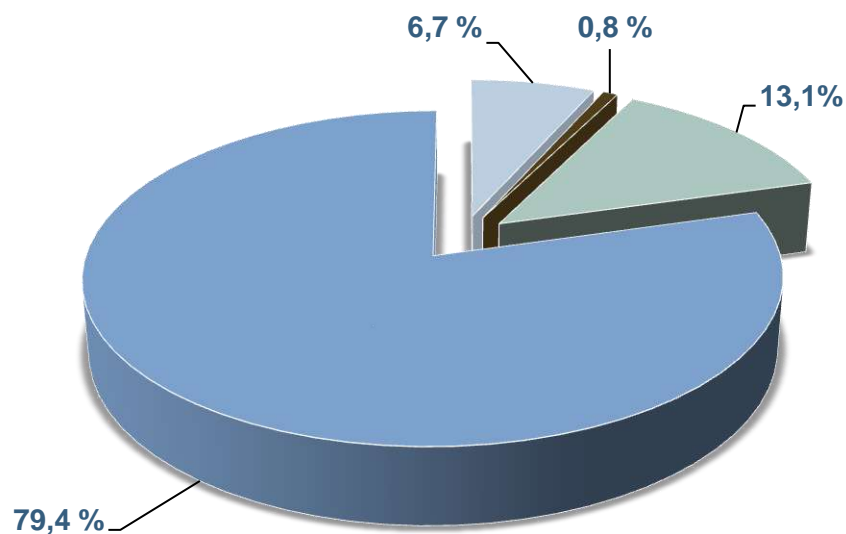


Industrial production of the Republic of Uzbekistan for January-June 2019

According to preliminary data, in January-June 2019, enterprises of the republic produced industrial products for 147.8 trillion. Sum, the industrial production index for the same period last year amounted to 106.9%.

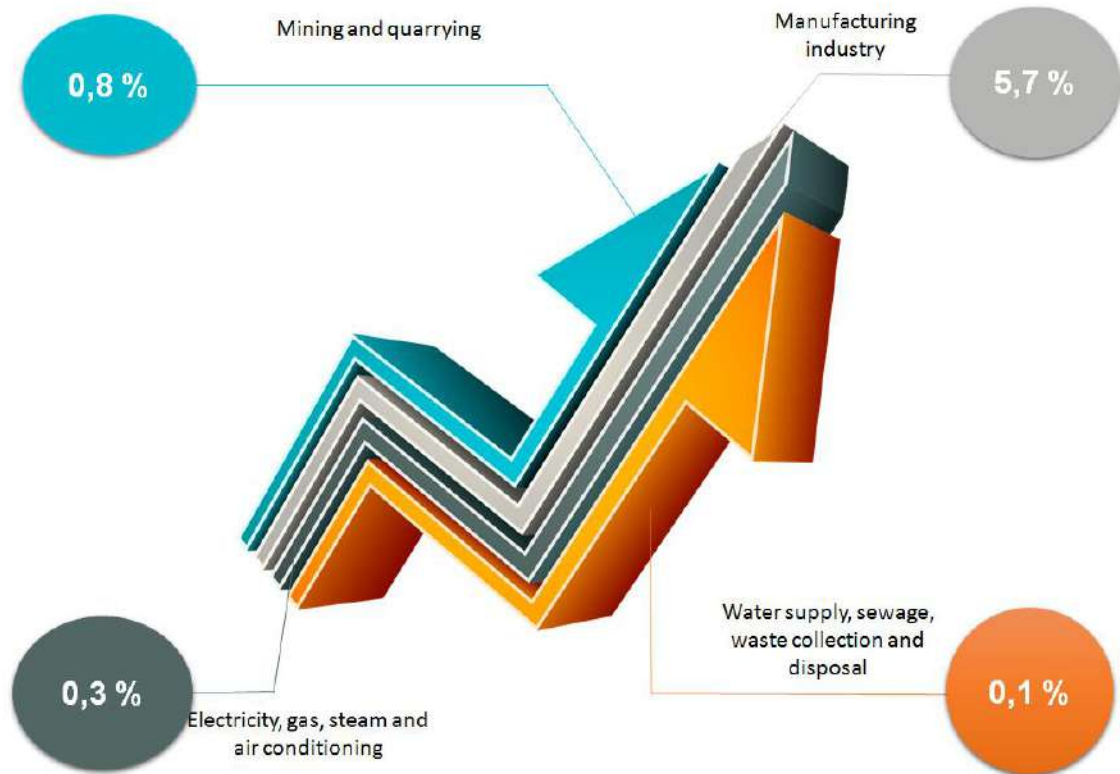
The main factor behind the growth in total industrial production was growth in the mining industry and quarrying by 4.7%, manufacturing - by 7.8%, electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning - by 3.6%, water supply, sewerage, collection and disposal of waste - by 7.9%.

Mining and quarrying

The volume of products produced by mining and quarrying enterprises in January-June 2019 amounted to 19.4 trillion. soum, or 13.1% of the total industry.

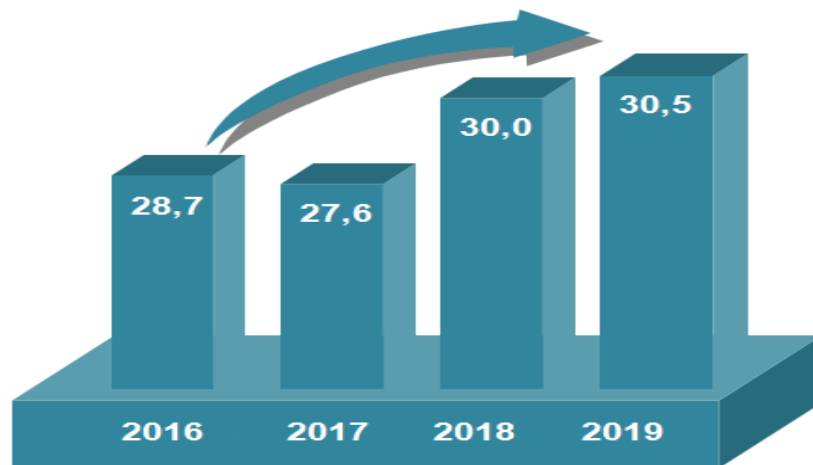
Compared to the same period last year, there was an increase in natural gas production by 1.8% and gravel - by 39.8%, with a decrease in coal production by 10.5%, oil - by 7.4%, gas condensate - on 2.6%, rubble - by 9.7%.



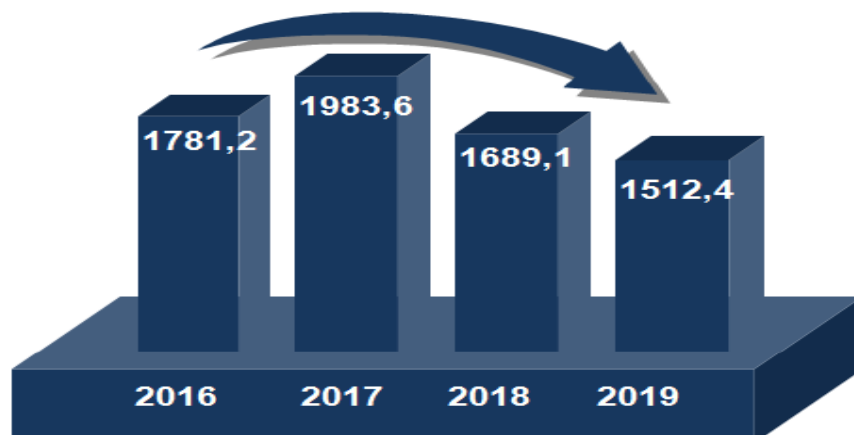

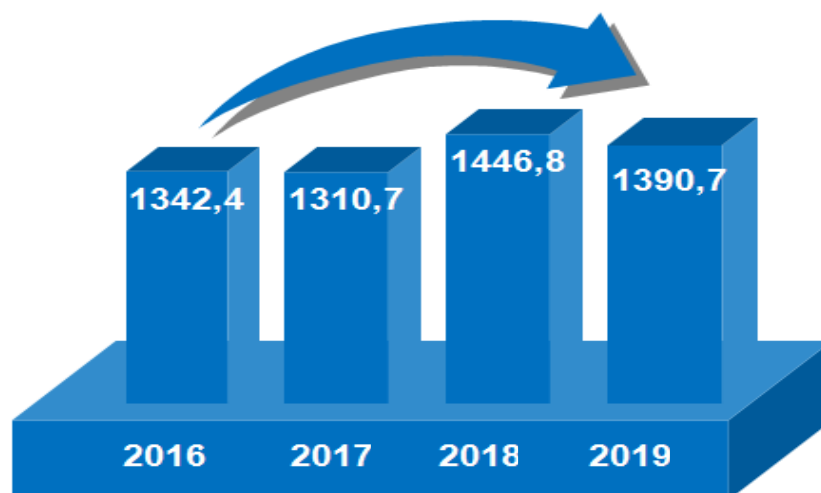
Natural gas production, billion cubic meters

(January-June 2016-2019)



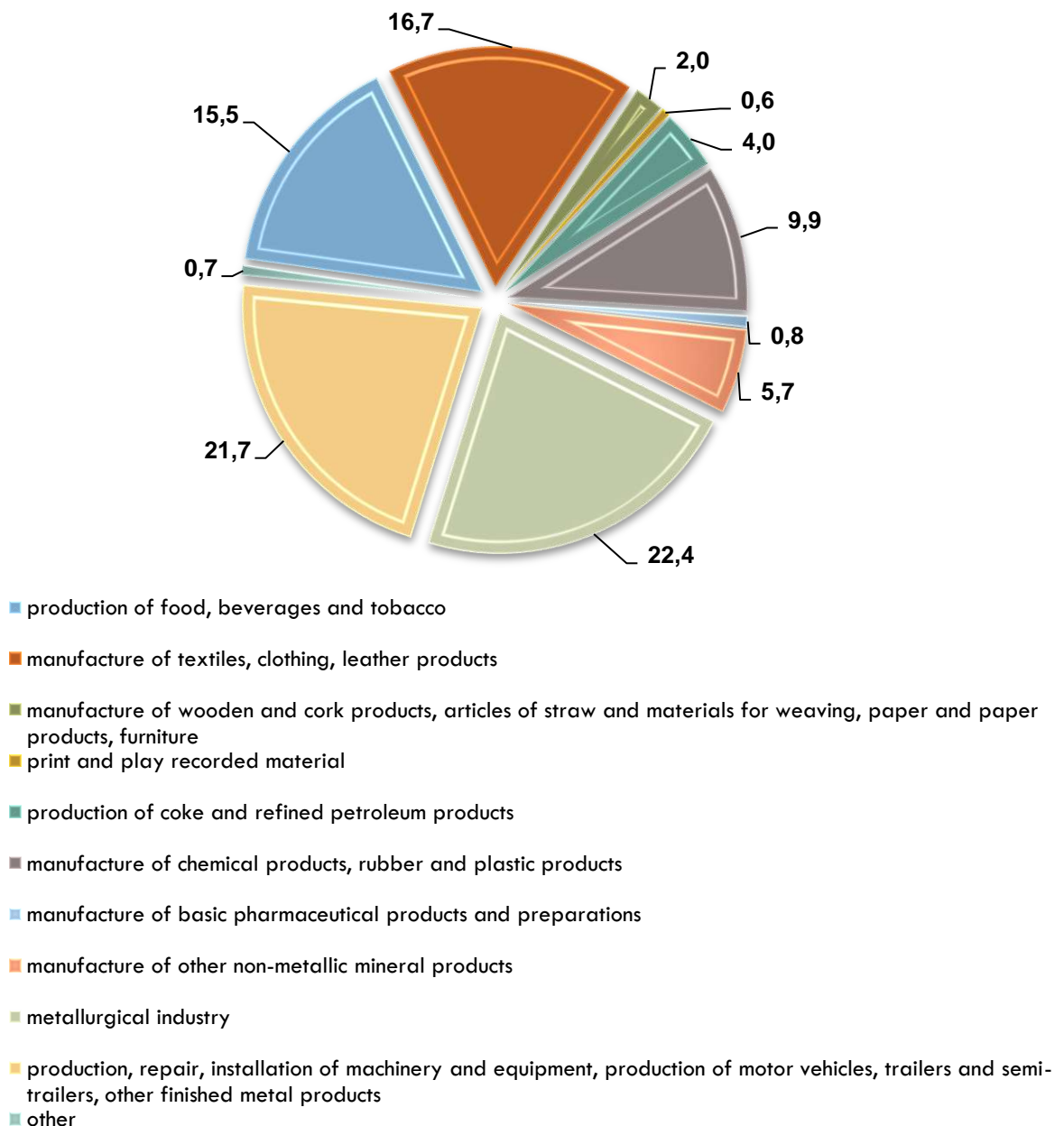
Oil production (including gas condensate), thousand tons

Manufacturing industry

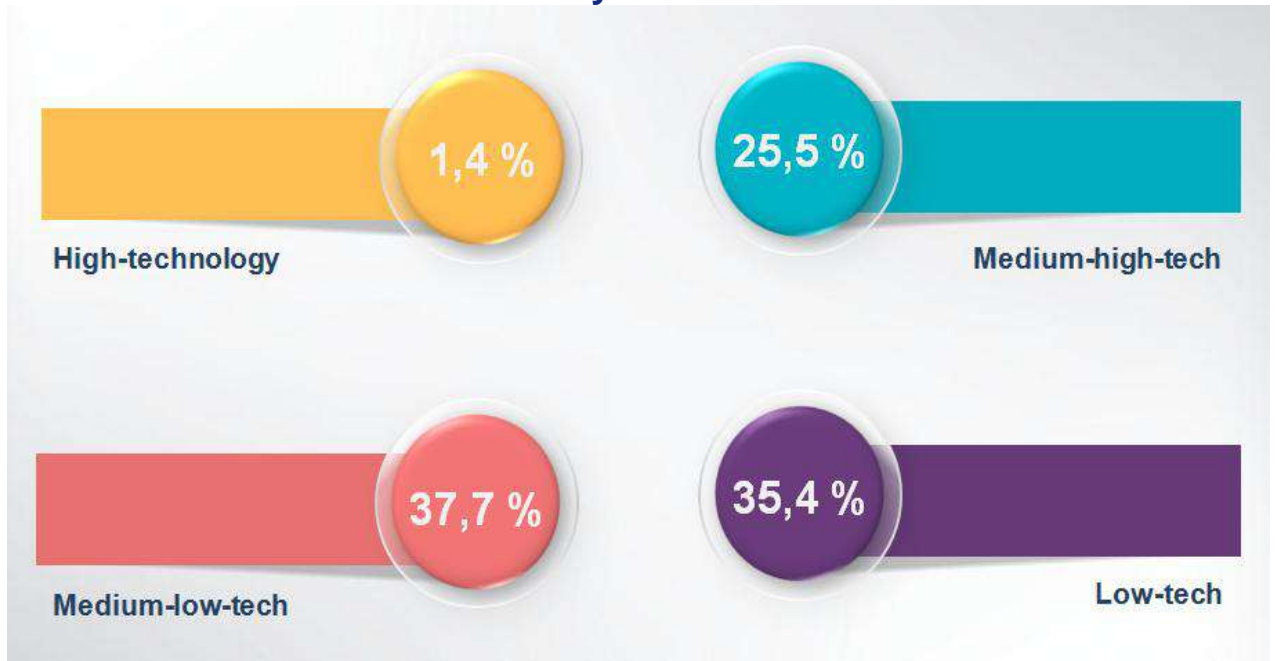
Manufacturing enterprises for January-June 2019, products produced at 117.3 trillion. soum, or 79.4% of the total industry.

Manufacturing production structure January-June 2019,%

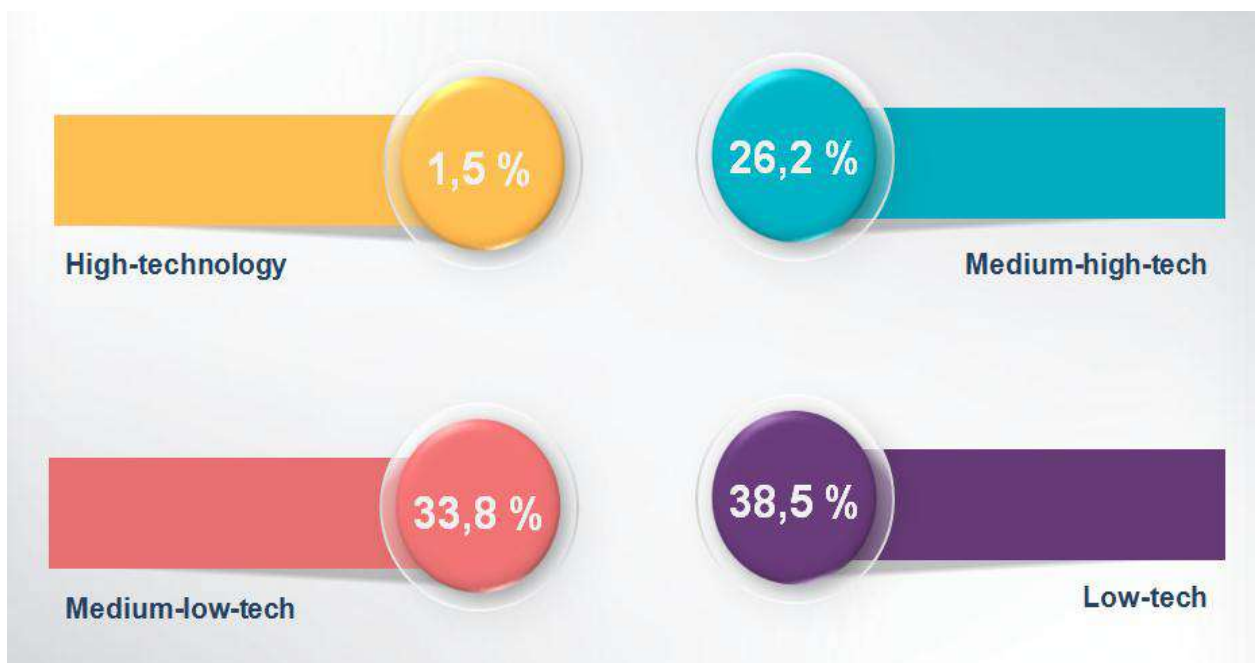


In the structure of the manufacturing industry, in comparison with the corresponding period of the previous year, the share of high-tech industries was 1.4% (1.5% in January-June 2018), medium-high-tech - 25.5% (26.2%), medium-low-tech - 37.7% (33.8%) and low-tech - 35.4% (38.5%).

In the processing industry, the share of enterprises producing, repairing, assembling machinery and equipment, manufacturing cars, trailers, semi-trailers and other finished products amounted to 21.7% (increase by 23.2% by January-June 2018), the share of the metallurgical industry - 22.4% (5.7%), enterprises for the production of textile, clothing and leather products - 16.7% (4.1%), for the production of food, beverages and tobacco products - 15.5% (6, 6%), enterprises for the production of chemical products, rubber and plastic products - 9.9% (2.6%).

At the same time in the manufacturing industry, in comparison with the corresponding period last year, the production of trucks increased by 1.6 p., passenger cars - by 1.5 p., automobile engines - by 1.6 p., buses - by 3.4 p., travel wheels, their parts and accessories - 1.5 p., radiators, noise suppressors and exhaust pipes, clutches, steering wheels, steering columns, crankcases of steering mechanisms and their parts - 1.5 p.

The overhaul of the process equipment allowed us to increase the capacity utilization of chemical enterprises and to exceed the previous year's production of potassium chloride (110.9% by January-June 2018), carbamide (121.1%), ammonium sulfate (113.8%), ammonium nitrate (113.5%), paints and varnishes based on acrylic or vinyl polymers (118.7%), herbicides (115.5%), caustic soda (147.4%), other nitrogen fertilizers and their mixtures (116.6%), mineral fertilizers containing nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium (115.0%).

Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning



The volume of products produced by the enterprises of electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning amounted to 9.9 trillion. soum (6.7% of the total industry).

In this industry in January-June 2019, compared with the corresponding period last year, the production, transmission and distribution of electricity, steam supply systems and air

conditioning increased by 4.3%.

Water supply, sewage, waste collection and disposal



The volume of products produced by water supply, sewerage, waste collection and disposal amounted to 1.2 trillion soum (0.8% of total industry).

Compared with the corresponding period last year, there is an increase in recycled materials containing aluminum, 2.1 t., Recycled materials containing copper - 2.8 t., Services for emptying, cleaning and processing cesspools, septic tanks and septic tanks 92.5%, services for the treatment and distribution of water through the water pipes - by 31.0%, services for the disposal, transportation of wastewater and their treatment - by 41.5%, services for the collection of non-hazardous waste - 73.3%

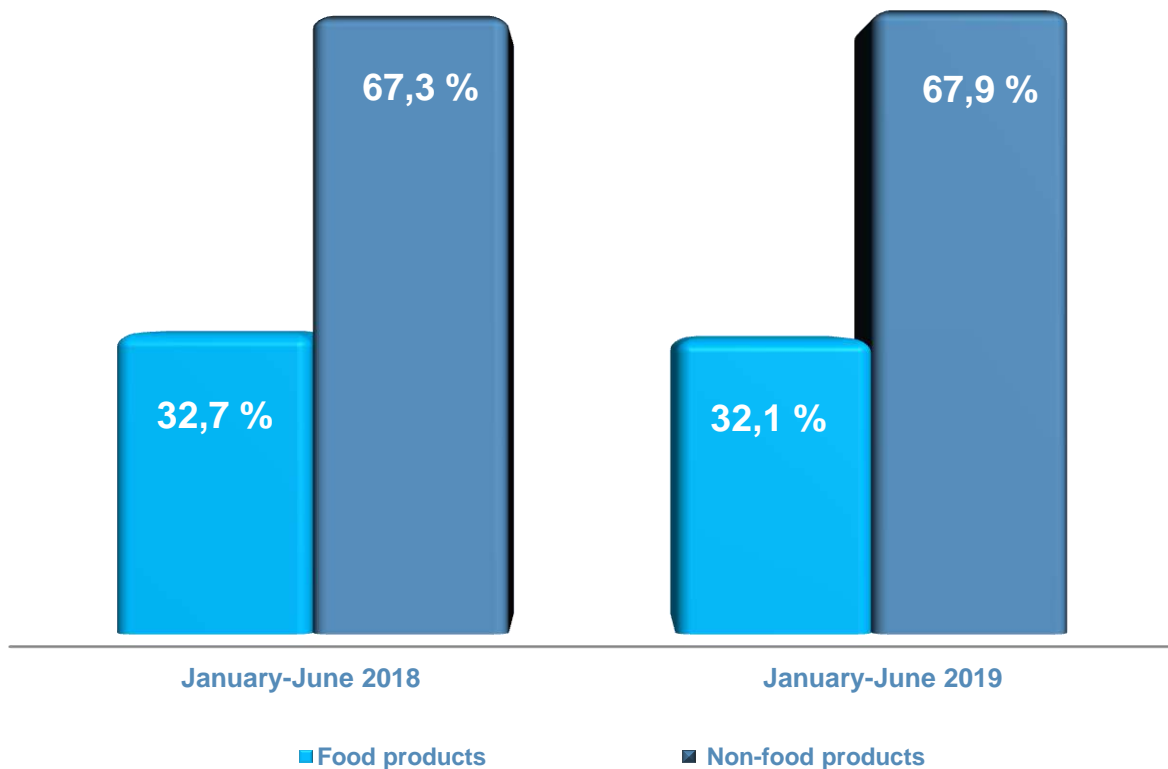

Consumer goods production

As a result of measures taken to expand the range and stimulating the production of finished products the production of consumer goods amounted to 48.7 trillion. sum and compared with the corresponding period of 2018, increased by 16.1%, the share in the total industry amounted to 33.0%.

Structure of production of consumer goods, in %



Compared to the same period in 2018, the share of non-food products increased from 67.3% to 67.9% in the structure of consumer goods production in January-June 2019.

In the structure of the output of food products, the production of wine products and beer was 6.3% (7.4% in January-June 2018).

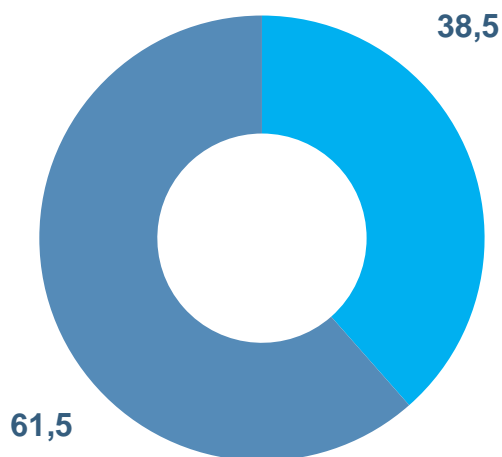
Production of enterprises with foreign investments

During the reporting period, enterprises with foreign investment produced goods to 54.6 trillion. sum

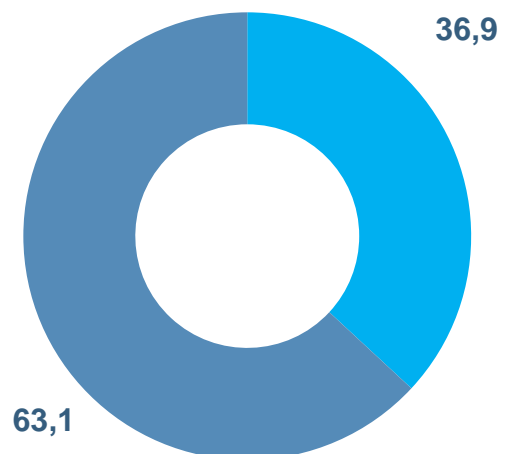
The share of products of enterprises with foreign investments in the total production volume amounted to 36.9%.

January-June 2018

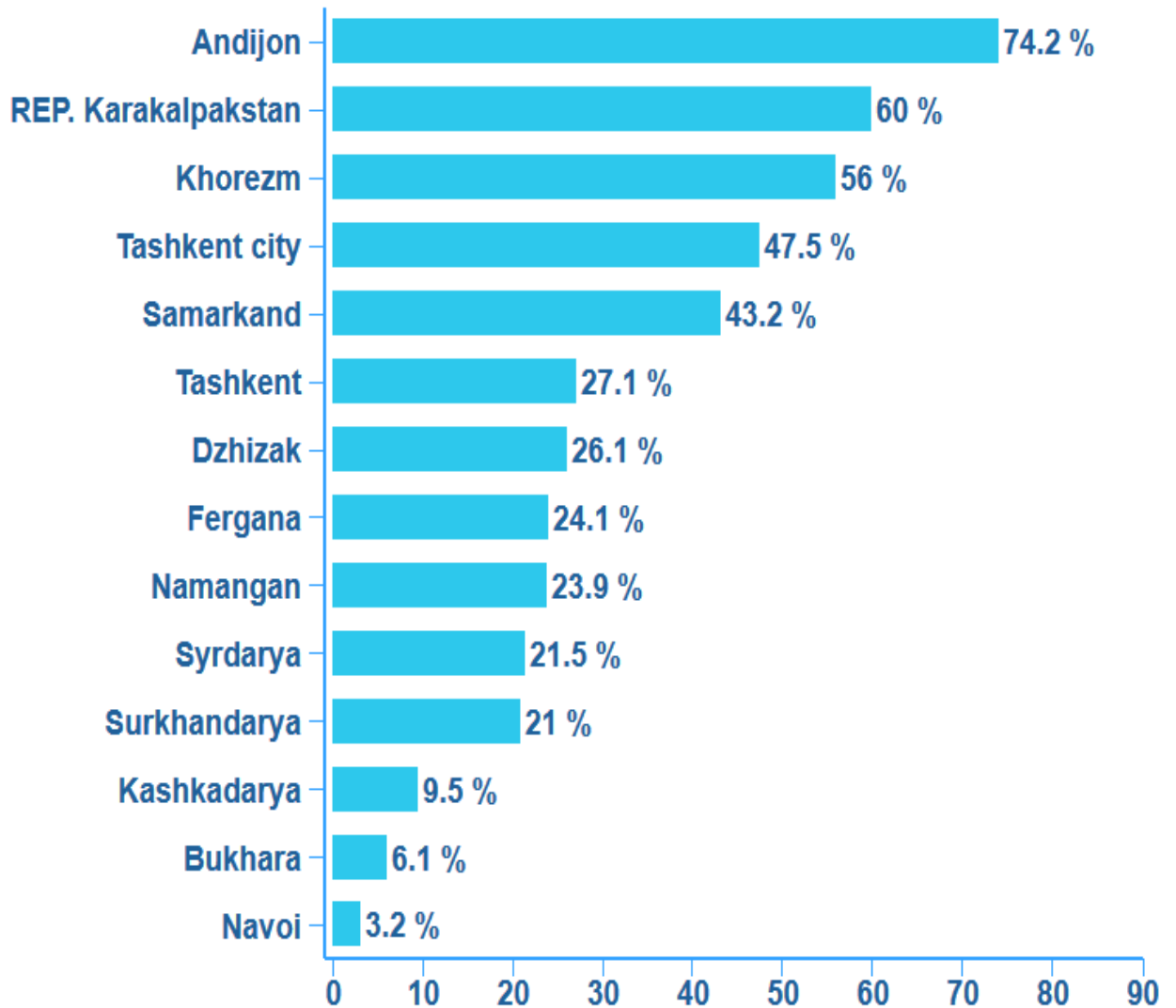

investments in the amount of regional production



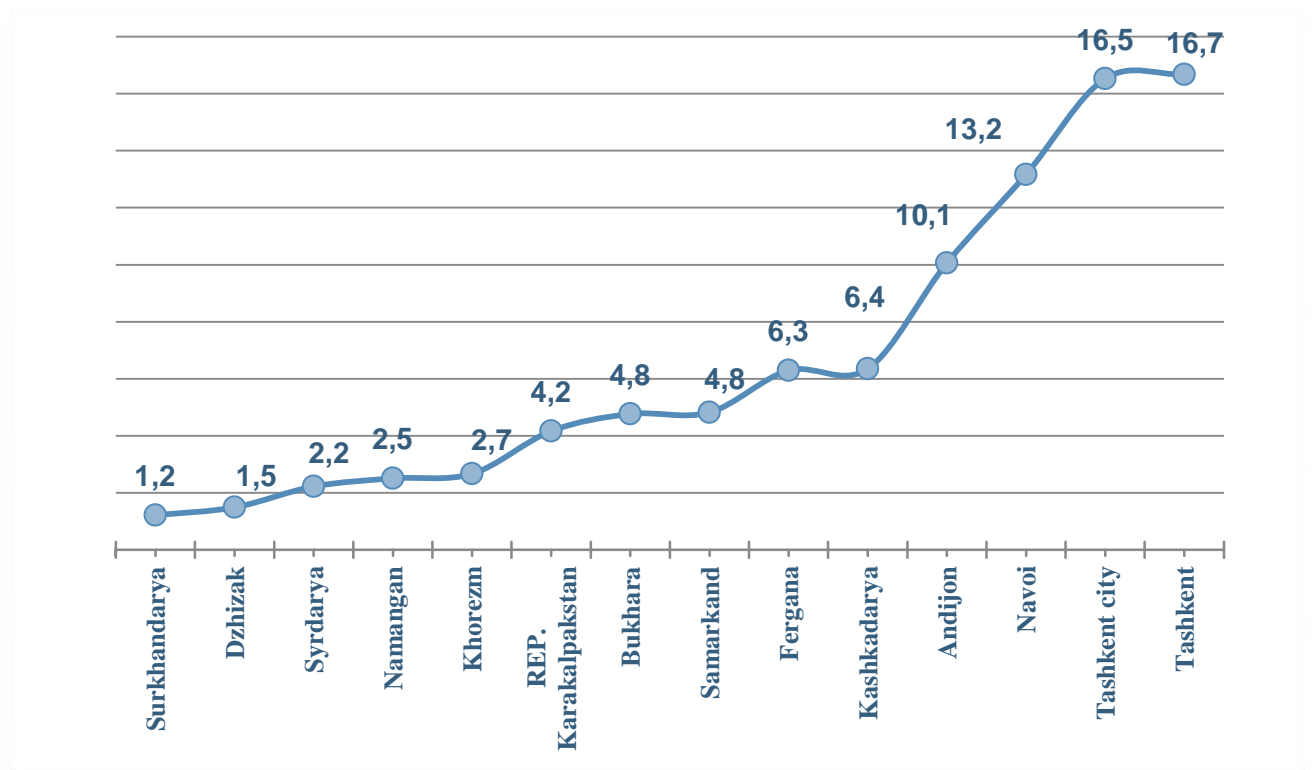

In the structure of industrial output of the republic, the largest share falls on the Tashkent region (16.7% of the national total industry), Tashkent (16.5%), Navoi (13.2%), Andijan (10.1%), Kashkadarya (6.4%) and Fergana (6.3%) regions.

The share of industrial production by regions, %

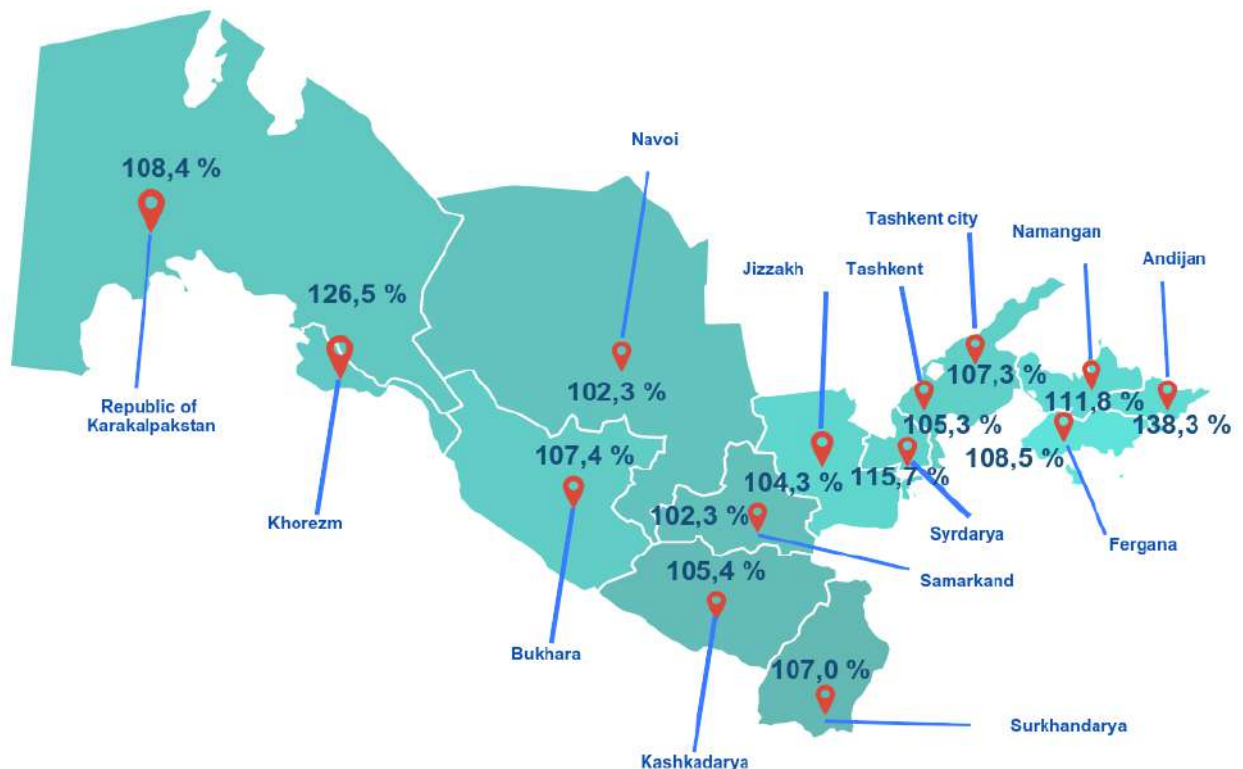


The consistent implementation of measures to increase the industrial potential of the regions contributed to a significant increase in industrial production in Andijan (117.8% by January-June 2018), Khorezm (110.8%), Tashkent (110.1%), Namangan (109.2%), Samarkand (109.1%) and Fergana (106.8%) regions.

At the same time, there was a significant increase in the production of consumer goods in Andijan (138.3% by January-June 2018), Khorezm (126.5%), Syrdarya (115.7%), Namangan (111.8%), Fergana (108,5%), Bukhara (107.4%), Surkhandarya (107.0%) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (108.4%).

Along with this, it should be noted that the largest share of consumer goods was produced in Andijan region (23.9% of total consumer goods of the republic), Tashkent city (22.1%), Tashkent (8.9%) and Samarkand (8,2%) regions.

Growth in consumer goods production by regions in January-June 2019, in % compared to January-June 2018



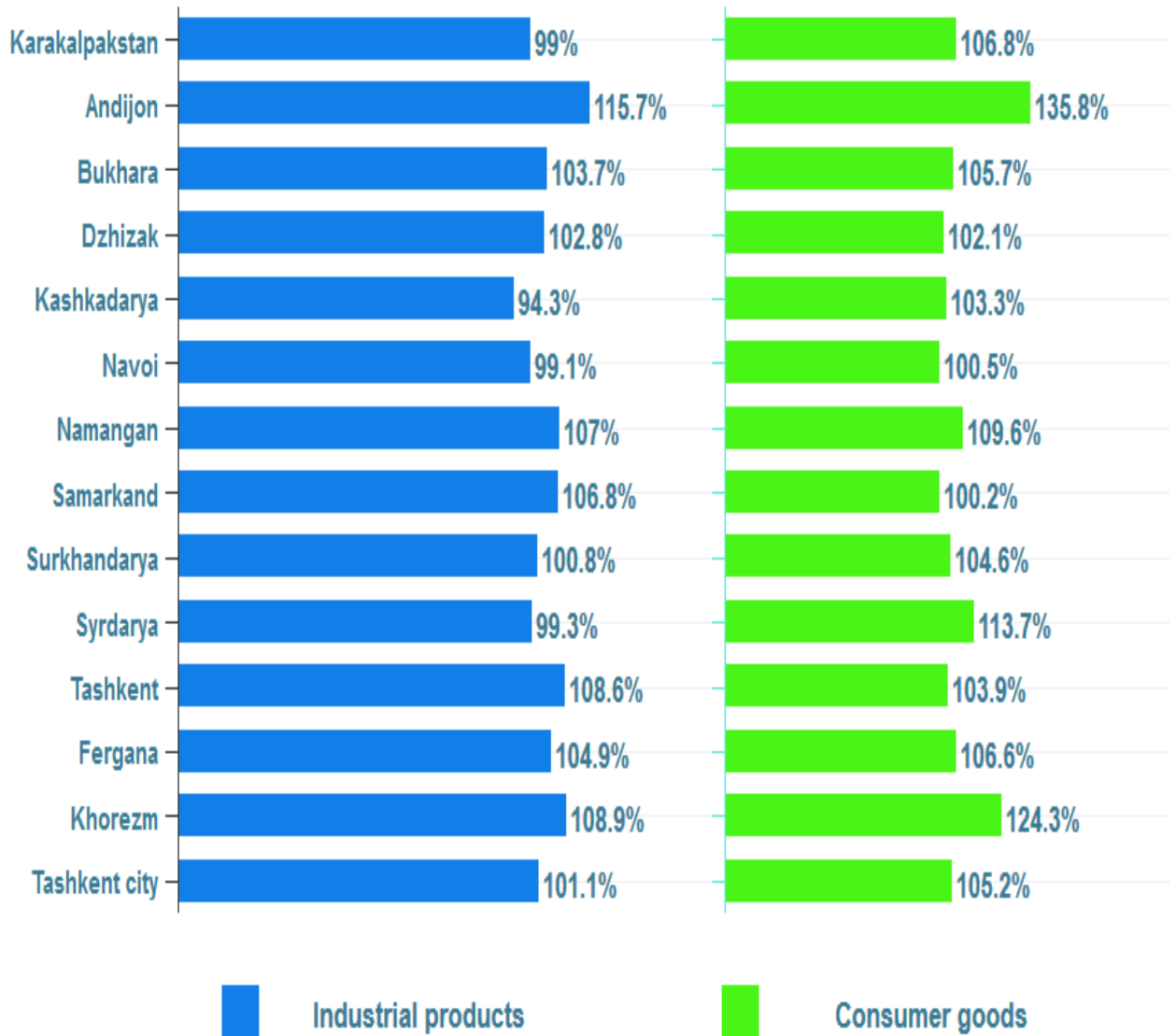
Analysis of the differentiation of industrial production per capita showed an excess of the average national indicator (4,427.5 thousand soums) in Navoi region (19797.8 thousand soums), Tashkent city (9680.0 thousand soums), Tashkent (8477.4 thousand soums) and Andijan (4833.1 thousand soums) regions.

In the reporting period, the production of consumer goods per capita in the republic amounted to 1,460.0 thousand soums, including 4267.8 thousand soums in Tashkent city, 3,792.7 thousand soums in Andijan region, 1508.0 in Syrdarya region thousand soums, Tashkent region - 1485.2 thousand soums, Navoi region - 1453.5 thousand soums and Khorezm region - 1350.0 thousand soums.

The contribution of small business in industrial production

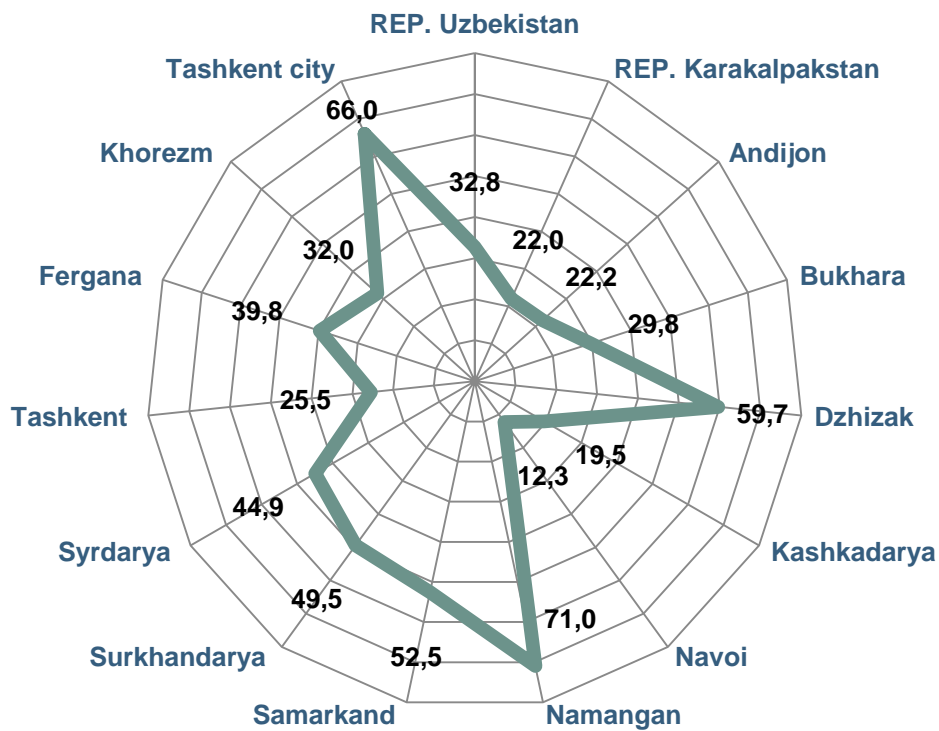
During the reporting period, by small businesses were produced goods – 48.4 trillion soums.

The share of small business in total production amounted to 32.8%.

In terms of regions, the largest share of small business was observed in Namangan (71.0% of total industry in region), Tashkent (66.0%), Jizzakh (59.7%), Samarkand (52.5%), Surkhandarya (49.5%), Syrdarya (44.9%) and Fergana (39.8%) regions.

At the same time, the smallest share of small business in regions was noted in Navoi (12.3%) and Kashkadarya (19.5%) regions, the Republic of Karakalpakstan (22.0%), and also in Andijan (22.2%) and Tashkent (25.5%) regions.

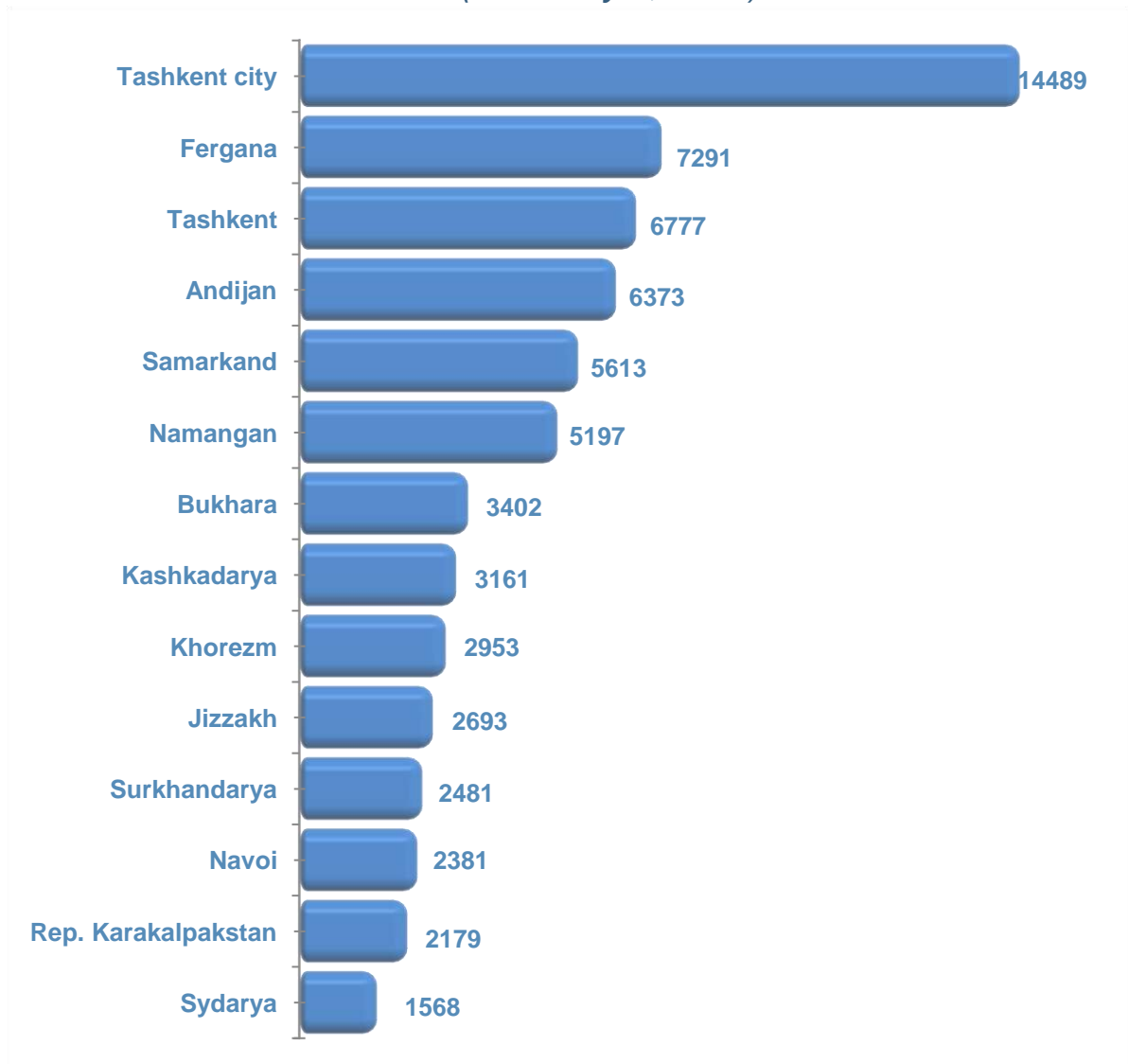
The share of small business in the volume of industrial production of regions, %



Operating and newly created industrial enterprises

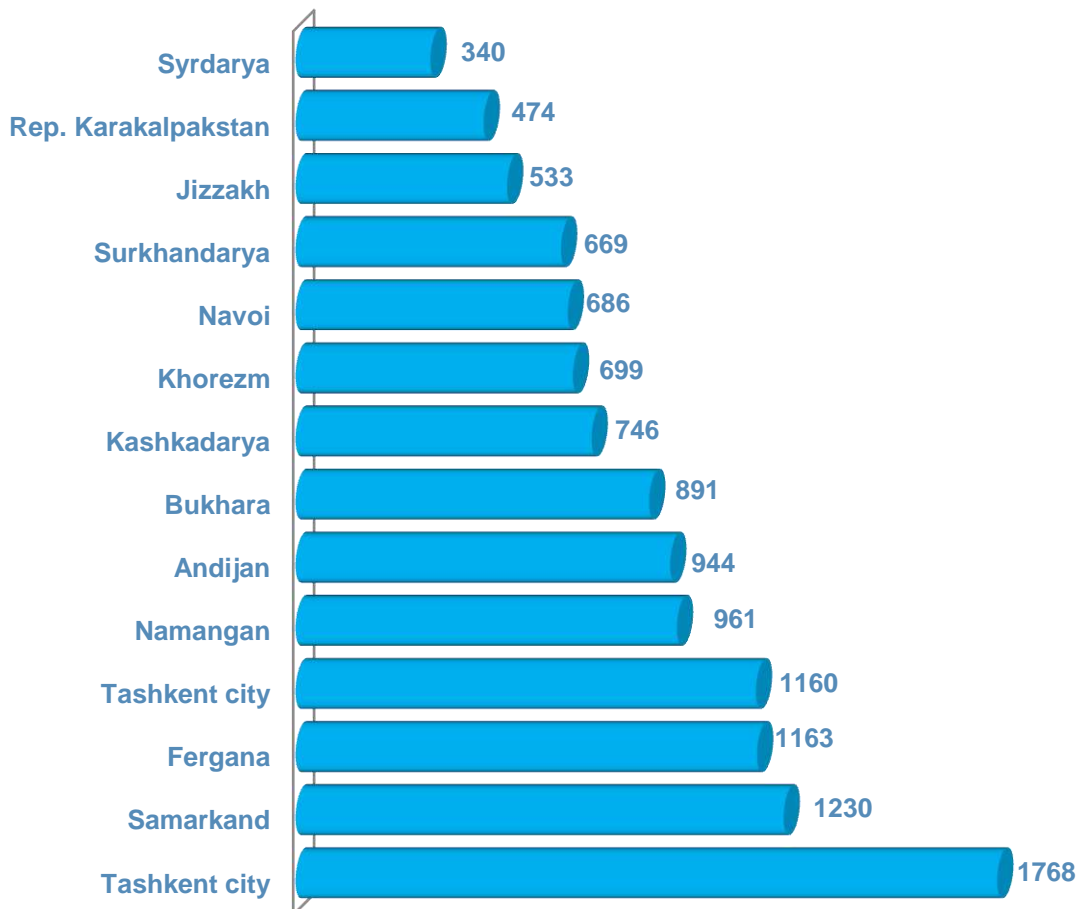
As of today, 66.6 thousand industrial enterprises operate in the republic, of which 14.5 thousand (21.8% of total number of operating enterprises) are in Tashkent city, 7.3 thousand (11.0%) - Fergana and 6.8 thousand (10.2%) - Tashkent region.

In January-June 2019, 12,264 industrial enterprises were re-established in the republic, of which 51.2% were in Tashkent city, Namangan, Tashkent, Samarkand and Fergana regions.

Implementation of the Program for the localizing the production of finished goods, components and materials

The development of industrial production in the republic was also promoted by the implementation of the Program for localizing the production of finished goods, components and materials, under 587 projects were produced goods for 7.9 trillion soums, localized products exports - 244.4 million USD, 1947 new jobs were created.

Compared to the same period of last year, in January-June 2019, the number of newly created jobs increased 3.9 times. However, compared to January-June 2018, there was a decrease in volume of localized products exports.
