

Demographic situation in the Republic of Uzbekistan

For January-June 2026

In accordance with Resolution No. 629 of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated 7 October 2025, "On Measures for Conducting the Population and Agricultural Census in the Republic of Uzbekistan," **the final results of the Population and Agricultural Census shall be prepared by 1 July 2027.**

Following the official publication of the final census results, data on the permanent population compiled on the basis of the census results will be disseminated in accordance with the established procedure.

In this regard, **the demographic indicators as of 1 July 2026** have been compiled based on the integrated data of the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs.

I. Main demographic indicators

As of 1 July 2026, **excluding the preliminary census results**, the permanent population of Uzbekistan amounted to **38 519,5** thousand people, representing a **1.7%** increase compared with the same period of 2025. In January-June 2026, there were **373,4** thousand live births and **86,9** thousand deaths, resulting in a natural increase of **286,5** thousand people. The number of immigrants from foreign countries amounted to **1 649** people, while the number of those who emigrated abroad totaled **5 422**. During this period, **92,3** thousand marriages and **24,8** thousand divorces were registered.

II. Permanent population

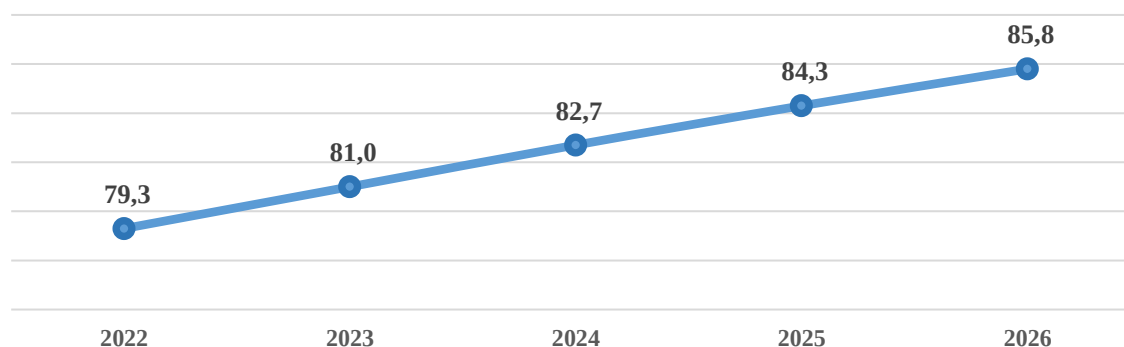
The permanent population in urban areas was **19 608,9** thousand people (**50,9%** of the total population), while in rural areas it was **18 910,6** thousand people (**49,1%**). Of these, **19 118,9** thousand are women (**49,6%**) and **19 400,6** thousand are men (**50,4%**).

In Uzbekistan, as of 1 July 2026, the population density across the country was **85,8** people per square kilometer. This is **1,5** people more compared to the corresponding period of 2025 (as of 1 July 2025, there were **84,3** people per 1 sq. km).

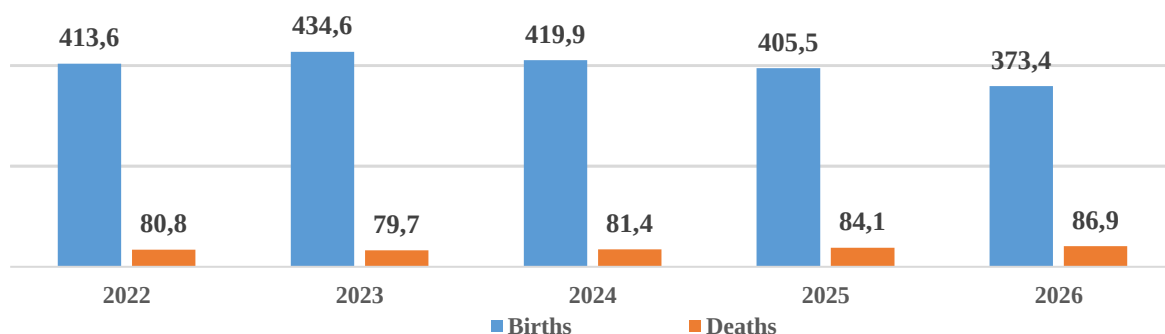

III. Births and deaths

The number of live births in January–June 2026 was 373,4 thousand people, with the birth rate per thousand population at **19,6** per mille. The number of births in January-June 2026 decreased by **32,1** thousand compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

The number of deaths recorded in January-June 2026 was **86,9** thousand people, with the mortality rate per thousand population at **4,6** per mille. The number of deaths in January-June of this year increased by **2,8** thousand compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

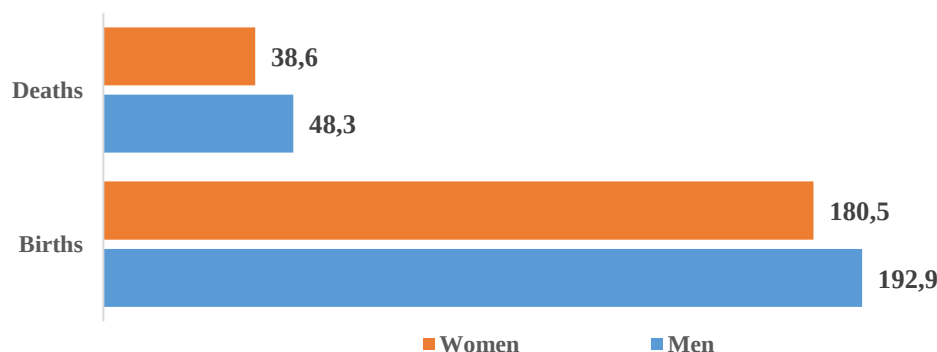
Number of births and deaths in January–June, thousand people



The number of live births in the republic during the period under review totaled **373,4** thousand people. Of these, **192,9** thousand (**51,7** % of total births) were boys and **180,5** thousand (**48,3** %) were girls. Of these, **182,9** thousand (**49,0** % of total births) were born in urban areas and **190,5** thousand (**51,0** %) in rural areas.

The total number of deaths in the republic during this period was **86,9** thousand people. Of these, **48,3** thousand (**55,6** % of total deaths) were men and **38,6** thousand (**44,4** %) were women. Of these, **47,3** thousand (**54,4** % of total deaths) lived in urban areas and **39,6** thousand (**45,6** %) in rural areas.

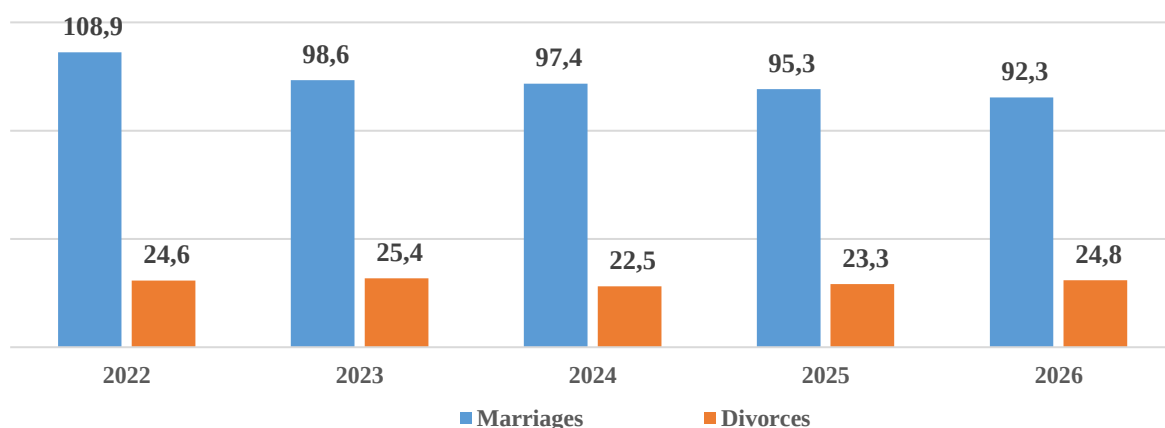

IV. Marriages and divorces

In Uzbekistan, **92,3** thousand marriages were registered in January-June 2026, with the marriage rate per thousand population being **4,9** per mille. The number of marriages decreased by **3,0** thousand compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

In January-June 2026, **24,8** thousand divorces were registered, with the divorce rate per thousand population being **1,3** per mille. The number of divorces in January-June 2026 increased by **1,5** thousand compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

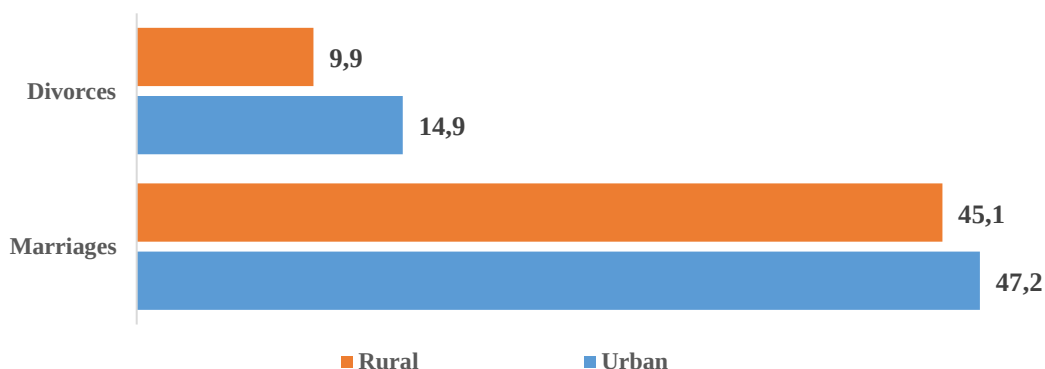
Number of registered marriages and divorces in January-June, thousand units



The number of registered marriages in the republic amounted to **92,3** thousand units, of which **47,2** thousand units (**51,1** %) were in urban areas and **45,1** thousand units (**48,9**%) in rural areas.

The number of divorces amounted to **24,8** thousand units, of which **14,9** thousand units (**60,1**%) were in urban areas and **9,9** thousand units (**39,9**%) in rural areas.

V. Population migration

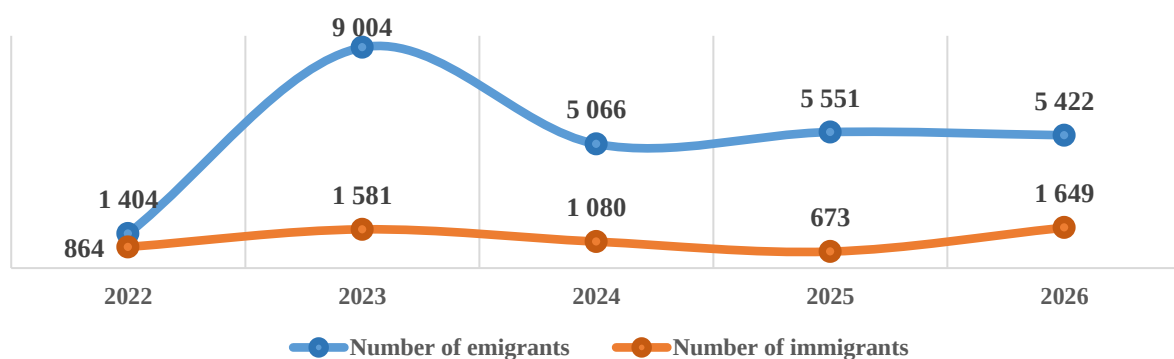
In January-June 2026, the total number of immigrants to the republic amounted to **185 570** people, including **183 921** migrants from other regions of the republic and **1 649** migrants from foreign countries.

The total number of emigrants was **189 343** people, including **183 921** migrants to other regions of the republic and **5 422** migrants to foreign countries.

VI. Methodological explanations and metadata of demographic indicators

In order to form demographic indicators, the National Statistics Committee, in cooperation with the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs, has established an interagency electronic data exchange between the relevant administrative information systems.

Since all data required for the formation of demographic indicators is obtained electronically through integration, a separate form of statistical observation has not been approved.

To form data describing demographic indicators, the statistical authorities process administrative data on vital events and population migration obtained from other government bodies. (the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Internal Affairs).

Official statistics on demographic indicators are compiled based on the following administrative data sources:

- birth registration record;
- death registration record;
- marriage registration record;
- divorce registration record;
- statistical registration sheet of arrival;
- data of the statistical registration sheet of departure.
