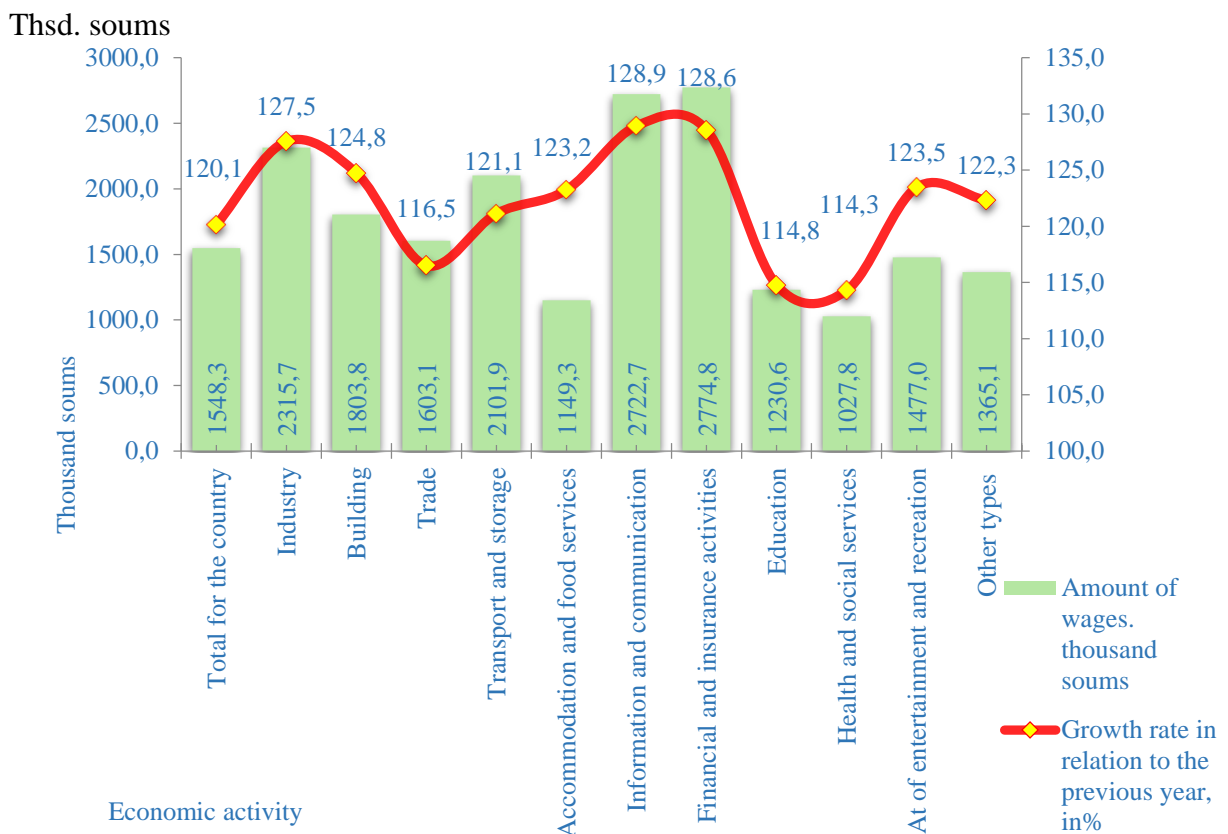


XV. AVERAGE ACCRUED MONTHLY NOMINAL WAGES

Average accrued monthly nominal wages²⁾ of employees for March 2018 was 1640,5 thousand soums¹⁾ and increased compared with March 2017 by 20,5 percent. On average in January-March 2018 the average wage was 1548,3 thousand soums and in comparison with January-March 2017 increased by 20,1 percent.

In comparison with the same period of the previous year the high growth of average wages by economic activity is observed in information and communication (by 28,9 percent), financial and insurance activities (28,6 percent), industry (27,5 percent) and construction (24,8 percent).

The high level of average wages was recorded for such types of economic activity as financial and insurance activity – 2774,8 thousand soums (79,2 percent higher than the average wage in the republic), information and communication – 2722,7 thousand soums (75,9 percent), industry – 2315,7 thousand soums (49,6 percent), transportation and storage – 2101,9 thousand

soums (35,8 percent), construction – 1803,8 thousand soums (16,5 percent) and trade – 1603,1 thousand soums (3,5 percent).

At the regional level the highest average accrued monthly nominal wage was registered in Tashkent city – 2129,9 thousand soums (1,4 times higher than the average national indicator) and Navoi region – 2118,8 thousand soums (1,4 times higher than the average national indicator).

The lowest level of the average accrued monthly nominal wages was observed in Namangan region (1223,9 thousand soums), Samarkand region (1234,8 thousand soums) and Surkhandarya region (1266,7 thousand soums). The average accrued monthly nominal wages in these regions was below the average national level by 21,0 percent, 20,2 percent and 18,2 percent respectively.
