

## AVERAGE ACCRUED MONTHLY NOMINAL WAGES

Average accrued monthly nominal wages<sup>2)</sup> of employees for June 2018 was 1753,3 thousand soums and increased compared with June 2017 by 23,4 percent. On average in January-June 2018 the average wage was 1609,1 thousand soums and in comparison with January-June 2017 increased by 21,4 percent.

In comparison with the same period of the previous year the high growth of average wages by economic activity is observed in information and communication (by 32,9 percent), industry (30,2 percent), construction (26,4 percent), financial and insurance activities (25,4 percent).

The high level of average wages was recorded for such types of economic activity as financial and insurance activity – 3054,9 thousand soums (89,9 percent higher than the average wage in the republic), information and communication – 3030,1 thousand soums (88,3 percent), industry – 2443,6 thousand soums (51,9 percent), transportation and storage – 2148,3 thousand soums (33,5 percent), construction – 1953,1 thousand soums (21,4 percent).

At the regional level the highest average accrued monthly nominal wage was registered in Tashkent city – 2252,1 thousand soums (1,4 times higher than the average national indicator) and Navoi region – 2153,0 thousand soums (1,3).

The lowest level of the average accrued monthly nominal wages was observed in Namangan region (1263,3 thousand soums), Samarkand region (1273,6 thousand soums) and Surkhandarya region (1314,9 thousand soums). The average accrued monthly nominal wage in these regions was below the average national level by 21,5 percent, 20,8 percent and 18,3 percent respectively.
