

DEMOGRAPHIC SITUATION

According to the preliminary data, the number of the resident population in the republic as of July 1, 2017 was 32345,0 thousand and has increased from the beginning of the current year by 224,5 thousand or 0,7 percent. The number of urban population was 16353,0 thousand (or 50,6 percent of total population) and that of rural population - 15992,0 thousand (49,4 percent).

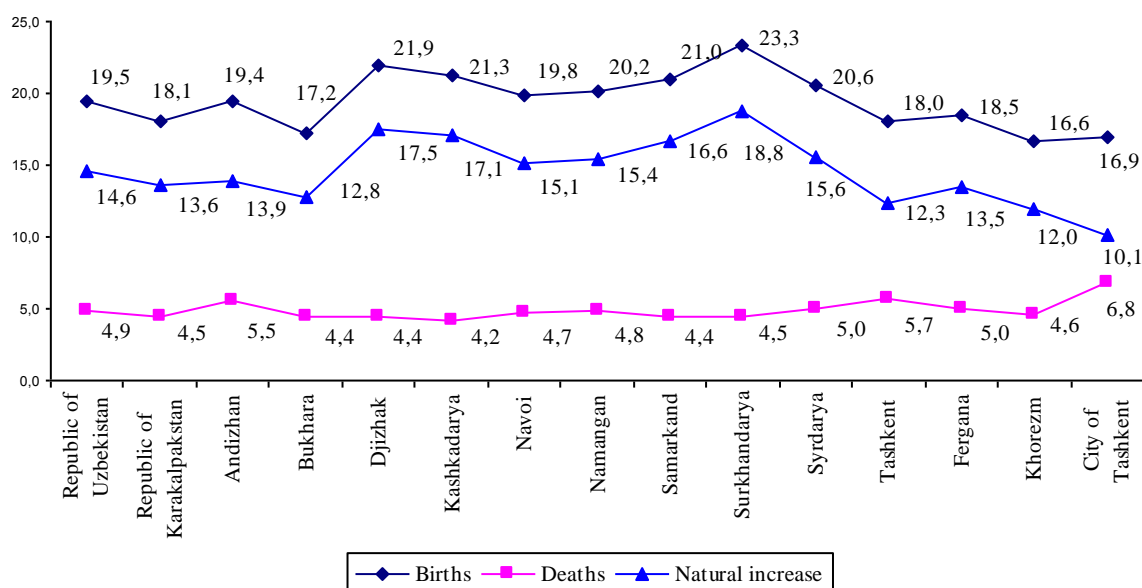
Vital statistics throughout the Republic as a whole in January-June are characterized by the following data:

Births. In January-June 2017 the number of births was 311,9 thousand and in comparison with January-June 2016 (317,9 thousand) decreased by 6,0 thousand, and respectively, the birth rate was 19,5 per mille.

The most significant decrease in birth rate is marked in Tashkent region (from 19,1 per mille to 18,0 per mille), Kashkadarya region (from 22,2 per mille to 21,3 per mille), Fergana region (from 19,4 per mille to 18,5 per mille), Khorezm region (from 17,5 per mille to 16,6 per mille), Djizhak region (from 22,7 per mille to 21,9 per mille), Namangan region (from 20,9 per mille to 20,2 per mille), Bukhara region (from 17,8 per mille to 17,2 per mille), Samarkand region (from 21,6 per mille to 21,0 per mille), and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (from 19,2 per mille to 18,1 per mille).

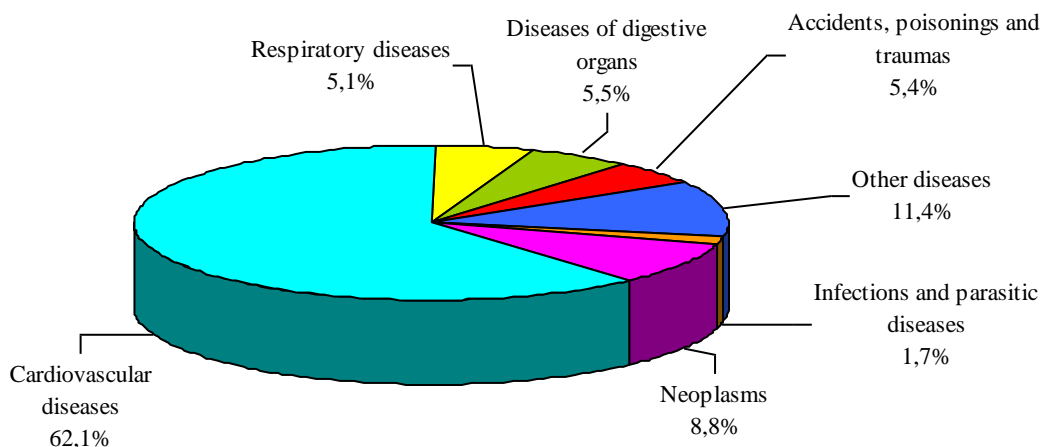
Deaths. In January-June 2017 the number of deaths was 78,8 thousand and in comparison with January-June 2016 (73,9 thousand) increased by 4,9 thousand, and respectively, the death rate was 4,9 pro mil (in January-June 2016 - 4,7 per mille).

The significant growth in the death rate was marked in Andizhan region (from 5,0 per mille to 5,5 per mille), Djizhak region (from 4,0 per mille to 4,4 per mille), Kashkadarya region (from 3,8 per mille to 4,2 per mille), Namangan region (from 4,4 per mille to 4,8 per mille), Surkhandarya region (from 4,1 per mille to 4,5 per mille), Fergana region (from 4,7 per mille to 5,0 per mille), Khorezm region (from 4,3 per mille to 4,6 per mille), and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (from 4,2 per mille to 4,5 per mille).

The decrease in the death rate is observed in the city of Tashkent (from 6,9 per mille to 6,8 per mille).

The lowest morbidity level is marked in Kashkadarya region (4,2 per mille), Bukhara region (4,4 per mille), Djizhak region (4,4 per mille), and Samarkand region (4,4 per mille).

In the structure of total deaths cardiovascular diseases make up 62,1 percent, neoplasms – 8,8 percent, diseases of digestive organs – 5,5 percent, accidents, poisonings and traumas – 5,4 percent, respiratory diseases – 5,1 percent, infectious and parasitic diseases – 1,7 percent, other diseases – 11,4 percent.



According to the preliminary data , 63 maternal deaths were recorded in January-June 2017, the maternal mortality ratio was 20,2 per mille (per 100,000 live births).

High maternal mortality rate was marked in Navoi region – 43,2 (per 100,000 live births), Kashkadarya region – 30,5 , Djizhak – 28,2 , Tashkent region – 27,7 , and the city of Tashkent – 24,5.

In January-June 2017 according to the preliminary data, 3,9 thousand children died at the age under one year. The infant death rate was 10,9 per mille (in January-June 2016 – 10,2 per mille).

High infant mortality was marked in the city of Tashkent – 18,1 (per 1000 live births), Khorezm region – 15,8, Andizhan region – 15,3, Djizhak region – 14,3, Syrdarya region – 14,0, Namangan region – 13,6, and the Republic of Karakalpakstan – 14,4.

Of the total number of children who died at the age under 1 year, 56,2 percent died of states occurring in perinatal period, 23,2 percent - respiratory diseases, 11,8 percent - congenital anomalies, 3,0 percent – infectious and parasitic diseases, 1,3 percent - from

accidents, poisoning and injuries, 0,2 percent - diseases of the digestive organs, 4,3 percent - other diseases.

Marriages and divorces. In January-June of the current year 96,3 thousand marriages and 15,6 thousand divorces were registered. There were 6,0 marriages (in January-June 2016 – 5,9 marriages) and 1,0 divorces (in January-June 2016 – 0,9 divorces) per 1000 population.

Migration. According to the preliminary data, in January-June 2017 the number of immigrants was 82,5 thousand persons and that of emigrants – 91,0 thousand persons. Balance of migration was minus 8,5 thousand persons versus minus 12,5 thousand persons in the corresponding period of 2016.

The most negative migration balance is observed in Tashkent region (- 3,3), Samarkand region (- 2,8), Kashkadarya region (- 1,8), Fergana region (- 1,4), Bukhara region (- 1,2), Andizhan region (- 1,0), and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (- 2,1). The positive balance of migration is marked in the city of Tashkent (+ 7,7).
