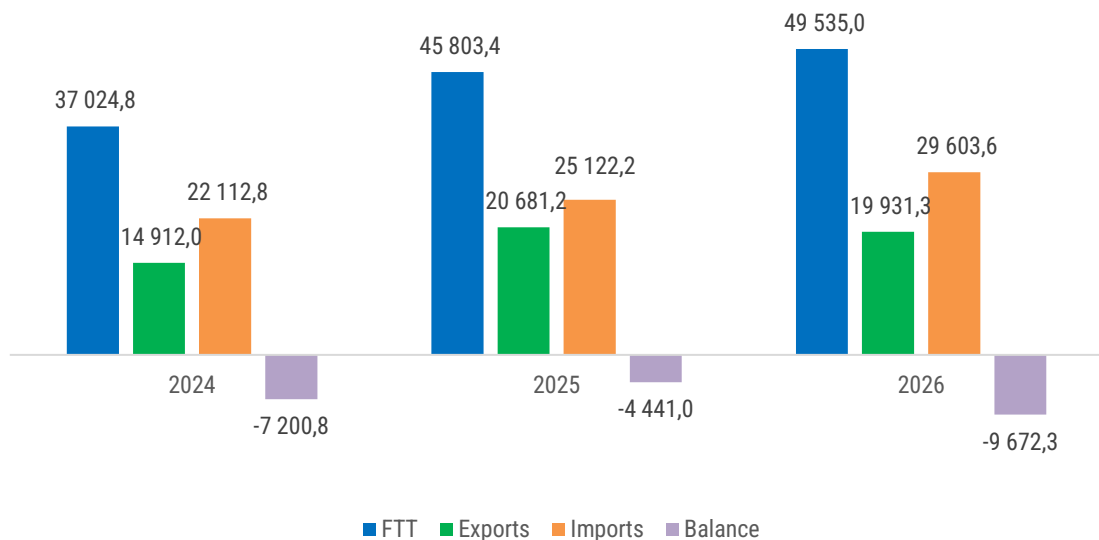

I. Foreign trade turnover

In January-July 2026, Uzbekistan's foreign trade turnover (FTT) amounted to USD 49,5 billion, increasing by USD 3,7 billion, or 8,1%, compared with the corresponding period of 2025.

Foreign trade turnover*, January-July, USD million



Within total FTT, exports amounted to USD 19,9 billion (down 3,6% from January-July 2025), while imports reached USD 29,6 billion (up 17,8% from January-July 2025). Consequently, a trade deficit of USD 9,7 billion was recorded.

At the same time, excluding gold, merchandise exports increased by 27,7% year on year to USD 9,8 billion.

Uzbekistan maintains trade relations with more than 200 countries. The largest shares of its foreign trade turnover were accounted for by China (22,7%), the Russian Federation (16,4%), Kazakhstan (6,6%), Türkiye (3,3%) and Afghanistan (2,5%).

Goods accounted for 63,2% of total exports. Manufactured goods made up 14,4%, miscellaneous manufactured articles 8,4%, chemicals and related products 7,8%, and food and live animals 7,7%.

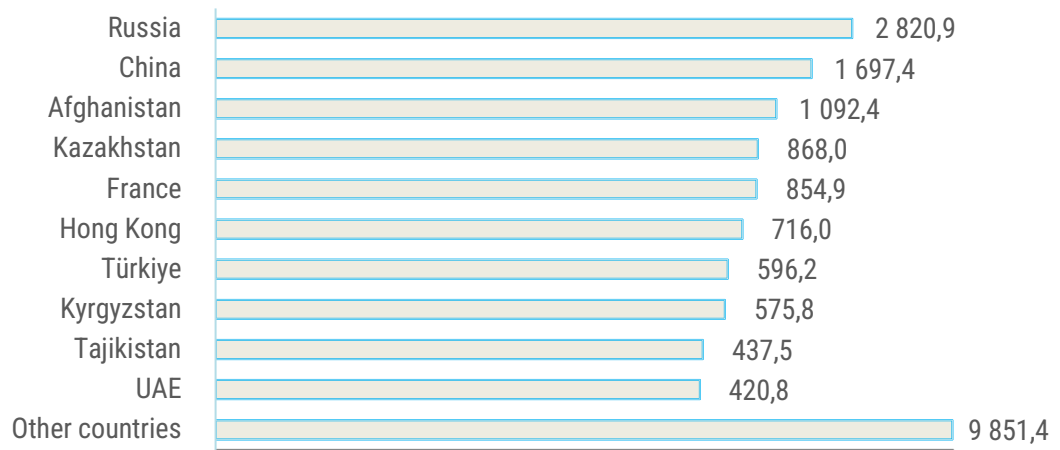

In January-July 2026, Uzbekistan's main export partners for goods and services were the Russian Federation (14,2%), China (8,5%), Afghanistan (5,5%), Kazakhstan (4,4%), France (4,3%), Hong Kong (3,6%), Türkiye (3,0%), the Kyrgyz Republic (2,9%), Tajikistan (2,2%) and the United Arab Emirates (2,1%). Together, they accounted for more than 50,0% of total exports.

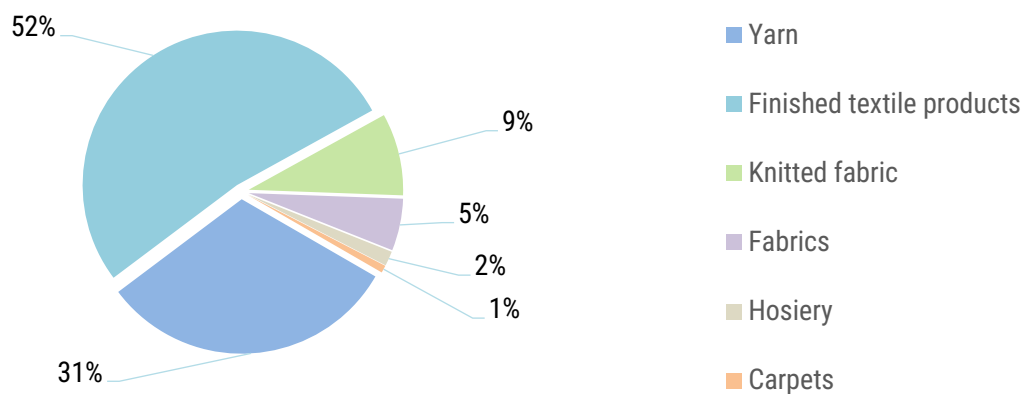
In January-July 2026, exports of fruit and vegetable products reached 1 283,9 thousand tonnes, up by 0,4%, or 5,5 thousand tonnes, from the corresponding period of 2025.

In January-July 2026, exports of fruit and vegetables amounted to USD 1 025,4 million, down 3,9% from the corresponding period of 2025 and accounting for 5,1% of total exports.

Composition of textile exports



In January-July 2026, textile products worth USD 1,9 billion were exported. They accounted for 9,5% of total exports, an increase of 26,6% from the corresponding period of 2025.

Finished textile products (52,2%) and yarn (31,4%) accounted for the largest shares of textile exports.

In January-July 2026, exports of services amounted to USD 7,3 billion, accounting for 36,8% of total exports and increasing by 35,3% from the corresponding period of 2025. Travel (tourism) accounted for 53,8% of service exports, transport services 31,7%, telecommunications, computer and information services 8,5%, and other business services 2,9%.

III. Import indicators

Imports amounted to USD 29,6 billion during the period, up 17,8% from January-July 2025. Machinery and transport equipment accounted for the largest share (32,8%), followed by manufactured goods (14,8%) and chemicals and related products (12,1%).

In January-July 2026, imports of goods increased by USD 4,1 billion from the corresponding period of 2025 to USD 26,0 billion, while imports of services amounted to USD 3,6 billion.

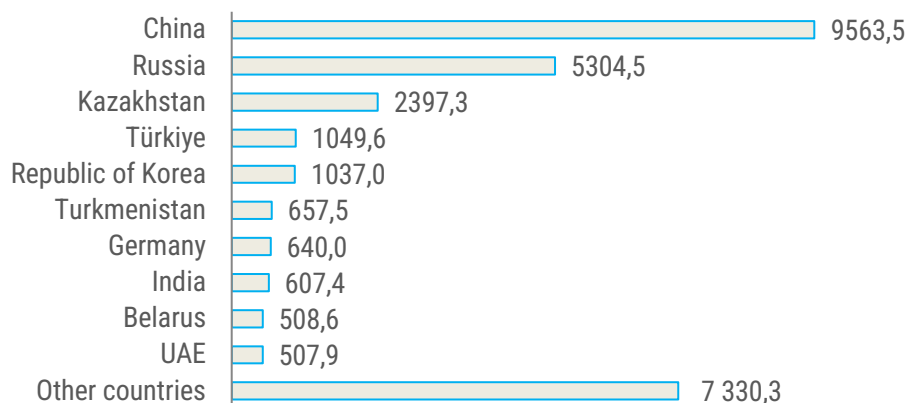

In January-July 2026, Uzbekistan imported goods and services from more than 160 countries. More than 65,0% of total imports came from major partners including China (32,3%), the Russian Federation (17,9%), Kazakhstan (8,1%), Türkiye (3,5%), the Republic of Korea (3,5%), Turkmenistan (2,2%) and Germany (2,2%).

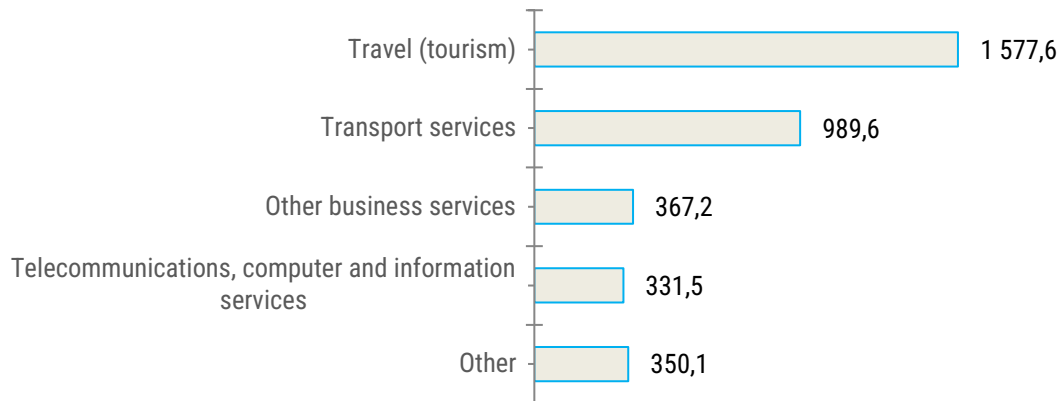

In January-July 2026, imports of services amounted to USD 3,6 billion, or 12,2% of total imports, and increased by 13,3% from the corresponding period of the previous year.

Travel (tourism) accounted for the largest share of service imports (43,6%), followed by transport services (27,4%), other business services (10,2%), and telecommunications, computer and information services (9,2%).

IV. Methodological notes

In compiling Uzbekistan's foreign trade statistics for goods, both the Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity (CN FEA) and the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) are used. SITC codes are assigned to goods using conversion keys between the CN FEA and SITC.

Foreign trade statistics are compiled from data on trade in goods and services. Cargo customs declarations of the Customs Committee, together with the National Statistics Committee's statistical surveys covering goods that do not cross the state border or are not included in customs declarations, as well as goods transferred by residents to non-residents, constitute the source data for foreign trade in goods statistics; foreign trade in services statistics are compiled from statistical surveys.

In some cases, minor differences between totals and the sum of their components are due to rounding.
