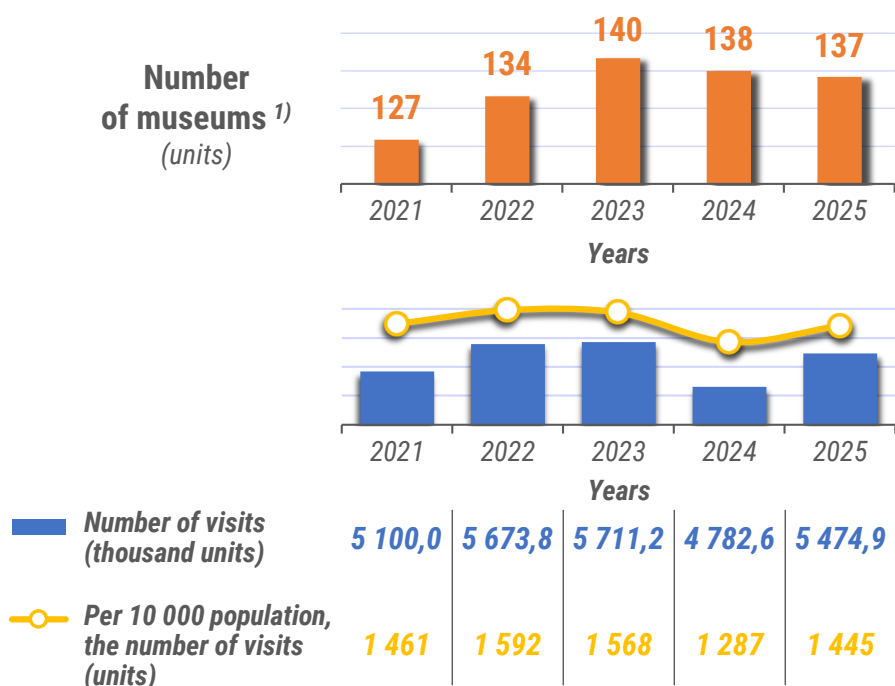
### **I. Museum activities**

**Museum** – a permanent non-profit cultural institution established by an owner to preserve, study and publicly display museum objects and museum collections ([No. ZRU-177 of 12.09.2008](#)).

**National Museum Fund** – the body of museum objects and museum collections permanently held on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan ([No. ZRU-177 of 12.09.2008](#)).

### Key indicators of museum activities

(for the respective year)



In 2025 the number of museums in Uzbekistan was **137 units** – down on 2024 **by 1 unit**, or **by 0,7 %**. Compared with 2021, however, the number of museums rose **by 10 units**.

The number of museum visits in 2025 reached **5 474,9 thousand visits**, increasing by **692,3 thousand visits**, or **14,5 %**, compared with 2024. The number of visits per **10 000 population** stood at **1 445 visits**, increasing by **158 visits**, or **12,3 %**.

In 2025 the largest number of museums was recorded in Tashkent city (**35 units**), as well as in Bukhara and Khorezm regions (**18 units each**). The lowest figures were recorded in Namangan, Surkhandarya and Syrdarya regions (**2 units each**).

The largest number of museum visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**1 856,6 thousand**), Samarkand (**1 183,1 thousand**) and Bukhara (**879,5 thousand**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Syrdarya (**4,8 thousand**), Jizzakh (**22,5 thousand**) and Navoi (**39,5 thousand**) regions.

Per **10 000 population**, the largest number of museum visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**5 903 units**), Bukhara (**4 204 units**) and Khorezm (**2 782 units**) regions. The lowest values were recorded in Syrdarya (**51 units**), Jizzakh (**145 units**) and Tashkent (**146 units**) regions.

## II. Activities of cultural and entertainment organizations

**Cultural and entertainment organizations** are cultural organizations whose principal activity is the creation of works of performing art and their public presentation (theatres, philharmonic societies, circuses, concert organizations (professional creative companies, musical groups, ensembles and others), cinematography organizations and others) ([No. ZRU-668 of 20.01.2021](#)).

In 2025 the largest number of theatres in Uzbekistan was recorded in Tashkent city (**12 units**), Fergana (**5 units**) and Samarkand (**4 units**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Navoi and Syrdarya regions (**1 unit each**).

By the number of performances staged in theatres, the highest figures were recorded in Tashkent city (**2,5 thousand**), Fergana region (**2,1 thousand**) and the Rep. of Karakalpakstan (**1,5 thousand**). The lowest figures were recorded in Navoi (**0,2 thousand**), Syrdarya (**0,3 thousand**) and Namangan (**0,4 thousand**) regions.

The largest number of theatre visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**1 107 thousand**), Fergana (**622 thousand**) and Khorezm (**507 thousand**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Navoi (**46 thousand**), Syrdarya (**101 thousand**) and Namangan (**130 thousand**) regions.

Per **10 000 population**, the largest number of theatre visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**3 519 units**), Khorezm region (**2 472 units**) and the Rep. of Karakalpakstan (**1 577 units**). The lowest values were recorded in Namangan (**411 units**), Navoi (**417 units**) and Kashkadarya (**459 units**) regions.

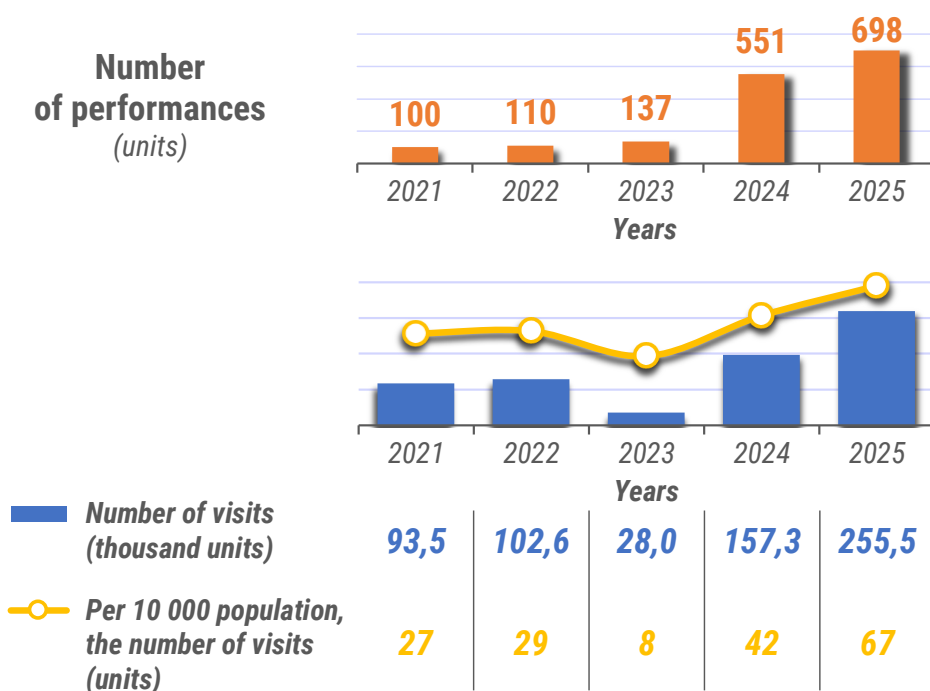
In 2025 the largest number of concert organizations in Uzbekistan was recorded in Tashkent city (**8 units**), the Rep. of Karakalpakstan (**5 units**), as well as in Surkhandarya and Fergana regions (**4 units each**). In all other regions the number was **3 units each**.

By the number of concerts held by concert organizations, the highest figures were recorded in Tashkent city (**5 266 units**), the Rep. of Karakalpakstan (**1 669 units**) and Surkhandarya region (**1 370 units**). The lowest figures were recorded in Khorezm (**1 067 units**), Navoi (**1 068 units**) and Syrdarya (**1 072 units**) regions.

The largest number of concert visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**3 031,4 thousand**), the Rep. of Karakalpakstan (**907,0 thousand**) and Fergana region (**864,9 thousand**). The lowest figures were recorded in Jizzakh (**576,3 thousand**), Samarkand (**611,7 thousand**) and Tashkent (**617,1 thousand**) regions.

Per **10 000 population**, the largest number of concert visits was recorded in Tashkent city (**9 637 units**), Syrdarya (**6 589 units**) and Navoi (**5 887 units**) regions. The lowest values were recorded in Samarkand (**1 410 units**), Kashkadarya (**1 723 units**) and Andijan (**1 832 units**) regions.

### Key indicators of circus activities (for the respective year)



Uzbekistan has **1 circus**, located in Tashkent city. In 2025 the number of circus performances was **698 units** – up on 2024 **by 147 units**, or **by 26,7 %**.

The number of circus visits in 2025 was **255,5 thousand units** – up on 2024 **by 98,2 thousand**, or **by 62,4 %**. Per **10 000 population**, the number of circus visits in 2025 was **67 units**, which is more than in 2024 **by 25 units**, or **by 59,5 %**.

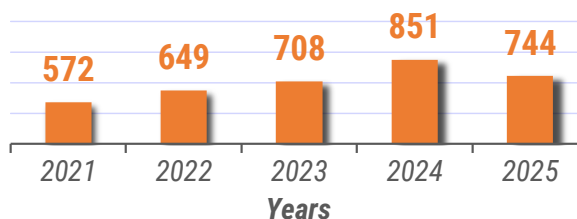
### III. Activities of zoos, botanical gardens and parks of culture and recreation

**Zoos (zoological centres)** – scientific and educational institutions that keep wild animals in captivity (in cages or enclosures) or in semi-free conditions (in large areas resembling a natural habitat) for the purposes of display, study and reproduction.

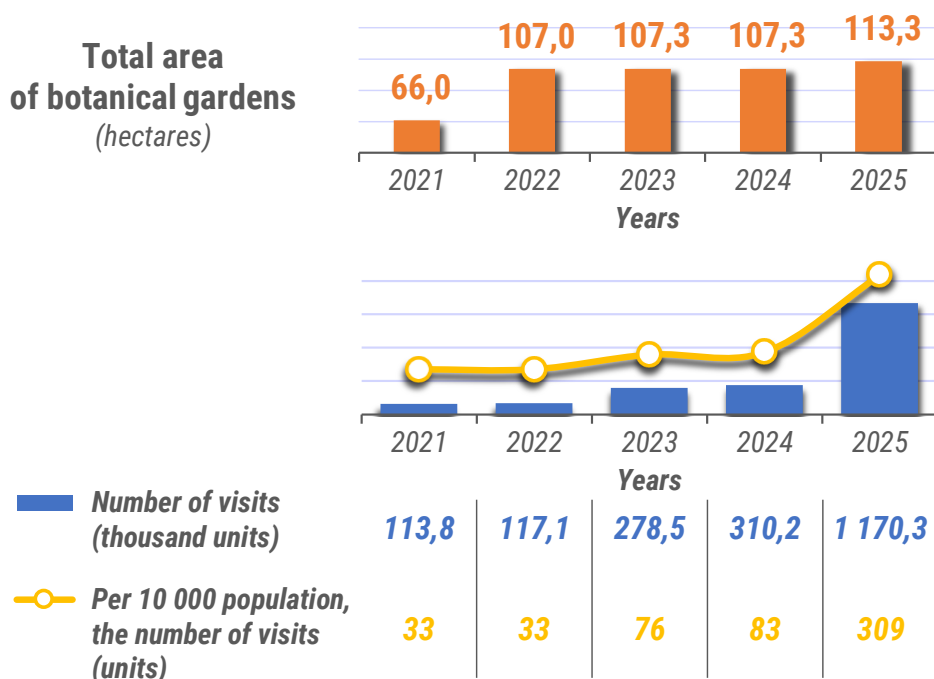
Uzbekistan has **7 zoos**: one zoo each is located in the Rep. of Karakalpakstan and in Andijan, Kashkadarya, Namangan, Surkhandarya and Fergana regions, as well as in Tashkent city.

In 2025 the number of fauna representatives (species) in zoos was **744 units** – down on 2024 **by 107 units**, or **by 12,6 %**.

The number of visits to zoos in 2025 was **1 465,4 thousand units** – up on 2024 **by 233,4 thousand**, or **by 18,9 %**. Per **10 000 population**, the number of visits to zoos in 2025 was **387 units**, which is more than in 2024 **by 56 units**, or **by 16,9 %**.

### Key indicators of botanical garden activities

(for the respective year)



Uzbekistan has **3 botanical gardens**: one botanical garden each is located in Tashkent city, the Rep. of Karakalpakstan and Bukhara region.

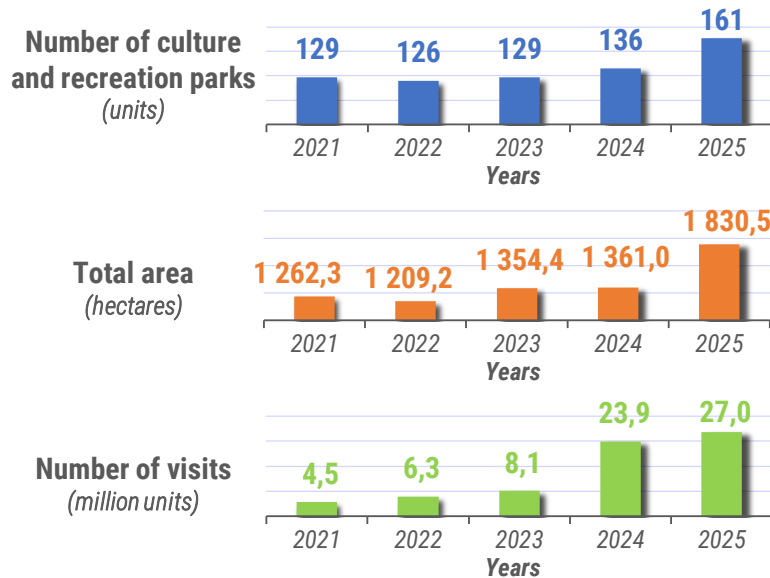
In 2025 the total area of botanical gardens was **113,3 ha** – up on 2024 **by 6,0 ha**, or **by 5,6 %**.

The number of visits to botanical gardens in 2025 was **1 170,3 thousand units** – up on 2024 **by 860,1 thousand**, or **by a factor of 3,8**. Per **10 000 population**, the number of visits to botanical gardens was **309 units**, which is more than in 2024 **by 226 units**, or **by a factor of 3,7**.

**Botanical garden** – an institution established to conserve flora and its genetic stock, to study, acclimatize and propagate plants, and to carry out scientific, teaching, educational and outreach activities.

**Parks of culture and recreation** – integrated, multi-purpose cultural institutions located in a city, town or village and having a natural and cultural-recreational area, intended for organizing cultural recreation for the population and physical fitness, health and leisure activities.

### Key indicators of activities of parks of culture and recreation (for the respective year)



In 2025 the number of parks of culture and recreation in Uzbekistan was **161 units** – up on 2024 **by 25 units**, or **by 18,4 %**. The total area of parks of culture and recreation was **1 830,5 ha**, which is more than in 2024 **by 469,5 ha**, or **by 34,5 %**. The number of visits to parks of culture and recreation in 2025 reached **27,0 million units** – up on 2024 **by 3,2 million**, or **by 13,2 %**.

In 2025 the largest number of parks of culture and recreation in Uzbekistan was recorded in Tashkent city (**29 units**), Andijan (**20 units**) and Samarkand (**17 units**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Tashkent (**3 units**) and Jizzakh (**4 units**) regions, as well as in Kashkadarya and Namangan regions (**5 units each**).

By the total area of parks of culture and recreation, the highest figures were recorded in Tashkent city (**404,1 ha**), Andijan (**397,7 ha**) and Bukhara (**175,1 ha**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Tashkent (**6,8 ha**), Kashkadarya (**43,6 ha**) and Fergana (**49,2 ha**) regions.

The largest number of visits to parks of culture and recreation was recorded in Tashkent city (**14 488,9 thousand**), Namangan (**9 218,5 thousand**) and Bukhara (**631,0 thousand**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Tashkent (**16,7 thousand**), Syrdarya (**34,0 thousand**) and Khorezm (**101,1 thousand**) regions.

Per **10 000 population**, the largest number of visits to parks of culture and recreation was recorded in Tashkent city (**46 063 units**), Namangan (**29 161 units**) and Bukhara (**3 016 units**) regions. The lowest values were recorded in Tashkent (**53 units**), Syrdarya (**362 units**) and Khorezm (**493 units**) regions.

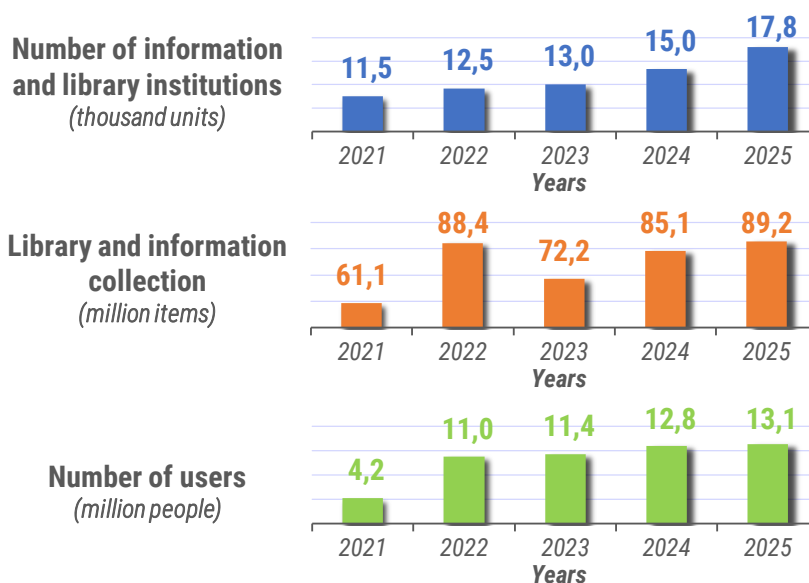

#### IV. Information and library activities

**Information and library activities** – the activities of information and library institutions to build information and library collections and to organize information and library services on the basis of information and communication technologies ([No. ZRU-280 of 13.04.2011](#)).

#### Key indicators of information and library institution activities

(for the respective year)



In 2025 the number of information and library institutions in Uzbekistan was **17,8 thousand units** – up on 2024 **by 2,8 thousand**, or **by 18,7 %**. The information and library collection amounted to **89,2 million items**, which is more than in 2024 **by 4,1 million**, or **by 4,8 %**. The number of users of information and library institutions in 2025 reached **13,1 million people** – up on 2024 **by 0,3 million**, or **by 2,3 %**.

**Information and library collection** – the aggregate of systematized information and library resources ([No. ZRU-280 of 13.04.2011](#)).

**Information and library resource** – information recorded on a material object in the form of text, sound recording or image and having attributes for its identification, storage and access ([No. ZRU-280 of 13.04.2011](#)).

**User** – a person registered with an information and library institution to receive information and library services ([No. ZRU-280 of 13.04.2011](#)).

In 2025 the largest number of information and library institutions in Uzbekistan was recorded in Samarkand (**2,0 thousand**) and Kashkadarya (**1,8 thousand**) regions, as well as in Surkhandarya and Fergana regions (**1,6 thousand each**). The lowest figures were recorded in Navoi (**0,7 thousand**), Jizzakh (**0,8 thousand**) and Syrdarya (**0,9 thousand**) regions.

By the size of the information and library collection, the highest figures were recorded in Tashkent city (**17,6 million items**), Andijan (**11,9 million**) and Samarkand (**10,5 million**) regions. The lowest figures were recorded in Syrdarya (**1,7 million**), Jizzakh (**1,8 million**) and Navoi (**2,7 million**) regions.

The largest number of users of information and library institutions was recorded in Samarkand (**1 318,3 thousand**) and Fergana (**1 305,1 thousand**) regions and in Tashkent city (**1 266,9 thousand**). The lowest figures were recorded in Navoi (**419,0 thousand**), Syrdarya (**507,5 thousand**) and Jizzakh (**574,9 thousand**) regions.

Per **10 000 population**, the largest number of users of information and library institutions was recorded in Syrdarya region (**5 407 people**), Tashkent city (**4 028 people**) and Tashkent region (**3 810 people**). The lowest values were recorded in Bukhara (**2 765 people**), Kashkadarya (**2 893 people**) and Samarkand (**3 039 people**) regions.

## **V. Methodological notes and metadata on culture and arts statistics**

Culture and arts statistics describe the state and development of cultural and arts institutions, their material and technical base, attendance, the holding of cultural events, and the activities of museums, theatres, concert organizations, circuses, zoos, botanical gardens, parks of culture and recreation and information and library institutions, as well as selected indicators of publishing and cinematography.

Statistical information on culture and the arts in the Republic of Uzbekistan is compiled on the basis of annual statistical reports and administrative data from authorized ministries, agencies and organizations. The aggregated data are used to describe the state and development of the cultural sphere, cultural infrastructure, attendance at cultural institutions, cultural and leisure activities, and the museum, theatre, concert, library and cinematography domains.

Statistical **information on museums and cultural heritage** is compiled on the basis of administrative data provided by the Cultural Heritage Agency of the Republic of Uzbekistan. These data contain information on museum collections, types of museum exhibits, the number of visits, and other indicators describing museum activities and the condition of cultural heritage sites.

Statistical **data on theatre activities** are compiled on the basis of administrative data provided by the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Uzbekistan for state theatres. This information includes data on the material and technical base of theatres, auditorium capacity, the number of performances and visits, and other indicators of theatre activity.

**Data on the activities of concert organizations and circuses** are compiled on the basis of administrative data provided by the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Uzbekistan for concert organizations and permanent and travelling circuses. These data are used to produce indicators on the number of concerts and visits, the number of permanent companies, and other indicators of the activities of concert organizations and circuses.

Statistical data on the activities of **zoos, botanical gardens and parks of culture and recreation** are compiled from the annual statistical report form **1 madaniyat (bog'lar)** "Report on the activities of zoos, botanical gardens and parks of culture and recreation". This report is submitted by zoos, botanical gardens and parks of culture and recreation of all forms of ownership. These data are used to produce indicators on the number of recreation facilities, attractions and visits, the number of employees, the number of animal and plant specimens, and other indicators of the activities of these institutions.

Statistical information on the activities of **information and library and information resource institutions** is compiled on the basis of administrative data provided by the Alisher Navoi National Library of Uzbekistan. These data are used to produce indicators describing the library network, library collections, the number of users, loans issued and other areas of library activity.

Aggregated statistical data on culture make it possible to assess the state of cultural infrastructure, attendance levels at cultural institutions, the development of cultural and leisure activities, and the accessibility of cultural services for the population.
