## Figures:

The volume of construction work reached **35984.4 billion soums**The share of large contractors amounted to **30.6%** 

The share of small enterprises and microfirms is equal 40.8%

The share of the informal sector was 28.6%

Construction activity in Uzbekistan is one of the most significant spheres of the economy and one of the attractive areas of investment.

In January-October of this year, the volume of construction work performed amounted to 35984.4 billion soums. The growth rate to the corresponding period of the previous year reached 106.2%.

The volume of construction work performed by large contracting organizations amounted to 1,1003.8 billion soums, or 102.4% of the corresponding period of the previous year, the share in the total volume of construction works

reached 30.6%.

Small enterprises and microfirms completed construction works for 14,696.9 billion soums, or 40.8% of the total volume of construction works, the growth rate was 114.4%. The share of the informal sector was 28.6%, or 10283.7 billion soums, the growth rate - 99.4%.




The main part of the construction work on the types of economic activity was carried out through the construction of residential buildings and non-residential premises. Their share in the total volume of construction work amounted to 77.6% and, compared to the same period of the previous year, increased by 0.6% points.


The share in the volume of construction works in this type of economic activity, such as civil engineering, amounted to 11.2% and, compared to the same period of the previous year, decreased by 0.4%.

The share of specialized construction work was 11.2% and, compared to the same period of the previous year, decreased by 0.2% points.



## Construction works by activities in January-October





The share in the volume of construction work in this type of economic activity, such as the construction of buildings and structures, performed by large contractors, amounted to 28.4% and, compared to the same period of the previous year, increased by 0.8% points. Accordingly, the share of small enterprises and microfirms was 35.4% (an increase of 1.7% points), the share of the informal sector - 36.2% (a decrease of 2.5% points).





Major contracting organizations performed 50.4% of the total volume of construction work, in this type of economic activity, as the construction of civil facilities. Compared with the same period of the previous year, it's increased by 2.1% points. The share of small enterprises and microfirms was 45.1% (a decrease by 2.1% points), the informal sector - 4.5%.

In the volume of specialized construction work, the share of large contracting organizations decreased by 6.4% points and amounted to 25.9%.

The share of small enterprises and microfirms accounts for 74.1% (an increase of 6.4% points).








In the current period, most of the volume of construction work was carried out by small enterprises and microfirms. From their side, the share in the total volume of construction work amounted to 40.8%, and increased by 1.9% points compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. On the part of large construction organizations, the share in the total volume of construction work reached 30.6%, and decreased by 10.9% in comparison with the corresponding period of the previous year. The share of the informal sector in the volume of construction work amounted to 28.6%, and increased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year by 8.7% points.




## Growth rates of construction work by type of enterprises




Navoi region leads in the regional structure of construction work carried out by large contractors. Major contractors in the region carried out 31.8% of the total volume of construction work, and compared with the same period of the previous year, this figure increased by 7.6%, respectively, in Tashkent, the figure was 26.9% and increased by 8.9% points.





The lowest share in the volume of construction work performed by large contracting organizations was recorded in the Samarkand region - 1.8%. The bulk of the construction work in this region fell to the share of the informal sector - 49.5% of the total construction work.





The highest growth rates of construction work were observed in the Navoi region. High growth rates (121.7%) were achieved here, due to:

- construction of a mine for the extraction and processing of goldbearing ores from the deposits of the "Auminzo-Amantay" ore field (GMZ-5) (stages I-II);
- reconstruction of the third line of the pumping station "Amudaryo-Zarafshon";
- Improvements in the extraction of gold from refractory ores from the "Kokpatas" and "Daugiztau" deposits.


The active construction of the following facilities ensured high growth rates in the Tashkent region (113,7 %):

- construction of highways UE "Avtomagistral";
- construction of a new plant in the Navoi region Subsidiary enterprise "Element-Qurilish";
- construction of "Qodiriya GES", as well as a military camp "Chorbog'gesqurilish" UE.



In Tashkent, high growth rates (110.7%) were achieved due to:

- construction of the "Yunusabad" and "Sergeli" metro lines;
- construction of hydropower plants in the Pskent district;
- construction of an overhead metro line in the city of Tashkent;
- reconstruction of the National park under the park of the Union of writers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
