


XVII. OFFENSES

According to the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the total number of recorded crimes for January-March 2018 was 9620 cases and, compared to 2017, the corresponding period, decreased by 40.9%. Based on 10.0 thousand of population, this number was 3.0.


The comparative state of criminality across all lines of services in terms of the severity of the crimes committed

In terms of severity in the Republic of Uzbekistan, there has been a decrease in particularly serious crimes from 657 cases in January-March 2017 to 455 cases in the corresponding period of 2018 (by 30.7%). For serious crimes, there has also been a decrease from 1,833 cases in January-March 2017 to 1,417 cases in 2018 of the corresponding period (by 22.7%). Compared with the corresponding period in 2017 (6,036 cases), the number of less serious crimes amounted to 3,388 cases in January-March 2018 (decreased by 43.9%)

The number of rapes and attempts to rape (by 69.7%), robberies (by 62.3%), theft by misappropriation or waste (by 51.6%), bribes (by 51.3%), robbery (by 49 , 4%), hooliganism (46.3%), fraud (43.9%), crimes against the foundations of the economy, economic activity, against the functioning of government bodies (by 39.6%), crimes related to illegal drug trafficking (by 27.0%), premeditated murders and attempts at murder (by 13.0%), deliberate grievous bodily harm (by 12.0%),.


Also, the number of thefts from apartments was reduced (by 44.8%), thefts from shops and other outlets (by 47.5%), bicycle and moped burglaries - by 58.8%.

In the first quarter of 2018, in all regions of Uzbekistan, in comparison with January-March 2017, there was a decrease in the number of crimes: in the Syrdarya (51.0%), Tashkent (by 48.5%), Kashkadarya (by 48.0%), Bukhara (47.2%), Khorezm (42.8%), Fergana (40.0%), Surkhandarya (38.1%), Navoi (34.9%), Andijan 34.8%), Samarkand (34.3%), Jizzakh (30.7%), Namangan (19.6%), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (49.6%) and Tashkent city (41 , 3%).



The total number of identified individuals who committed crimes was 11,347 and, compared to the corresponding period in 2017, decreased by 38.9%. Of these, 8,966 were prosecuted.

In the sex distribution, the number of identified individuals who committed crimes decreased among women (by 44.2%) and men (by 38.1%).

On employment at the time of the crime, the number of persons who committed crimes among able-bodied, unemployed and not pupils (by 44.7%), students of general and specialized secondary schools, vocational educational institutions (by 40.0%) decreased..

Among all categories of persons who committed crimes, the number of minors (by 41%), who committed crimes in the group (by 38.2%), persons who had committed crimes (by 34.2%), in a state of intoxication (by 31, 3%).
