3. ACCURACY AND RELIABILITY

3.1 Source data

3.1.1 Source data collection programs (Required)

Information about agricultural land that is temporarily at the disposal (discretion) of district khokimiyats for the organization of farms, such as irrigated land, rainfed land, and others, is formed once a year for the purpose of developing Millih hisobot (National report)

3.1.2 Source data definitions, scope, sectorization, classifications, valuation, and time of recording (Encouraged)

Information about all types of agricultural land that is temporarily at the disposal (discretion) of district khokimiyats for the organization of farms is provided to the state Committee of land management For generalization

3.1.3 Source data timeliness (Encouraged)

Preparation of information is carried out strictly within the time limit set in the work Program of land preparation approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

3.2 Assessment of source data

3.2.1 Source data assessment (Encouraged)

The data received from regional administrations are subject to comprehensive control by the state Committee for land management. If errors are detected in the information, it is necessary to check with the subjects.

3.3 Statistical techniques

3.3.1 Source data statistical techniques (Required as relevant to data category)

The data provided by the regional departments are carried out in the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan for land resources, geodesy, cartography and state cadaster, regional administrations on the basis of certain statistical indicators

3.3.2 Other statistical procedures (Required as relevant to data category)

The information generated by State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan for land resources, geodesy, cartography and state cadaster, regional administrations is sent to the relevant ministries and departments to determine statistical indicators.

3.4 Data validation

3.4.1 Validation of intermediate results (Encouraged)

Reports on reserve lands are submitted by territorial administrations to the Central office of the Committee once a quarter, and interim data are compared in accordance with the established procedure.

3.4.2 Assessment of intermediate data (the recommended category)

Reports on reserve lands are submitted by territorial administrations to the Central office of the Committee once a quarter, and interim data are compared in accordance with the established procedure.

3.4.3 Assessment of discrepancies and other problems in statistical outputs using (featured category)

Statistical discrepancies in output statistics are studied, data for the reporting period is compared with the results of the previous quarter and year, and the reasons for significant discrepancies are identified and analyzed.
