


OFFENSES

According to the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the total number of recorded crimes for January-June 2018 was 21568 cases, and, compared with the corresponding period in 2017, decreased by 38.7%. In the calculation for 10.0 thousand of the population, this number was 6.6.


The comparative state of criminality in all lines of services in terms of the severity of the crimes committed,



In terms of severity in the Republic of Uzbekistan, there has been a decrease in particularly serious crimes from 1354 cases in January-June 2017 to 896 cases in the corresponding period of 2018 (by 33.8%). For serious crimes, there is also a decrease from 4,554 cases in January-June 2017 to 3565 cases in the corresponding period of 2018 (by 21.7%). Compared with the corresponding period 2017 (12125 cases), the number of less serious crimes amounted to 7017 cases in January-June 2018 (decreased by 42.1%).

The structure of crimes in the context of the territories is as follows: from the point of view of the gravity of the crimes committed, it is clear that the largest number is made of less serious crimes: from 24.1% in Tashkent to 35.2% in Jizzakh, Samarkand and Syrdarya regions; grave crimes in the republic are 16.5% and the lowest is 10.1 in the Surkhandarya and 10.2 in the Syrdarya region, and the largest is 23.9% and 19.9% in the city of Tashkent and the Khorezm region; especially grave crimes lie in the range of 2.5% in the Namangan region to 6.1% in the Samarkand region.

In January-June 2018, in all regions of Uzbekistan, in comparison with January-June of 2017, there was a decrease in the number of crimes: in the Syrdarya (by 50.4%), Kashkadarya (by 50.3%), Khorezm (by 40.5% %), Samarkand (40.0%), Bukhara (38.1%), Navoi (37.8%), Tashkent (36.3%), Surkhandarya (36.1%), Fergana (32.0%), Andizhan (26.8%), Jizzakh (25.3%), Namangan (25.0%), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (42.7%) and Tashkent 50.1%).


Number of registered crimes by types in the Republic of Uzbekistan for January-June 2018, units



The number of rapes and attempts to rape decreased by 62.8%, robberies by 58.8%, robberies by 58.6%, hooliganism by 50.1%, bribes (by 46.8%), , theft by misappropriation or embezzlement (by 43.0%), crimes against the foundations of the economy, in the sphere of economic activity, against the functioning of the authorities (by 39.3%), fraud (39.2%), crimes related to illegal drug trafficking (23.3%), deliberate grievous bodily harm (17.7%), premeditated murders and attempts at murder (17.6%).

Also, the number of thefts from shops and other outlets decreased (by 45.7%), bicycle and moped burglaries - by 45.6%, thefts from apartments and private houses (by 43.6%).

The proportion of minors among the identified persons who committed crimes in January-June 2017-2018.




As can be seen from the graph, the largest number of minors among the identified persons who committed crimes is in Surkhandarya region - 3.4% and, further, with a decrease: 2.6% in Namangan, 2.5% in Bukhara, 2.3 % to Fergana, 2.0% to Syrdarya region, 1.9% to the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Khorezm region, 1.7% to Tashkent, Jizzakh, Andijan, Samarkand and Tashkent regions, 1.4% to Kashkadarya region and less than one percent - 0.9% to Navoi region.

In comparison with the same period in 2017, in some areas there was a slight increase in this indicator, for example in Tashkent by 1.2%, by 0.7% in Jizzakh and Namangan regions, by 0.6% in Bukhara region, by 0, 5% in the Samarkand region, 0.4% in the Syrdarya

region, 0.3% in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Navoi region. However, there are also small positive changes in this indicator: 0.8% decreased in Tashkent, 0.7% in Tashkent region, 0.3% in Kashkadarya and Fergana oblasts and 0.1% in Andijan and Khorezm regions.

The total number of identified perpetrators of crimes was 23143 and, compared to the corresponding period in 2017, decreased by 39.3%. 18031 of them were brought to criminal liability, or 56.6% of the number of those brought to criminal liability in January - June 2017.

In the sex distribution, the number of identified persons who committed crimes decreased among women (by 40.8%) and men (by 39.0%).

By employment at the time of the crime, the number of persons who committed crimes among able-bodied, unemployed and not students (by 44.0%), students of general and specialized secondary, vocational educational institutions (by 42.0%).

Among all categories of persons who previously committed crimes (by 43.4%), in a state of alcoholic intoxication (by 41.7%), persons who committed crimes in the group (by 40.5%) who committed crimes, the number of minors decreased (by 39.7%).
