Production of market services by kinds of economic activities in January-June 2017 is characterized by the following data:

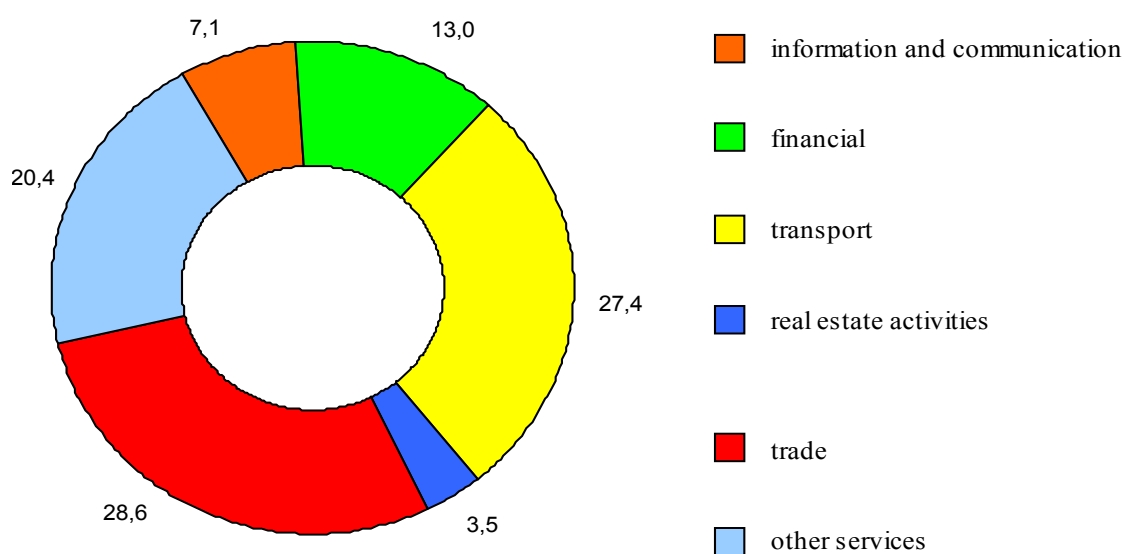

The highest growth rate of services was achieved in the city of Tashkent (113,7 percent), and Namangan region (111,9 percent).

The greatest volume of services per capita is marked in the city of Tashkent (6298,8 thousand soums), Tashkent region (1538,6 thousand soums), and Navoi region (1523,6 thousand soums).

More than 50 percent of services rendered in the republic fall on the city of Tashkent (31,4 percent), Tashkent region (8,9 percent), Samarkand region (6,3 percent), Fergana region (6,2 percent) and Andizhan region (5,9 percent).

In the services sector the share of the non-government sector (89,9 percent) prevails over the state sector (10,1 percent) and make up 43890,0 billion soums.
