**An important indicator of the level of well-being of the population is the total income, which is the gross income before deducting from it the mandatory or other deductions.**

**Comprehensive income includes both cash income and income in kind, and consists of income, which, as a rule, has the property of repetition and enters the household or its individual members on a regular basis, annually or at shorter intervals.**



If you look at the figures, then, according to preliminary data, in January-December 2018, the total volume of total income of the population amounted to 286.3 trillion soums, which, per person, averages 8.7 million soums.

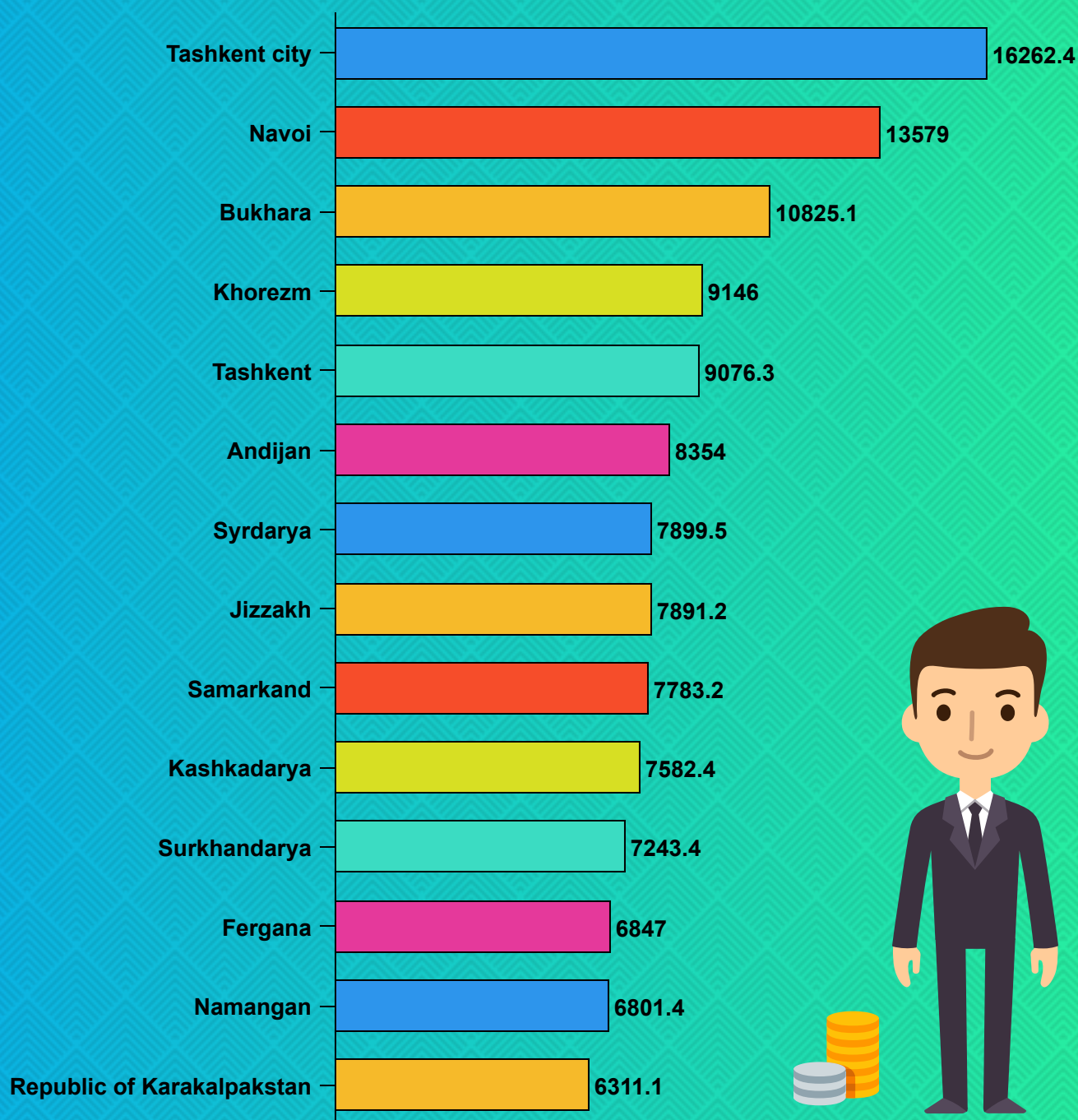
Real incomes characterize nominal incomes taking into account changes in retail prices and tariffs, representing the real purchasing power of people with nominal incomes.

Due to the change in consumer prices, the growth rate of the aggregate income of the population, compared to the same period last year, in real terms was 110.3 %, and per capita income was 108.4 %.





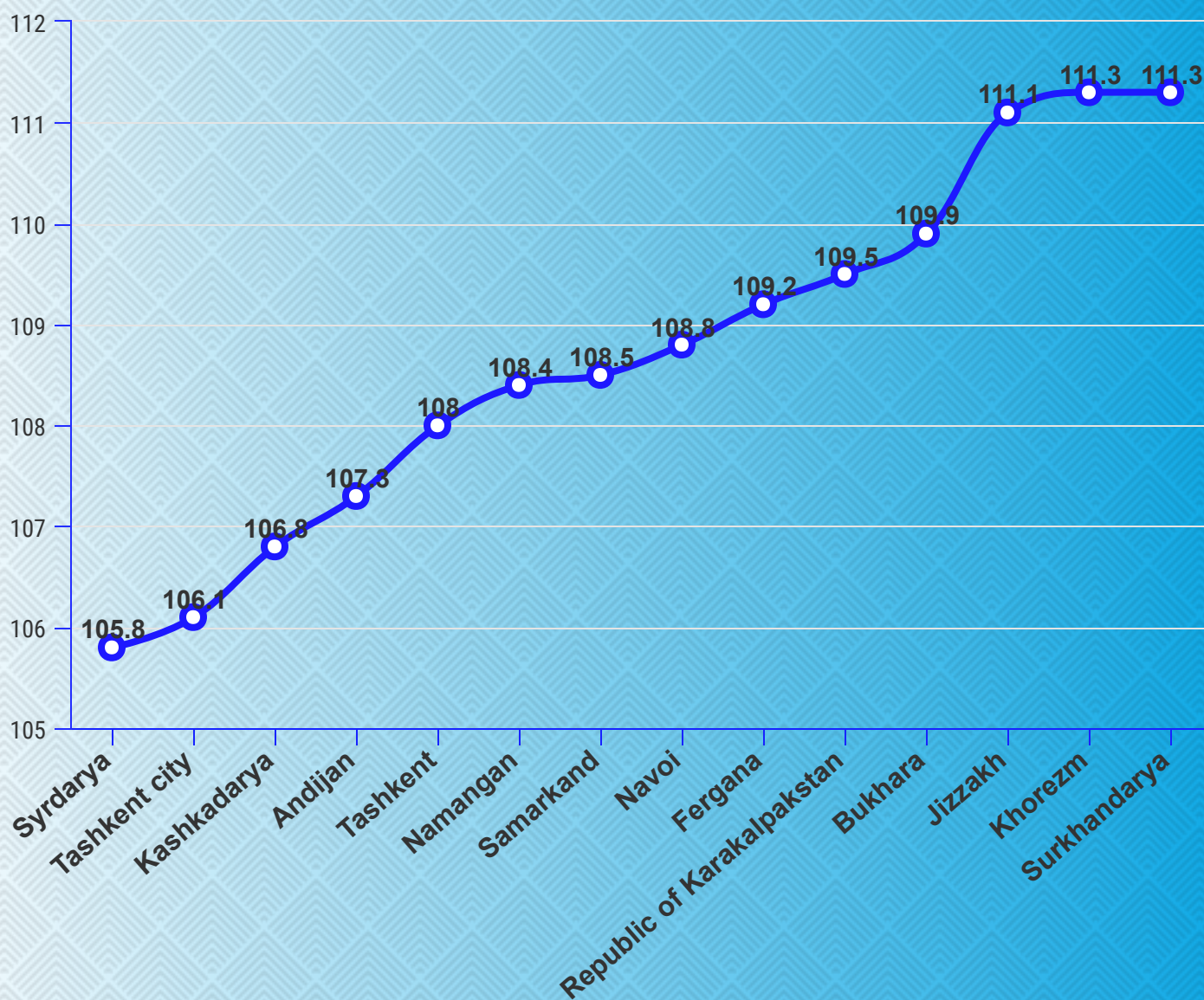
# The volume of per capita total income of the population in the regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan for January-December 2018, thousand soums



The average per capita nominal aggregate income of the population above the national average was recorded in the Tashkent city - 16262.4 thousand soums, Navoi - 13579.0 thousand soums, Bukhara - 10825.1 thousand soums, Khorezm - 9146.0 and Tashkent - 9076.3 thousand soums, regions. The lowest indicator of the average per capita nominal aggregate income of the population was recorded in the Republic of Karakalpakstan - 6311.1 thousand soums and Namangan region - 6801.4 thousand soums.



## Real growth rates of average per capita total income in the regions of the Republic of Uzbekistan in January-December 2018, %



A very high rate of real growth in per capita total income was recorded in the Surkhandarya and Khorezm regions - 11.3 %. Also in Jizzakh - 11.1 %, Bukhara - 9.9 %, the Republic of Karakalpakstan - 9.5%, Fergana - 9.2 %, Navoi - 8.8 % and Samarkand - 8.5 % regions the average per capita income exceeds the average level.

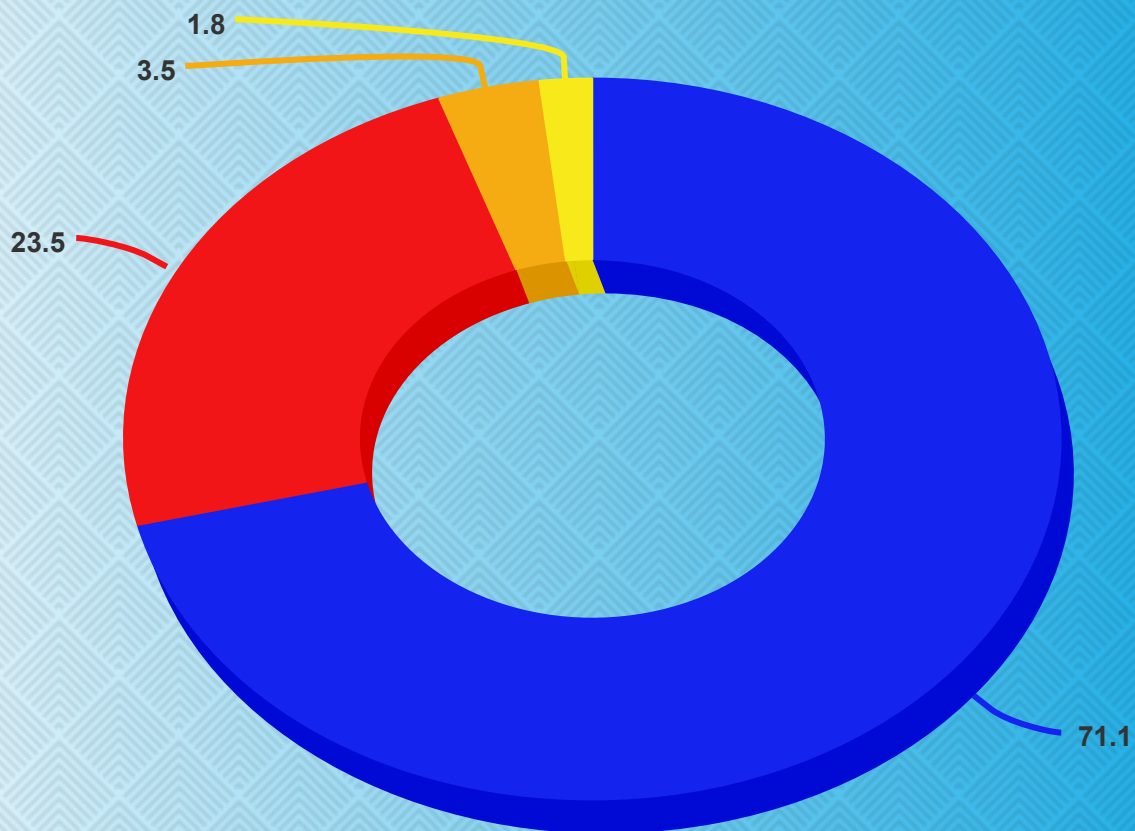






Significant growth in total aggregate income of the population is mainly due to significant changes in income from employment (incomes of employees and from self-employment), which account for 71.1 % of total income and 23.5 % are income from transfers..

## Structure of total income of the population, %

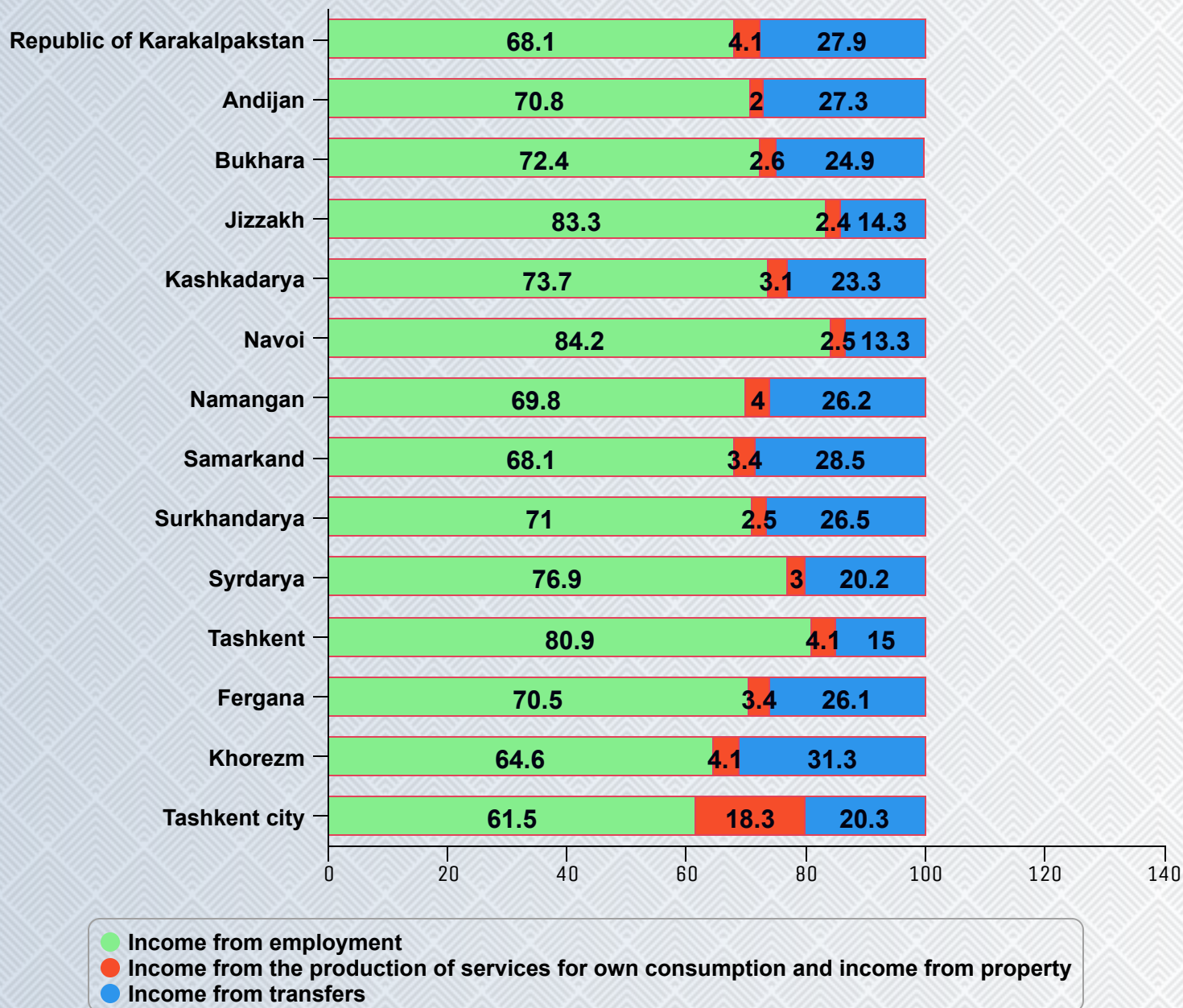


- Income from employment

In the total income of the regions, the largest share of income received from labor activity (income of employees and income from self-employment) was observed in the Navoi region (84.2 %). On the contrary, in the Tashkent city, Khorezm, Samarkand, Namangan, Fergana, Andijan regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan it is fixed below the national average.

Also in the Khorezm region, the share of income from transfers amounted to more than 30 % of the total income of the population.

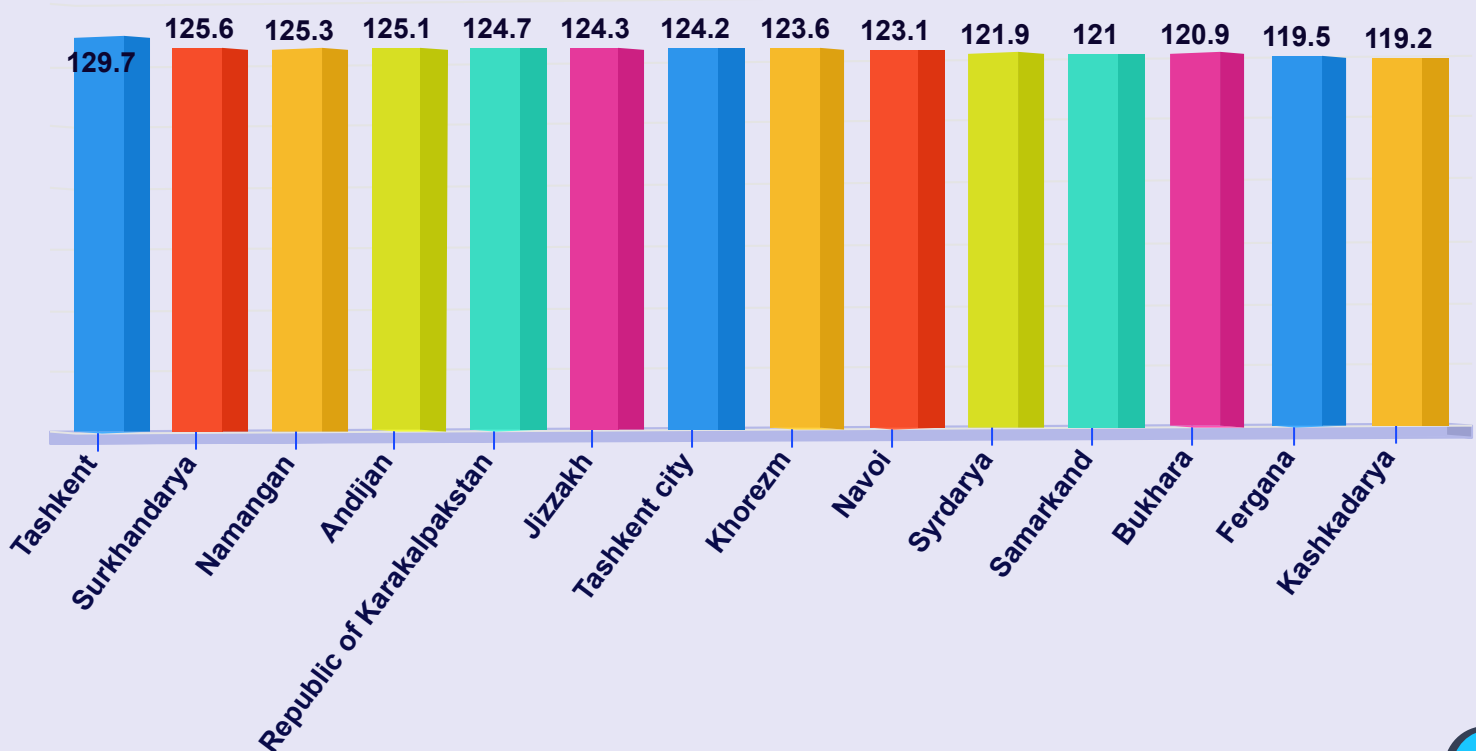

The growth rate of income of employees in the regions in January-December 2018 (% compared to the corresponding period last year)



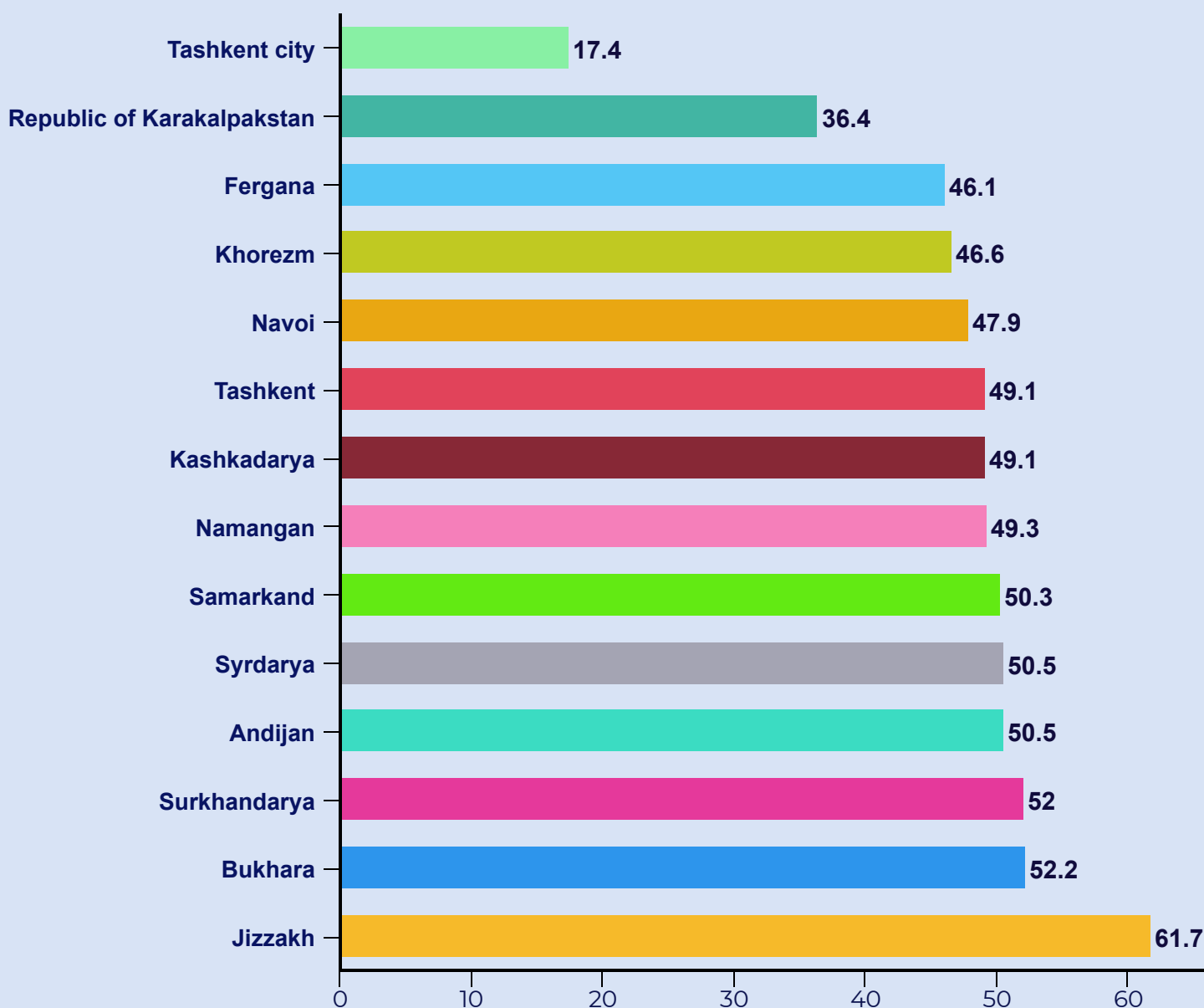
# Self-employment income

The next main source of income from employment is income from self-employment of the population.

In January-December 2018, the nominal growth rate of income of the population from self-employment amounted to 126.0 %. In the total volume of total income of the population, this source of income is significant and its share is 44.8 %.

The share of income from self-employment in total income in the regions varies and varies from 17.4 % (in the Tashkent city) to 61.7 % (in the Jizzakh region). Over 50 % of the share of income from self-employment was recorded in Bukhara (52.2 %), Surkhandarya (52.0 %), Andijan, Syrdarya (50.5 %) and Samarkand (50.3 %) regions.

**The share of income from self-employment in the total volume of aggregate income of the population by region, %**

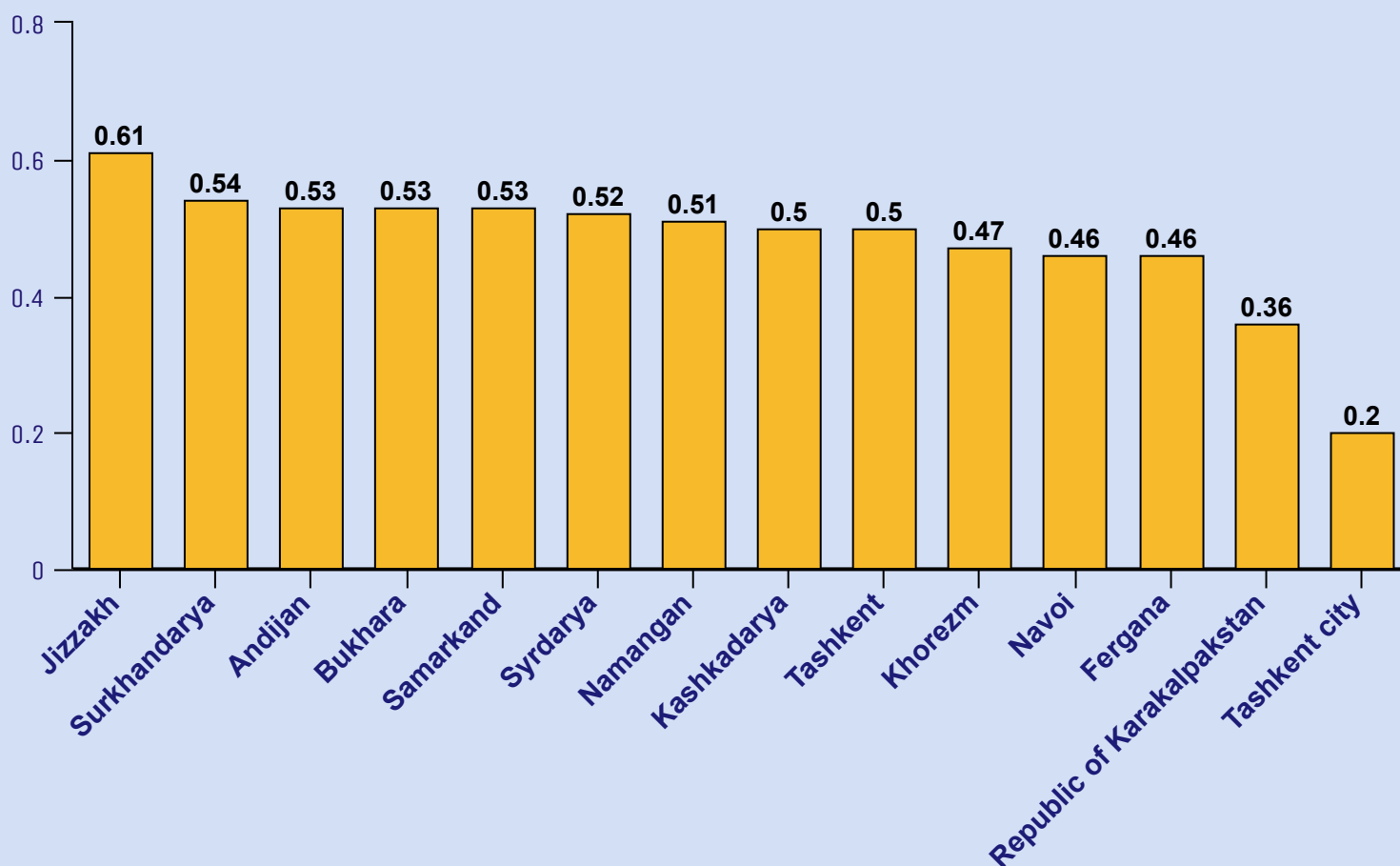


# Self-employment income

Revenues from self-employment in terms of their share also have a significant impact on the total income of the population. So, with an increase in income from self-employment by 1 %, the total volume of total income increases by 0.46 %. Meanwhile, the share of income from self-employment in the structure of aggregate income of the population and high growth rates have a large impact on the growth of gross income.

In Jizzakh region, the share of income derived from self-employment in the total volume of total income of the population was 61.7 %, and the nominal growth rate reached 133.2 % compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. Only the same incomes led to an increase in total income in the Jizzakh region by 20.3 %.

Similarly, in the Surkhandarya region, a 52.0 % share and 129.1 % growth rate accounted for 15.7 % growth rate of the total income of the population.

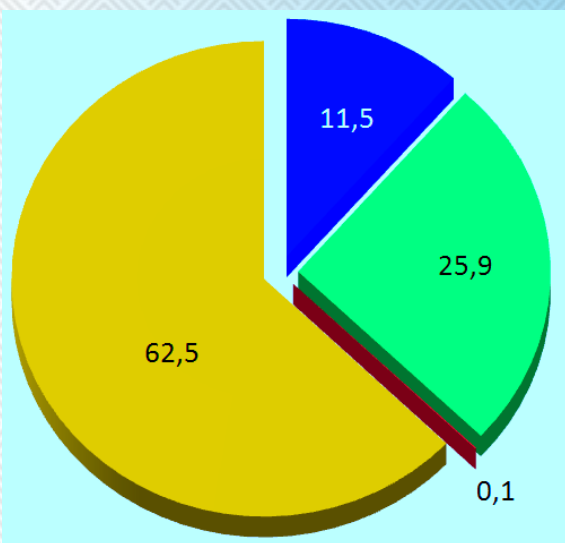

# Transfer incomes



According to preliminary data in January-December 2018 nominal growth rate of transfer income was 146.2%, to the corresponding period of the previous year.

In addition, a share of transfers in total volume of comprehensive income of population increased by 2.6 percentage points during the same period and amounted to 23.5%.

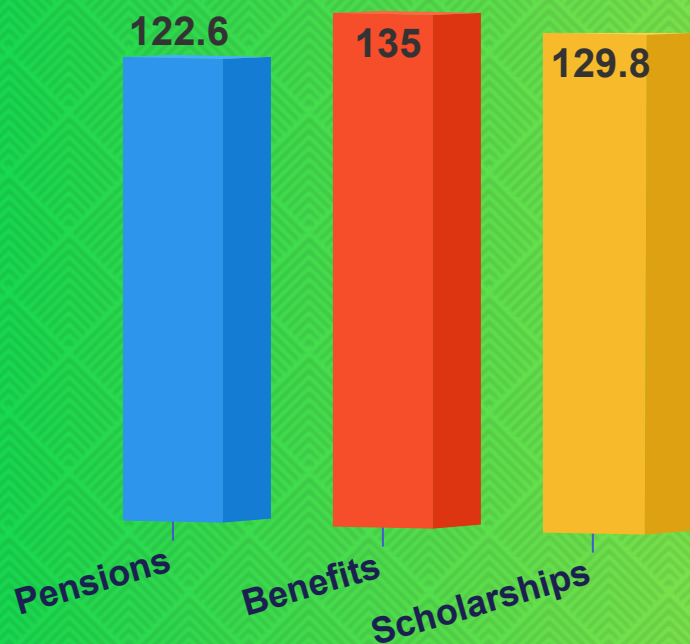

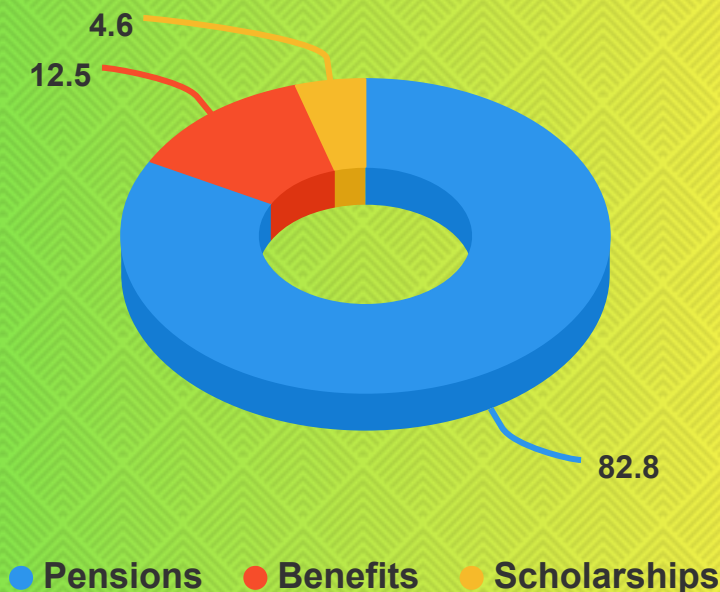

# Social transfers

Changes over the past period of pensions, benefits and scholarships contributed to the growth of total volume of population comprehensive income by 2.3%.

Pensions, which amounted to 82.8% of total volume is mainly impact on growth of social transfers.



In January-December of this year, 3.3 trillion soums of benefits and social assistance were allocated for social support of population.

Of this amount, 52.3% of social benefits were financed by off-budgetary pension fund means, and 47.7% were allocated from a general and local budget means.

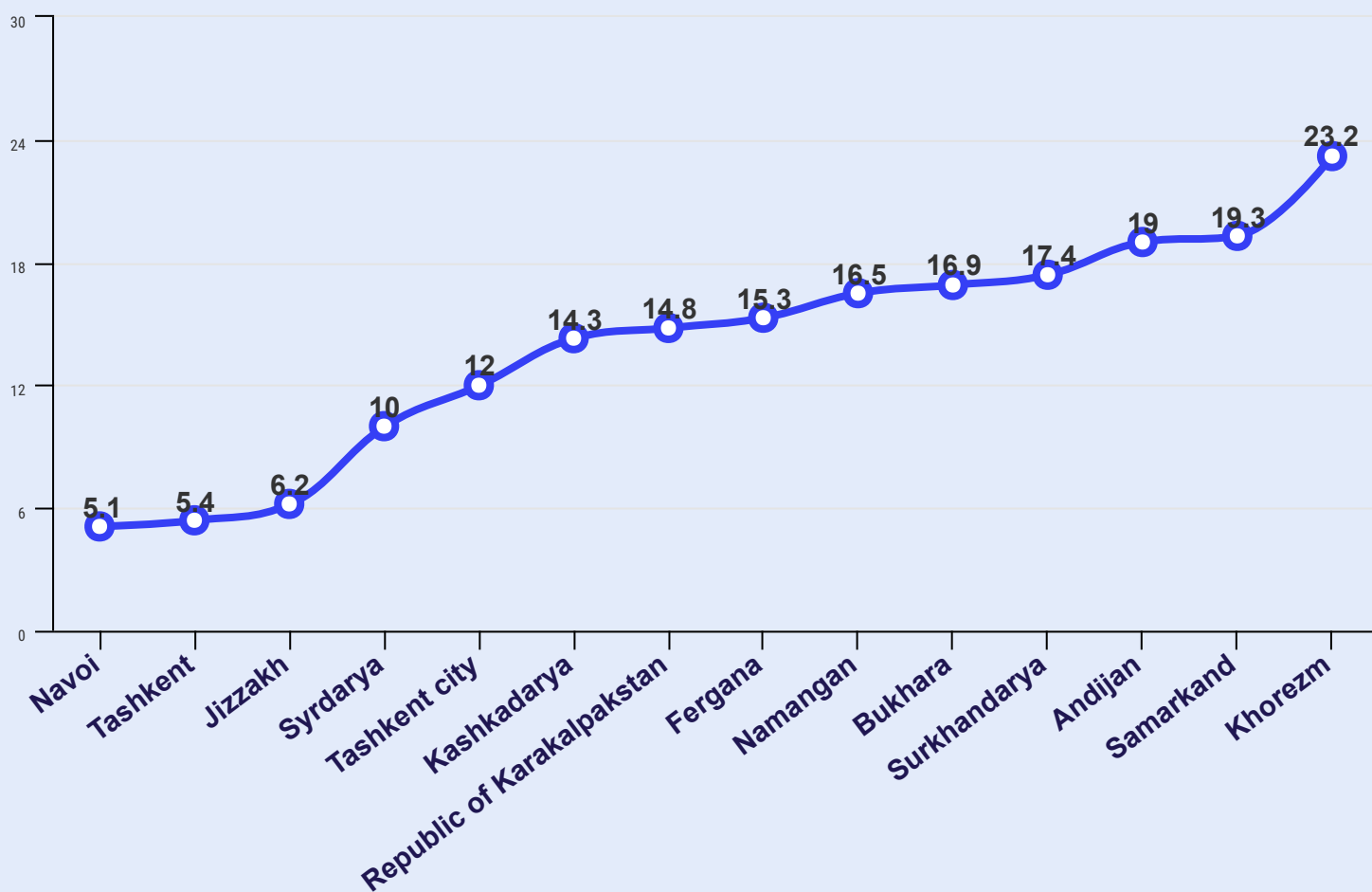


## Other current transfers

The nominal growth rate of remittances from abroad, which are part of other current transfers in January-December 2018, amounted to 164.6%, and their share, as compared with the same period of last year, in comprehensive income of population increased by 3.0 % Such a significant change in income provided an increase by 7.3% in nominal value of comprehensive income of population.



**The share of remittances from abroad in total volume of comprehensive income by regions, %**





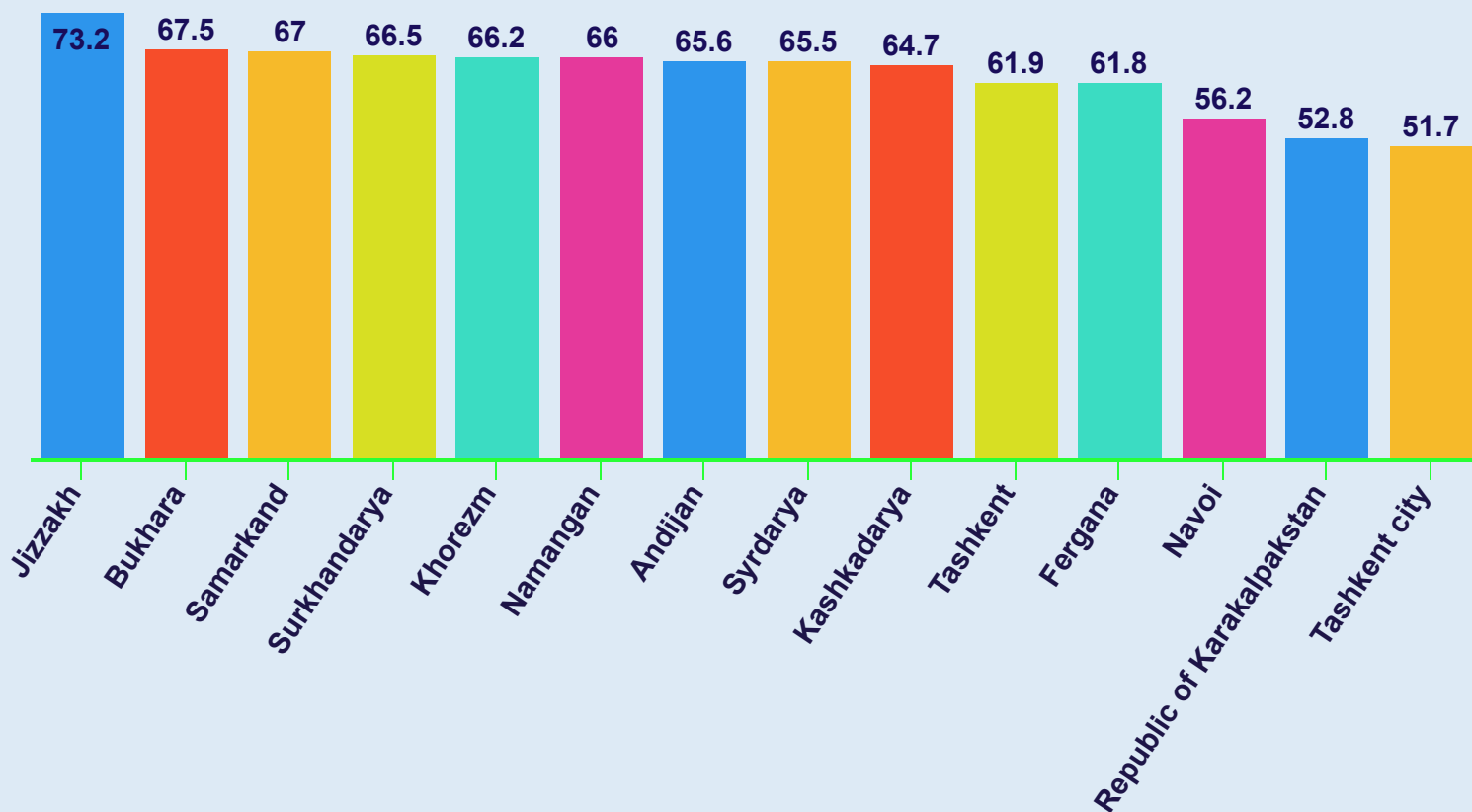
# Entrepreneurial income



According to preliminary data in January-December 2018, of the comprehensive income of population, a share of entrepreneurial income was 62.6%.

A share of entrepreneurial income in comprehensive income of population varies by regions: the highest amount accounted for Jizzakh region - 73.2%, the lowest on Tashkent city - 51.7%.
