

INFORMATION*

on minimum and maximum prices for certain types of food products in the central dehkan markets of the regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan

*(Prices are recorded at the time of the survey and may be subject to fluctuations when the time, date, and location change. Price registration is carried out only on the territory of **dehkan markets** and does not cover such objects of organized trade as **supermarkets, minimarkets, shops, etc.**)*



According to the results of a sample statistical survey of prices of certain types of food products in the central dehkan markets of the centers of regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Tashkent city, conducted by the statistical authorities on June 23, 2020 the following minimum and maximum prices were recorded:

Beef
(except boneless meat)
from 38 000 to 65 000 soums per kg.



The minimum price for beef (except boneless meat) was registered in Nukus city at the market of “Nukus dehqon bozori” amounted to 38 000 soums per kg.

The maximum price was noted at the level of 65 000 soums per kg at the markets of “Oloy dehqon bozori”, “Farhod dehqon bozori” and “Mirobod dehqon bozori” in Tashkent city.



Mutton
from 39 000 to 75 000 soums per kg.



The lowest price of a kilogram of lamb was 39 000 soums and was registered in Tashkent city – “Mirobod dehqon bozori” market.

The highest price of 75 000 soums per kg was noted at the capital's market of “Oloy dehqon bozori”.



Potato
from 1 000 to 5 500 soums per kg.

The minimum price of potatoes was 1 000 soums per kg. and was registered in Andijon city – “Yangi bozor dehqon bozori” markets.



The maximum price of 5 500 soums per kg was marked in Tashkent city – “Oloy dehqon bozori” market.

Onion
from 750 to 3 000 soums per kg.



The lowest price of onions 750 soums per kg was observed in Termiz city – “Markaziy dehqon oziq-ovqat bozori” market.

The maximum price of 3 000 soums per kg is registered in Tashkent city – “Oloy dehqon bozori” and “Mirobod dehqon bozori” markets.



Carrot
from 1 000 to 4 500 soums per kg.

The minimum price of carrots was 1 000 soums per kg. and was registered in Jizzakh city – “Eski shahar dehqon bozori”, Guliston city – “Guliston dehqon bozori”, Fergana city – “Markaziy dehqon bozori” and Tashkent city – “Farhod dehqon bozori” markets.



The maximum price of 4 500 soums per kg was registered at the market of “Oloy dehqon bozori” in Tashkent city.

Eggs
from 5 000 to 13 000 soums per dozen



The minimum price for a dozen eggs in the amount of 5 000 soums was registered in Andijan city - “Yangi bozor dehqon bozori” and “Andijon shahar markaziy dehqon bozori” markets, Gulistan city at the market of “Guliston dehqon bozori”.

The highest price of 13 000 soums was also noted in Tashkent city – “Oloy dehqon bozori” market.



Rice
from 4 500 to 18 000 soums per kg.

The lowest price of rice at the level of 4 500 soums per kg was observed in Nukus city at “Nukus dehqon bozori” (domestic rice sort of “Nukus 2”) market.



The maximum price was 18 000 soums per kg (sort “Laser”) and was registered in Tashkent city at “Mirobod dehqon bozori” market.

Vegetable oil
from 8 400 to 14 500 soums per 1 liter



The minimum price of vegetable oil at the level of 8 400 soums per liter (domestic cottonseed oil) was observed in Tashkent city at “Mirobod dehqon bozori”, “Qo‘yliq dehqon bozori” and “Eski jo‘va dehqon bozori” markets.

The maximum price was 14 500 soums per liter (imported sunflower oil) and was registered in Tashkent city at the market of “Oloy dehqon bozori”.



Sugar

from 5 800 to 7 000 soums per kg.



The cheapest sugar was sold 5 800 soums per kg in Namangan city - “Namangan chorsu dehqon universal bozori”, Termez city - “Markaziy dehqon oziq-ovqat bozori”, Gulistan city - “Guliston dehqon bozori”, Tashkent city – “Oloy dehqon bozori”, “Farhod dehqon bozori”, “Qo‘yliq dehqon bozori”, “Eski jo‘va dehqon bozori” and “Mirobod dehqon bozori” markets.

The maximum sugar price of 7 000 soums per kg was registered in Tashkent city – at “Mirobod dehqon bozori” and “Oloy dehqon bozori” markets.



More detailed information by central dehqan markets is provided below:

*) Monitoring of **MINIMUM** and **MAXIMUM** prices for certain types of food products is carried out by statistical agencies in the administrative centers of the regions, the cities of Nukus and Tashkent on a **SAMPLE RANGE** of central **DEHKAN MARKETS**.

When determining the **MINIMUM** and **MAXIMUM** prices in the central dehkan markets of the regions of the country, objects of trade that are not dehkan markets (minimarkets, supermarkets, shops, stalls, etc.) are **NOT EXAMINED**.

THE PURPOSE OF OBSERVATION IS THE DETERMINATION OF THE RANGE OF PRICES for basic food products in the dehkan markets of the republic on the basis of the State Statistical Work Program approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Prices registered in this way **CANNOT** be used to evaluate and characterize average consumer prices, as well as the dynamics of their change.

The fact of registration in the dehkan market of a certain region of the **MINIMUM** or **MAXIMUM** price for a particular product **DOES NOT** be the basis for assuming that the average price level in this region is also **MINIMUM** or **MAXIMUM** in the republic.

The level of **MINIMUM** and **MAXIMUM** prices in dehkan markets is influenced by assortment and territorial shifts, as well as the current situation at the time of the survey.

Prices are recorded at the time of the survey and may be subject to fluctuations when the time, date and place of data collection changes.
