

VII. PRIVATIZATION OF ENTERPRISES AND OBJECTS

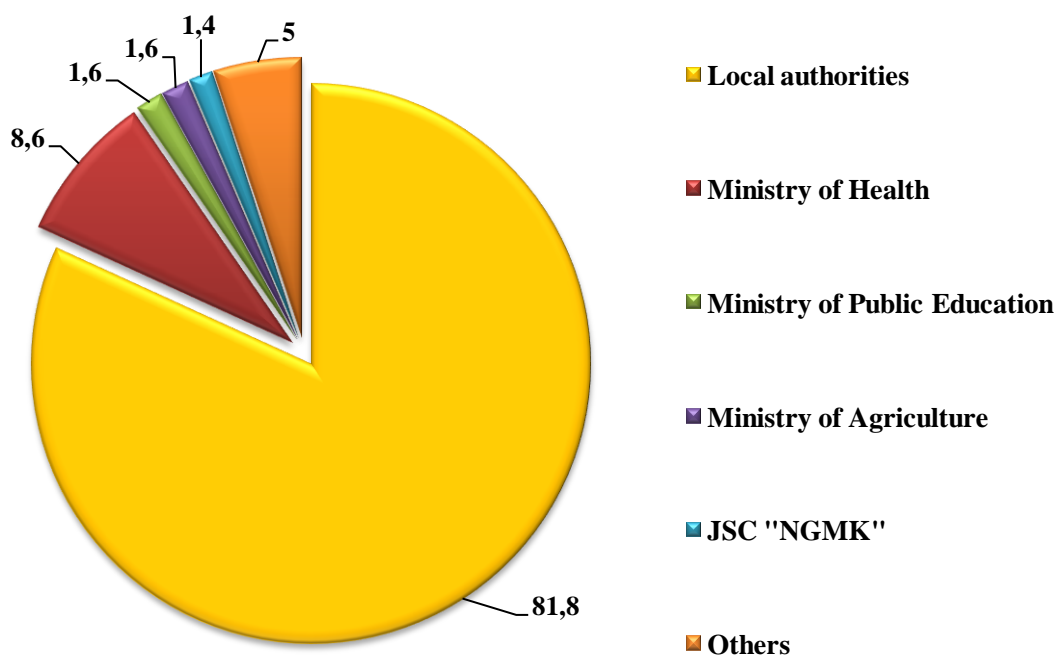
According to the State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Assistance to Privatized Enterprises and the Development of Competition, in January-December 2018, 835 enterprises and objects (hereinafter referred to as facilities) were privatized (including program and non-program facilities).

In the reporting period, the largest number of objects were privatized in the Tashkent region - 133 objects (15.9 % of the total number of privatized objects in the republic), Fergana region - 84 objects (10.1 %), and the Republic of Karakalpakstan - 74 objects (8.9 %) Surkhandarya region - 73 objects (8.7 %), Kashkadarya region - 69 objects (8.2 %), Andijan region - 66 objects (8.0 %).

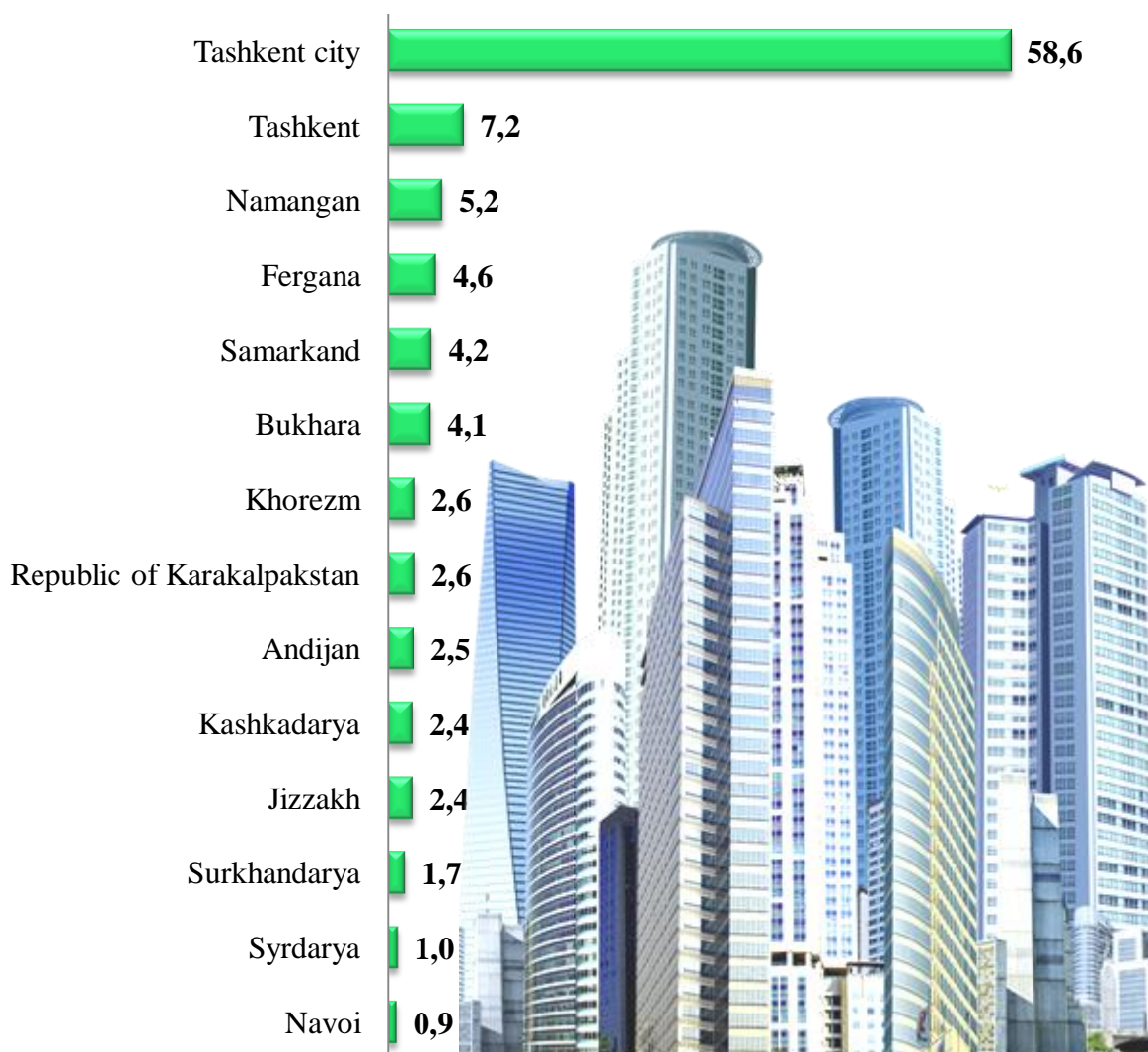
The structure of privatized state property by ministries and departments in January-December 2018 (% of the total)



In the structure of privatized state property, the largest share falls on objects of local authorities - 683 objects (81.8 % of the total number of objects privatized in the republic), the Ministry of Health - 72 objects (8.6 %), the Ministry of Public Education –13 objects (1.6 %), Ministry of Agriculture –13 objects (1.6 %), Navoi Mining and Smelting Complex - 12 objects (1.4 %).

The flow of funds from the privatization of state property in January-December 2018 amounted to 223.0 billion soums.

Territorially, the largest share of state property privatization comes from Tashkent city (58.6 % of all revenues), Tashkent (7.2 %), Namangan (5.2 %), Fergana (4.6 %), Samarkand (4.2 %) and Bukhara (4.1 %) regions.

In order to effectively use the state non-residential fund, in 2018 more than 30.9 thousand lease agreements were concluded. As a result, more than 5.5 thousand new jobs were created. From the transfer to lease of state property in general received 135.0 billion soums.

Territorially, the largest part of the revenues from the lease of state property falls on the Tashkent city (50.7 % of all revenues), Tashkent (7.3 %), Andijan (5.3 %), Samarkand (4.6%), Bukhara (4.5 %) regions.
