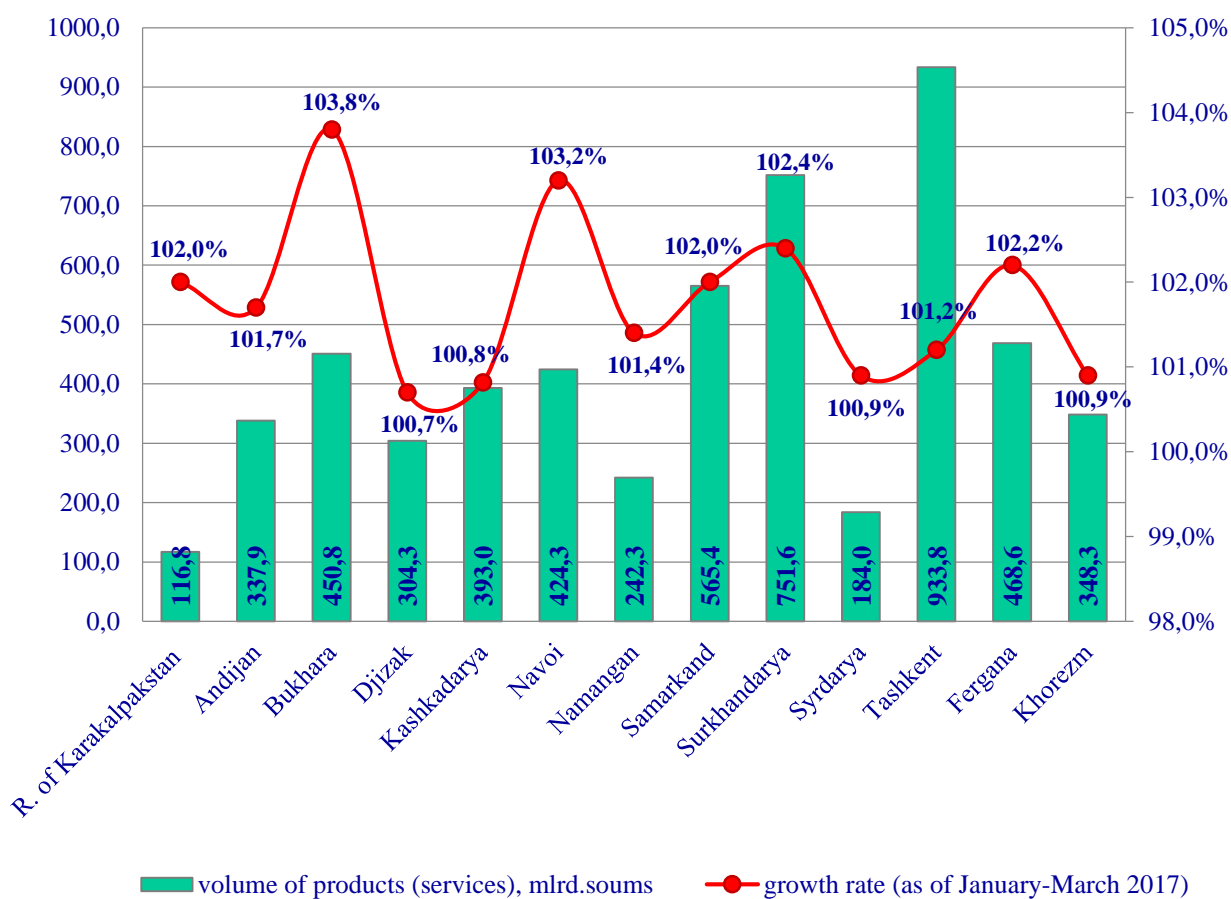


IV. AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHING

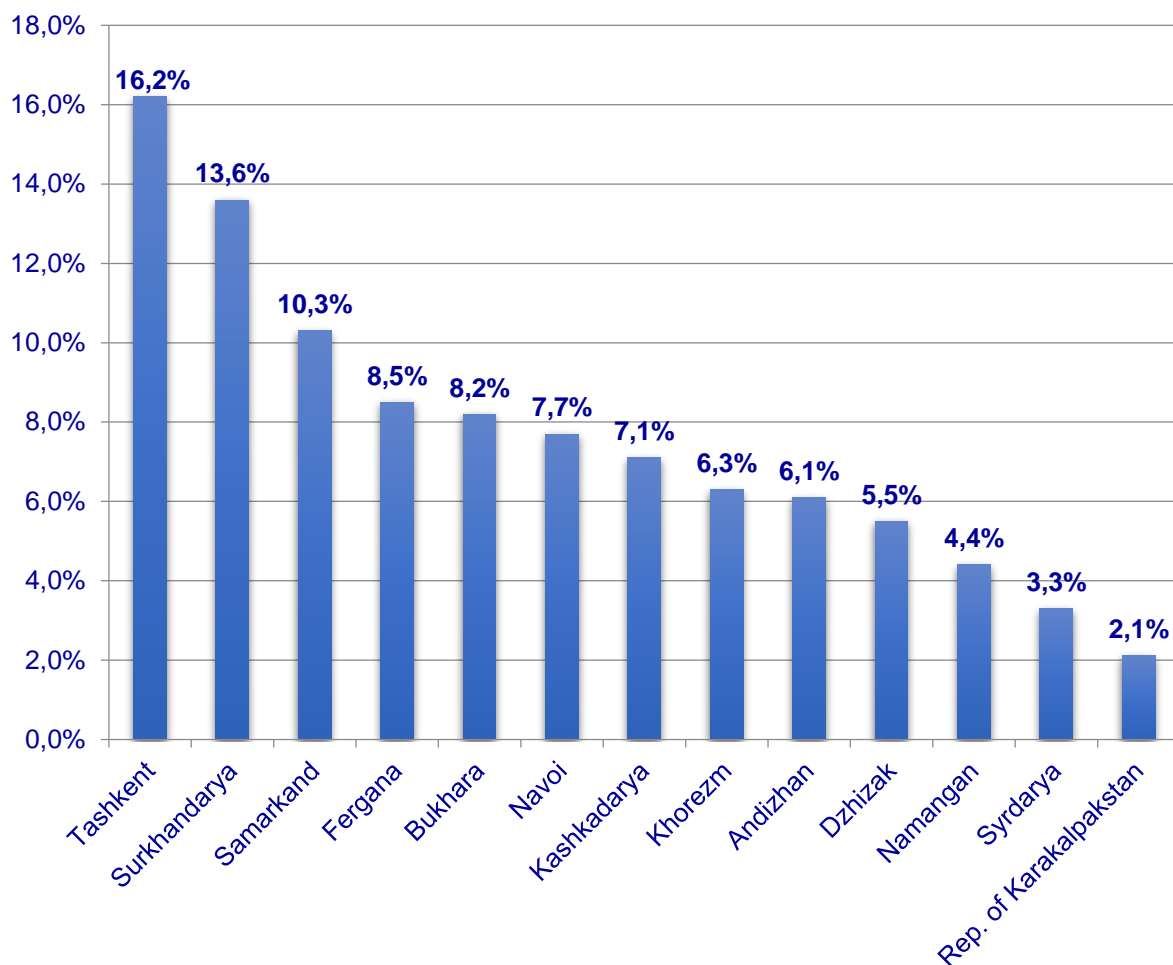
According to preliminary data the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fishing in January-March 2018 was 5 521,1 billion soums or 101,8 percent to the corresponding period of 2017, of which 5 443,2 billion soums (101,8 percent) belong to crop and livestock production, hunting and related services activities, 27,9 billion soums (100,9 percent) - forestry, 50,0 billion soums (105,1 percent) - fishing.

Volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fishing by region



The highest growth rates were observed in Bukhara region (103,8 percent), Navoi region (103,2 percent), Surkhandarya region (102,4 percent) and Fergana region (102,2 percent). In contrast, the low rates were marked in Djizzak region (100,7 percent), Syrdarya region and Khorezm region (100,9 percent).

Share of regions in total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fishing

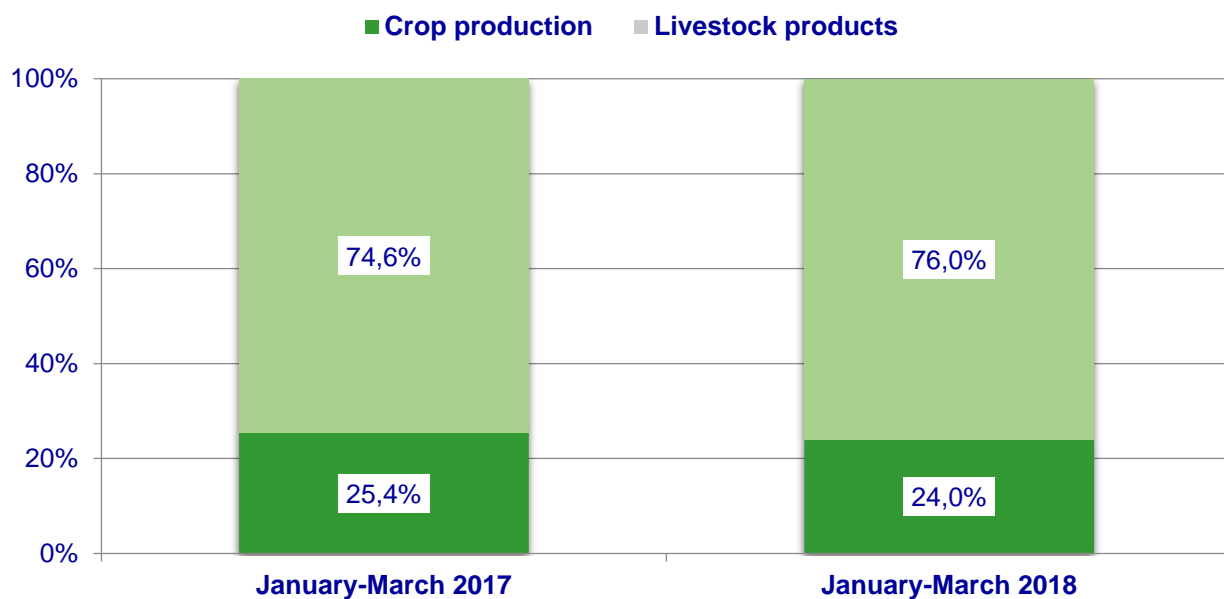


The share of Tashkent region in the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fishing was 16,9 percent and it is a leader among the regions, Surkhandarya region and Samarkand region occupy the following places with 13,6 percent and 10,3 percent respectively. The lowest share is observed in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2,1 percent), Syrdarya region (3,3 percent) and Namangan region (4,4 percent).

Agricultural output

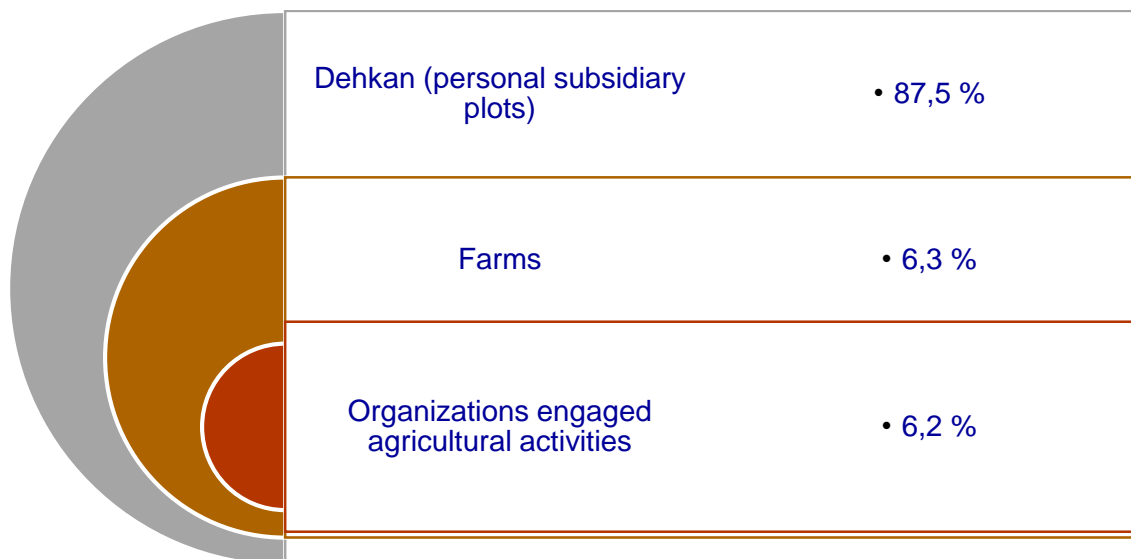
The growth of the total agricultural output in January-March 2018 compared with the corresponding period 2017 amounted to 101,8 percent, including 101,9 percent of crop production and 101,8 percent of livestock production.

Distribution of agricultural production



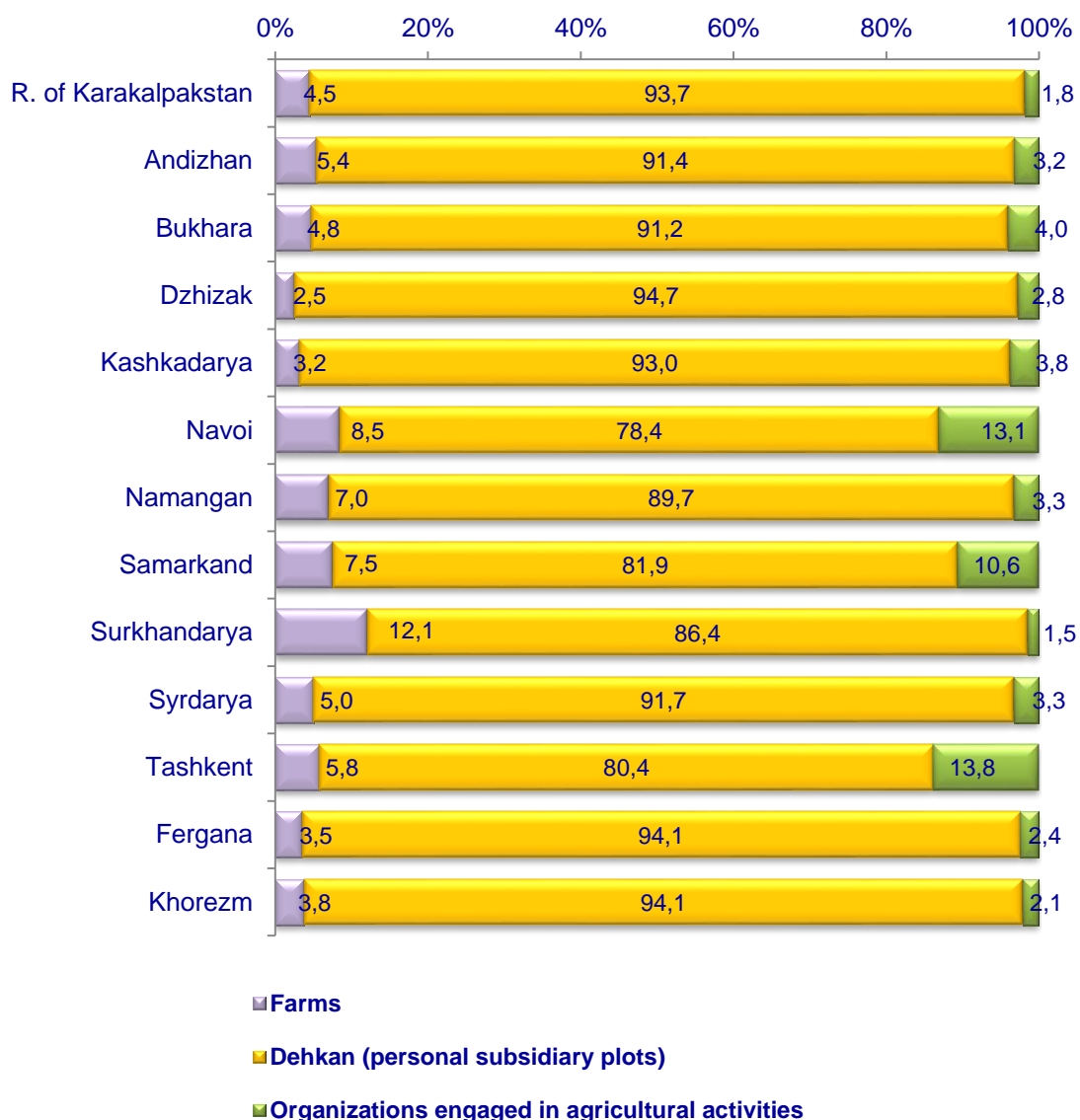
In January-March 2018 in the structure of gross agricultural output the share of livestock production increased to 76,0 percent against 74,6 percent in January-March 2017, and respectively, during the same period the share of crop production decreased to 24,0 percent against 25,4 percent.

Distribution of agricultural production by type of farm



Analysis by type of farm shows that 87,5 percent of total agricultural output falls on dekhkan (private) farms, 6,3 percent - farm enterprises, 6,2 percent - organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Distribution of agricultural production by type of farm and region



When analyzing the distribution of the shares of the gross agricultural output by type of farm and region, it was observed that the highest indicators in all regions fall on dekhkan (private) farms.

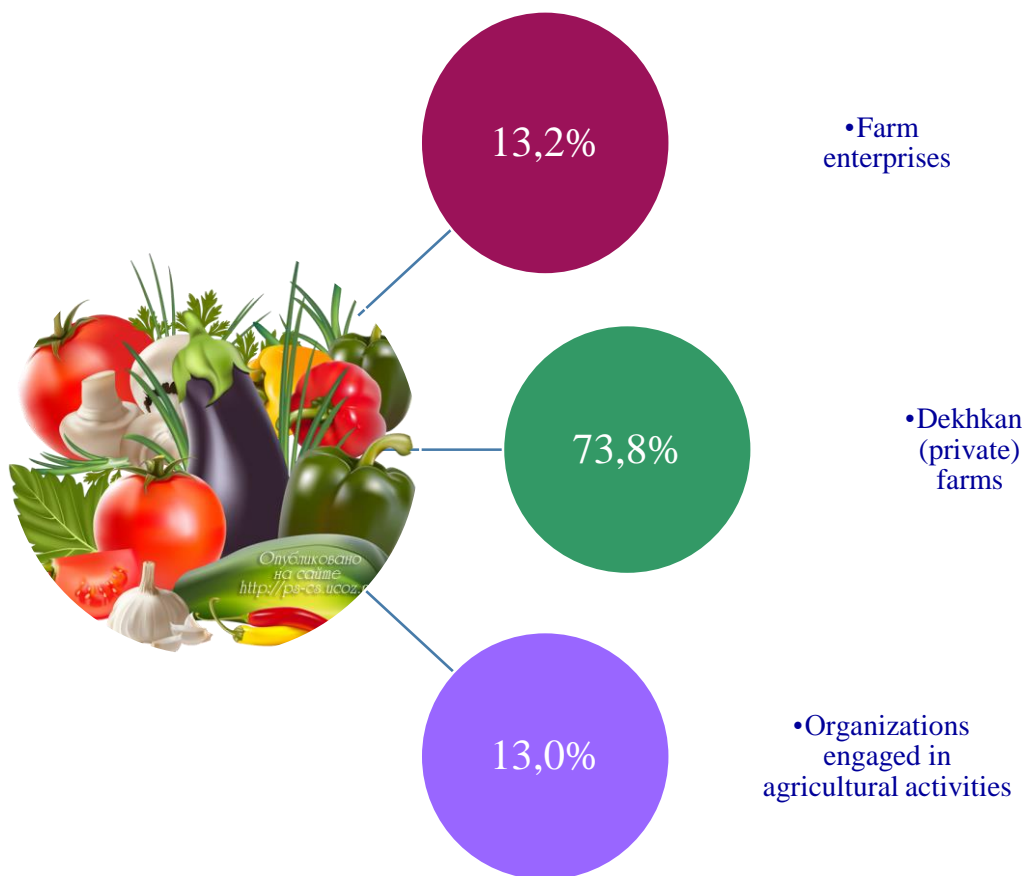
Crop production

The volume of crop production in January-March 2018 was 1 289,8 billion soums, or 101,9 percent to the corresponding period of 2017. The share of crop production in the total agricultural output was 24,0 percent.

Harvesting. In January-March of the current year 56,0 thousand tons of vegetables were harvested by farms of all types (102,2 percent).

Dekhkan (private) farms remain the main producers of vegetables. Analyzing the data on vegetable production by type of farm in January-March 2018 it should be noted that 13,2 percent of vegetable production falls on farm enterprises, 73,8 percent - dekhkan (private) farms, 13,0 percent - organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

Livestock production

The volume of livestock production in January-March 2018 was 4 078,6 billion soums, or 101,8 percent to the corresponding period of 2017. In the total agricultural output the share of livestock production was 76,0 percent.

In January-March 2018 farms of all types produced 440,9 thousand tons of meat in living weight (1,5 percent more than in January-March 2017), 1684,7 thousand tons of milk (2,4 percent), 1236,8 million eggs (2,5 percent), 407,4 thousand pieces of astrakhans (0,9 percent less).

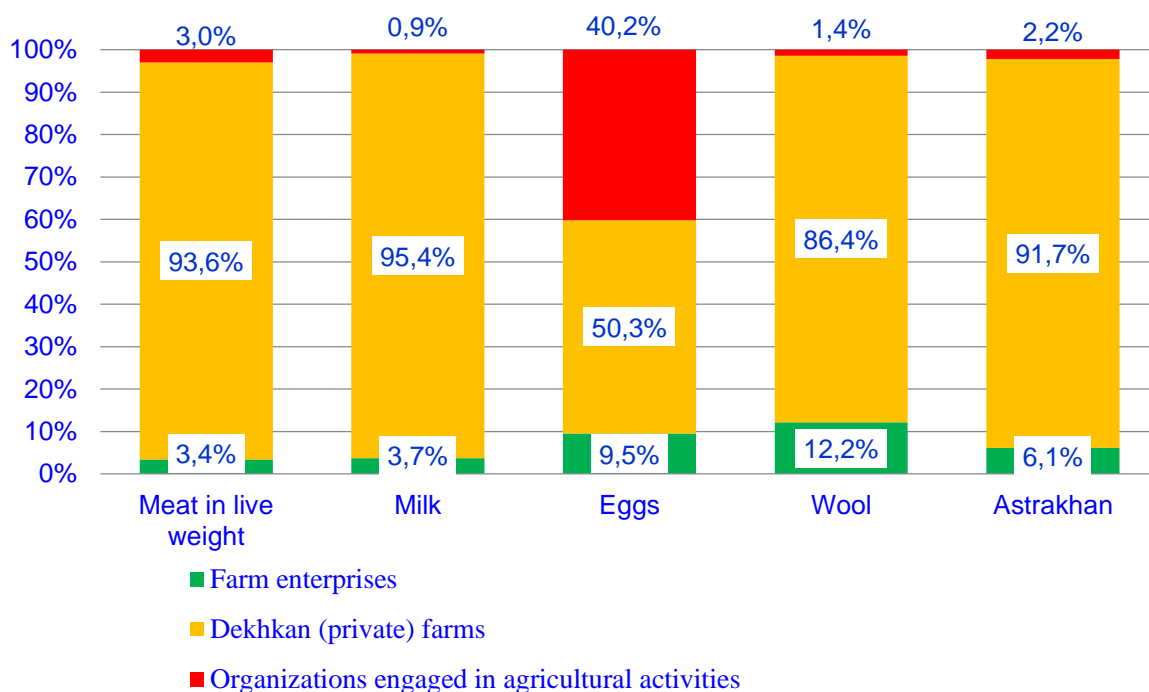

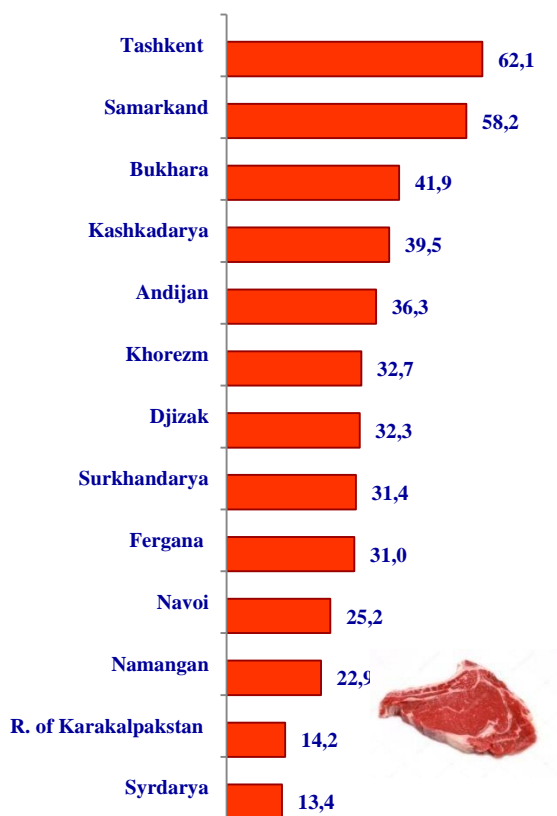

Production of basic livestock products by type of farm

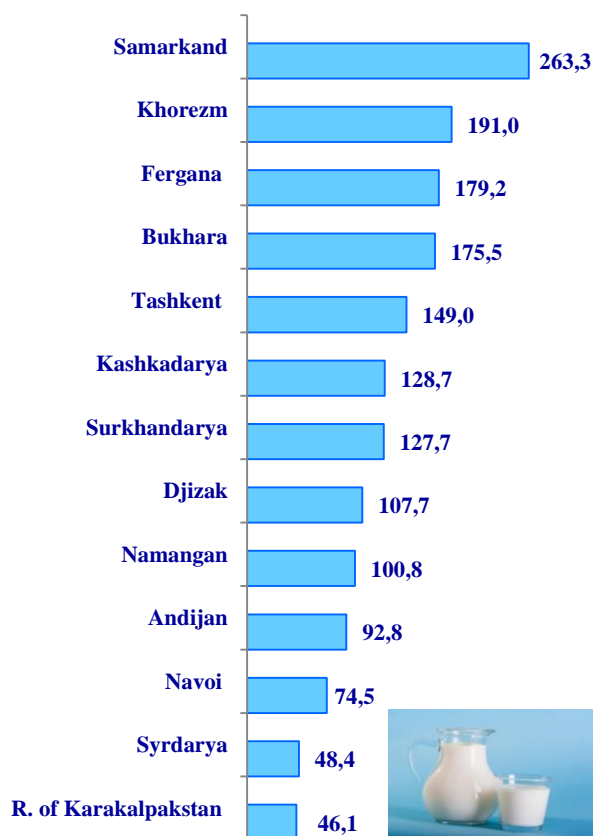


Production of basic livestock and fishing products by region

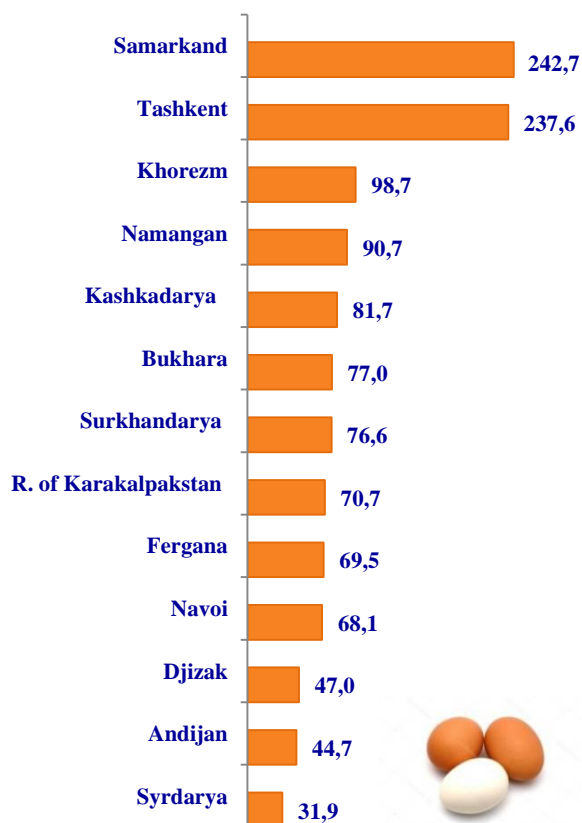
Meat (Thsnd. tons)



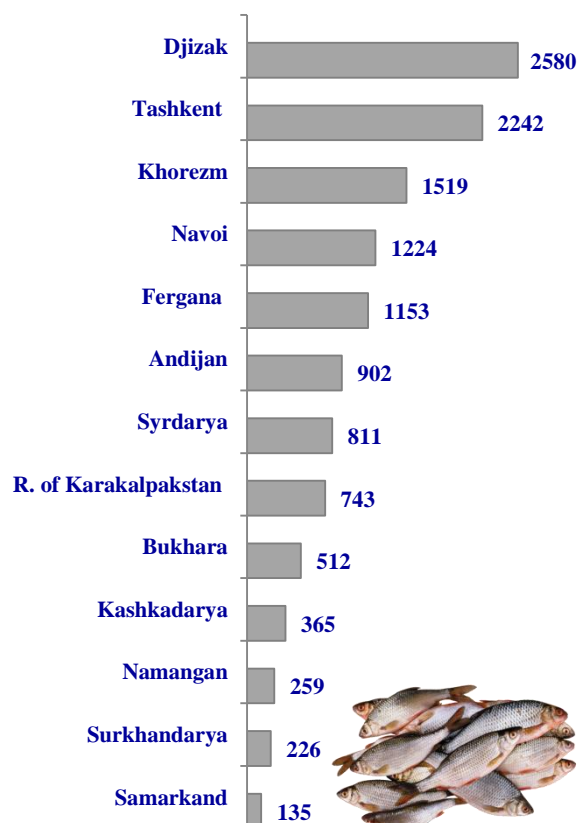
Milk (thsnd.tons)

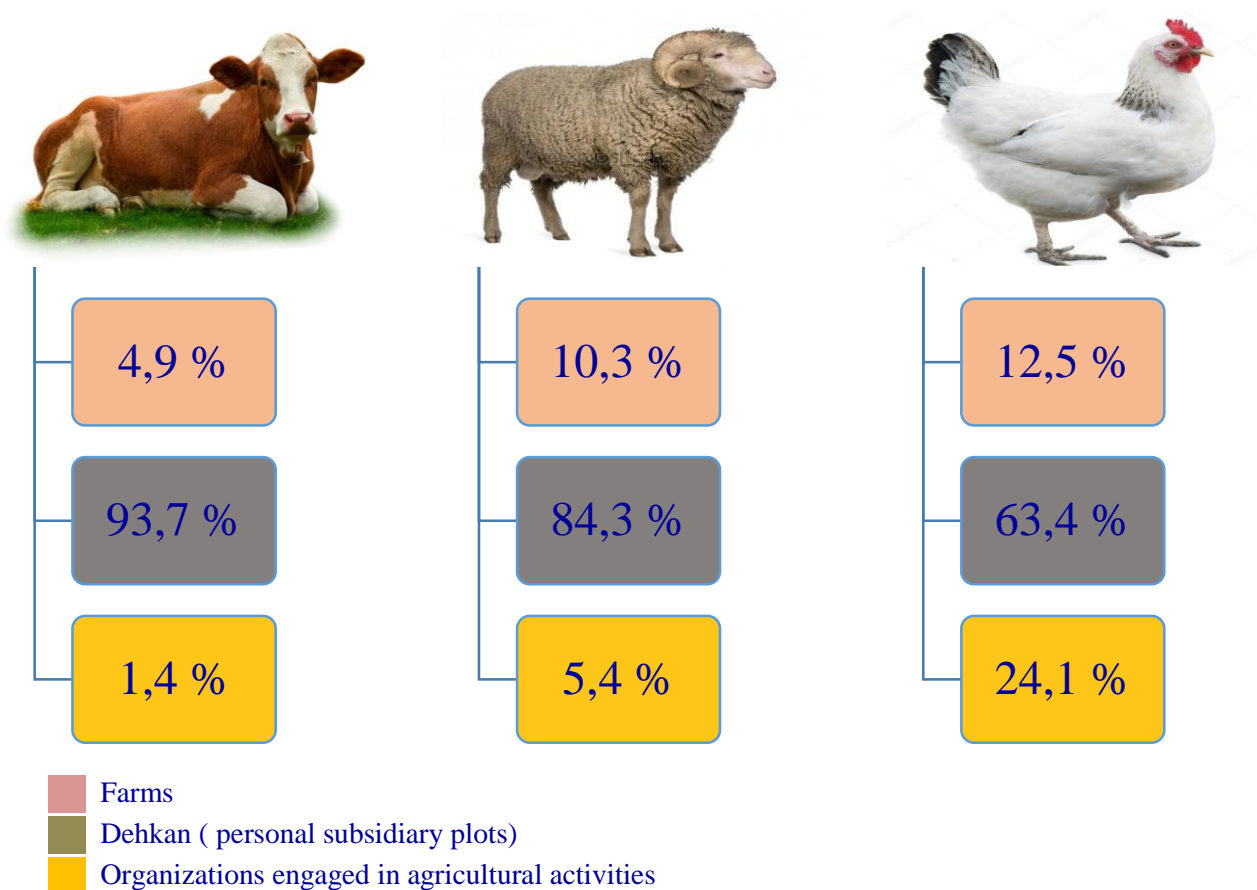

As of April 1, 2018 the total number of cattle reached 12 240,1 thousand, of which 4 300,4 thousand - cows, sheep and goats - 20 427,8 thousand, poultry - 71 122,7 thousand.

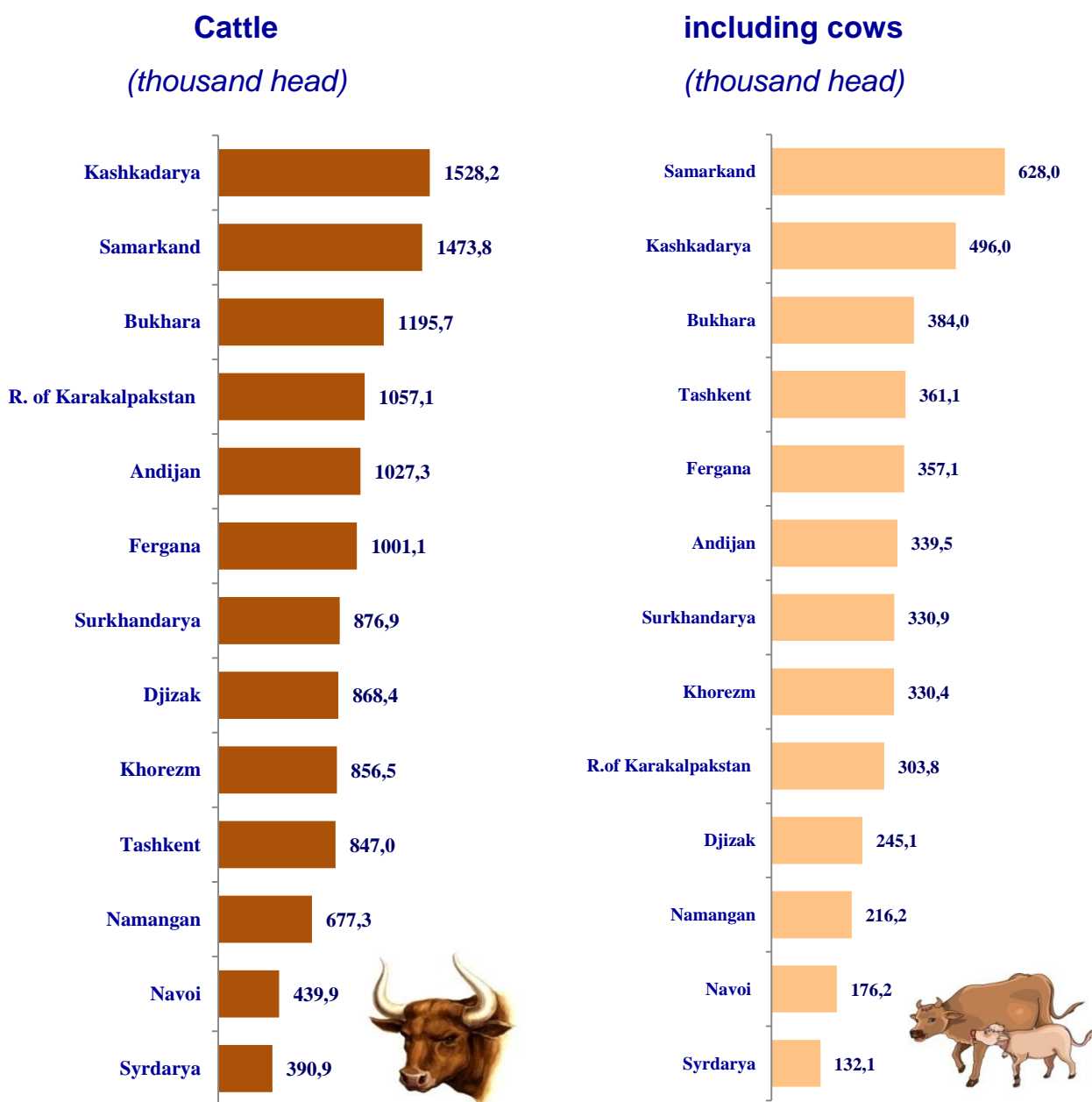
In comparison with the corresponding period of 2017 in farms of all types the number of cattle increased by 281,6 thousand (by 2,4 percent), including cows - by 34,9 thousand (0,8 percent), sheep and goats - by 504,8 thousand (2,5 percent), poultry - by 4 274,1 thousand (6,4 percent).

Share of farms of all types in livestock and poultry number



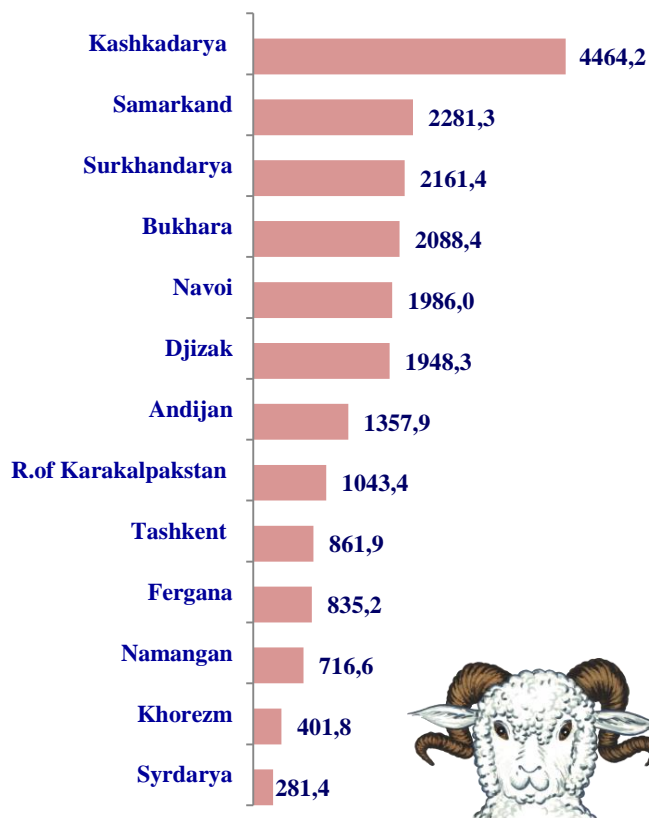
Analyzing the data on the number of cattle by type of farm as of April 1, 2018 it should be noted that 4,9 percent of cattle belong to farm enterprises, 93,7 percent - dekhkan (private) farms, 1,4 percent - organizations engaged in agricultural activities, respectively, from the total number of sheep and goats 10,3 percent belong to farm enterprises, 84,3 percent - dekhkan (private) farms, 5,4 percent - organizations engaged in agricultural activities, from the total number of poultry 12,5 percent belong to farm enterprises, 63,4 percent - dekhkan (private) farms, 24,1 percent - organizations engaged in agricultural activities.
