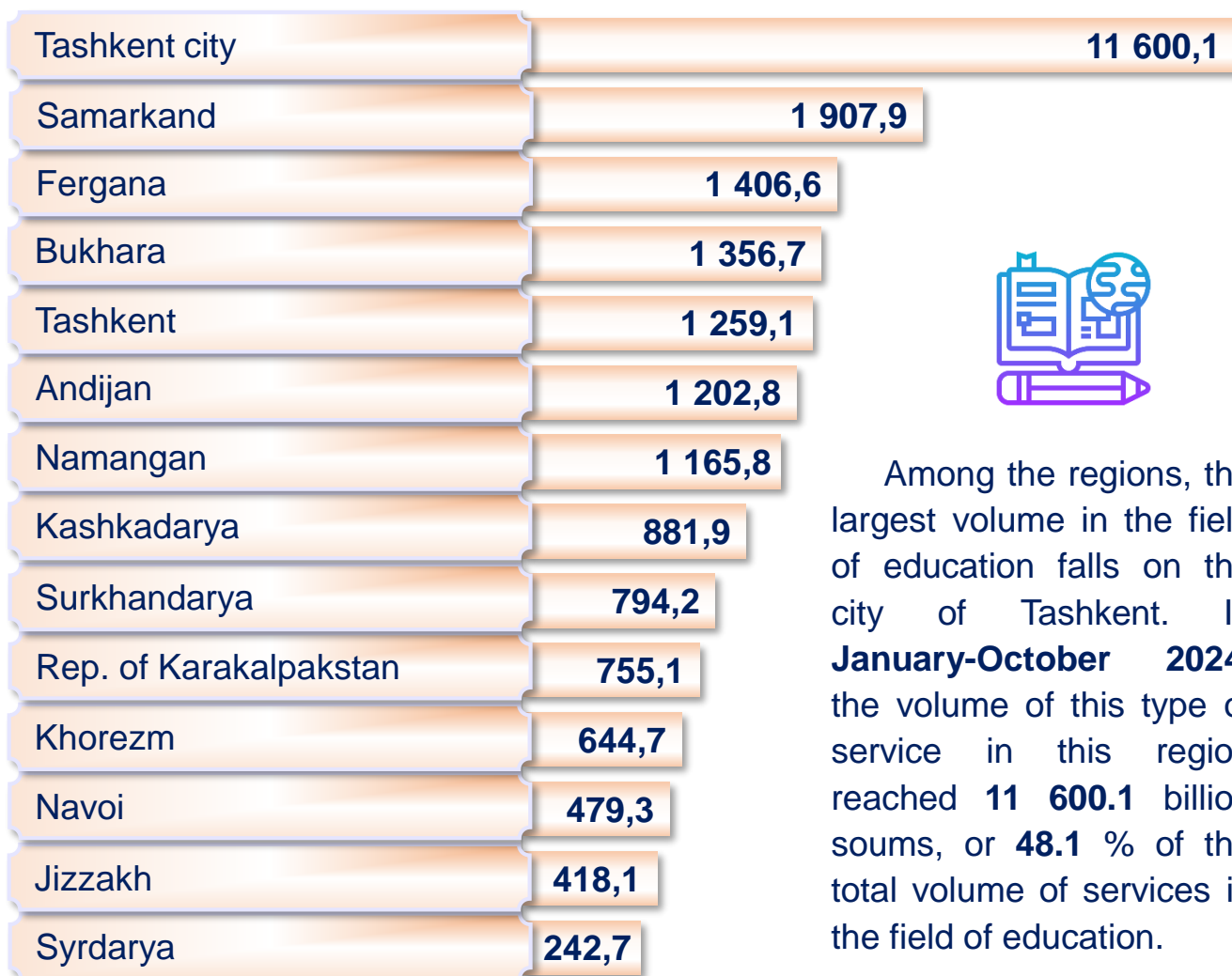


In the total volume of services in the field of education, services in the field of higher education predominate; for **January-October 2024**, their share amounted to **49.4%**.



Educational services by region

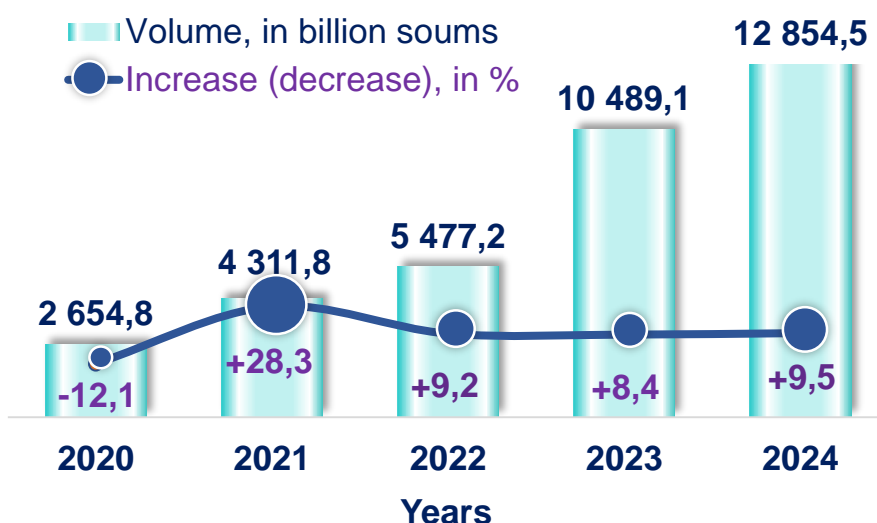

Among the regions, the largest volume in the field of education falls on the city of Tashkent. In **January-October 2024**, the volume of this type of service in this region reached **11 600.1** billion soums, or **48.1 %** of the total volume of services in the field of education.

In January-October 2024, other health care services accounted for **53.1%** of the total volume of health care services. Hospital services accounted for **30.6%**, and medical practice and dental services accounted for **16.3 %**.

(for January-October 2024)



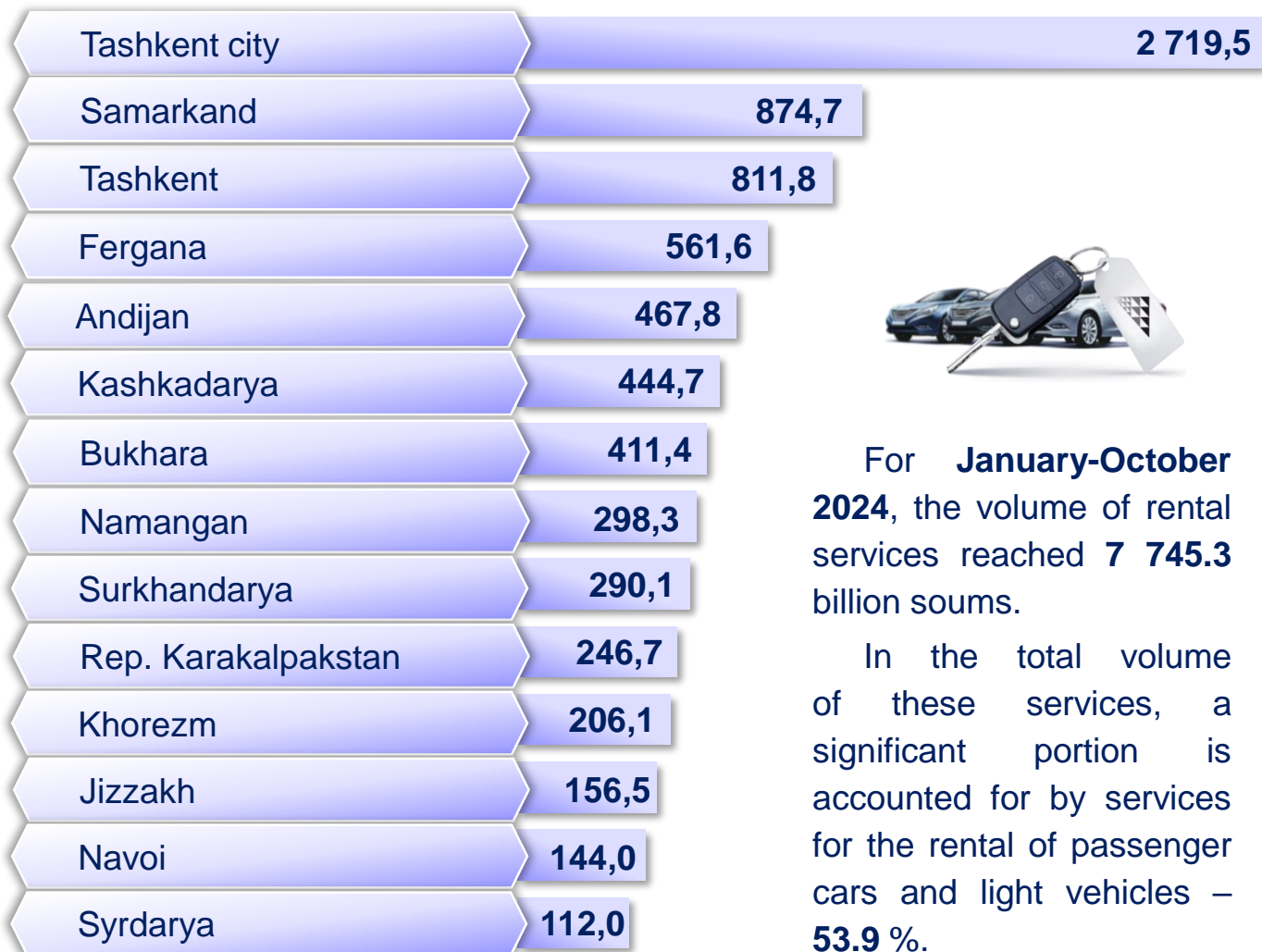

In the total volume of these services, a significant portion is accounted for by services for the rental of passenger cars and light vehicles – **53.9 %**.

Dynamics of services in the field of law and accounting

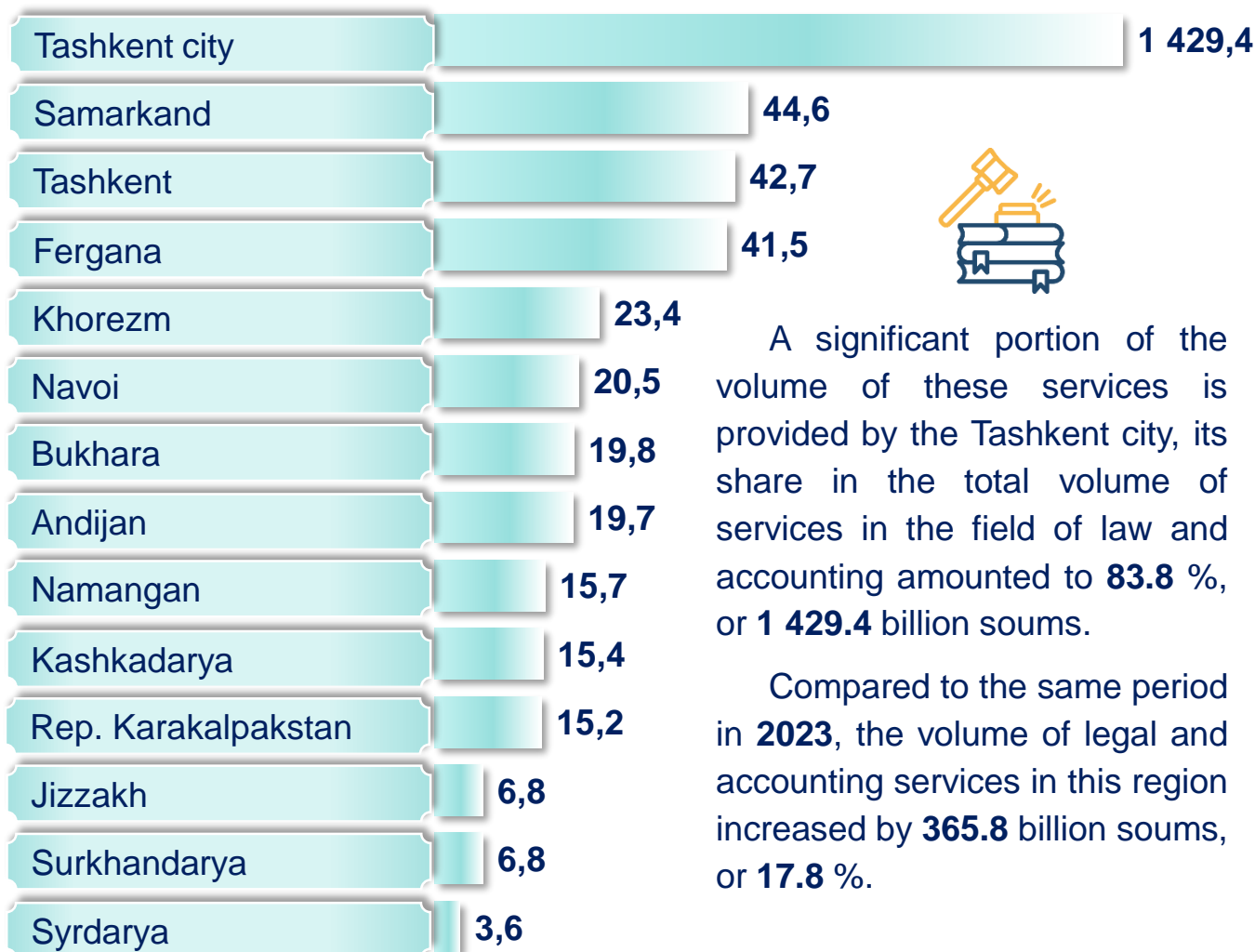

In **January-October 2024**, the volume of services in the field of law and accounting reached **1 705.1** billion soums.

Legal and accounting services

A significant portion of the volume of these services is provided by the Tashkent city, its share in the total volume of services in the field of law and accounting amounted to **83.8** %, or **1 429.4** billion soums.

Compared to the same period in **2023**, the volume of legal and accounting services in this region increased by **365.8** billion soums, or **17.8** %.

Dynamics of legal and accounting services per capita

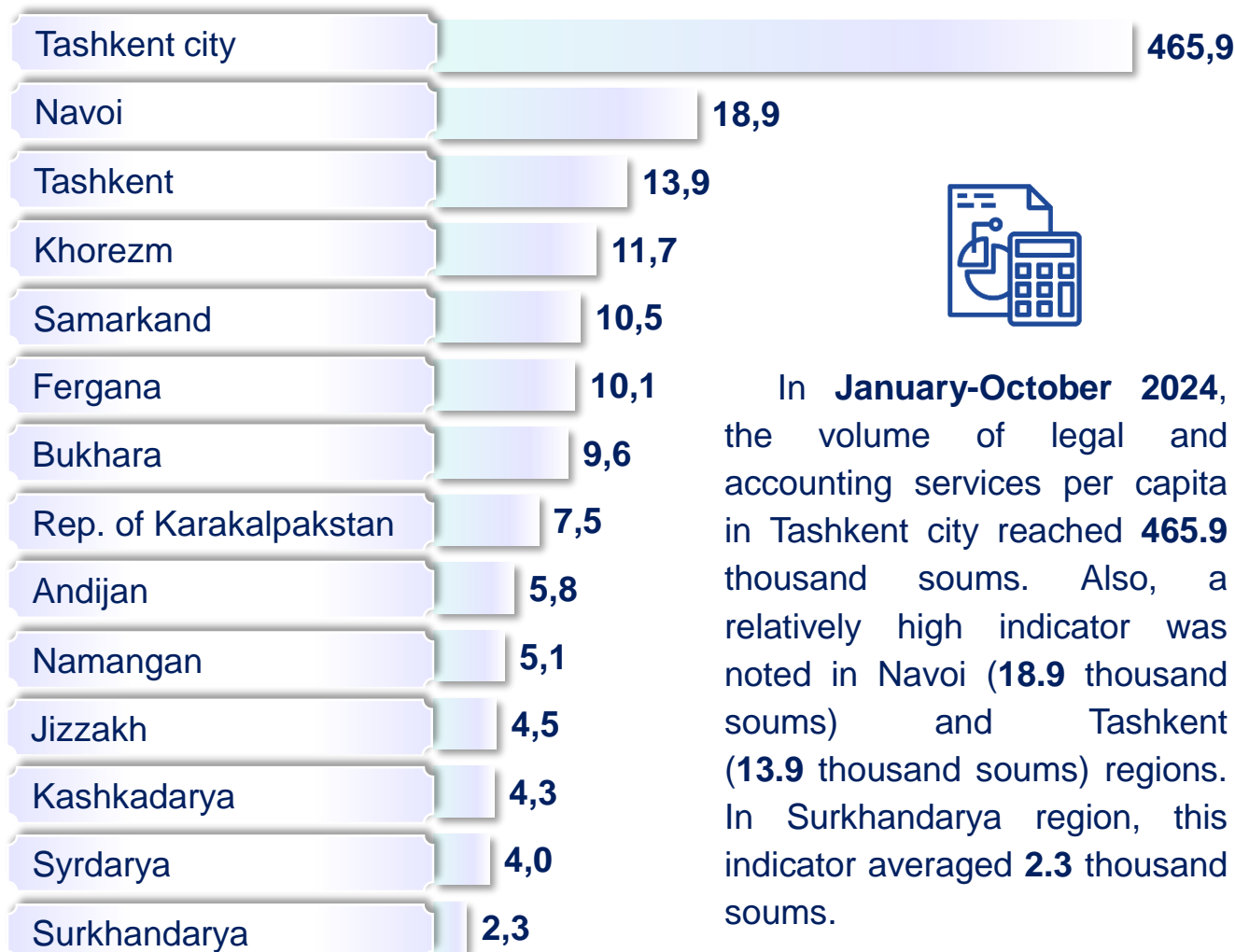

Legal and accounting services play a main role in modern business and personal life, providing legal protection and financial transparency.



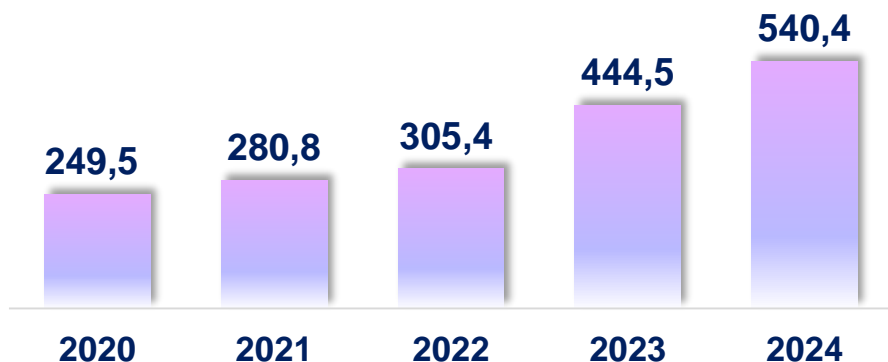
Legal and accounting services per capita by region

(for January-October 2024, in thousands of soums)



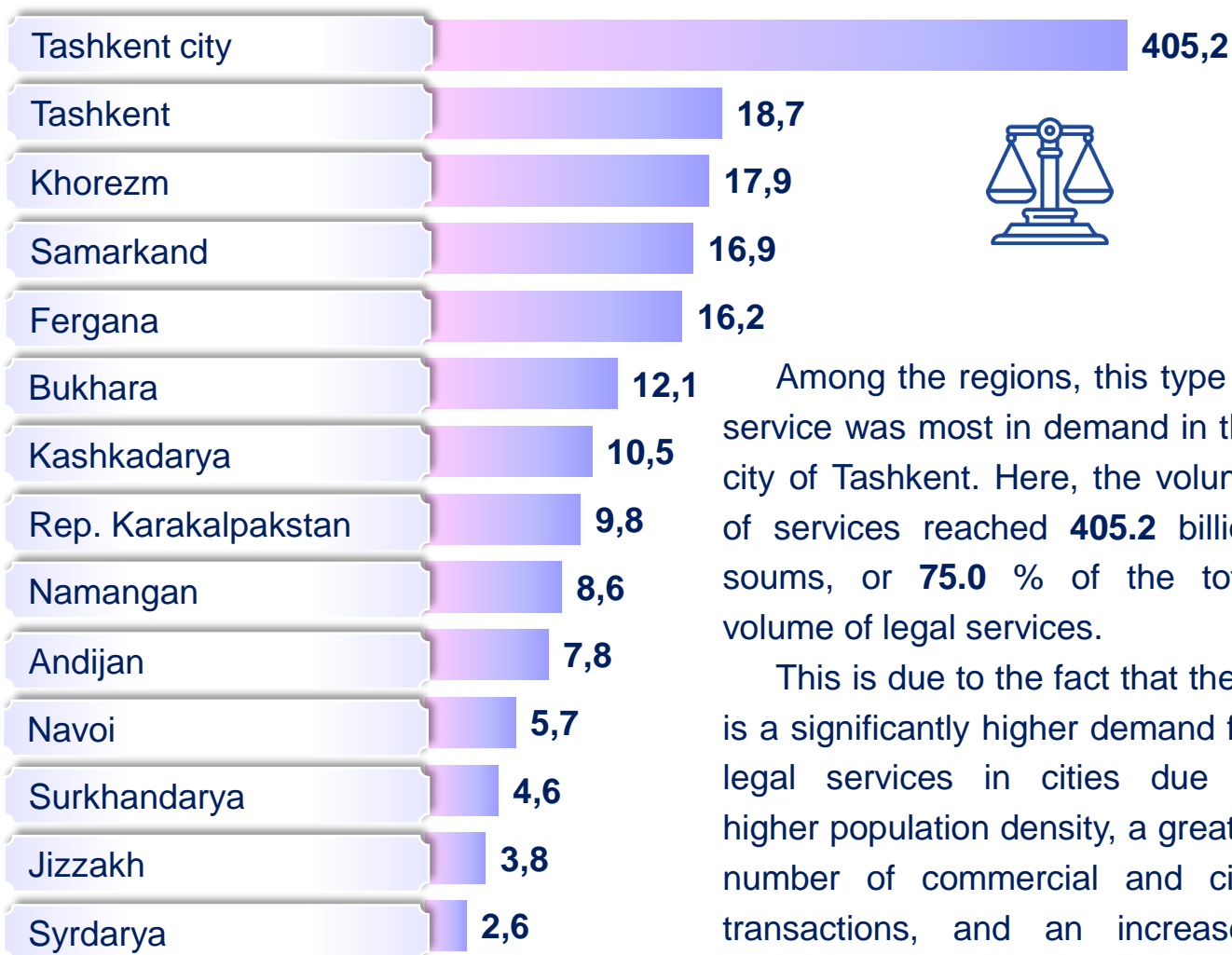
In **January-October 2024**, the volume of legal and accounting services per capita in Tashkent city reached **465.9** thousand soums. Also, a relatively high indicator was noted in Navoi (**18.9** thousand soums) and Tashkent (**13.9** thousand soums) regions. In Surkhandarya region, this indicator averaged **2.3** thousand soums.

For **January-October 2024**, the share of legal services in the total volume of services in the field of law and accounting amounted to **31.7 %**, or **540.4** billion soums.

Legal services by region *(for January-October 2024, in billion soums)*



Among the regions, this type of service was most in demand in the city of Tashkent. Here, the volume of services reached **405.2** billion soums, or **75.0 %** of the total volume of legal services.

This is due to the fact that there is a significantly higher demand for legal services in cities due to higher population density, a greater number of commercial and civil transactions, and an increased number of legal disputes.

For the period under review in **2024**, the volume of legal services per capita amounted to an average of **14.6** thousand soums.

In **January-October 2024**, the volume of legal services per capita in the Tashkent city reached **132.1** thousand soums. Along with this, a relatively high indicator was noted in the Khorezm (**8.9** thousand soums) and Tashkent (**6.1** thousand soums) regions. In the Surkhandarya region, the volume of legal services was observed at an average of **1.6** thousand soums.

Dynamics of computer and household goods repair services

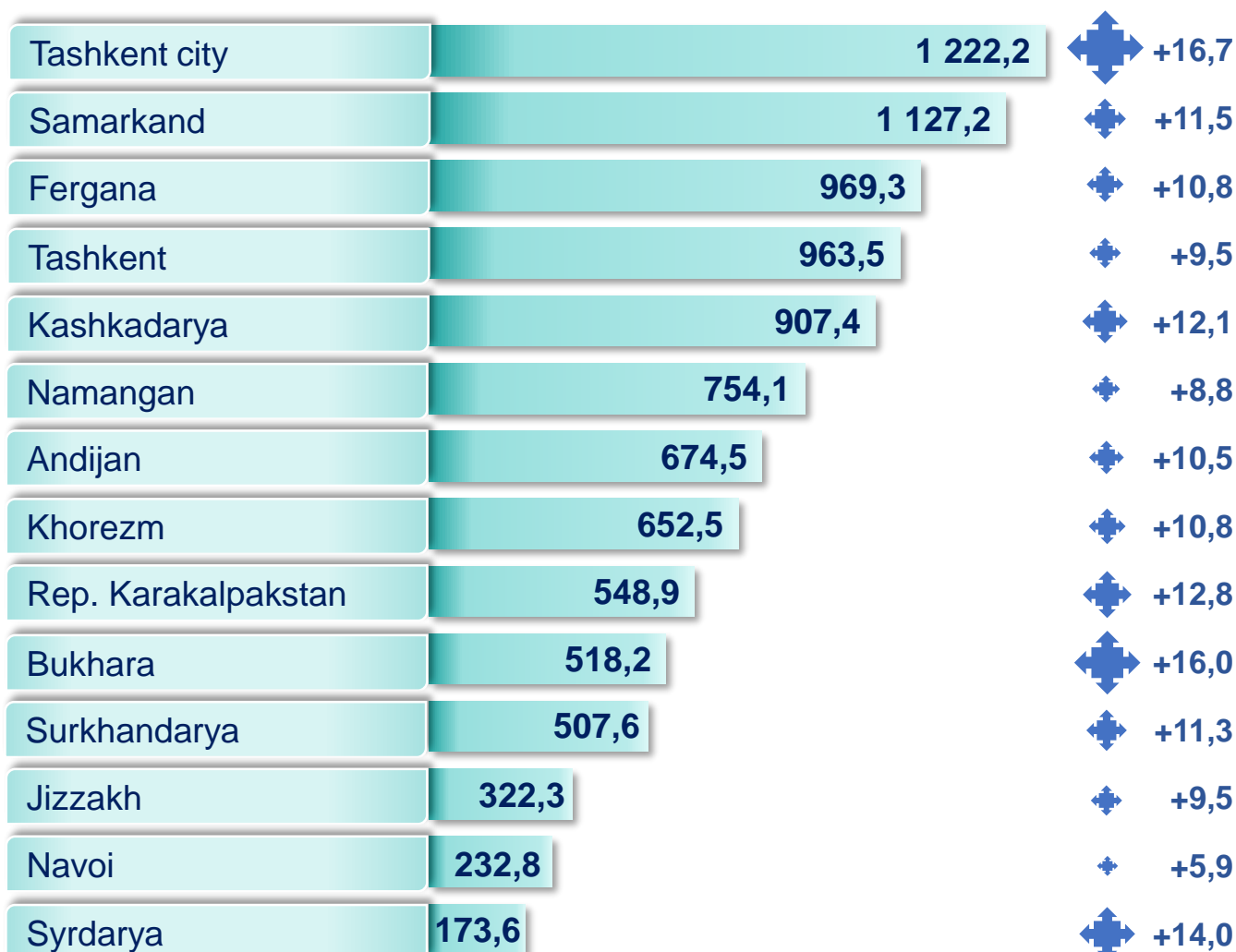

In **January-October 2024**, the volume of services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys, technical testing and analysis reached **8 439.9** billion soums.

In the total volume of these services, the share of the Tashkent city amounted to **59.0 %**.

The volume of financial services is taken into account by the volume of interest income received from financial intermediation (in the amount of payment for them), as well as in the form of fees for the services of a financial institution in providing a loan or maintaining a deposit.

The volume of transport services is the sum of income from transportation and other activities directly related to the implementation of the transport process (loading and unloading, transport and forwarding services, transport maintenance, etc.) by type of transport.

Road transport services include all land passenger transport services except rail transport, other land passenger transport services and road freight transport services, as well as moving services.

The volume of **trade services, including electronic ones**, is the gross income, which is the difference between the selling and purchase price of the goods sold. In the case of a transaction for the purchase and sale of goods in the interests of another person on the basis of contracts, assignment, commission or agency agreements, the cost of services in the amount of remuneration is reflected.

The volume of communication and information services in current prices is defined as the sum of the income of enterprises and organizations (in the amount of revenue from their sale) providing services in this area.

The Education section includes public and private education of any level and training in any profession, full-time or part-time, as well as via Internet channels and postal correspondence. This includes education provided by institutions within the regular school system at various levels, as well as adult education (training and retraining courses), auxiliary activities in the field of education, etc. When carrying out **activities in the field of education**, the cost of provided market services is reflected, including distance learning (contractual).

The volume of services in the health care sector is the cost of market services provided for various types of medical care and sanitary services by health care institutions.

The volume of services for the provision of food and beverages is the value of the turnover, which includes, in addition to the sold overlay, the cost of products used in the preparation of food and sold without processing.

The volume of accommodation services includes the cost of services rendered for the provision of places for short-term accommodation (hotels, motels, etc.).

When providing **services related to real estate**, the cost of services related to real estate transactions, from the lease of own real estate under economic management, operational management or leased, is indicated.

The output of **rental services** is determined by the amount of revenue from the rental of machinery and equipment without an operator, and the rental of household goods and personal items.

The volume of computer and household goods repair services is the amount of revenue from the rendered market services for the repair, maintenance of computers and peripheral equipment, repair of communications equipment, consumer electronics, home and garden equipment, footwear and leather goods, furniture and household accessories, clothing and accessories, sporting goods, musical instruments, hobby items and other personal consumption items and household goods.

The volume of **services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys and provision of technical consultations** includes the cost of design, survey, engineering, technological works and services performed in accordance with the requirements stipulated in the contract, as well as the cost of construction supervision works and other engineering services performed by own forces.

The volume of legal and accounting services is the amount of revenue from the provision of market services in the field of law, for providing advice to clients on their legal rights and obligations and other legal services, as well as for maintaining accounting books, accounting and auditing, and preparing tax returns.

The volume of legal services includes the cost of rendered market services for legal representation and protection of interests in courts and other judicial bodies, by persons who are members of the bar association or under their supervision: provision of consulting services and representation in civil, criminal cases, labor disputes, as well as the preparation of legal documents, services of bailiffs, arbitrators, inspectors and judges.
