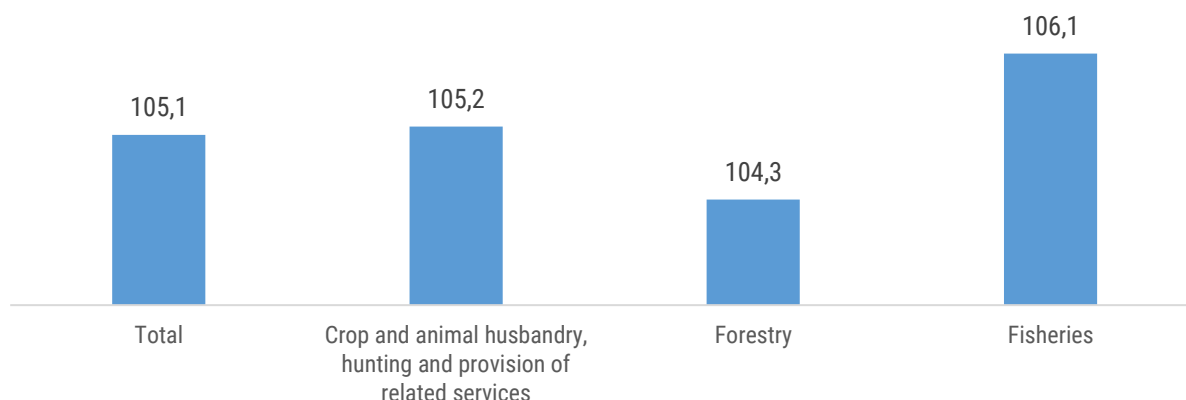

### I. Volume of products (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries

According to preliminary data, the total volume of products (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-March 2026 amounted to **63 384,3** billion soums, including crop and livestock farming, hunting, and service provision in these areas - **59 780,7** billion soums, forestry - **3 063,5** billion soums, fisheries - **540,1** billion soums.

### II. Volume of products (services) in agriculture, forestry and fisheries by regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan

Analyzing the growth rates of agricultural, forestry, and fishery products (services) by region compared to 2024, it should be noted that high growth rates were observed in Surkhandarya (**109,7%**), Syrdarya (**107,8%**), Bukhara (**106,0%**), Andijan (**105,7%**) and Navoi (**105,4%**) regions.

Compared to other regions, lower growth rates were noted in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**102,4%**), Tashkent (**102,4%**), Jizzakh (**104,2%**), Fergana (**104,4%**) and Namangan (**104,6%**) regions.

### III. Agricultural products

In January–March 2026, the volume of agricultural output amounted to **58 451,8 billion soums**, or **104,8%** compared with the corresponding period of 2025. Of this, crop production accounted for **3 867,5 billion soums (127,4%)**, and livestock production for **54 584,3 billion soums (103,3%)**.

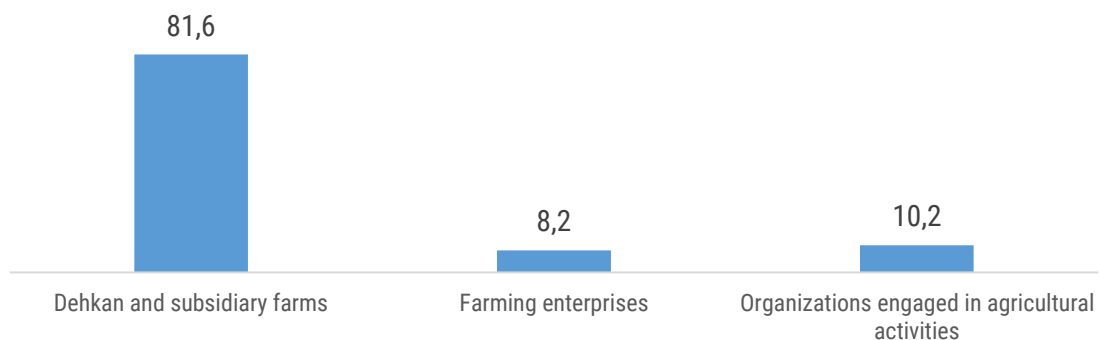
By region, the largest volumes of agricultural output were recorded in the Samarkand (**7 642,3 billion soums**), Tashkent (**6 664,1 billion soums**), Bukhara (**5 589,8 billion soums**) and Surkhandarya (**5 000,1 billion soums**) regions.

In turn, the regions with the smallest volumes were the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**1 751,5 billion soums**), Syrdarya region (**1 790,8 billion soums**) and Navoi region (**3 098,8 billion soums**).

High growth rates were recorded in Surkhandarya (**109,7%**), Syrdarya (**107,7%**) and Bukhara (**105,8%**) regions.

In Tashkent (**101,8%**), Fergana (**103,9%**) and Namangan (**104,0%**) regions, by contrast, lower growth rates were observed compared with other regions.

### Distribution of agricultural production by farm categories, %

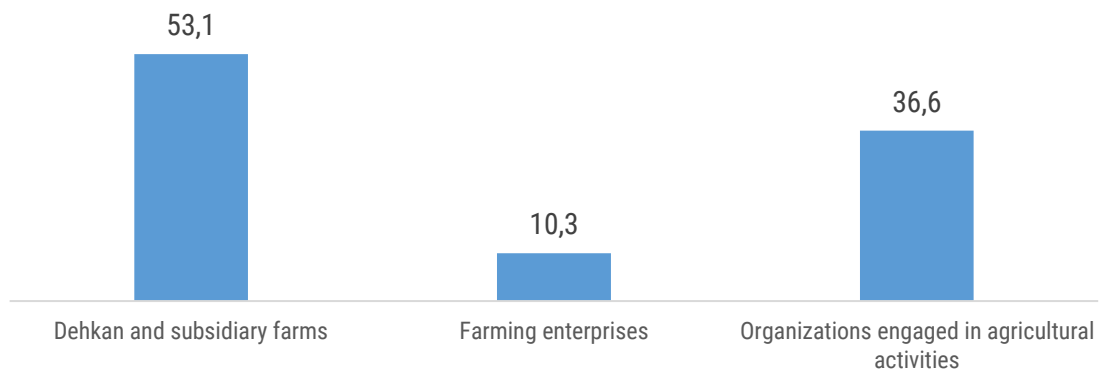


Analysis by farm categories showed that **81,6%** of the total agricultural output is produced by dehqan and subsidiary farms, **8,2%** by farms, and **10,2%** by organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

In the current period, **9,6%** of vegetables were produced by farms, **51,2%** by dehqan and household farms, and **39,2%** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

**Livestock products**

The volume of livestock production in January-March 2026 amounted to **54 584,3 billion soums**, or **103,3%** compared to 2024.

By region, the largest volumes of livestock output were recorded in Samarkand (**7 398,7 billion soums**), Tashkent (**6 194,8 billion soums**), Bukhara (**5 160,6 billion soums**), Kashkadarya (**4 715,9 billion soums**) and Fergana (**4 623,5 billion soums**) regions.

In turn, regions with the smallest volumes are Syrdarya region (**1 625,2 billion soums**), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (**1 608,0 billion soums**) and Navoi region (**2 962,4 billion soums**).

High growth rates were recorded in Syrdarya (**104,9 %**), Khorezm (**104,7 %**), Samarkand (**104,1 %**) and Navoi (**104,0 %**) regions.

Over the period under review, the volume of meat production (live weight) amounted to **102,9 %** compared with the corresponding period of 2025; milk yield – **104,1 %**; eggs obtained – **105,7 %**; wool clip – **128,9 %**; and karakul pelts obtained – **105,0 %**.

In January–March 2026, when analysing data on livestock products produced by category of farms, it should be noted that out of the total volume of meat produced, **6,9 %** is accounted for by farms, **83,4 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **9,7 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

Accordingly, in the structure of milk yield, **9,8 %** is accounted for by farms, **87,7 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **2,5 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

At the same time, in the structure of eggs obtained, **19,0 %** is accounted for by farms, **45,5 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **35,5 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

Likewise, **23,0 %** of the wool clip is accounted for by farms, **65,6 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **11,4 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

In addition, in the structure of karakul pelts obtained, **13,1 %** is accounted for by farms, **81,5 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **5,4 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

In turn, in the structure of fish caught, **39,9 %** is accounted for by farms, **7,0 %** by dehqan and household farms, and **53,1 %** by organisations engaged in agricultural activity.

## V. Methodological explanations and metadata on agriculture, forestry and fisheries

**Gross output of agricultural, forestry and fishery products (services)** is the value of products produced for own consumption and sale in the industry, as well as the total value of services formed on the basis of the gross output (services) of crop production and animal husbandry, hunting, forestry and timber harvesting, fishing and aquaculture.

**Agricultural output** represents a comprehensive indicator of the volume of agricultural production and is defined as the sum of the value of crop and livestock products produced during the reporting period by farms, dehqan and subsidiary farms, and organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

**Farm** - an entrepreneurial entity engaged in the production of agricultural products and other types of activities not prohibited by law, using land plots provided on lease.

**A dehqan farm** is a farm that cultivates and sells agricultural products based on the personal labor of dehqan farm members on a land plot granted to the head of the dehqan farm with the right of lifelong inheritable possession or lease (sublease).

**A subsidiary farm** is a labor activity related to the cultivation (processing) of agricultural products intended for both free trade and family needs on personal household plots.

**Agricultural organizations** are large agricultural organizations, microfirms, and small enterprises engaged in agricultural activities as legal entities, as well as non-agricultural organizations with subsidiary plots.

**Livestock population** includes all age groups of main livestock species (cattle, including cows, sheep and goats, pigs, etc.) by farm category.

**Meat production** includes the live weight of all types of farm animals and poultry, both sold for slaughter and slaughtered on the farm.

**Milk production** is determined by the actual milk yield from cows, goats, sheep, mares, and camels, including milk and colostrum used for feeding young animals. Milk suckled by calves is not included in gross production.

**Egg production** includes the number of eggs obtained from all types of birds, as well as eggs used for hatching chicks by broody hens or in incubators.
