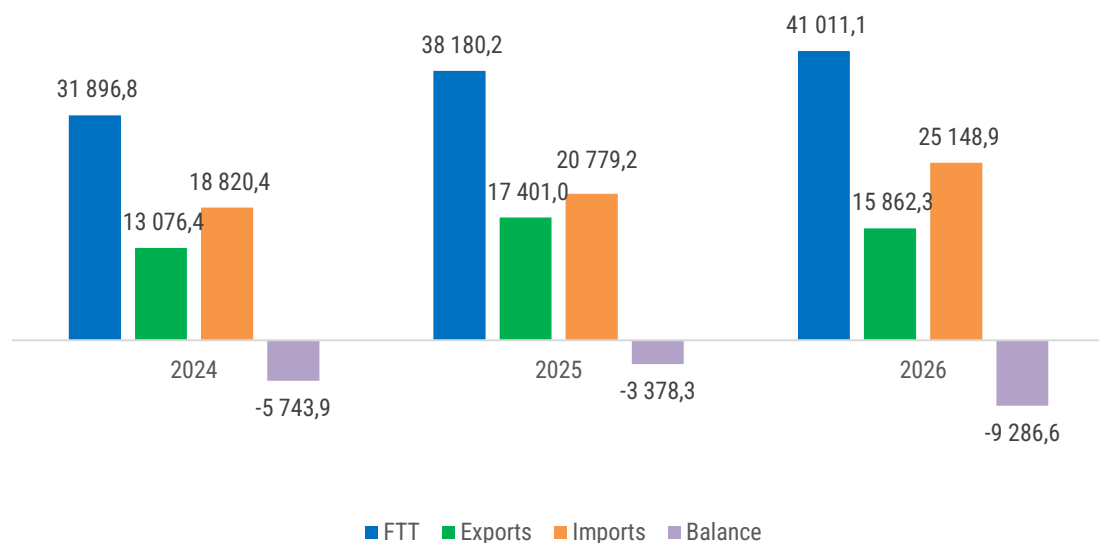
Preliminary data for January-June 2026

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I. Foreign trade turnover

In January-June 2026, Uzbekistan's foreign trade turnover (FTT) amounted to USD 41,0 billion, increasing by USD 2,8 billion, or 7,4%, compared with the corresponding period of 2025.

Foreign trade turnover*, January-June, USD million



Within total FTT, exports amounted to USD 15,9 billion (down 8,8% from January-June 2025), while imports reached USD 25,1 billion (up 21,0% from January-June 2025). Consequently, a trade deficit of USD 9,3 billion was recorded.

At the same time, excluding gold, merchandise exports increased by 28,7% year on year to USD 8,2 billion.

Uzbekistan maintains trade relations with more than 195 countries. The largest shares of its foreign trade turnover were accounted for by China (23,1%), the Russian Federation (17,1%), Kazakhstan (6,8%), Türkiye (3,4%) and Afghanistan (2,6%).

Goods accounted for 60,9% of total exports. Manufactured goods made up 15,2%, miscellaneous manufactured articles 8,6%, food and live animals 8,3%, and chemicals and related products 8,1%.

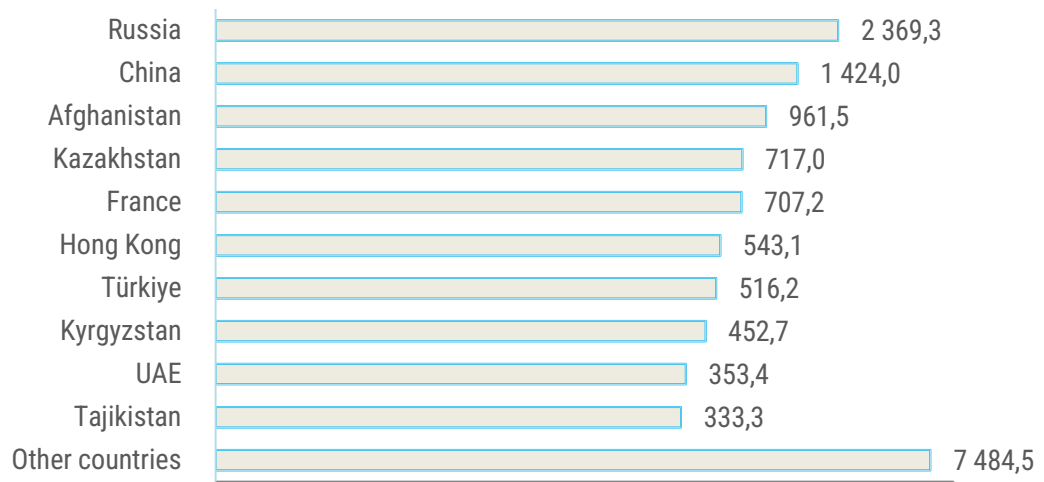

In January-June 2026, Uzbekistan's main export partners for goods and services were the Russian Federation (14,9%), China (9,0%), Afghanistan (6,1%), Kazakhstan (4,5%), France (4,5%), Hong Kong (3,4%), Türkiye (3,3%), the Kyrgyz Republic (2,9%) and the United Arab Emirates (2,2%). Together, they accounted for more than 50,0% of total exports.

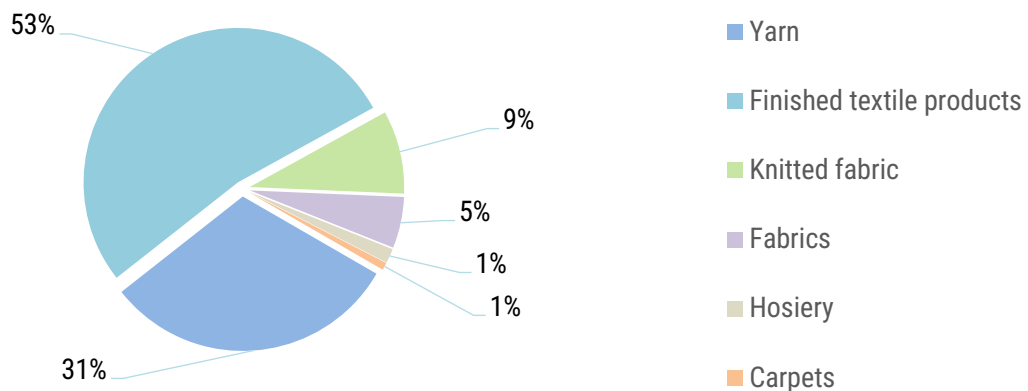

In January-June 2026, exports of fruit and vegetables amounted to USD 872,9 million, up 3,0% from the corresponding period of 2025 and accounting for 5,5% of total exports.

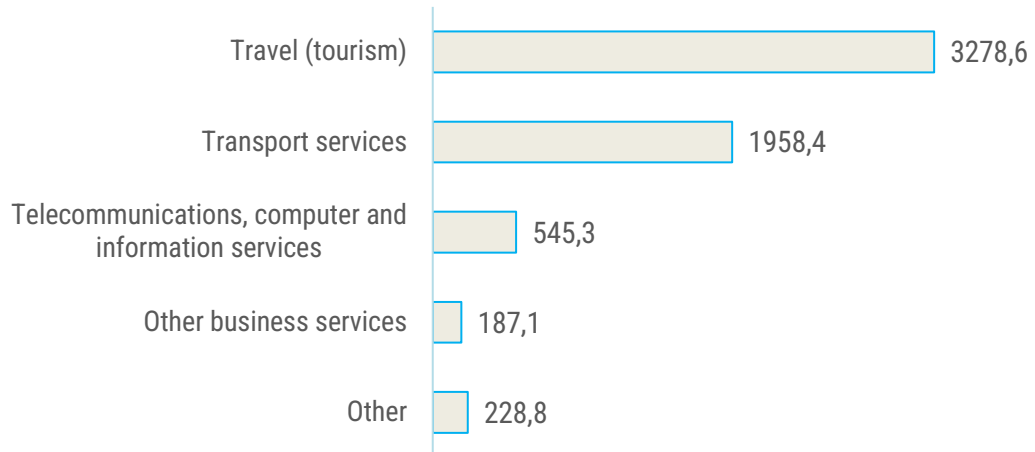
Composition of textile exports



In January-June 2026, textile products worth USD 1,6 billion were exported. They accounted for 10,1% of total exports, an increase of 24,1% from the corresponding period of 2025.

Finished textile products (52,6%) and yarn (31,1%) accounted for the largest shares of textile exports.

In January-June 2026, exports of services amounted to USD 6,2 billion, accounting for 39,1% of total exports and increasing by 35,7% from the corresponding period of 2025. Travel (tourism) accounted for 52,9% of service exports, transport services 31,6%, telecommunications, computer and information services 8,8%, and other business services 3,0%.

III. Import indicators

Imports amounted to USD 25,1 billion during the period, up 21,0% from January-June 2025. Machinery and transport equipment accounted for the largest share (32,8%), followed by manufactured goods (14,8%) and chemicals and related products (12,1%).

In January-June 2026, imports of goods increased by USD 4,0 billion from the corresponding period of 2025 to USD 22,2 billion, while imports of services amounted to USD 3,0 billion.

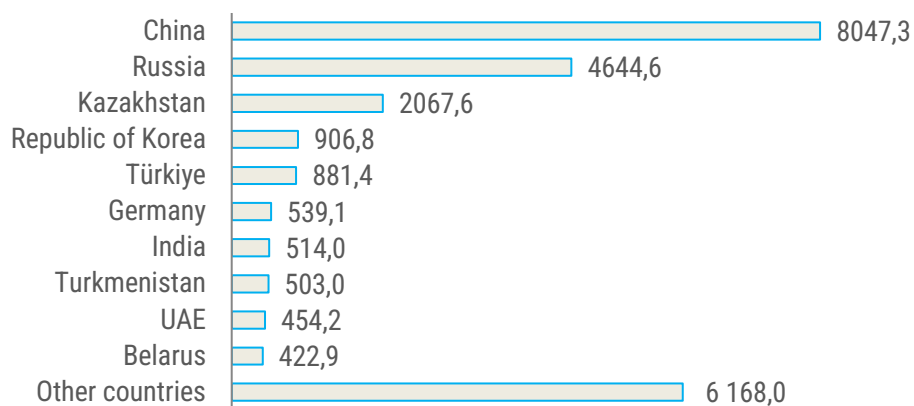

In January-June 2026, Uzbekistan imported goods and services from more than 155 countries. More than 70,0% of total imports came from major partners including China (32,0%), the Russian Federation (18,5%), Kazakhstan (8,2%), the Republic of Korea (3,6%), Türkiye (3,5%), Germany (2,1%) and India (2,0%).

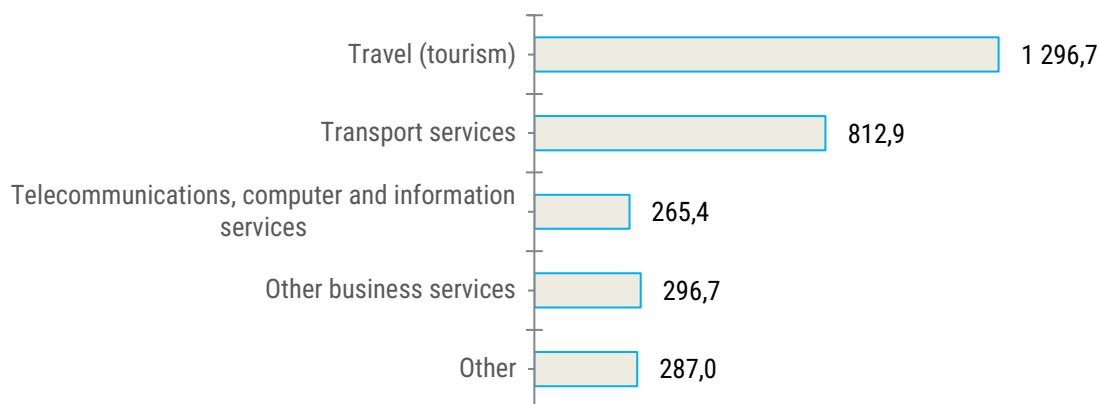

In January-June 2026, imports of services amounted to USD 3,0 billion, or 11,8% of total imports, and increased by 12,3% from the corresponding period of the previous year.

Travel (tourism) accounted for the largest share of service imports (43,8%), followed by transport services (27,5%), other business services (10,0%), and telecommunications, computer and information services (9,0%).

IV. Methodological notes

In compiling Uzbekistan's foreign trade statistics for goods, both the Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity (CN FEA) and the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) are used. SITC codes are assigned to goods using conversion keys between the CN FEA and SITC.

Foreign trade statistics are compiled from data on trade in goods and services. Cargo customs declarations of the Customs Committee, together with statistical surveys of the National Statistics Committee covering goods that do not cross the state border, are not included in customs declarations, and are transferred by residents to non-residents, constitute the source data for foreign trade in goods statistics. Foreign trade in services statistics are compiled from statistical surveys.

In some cases, minor differences between totals and the sum of their components are due to rounding.
