

FOREIGN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

In January-September 2017 the republic's external trade turnover was USD 19 951,5 million, of which USD – 10359,6 million – exports, USD – 9 591,9 million – imports.

The positive balance of foreign trade was USD – 767,7 million: with CIS countries - USD – 715,8 million, with non-CIS countries – USD – 51,9 million.

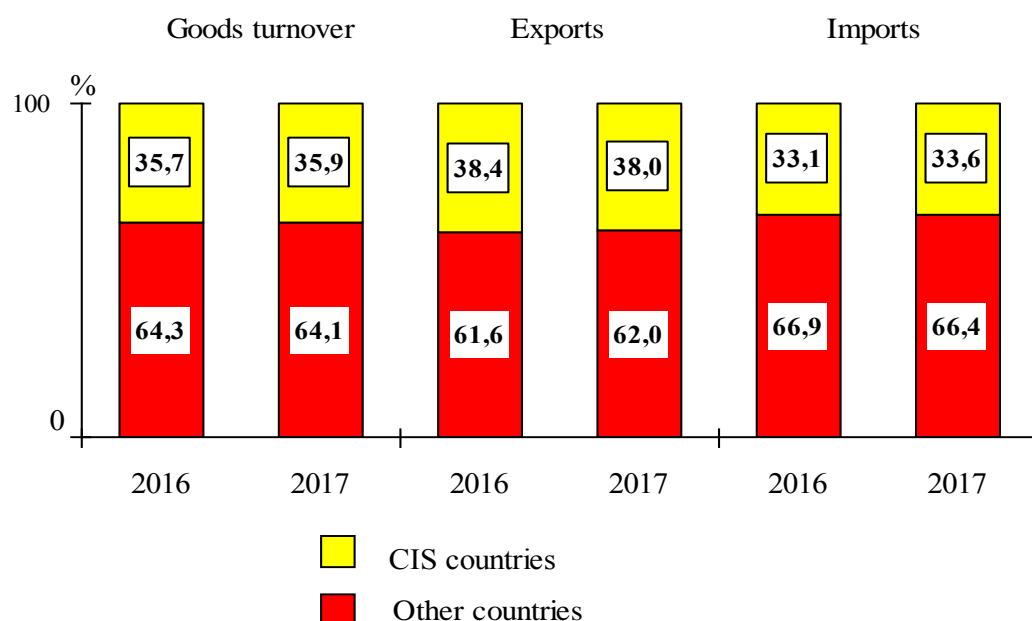

Foreign trade operations of the residents of the republic are mainly carried out with the countries of Asia (45,7 percent of the total volume of trade turnover), Europe (44,2 percent) and America (2,6 percent), which share is 92,5 percent of total turnover.

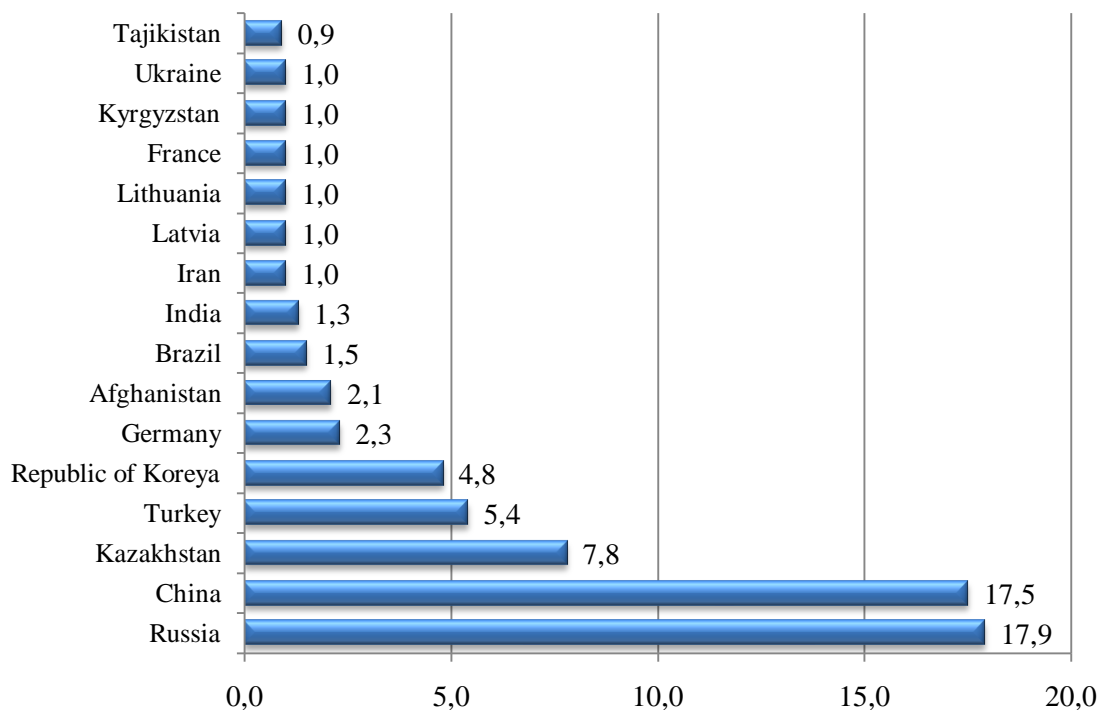

Among the CIS countries the main foreign trade partners are Russia, Kazakhstan, Ukraine, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, which share is 28,6 percent of foreign trade turnover, among the non-CIS countries – China, Turkey, the Republic of Korea, Germany, Afghanistan, Brazil, India, Iran, Latvia, Lithuania, France, the United States, Italy which share is 40,4 percent of total foreign trade turnover.

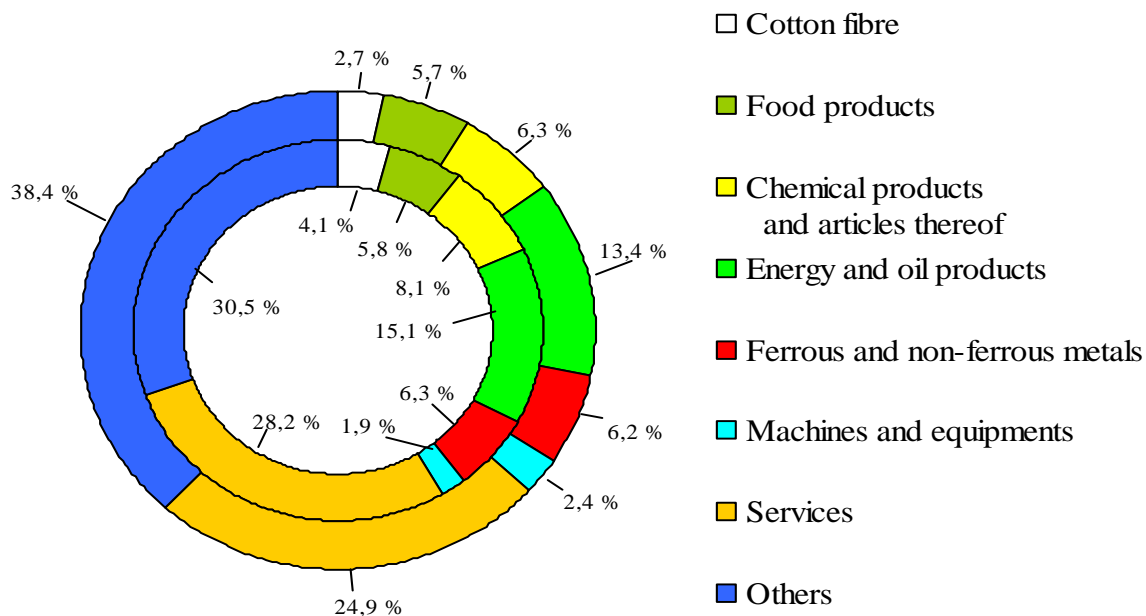

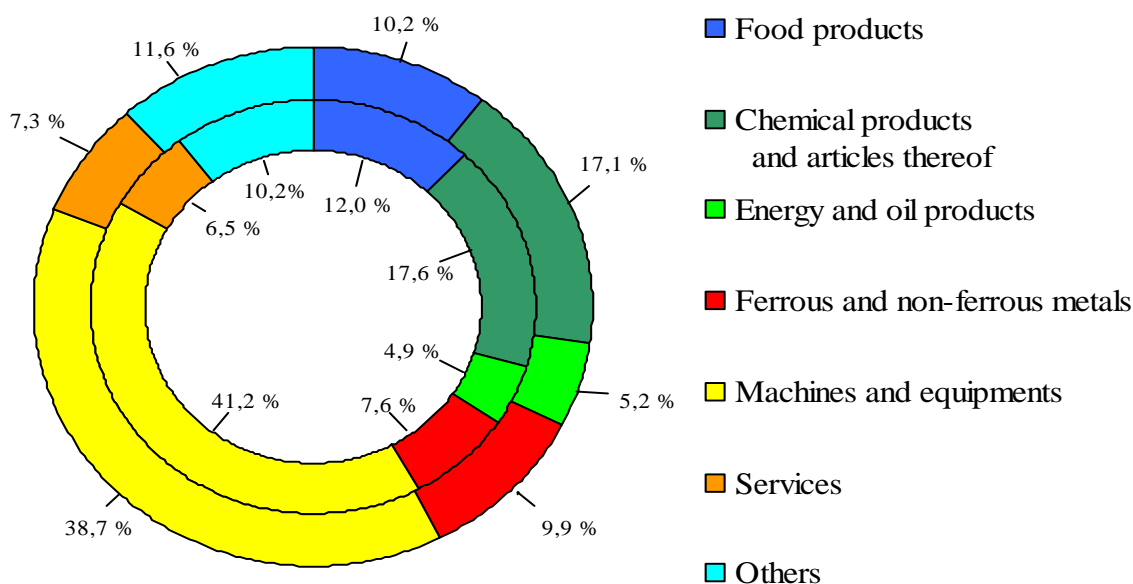

 internal ring for January-September 2016)



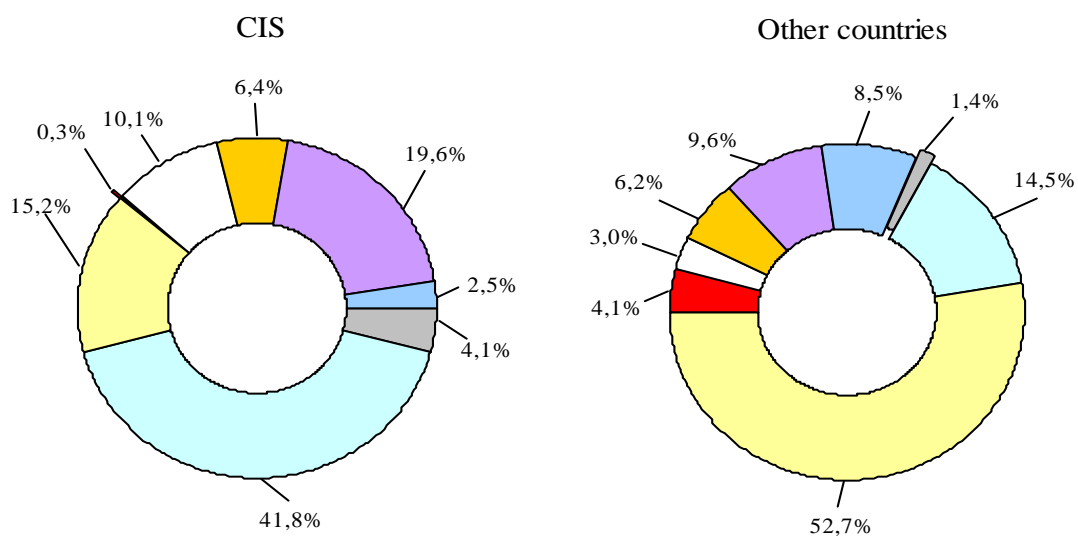
Structure of import of goods and services, as percent of total
