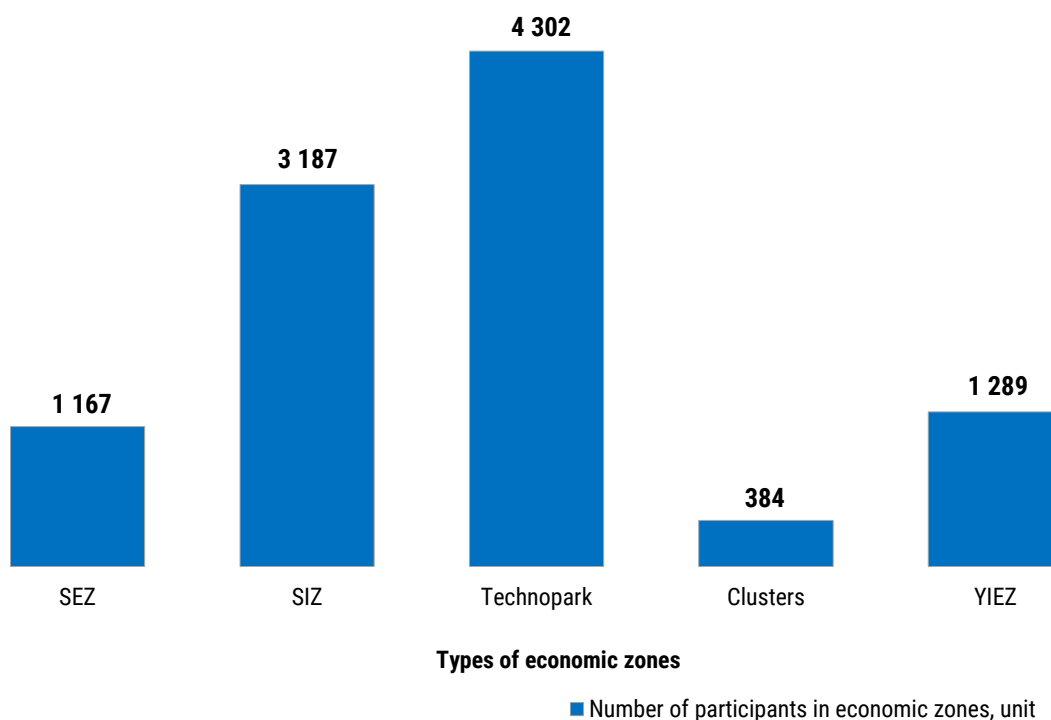

### **I. Number of SEZ, SIZ, technoparks, clusters, and YIEZ that include enterprises with resident status<sup>1</sup>**

As of July 1, 2026, there are 34 special economic zones (hereinafter - SEZ), 400 small industrial zones (hereinafter - SIZ), 27 technoparks, 354 clusters, and 163 youth industrial and entrepreneurial zones (hereinafter - YIEZ) in the country that include enterprises with resident status. These comprise: 1,167 enterprises in SEZ, 3,187 in SIZ, 4,302 in technoparks, 384 in clusters, and 1,289 in YIEZ.

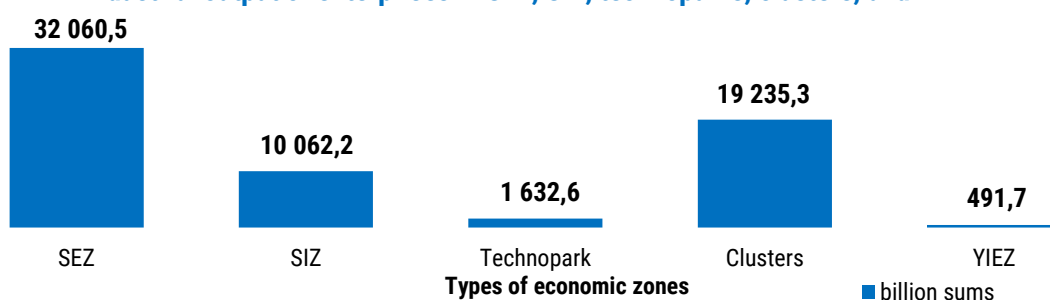
### Industrial output of enterprises in SEZ, SIZ, technoparks, clusters, and YIEZ

The industrial output for the specified period was 32,060.5 billion UZS in SEZ, 10,062.2 billion UZS in SIZ, 1,632.6 billion UZS in technoparks, 19,235.3 billion UZS in clusters, and 491.7 billion UZS in YIEZ.

The highest industrial output was recorded in SEZ at 32,060.5 billion UZS, which is an increase of 21.0% compared to the same period of the previous year.

**For comparison:** in January-June 2025, industrial output was 26,504.1 billion UZS in SEZ, 8,823.1 billion UZS in SIZ, 1,011.2 billion UZS in technoparks, and 16,701.0 billion UZS in clusters.

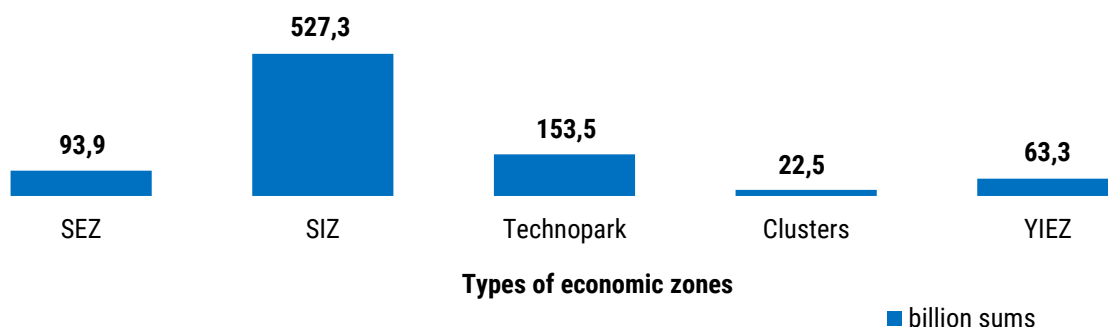

**Volume of construction work performed by enterprises located in SEZ, SIZ, technoparks, clusters, and YIEZ**

The volume of construction work performed in-house during the specified period amounted to 93.9 billion UZS in SEZ, 527.3 billion UZS in SIZ, 153.5 billion UZS in technoparks, 22.5 billion UZS in clusters, and 63.3 billion UZS in YIEZ.

The largest volume of construction work performed in-house was recorded at enterprises located in small industrial zones, at 527.3 billion UZS.

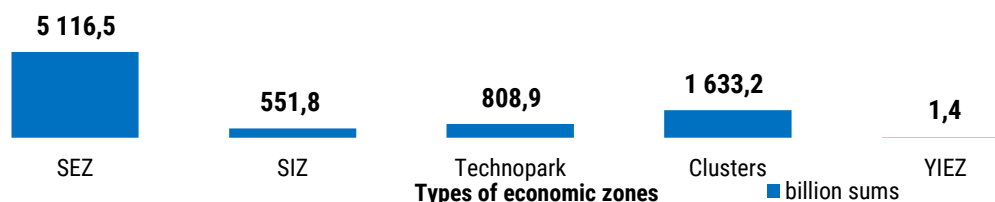

**Volume of investment in fixed assets of enterprises within SEZ, SIZ, technoparks, clusters, and YIEZ**

During the specified period, the volume of investment in fixed assets from all funding sources amounted to 5,116.5 billion UZS in SEZ, 551.8 billion UZS in SIZ, 808.9 billion UZS in technoparks, 1,633.2 billion UZS in clusters, and 1.4 billion UZS in YIEZ.

### IV. Key Performance Indicators of IT Park Participants

In January-June 2026, the volume of export services by IT Park participants amounted to 392.5 million US dollars. Compared to the same period in the previous year, this figure increased by 90.3 million US dollars.

In January-June 2026, the volume of import services by IT Park participants amounted to 160.1 million US dollars.

In January-June 2026, the volume of market services provided by residents of the IT Park amounted to 18,166.4 billion UZS. Compared to the same period in the previous year, this figure increased by 4,111.8 billion UZS.

In January-June 2026, investments in fixed capital from all financing sources by IT Park residents totaled 647.5 billion UZS, an increase of 352.0 billion UZS compared to the same period in the previous year.

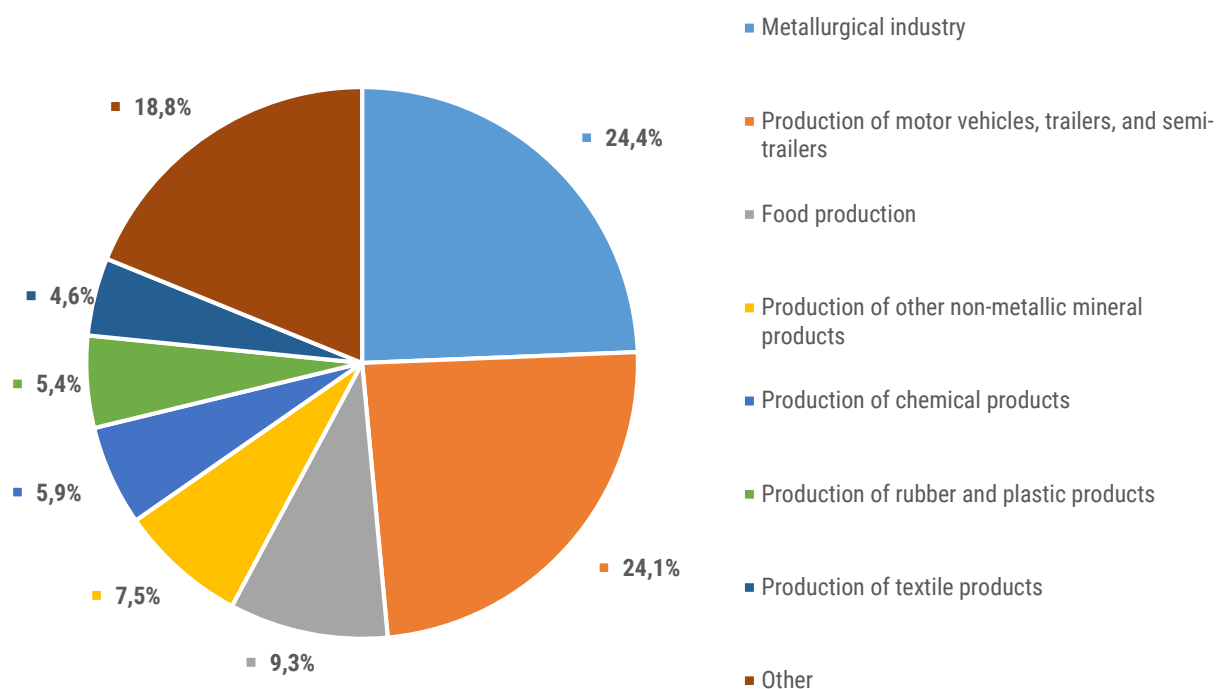

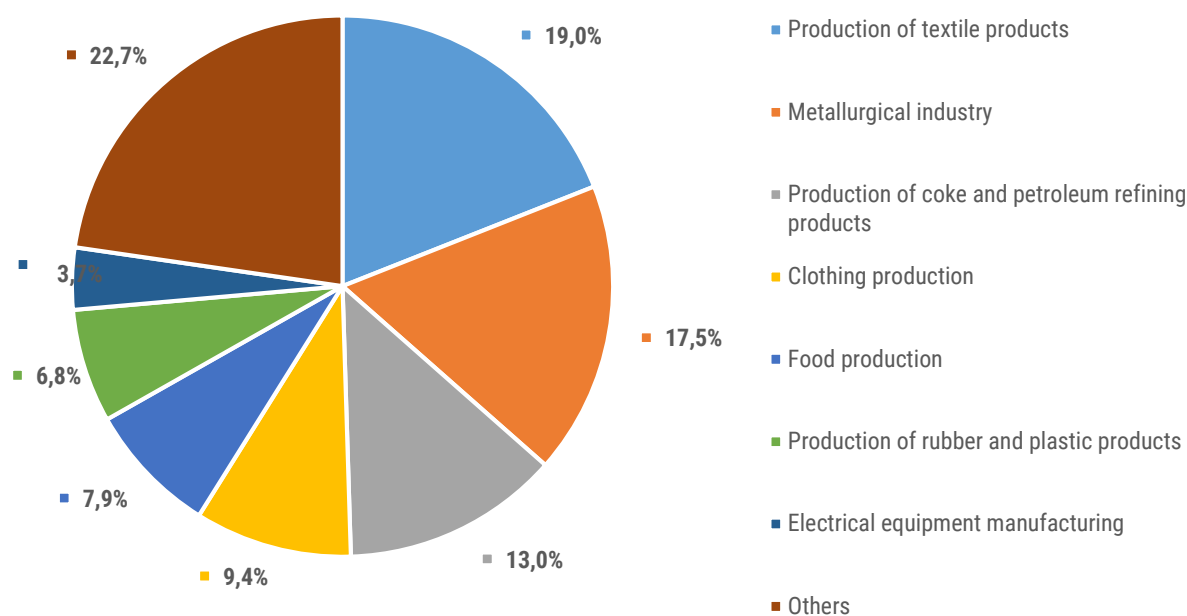


## V. Share of production volume (works, services) by enterprises within SEZ and SIZ, by type of activity

## **VI. Methodological Explanations and Metadata for SEZ, SIZ, Technoparks, Clusters, and YIEZ**

**Special Economic Zone** – a territory with defined borders and a special legal regime, specifically established to attract foreign and domestic investment, advanced technologies, and management expertise for the accelerated socio-economic development of the corresponding region.

**Small Industrial Zone** – a territory that includes a specific land plot and, in some cases, production facilities equipped with engineering and utility infrastructure.

**Youth Industrial and Entrepreneurial Zones** are specially designated territories intended to accelerate the socio-economic development of a given region, provide employment for youth—primarily those included in the "Youth Notebook"—and support the implementation of investment projects by youth entrepreneurship entities.

**Technopark** – a form of integration of commercial and non-commercial science and education organizations, financial institutions, and entrepreneurs, who interact with each other and with state and local self-government bodies, to create a modern technological and organizational environment for conducting entrepreneurial, investment, and scientific activities.

**Cluster** – a form of production organization for the cultivation and deep processing of fruit, vegetable, and agricultural resources; the creation of livestock, fishery, and other complexes; and the manufacturing of competitive, high-tech, and export-oriented textile, food, and other types of products.

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
