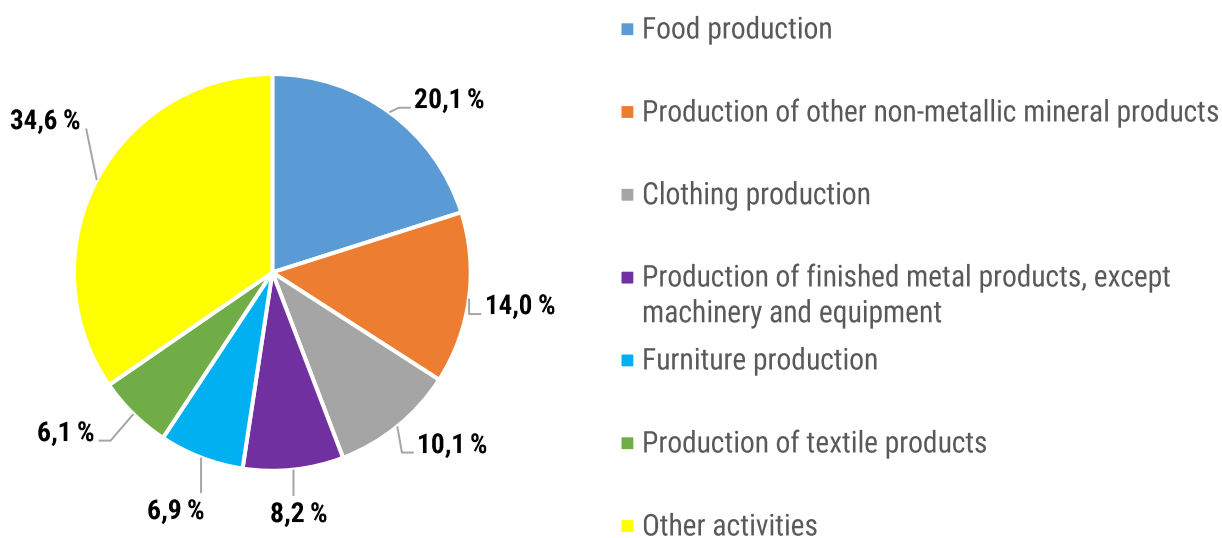

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I. Number of Operating Industrial Enterprises in Uzbekistan

As of July 1, 2026, there were 63,3 thousand operating industrial enterprises in the republic. By main types of economic activity, the largest number of enterprises is in the following sectors:

- Food production – 12,7 thousand (20,1%);
- Production of other non-metallic mineral products – 8,9 thousand (14,0%);
- Apparel manufacturing – 6,4 thousand (10,1%);
- Production of fabricated metal products – 5,2 thousand (8,2%);
- Furniture manufacturing – 4,4 thousand (6,9%);
- Textile manufacturing – 3,9 thousand (6,1%);
- Production of rubber and plastic products – 2,9 thousand (4,7%).

II. Key Indicators of Industry in Uzbekistan

In January-June 2026, enterprises in the republic produced industrial goods worth **637,2** trillion soums. This represents an increase of **8,0** % compared to the same period last year.

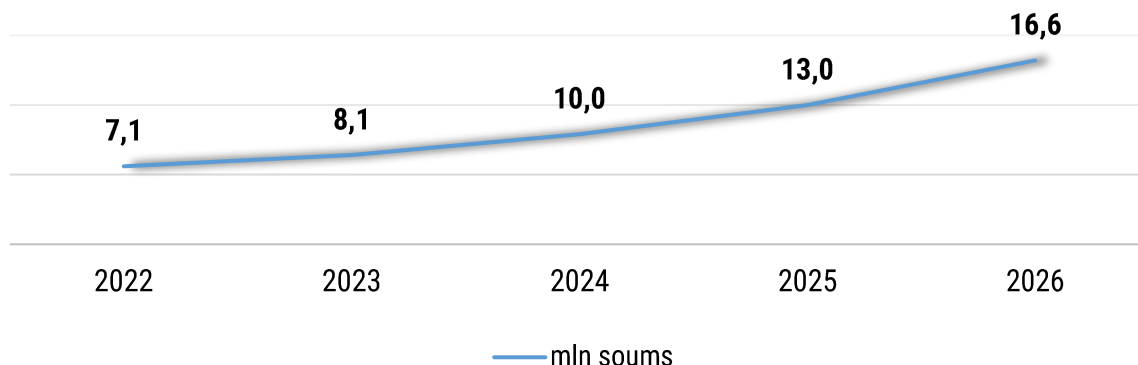
Volume of industrial production per capita

An analysis of the volume of industrial production per capita shows that figures higher than the national average (**16,6** million soums) were recorded in the Navoi Region (**139,0** million soums), the City of Tashkent (**34,3** million soums), and the Tashkent Region (**31,5** million soums).

At the same time, while the growth rate of industrial production per capita for the republic was **106,1**%, the Jizzakh Region (**110,3**%), Samarkand Region (**107,8**%), and Andijan Region (**107,4**%) all recorded figures above the national level.

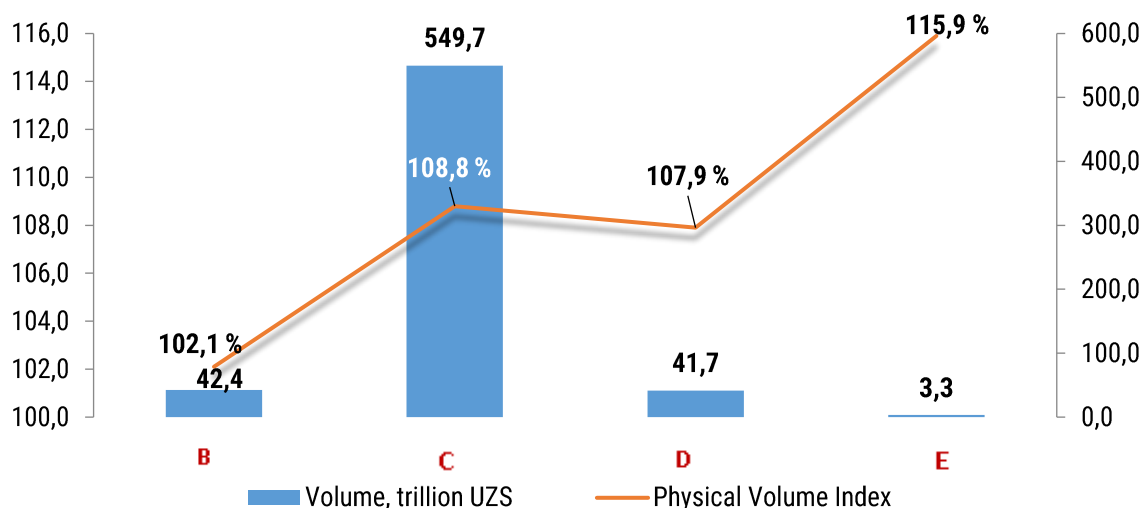

Main industrial sectors

In the structure of industrial production for January-June 2026, the manufacturing industry accounted for the largest share at **549,7** trillion soums, representing a share of total industrial output of **(86,3%)**; mining and quarrying accounted for **42,4** trillion soums **(6,7%)**; electricity, gas, steam, and air conditioning supply accounted for **41,7** trillion soums **(6,5%)**; and water supply, sewerage, waste collection, and disposal accounted for **3,3** trillion soums **(0,5%)**.

The structure of industrial production consists of 4 main sections: B, C, D, and E:

B - Mining and quarrying

C - Manufacturing

D - Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply

E - Water supply; sewerage, waste collection and disposal

III. Production of selected industrial goods by large industrial enterprises

In January-June 2026, the republic produced the following:

Natural gas – **18,3** billion m³, oil – **313,8** thousand tons, coal – **2,5** million tons, motor gasoline – **614,2** thousand tons, diesel fuel – **568,0** thousand tons, Portland cement – **10,1** million tons, yarn – **433,6** thousand tons, soft wheat and spelt flour – **724,1** thousand tons.

Industrial production volumes for selected types of economic activity within the manufacturing industry

In the manufacturing industry, the share of food, beverage, and tobacco production is **16,8%**; the share of textile, apparel, leather, and leather goods production is **13,9%**; the share of fabricated metal products (excluding machinery and equipment), computers, electronic and optical products, electrical equipment, machinery and equipment not elsewhere classified, motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, other transport equipment, as well as the repair and installation of machinery and equipment is **16,3%**; and the share of chemical, rubber, and plastic products is **6,6%**.

By section: Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply

In January-June 2026, 44 140,8 million kWh of electricity was generated, which is 5,7% more than in the corresponding period of the previous year (excluding electricity generated by small businesses and households for which electricity production is not a primary activity).

The volume of heat energy produced by large enterprises decreased by 18,1 percent.

In January–June 2026, no gas was produced through underground coal gasification.

**By section: Water supply, sewerage, waste collection, and disposal
(for large enterprises)**

Compared to the same period of the previous year, the volume of textile waste increased by **12,7** percent, and services for wastewater disposal, transportation, and treatment increased by **12,3** percent.

IV. Methodological Notes and Metadata

Data on the volume of industrial production by product type are compiled using codes from the Statistical Classifier of Products (Goods, Works, Services) of the Republic of Uzbekistan by Type of Economic Activity (O'zDSt 2914:2014). This includes the mining and quarrying industry, manufacturing industry, electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply, water supply, wastewater treatment, and waste collection and processing services (Sections B, C, D, E).

In some cases, minor discrepancies between the total and the sum of its components are due to data rounding.

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
