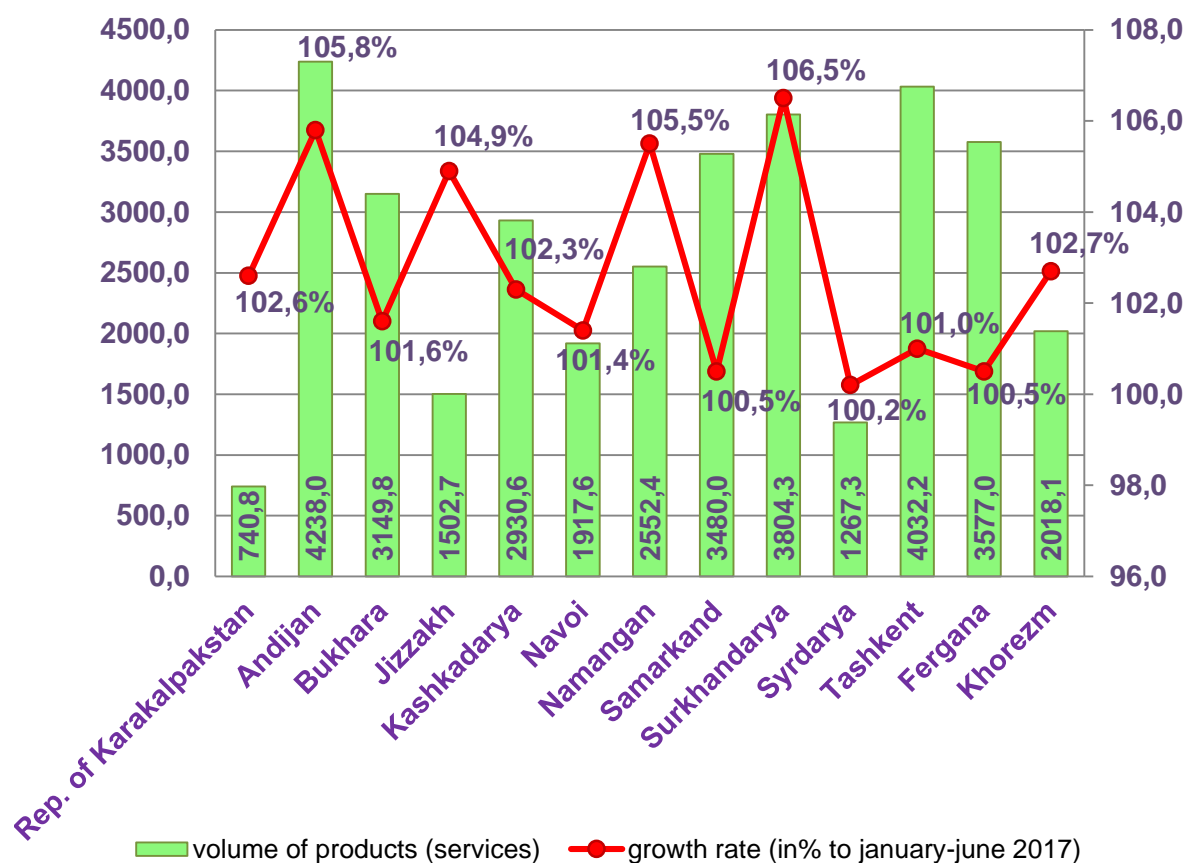


AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES

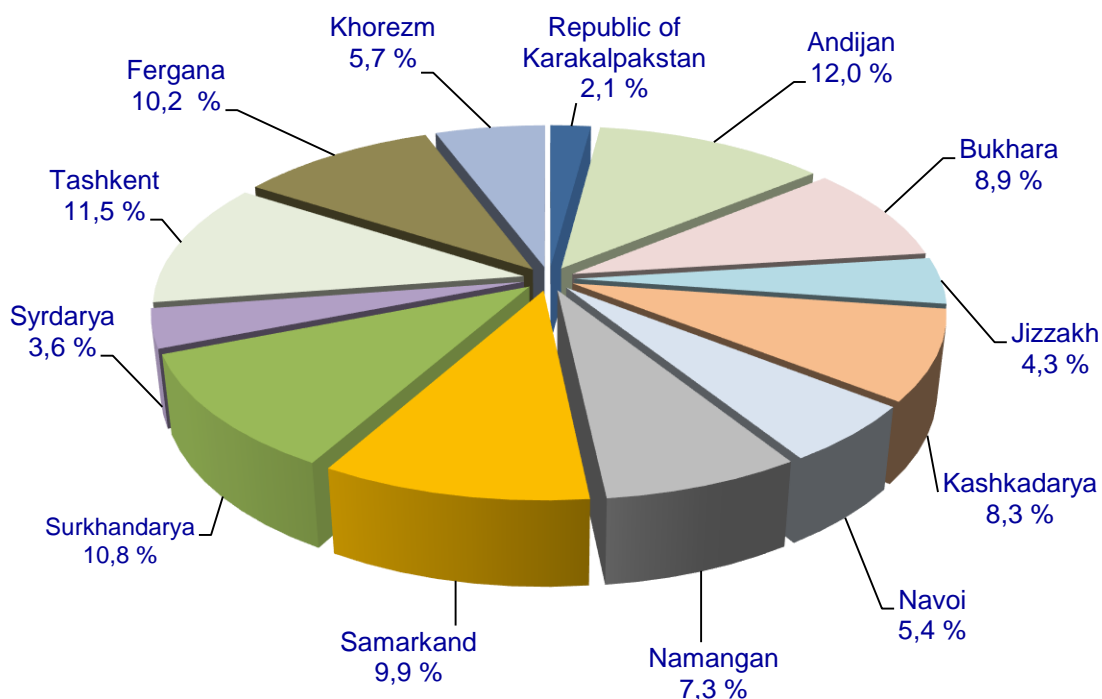
According to preliminary data, the total volume of products (services) of agriculture, forestry and fisheries in January-June of 2018 amounted to 35,210.8 billion soums, or 102.7% of the corresponding period in 2017, including in crop production and livestock, hunting and provision of services in these areas - 35,012.3 billion soums (102.7%), in forestry - 58.7 billion soums (100.7%), fisheries - 139.8 billion soums (130, 2%).

The highest growth rates were observed in Surkhandarya (106.5%), Andijan (105.8%), Namangan (105.5%) and Jizzakh (104.9%) regions. In contrast, the Syrdarya (100.2%), Samarkand and Fergana (100.5%) oblasts experienced low rates.

The share of regions in the total volume of products (services) agriculture, forestry and fisheries

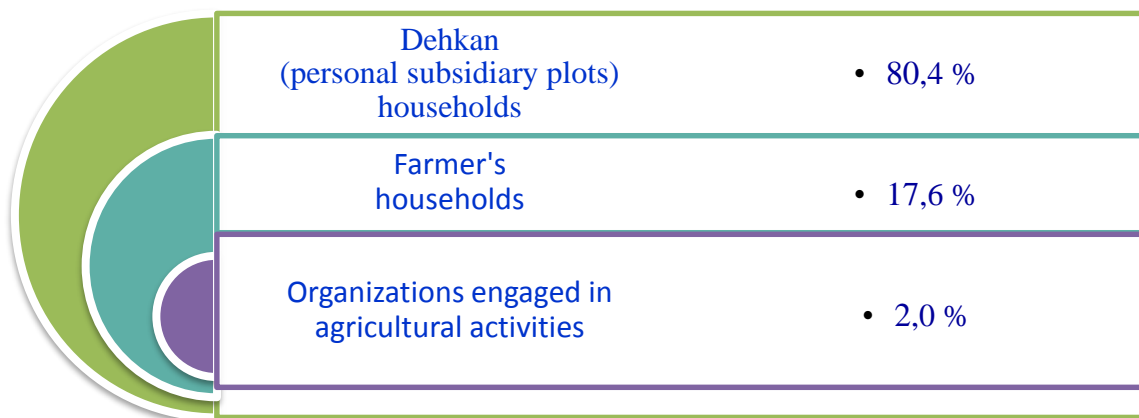


The share of Andijan region in the total volume of products (services) of the country's agriculture, forestry and fisheries was 12.0% and is in the lead among the regions, the Tashkent and Surkhandarya regions occupy the following places with indicators of 11.5% and 10.8% respectively. The lowest share is recorded in the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2.1%), Syrdarya (3.6%) and Jjizakn (4.3%) regions.

Agricultural products

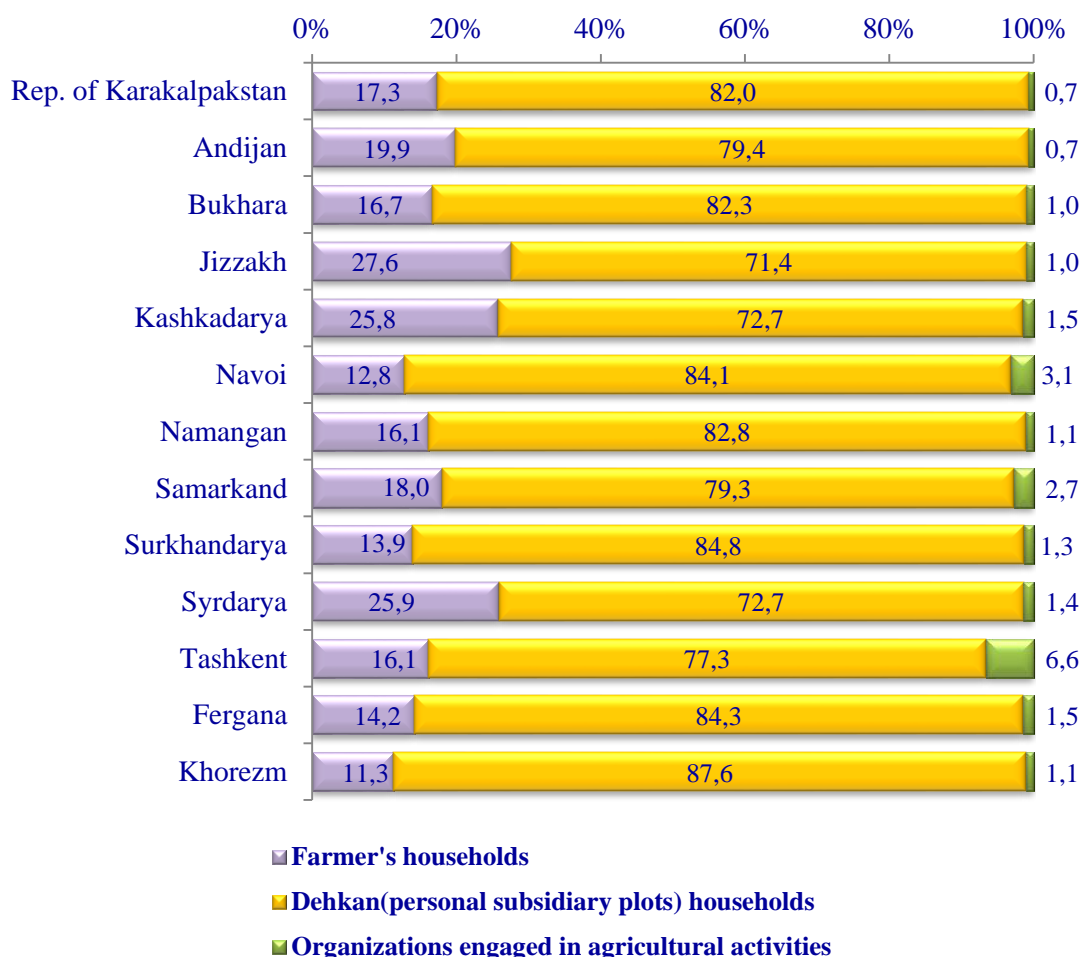
Growth in agricultural production in January-June 2018, compared with the corresponding period of 2017, was 102.7%, including crop production - 101.1%, livestock products - 105.4%.

Distribution of production agriculture by categories of farms



The analysis by categories of farms showed that 80.4% of the total volume of agricultural production falls on dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms, 17.6% - on farms, 2.0% - on organizations engaged in agricultural activities.

When analyzing the distribution of the shares of the gross output of agriculture by categories of farms in the context of the territories, it was observed that the highest indicators in all regions fall on dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms.

Crop production

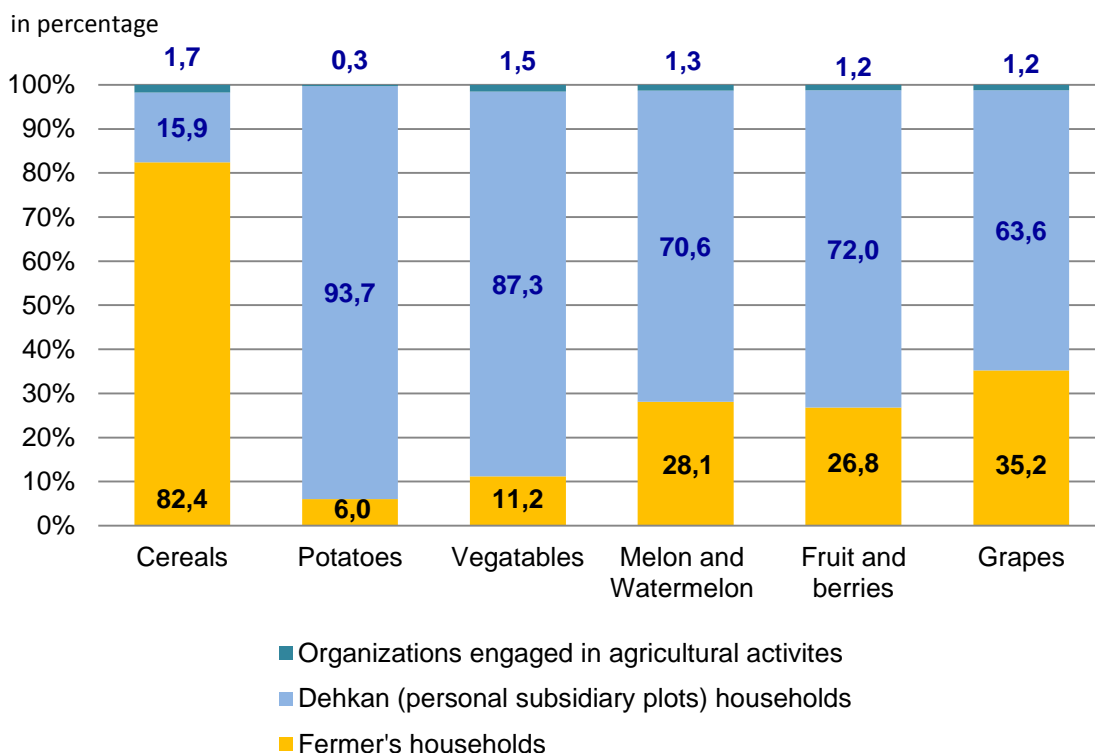
The volume of production of plant growing in January-June 2018 was 21 242.8 billion soums, or 101.1% of the corresponding period in 2017. The share of crop production in the total volume of agricultural production was 61.5%.

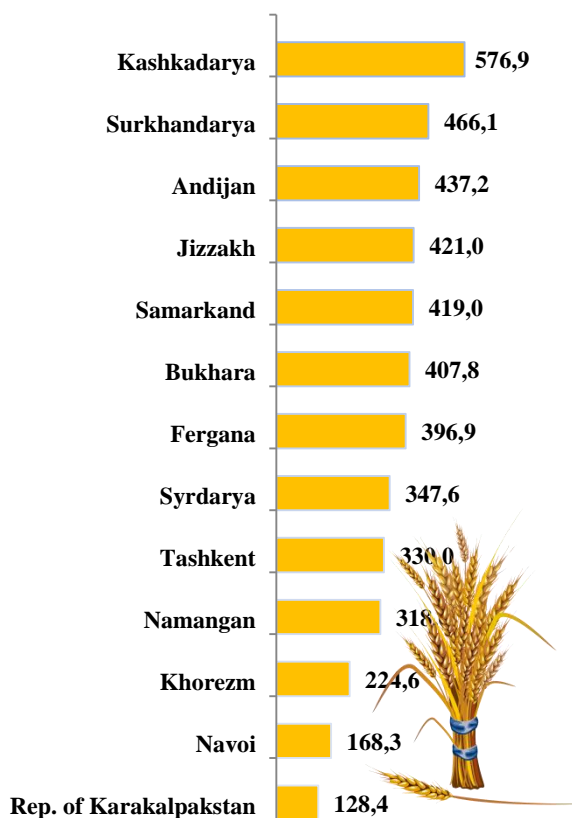
Harvest. In January-June of this year, 4 642.4 thousand tonnes (85.9%) of grain crops were produced by all types of farms, 1 485.9 thousand tonnes (105.3%) of potatoes were harvested, 3 140 vegetables were harvested, 1 thousand tons (104.7%), melons - 215.4 thousand tons (112.6%), fruit and berries - 934.6 thousand tons (100.5%), grapes - 41.6 thousand tons .t (149.2%).

Share of farm categories in production main types of crop production

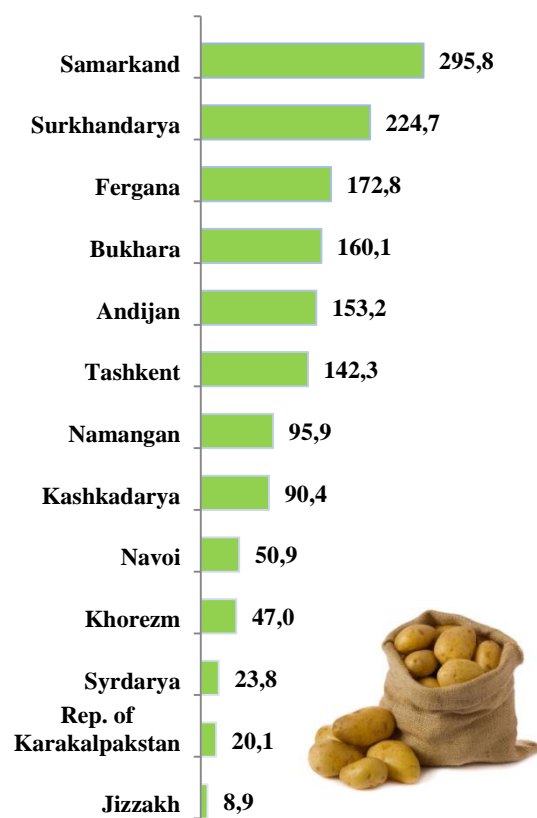


Production of the main types of crop production by regions for January-June 2018

Cereals (thousand tons)

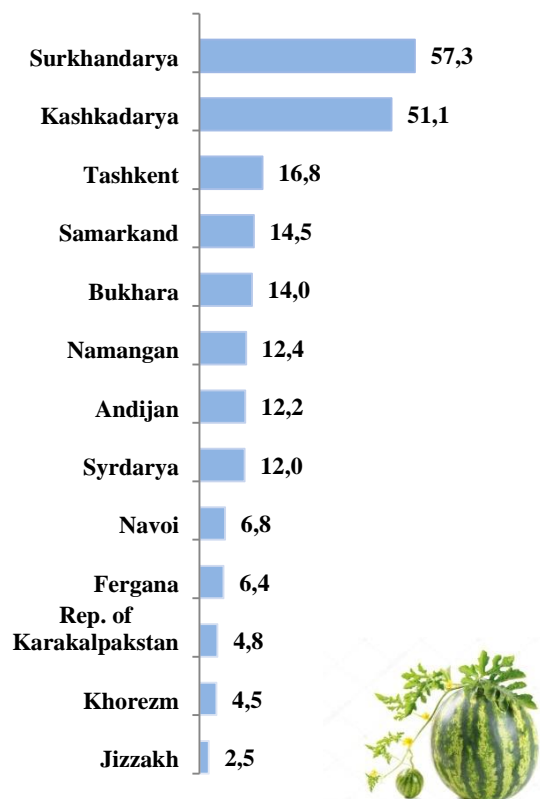
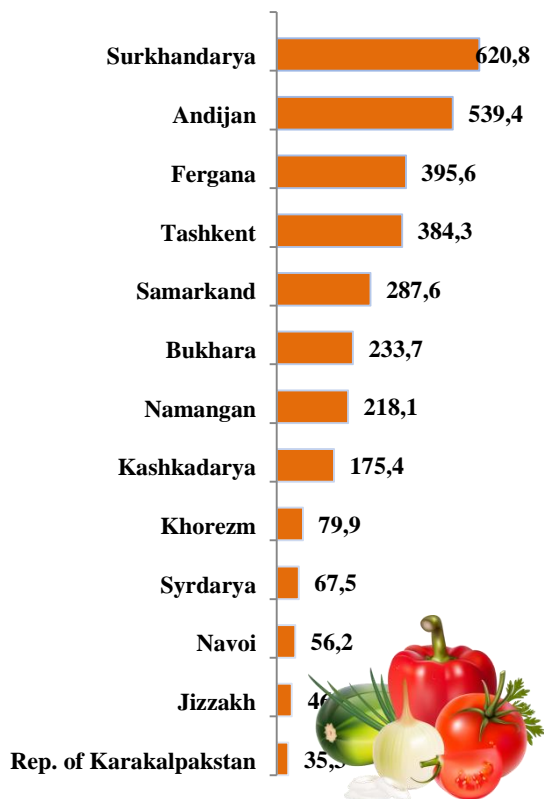


Potatoes (thousand tons)

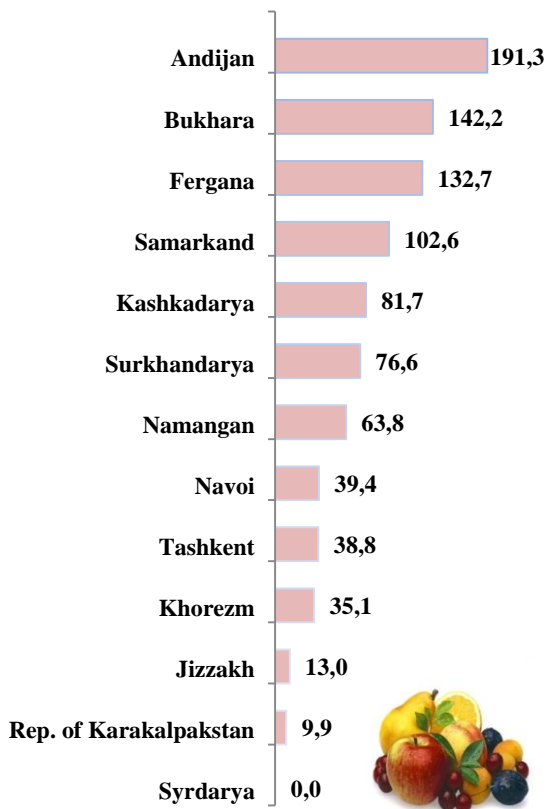


Vegetables (thousand tons)

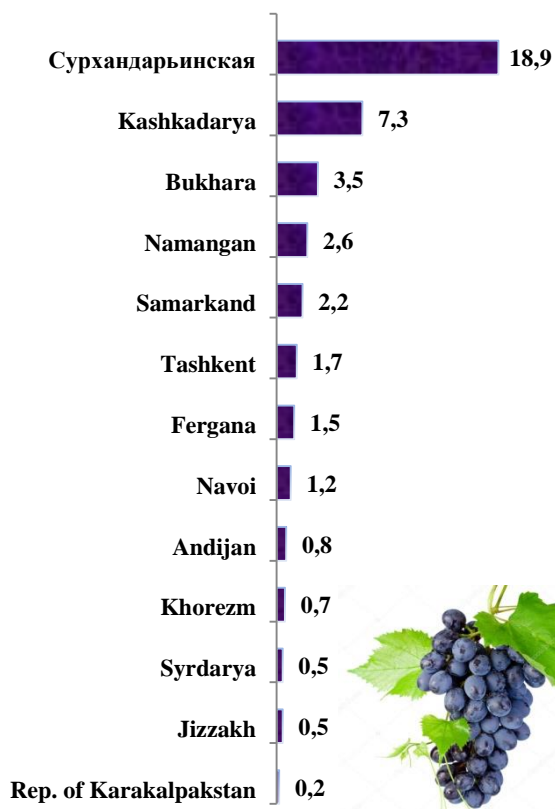

Livestock

The volume of production of livestock products in January-June of 2018 amounted to 13 289.8 billion soums, or 105.4% of the corresponding period in 2017. In the total volume of agricultural production, the share of livestock products amounted to 38.5%.

In January-June, 2018, all categories of farms were produced 1 133.9 thousand tonnes of meat in live weight (5.3% more than in January-June 2017), 4 741.7 thousand tonnes of milk (5.4%), 3,554.9 million units. eggs (by 9.6%), 19,9 thousand tons of wool (by 0,6%).

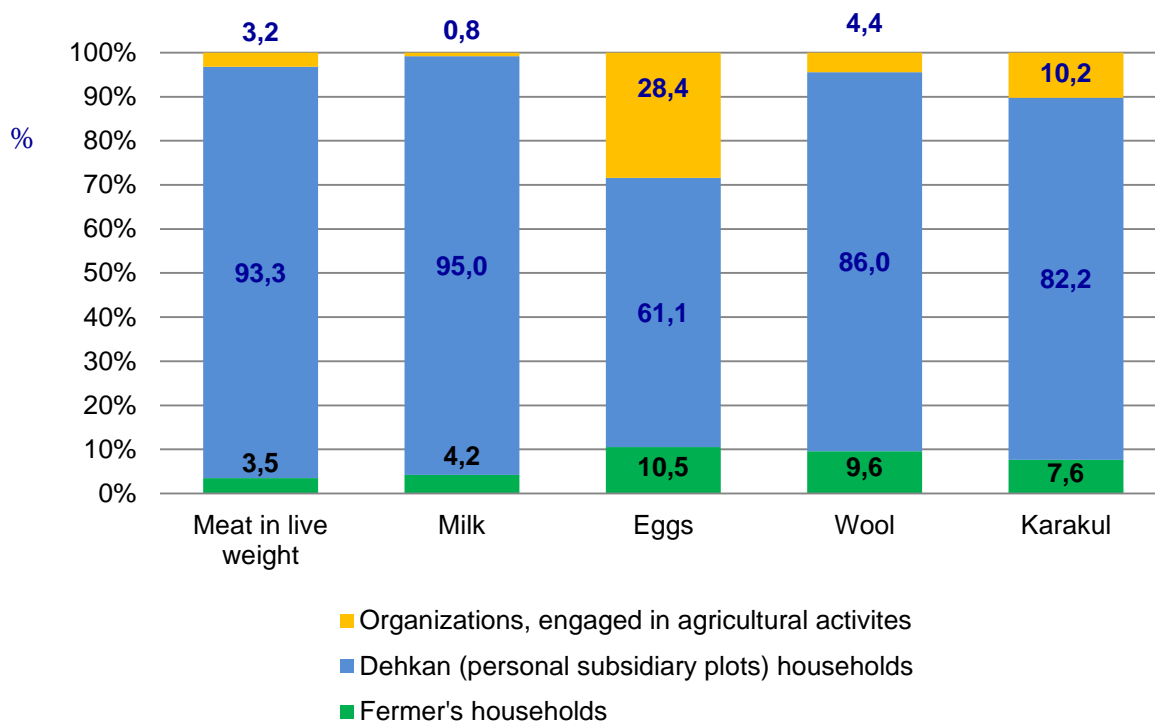

Analyzing the indicators of production of livestock products by categories of farms, it should be noted that 93.3% of the total volume of meat in live weight falls on dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms, as well as 95.0% of milk, 61.1% of eggs, 86.0% of wool, 82, 2% of scribble also occur on the share of dehkan (personal subsidiary) holdings.

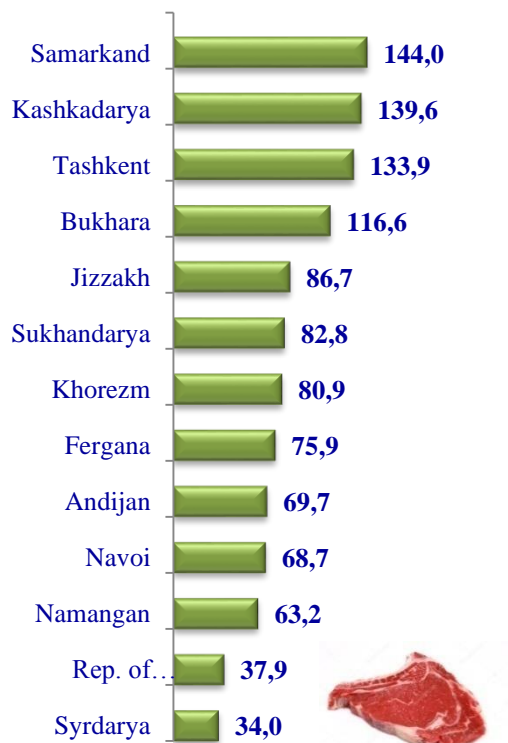
Share of farm categories in production main types of livestock products

in percentage

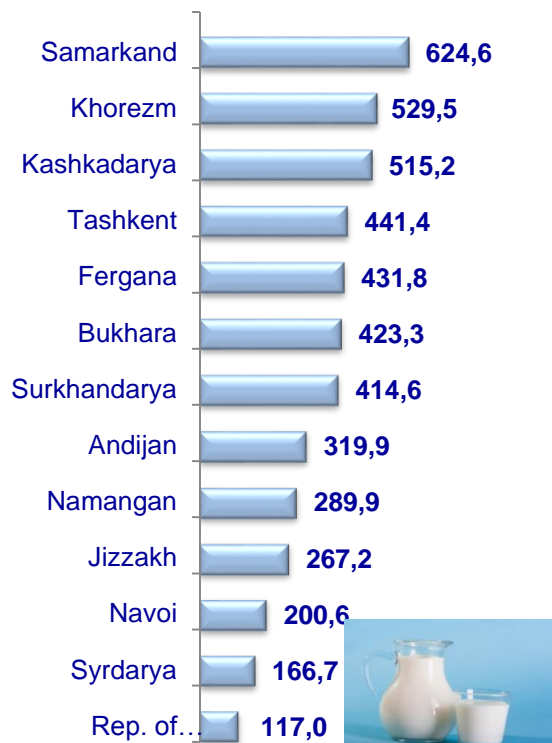


Production of the main types of livestock and fish products in the context of the regions

Meat (thousand tons)

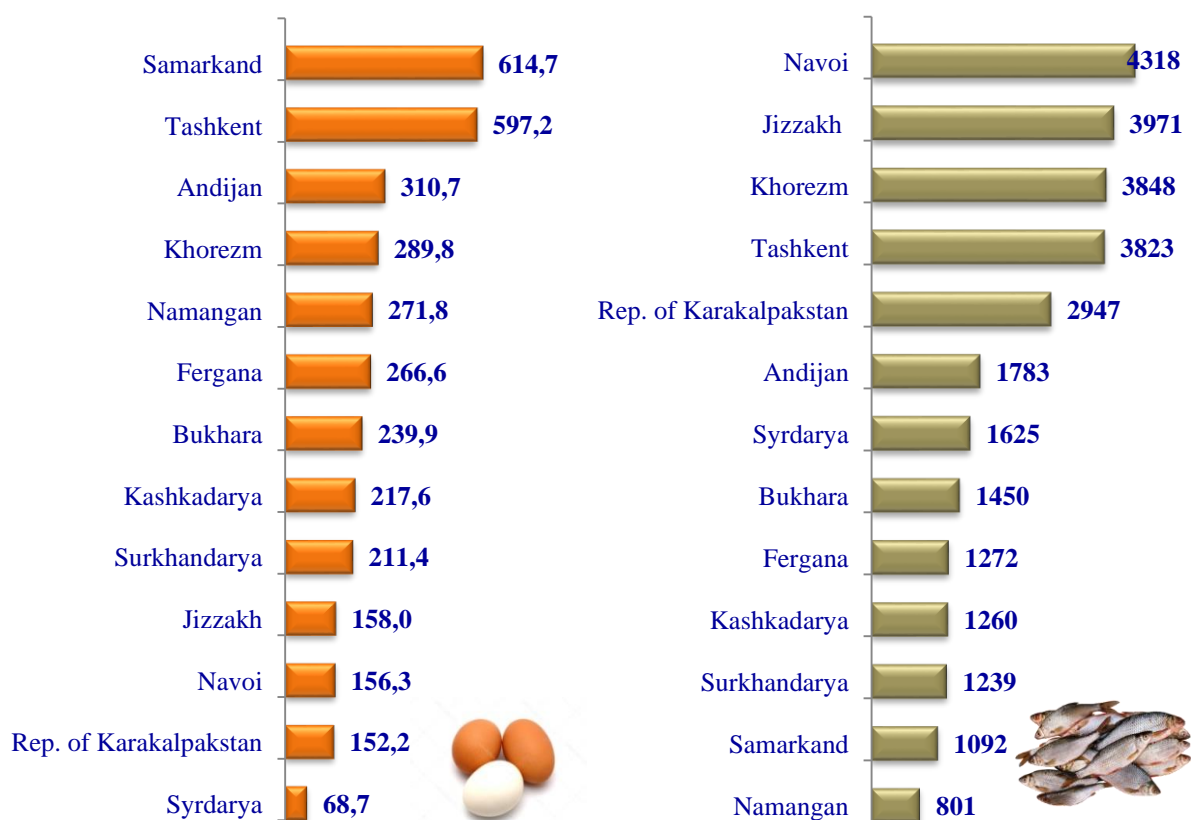


Milk (thousand tons)

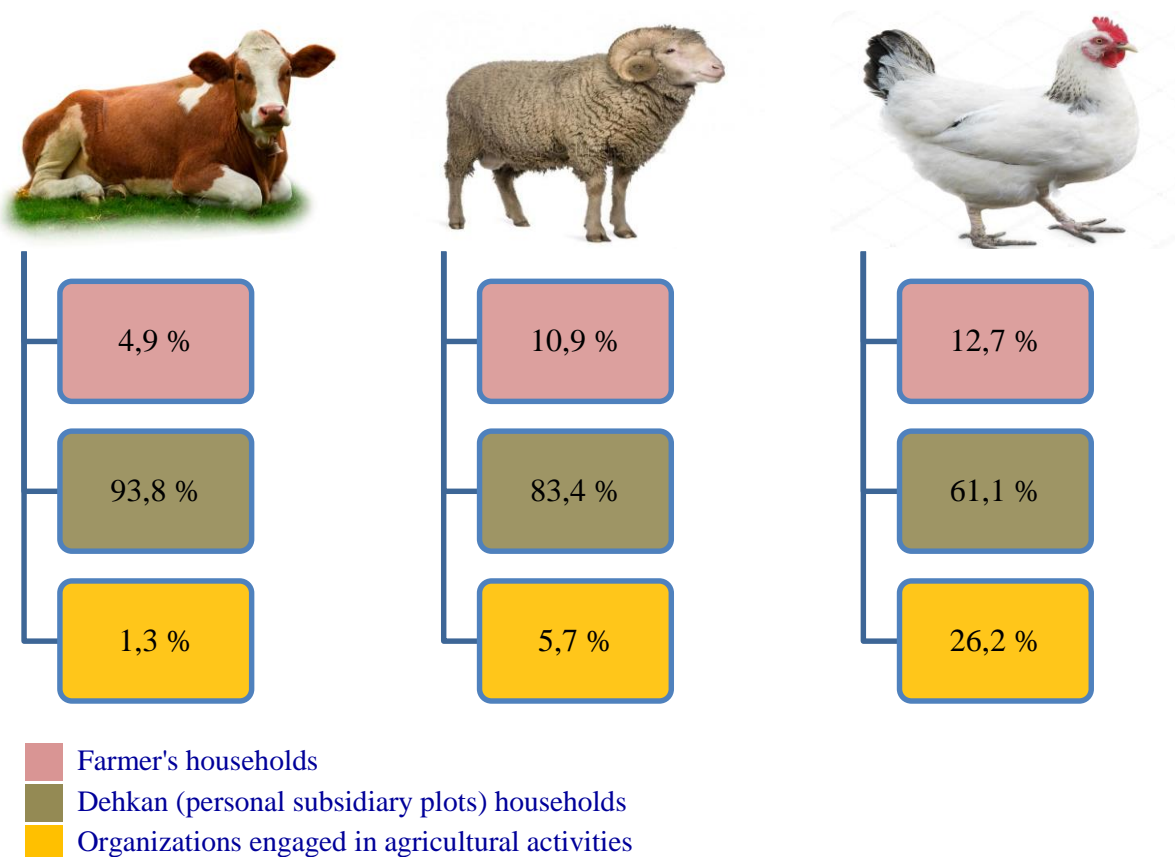

As of July 1, 2018, the total number of cattle reached 12,282.4 thousand heads, including cows - 4,408.3 thousand heads, sheep and goats - 21 050.6 thousand head, birds - 74 203.7 thousand head.

In comparison with the corresponding period of 2017, in all categories of farms the number of cattle increased by 106.9 thousand head (by 0.9%), including cows - by 70.3 thousand head (by 1.6%), sheep and goats - by 662.1 thousand head (by 3.2%), birds - by 5 296,9 thousand head (by 7,7%).

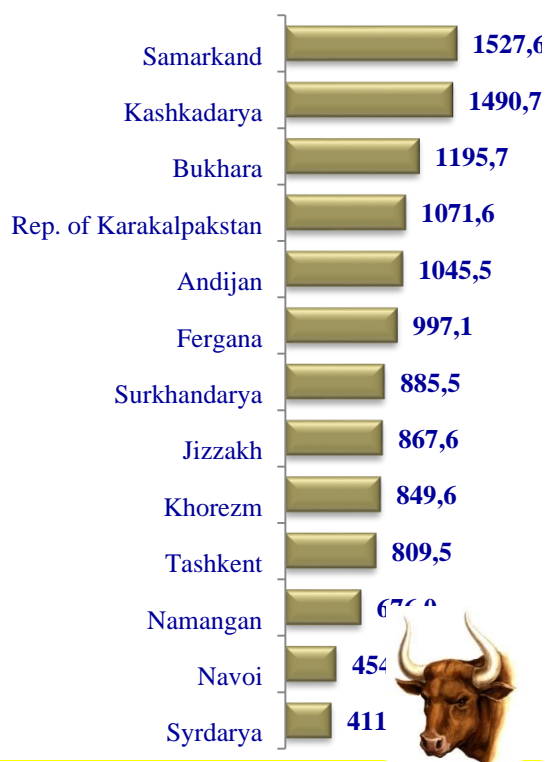
Share of farm categories in livestock and poultry



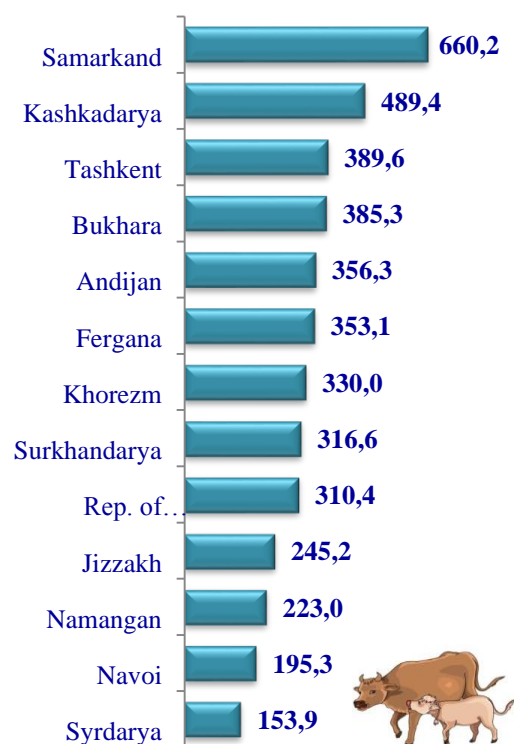
Analyzing data on the number of cattle by farm categories as of July 1, 2018, it should be noted that 4.9% of cattle fall on farms, 93.8% in dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms, 1.3% the organizations that carry out agricultural activities, respectively, of the total number of sheep and goats on farms account for 10.9%, for dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms - 83.4%, for organizations engaged in agricultural activities - 5.7%, and also of the total number of birds per 12.7% in the economy, 61.1% in dehkan (personal subsidiary) farms, 26.2% in organizations engaged in agricultural activities – 26,2 %.

Livestock and poultry by regions on July 1, 2018

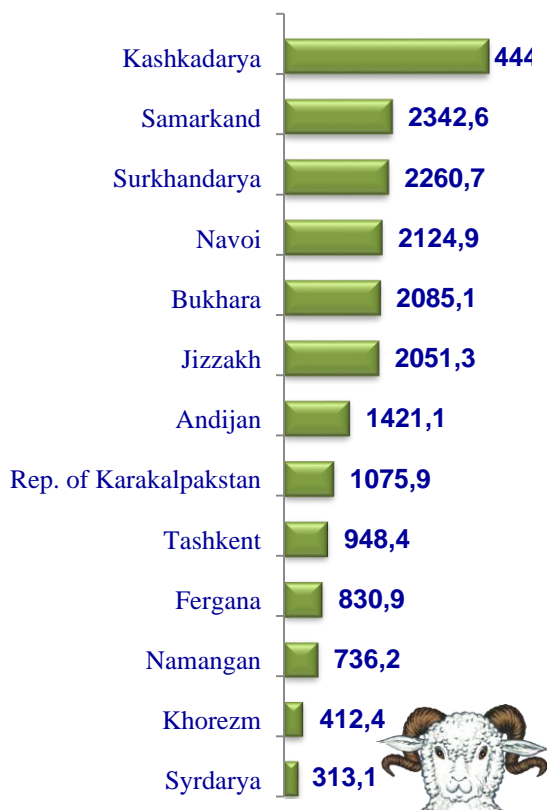
Cattle (thousand head)
