



# Enterprises and organizations

(excluding farm enterprises and dekhkan farms)

## FIGURES:

- Number of operating enterprises and organizations has increased by **- 15,1 thsd. units**
- The share of non-operating enterprises remained unchanged.
- Number of newly established enterprises became 15,4 thsd. units more than liquidated ones.

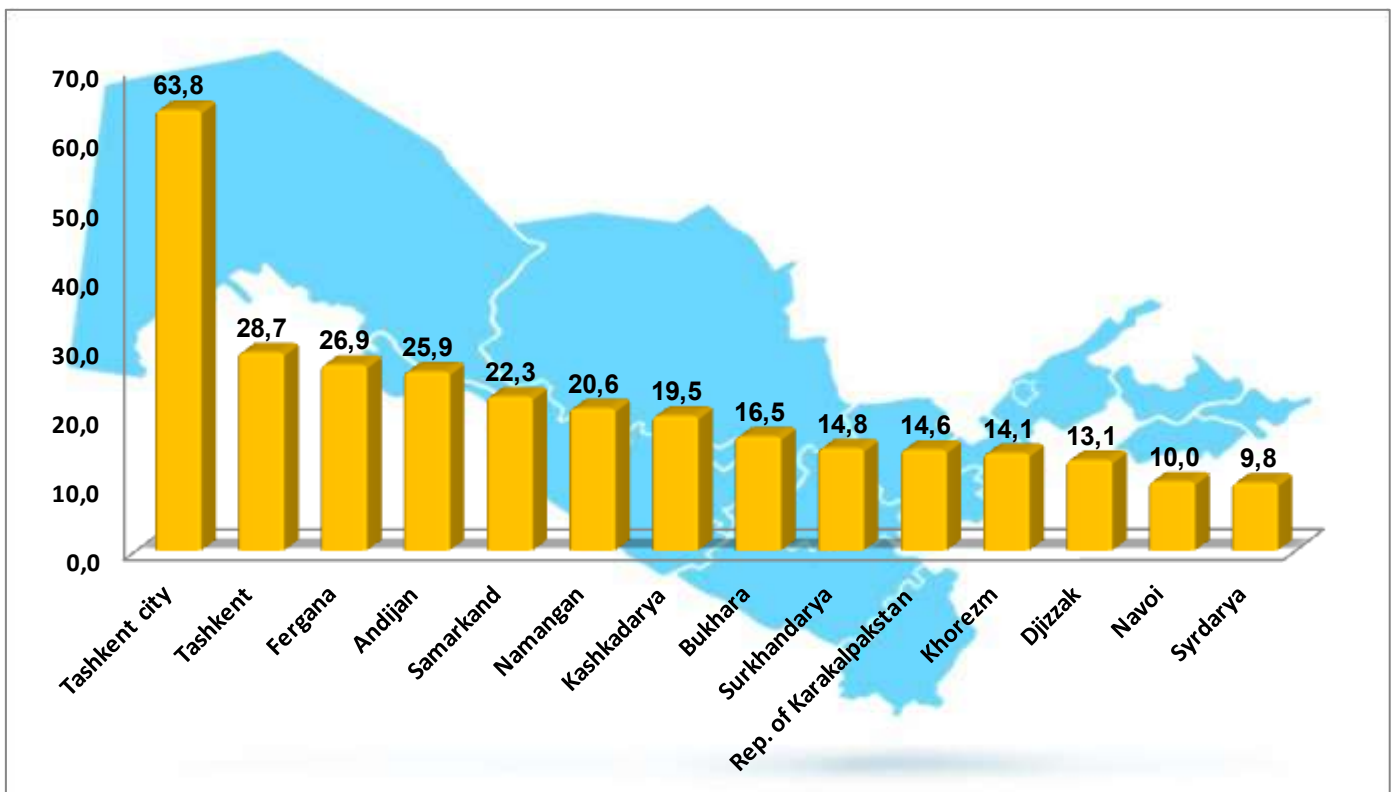
In January-April 2018 the number of newly created enterprises and organizations in the Republic of Uzbekistan was 20.7 thousand, which is 2.7 thousand more than in the same period of the last year.

The number of enterprises and organizations that have ceased their activity, as compared to the same period of the last year, decreased by 5.6 % and amounted to 5.3 thousand units.

As a result, the number of operating enterprises and organizations has increased by 15.1 thousand (5.3 %) since the beginning of the year and amounted to 300.6 thousand.

The largest share of operating enterprises and organizations was observed in Tashkent city (21.2 %), Tashkent region (9.5 %), Fergana region (8.9 %) and Andijan region (8.6 %).

(excluding farm enterprises and dekhkan farms), thsd. units**

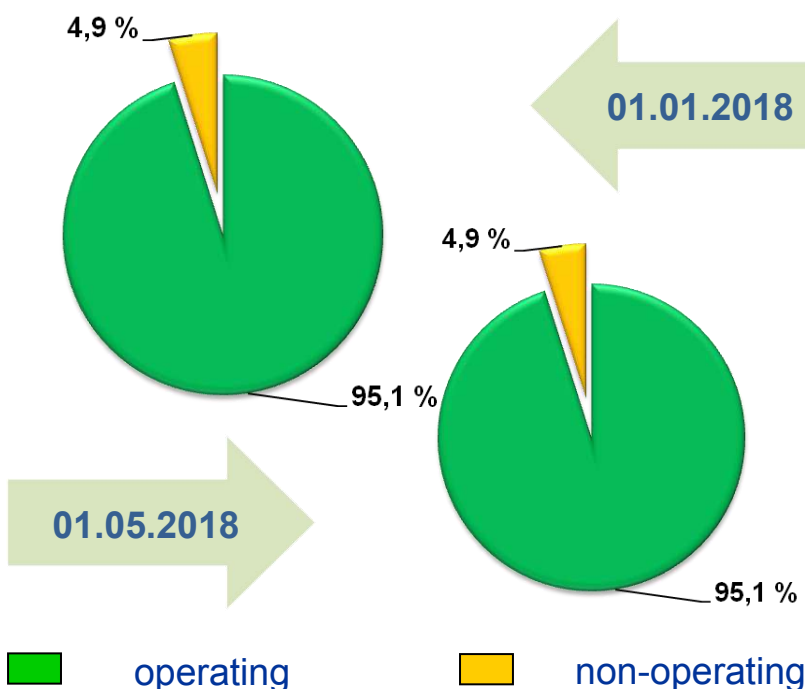

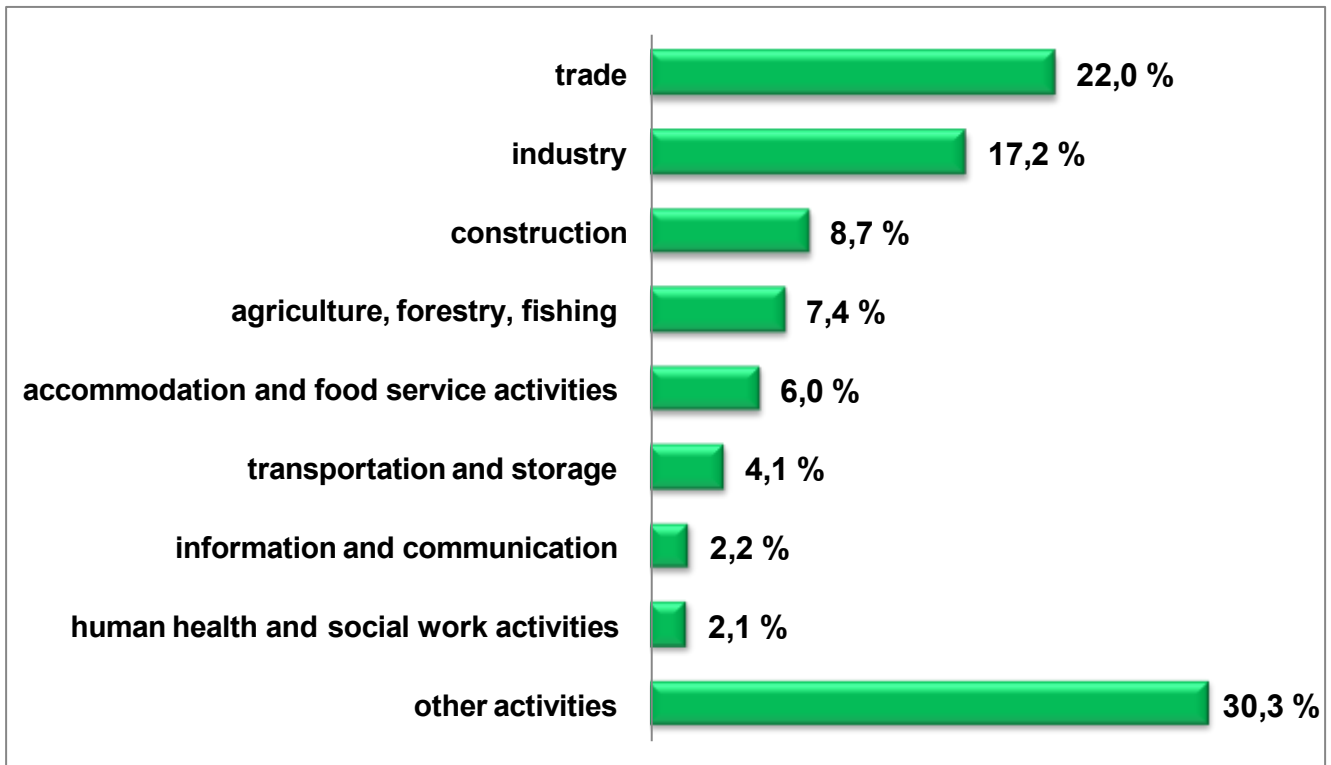
### **Share of operating and non-operating enterprises and organizations, %**



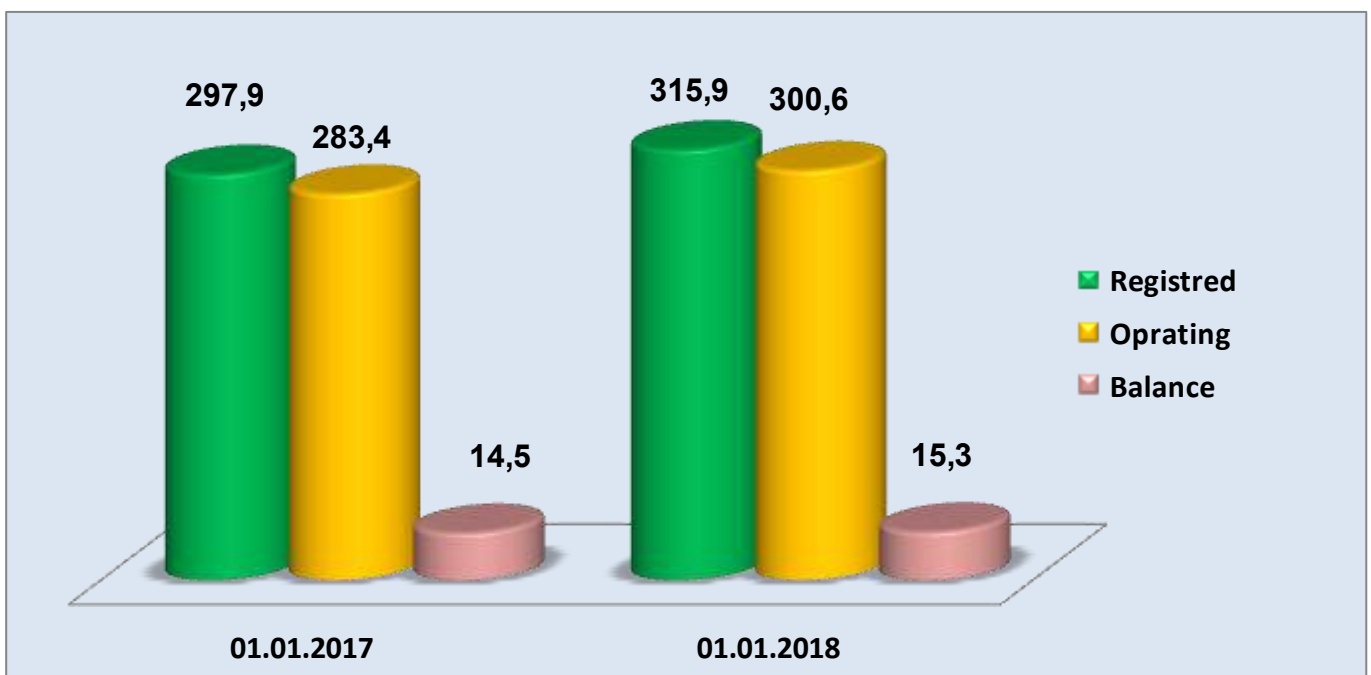
Out of the total registered enterprises and organizations the share of operating ones was 95,1 percent and that of non-operating ones – 4,9 percent. The share of non-operating enterprises and organizations remained unchanged compared to the beginning of the reporting year.

Out of the total number of operating enterprises and organizations 22.0% is the share of trade, 17.2% - industry, 8.7% - construction, 7.4% - agriculture, forestry and fishing, 6.0% - accommodation and food services, 4.1% - transportation and storage, 2.2% - information and communication, 2.1% - human health and social work, 30.3% - other economic activity.

(excluding farm enterprises and dekhkan farms), %

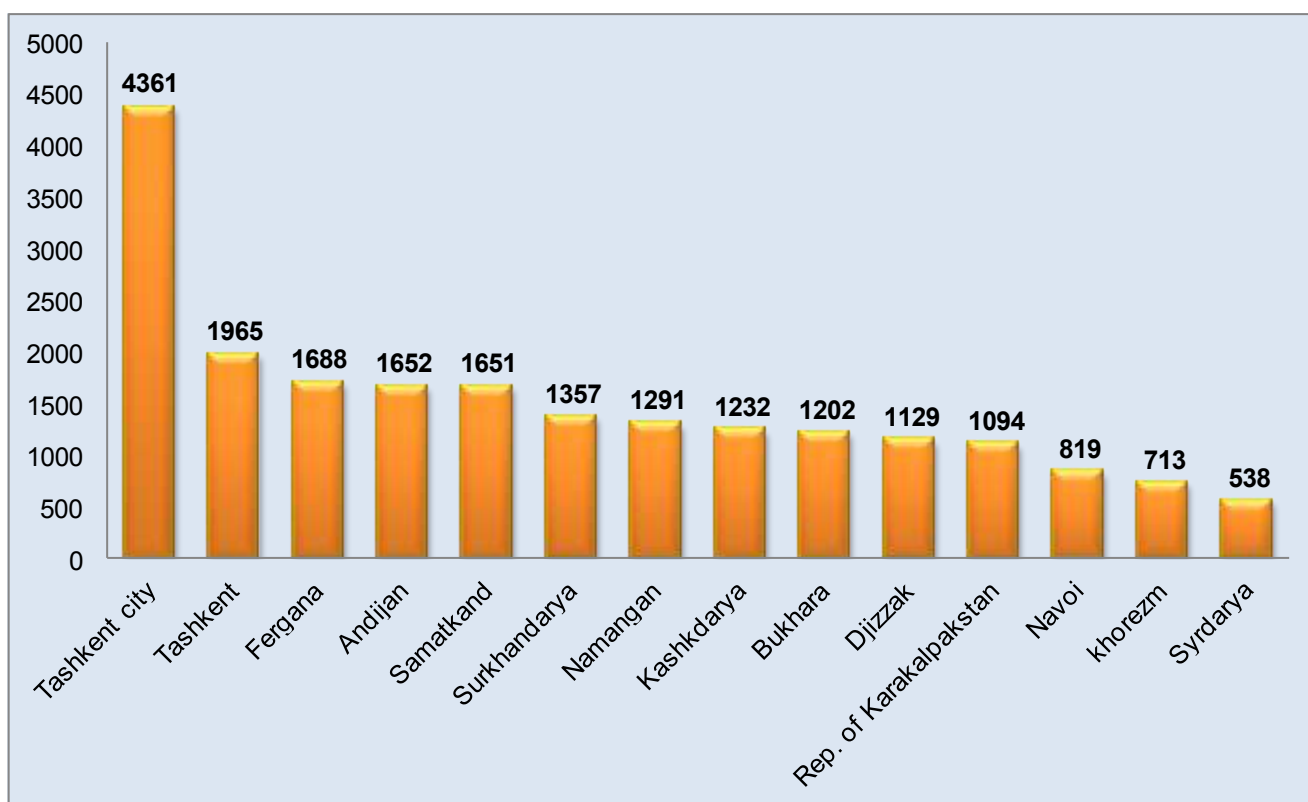


**Growth dynamics of registered and operating enterprises and organizations**  
(excluding farm enterprises and dekhkan farms), units



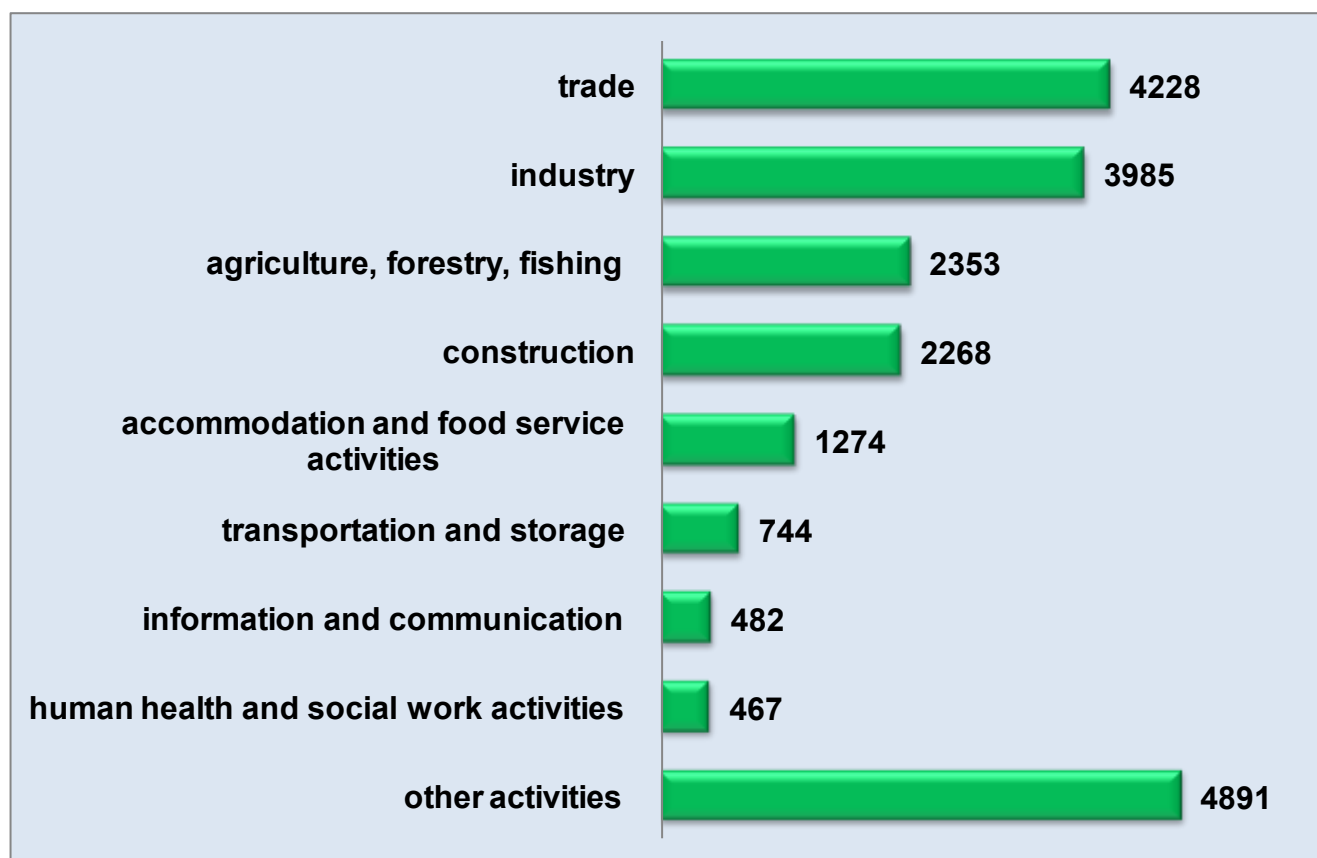
In January-April 2018 in the number of newly created enterprises and organizations amounted to 20692 units, which is 15.0% more than in the same period of the last year. The largest part of newly created enterprises and organizations falls on Tashkent city (4361 units), Tashkent region (1965 units), Fergana region (1688 units) and Andijan region (1652 units) and the smallest one - on Syrdarya region (538 units), Khorezm region (713 units) and Navoi region (819 units).

If we consider the number of newly created enterprises and organizations by economic activity the most part falls on trade (4228 units), industry (3985 units), agriculture, forestry and fishing (2353 units) and construction ( 2268 units). The smallest number is observed in human health and social work (467 units), information and communication (482 units) and transportation and storage (744 units).

The decrease in the share of operating enterprises and organizations by economic activity, compared with the same period of the last year, is observed in human health and social work activities (-0.9 percentage points), trade (-0.7 pp), which is due to an increase in the share of operating enterprises and organizations in industry (+0.8 pp), construction (+ 0.4 pp), agriculture, forestry and fishing (+0.2 pp. ), accommodation and food services, as well as other activities (+0.1 pp).

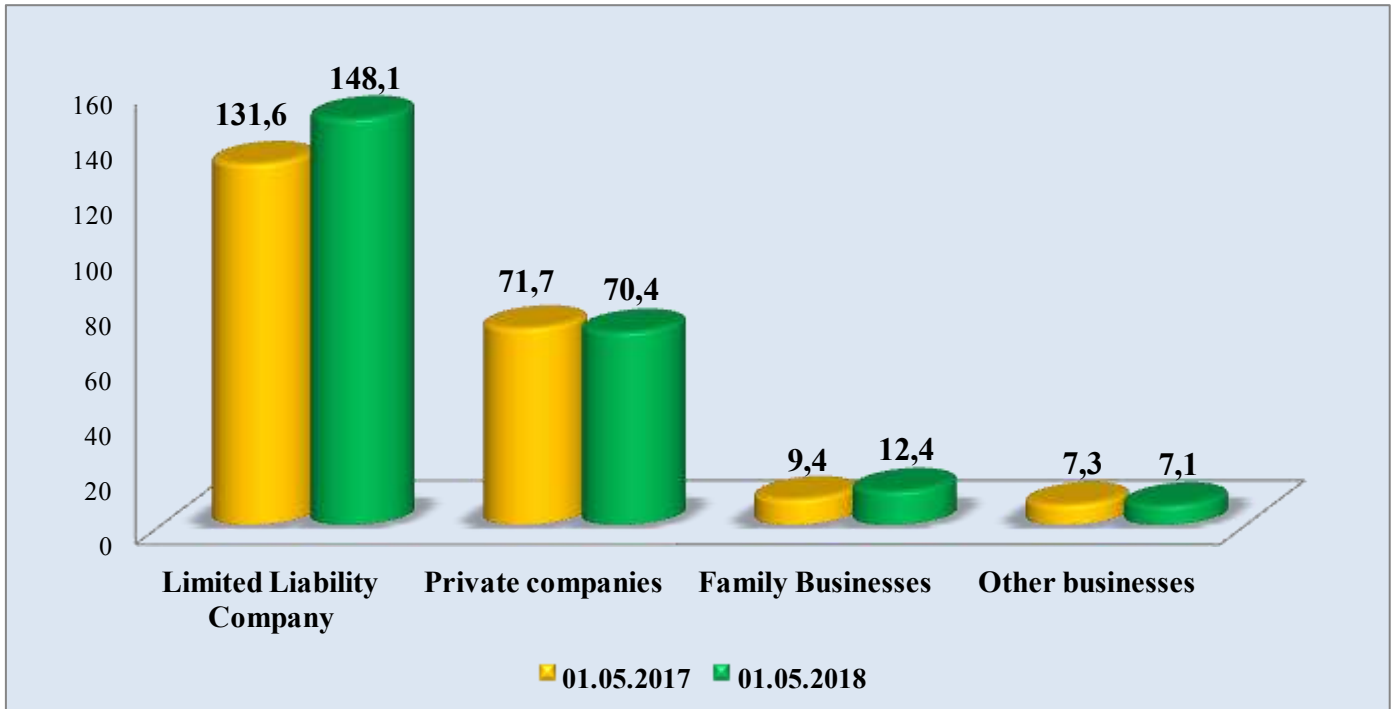
**Number of operating commercial enterprises according to Classification of organizational and legal arrangements**

The number of operating commercial enterprises and organizations as of May 1, 2018 amounted to 244.7 thousand units, of which 71.2 thousand units - private enterprises, 13.0 thousand units - family enterprises, 153.2 thousand units - limited liability companies, 0.6 thousand units - joint-stock companies and 6.7 thousand units - other enterprises.





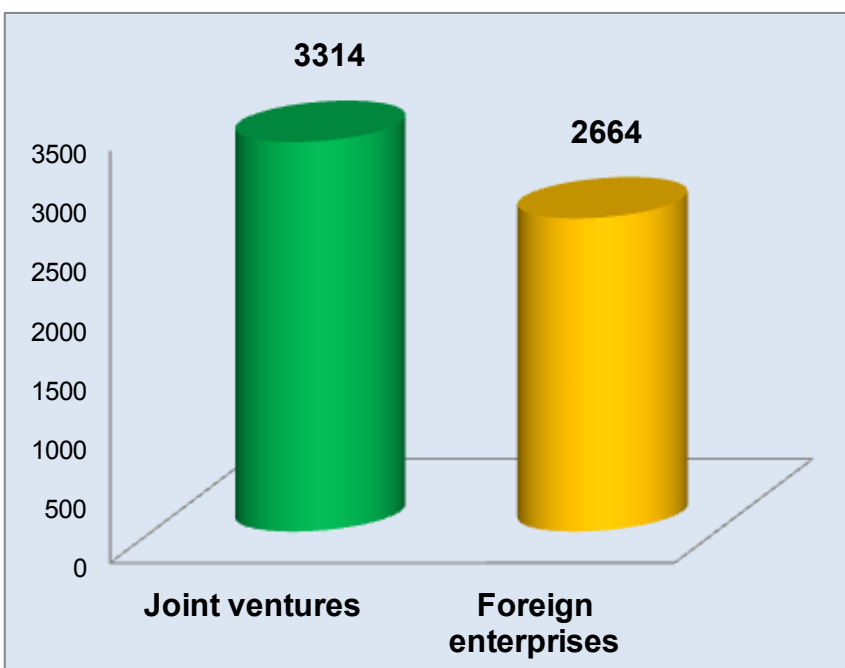
## Number of operating legal persons according to Classification of organizational and legal arrangements , thsd. units



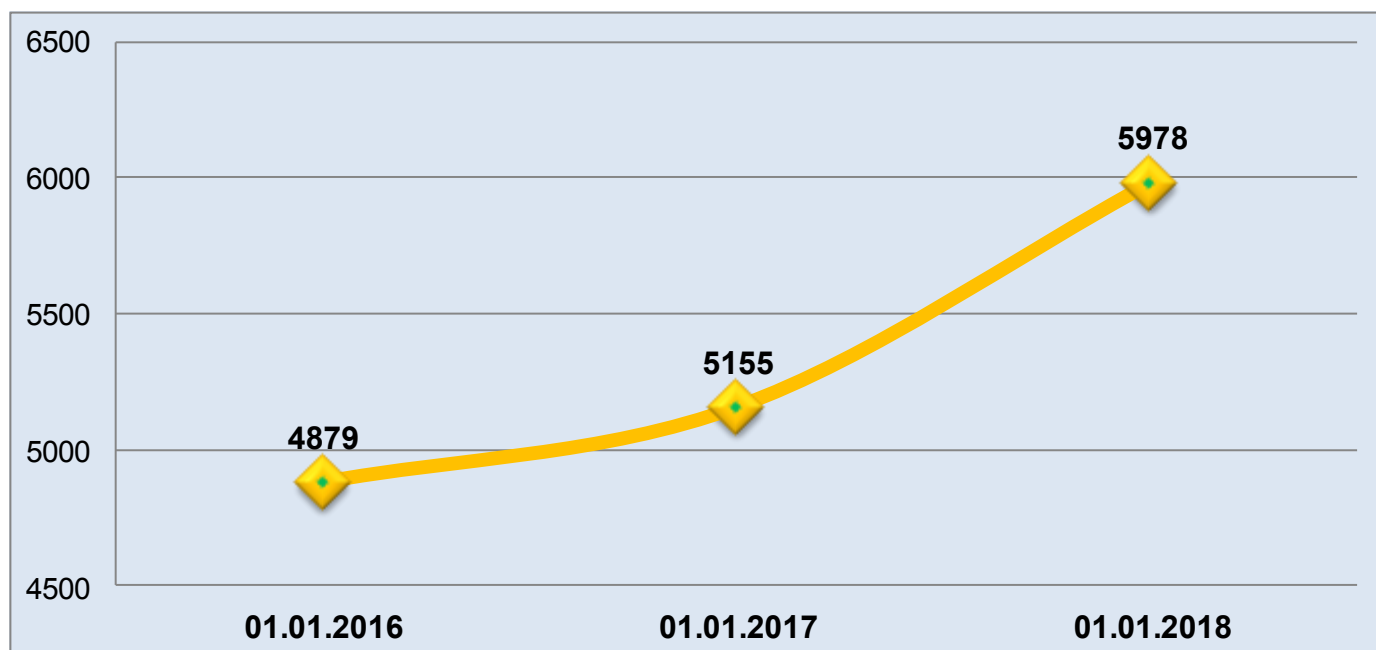
## Enterprises with foreign capital

As of May 1, 2018 the number of operating enterprises with foreign capital was 5978 units. In comparison with the previous year the growth in the number of operating enterprises reached 16.0% or 823 units. Of these joint ventures amount to 3314 units, foreign enterprises - 2664 units.

## Number of joint ventures and foreign enterprises within operating enterprises with foreign capital, units

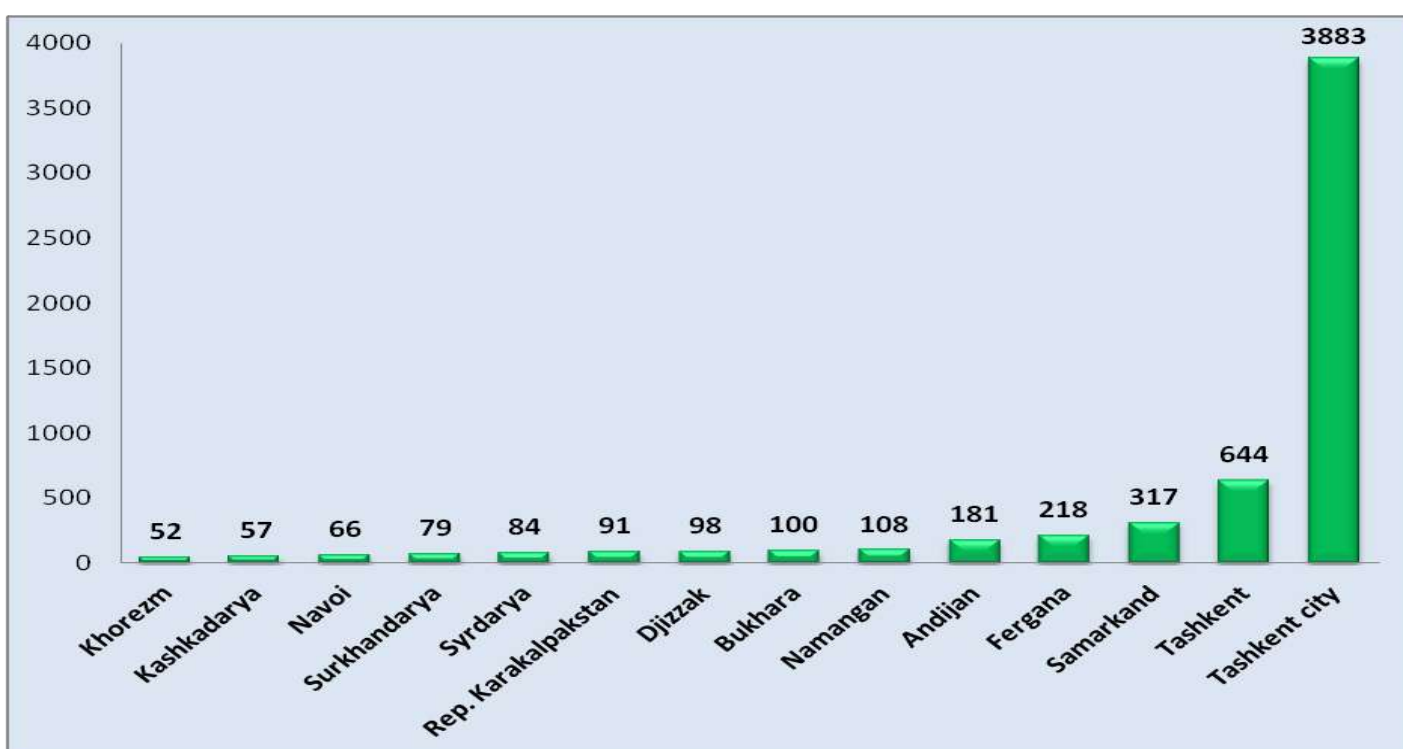


## Growth dynamics of enterprises with foreign capital, units



The main part of enterprises with foreign capital falls on Tashkent city - 3883 units (65.0%), Tashkent region - 644 units (10.8%) and Samarkand region - 317 units (5.3%), while the smallest one - Khorezm - 52 units (0.9%), Kashkadarya region - 57 units (1.0%), Navoi region - 66 units (1.1%) and Surkhandarya region - 79 units (1.3%). This indicates the need to strengthen joint work with foreign partners, develop and attract foreign investment in these regions.

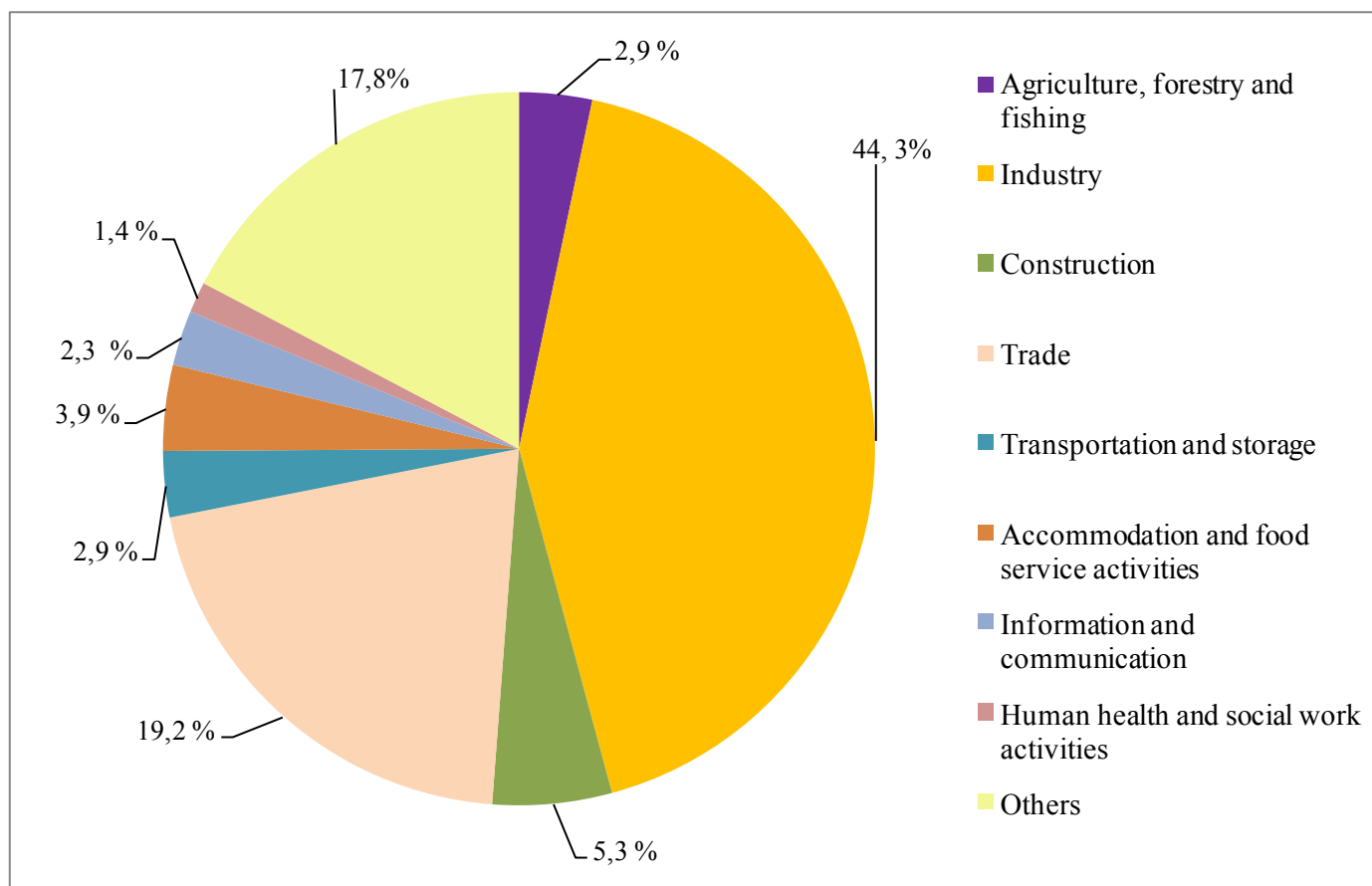
## Number of operating enterprises with foreign capital by region, units





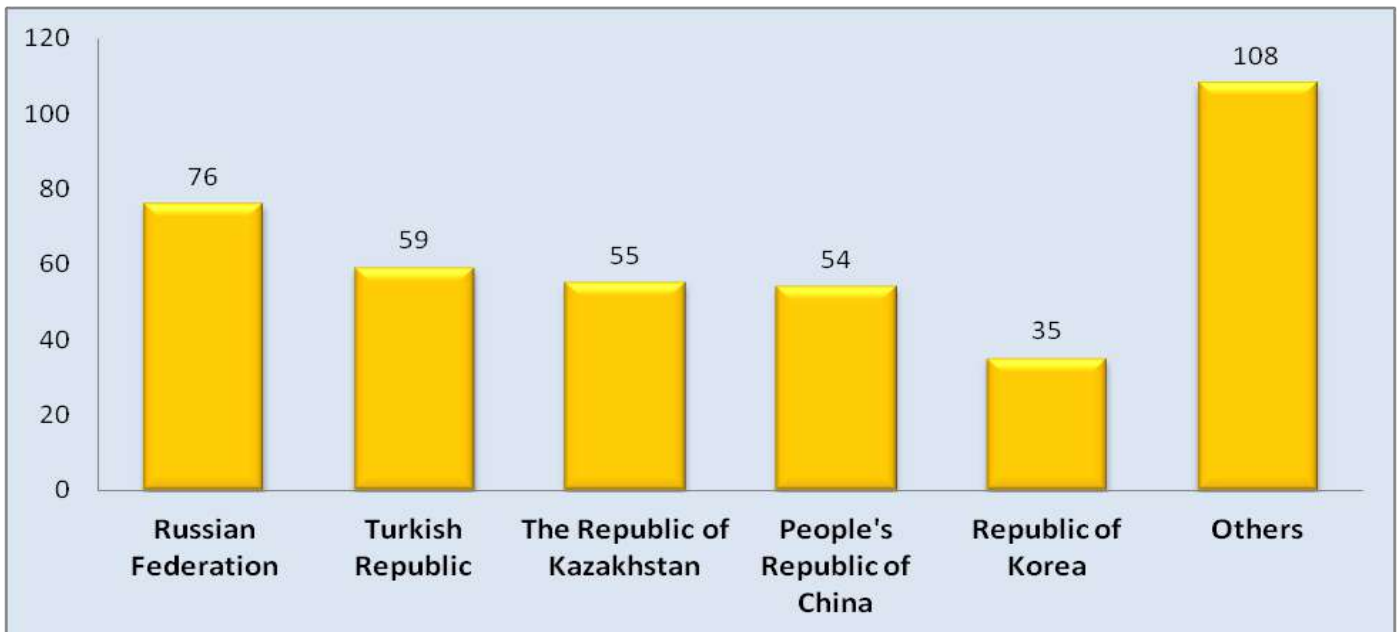
If we consider the number of operating enterprises with foreign capital by economic activity as of May 1, 2018, then the largest number falls on industry - 2542 units (42.5%), trade - 1239 units (20.7%) and other activity - 1036 units (17.3%), the lowest one - on human health and social work - 81 units (1.4%), information and communication - 150 units (2.5%), transportation and storage - 177 units (3.0%), agriculture, forestry and fishing - 198 units (3.3%), accommodation and food services - 233 units (3.9%) and construction - 322 units (5.4%). It is thus seen that the main part of operating enterprises with foreign capital are in industry and trade, the smallest one - in human health and social work and information and communication.

**Share of operating enterprises with foreign capital by economic activity, %**



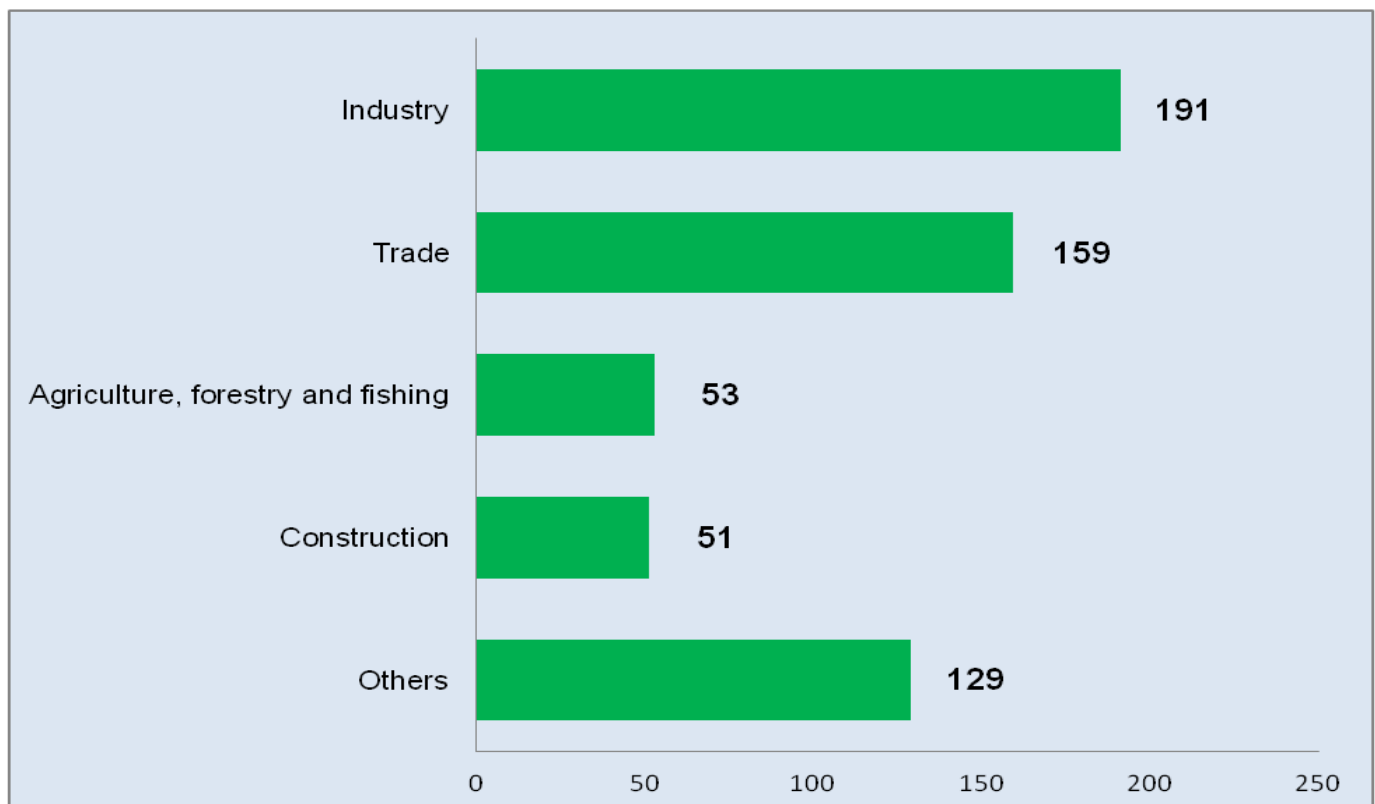
In January-April 2018 the number of newly created enterprises with foreign capital was 583 units. In comparison with the previous year the growth in the number of operating enterprises increased by 2.6 times and amounted to 360 units, while the number of enterprises with the capital of residents of the Russian Federation amounted to 119, Turkey - 85, Kazakhstan - 77, the PRC - 75 and the Republic of Korea - 54. Residents of Afghanistan, India, Germany, Ukraine, Azerbaijan, etc. also showed interest in joint activities in 2018.

If we consider newly created enterprises with foreign capital by economic activity the main part falls on industry - 191 units, trade - 159 units, agriculture, forestry and fishing - 53 units, construction - 51 units, and other activity - 129 units.

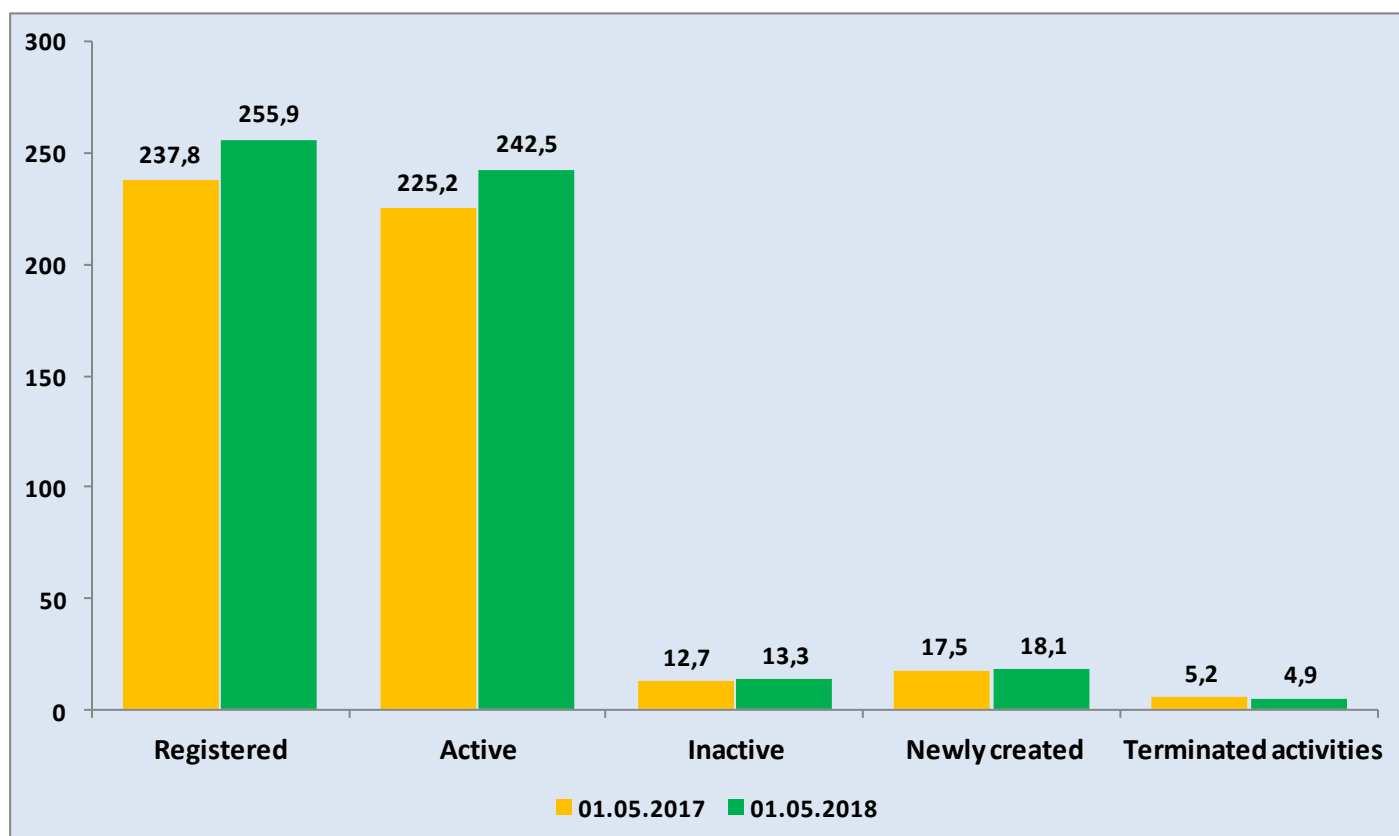
## Number of newly created enterprises with foreign capital by economic activity, units



## Number of small enterprises and micro-firms

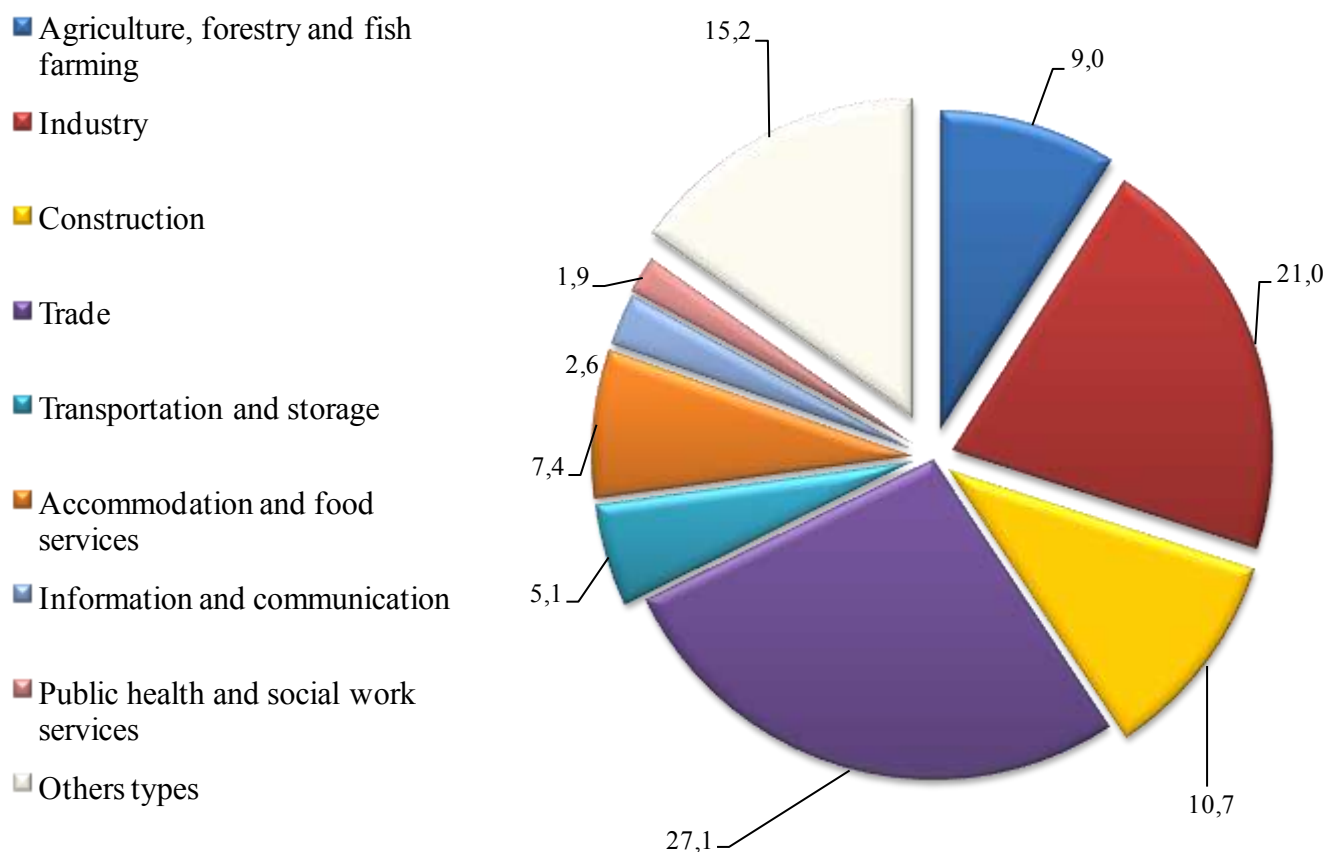
As of May 1, 2018 the number of operating small enterprises and micro-firms in the country was 242.5 thousand units. This indicator is 7.7% more than in the same period of the previous year. The main part of operating small enterprises and micro-firms belongs to Tashkent city - 54.7 thousand units (22.6%), Tashkent region - 23.2 thousand units (9.6%), Fergana region - 21.4 thousand units (8.8%) and Andijan region - 21.2 thousand units (8.7%).

Of the total number of operating small enterprises and micro-firms by economic activity the share of trade - 65.8 thousand units (27.1%), industry - 51.0 thousand units (21.0%), construction - 25.9 thousand units (10.7%), agriculture, forestry and fishing - 21.8 thousand units (9.0%), accommodation and food services - 17.9 thousand units (7.4%), transportation and storage services - 12.3 thousand units (5.1%), information and communication - 6.3 thousand units (2.6%), human health and social work activities - 4.7 thousand units (1.9%), as well as other activity - 36.8 thousand units (15.2%). From this it can be seen that the most part of operating small enterprises and micro-firms falls on industry and trade, the smallest one - human health and social work activities, as well as information and communication.

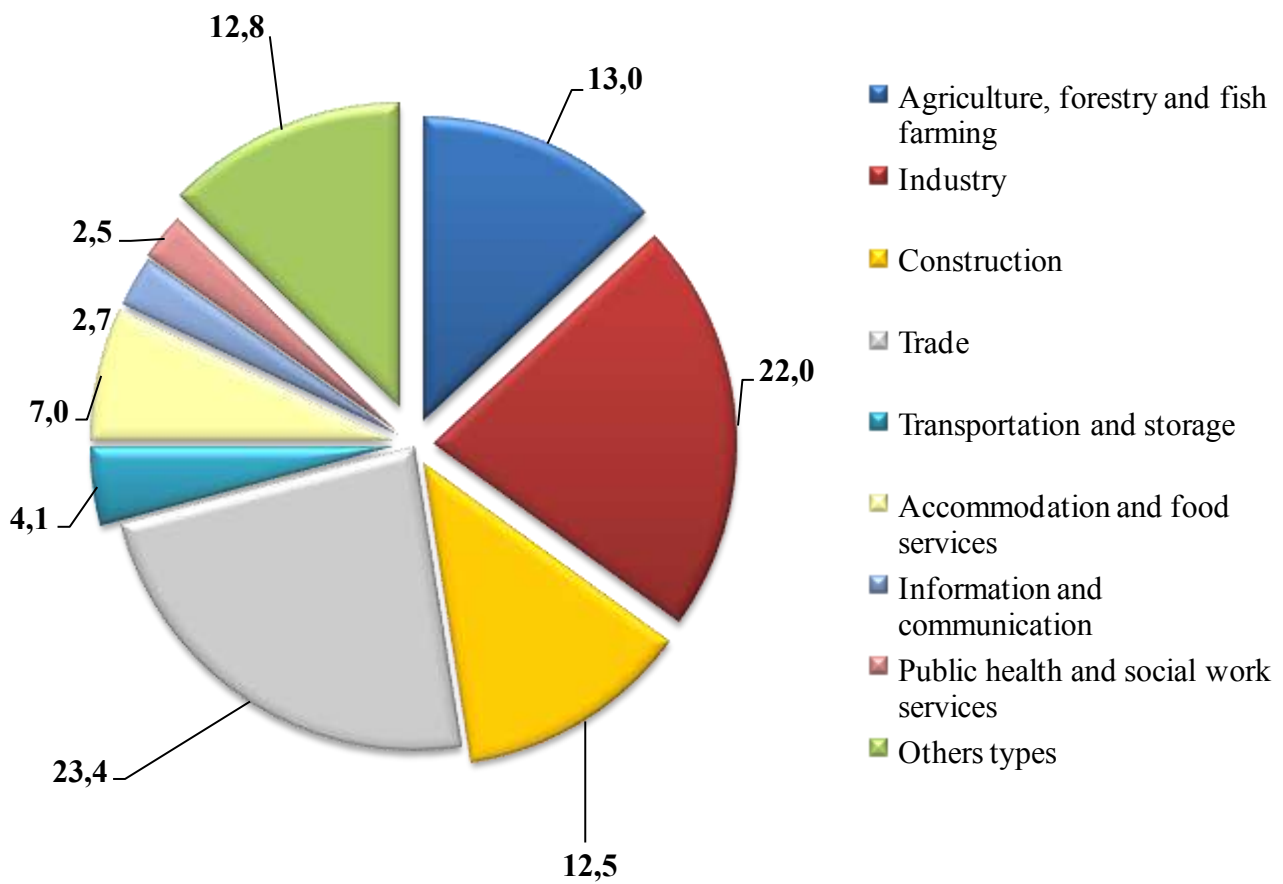
## Share of operating small enterprises and micro-firms by economic activity, %



In January-April 2018 the number of newly created small businesses and micro-firms amounted to more than 18.0 thousand units, which is 3.4% more than in the same period of the last year. A significant part of the total newly created small enterprises is marked in Tashkent city (4133 units), Tashkent region (1814 units), Samarkand region (1532 units) and Fergana region (1422 units), the smallest one - in Syrdarya region (494 units), Khorezm region (612 units) and Navoi region (693 units).

If we consider the number of newly created small enterprises by economic activities, then the largest part falls on trade - 4221 units, industry - 3979 units, agriculture, forestry and fishing - 2346 units, construction - 2265 units, the smallest one - on human health and social work activities - 460 units, information and communication - 481 units, as well as transportation and storage - 741 units.

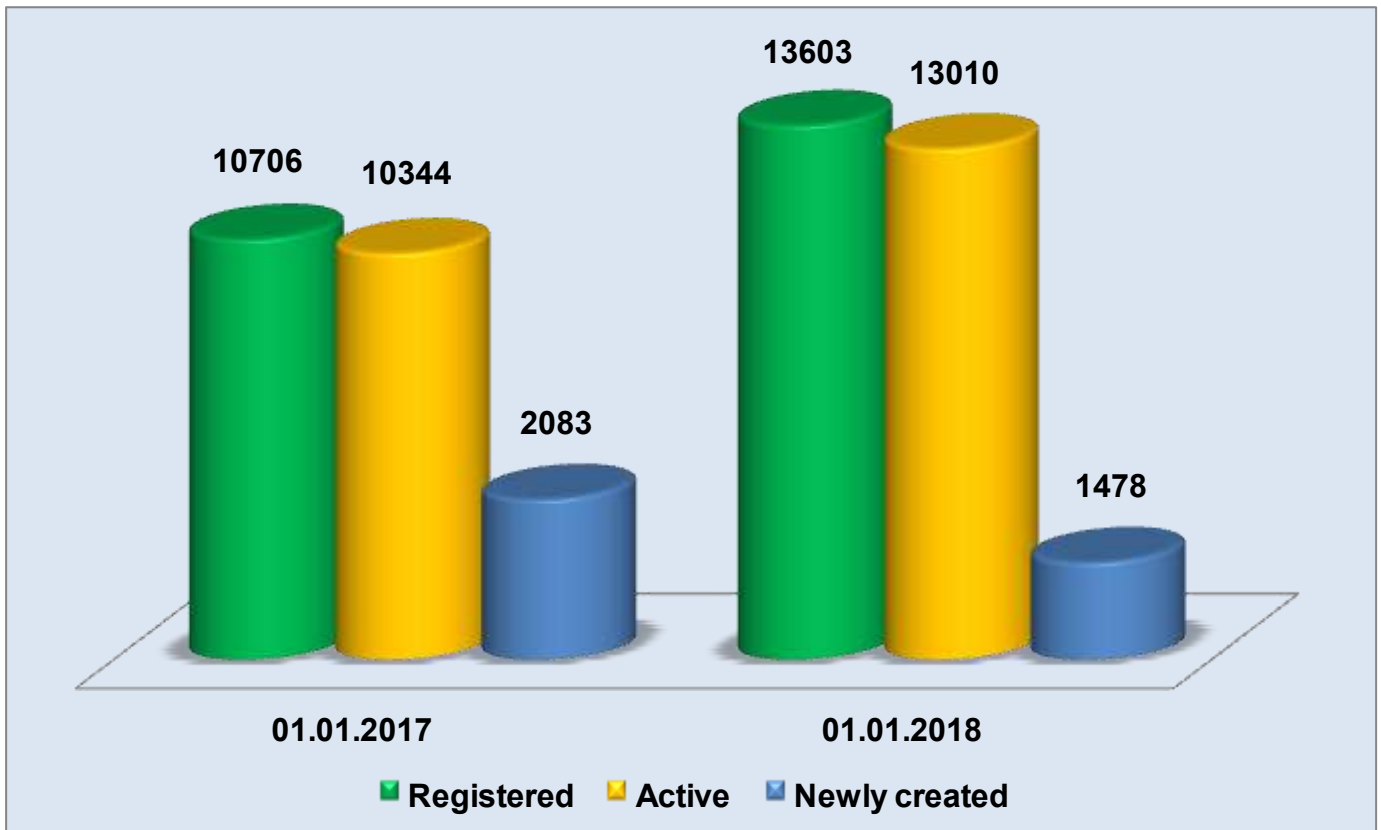
## Share of newly created small enterprises and micro-firms by economic activity, %



## Number of family enterprises

As of May 1, 2018 the number of family enterprises that passed state registration as a legal entity was 13603 units, of which 13010 units or 95.6% are operating. In comparison with the previous year the growth in the number of registered and operating family enterprises averaged 26.4%.

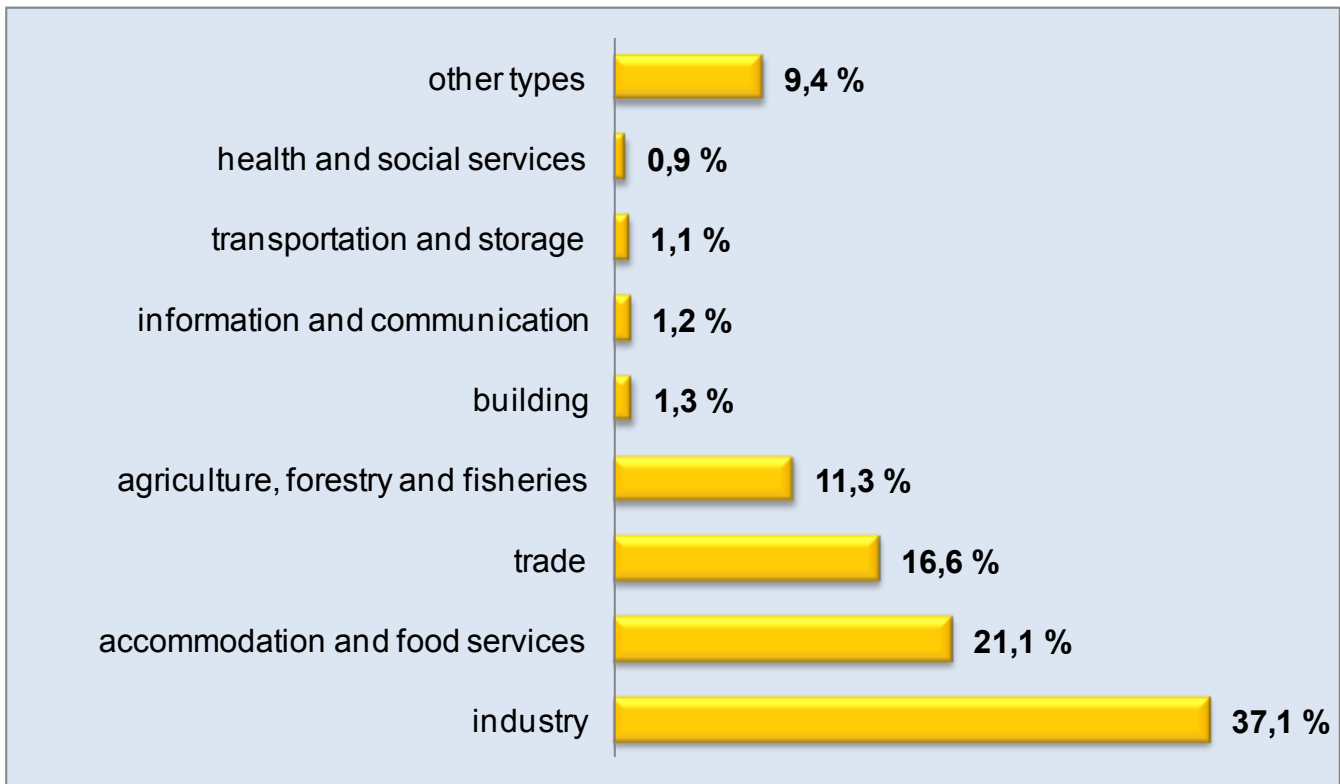
### Growth dynamics of family enterprises, units





If we consider the number of operating family enterprises by economic activity the main share falls on industry - 37.1% or 4832 units, accommodation and food services - 21.1% or 2739 units, trade - 16.6% or 2168 units, agriculture, forestry and fishing - 11.3% or 1469 units, construction - 1.3% or 172 units, information and communication - 1.2% or 152 units, transportation and storage - 1,1% or 142 units, human health and social work - 0,9% or 117 units and other activity - 9.4% or 1219 units.
