

## FOREIGN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

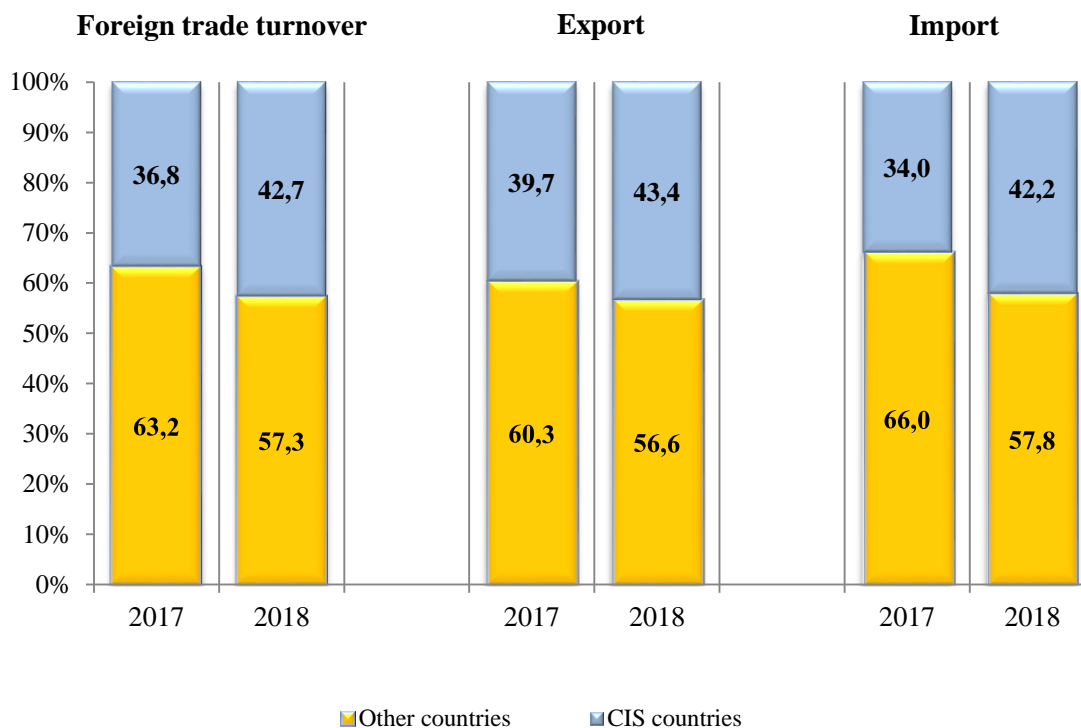
In January-June 2018 the republic's foreign trade turnover was USD 17688,6 million, of which US dollars 7793,7 million - exports, US dollars 9894,9 million - imports.

The balance of foreign trade was minus US dollars 2101,2 million of which minus US dollars 796,3 million with CIS countries and minus US dollars 1304,9 million with non-CIS countries.

Foreign trade operations of the residents of the republic are mainly carried out with the countries of Asia (42,5 percent of total trade turnover), Europe (35,9 percent) and America (1,6 percent), which share is 80,0 percent of total turnover.

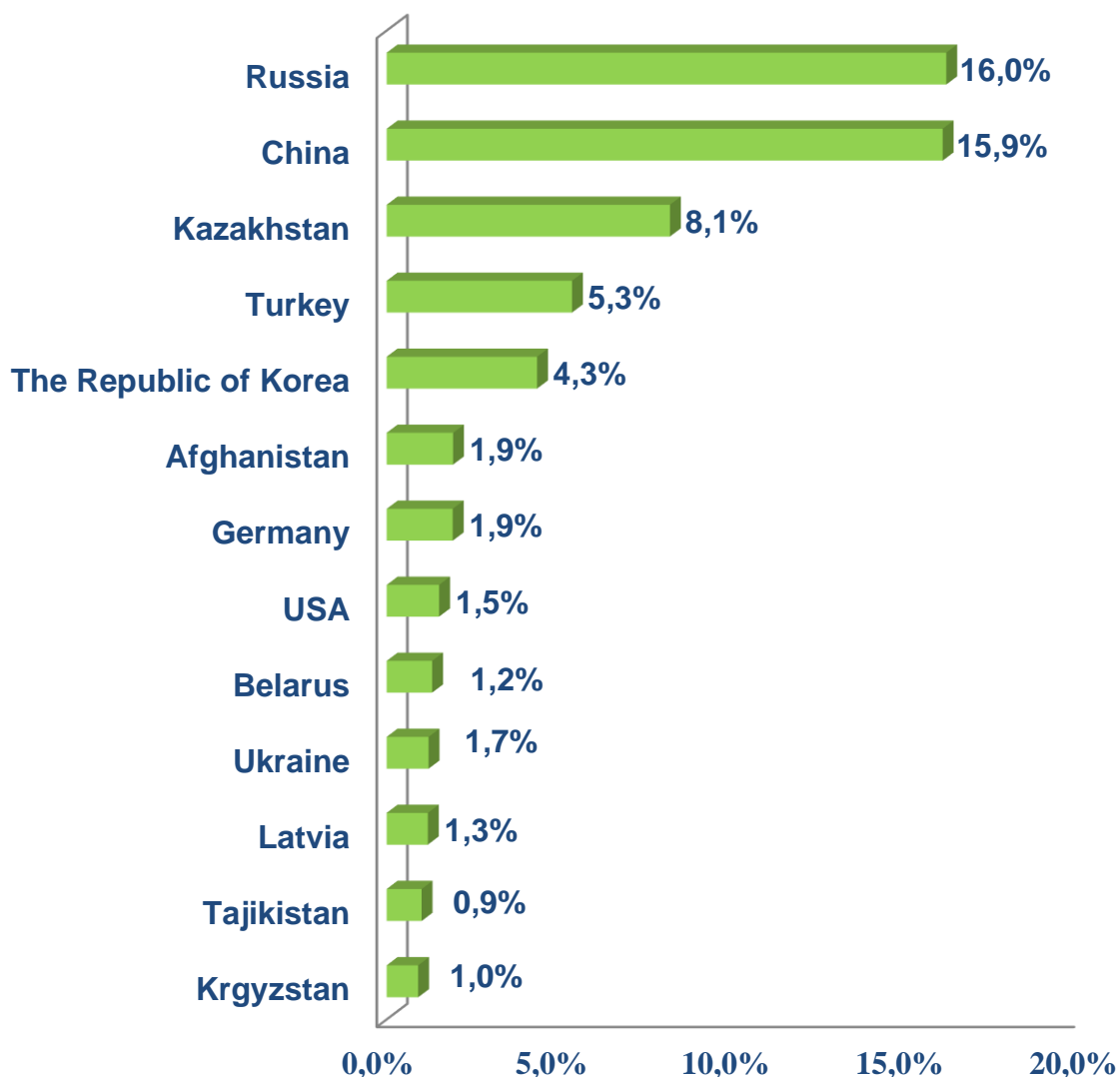

Among the CIS countries the main foreign trade partners are Russia, Kazakhstan, Belarus, Ukraine, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, which share is 28,4 percent of foreign trade turnover, among the non-CIS countries - China, Turkey, the Republic of Korea,

Afghanistan, Germany, USA, Latvia, Iran, France, India, which share is 34,6 percent of total foreign trade turnover.

Among the countries of the world the main partners in export are China, Russia, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Afghanistan, Kyrgyzstan, Iran, Tajikistan, France, Ukraine, the Republic of Korea, Singapore, which share is 56,2 percent, in import - Russia, China, Kazakhstan, the Republic of Korea, Turkey, Germany, USA, Latvia, Belarus, Ukraine, Lithuania, India, which share is 66,9 percent.

Export of energy and oil products increased as compared with the same period of the last year by 78,5 percent due to the export of natural gas by 91,6 percent.

Export of food products grew by 58,9 percent due to increase in the export of fruit and vegetable by 73,3 percent.

The share of services in total exports was 30,8 percent, of which 10,5 percent are transport services and 18,4 percent - trips.

A certain place in the structure of exports is occupied by other goods - 30,3 percent, where export of textiles amounted to USD 652,0 million and increased by 16,7 percent in comparison with the same period of the last year,

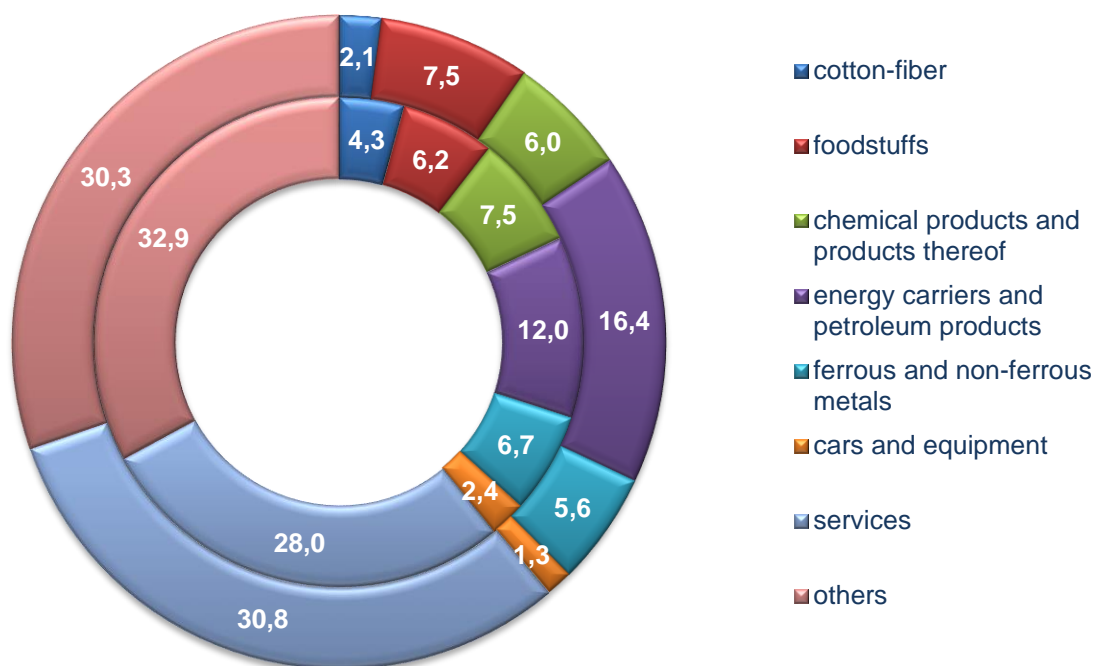
In the structure of imports the main share belongs to machinery and equipment – 33,8 percent and chemical products and articles thereof -11,5 percent.

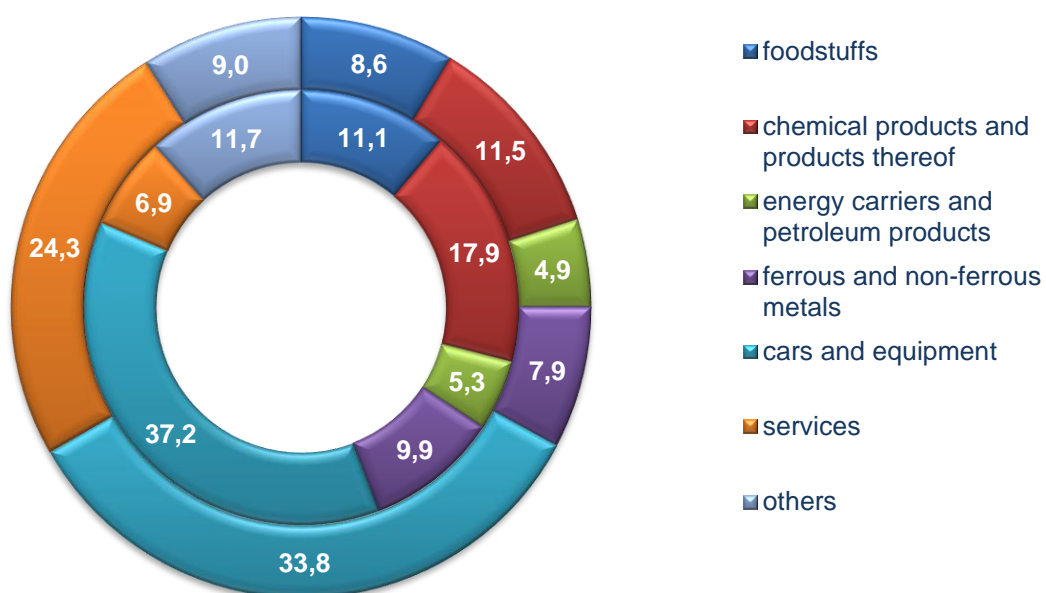

*(January-June 2018)*

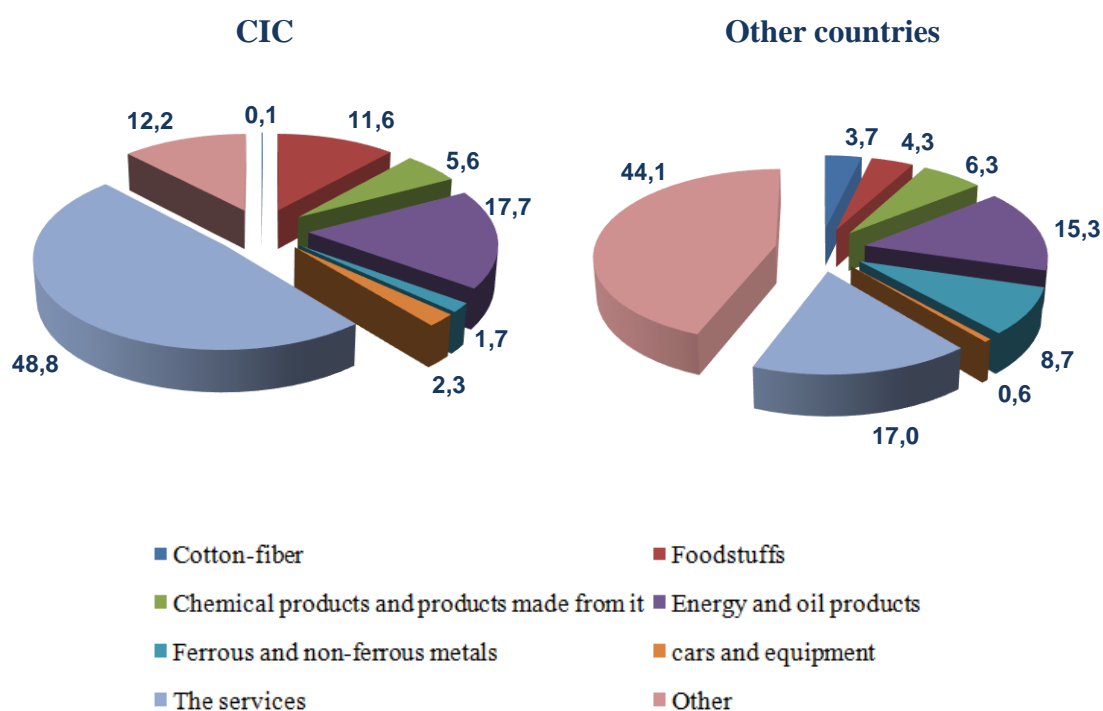
