

GROSS REGIONAL PRODUCT



In accordance with the State Statistical Works Program, the State Committee on Statistics has carried out a preliminary assessment of the gross regional product (hereinafter referred to as GRP) of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regions and Tashkent city for January – June 2019.

GRP – is the main indicator of the national accounts system, which characterizes the final result of the production activities of the institutional units - residents located in the economic territory of the region, for a certain period of time. GRP is calculated using the production method as the sum of gross value added by economic activity in basic prices and net taxes on products.

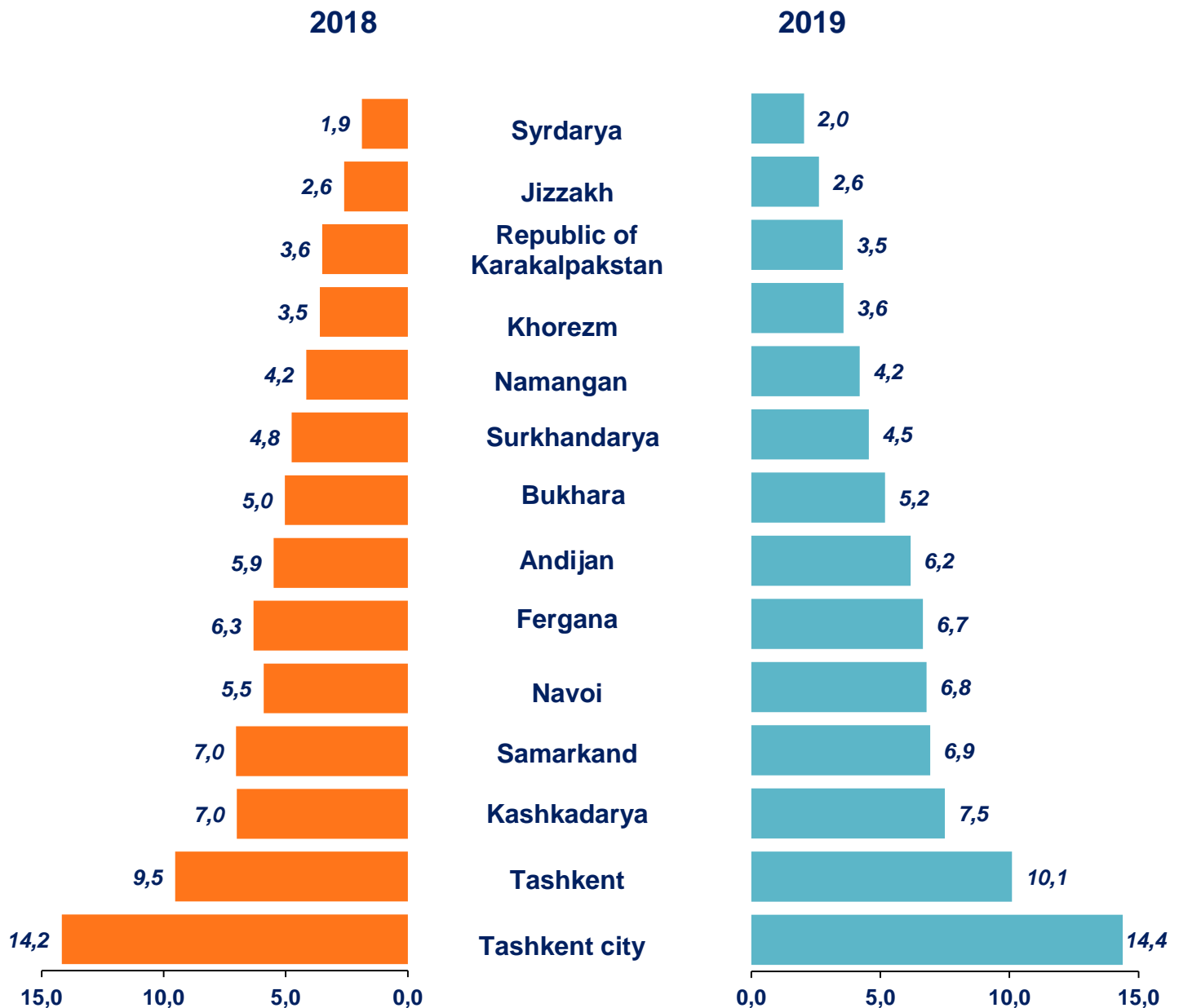
According to the results of January-June 2019, outpacing rates of growth of GRP were recorded in Tashkent city (107.2%), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (107.2%), Tashkent (107.1%), Khorezm (106.5%) and Andijan (106.2%) regions. Low growth rates of GRP, as compared with the republican level (105.8%), were observed in Navoi (103.3%), Surkhandarya (103.5%) and Kashkadarya (103.5%) regions.

The largest contribution to the formation of the republic's GDP was made by Tashkent city with a specific weight of 14.4%. Tashkent and Kashkadarya regions occupy the following places with indicators of 10.1% and 7.5%,

respectively. The smallest share of GRP in the formation of the republic's GDP was recorded in Syrdarya (2.0%), Jizzakh (2.6%), Khorezm (3.6%) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.5%).

Participation of regions in the formation of GDP

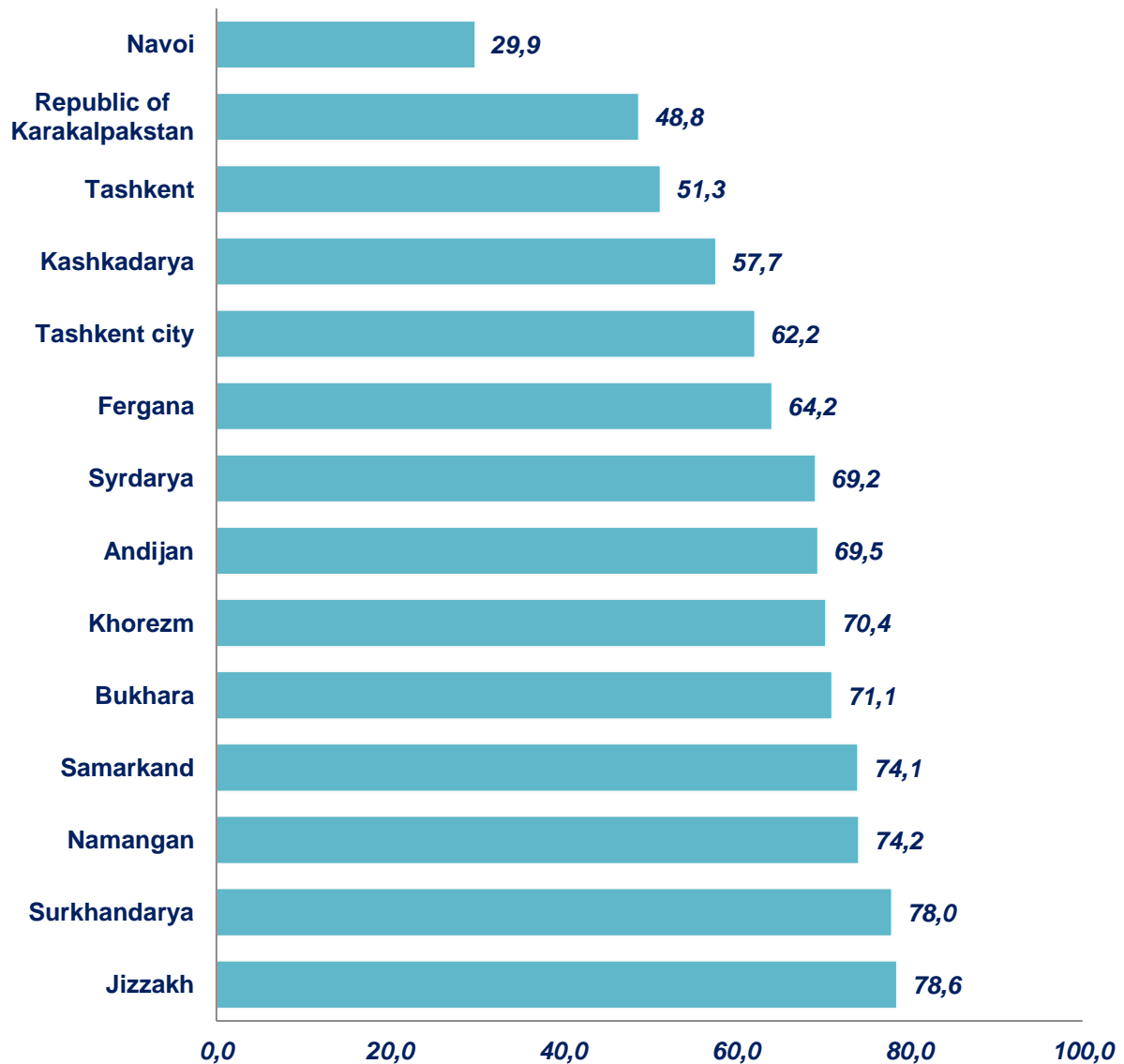
January - June (% of GDP)



In January-June 2019, the share of small business (business) in the republic's GDP was 54.0%. In the regions, the largest share of small business (business) was observed in Jizzakh (78.6% of the total gross value added created in the region), Surkhandarya (78.0%) and Namangan (74.2%) regions.

The smallest share of small business (business) was recorded in the Navoi region (29.9%), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (48.8%) and the Tashkent region (51.3%).

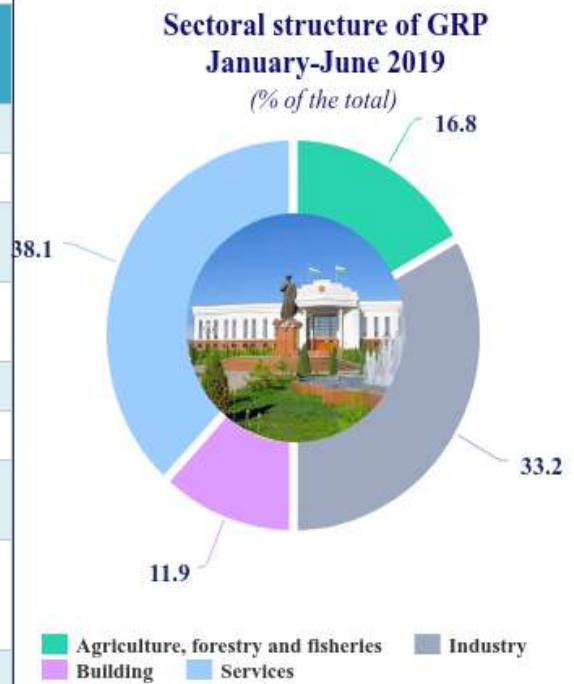
The share of small business (business) in the GRP

According to preliminary data, the GRP of **the Republic of Karakalpakstan** over January-June 2019 in current prices amounted to 7,861.8 billion soums and grew, in real terms, by 7.2% compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the main sectors of the regional economy, such as agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 105.4% (share in the structure of GRP - 16.8%), industry - 100.5%

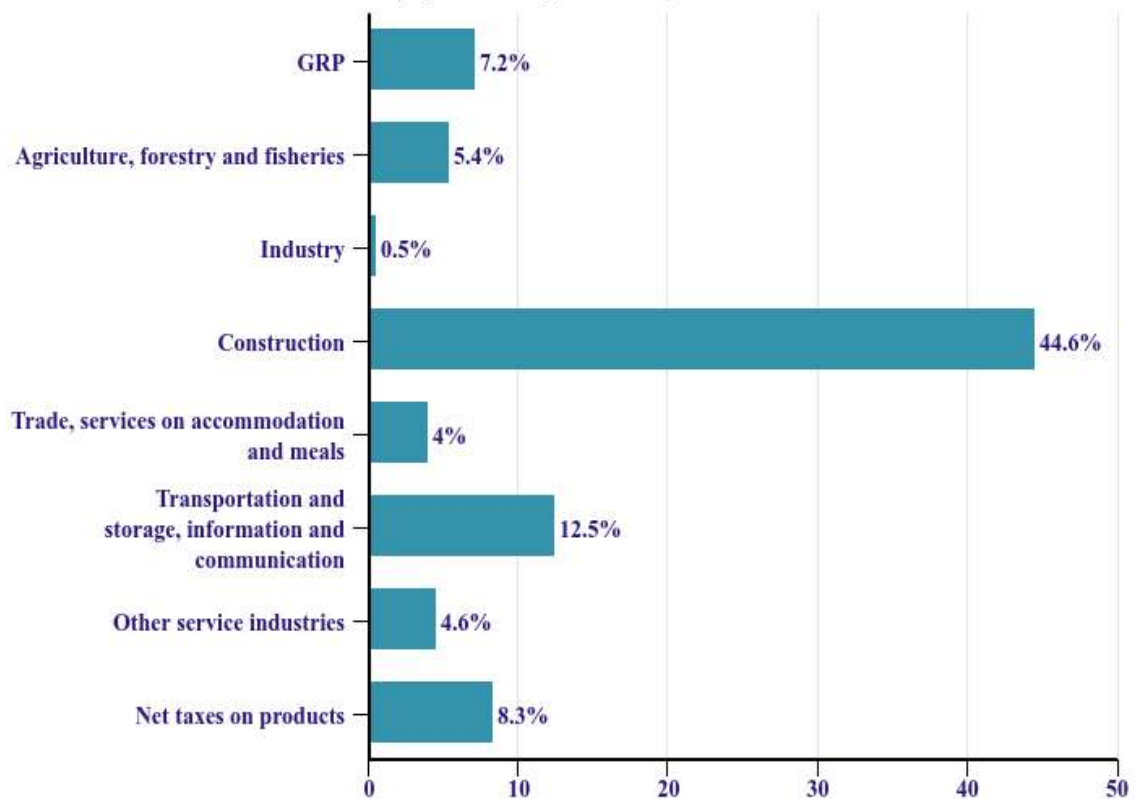
(33.2%) construction - 144.6% (11.9%), services - 106.1% (38.1%). GRP per capita amounted to 4191 thousand soums and grew by 5.6%.

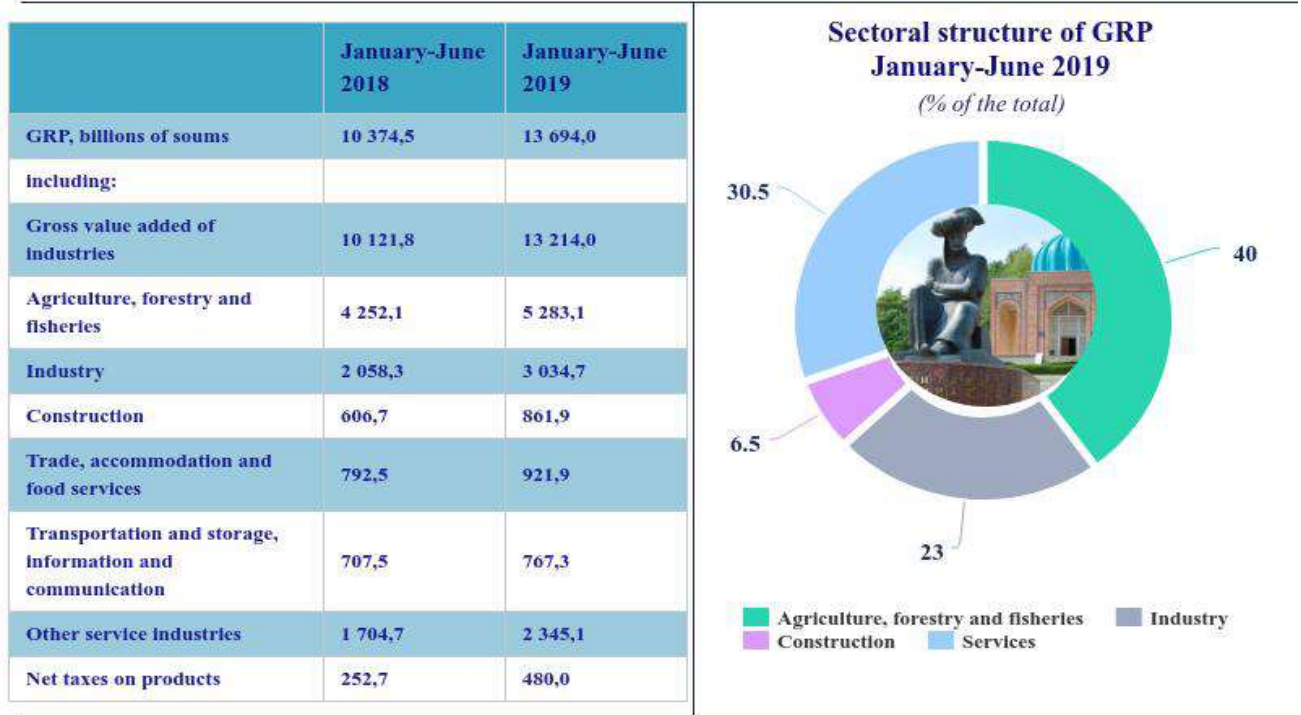


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019

(% from January-June 2018)

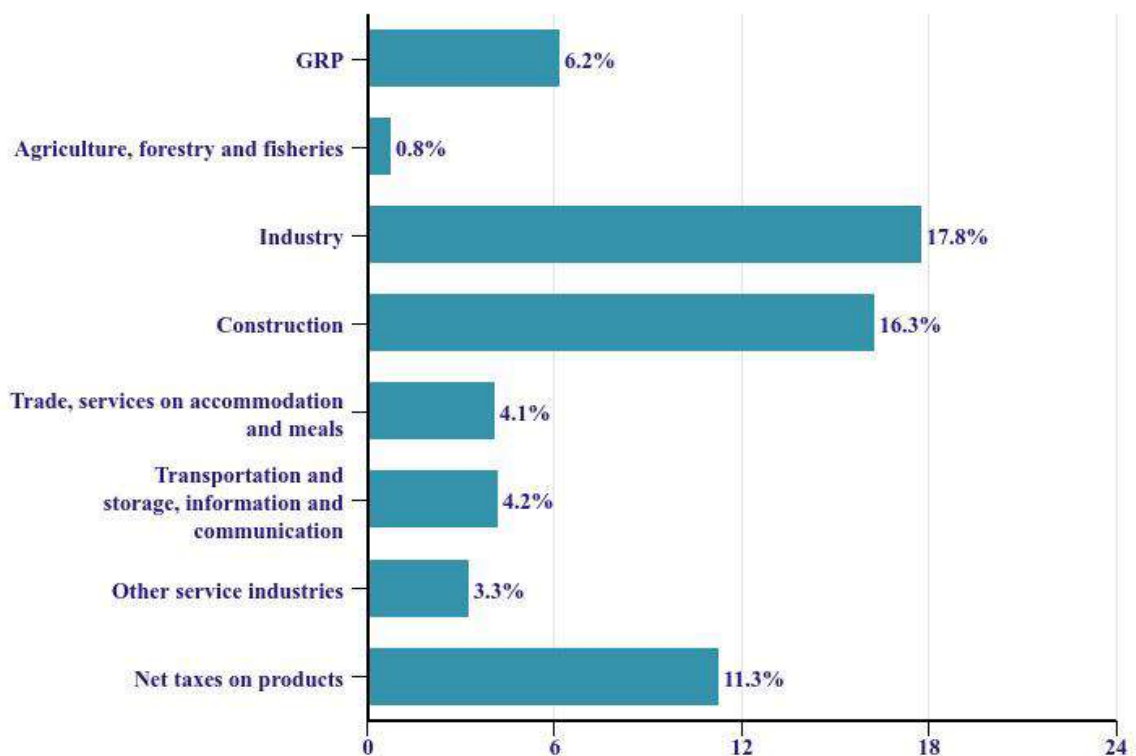


In **Andijan region**, the GRP volume grew by 6.2% and amounted to 13,694.0 billion soums. Economic growth is due to positive growth rates in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 100.8% (share in the GRP structure - 40.0%), industry - 117.8% (23.0%), construction - 116.3% (6.5%), services - 103.7% (30.5%). GRP per capita amounted to 4 449 thousand soums and grew by 4.3%.

(% from January-June 2018)

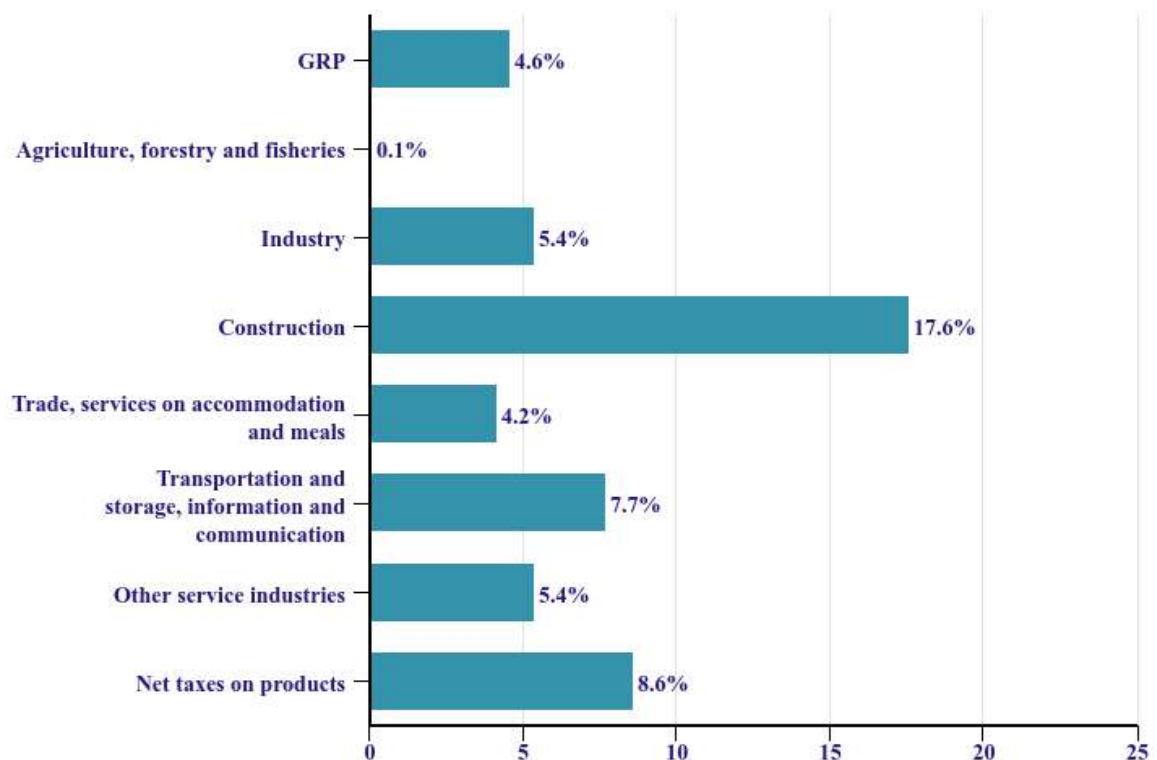


The increase in the GRP of **Bukhara region** was 4.6% and reached 11,513.6 billion soums. In the sectoral structure of GRP, growth rates were as follows: in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 100.1% (share in the structure of GRP - 38.9%), industry - 105.4% (20.9%), construction - 117.6 % (9.9%), services - 105.6% (30.3%). The volume of GRP per capita increased by 2.9% and amounted to 6,058 thousand soums.



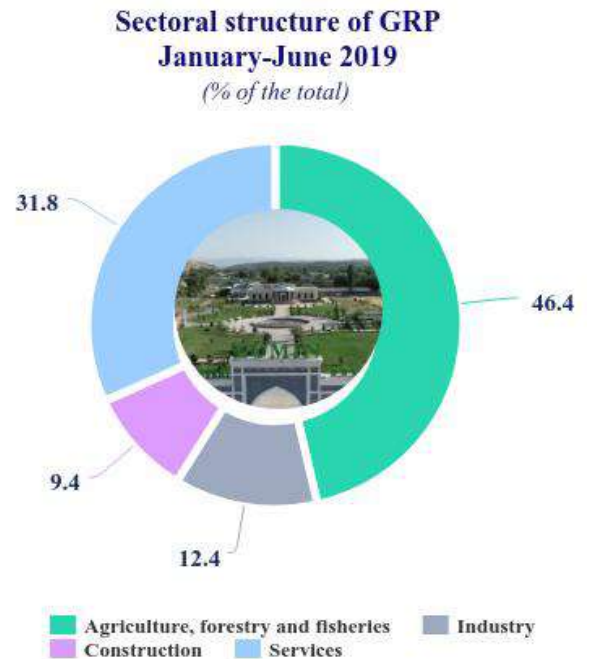
GRP growth rates for January-June 2019

(% from January-June 2018)

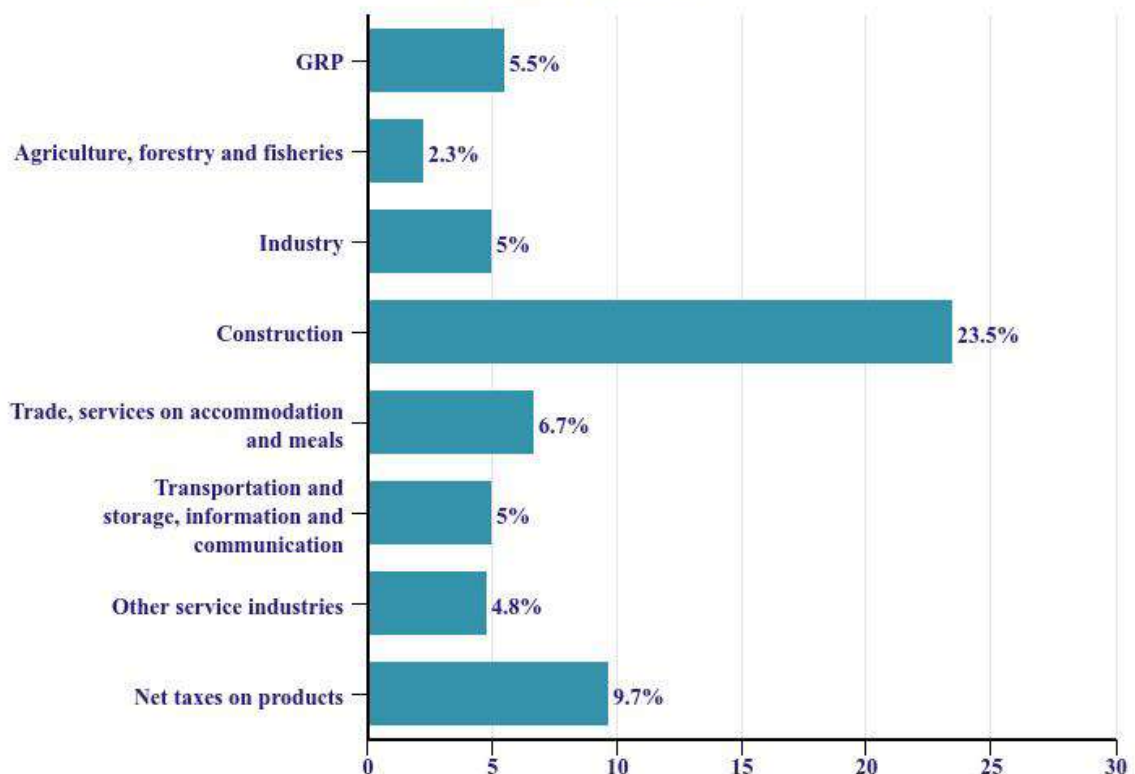


The GRP of **Jizzakh region** reached 5,824.9 billion soums with an increase of 5.5%. The growth rates of agriculture, forestry and fisheries amounted to 102.3% (the share in the GRP structure is 46.4%), industry 105.0% (12.4%) of construction 123.5% (9.4%), services - 105.3% (31.8%). The volume of GRP per capita was 4,287 thousand soums and grew by 3.3%.

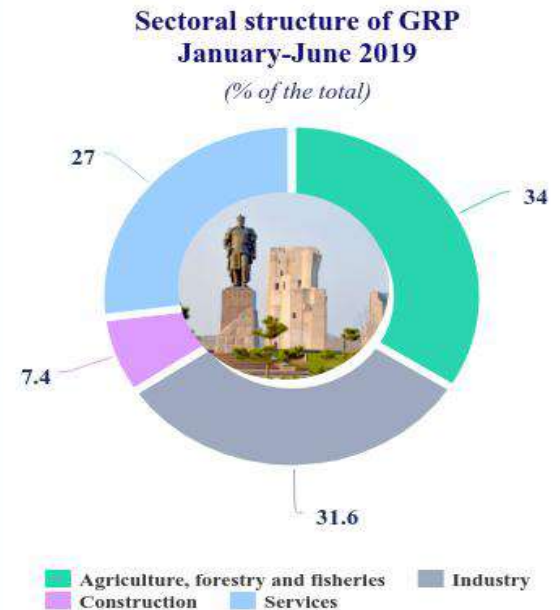


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019
(% from January-June 2018)

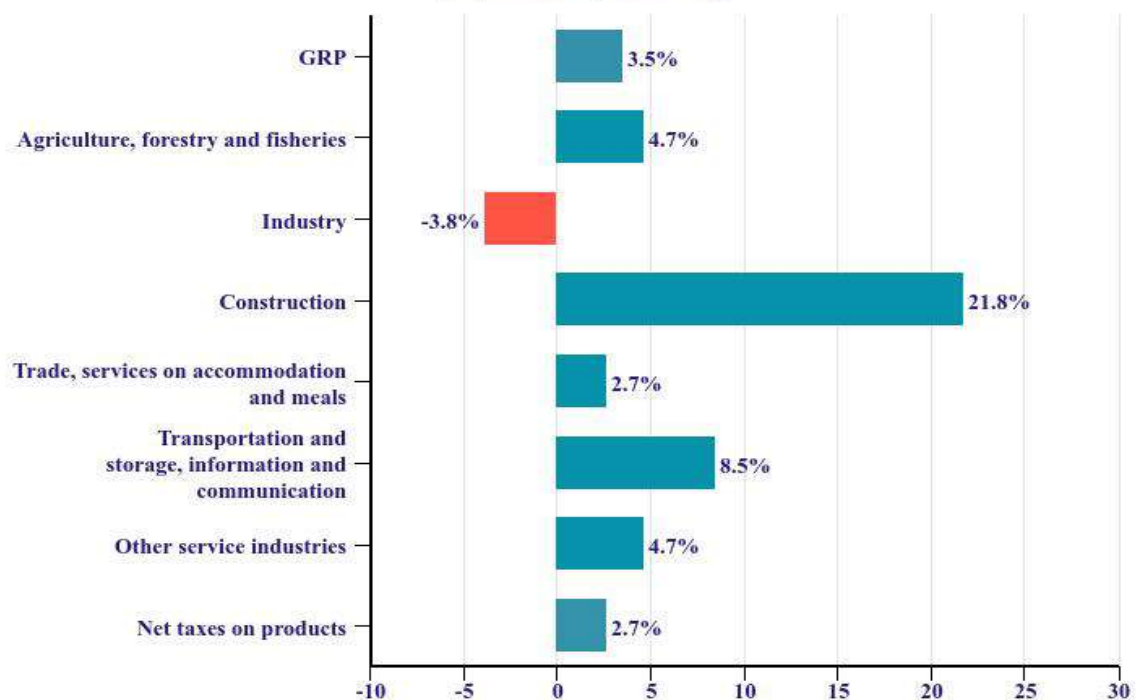


The GRP volume of **Kashkadarya region** amounted to 16,639.0 billion soums and increased, in real terms, by 3.5% compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. In the following main sectors, positive growth rates were noted: in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 104.7% (share in the GRP structure - 34.0%), construction - 121.8% (7.4%), service sector - 105.0% (27.0%). In industry, a decrease in comparable prices, which amounted to 96.2% of the level of January-June of the previous year (the share of this industry in the structure of the GRP is 31.6%). GRP per capita grew by 1.4% and reached 5 157 thousand soums.

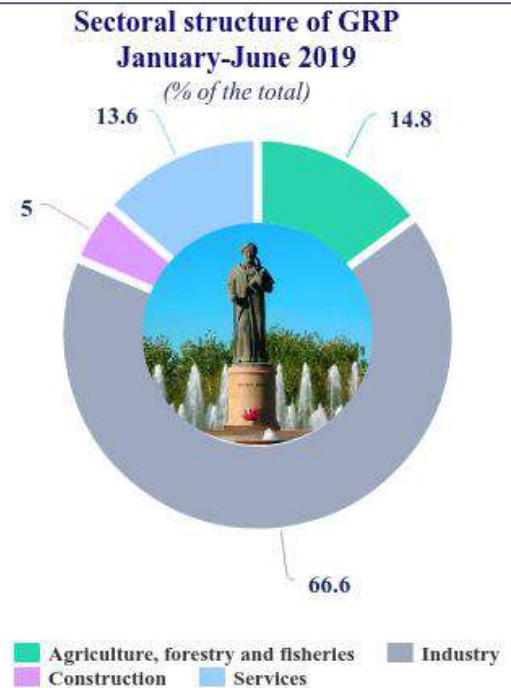


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019
(% from January-June 2018)



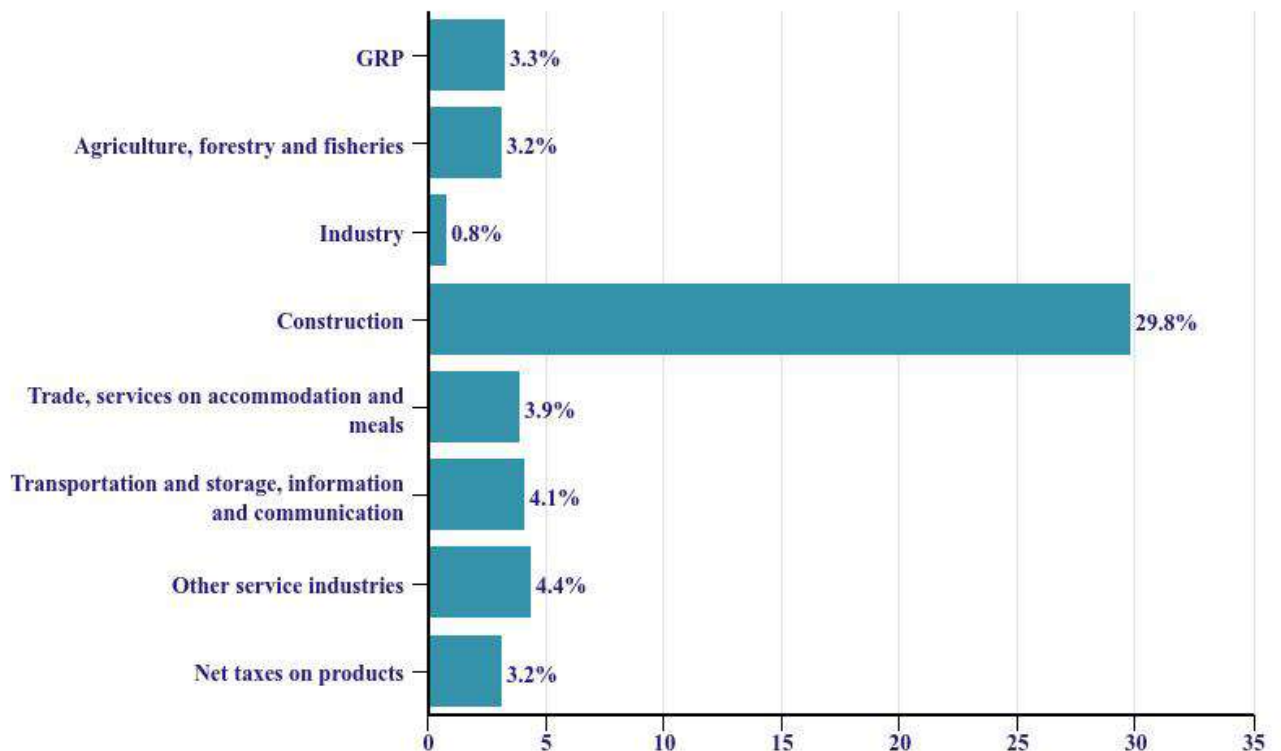
The GRP of **Navoi region** reached 15 069.0 billion soums and the increase was 3.3%. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the main sectors of the regional economy. In the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors, growth rates reached 103.2% (share in the GRP structure - 14.8%), industry - 100.8% (66.6%), construction - 129.8% (5.0 %), services - 104.2% (13.6%). GRP per capita increased by 1.5% and amounted to 15 330 thousand soums.

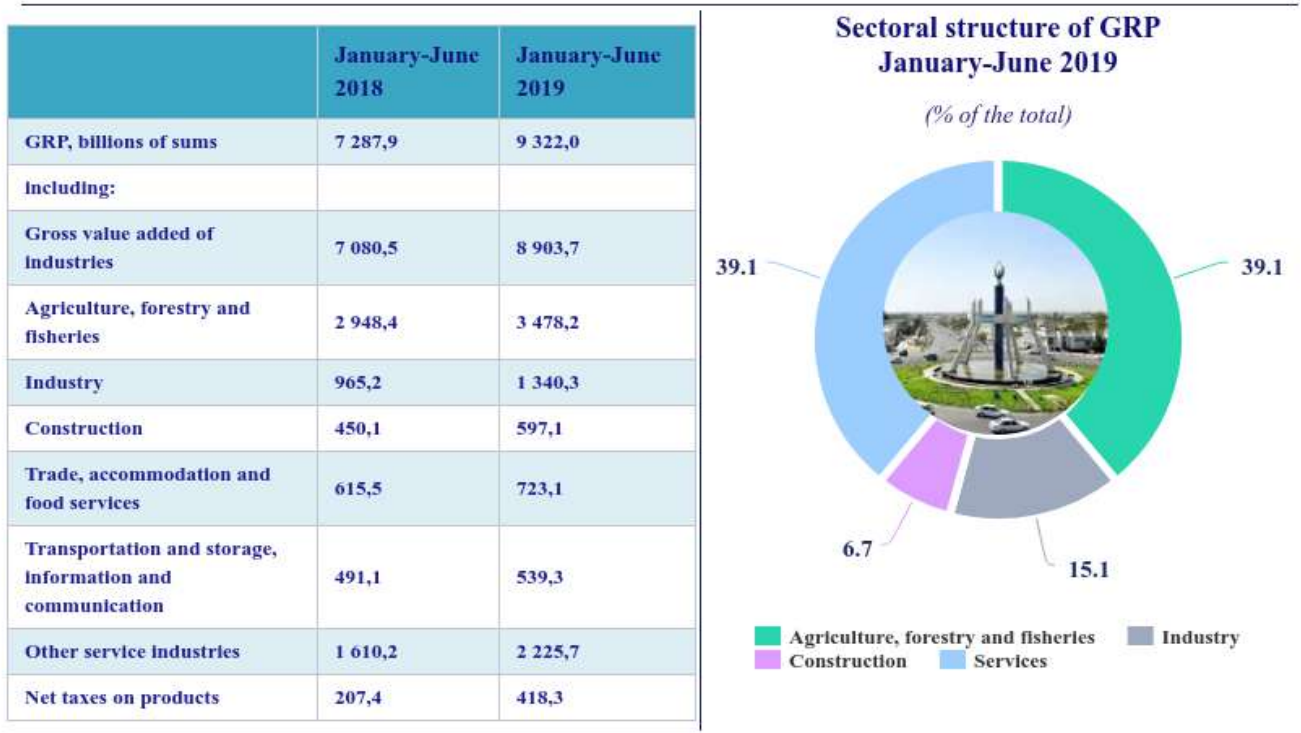


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019

(% to January-June 2018)

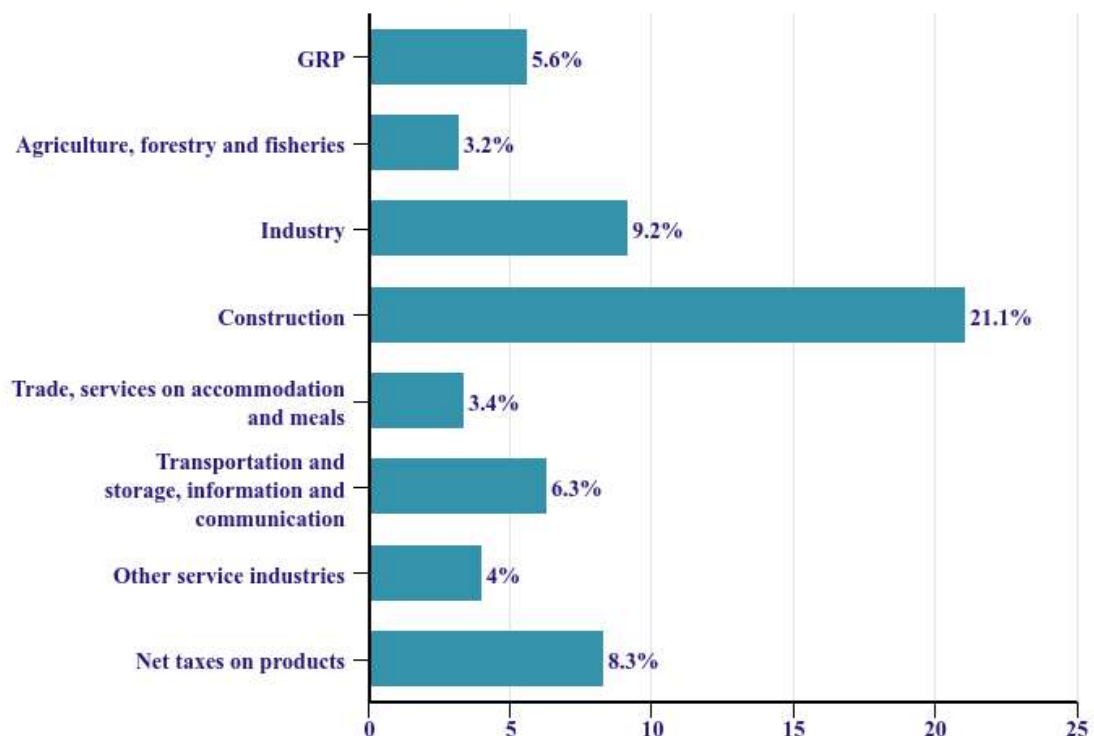


The GRP of **Namangan region** was 9 322.0 billion soums, which is 5.6% higher than the data for January-June 2018. GRP growth rates are due to positive growth rates in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 103.2% (share in the GRP structure - 39.1%), industry - 109.2% (15.1%), construction - 121.1 % (6.7%) and services - 104.3% (39.1%). GRP per capita increased by 3.5% and amounted to 3,372 thousand soums.

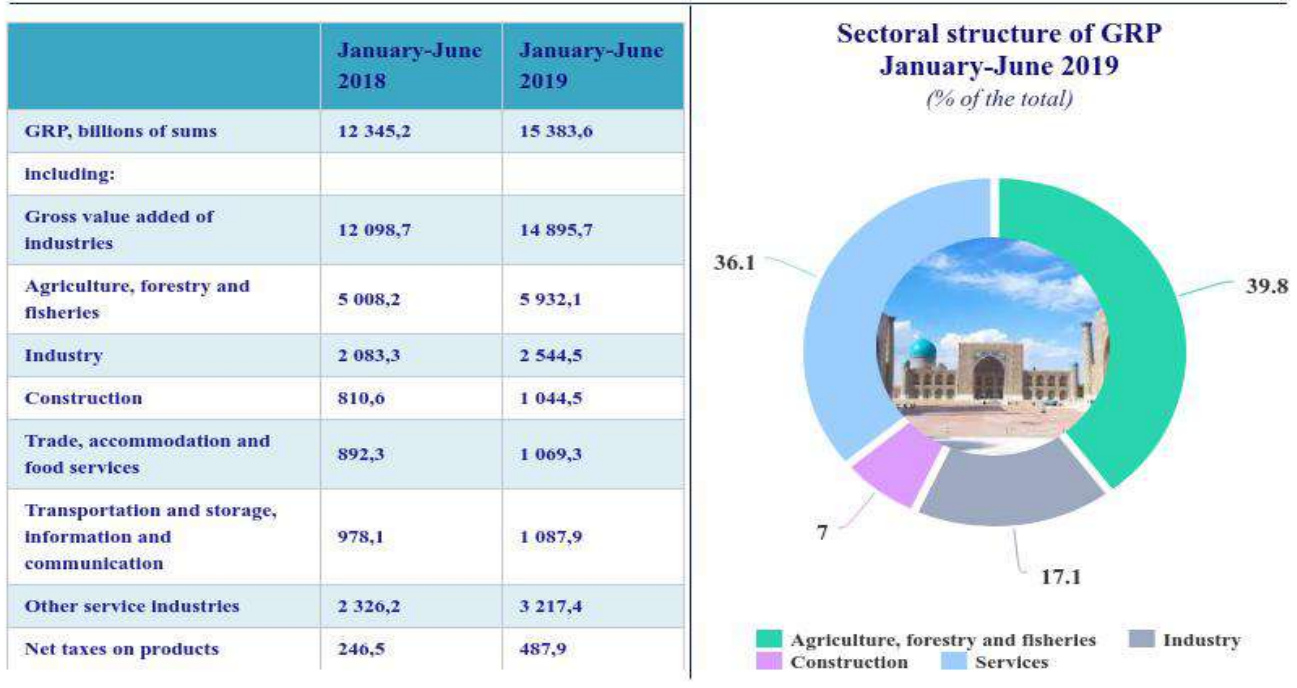


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019

(% from January-June 2018)

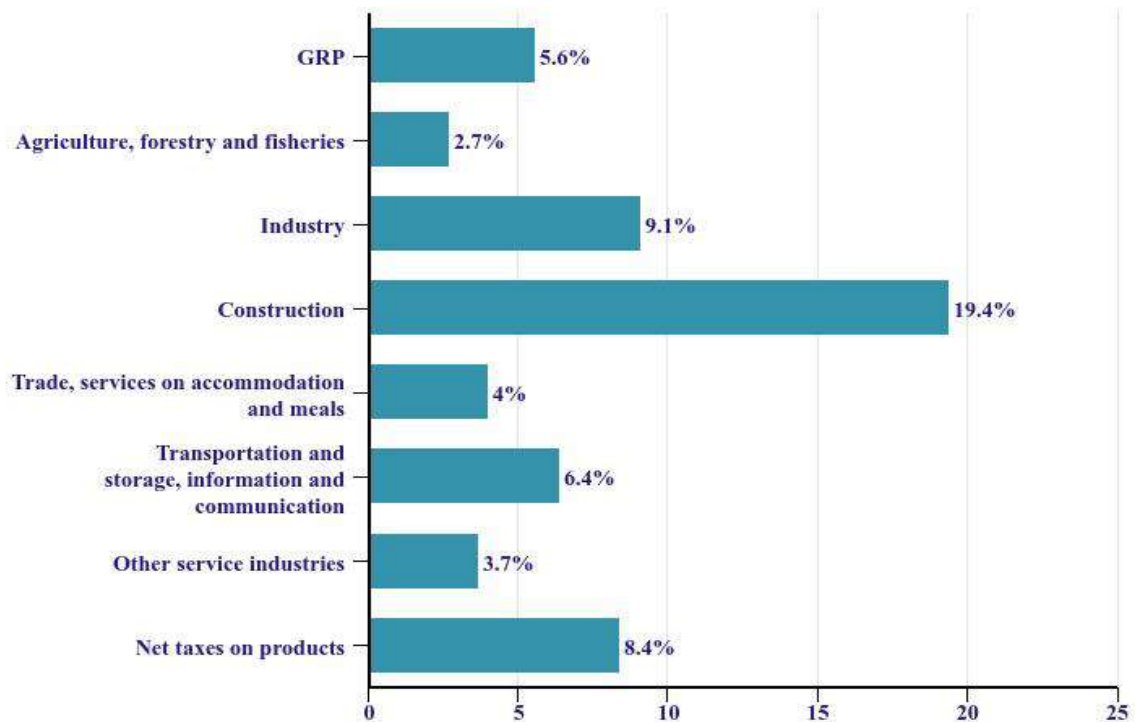


The GRP volume of **Samarkand region** amounted to 15 383.6 billion soums and the increase reached 5.6%. In this region, positive growth rates were noted in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 102.7% (share in the GRP structure - 39.8%), industry - 109.1% (17.1%), construction - 119.4% % (7.0%), services - 104.4% (36.1%). GRP per capita grew by 3.4% and amounted to 4,031 thousand soums.



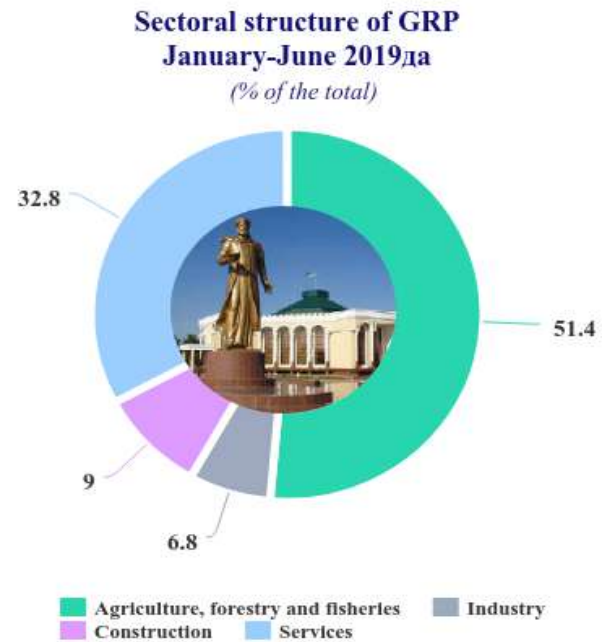
GRP growth rates for January-June 2019

(% from January-June 2018)

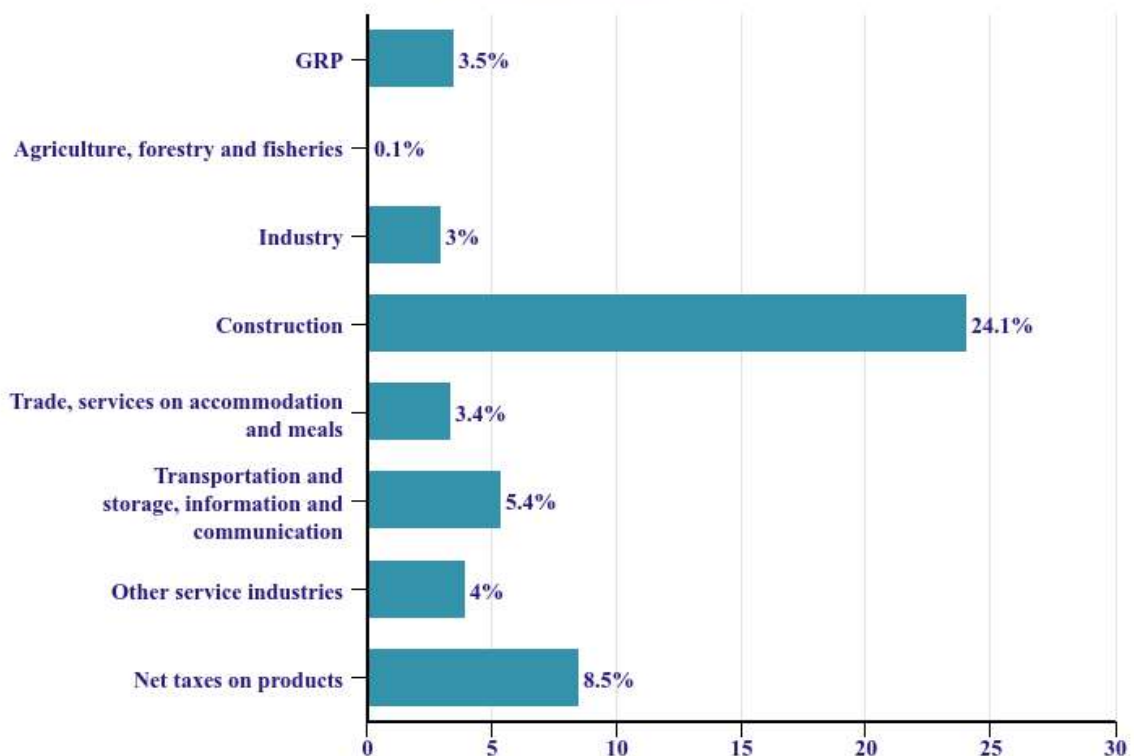


In **Surkhandarya region**, the GRP grew by 3.5% and amounted to 10101.3 billion soums. Growth factors in the GRP were growth rates in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 100.1% (share in the GRP structure - 51.4%), industry - 103.0% (6.8%), construction - 124.1% (9.0%), services - 104.0% (32.8%). GRP per capita amounted to 3 912 thousand soums and increased by 1.2%.

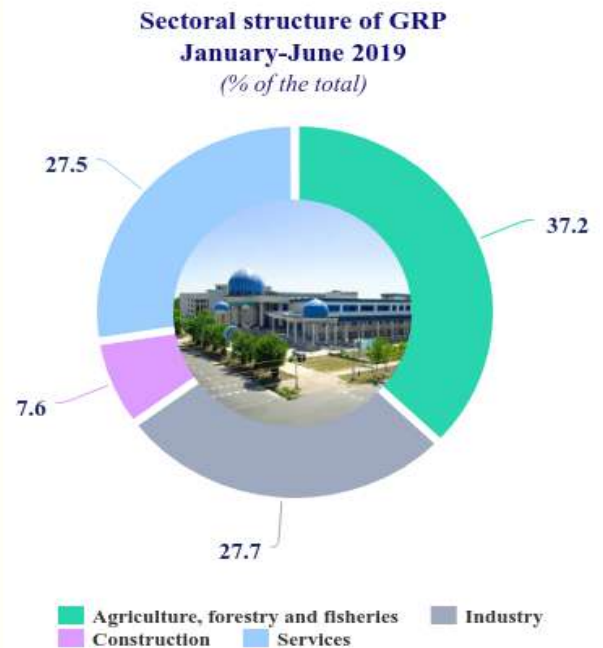


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019
(% from January-June 2018)

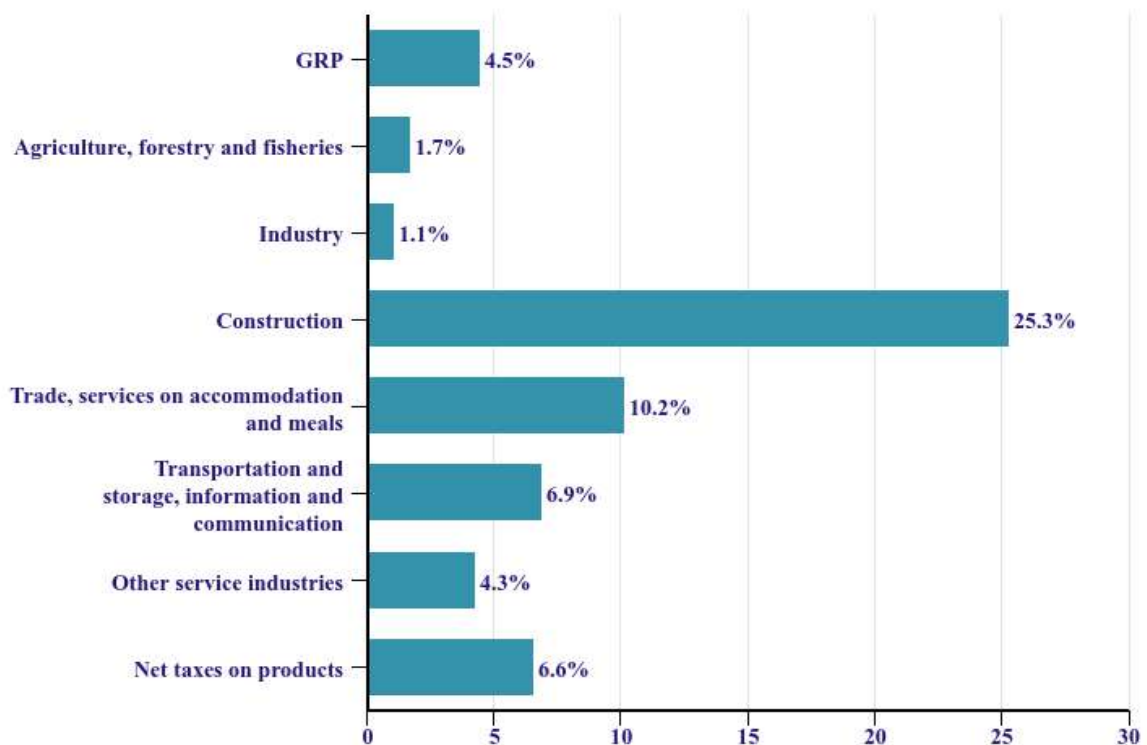


The GRP of **Syrdarya region** amounted to 4 535.9 billion soums with an increase of 4.5%. In this region, positive growth rates were noted in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 101.7% (share in the GRP structure - 37.2%), industry - 101.1% (27.7%), construction - 125.3% % (7.6%), services - 106.1% (27.5%). The volume of GRP per capita reached 5 443 thousand soums and grew by 2.6%.

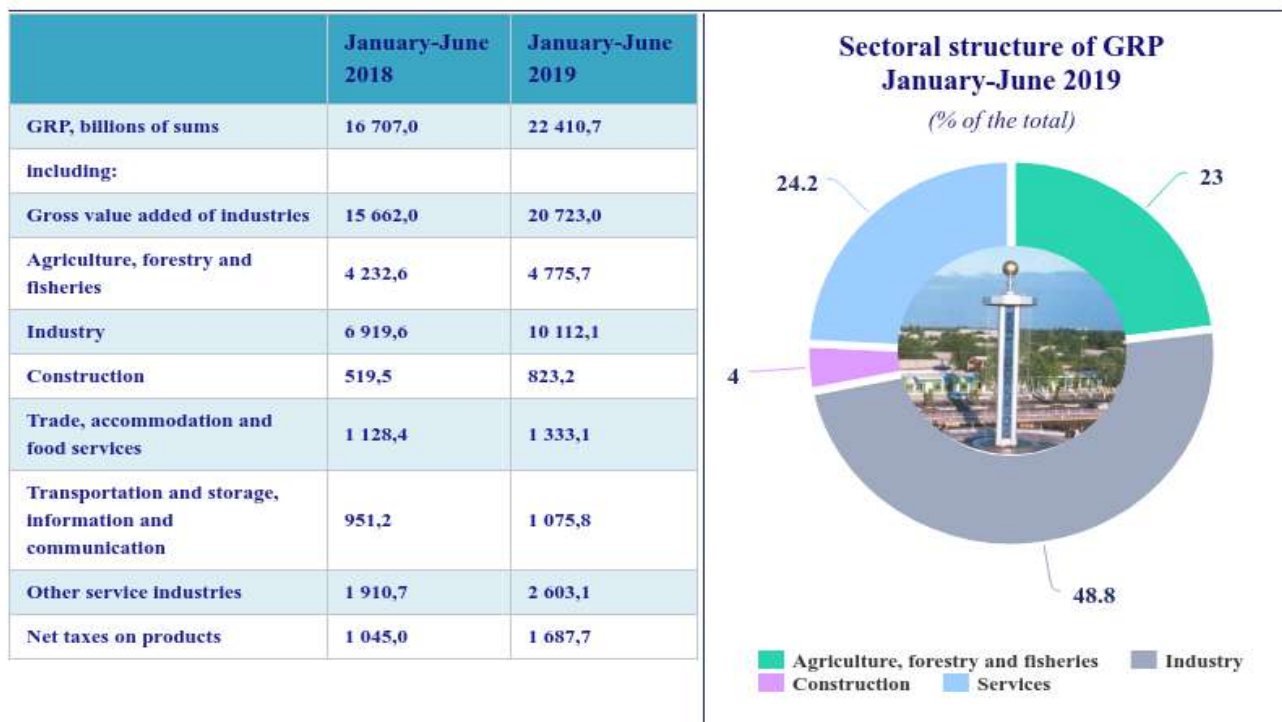

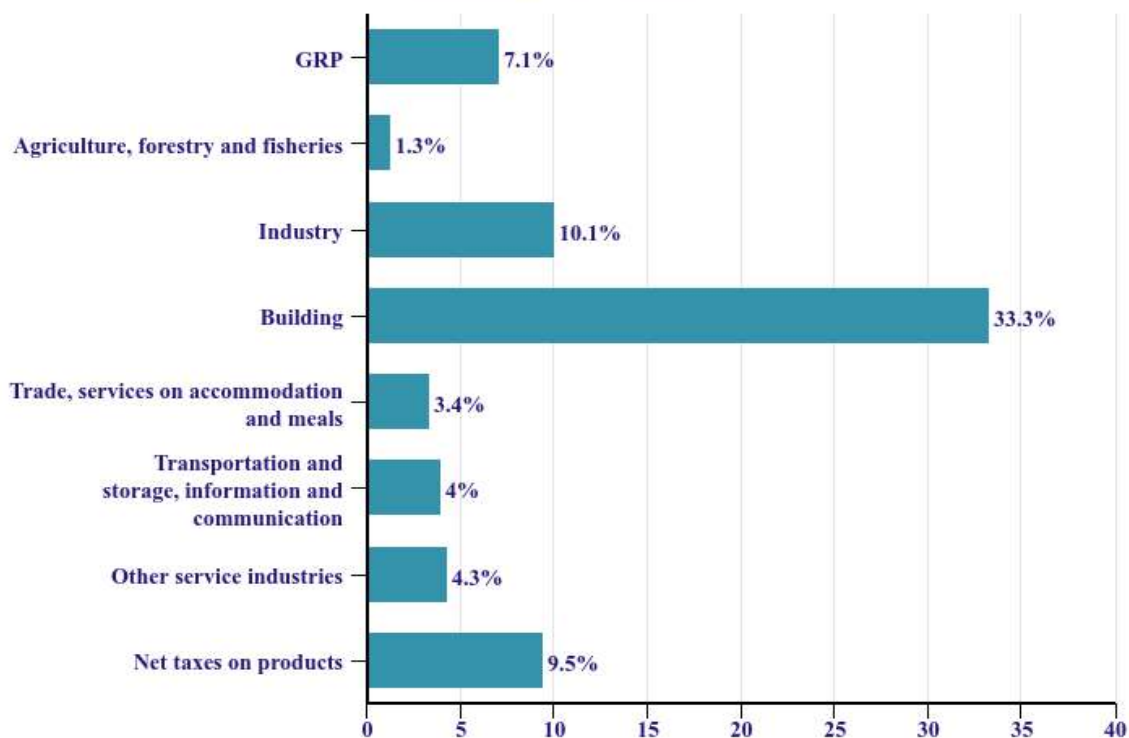
GRP growth rates for January-June 2019 (% from January-June 2018)



In **Tashkent region**, the GRP volume increased by 7.1% and amounted to 22 410.7 billion soums. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the sectors of the regional economy: in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 101.3% (share in the structure of GRP - 23.0%), industry - 110.1% (48.8%), construction - 133.3% (4.0%), services - 104.0% (24.2%). GRP per capita increased by 5.7% and amounted to 7 707 thousand soums.

(% from January-June 2018)

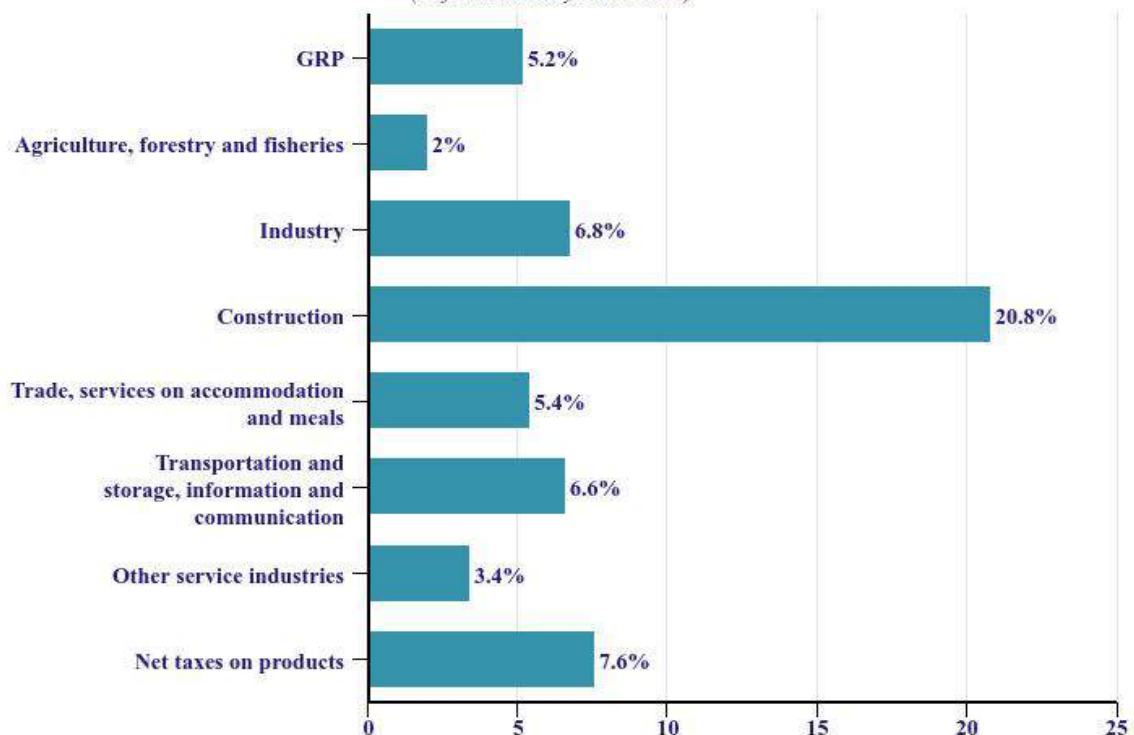


The GRP of **Fergana region** grew by 5.2% and amounted to 14 765.3 billion soums. The growth rate of the GRP is due to the positive growth rates of the regional industries. In agriculture, forestry and fisheries, growth rates reached 102.0% (share in the GRP structure — 31.5%), industry — 106.8% (26.1%), construction — 120.8% (6.5%) , the services sector - 104.5% (35.9%). GRP per capita amounted to 3 994 thousand soums and grew by 3.3%.

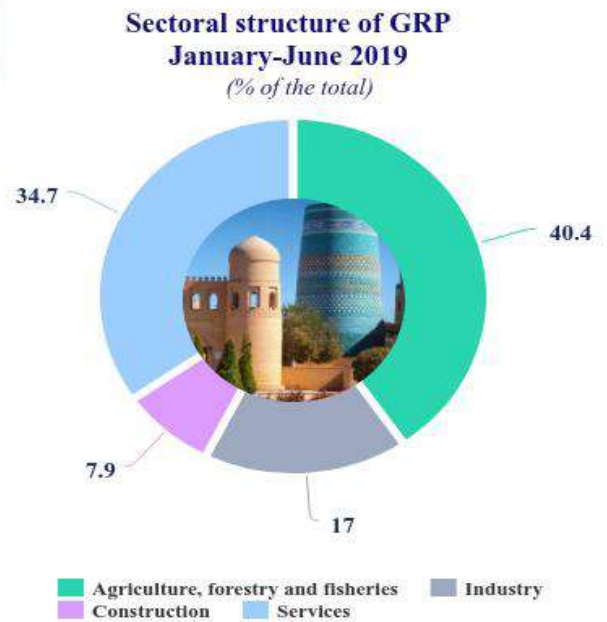


GRP growth rates for January-June 2019
(% from January-June 2018)



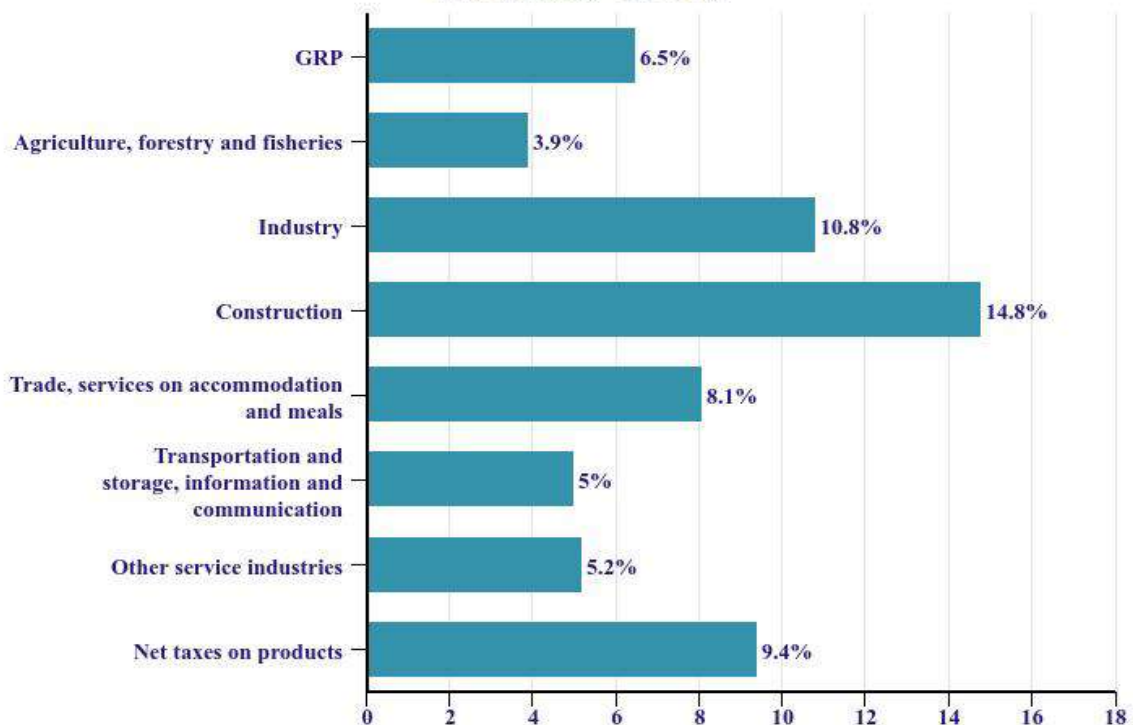
The GRP of **Khorezm region** reached 7 923.2 billion soums, which is 6.5% higher than the same period last year. The growth of GRP is due to the growth rates in the agriculture, forestry and fishery sectors - 103.9% (the share in the GRP structure is 40.4%), industry - 110.8% (17.0%), construction - 114.8% (7.9%), services - 105.7% (34.7%). GRP per capita increased by 4.7% and amounted to 4 304 thousand soums

The GRP of **Tashkent city** grew by 7.2% and amounted to 31 935.3 billion soums. The main growth factors for GRP were 103.1% (share in the GRP structure - 33.4%), construction - 129.7% (12.0%), services - 105.6% (54.6%). GRP per capita increased by 5.1% and reached 12 652 thousand soums.
