

In January - April of the current year, the volume of construction work in the Republic of Uzbekistan amounted to **23 292.3 billion soums**, and the growth rate in relation to the corresponding period of 2019 reached **90.1%**.




The structure of the volume of construction work, share in% for January - April 2020



It is known that the volume of construction work is formed by their composition, carried out by large construction organizations, small enterprises and microfirms, as well as the informal sector.


For information: Construction activity is the result of construction work carried out on its own, the volume of new construction, overhaul and maintenance, as well as other contract work.





Information on operating enterprises and organizations in the construction sector, units

As of May 1, 2020, the number of enterprises and organizations in the construction sector reached **37.9** thousand units. and, compared with the same period last year, it increased by **6.9** thousand units.



The main factor in the growth in the number of construction enterprises and organizations was an increase in specialized work by 114.7% (the share of their total number is 57.9%), in the construction of civilian facilities the number of enterprises and organizations increased by 133.1% (a share of their the total number is 8.5%), in the field of construction of buildings and structures - by 134.4% (the share of their total number reached 32.4%).







The share of existing construction enterprises in the Republic of Uzbekistan as of 01.05.2020, share in%




For information: the highest share in the number of construction enterprises in the republic was observed in Tashkent city- 18.4%, Tashkent - 8.5% and Kashkadarya - 8.3% regions.



The volume of construction work carried out by large construction organizations in January - April of the current year amounted to **6 578.0** billion soums. Compared with 2019, in the period under review, the growth rate of construction work amounted to **100.8%**, and their share in the total volume increased by **2.9%** and amounted to **28.2%**.



The volume of construction work performed by large construction organizations




For information: The highest share in the volume of construction work performed by large construction organizations was noted in Tashkent city (25.6% of the total volume of construction work in this region, or 109.3% of the corresponding period in 2019), Navoi region (25.3 % of the total volume of construction work in this region, or 118.1% of the corresponding period in 2019) and Surkhandarya region (17.8% of the total volume of construction work in the region, or 138.9% of the corresponding period of 2019).

The volume of construction work carried out by small enterprises and micro-firms. compared with other organizations, decreased in January-April 2020, their share was 55.1% of the total, which is 2.9% less when compared with the same period last year . Thus, the volume of construction work they completed amounted to 12 824.8 billion soums and, compared to January - April 2019, the growth rate reached **85.6%**.

The share of construction work in the informal sector, compared to the same period last year, remained unchanged and amounted to **16.7%**, or **3 889.5 billion soums**, the growth rate, compared to January - April 2019, reached **89.8** %.



Construction work in the country whole, carried as a out by state organizations, amounted to 947.6 billion soums, the growth rate compared to January - April 2019 reached 76.8%. The volume of construction non-governmental organizations work carried out by amounted 22 344.7 billion soums, the growth rate reached 90.8%, and their share was **4.1%** and **95.9%**, respectively.

The share of new construction, reconstruction, expansion and modernization in the total volume of construction work

January - April 2020



A significant part of the construction of new buildings and structures was completed in January - April 2020. So, 73.9% of the total volume of construction work, or 17,213.2 billion soums, were aimed at creating new production capacities in the economy, housing and communal services and other social facilities.

Large construction organizations completed construction work on new construction in the amount of **5,934.2** billion soums, or 90.2% of their total volume.





Small enterprises and micro-firms carried out construction work on new construction for **7,821.8** billion soums, or 61.0% of their total volume.

In the informal sector, construction work on new construction was performed in the amount of **3,457.2** billion soums, or 88.9% of their total volume.

For information: the bulk of the construction work by type of economic activity was the construction of residential and non-residential buildings, as well as the construction of buildings not intended for living.








Construction of buildings and structures

The share in the total volume of construction work performed by large construction organizations in the overall structure of buildings and structures amounted to **28.0%** and, compared with January - April 2019, increased by **1.8%** points.

The share of small enterprises and microfirms in this type of activity, compared with January - April 2019, decreased by **2.2%** points and amounted to **49.1%**.

The share of the informal sector, compared with January - April 2019, increased by **0.4%** points and amounted to **22.9%**.




Construction work on the construction of civilian facilities

Share in %

The proportion of the volume of construction work carried out by large construction organizations for the construction of civilian facilities amounted to **40.7%** and increased by **12.7%** compared with January - April 2019.

Also, the share of small enterprises and micro-firms in the construction of facilities amounted to **59.2%** (a decrease of **10.6%**), and the informal sector - **0.1%** (a decrease of **2.1%**).

In the total volume of specialized construction work, the share of large contractors decreased by **1.0** percentage points and amounted to **16.0%**, as a result of which the share of small enterprises and micro-firms reached **84.0%** (an increase of **1.0** percentage point).



Construction work by type of economic activity and region, share in%


Construction of buildings and structures



The highest share in the total volume of works on construction of buildings and structures in January-April of the current year was noted in the Tashkent city (15.8% of the total volume of construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 2677.4 billion soums), Samarkand region (7.1% of the total volume of construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 1 207.9 billion soums), Tashkent region (7.0% of the total volume of construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 1183.7 billion soums)

The highest share in the total volume of construction of civil facilities in January-April of this year was noted in Tashkent city (28.3% of the total construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 921.0 billion soums), Surkhandarya region (10.0% of the total volume of construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 324.4 billion soums), Tashkent region (7.6% of the total volume of construction of buildings and structures in this region, or 246.0 billion soums).

In January-April 2020, the largest volumes, in comparison with other regions, were recorded in Tashkent city (4,614.8 billion soums), as well as in Tashkent (1812.4 billion soums), Samarkand (1471.2 billion sum), Fergana (1416.2 billion soums), Kashkadarya (1329.1 billion soums), Bukhara (1237 billion soums) and Andijan (1177.6 billion soums) regions.



For information: today there are more than 37 thousand construction companies and monitoring surveys conducted during the coronavirus pandemic have revealed a temporary cessation of construction work. It is noted that the current situation as a whole negatively affected construction in the country.

As a result, the share of small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 54.3% of the total volume of construction work and compared to the same period last year, their volume of work decreased by 15.6%.

As a result of the pandemic, such state programs as "Kishlok Rim", "Mahalla Rim", as well as the construction of social facilities included in the investment program for 2020, were suspended due to financial difficulties, which, in turn, compared with the corresponding last year, negatively affected the decline in construction volume.
