

VII. PRIVATIZATION OF ENTERPRISES AND OBJECTS

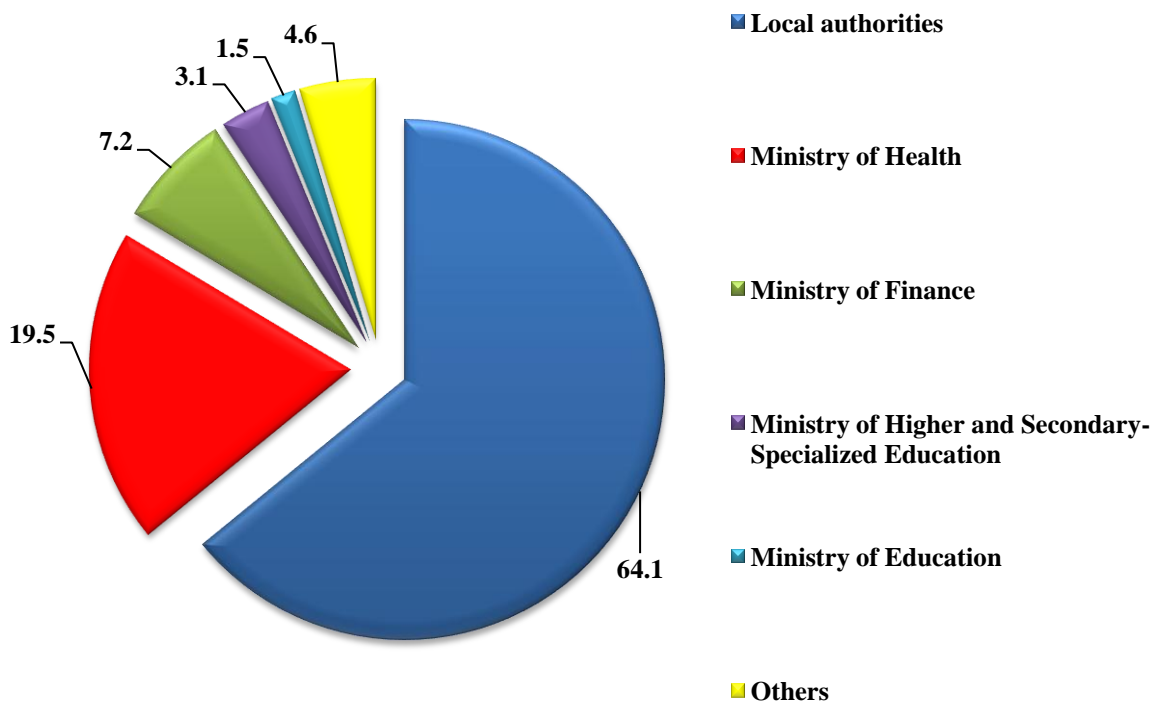
According to the Agency for management of state assets of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in January-March 2019, 195 enterprises and objects (hereinafter referred to as objects) were privatized (including program and non-program objects).

In the reporting period, the largest number of objects were privatized in Andijan region - 61 objects (31.3% of total number of privatized objects in the republic), Tashkent region - 27 objects (13.8%), Bukhara region - 16 objects (8.2%), Surkhandarya region - 16 objects (8.2%), Fergana region - 16 objects (8.2%), Kashkadarya region - 13 objects (6.7%).

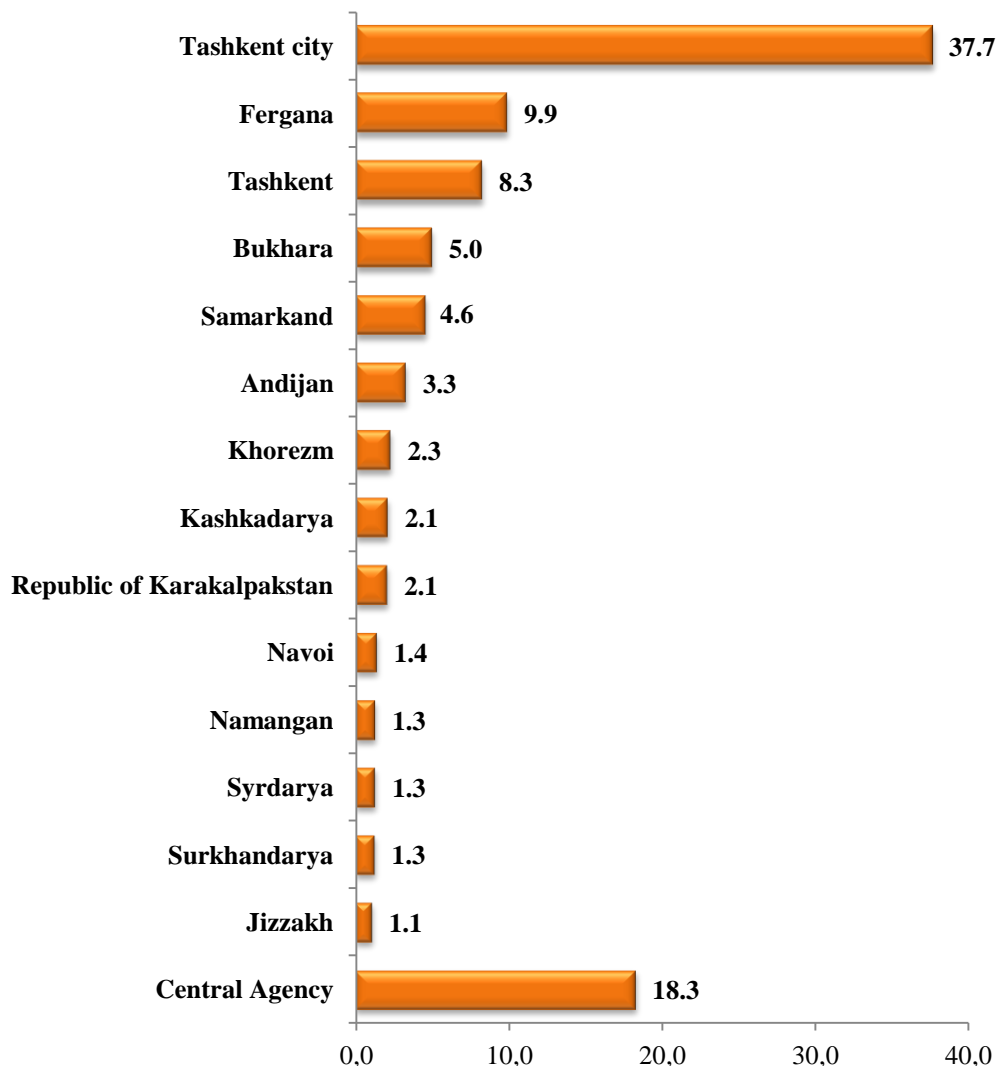
The structure of privatized state property by ministries and departments

In the structure of privatized state property, the largest share falls on objects of local authorities - 125 objects (64.1% of the total number of objects privatized in the republic), Ministry of Health - 38 objects (19.5%), Ministry of Finance - 14 objects (7.2%), Ministry of higher and secondary specialized education - 6 objects (3.1%), Ministry of Public Education - 3 objects (1.5%).

The inflow of funds from the sale of state assets in January-March 2019 amounted to 55.9 billion soums.

In terms of regions, the largest part of revenues from the sale of state assets falls on Tashkent city (37.7% of all revenues), Central Agency (18.3%), Fergana (9.9%), Tashkent (8.3%), Bukhara (5.0%) and Samarkand (4.6%) regions.

In order to effectively use the state non-residential fund, in January-March 2019, more than 16.8 thousand leases of state property were concluded. As a result, more than 2.6 thousand new jobs were created. From the transfer to lease of state property in general, 36.0 billion soums were received.

In terms of regions, the largest part of revenues from the lease of state property falls on Tashkent city (58.2% of all revenues), Tashkent (6.7%), Khorezm (4.5%), Andijan (4.2%), Samarkand regions(3.5%).
