

I. Foreign Trade Turnover

In January 2026, the foreign trade turnover (FTT) of the country amounted to 5.8 billion USD and increased by 1 318.6 million USD, or by 29,2%, compared to the same period of 2025.

Of the total FTT, exports amounted to 1 693.1 million USD (an increase of 26.7% compared to the same period of 2025), and imports reached 4 137.4 million USD (an increase of 30.3% compared to the same period of 2025). As a result, a negative trade balance of 2 444.3 million USD was recorded.

The Republic of Uzbekistan conducts trade relations with more than 145 countries worldwide. The largest volume of foreign trade turnover was recorded with China (27,9%), Russia (18,7%), Kazakhstan (7,1%), Türkiye (3,6%) and Afghanistan (2,4%).

In the export structure, goods account for 56,2%, including manufactured goods — 18,1%, food products and live animals — 10,0%, chemicals and related products — 10,0%, and miscellaneous manufactured articles — 7,1%.



The main partners of Uzbekistan in the export of goods and services in January 2026 were such countries as Russia (19,2%), China (10,5%), Afghanistan (8,1%), France (6,1%), Türkiye (5,0%), Kazakhstan (4,8%), the Kyrgyz Republic (2,7%), Tajikistan (2,7%) and the UAE (2,4%). Their share in total exports exceeded 60,0%.



In January 2026, exports of fruits and vegetables amounted to 99.4 million USD. This indicator increased by 21.6% compared to the same period of 2025, and the share in total exports was 5.9%.


Share of textile exports



For January 2026, textile exports amounted to 216,5 million USD, representing 12,8% of total exports and an increase of 9,0% compared to the same period of 2025.

In the structure of textile exports, the main share is occupied by finished textile products (51,4%) and yarn (31,3%).

In January 2026, the volume of services exports amounted to 742.1 million USD, accounting for 43.8% of total exports, and increased by 44.1% compared to the same period of 2025. The main share in the structure of services exports was accounted for by travel (47.9%), transport services (35.9%), telecommunications, computer, and information services (10.9%), and other business services (1.9%).

III. Import Volume

During this period, imports amounted to 4 137,4 million USD (compared to the same period of 2025, imports increased by 30,3%). The main share in its structure is occupied by machinery and transport equipment (35,9%), manufactured goods (13,9%), and chemicals and related products (11,8%).

Analysis of the dynamics of goods imports showed that in January 2026, compared to the same period of 2025, the volume of goods imports increased by 869,4 million USD and amounted to 3 694,4 million USD, while service imports reached 443,0 million USD.



Overall, in January 2026, goods and services were imported into Uzbekistan from more than 125 countries. Over 70,0% of total imports came from such major partner countries as China (35,0%), Russia (18,5%), Kazakhstan (8,0%), the Republic of Korea (3,0%), Türkiye (3,0%), Germany (2,3%) and Turkmenistan (2,0%).



The volume of service imports for January 2026 amounted to 443.0 million USD, or 10.7% of the total volume, and increased by 26.3% compared to the same period of 2025.

In the structure of services imports, the main share was accounted for by travel (56.2%), transport services (18.7%), telecommunications, computer, and information services (10.2%), and other business services (8.7%).

IV. Metadata

In compiling statistical indicators on foreign trade in goods of the Republic of Uzbekistan, along with the HS (Harmonized System), the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) is used, which allows, for analytical purposes, to group exported and imported goods into 10 broad sections. SITC codes are assigned to goods using concordance keys between the HS and SITC.

Foreign trade statistics are compiled on the basis of data on foreign trade in goods and services: the source data for compiling foreign trade in goods statistics are customs cargo declarations from the Customs Committee and statistical surveys of the National Statistics Committee on goods transferred from residents to non-residents that do not cross the state border and are not included in customs declarations; foreign trade services statistics are compiled on the basis of statistical surveys.

In certain cases, minor discrepancies between the total and the sum of the components are due to rounding of data.
