FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER



The economic reforms carried out in our republic serve the rapid growth of trade relations with foreign countries. In particular, the decisions taken to increase export potential will allow local companies to gain more experience in working in foreign markets. Ultimately they will have a competitive advantage in global trade.

As a result of the measures taken in the republic in recent years to stimulate exports, optimize imports and, in general, to ensure a balanced foreign trade, in January-December 2023 the foreign trade turnover in the country amounted to 62.6 billion US dollars and increased compared to the same period in 2022, by 12.1 billion US dollars, or by 23.9%.

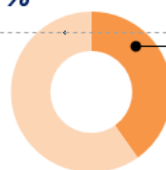

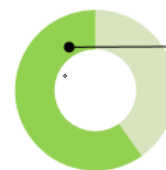

Foreign trade turnover is the sum of the values of a country's exports and imports for a certain period. Statistics of foreign trade in goods keeps records of goods that are added to or subtracted from stocks of material resources as a result of their entry (import) into the customs territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan or their exportation (export) outside the customs territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the **basis of a general system of accounting for foreign trade**.

Of the total FTT volume, exports amounted to 24 426.2 million US dollars (an increase of 23.8% was noted by January-December 2023), and imports amounted to 38 141.2 million US dollars (an increase of 24.0%). As a result, the balance of foreign trade turnover amounted to a negative balance in the amount of -13 715.0 million US dollars.

Today, the Republic of Uzbekistan carries out trade relations with 198 countries of the world. The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with China (21.9%), Russia (15.8%), Kazakhstan (7.0%), Türkiye (5.0%) and the Republic of Korea (3.7%).

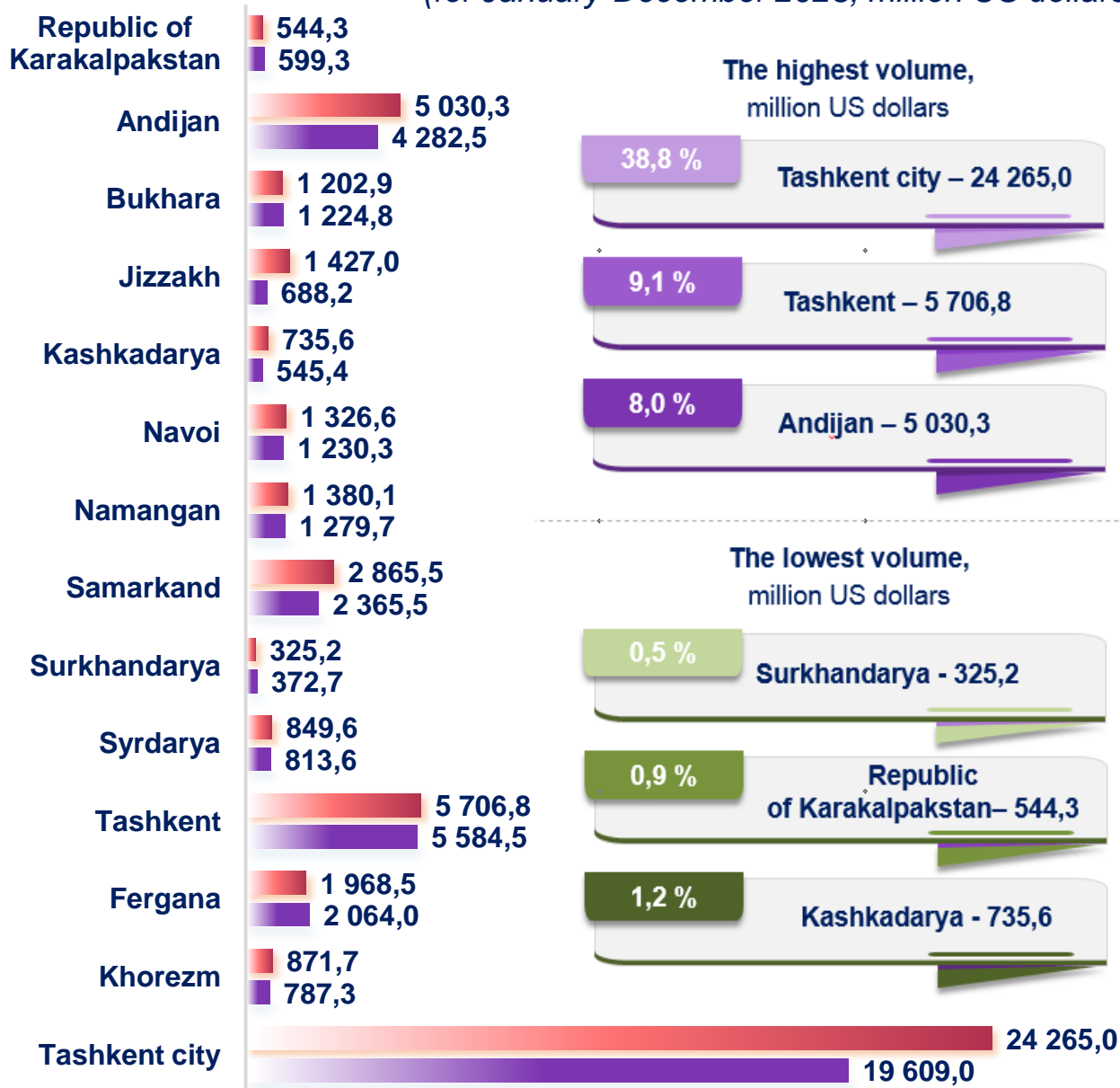

(for January-December 2023, million US dollars)*



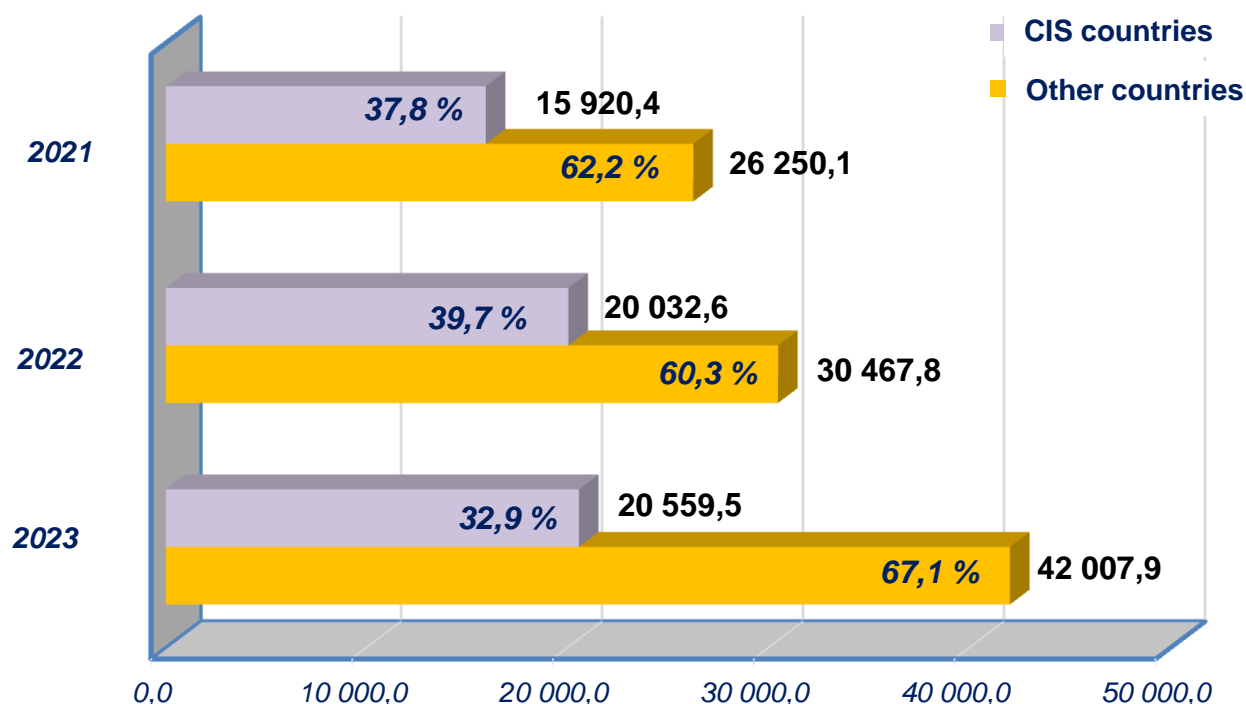

In the structure of the foreign trade turnover of the republic, a significant share is noted in Tashkent city, which is 38.8%, or 24 265.0 million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded at 0.5%, or 325.2 million US dollars, in Surkhandarya region.

DYNAMICS OF THE VOLUME OF CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES IN FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-December 2023, million US dollars, share)



The share of foreign trade turnover of the CIS countries during the period under review, compared to the same period in 2022, decreased by 6.8% and their share in foreign trade turnover, based on the results of January-December 2023, amounted to 32.9%.



The volume of foreign trade turnover of other countries for January-December 2023, compared to the same period in 2022, respectively increased by 6.8% and amounted to 67.1% of the total foreign trade turnover.

The foreign trade turnover of Uzbekistan with the CIS countries reached 20 559.5 million US dollars, of which the export volume amounted to 8 092.6 million US dollars, and the import volume amounted to 12 466.9 million US dollars.



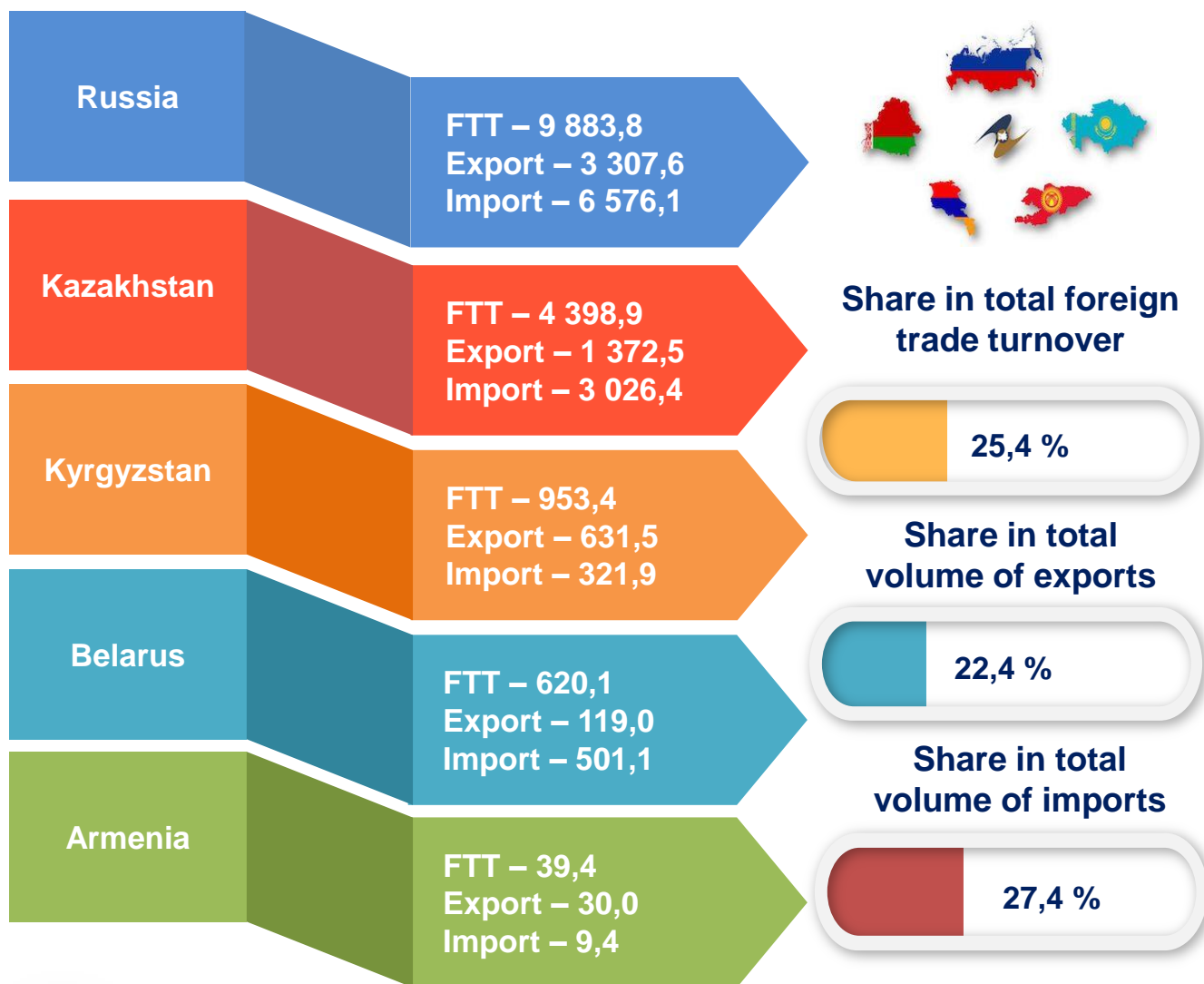

The largest volume of foreign trade turnover with the CIS countries was recorded with Russia (48.1%), Kazakhstan (21.4%) and Turkmenistan (5.3%).

FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN WITH THE EAEU COUNTRIES

 The foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the EAEU countries during the period under review amounted to 15 895.6 million US dollars, of which the export volume was 5 460.7 million US dollars, and the import volume was 10 434.9 million US dollars.

It should be noted that a common economic territory with a unified customs system has been formed between the EAEU member states (Russia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Armenia and Kyrgyzstan), ensuring freedom of movement of goods and services, movement of migrants and movement of capital.

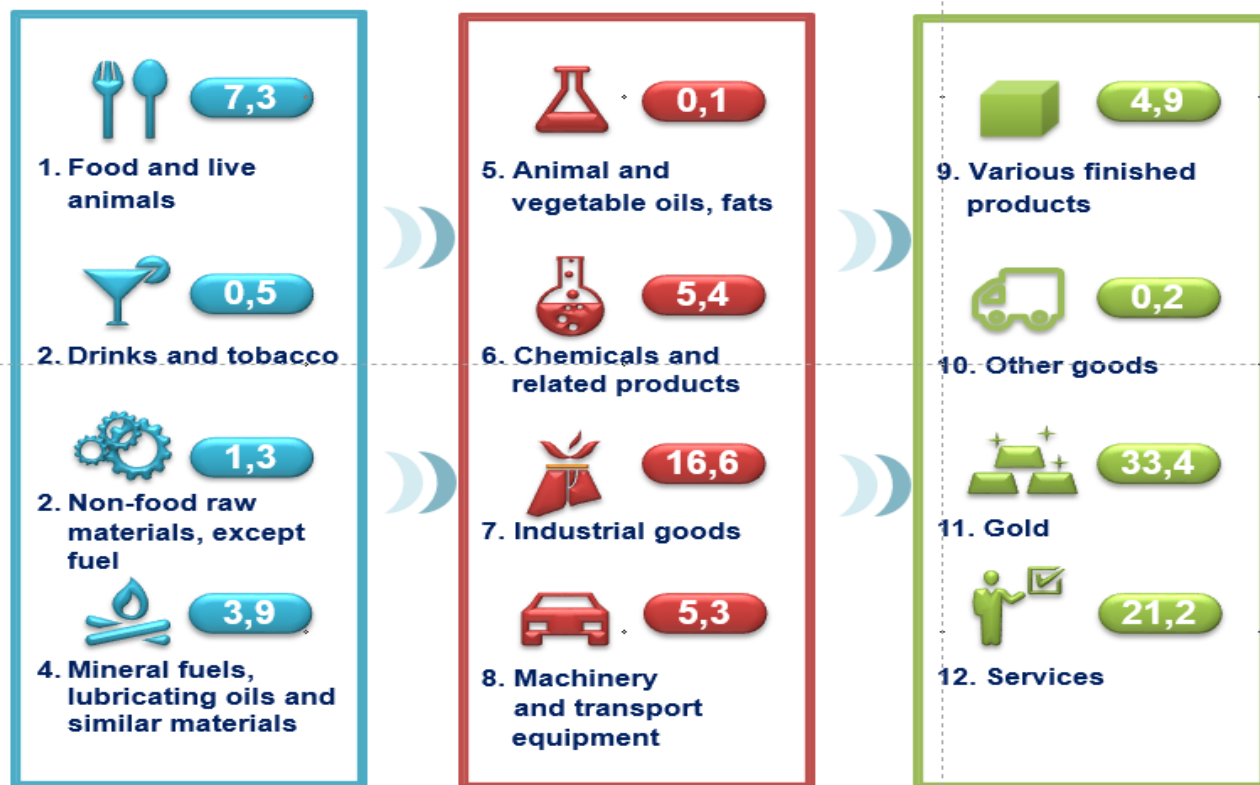


EXPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-December 2023)

The development of international economic relations contributes to stable growth of exports, and this, in turn, creates the basis for achieving certain results. Based on the reforms carried out aimed at increasing the country's export potential, supporting exporters from the state and expanding the range of export products, the number of exporters reached 7 255 and the volume of exports of goods and services amounted to 16 272.4 million US dollars (in addition to non-monetary gold) and , compared to the same period in 2022, increased by 4.5%.

When generating statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (hereinafter referred to as SITC) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods. Assignment of SITC codes to goods is carried out using transition keys between the Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity and SITC.

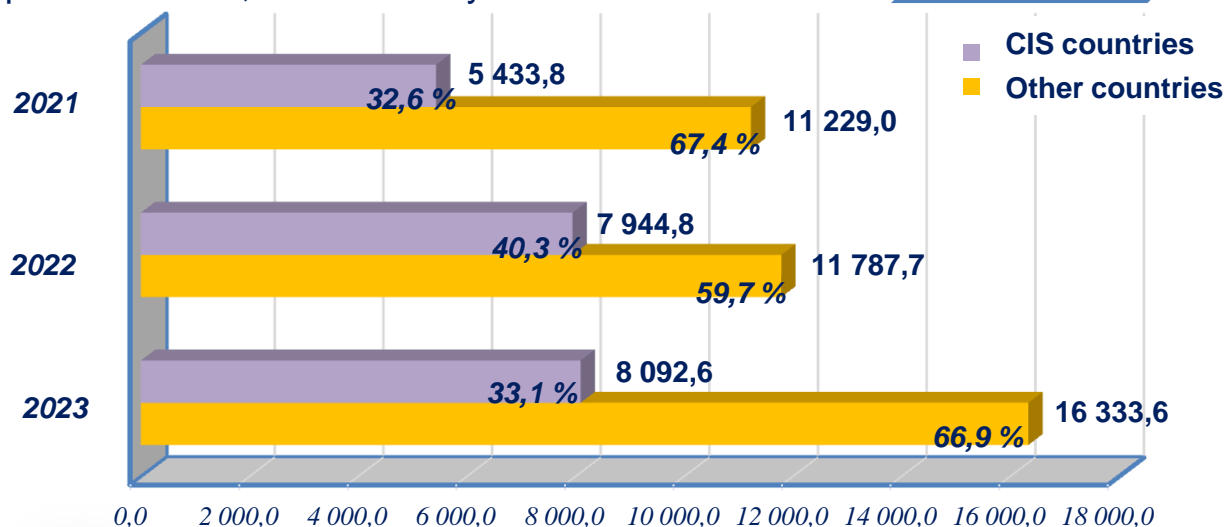

In the statistics of foreign trade of Uzbekistan, partner countries include: when importing, the country of origin of the goods, and if the country of origin is unclear, then the country of the sender. For export, this is the country where the goods are sent.

DYNAMICS OF EXPORT VOLUME TO THE CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES (for January-December 2023, million US dollars, share)

The share of exports from CIS countries in January-December 2023, compared to the same period in 2022, decreased by 7.1%.



Our main partners for the export of goods and services in foreign trade turnover in January-December 2023 were countries such as Russia, China, Kazakhstan, Türkiye, Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan. Their share in total exports reached 40.4%.

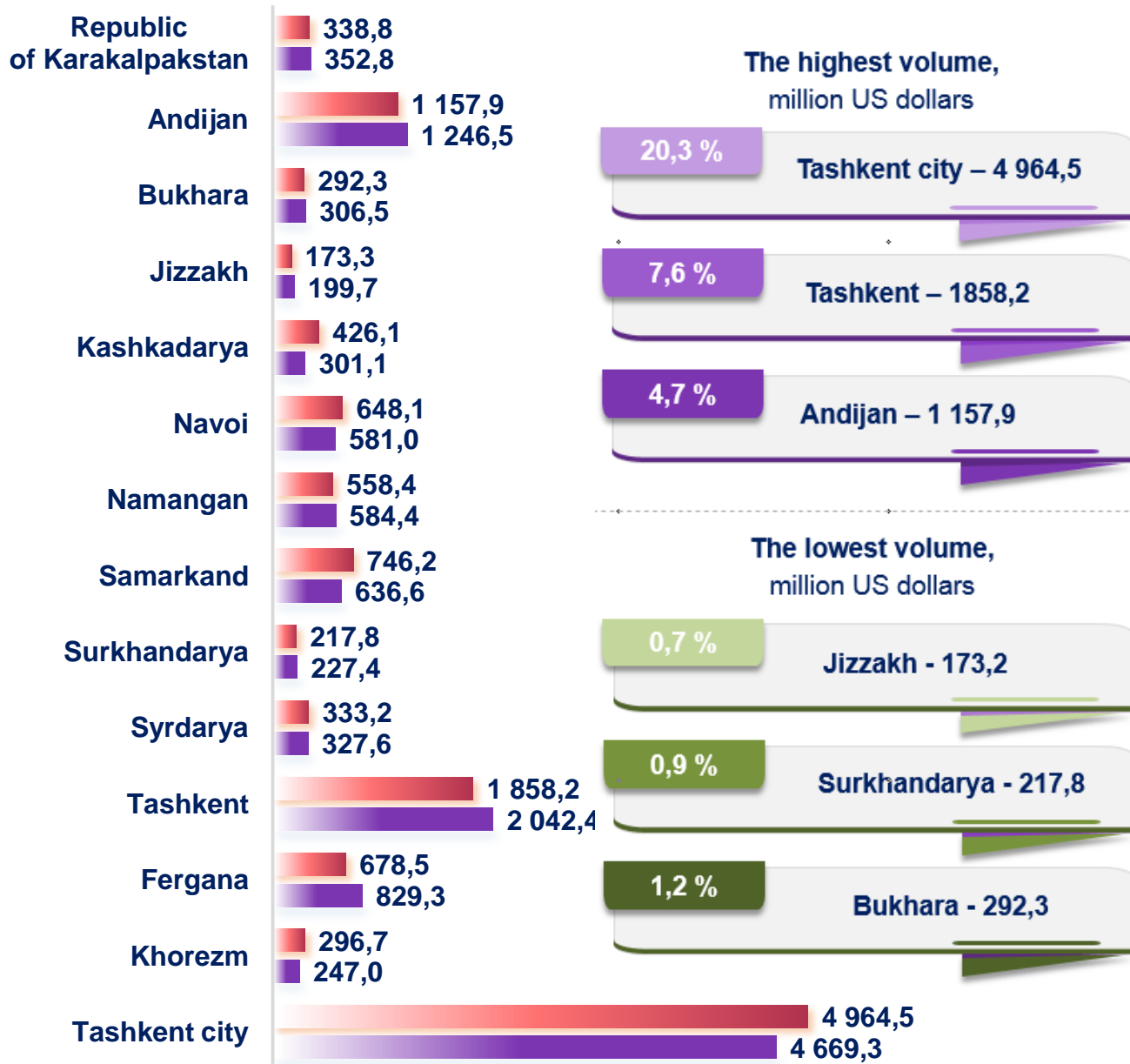

In the structure of the republic's exports, a significant share is noted in Tashkent city, which is 20.3%, or 4 964.5 million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded at 0.7%, or 173.3 million US dollars in the Jizzakh region.

* Supplies of natural gas and electricity, tourism services, as well as the volume of special exports are not distributed among regions, cities and districts of the Republic of Uzbekistan.



EXPORT OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES PRODUCTS

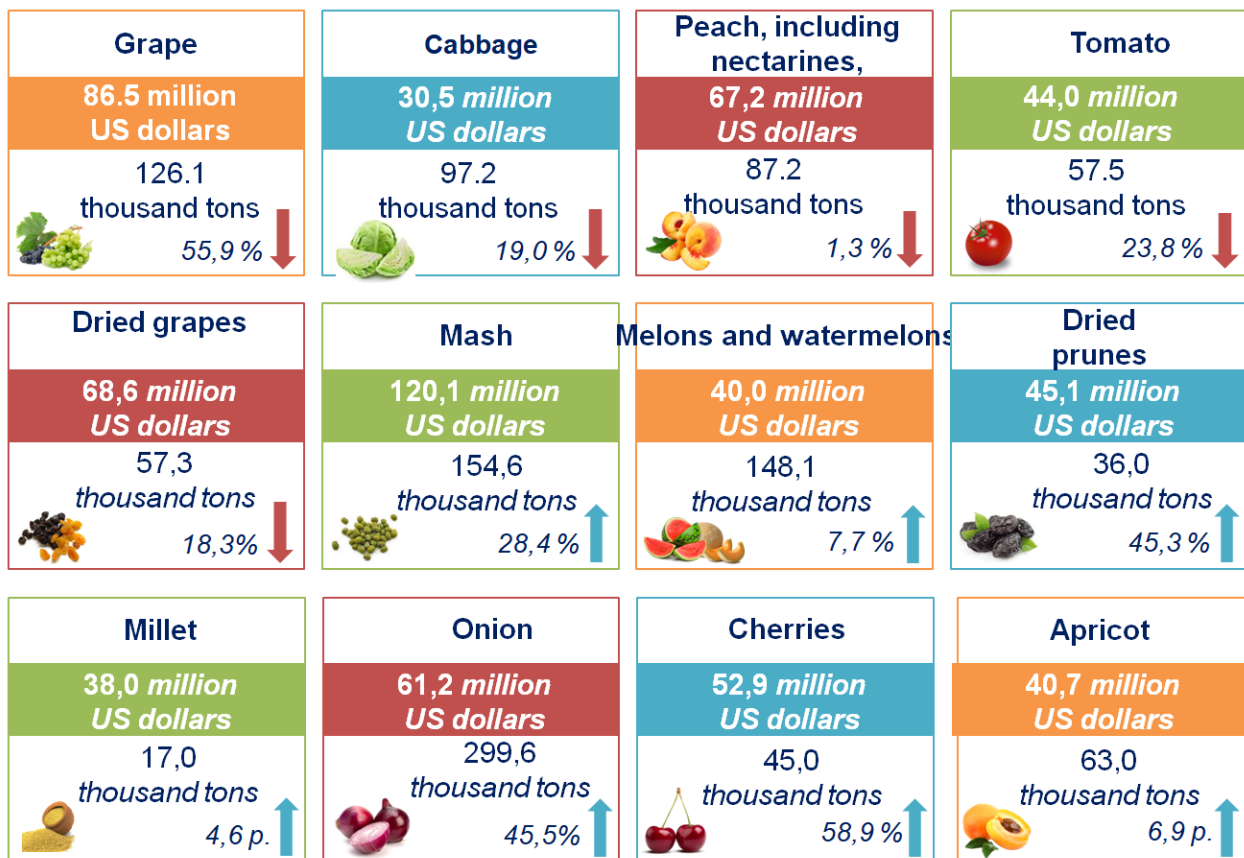
Due to the fact that the state pays great attention to the development of agriculture and horticulture, the quality and volumes of exported products are increasing from year to year. In particular, in January-December 2023, 1,757.7 thousand tons of fruits and vegetables were exported, and, compared to the same period in 2022, this figure increased by 1.1%, or 18.9 thousand tons.

The main markets for the export of fruits and vegetables were Russia (37.0%), Pakistan (16.7%), China (12.3%) and Kazakhstan (10.3%)

The volume of exports of fruits and vegetables during the period under review amounted to 1 180.8 million US dollars (the rate of increase, compared to the same period in 2022, was 3.3%). In total exports amounted to 4.8%.

Based on the results of January-December 2023, the largest volume in value terms of exports of fruits and vegetables falls to Russia (37.0% of the total volume of fruits and vegetables), which exceeds the volume of exports to Pakistan by 2.2 times.



EXPORT OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS



In recent years, the light industry has seen the development of production of products with high added value. Being an economically important industry for Uzbekistan, light industry provides a high level of employment, and also contributes to the industrial potential and international reputation of our country.

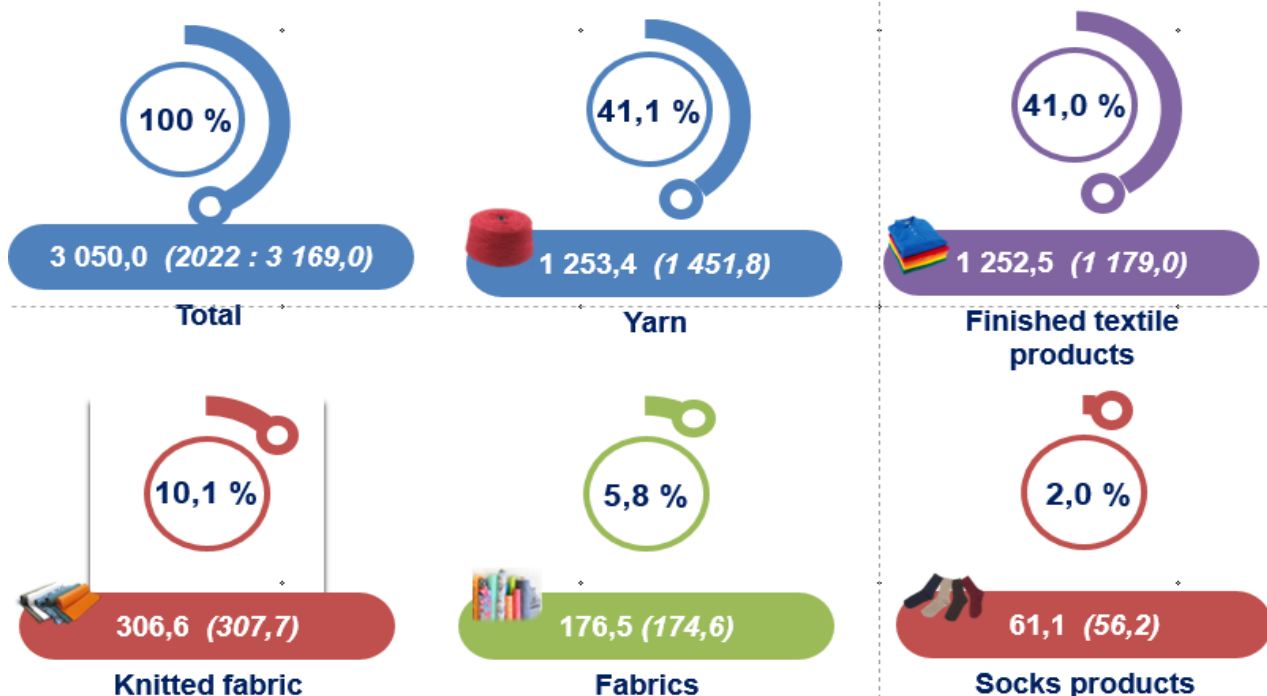
The increase in textile exports can be seen as a result of reforms carried out to produce finished goods instead of raw cotton and create added value.

Based on the results of January-December 2023, textile products were exported in the amount of 3 050.0 million US dollars, which amounted to 12.5% of its total volume and, compared to the same period in 2022, it decreased by 3.8%.

In the structure of exports of textile products, the main share is occupied by finished textile products (41.1%), as well as yarn (41.0%). Thus, in January-December 2023, 639 types of textile products were exported to 65 countries.



EXPORT OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS (for January-December 2023, million US dollars)

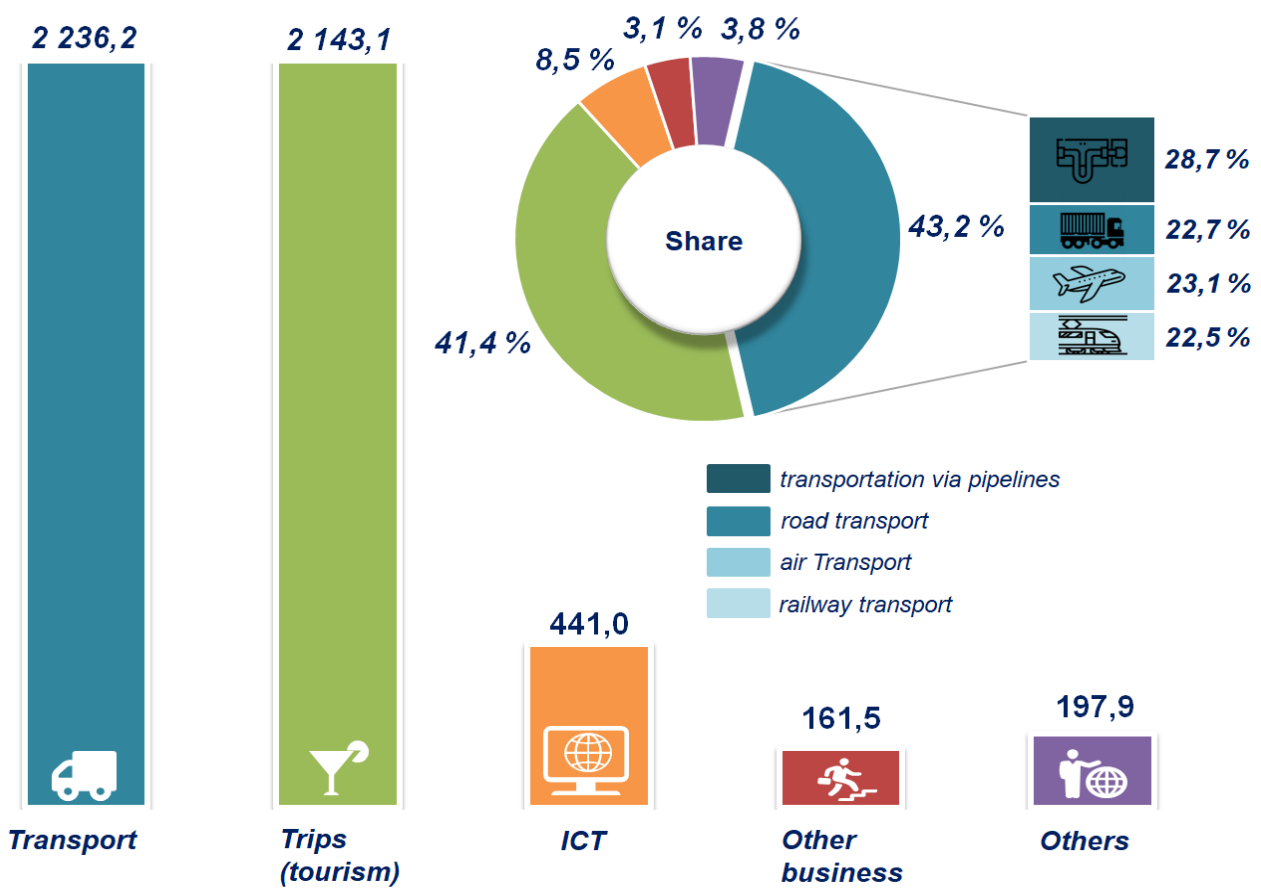




As a result of the widespread use of new production technologies and modern equipment in the country, as well as the introduction of a quality management system, labor productivity increases, which, in turn, allows finished products to find their place in world markets.



EXPORT OF SERVICES OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-December 2023, million US dollars)



The volume of exports of services in January-December 2023 amounted to 5 179.7 million, or 21.2% of the total volume of trade exports and increased by 22.6% compared to the same period in 2022. As part of the export of services, the lion's share is occupied by transport services (43.2%), travel (tourism) (41.4%), telecommunications, computer and information services (8.5%), and other business services (3.1%). At the same time, other services (3.8%) account for the largest share, respectively, of insurance and pension services (1.6%), financial services (1.2%), government goods and services (0.5%) and etc.



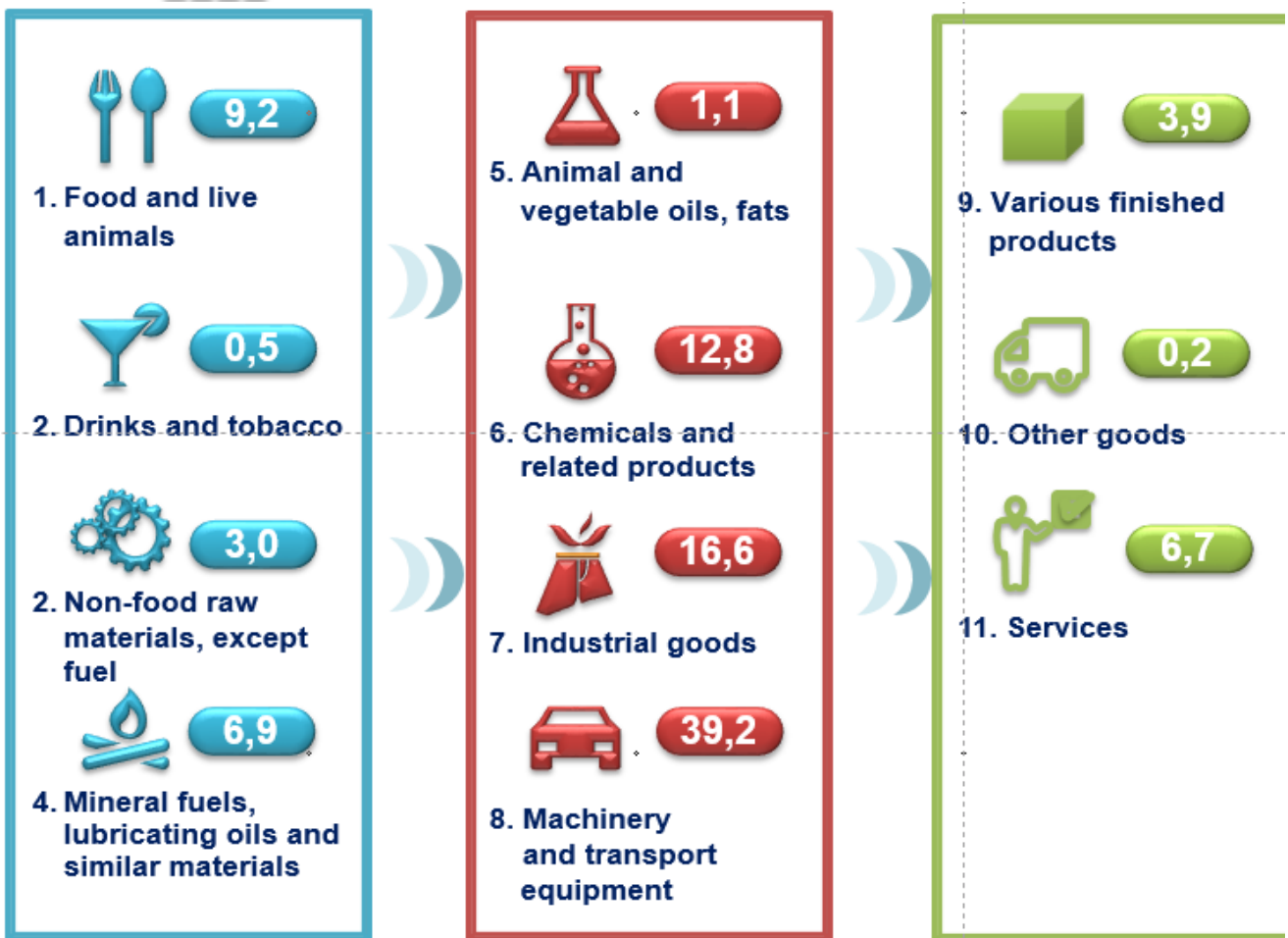
IMPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

During the reporting period, imports amounted to 38 141.2 million US dollars (the increase in growth rates compared to January-December 2022 was 24.0%). The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (39.2%), industrial goods (16.6%), as well as chemicals and similar products (12.8%).

An analysis of the dynamics of imports of goods also showed that in January-December 2023, compared to the same period in 2022, the volume of imports of goods increased by 7 373.5 million US dollars and amounted to 35 574.8 million US dollars, and imports of services reached 2 566.4 million US dollars.

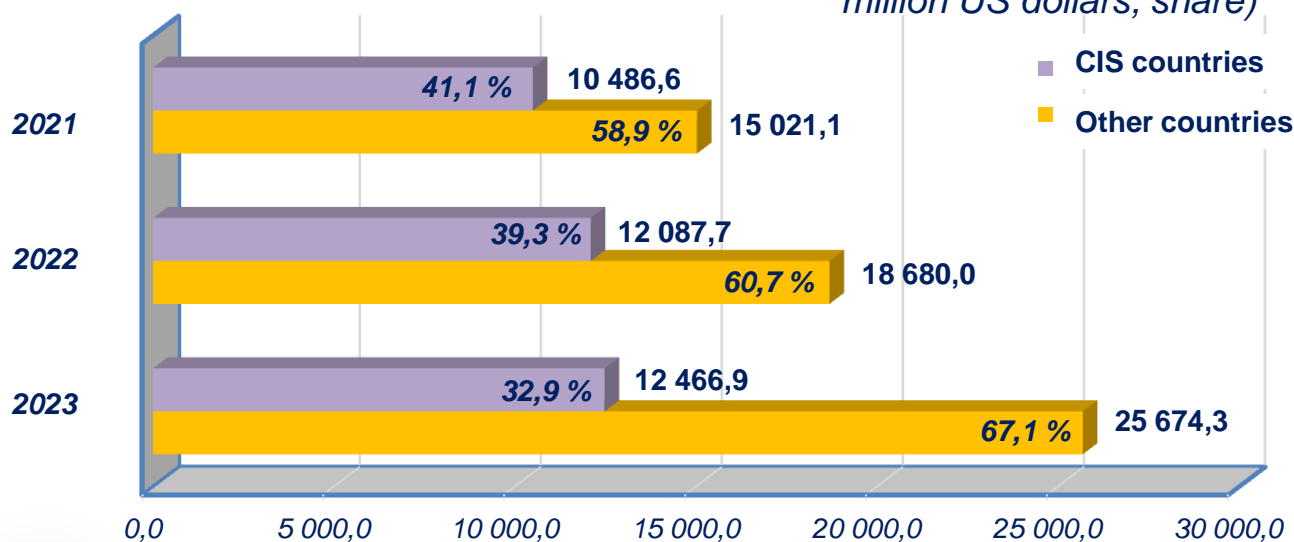

The methodology for maintaining foreign trade statistics provides that it does not include transit goods, as well as goods temporarily admitted into the country or temporarily exported from it.

 The share of imports from the CIS countries, compared to the same period in 2022, decreased by 6.6% and, based on the results of January-December 2023, it amounted to 32.7%.

DYNAMICS OF THE VOLUME OF IMPORTS FROM THE CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES

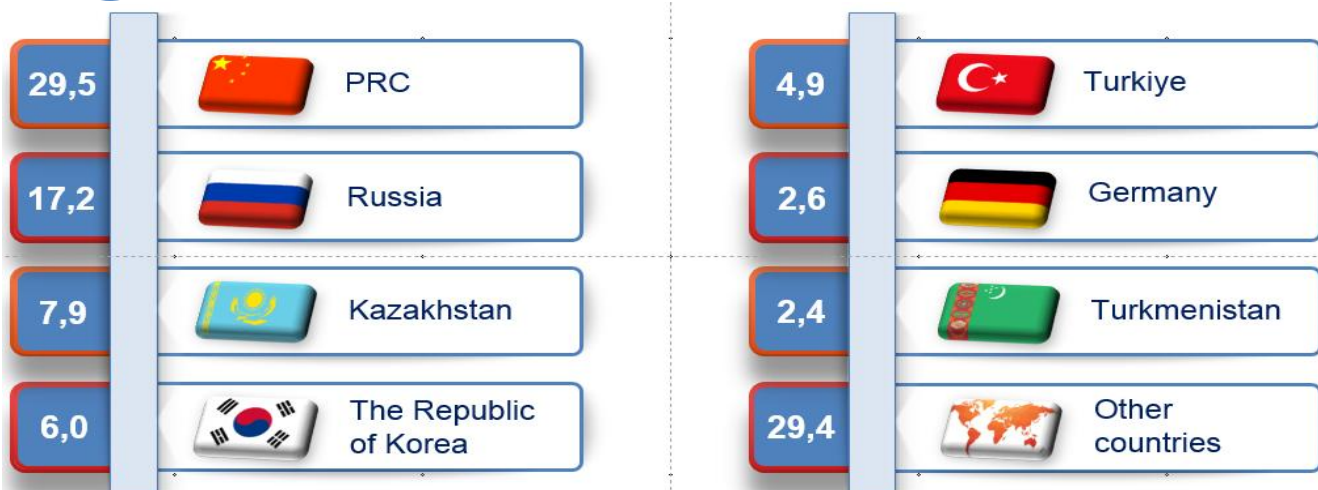

SHARE OF SEVEN LARGE PARTNER COUNTRIES IN IMPORT (for January-December 2023, share, in %)



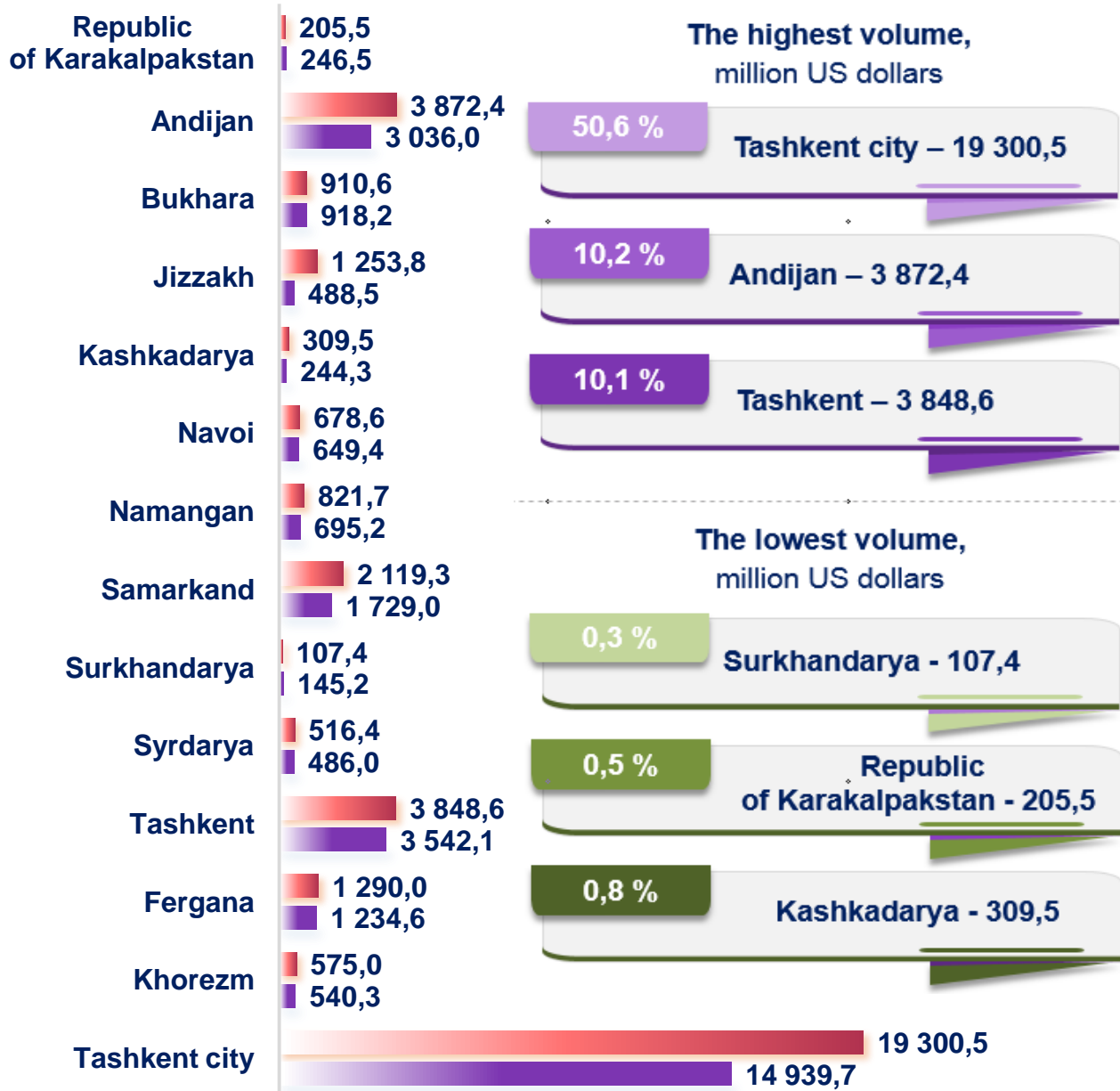

(for January-December 2023, million US dollars)



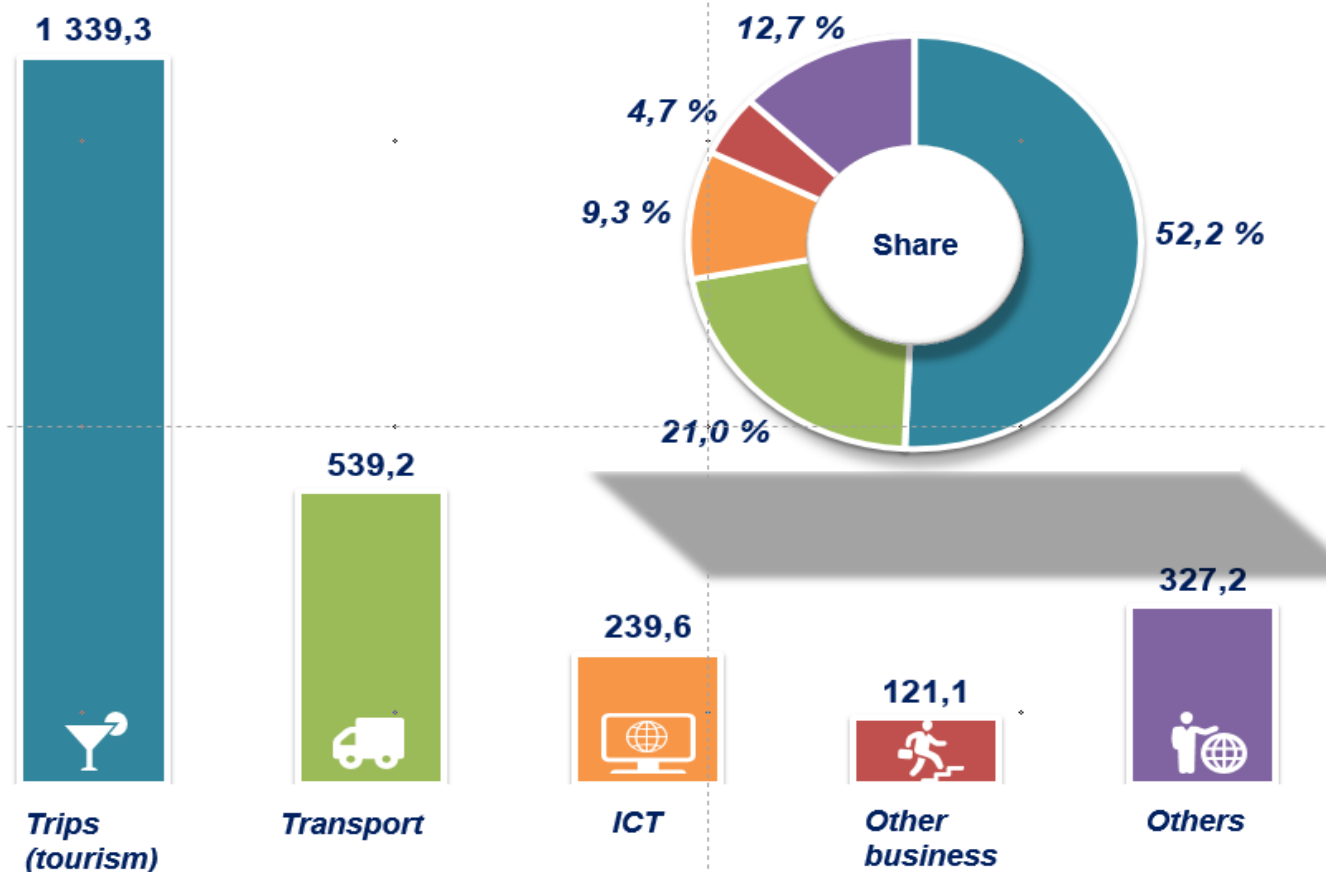

In the structure of imports of the republic, a significant share is noted in Tashkent city, which is 50.6%, or 19 300.5 million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded in Surkhandarya - 0.3%, or 107.4 million US dollars.

The volume of imports of services for January-December 2023 amounted to 2 566.4 million US dollars, or 6.7% of its total volume and decreased by 1.6% compared to the same period in 2022. As part of the import of services, the main share is occupied by travel (tourism - 52.2%), transport services (21.0%), telecommunications, computer and information services (9.3%), other business services (4.7%).

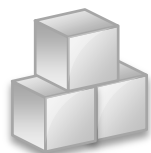

IMPORT OF INDUSTRIAL GOODS

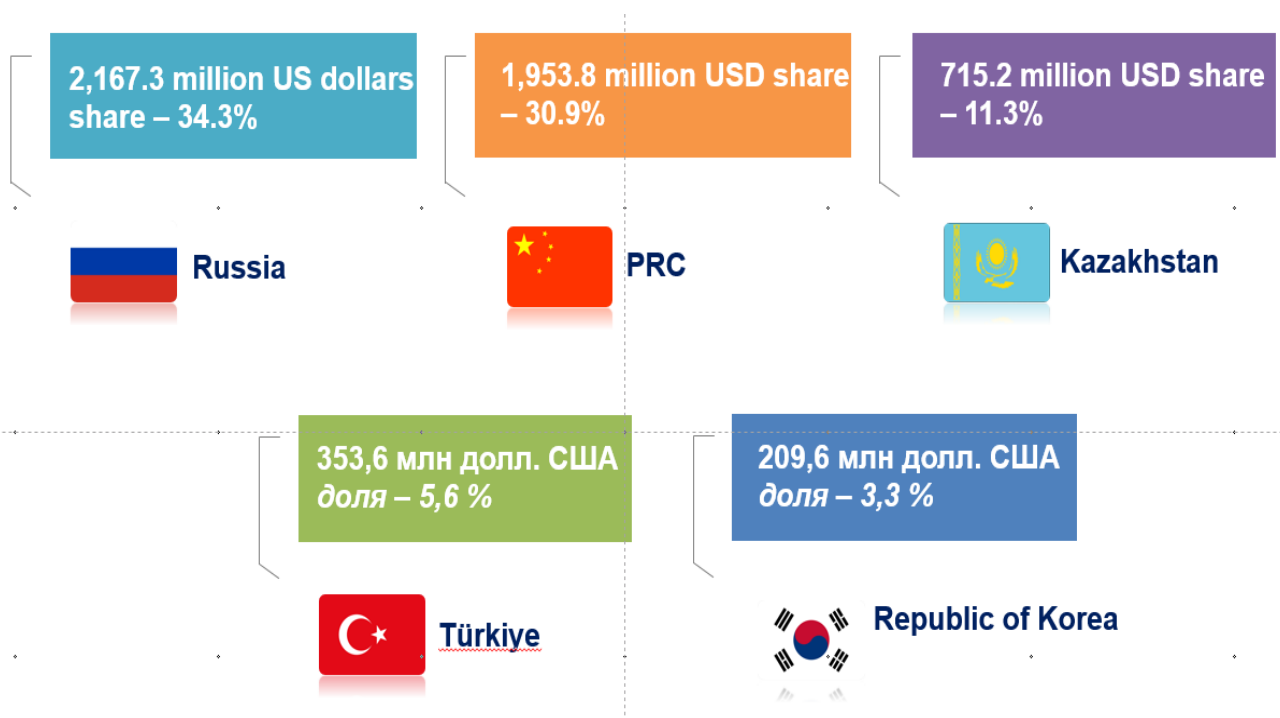


According to the results of January-December 2023, in the structure of imports, the volume of industrial goods reached 6 322.8 million US dollars and increased, compared to the same period in 2022, by 10.0%, in general, the share in the total volume of imports amounted to 16.6 %.
