

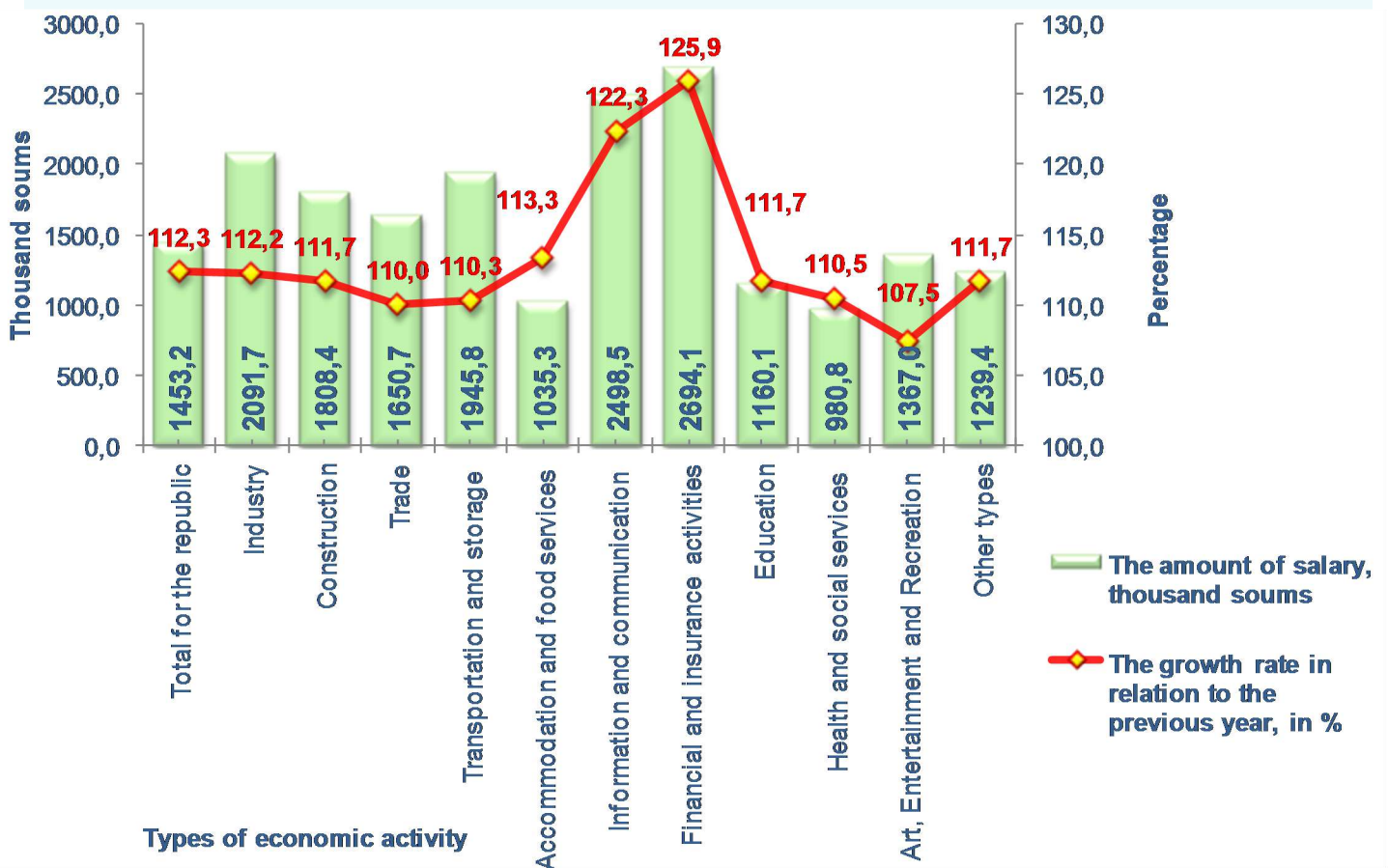


Average monthly nominal accrued wages in the Republic of Uzbekistan

January-December 2017 (preliminary data)

According to preliminary data, in January-December 2017, the average monthly nominal wages in the Republic of Uzbekistan amounted to **1 453,2** thousand soums (including wage increases, remuneration, incentive payments, compensation and non-working hours payments, as well as withholding from physical persons income tax, social insurance contributions and trade union fund), and increased by **12,3 %** compared to the same period in 2016.

The size and growth rate of the average monthly nominal accrued wages (for January-December 2017, without agriculture and small business entities)



In the structure of economic activities, the highest average monthly nominal accrued wages are noted in financial and insurance activities - **2 694,1** thousand soums (**85,4** % higher than the average national level), in the sphere of information and communication - **2 498,5** thousand soums (by **71,9** %), in industry - **2 091,7** thousand soums (**43,9** %), in transportation and storage - **1 945,8** thousand soums (by **33,9** %) and in construction - **1 808,4** thousand soums (by **24,4** %).

In terms of types of economic activity, the greatest growth in relation to 2016 was observed in financial and insurance activities (**25,9** %), information and communication (**22,3** %), accommodation and food services (**13,3** %).

By types of economic activity, the largest share of the number of employees and the wage fund falls on:

- the sphere of education - in **19 034** institutions **982,1** thousand people work (the share in the total number of workers in the country is **38,1 %**), the wage fund accrued to these workers was **13 671,6** billion soums (specific weight in wage fund in the republic - **30,4 %**);

- industry - **479,6** thousand people (**18,6 %**) work in **619** enterprises, the wage fund amounted to **12 038,4** billion soums (**26,7 %**);

- the sphere of health care and the provision of social services - **420,4** thous. people (**16,3 %**) work in **1 420** institutions, and the wage fund amounted to **4 948,2** billion soums (**11,0 %**).

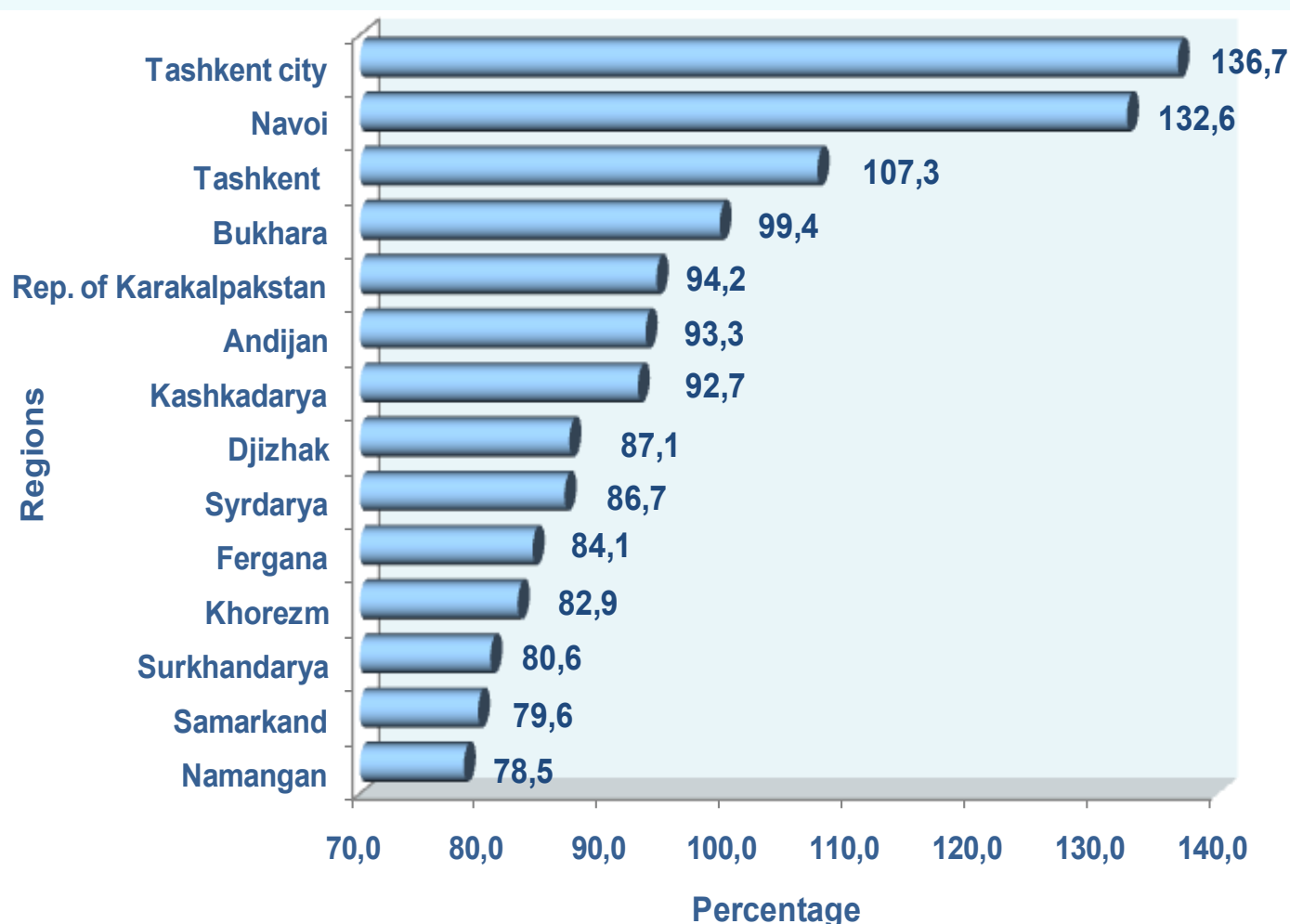


For reference: According to the Labor Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the monthly salary of an employee who has fulfilled the labor standards and labor obligations fully defined for this period can not be lower than the established by the legislation size for the first category of the Unified Wage Grid (in January-December 2017 amounted to 375,5 thousand soums).

If we consider the average monthly nominal salary in the context of regions, then its highest level is observed in Tashkent city - **1 986,5** thousand soums (**136,7 %** of the average republican indicator), in Navoi region - **1 926,5** thousand soums (**132,6 %**) and in the Tashkent region - **1 559,7** thousand soums (**107,3 %**), and the lowest in the Namangan region - **1 140,5** thousand soums (**78,5 %**), the Samarkand region **1 157,3** thousand soums (**79,6 %**).
