

XIV. DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION

As of April 1, 2019, the resident population of the republic, according to preliminary data, amounted to 33,375.8 thousand people and from the beginning of the year, increased by 120.3 thousand people, or by 0.4%.

At the same time, the urban population was 16 865.1 thousand (50.5% of total population), the rural population - 16 510.7 thousand people (49.5%).

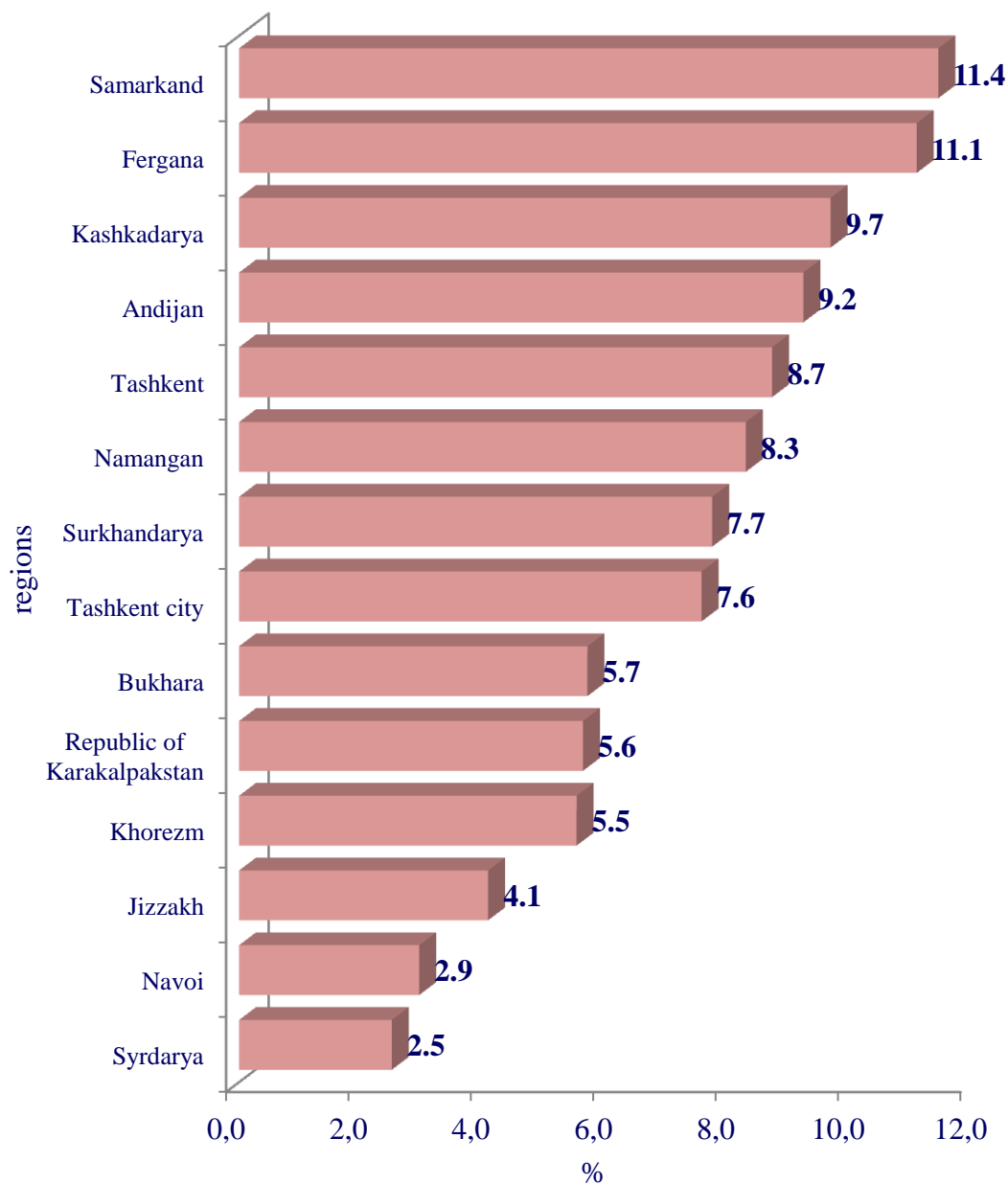

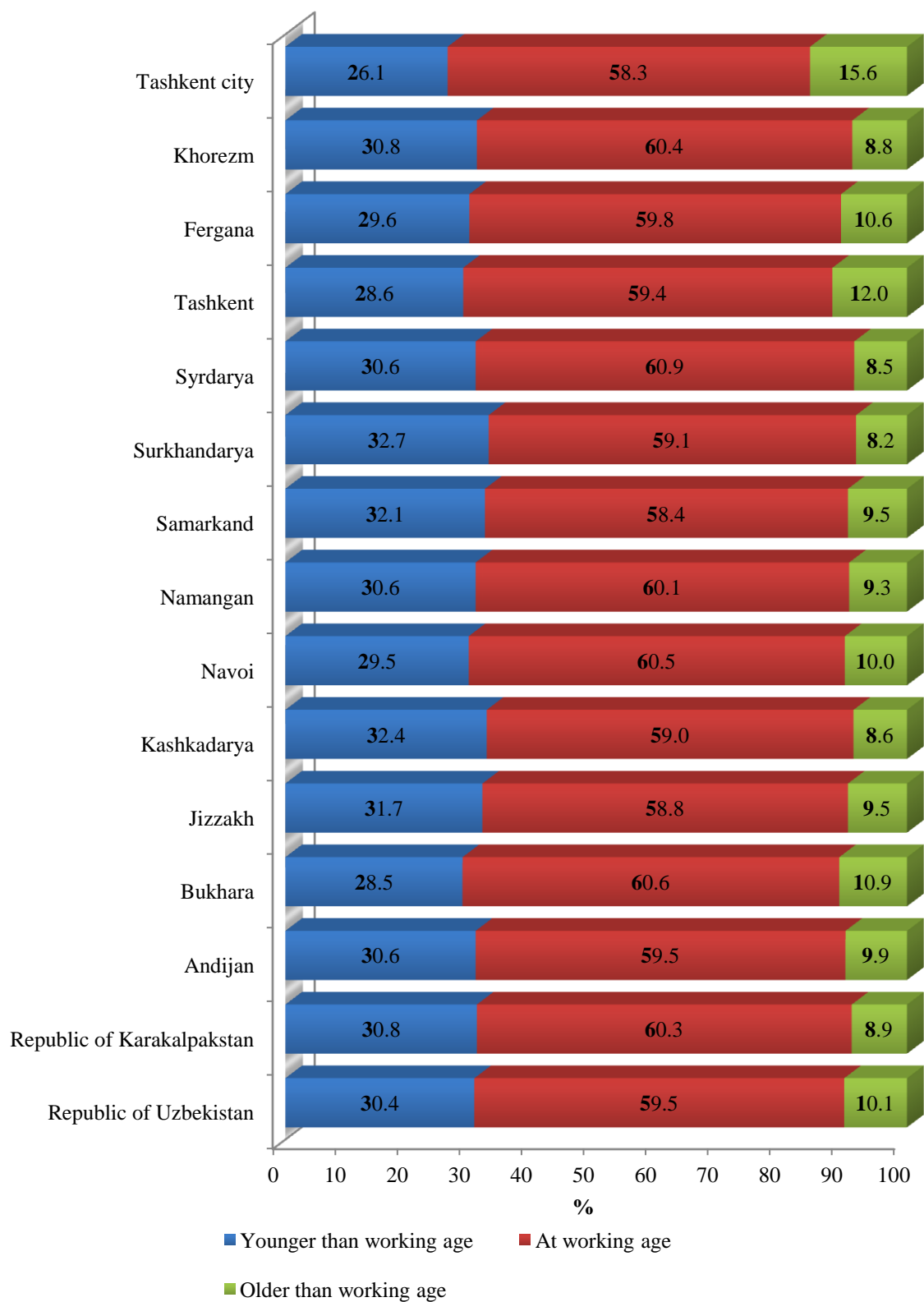
As of April 1, 2019, the largest share in Samarkand region was 3813.6 thousand people (share in total population of the republic was 11.4%), Fergana region was 3695.5 thousand people (11.1%), Kashkadarya region - 3225.8 thousand people (9.7%) and Andijan region - 3077.2 thousand people (9.2%).

As of April 1, 2019, younger than the working age was 30.4% of total population, 59.5% of the working age, 10.1% were older than the working age.

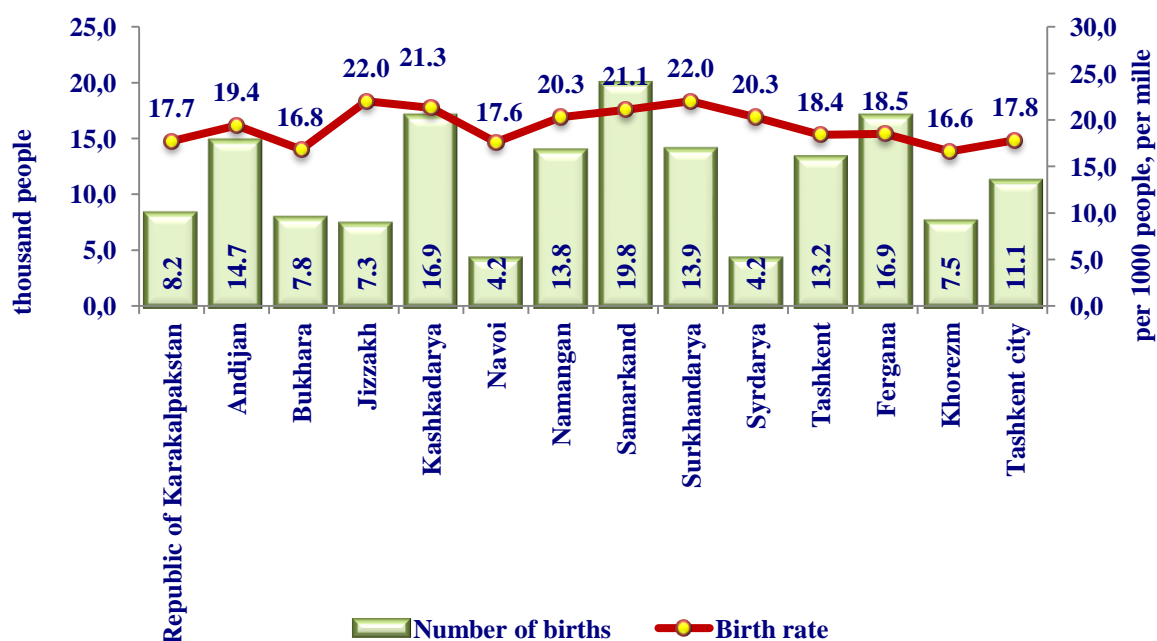

Births. In January-March 2019, the number of births (here and hereinafter referred to as births live births) amounted to 159.5 thousand people and, compared to the corresponding period of 2018 (147.1 thousand people), increased by 12.4 thousand people, the birth rate was 19.4 per mille.

(January-March 2019)

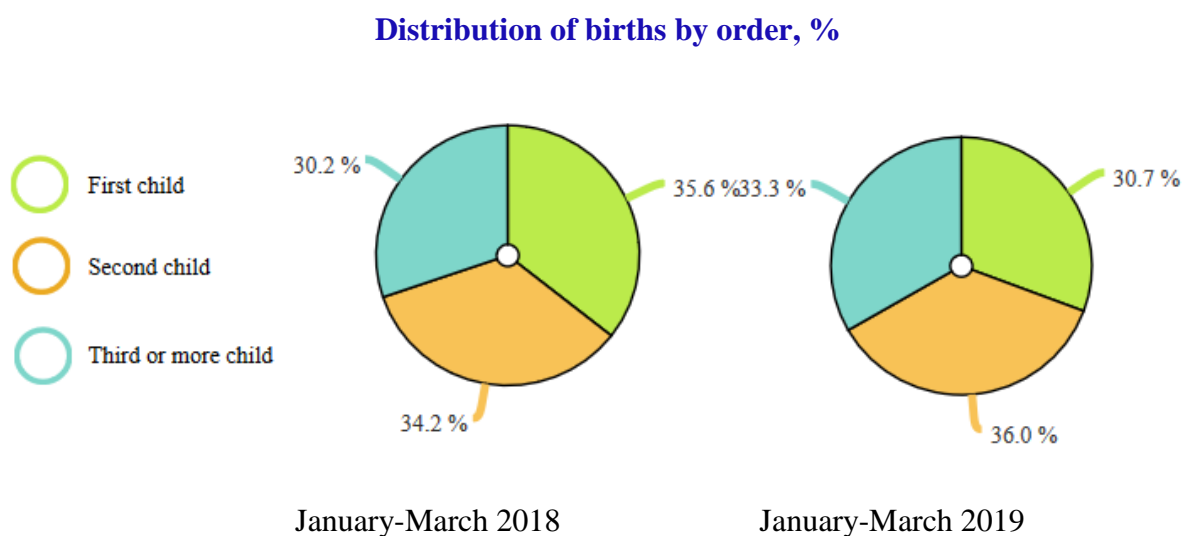

An increase in the birth rate was observed in Tashkent city (from 15.7 to 17.8 per mille), Syrdarya (18.1 to 20.3 per mille), Jizzakh (20.2 to 22.0 per mille), Tashkent (16.6 to 18.4 per mille), Namangan (18.8 to 20.3 per mille), Andijan (18.0 to 19.4 per mille), Fergana (17.1 to 18.5 per mille) regions.

At the same time, a high birth rate is observed in Surkhandarya and Jizzakh (22.0 per mille), Kashkadarya (21.3 per mille) and Samarkand (21.1 per mille) regions.

By order of birth in January-March 2019, 30.7% fall on the first child (35.6% in January-March 2018), 36.0% on the second child (34.2 in January-March 2018 %), 33.3% - for the third and more children (in January-March 2018 - 30.2%).



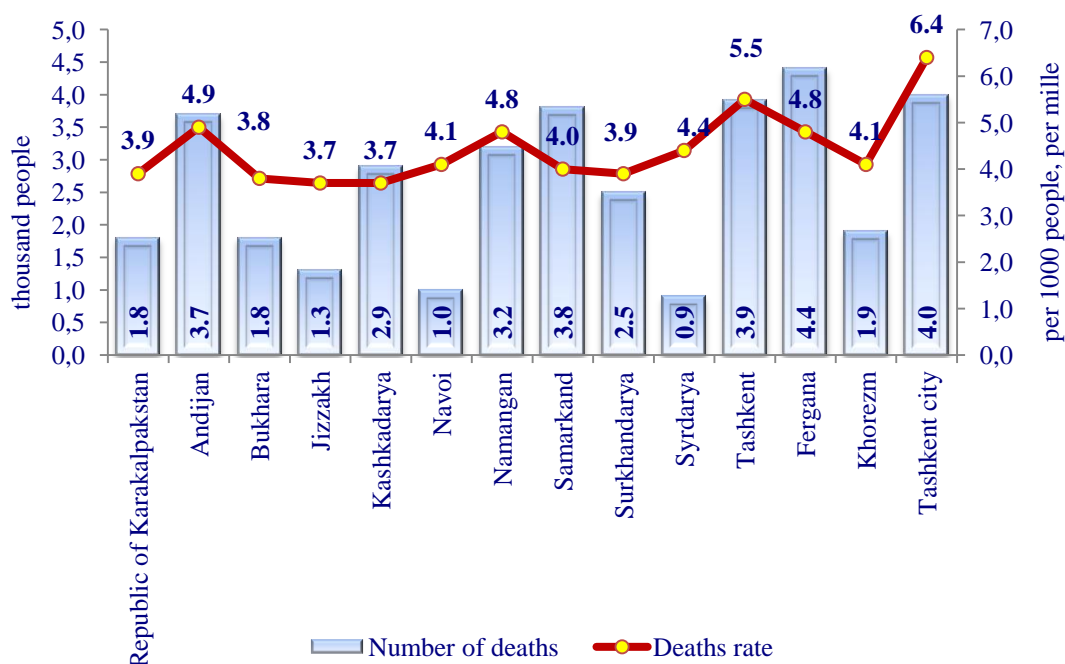
Deaths. The number of deaths in January-March 2019 was 37.1 thousand people and, compared to the corresponding period of January-March 2018 (37.7 thousand people), decreased by 0.6 thousand people, respectively, the mortality rate was 4,5 per mille (in January-March 2018, 4.7 per mille).

The lowest mortality rate was recorded in Kashkadarya and Jizzakh (3.7 per mille), Bukhara (3.8 per mille), Surkhandarya (3.9 per mille) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.9 per mille).

In the structure of total deaths, 63.8% were circulatory system diseases, 9.0% – neoplasms, 5.2% – diseases of the digestive organs, 5.1% – respiratory diseases, 4.3% – accidents, poisoning and injuries, 1.4% - infectious and parasitic diseases, 11.2% - other diseases.

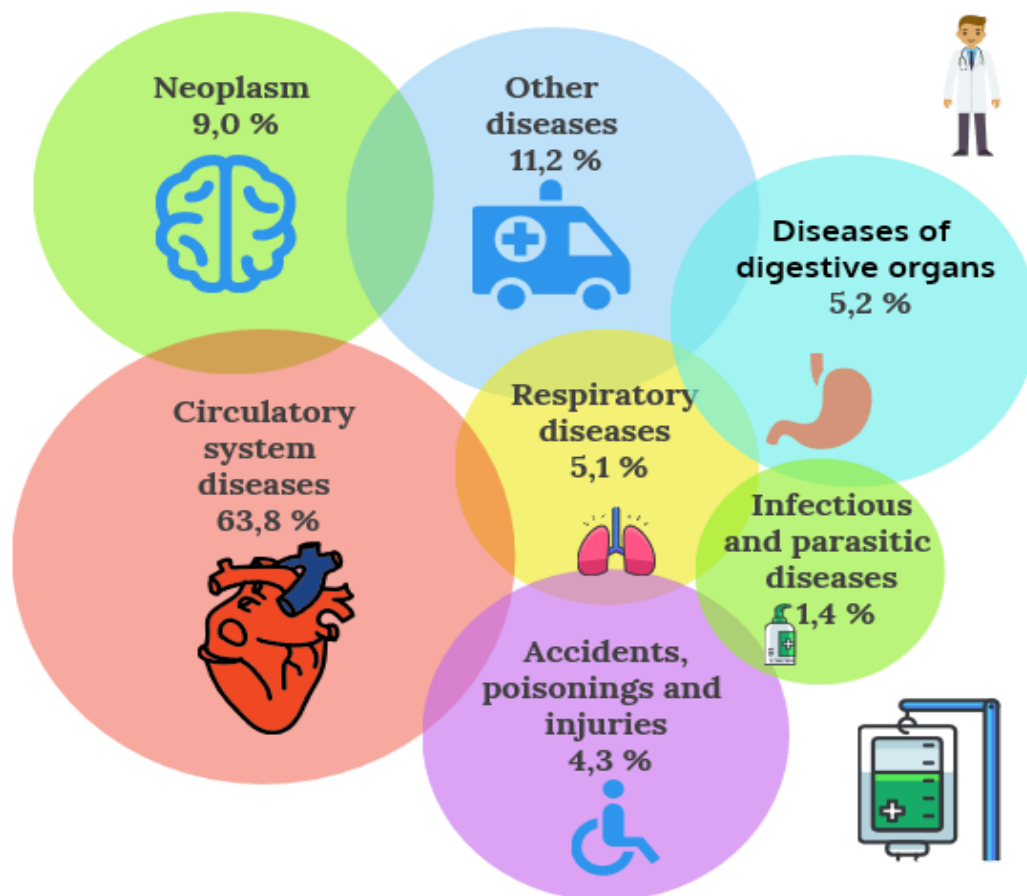
Number and rate of deaths by regions

According to preliminary data, in January-March 2019, was recorded 1.6 thousand infant deaths under the age of one year. The infant mortality rate was 8.3 per mille (in January-March 2018 - 9.8 per mille).

High rates of infant mortality were recorded in Tashkent city (11.6 per 1,000 live births), Namangan (11.4), Jizakkh (11.2), Andijan (10.9), Khorezm (10.2) regions.

From total number of infant deaths under the age of 1 year, 52.1% died from conditions arising in the perinatal period, 20.3% from respiratory diseases, 16.0% from congenital anomalies, 2.1% from infectious and parasitic diseases, 2.1% from accidents, poisoning and injuries, 0.7% from diseases of the digestive system, 6.7% from other diseases.

Also, according to preliminary data, in January-March 2019, 24 cases of maternal death were recorded, and the maternal mortality rate was 15.1 per mille (per 100 thousand live births).

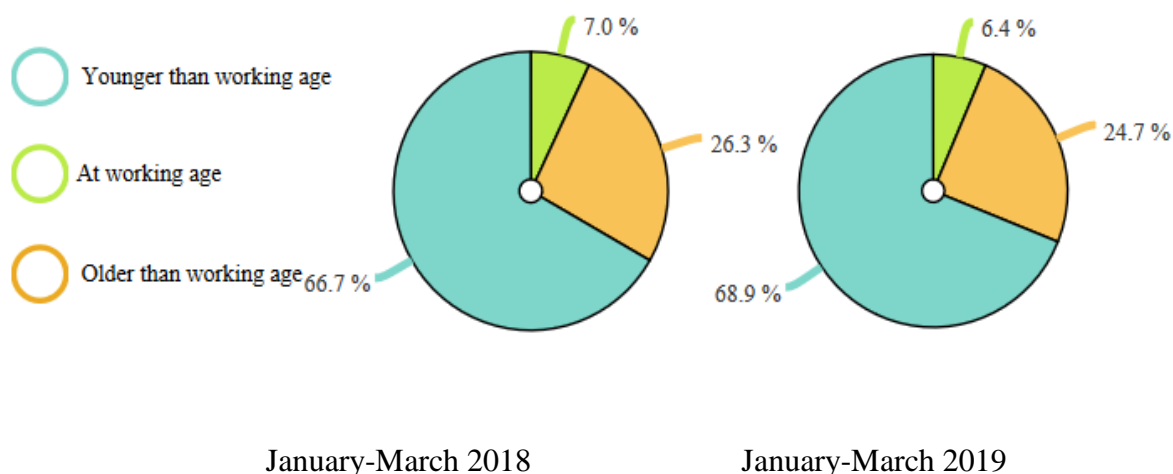
High rates of maternal mortality were noted in Samarkand (25.3 (per 100 thousand live births)), Navoi (23.5), Tashkent (22.7) Namangan (21.8), Surkhandarya (21.5) and Andijan (20.4) regions.

From total number of deaths, 6.4% died at younger than the working age (7.0% in January-March 2018), 24.7% at the working-age (26.3% in January-March 2018) and 68.9% are older than working-age (in January-March 2018 - 66.7%).

Most of the dead (68.9%) are among those who are older than the working-age.

(% of total)

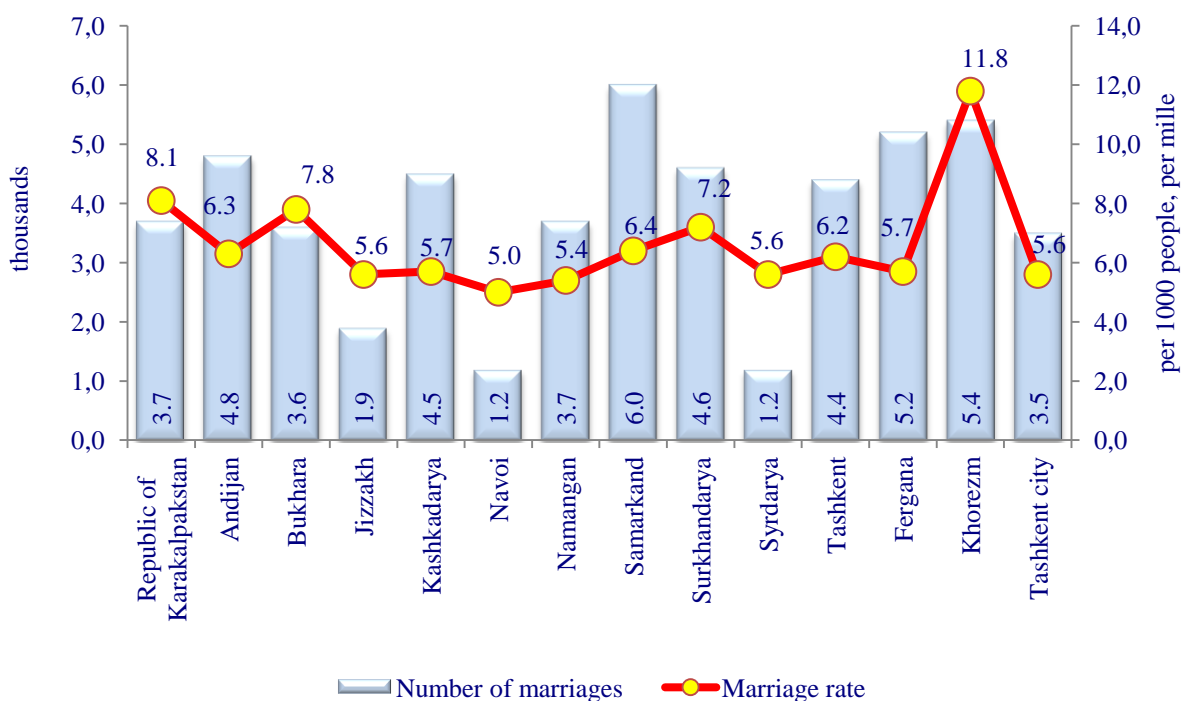


Marriages. During the period from January to March 2019, the civil registry offices recorded 53.7 thousand marriages. In the republic, the marriage rate per 1000 population was 6.5 per thousand.

The marriage rate increased significantly in Namangan (from 4.7 to 5.4 per mille), Tashkent (from 5.5 to 6.2 per mille), Bukhara (from 7.4 to 7.8 per mille), Jizzakh (from 5.2 to 5.6 per mille), Andijan (from 6.0 to 6.3 per mille), Navoi (from 4.9 to 5.0 per mille), Surkhandarya (from 7.1 to 7.2 per mille) regions and the city of Tashkent (from 5.0 to 5.6 per mille).

(January-March 2019)

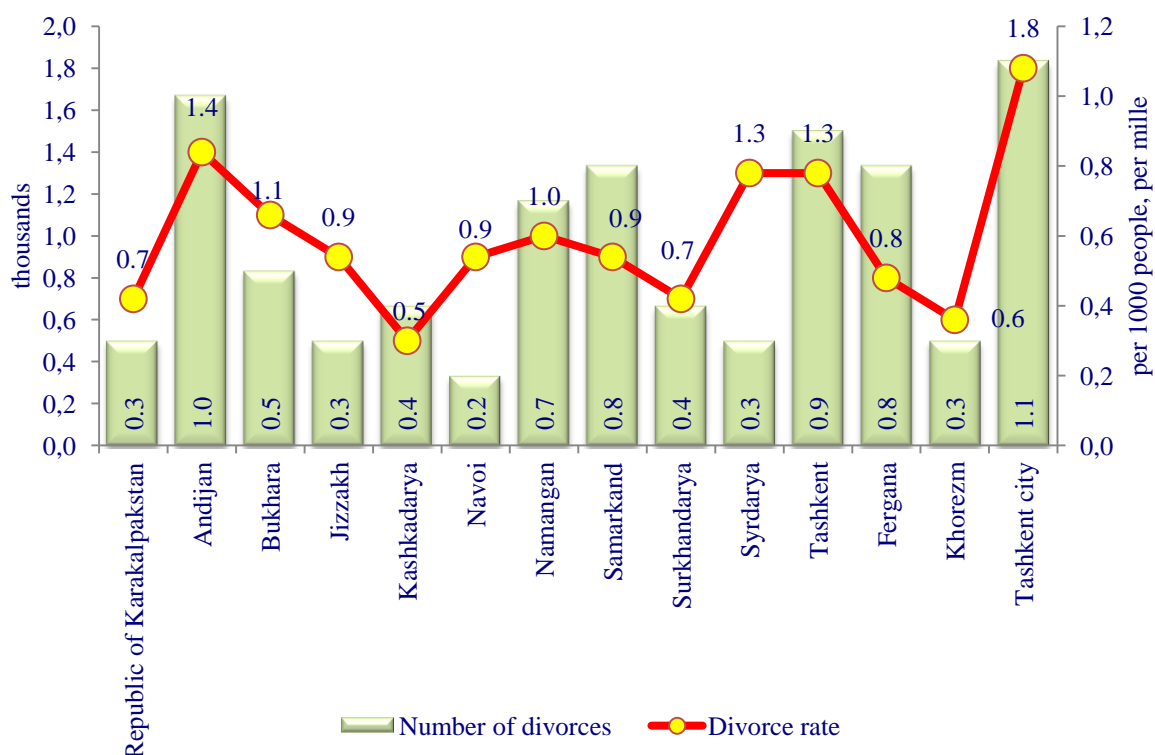


Divorces. During the period from January to March 2019, the civil registry offices recorded 8.0 thousand divorces. In the republic, the divorce rate per 1000 population was 1.0 per mille.

The divorce rate increased significantly in Andijan (from 1.2 to 1.4 per mille) region and Tashkent city (from 1.6 to 1.8 per mille).

Migration. According to preliminary data, in January-March 2019 in the republic the number of arrivals was 41.5 thousand people, the number of departures - 43.6 thousand people.

The migration balance was a decrease 2.1 thousand people against a decrease 2.5 in the corresponding period of January-March 2018.

The most significant negative balance of migration was observed in Kashkadarya (minus 1.4), Tashkent and Bukhara (minus 0.8), Surkhandarya (minus 0.7) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (minus 0.7).

The positive balance of migration was noted in Tashkent city (plus 5.8).

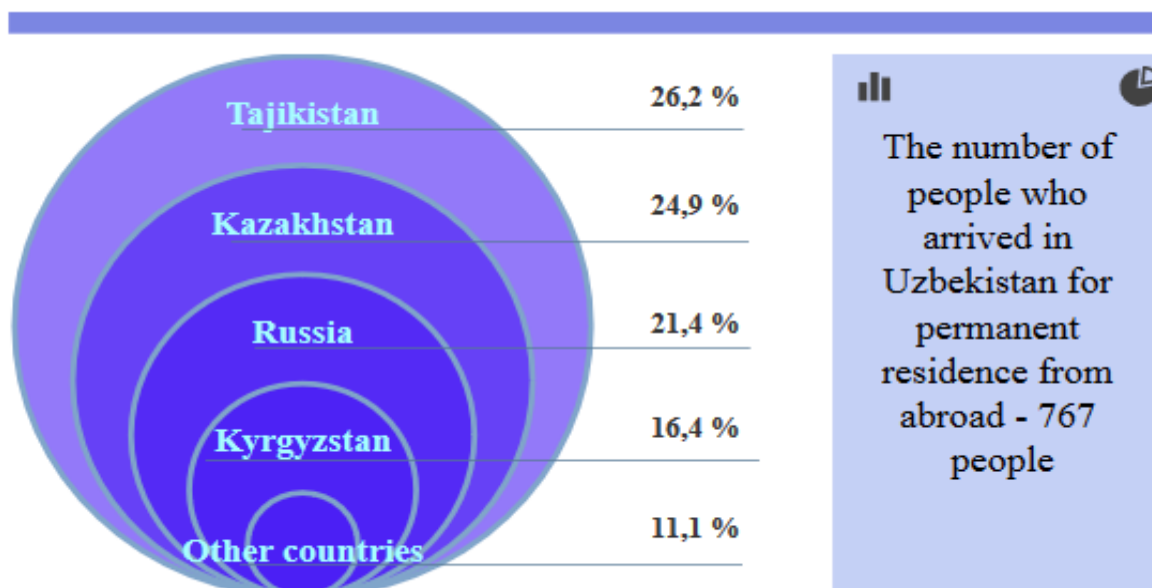

Also, according to preliminary data, in January-March 2019, the number of people arriving in Uzbekistan for permanent residence from abroad amounted to 0.8 thousand, and the number of those who left Uzbekistan for permanent residence abroad - 2.9 thousand..

The largest share of arrivals from abroad to the Republic of Uzbekistan (i% of total number of arrivals from abroad) was accounted for arrivals from the Republic of Tajikistan (26.2%), the Republic of Kazakhstan (24.9%) and the Russian Federation (21.4 %), and the smallest - to the Republic of Kyrgyzstan (16.4%) and other countries (11.1%).

The largest share of those departing abroad from the Republic of Uzbekistan (% of total number of those departing abroad) was accounted for those departing to the Republic of Kazakhstan (47.9%) and the Russian Federation (45.6%), and the smallest - Israel (1.1%), The United States of America (0.7%) and other countries (4.7%).
