FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER

The economic reforms carried out in our republic serve the rapid growth of trade relations with foreign countries. In particular, the decisions taken to increase export potential will allow local companies to gain more experience in working in foreign markets. Ultimately they will have a competitive advantage in global trade.

As a result of the measures taken in the republic in recent years to stimulate exports, optimize imports and, in general, to ensure a balanced foreign trade, in January-June 2024 the foreign trade turnover in the country amounted to 31.8 billion US dollars and increased compared to the same period in 2023, by 2.5 billion US dollars, or 8.5%.

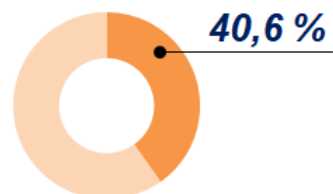

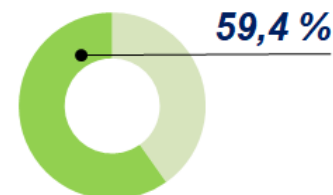

Of the total FTT volume, exports amounted to 12 992.7 million US dollars (an increase of 5.5% was noted by January-June 2023), and imports amounted to 18 835.5 million US dollars (an increase of 10.6%). As a result, the balance of foreign trade turnover amounted to a negative balance of – 5 842.9 million US dollars.

It should be noted that Kazakhstan has become one of the largest foreign economic partners of Uzbekistan (after China and Russia). The reasons for this: the presence of a common border, trade in the CIS free trade zone, as well as the liberalization of mutual economic relations.

Today, the Republic of Uzbekistan carries out trade relations with 186 countries of the world. The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with China (18.5%), Russia (18.1%), Kazakhstan (6.0%), Türkiye (4.5%) and the Republic of Korea (3.4%).

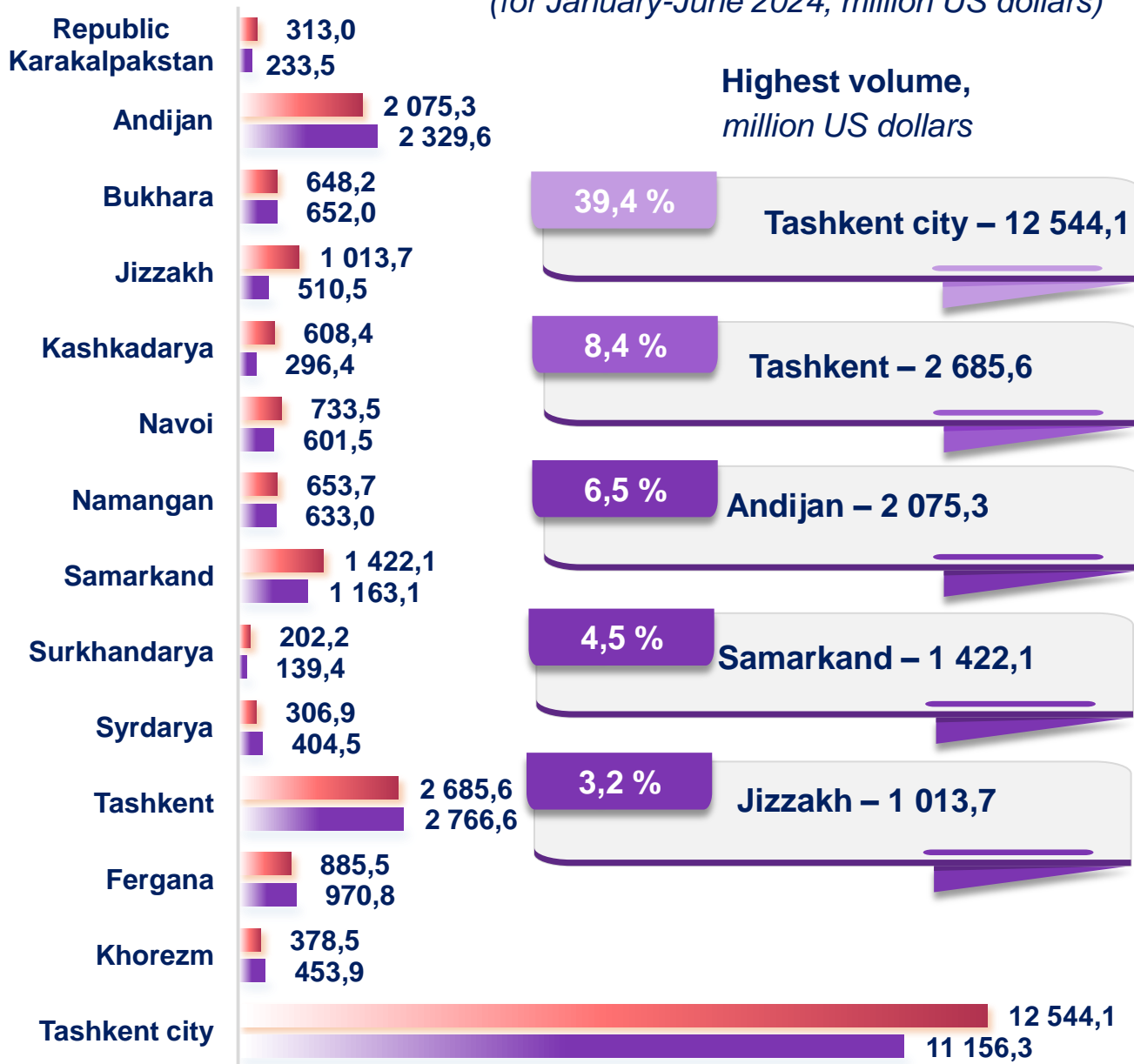

(for January-June 2024, million US dollars)*



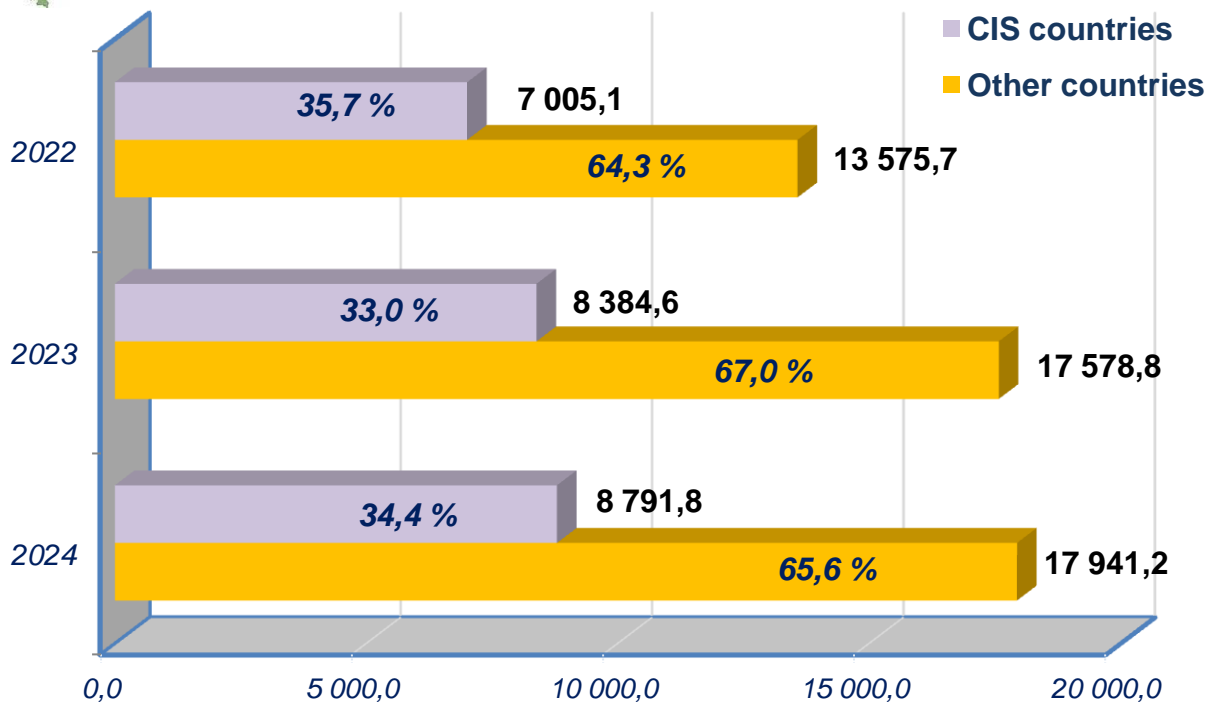

In the structure of the foreign trade turnover of the republic, a significant share is noted in Tashkent city, which is 39.4%, or 12 544.1 million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded in Surkhandarya region which amounted to 0.6%, or 202.2 million US dollars.

DYNAMICS OF THE VOLUME OF CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES IN FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-June, million US dollars, share)



The share of foreign trade turnover of the CIS countries during the period under review, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 1.4% and, in general, their share amounted to 34.4%.

The economic growth of countries trading with Uzbekistan may lead to an increase in demand for the republic's exports from consumers of these countries.

The volume of foreign trade turnover of other countries of the world for January-June 2024, compared to the same period in 2023, decreased by 1.4% respectively and amounted to 65.6% of the total foreign trade turnover.

For January-June 2024, the foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the CIS countries reached 10 954.5 million US dollars, of which the export volume amounted to 4 128.1 million US dollars, and the import volume amounted to 6 826.4 million US dollars.

for January-June 2024, share, in %

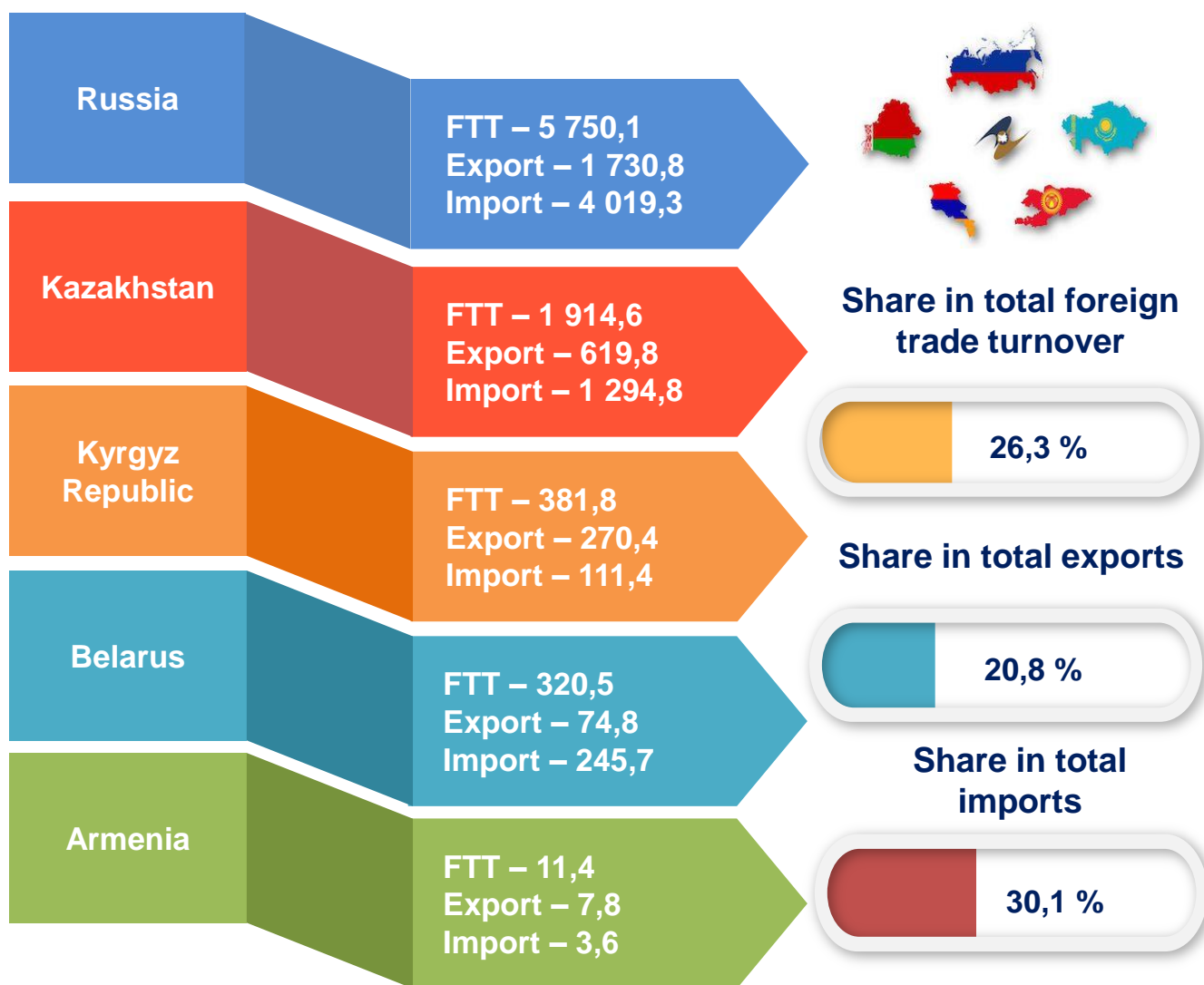


Trade in the CIS free trade zone has a positive effect on the overall foreign trade turnover of Uzbekistan.

The largest volume of foreign trade turnover with the CIS countries was recorded with Russia (52.5%), Kazakhstan (17.5%) and Turkmenistan (5.6%).

The foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the EAEU countries during the period under review amounted to 8 378.4 million US dollars, of which the export volume was 2 703.5 million US dollars, and the import volume was 5 674.9 million US dollars.

It should be noted that a common economic territory with a unified customs system has been formed between the EAEU member states (Russia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Armenia and Kyrgyz Republic), ensuring freedom of movement of goods and services, movement of migrants and movement of capital.

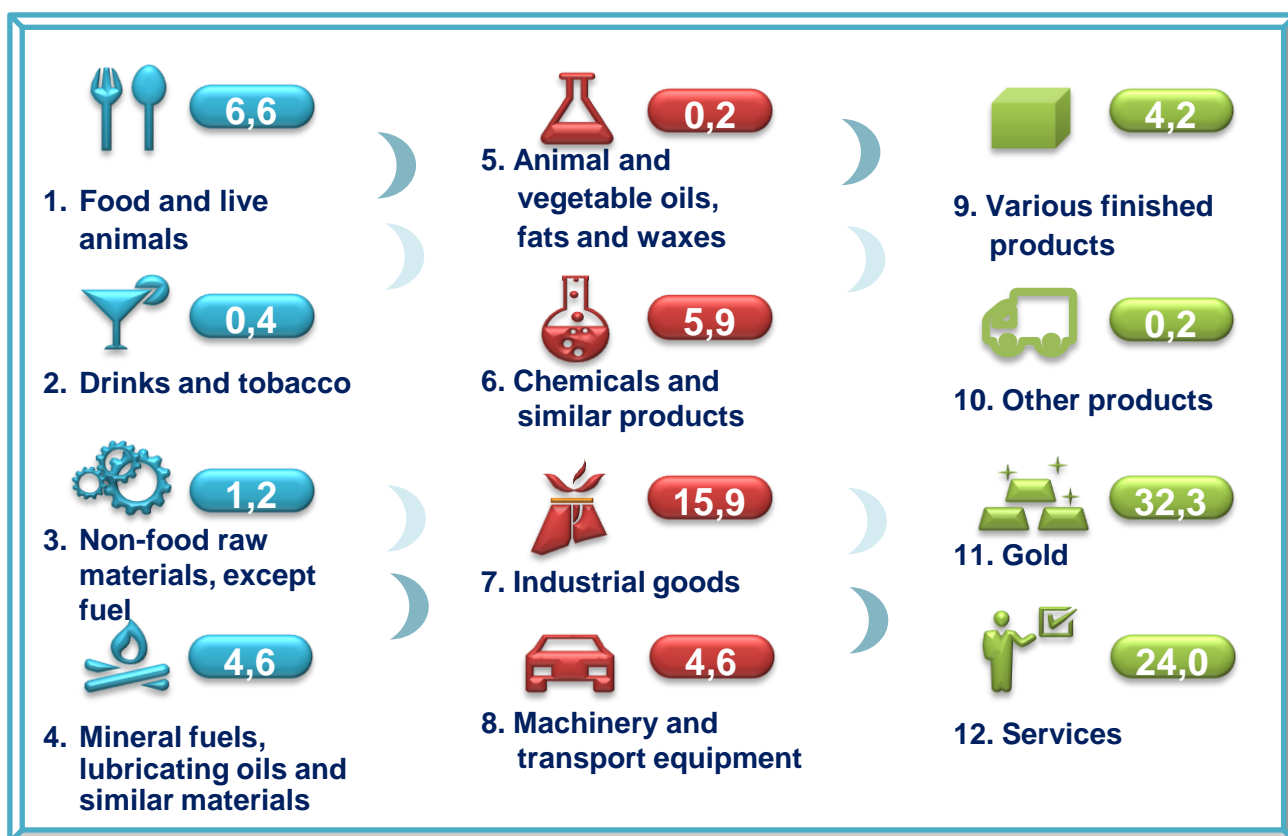


EXPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN (for January-June 2024)

The development of international economic relations contributes to stable growth of exports, and this, in turn, creates the basis for achieving certain results. Based on the reforms carried out aimed at increasing the country's export potential, supporting exporters from the state and expanding the range of export products, the number of exporters reached 5 682, and the volume of exports of goods and services amounted to 8 798.0 million US dollars (in addition to non-monetary gold) and, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 10.9%.

When generating statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, International Standard Trade Classification of the United Nations (hereinafter referred to as ISTC) is used, which allows for analytical purposes to group exported and imported goods. Assignment of ISTC codes to goods is carried out using transition keys between the Commodity Nomenclature of Foreign Economic Activity and ISTC.

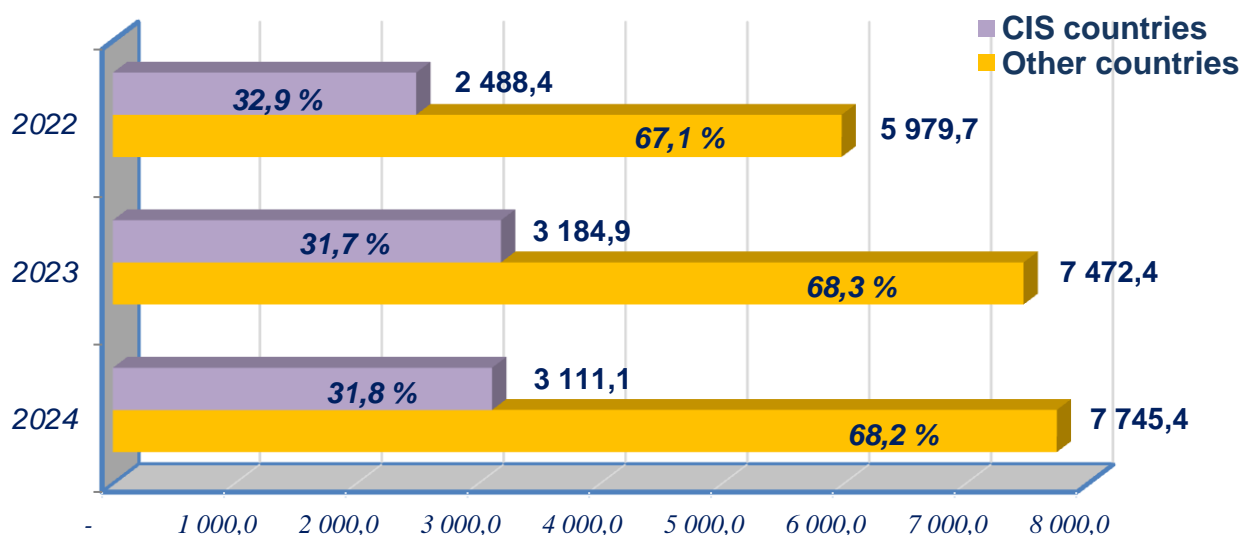

In the statistics of foreign trade of Uzbekistan, partner countries include: when importing - the country of origin of the goods, and if the country of origin is unclear, then the country of the sender. For export, this is the country where the goods are sent.

DYNAMICS OF EXPORT VOLUME TO THE CIS COUNTRIES AND OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES (for January-June, million US dollars, share)

The share of exports from CIS countries for January-June 2024, compared to the same period in 2023, decreased by 0.1%.



Our main partners for the export of goods and services in foreign trade turnover in January-June 2024 were countries such as Russia, China, Kazakhstan, Turkiye, Afghanistan, France and the Kyrgyz Republic. Their share in total exports reached 37.3%.

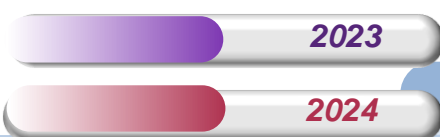
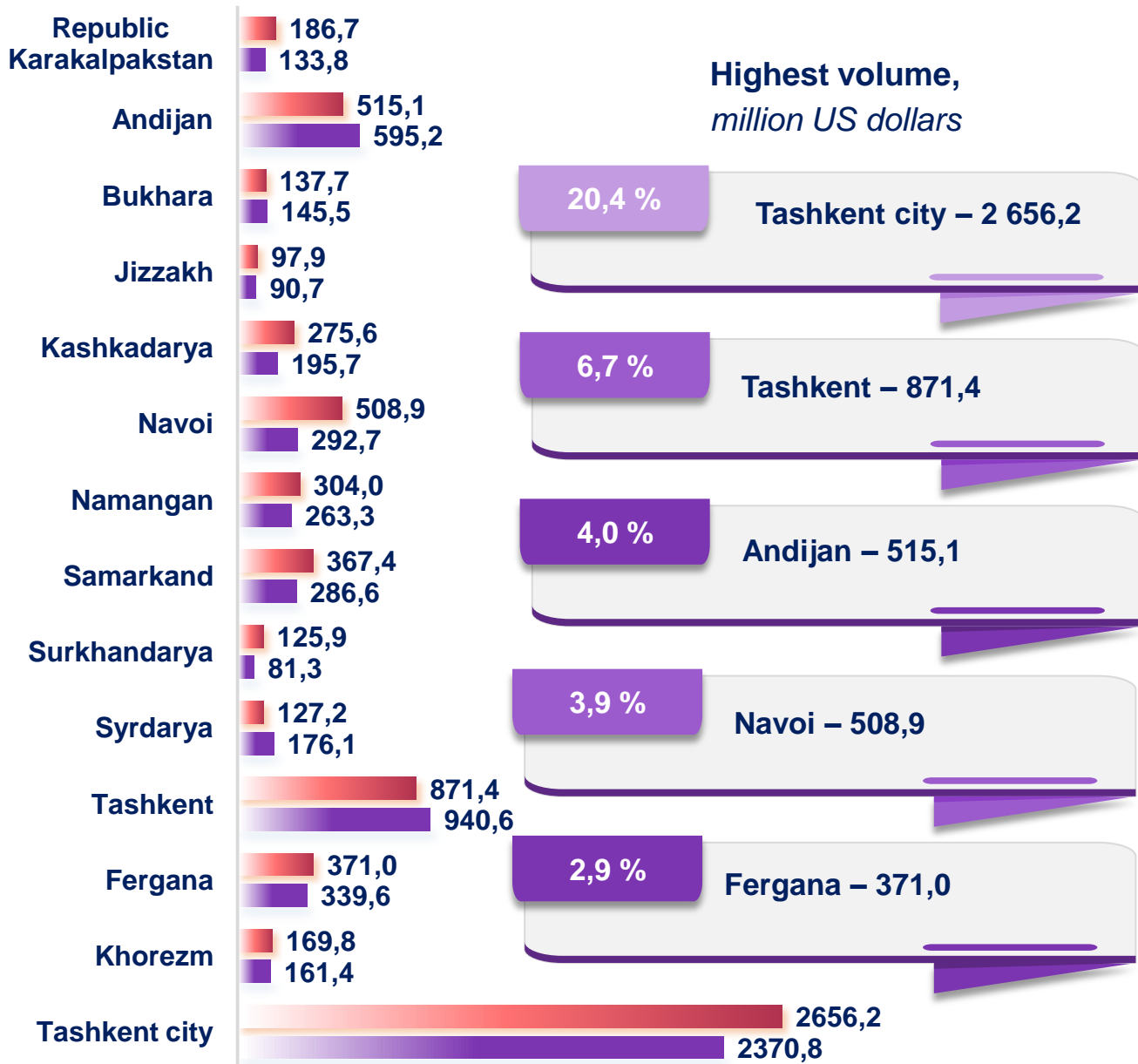

In the structure of the republic's exports, a significant share is noted in Tashkent city, which is 20.4%, or 2 656.2 million US dollars, and the smallest share is recorded at 0.8%, or 97.9 million US dollars in the Jizzakh region.

EXPORT OF FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

Due to the fact that the state pays great attention to the development of agriculture and horticulture, the quality and volumes of exported products are increasing from year to year. In particular, in January-June 2024, 1 000.6 thousand tons of fruits and vegetables were exported, and, compared to the same period in 2023, this figure increased by 4.7%, or 45.3 thousand tons. The main export markets for fruits and vegetables were Russia (41.2%), Kazakhstan (16.8%), Pakistan (15.3%) and China (5.9%).

The volume of exports of fruits and vegetables during the period under review amounted to 607.3 million US dollars (the rate of increase, compared to the same period in 2023, was 8.0%). In total exports amounted to 4.7%.

Based on the results of January-June 2024, the largest volume in value terms of exports of fruits and vegetables comes from Russia (41.2% of the total volume of fruits and vegetables), which exceeds the volume of exports, for example, from Pakistan, by 2.7 times.



EXPORT OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS

In recent years, the light industry has seen the development of production of products with high added value. As an economically important industry for Uzbekistan, light industry provides a high level of employment, and also contributes to the industrial potential and international reputation of our country.

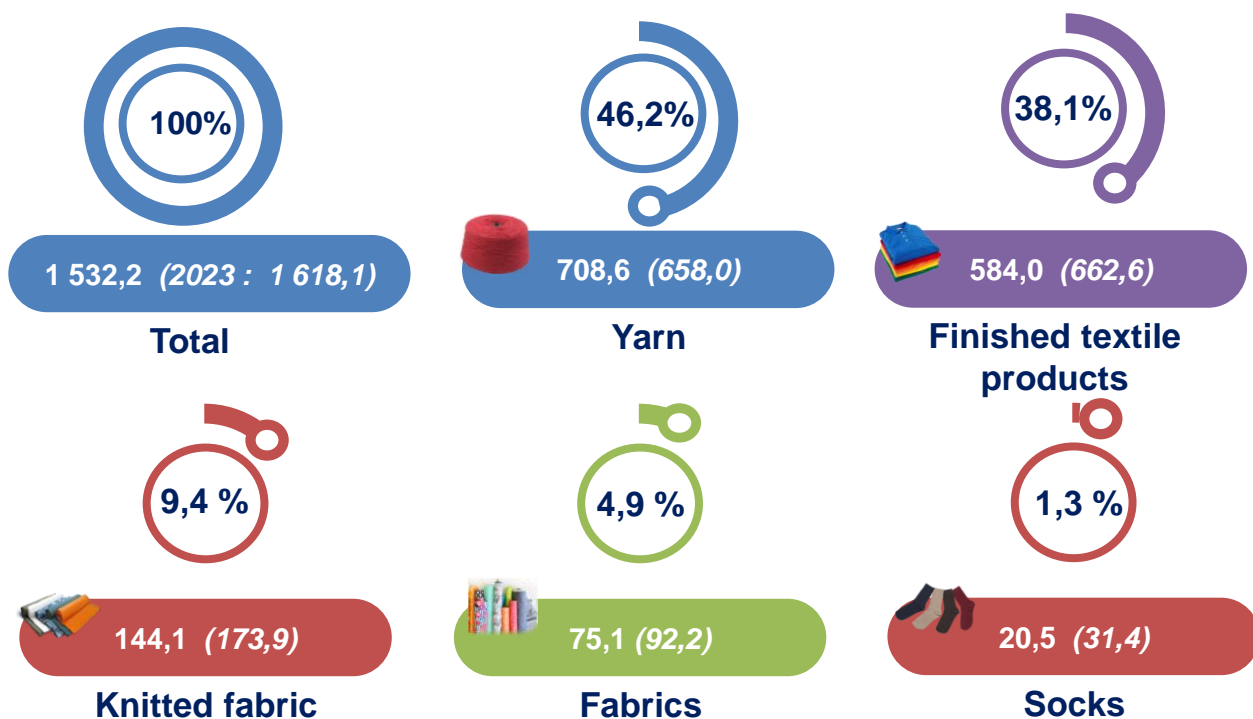
The increase in textile exports can be seen as a result of reforms undertaken to produce finished goods instead of raw cotton and create added value.

Based on the results of January-June 2024, textile products were exported in the amount of 1 532.2 million US dollars, which amounted to 11.8% of its total volume and, compared to the same period in 2023, it decreased by - 5.3%.

In the structure of exports of textile products, the main share is also occupied by yarn (46.2%) and finished textile products (38.1%). Thus, in January-June 2024, 496 types of textile products were exported to 55 countries..



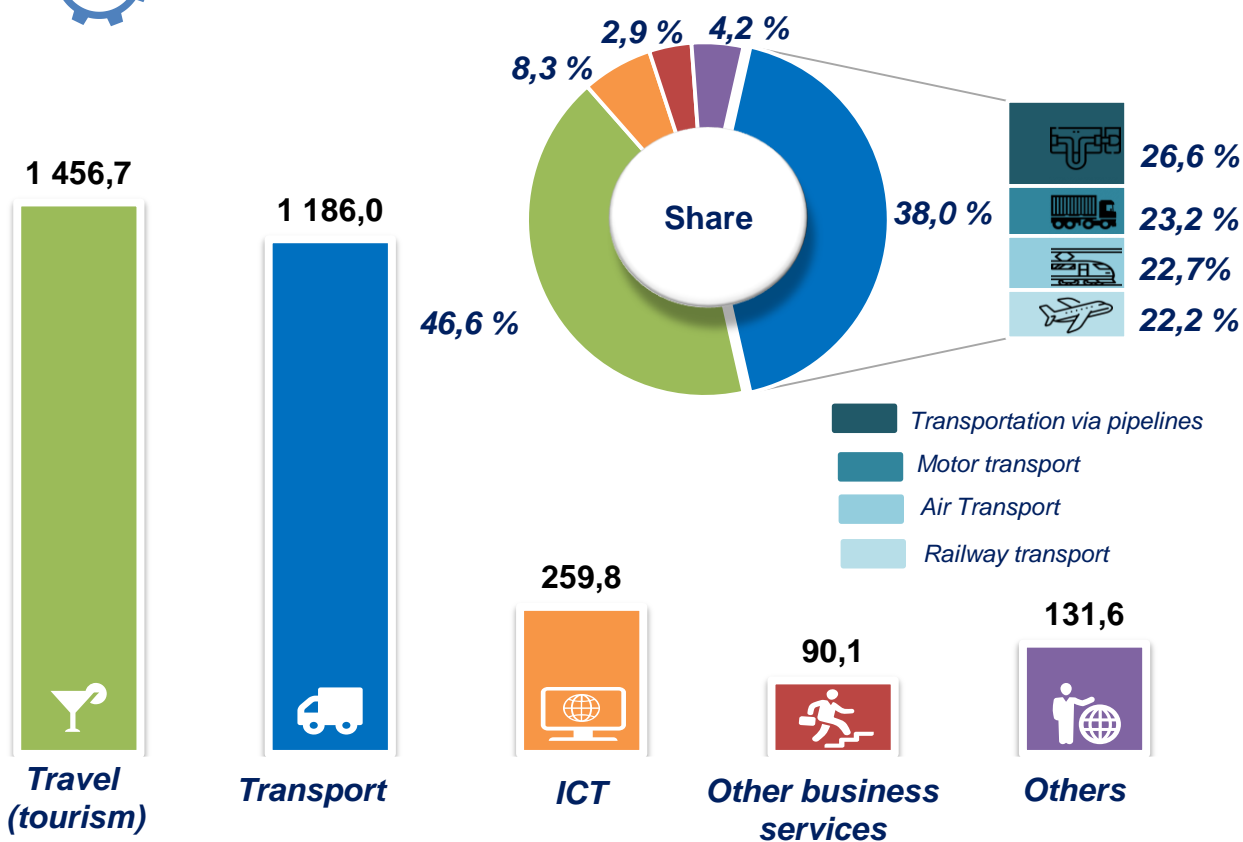
EXPORT OF TEXTILE PRODUCTS for January-June 2024, million US dollars



As a result of the widespread use of new production technologies and modern equipment in the country, as well as the introduction of a quality management system, labor productivity is increasing, which, in turn, allows finished products to find their place in world markets.

The volume of services exports for January-June 2024 amounted to 3 124.3 million US dollars, or 24.0% of the total volume of trade exports and increased by 26.4% compared to the same period in 2023. The lion's share of services exports is made up of travel (tourism) (46.6%), transport services (38.0%), telecommunications, computer and information services (8.3%), and other business services (2.9%). At the same time, the largest share of other services (4.2%) is accounted for by financial services (1.1%), insurance and pension services (1.0%), construction services (0.7%), etc.



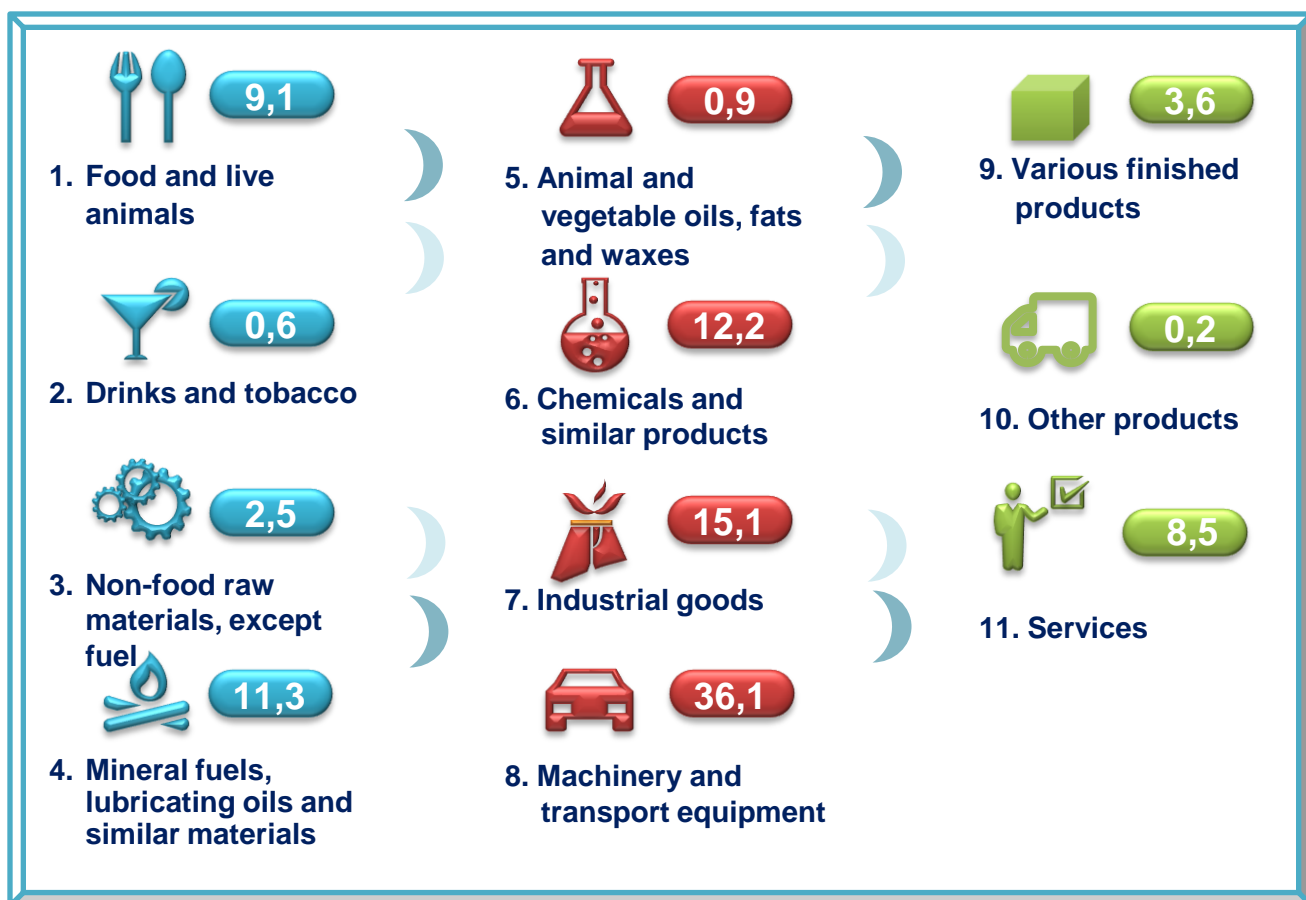
IMPORT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

During the reporting period, imports amounted to 18 835.5 million US dollars (the increase in growth rates compared to January-June 2023 was 10.6%). The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (36.1%), industrial goods (15.1%), as well as chemicals and similar products (12.2%).

An analysis of the dynamics of imports of goods also showed that in January-June 2024, compared to the same period in 2023, the volume of imports of goods increased by 1 227.9 million US dollars and amounted to 17 242.8 million US dollars, and imports of services reached 1 592.7 million US dollars.

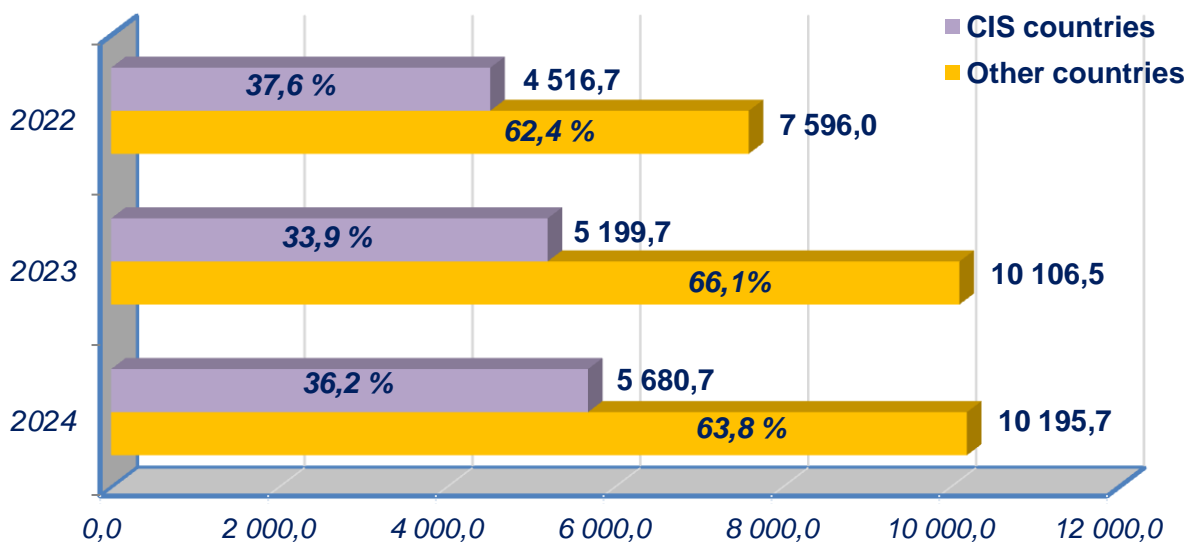

The methodology for maintaining foreign trade statistics provides that it does not include transit goods, as well as goods temporarily admitted into the country or temporarily exported from it.

The share of imports from the CIS countries, compared to the same period in 2023, increased by 2.3% and, based on the results of January-June 2024, it amounted to 36.2%.

In general, based on the results of January-June 2024, goods and services were imported into Uzbekistan from 160 countries. More than 2/3 of imports come from such large partner countries as China, Russia, Kazakhstan, the Republic of Korea, Turkiye, Germany and Turkmenistan.

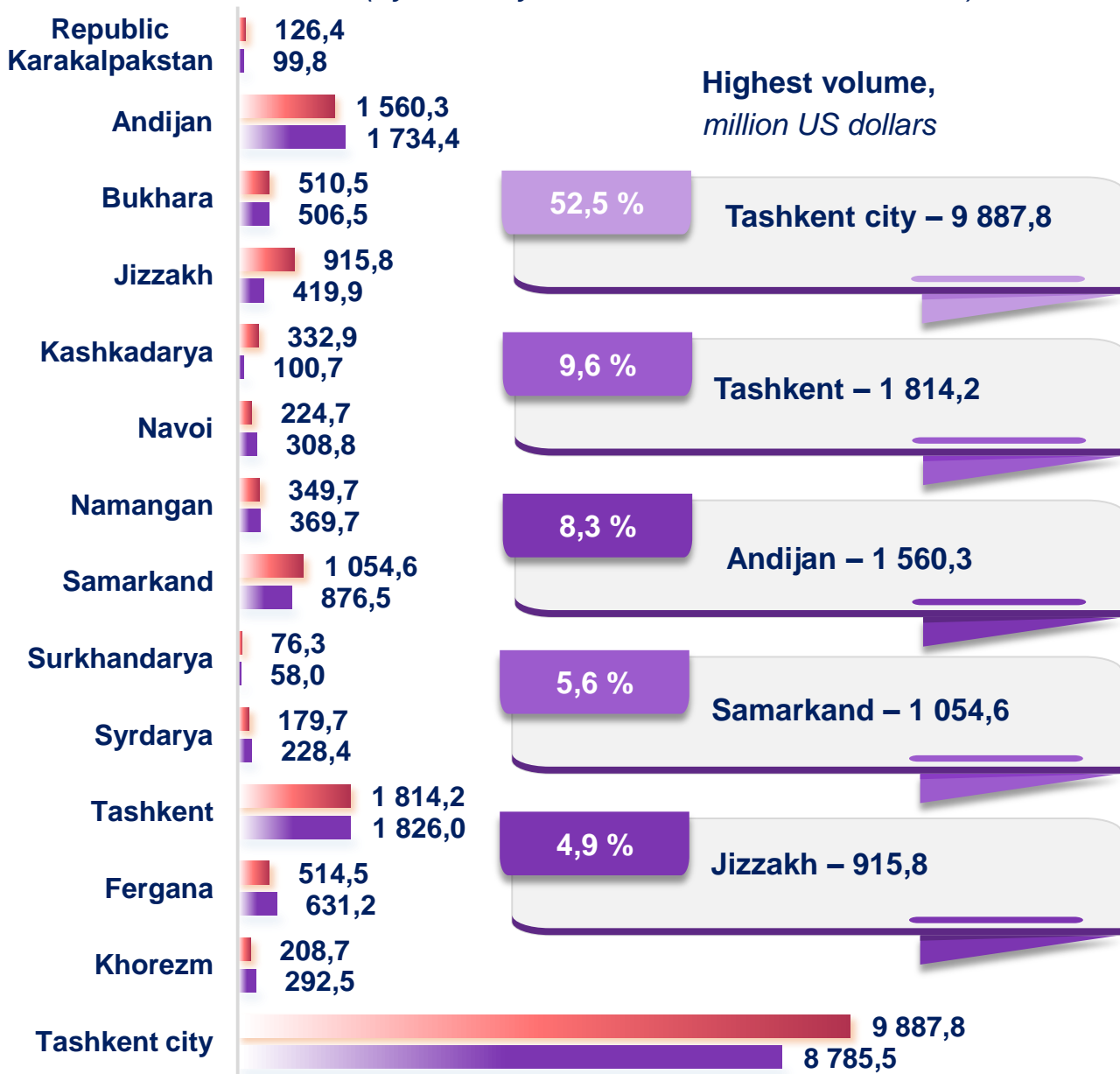

(by January-June 2024, million US dollars)



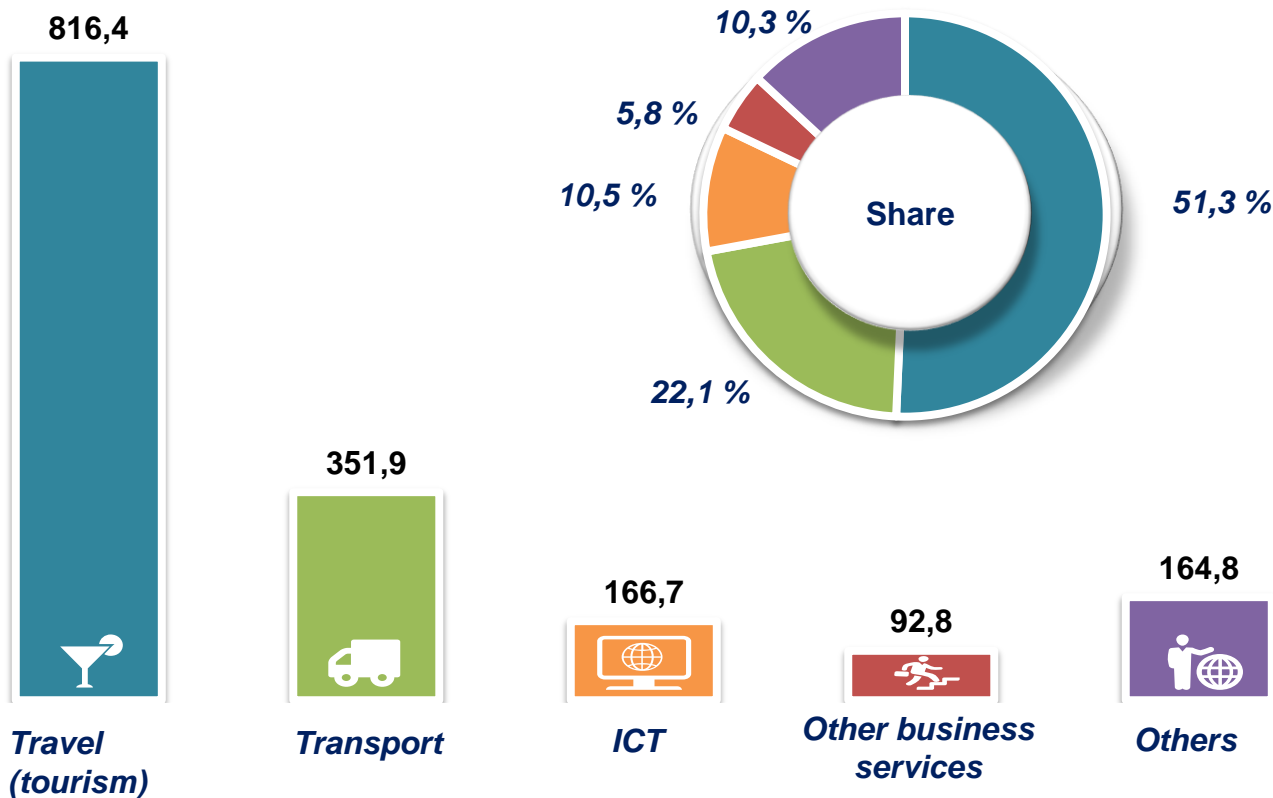

In the structure of imports of the republic, a significant share was noted in the Tashkent city, which is 52.5%, or 9 887.8 million US dollars, and the smallest share was recorded in the Surkhandarya region - 0.4%, or 76.3 million US dollars.

The volume of imports of services for January-June 2024 amounted to 1 592.7 million US dollars, or 8.5% of its total volume and increased by 56.8% compared to the same period in 2023.

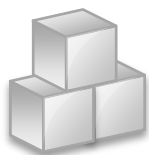
As part of the import of services, the main share is occupied by travel (tourism - 51.3%), transport services (22.1%), telecommunications, computer and information services (10.5%), as well as other business services (5.8%).

In addition, other services accounted for 10.3% of total imports, including a high share of fees for the use of intellectual property not classified as other categories (3.9%), maintenance and repair services not classified as other categories (2.8%), insurance and pension services (1.5%), etc.



IMPORT OF INDUSTRIAL GOODS

According to the results of January-June 2024, in the structure of imports, the volume of industrial goods reached 2 840.8 million US dollars and increased, compared to the same period in 2023, by 2.1%, in general, the share in the total volume of imports amounted to 15.1 %.
